The ornamental design for a torchiere lamp, as shown and described.

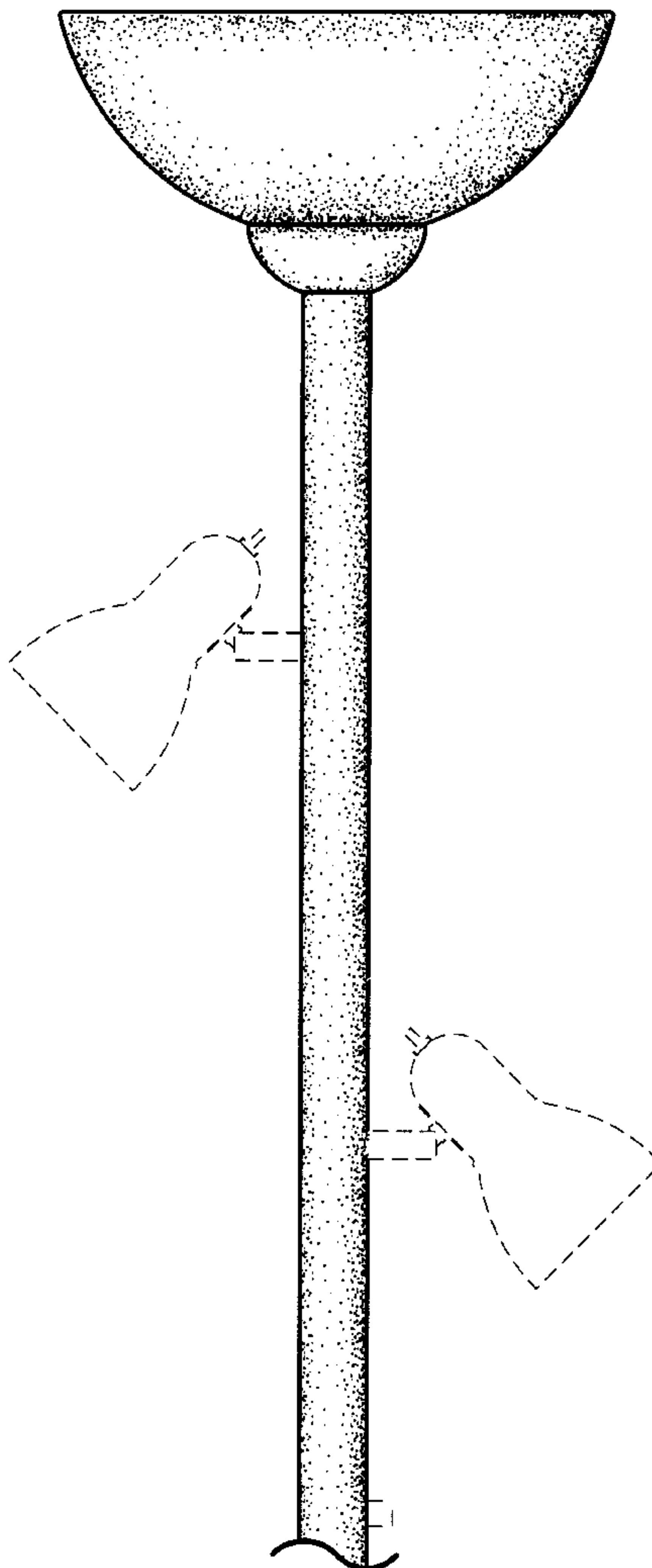
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view thereof;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear, left side, and right side views being identical to that shown;  
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and,  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line showing of environmental structure in FIGS. 1-4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

The pole has been shown broken away at the bottom to indicate indeterminate length.

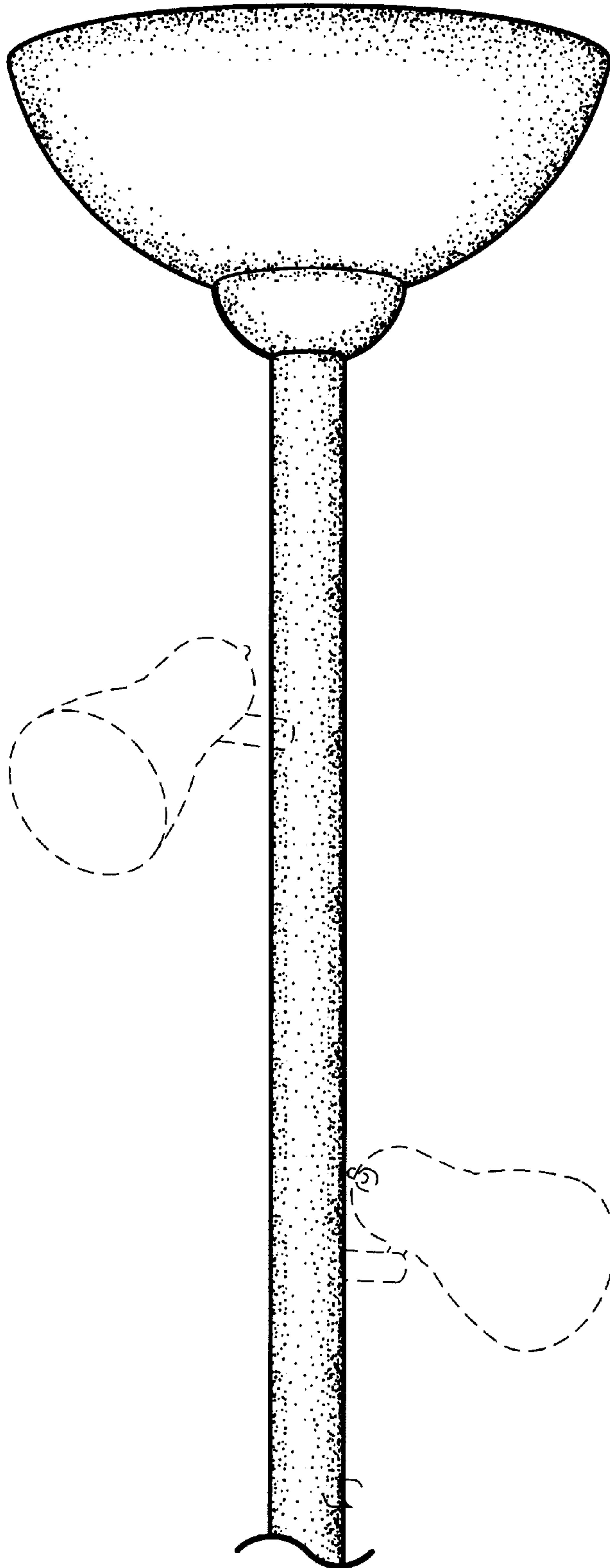

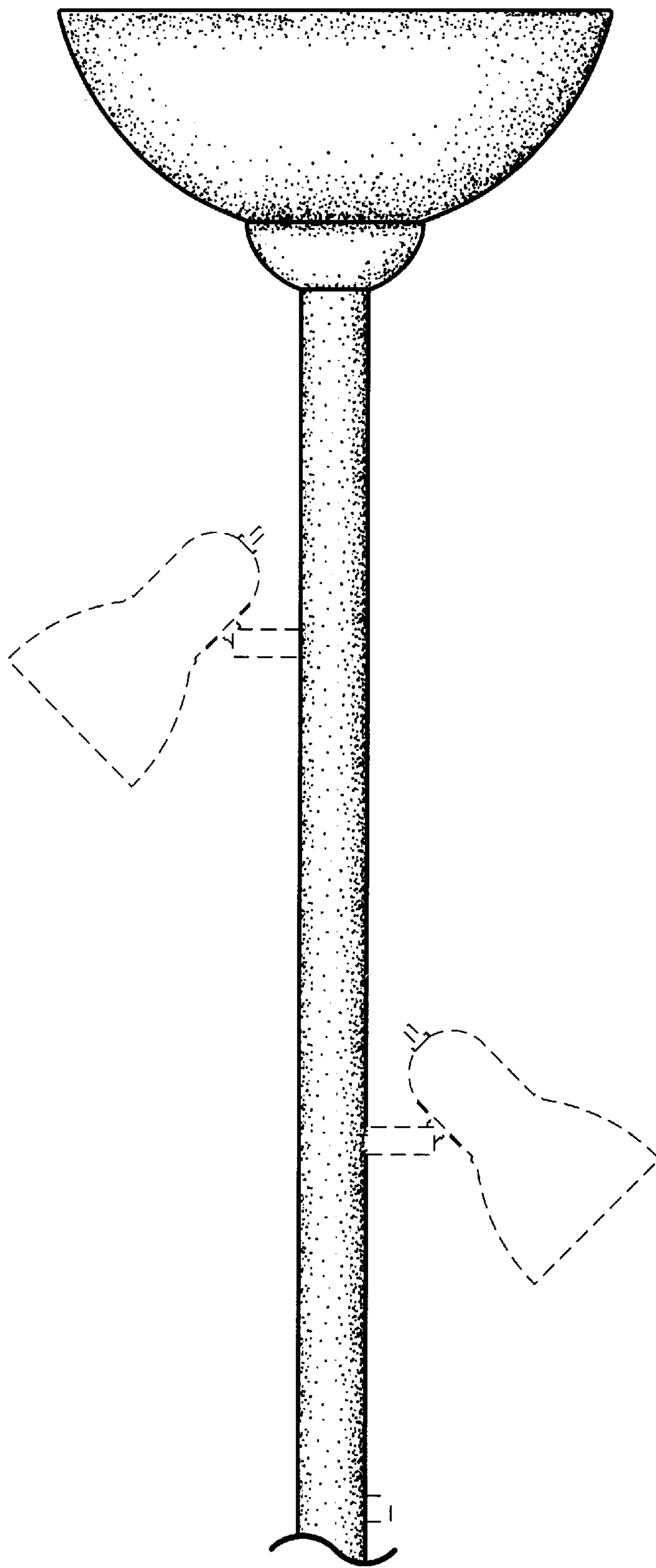
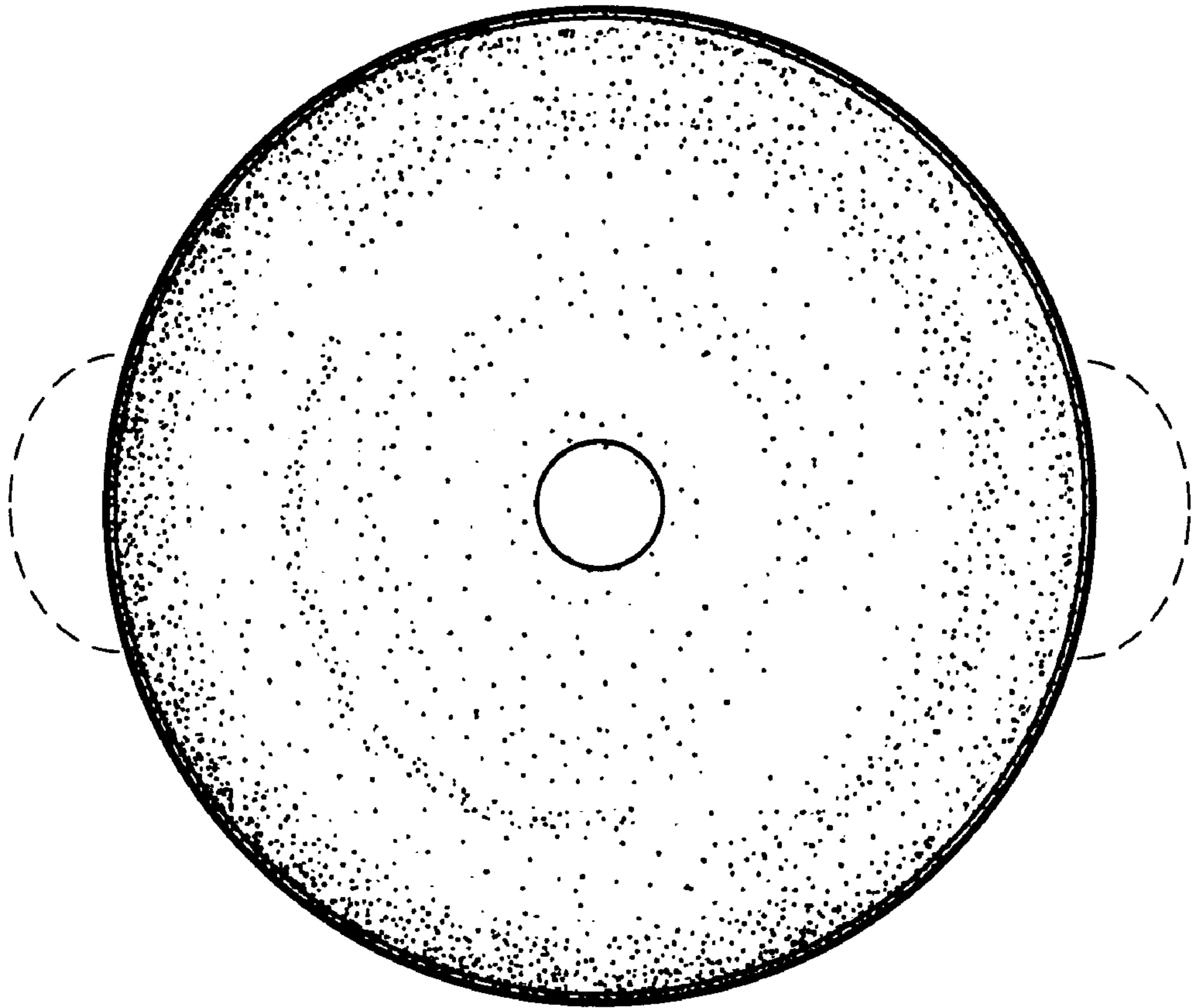
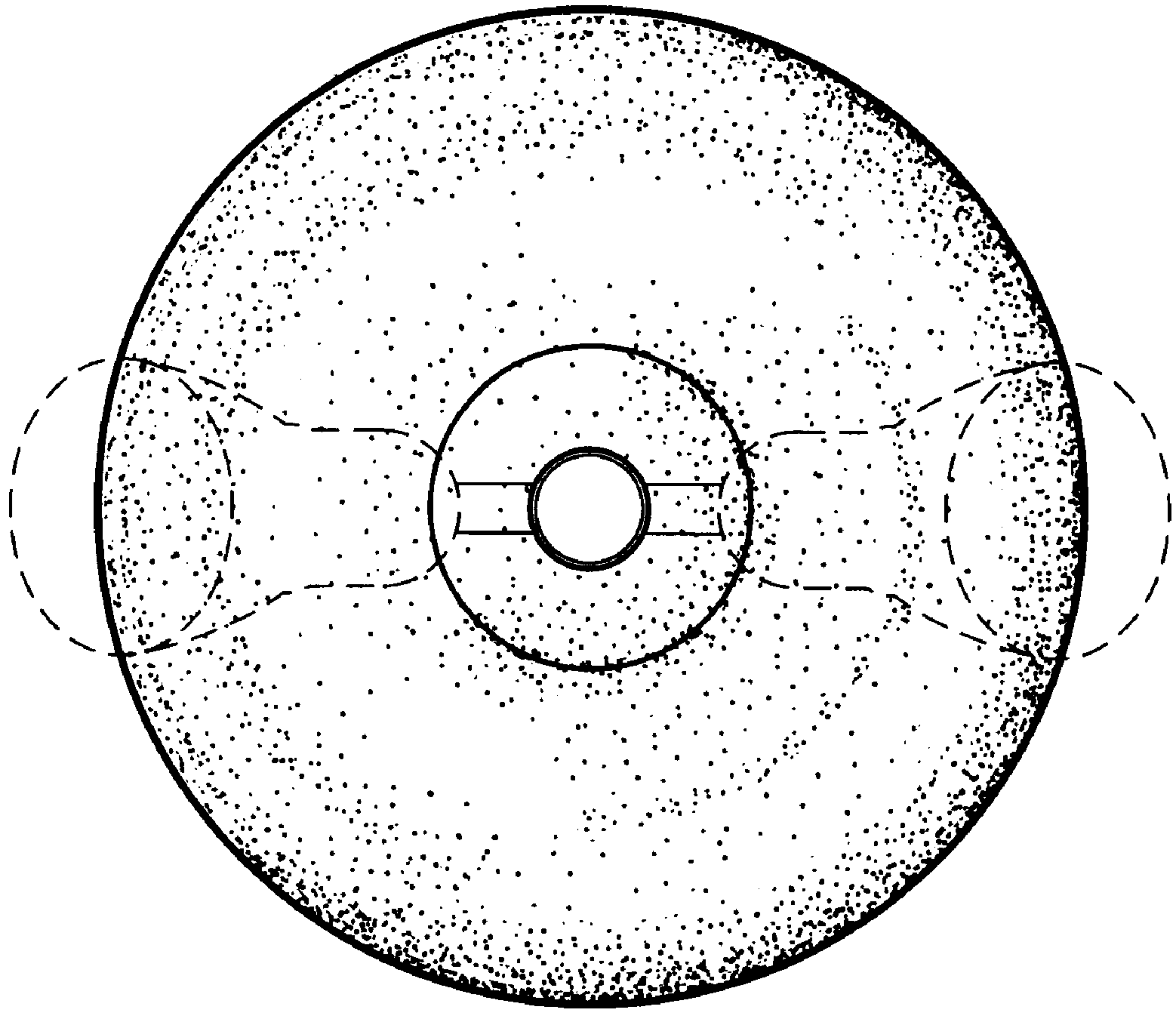
