[57] CLAIM

I claim the ornamental design for an in-line skate shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side perspective view of my new design of a in-line skate shoe;

FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a front perspective view thereof.

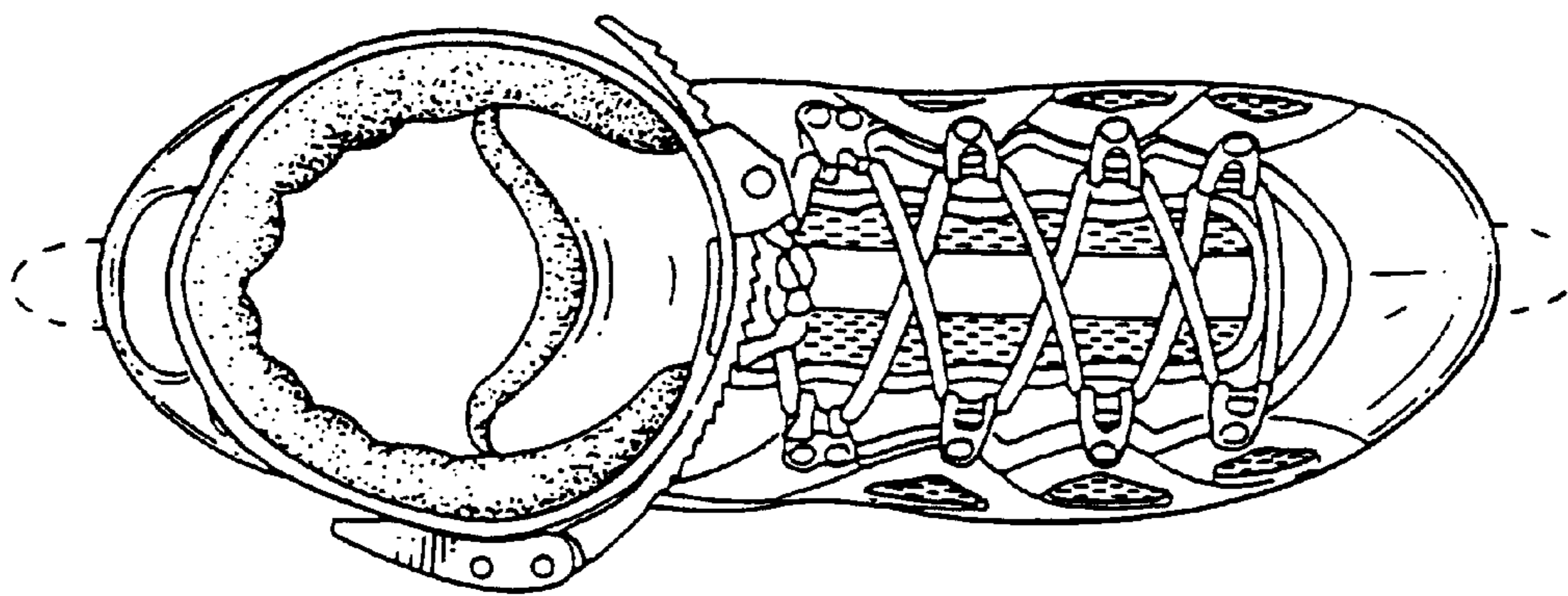
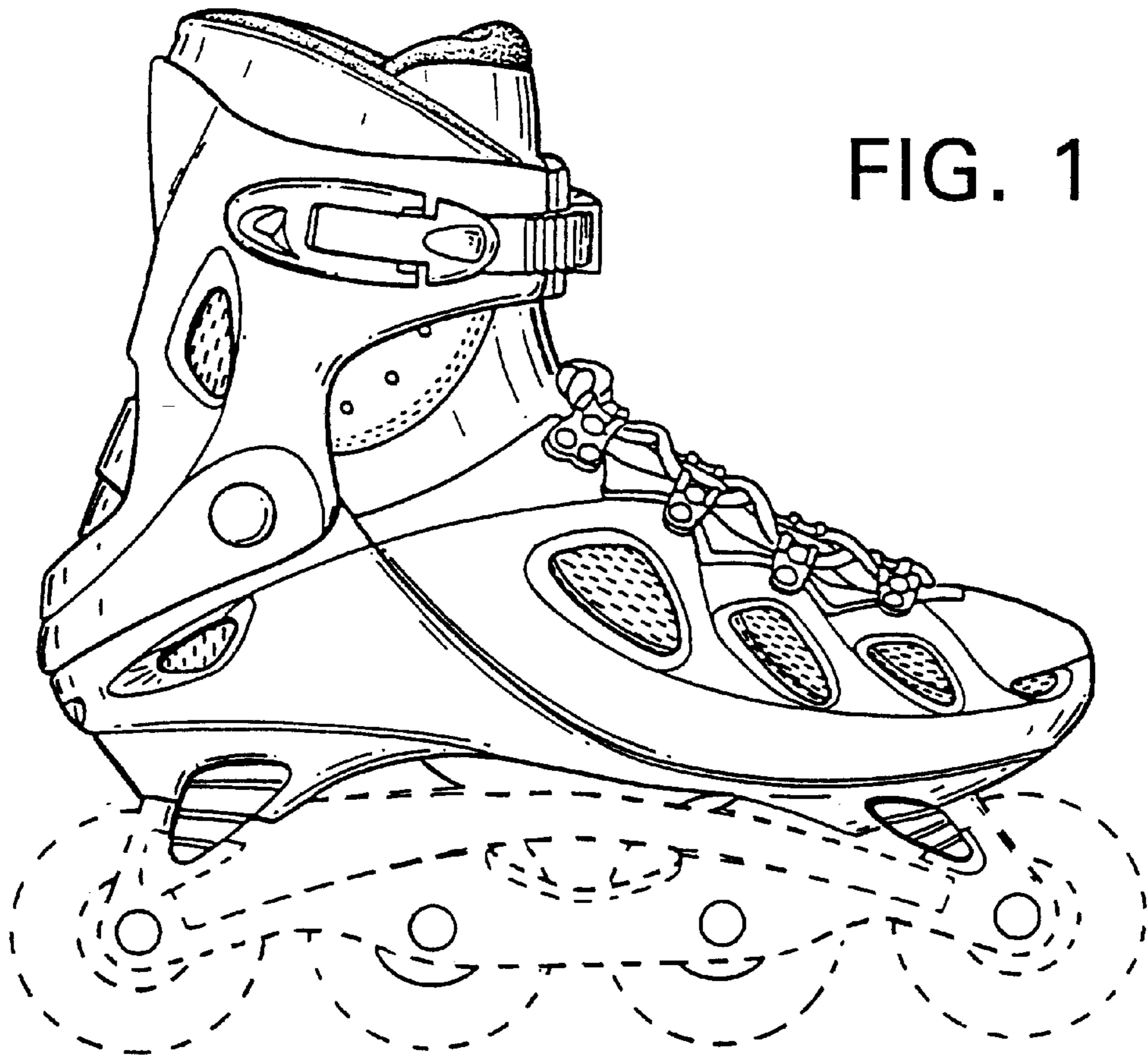

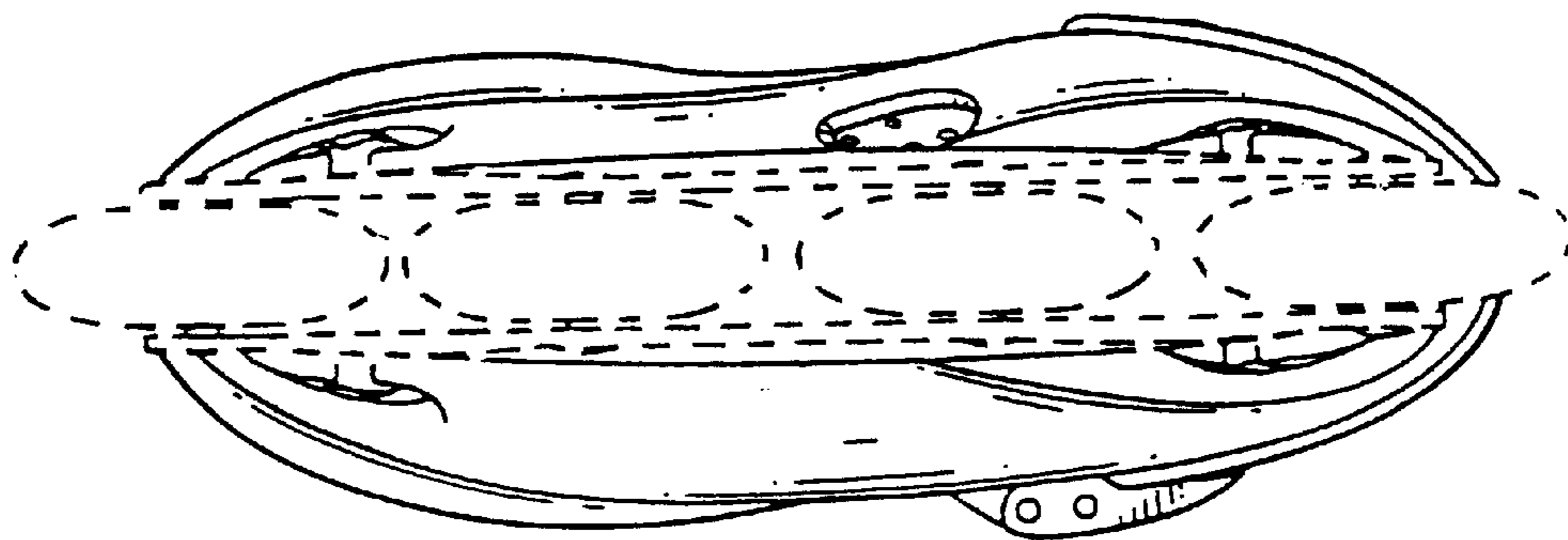

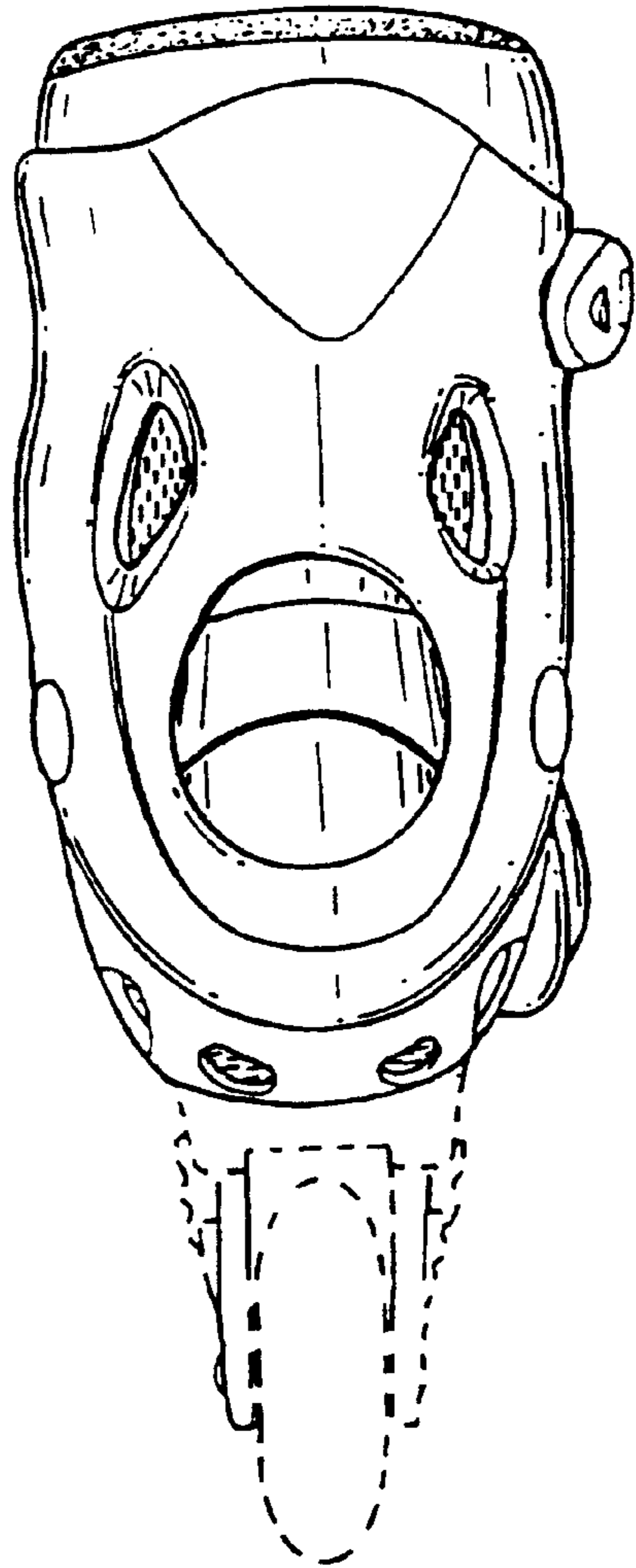
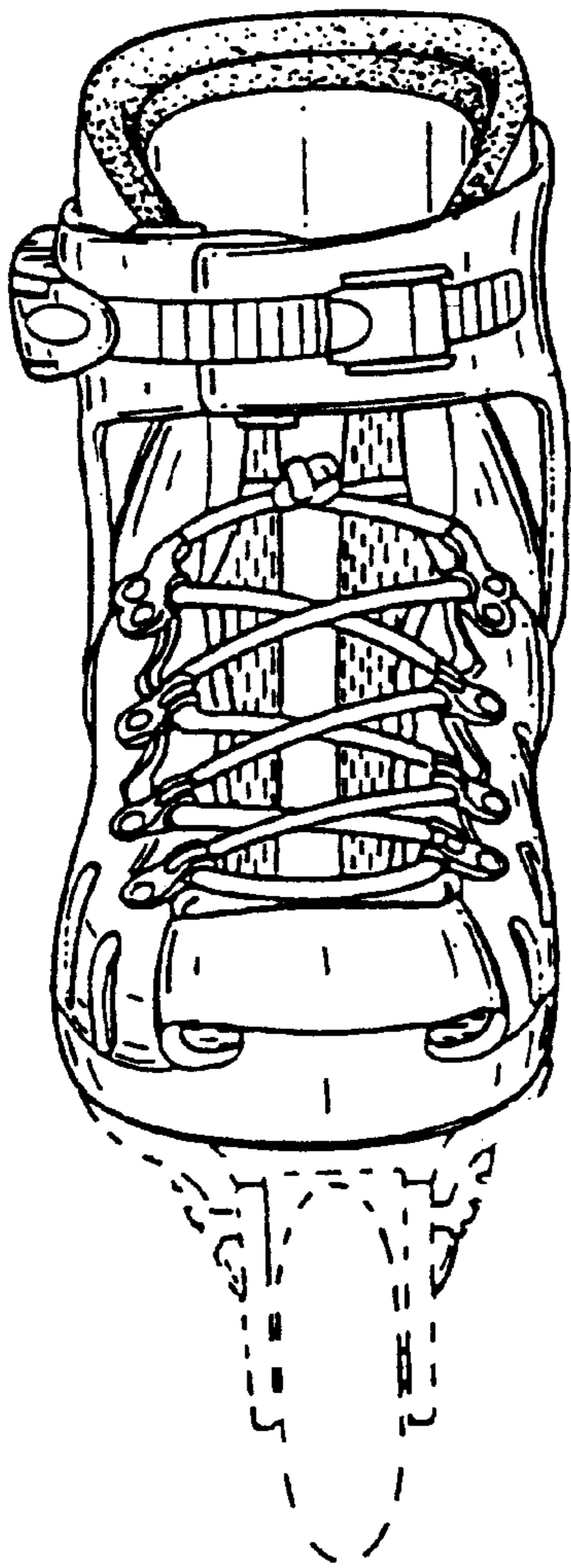
