[57] **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for an embossed tissue, as
shown and described.

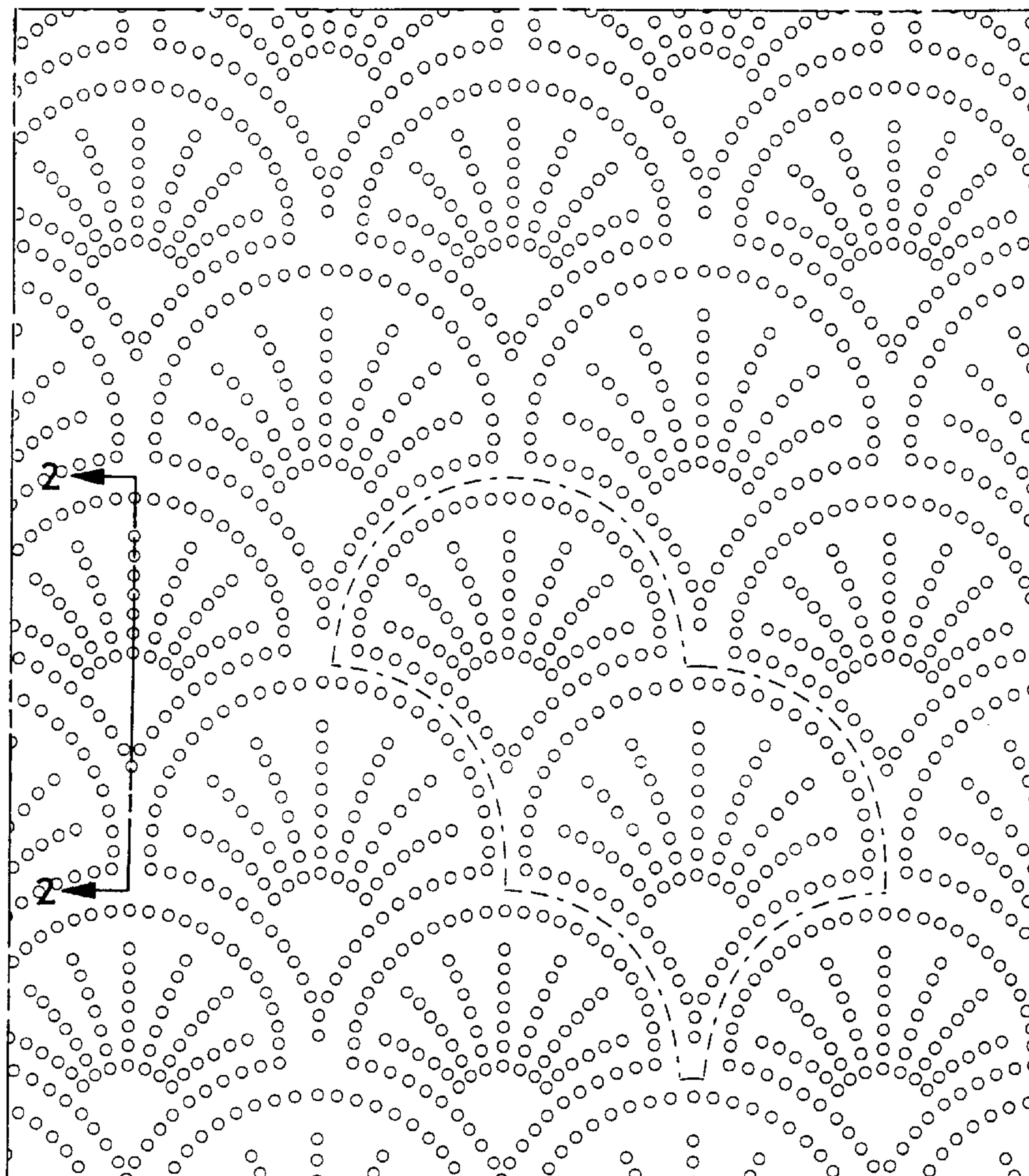
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of an embossed tissue illustrating the
claimed design. A repeat unit is outlined in phantom lines,
which form no part of the claimed design; and,
FIG. 2 is a fragmentary sectional view of the tissue of FIG.
1 taken along line 2-2 .

The surfaces or portions of the article not shown in the
drawing or deccribed in the specification form no part of the
claimed design.

In FIG. 1 , the outermost broken lines depict the boundaries
of the claimed design and form no part thereof.

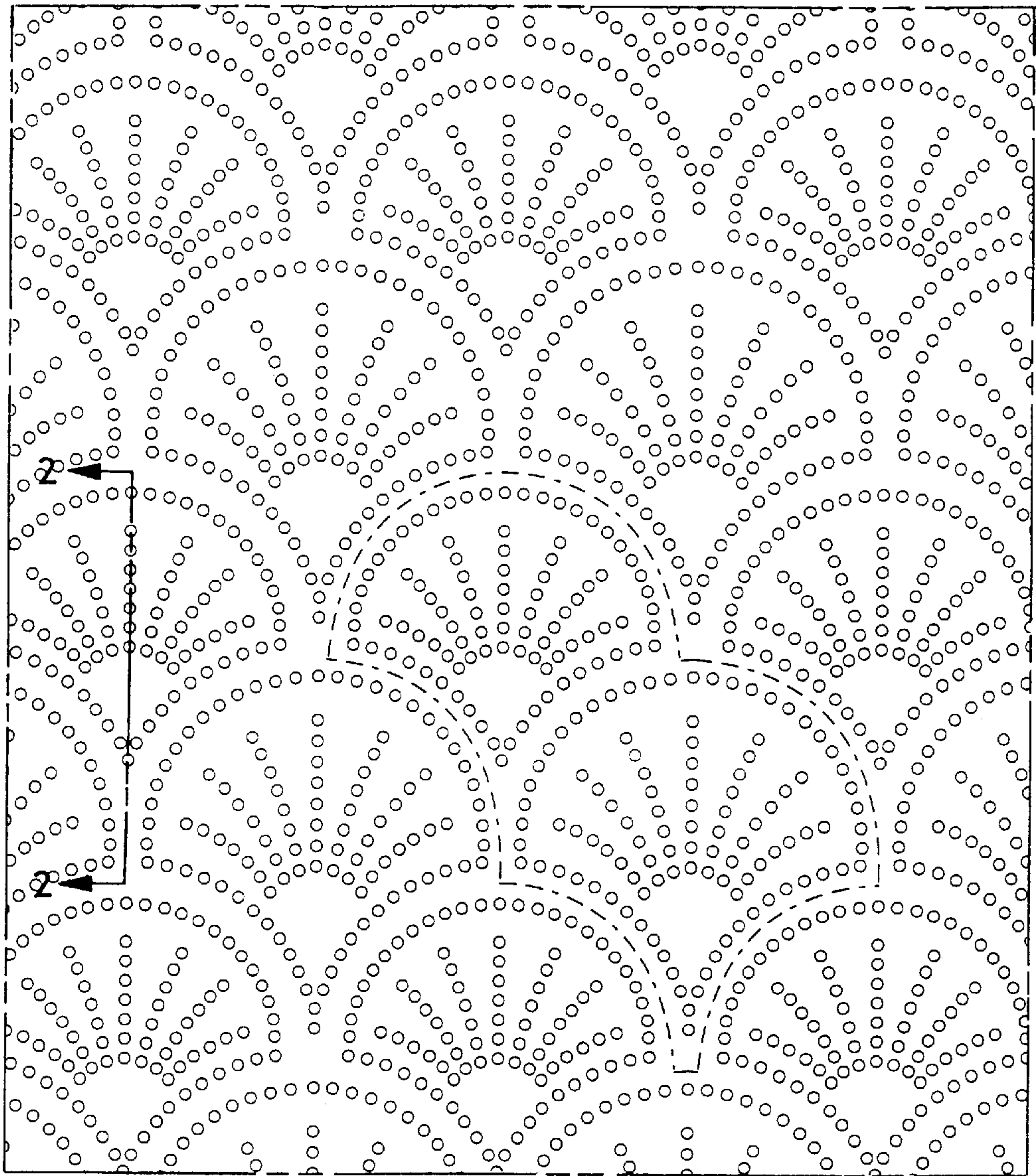
