[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of a handle embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the right side, left side, and rear elevational views being identical to the front elevational view shown;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line representations of an escutcheon in FIGS. 1–4, and of mounting structure in FIG. 4, are for the purpose of illustration only, and form no part of the claimed design.

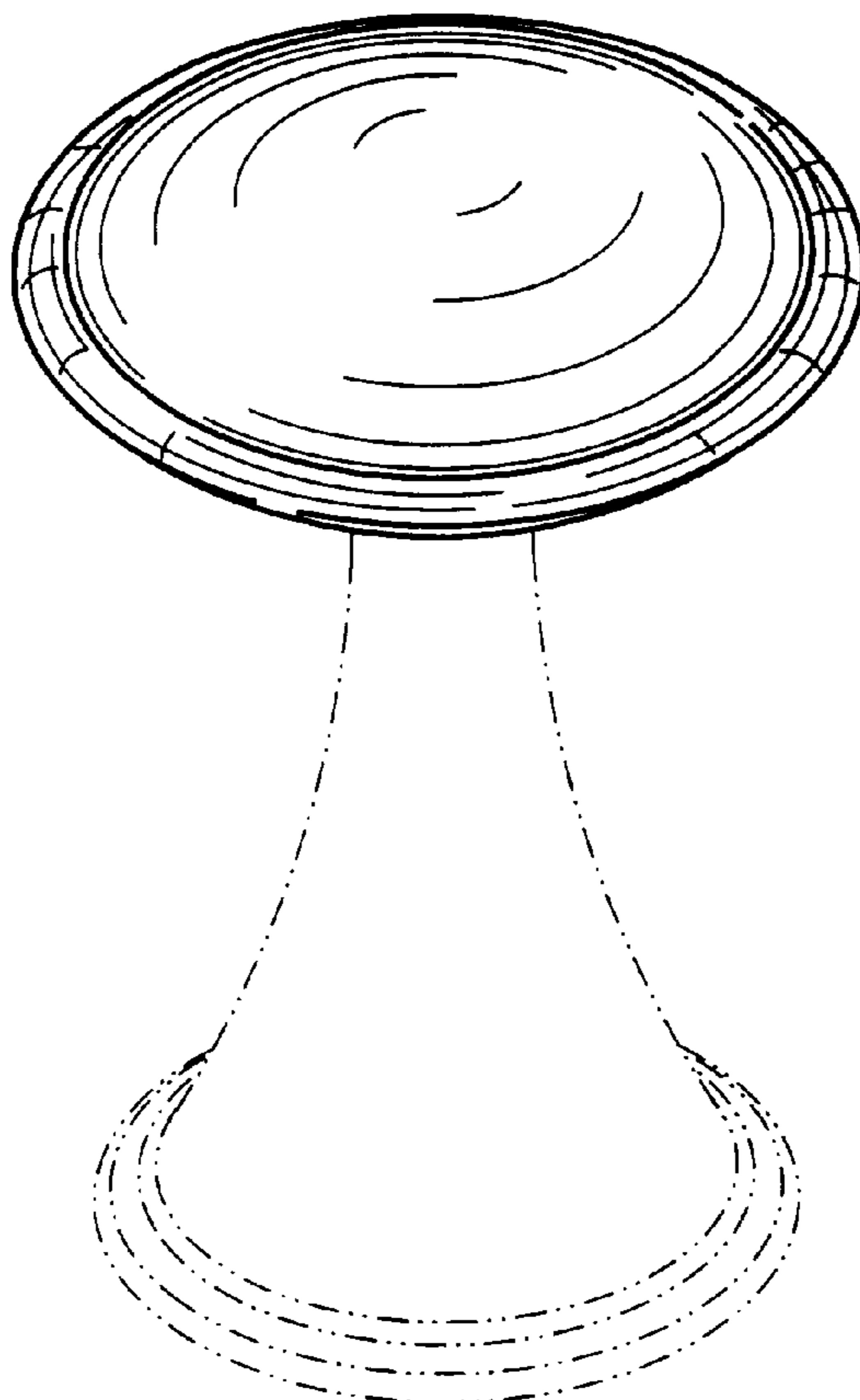

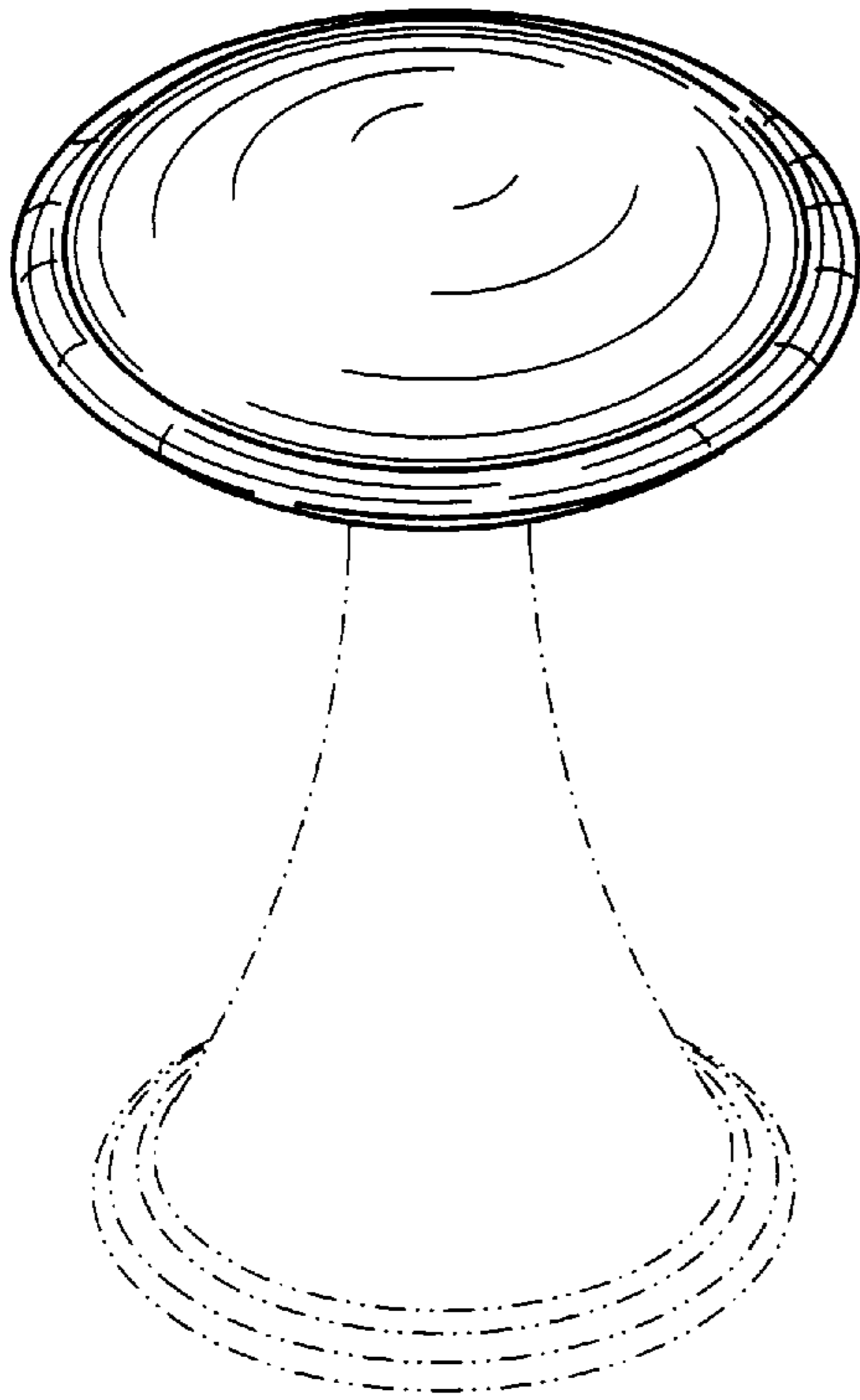

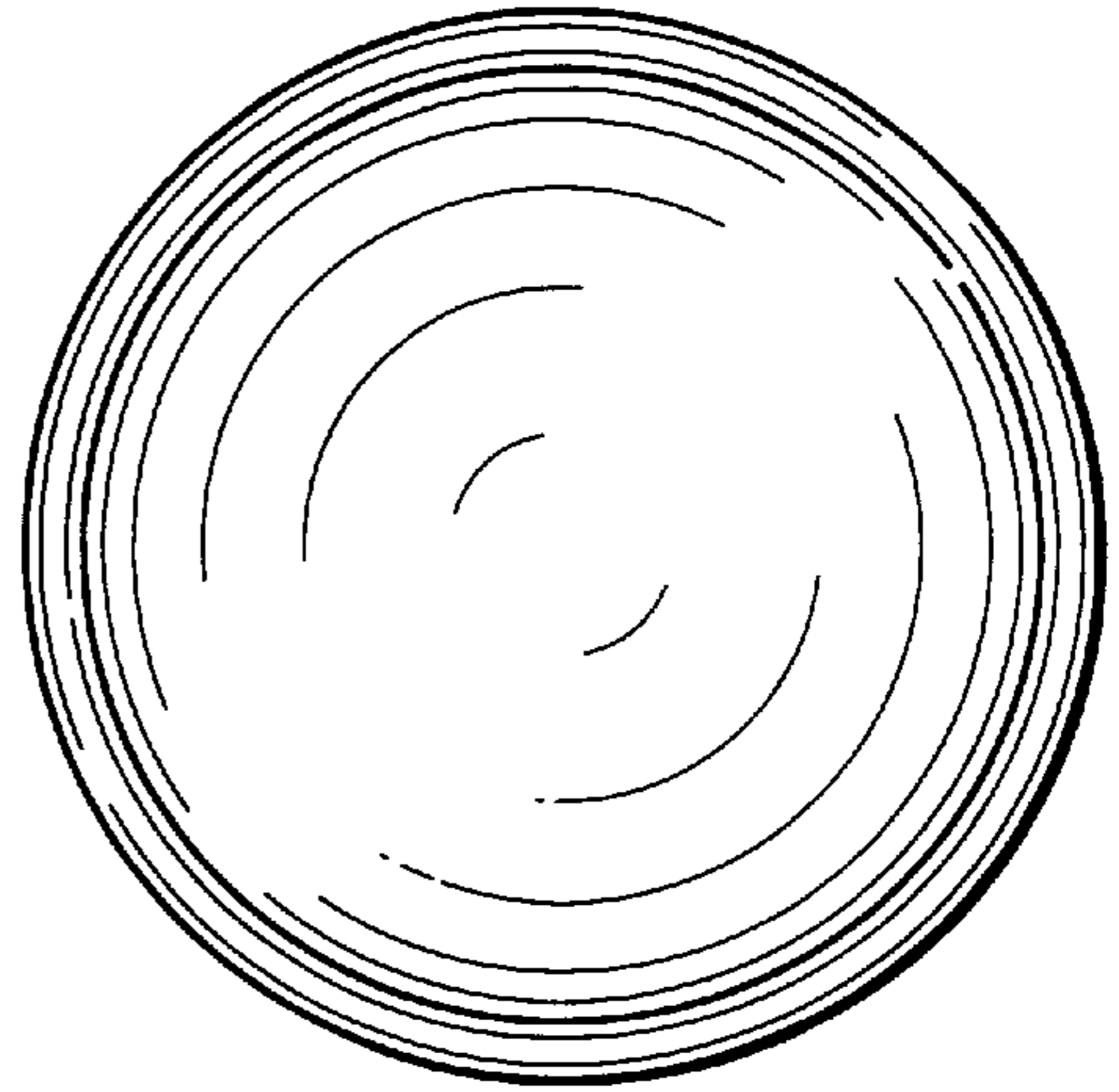

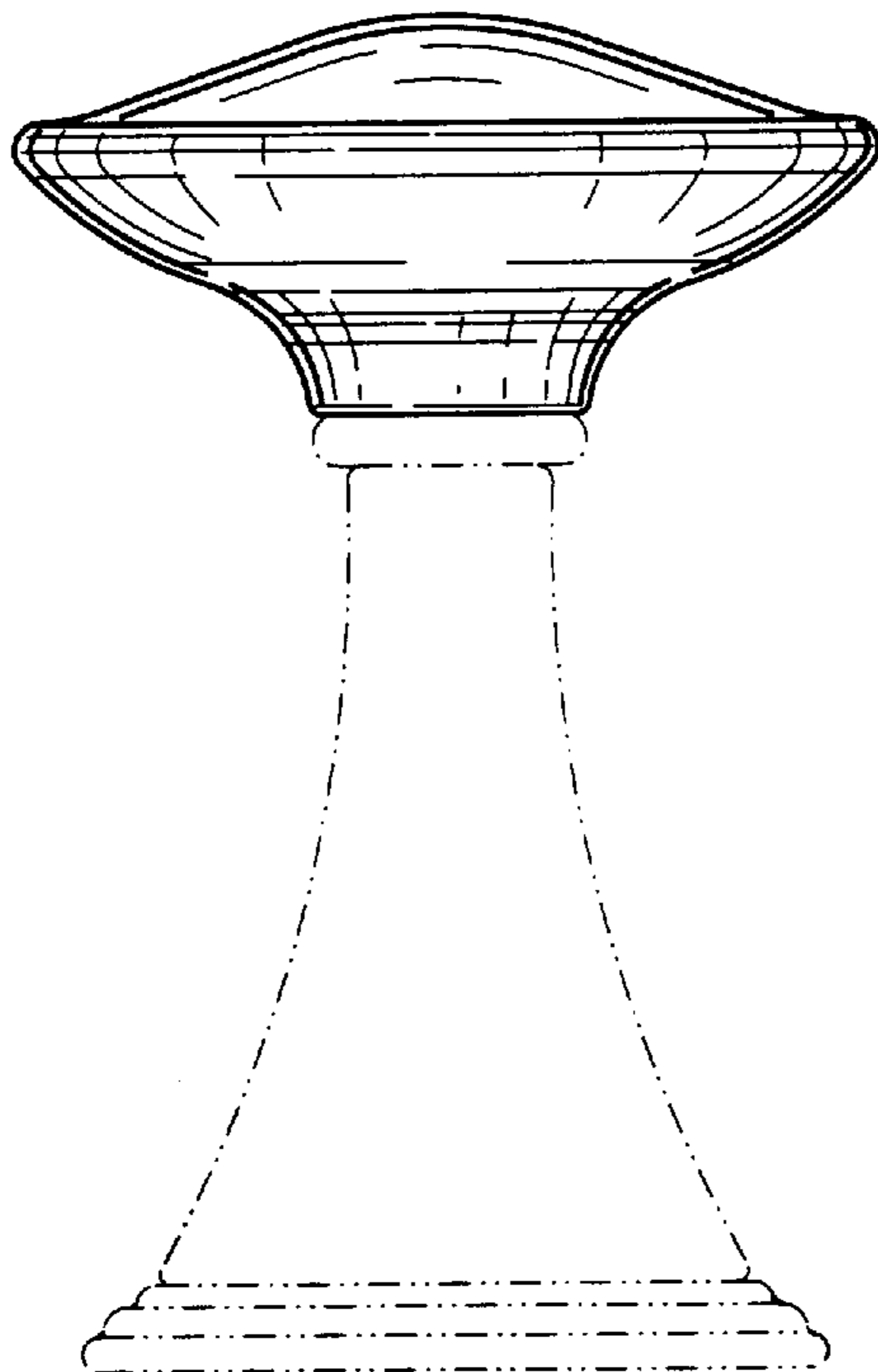
