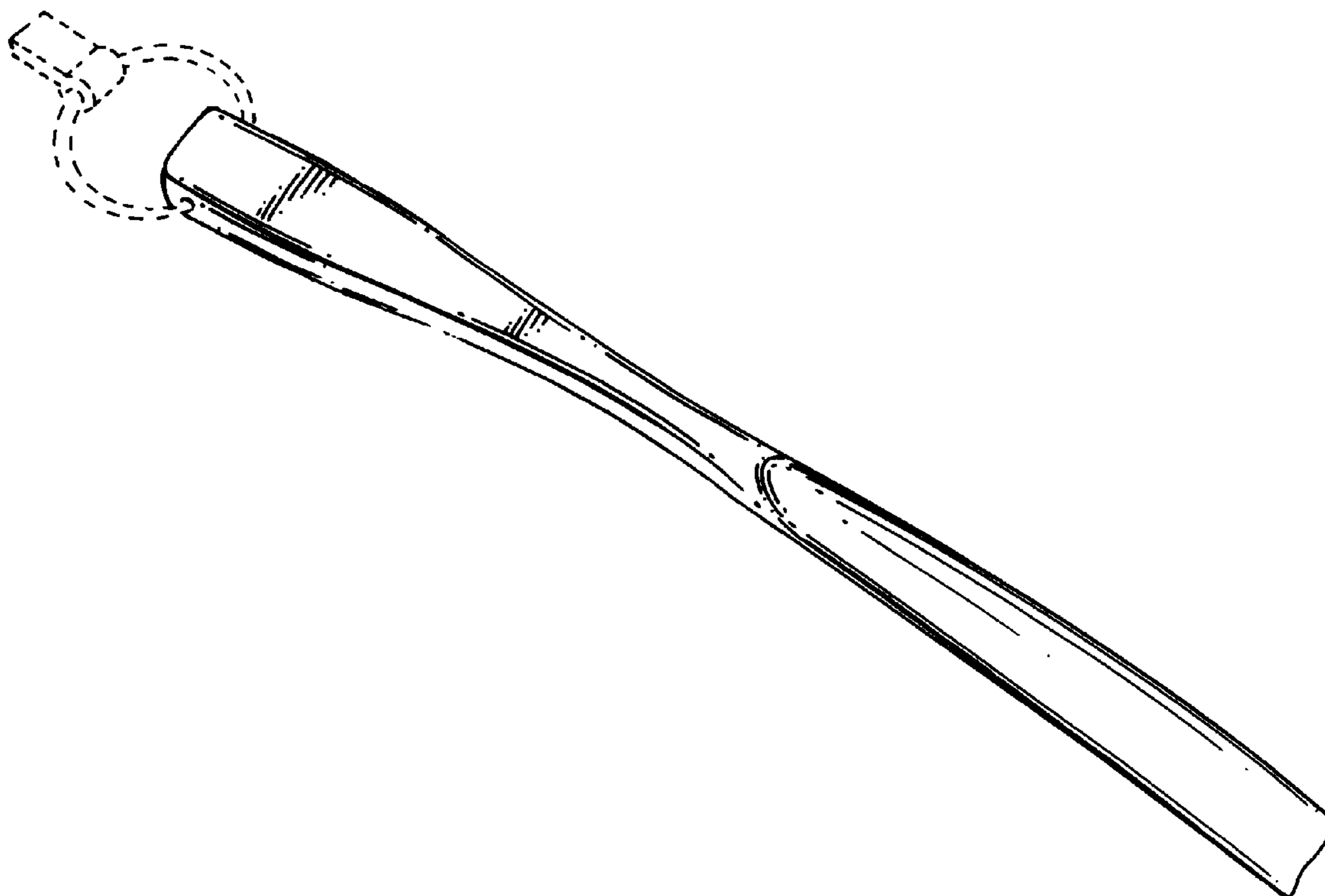
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoehorn, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoehorn showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof, the right side being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.
The broken lines in FIGS. 1-4 represent unclaimed matter.

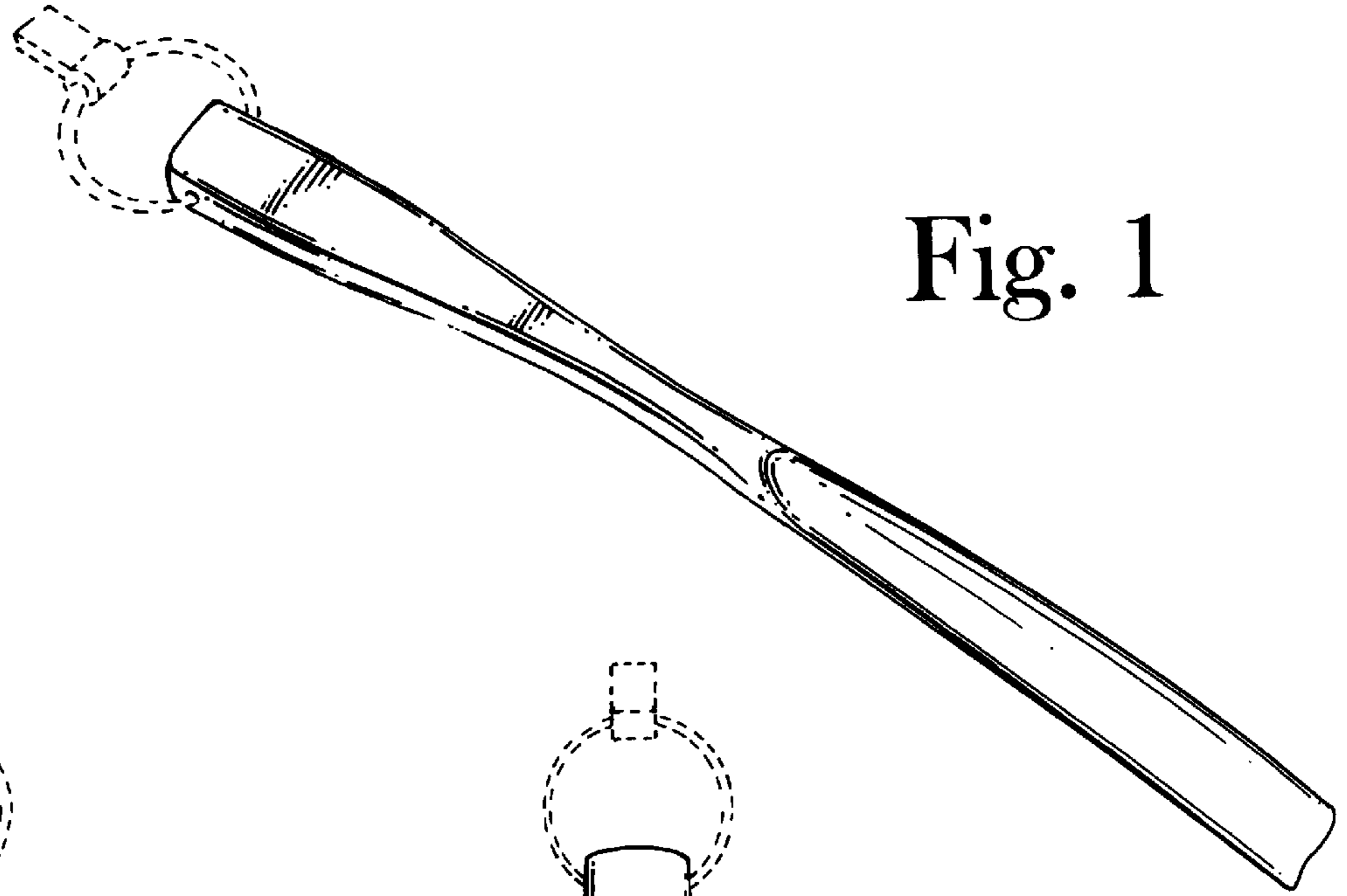

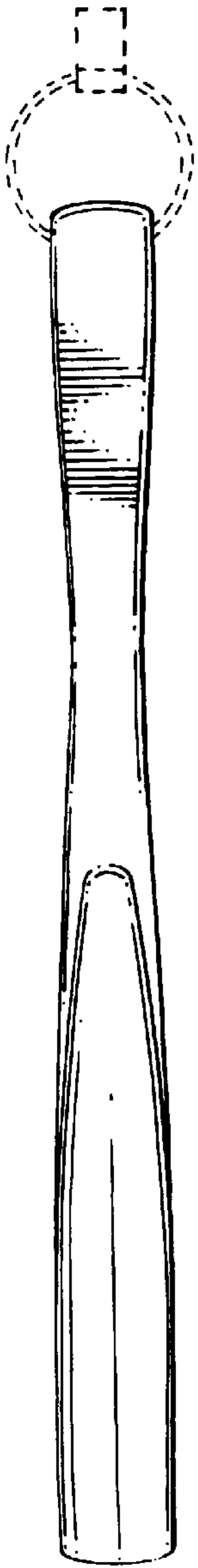

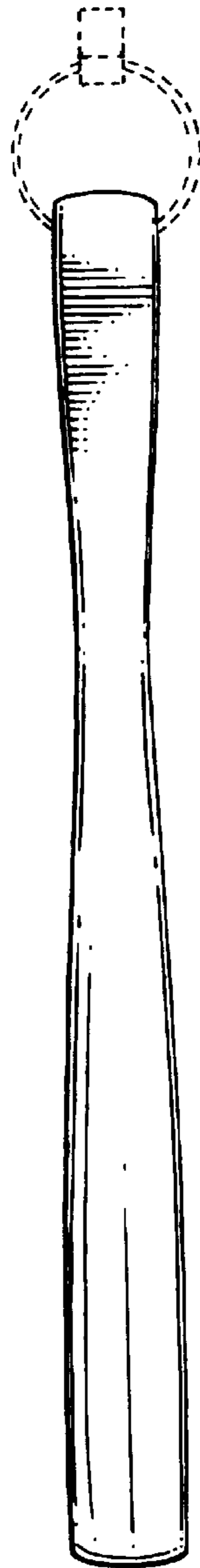
