The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe sole, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a view of the opposite side;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a side perspective view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the opposite side.

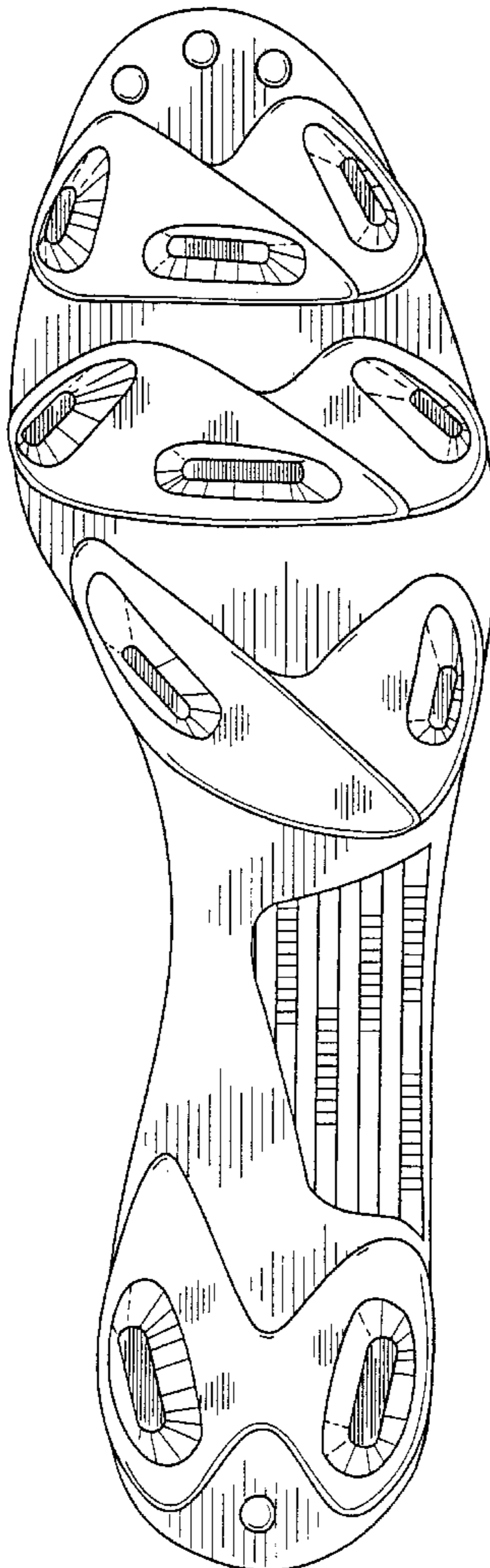
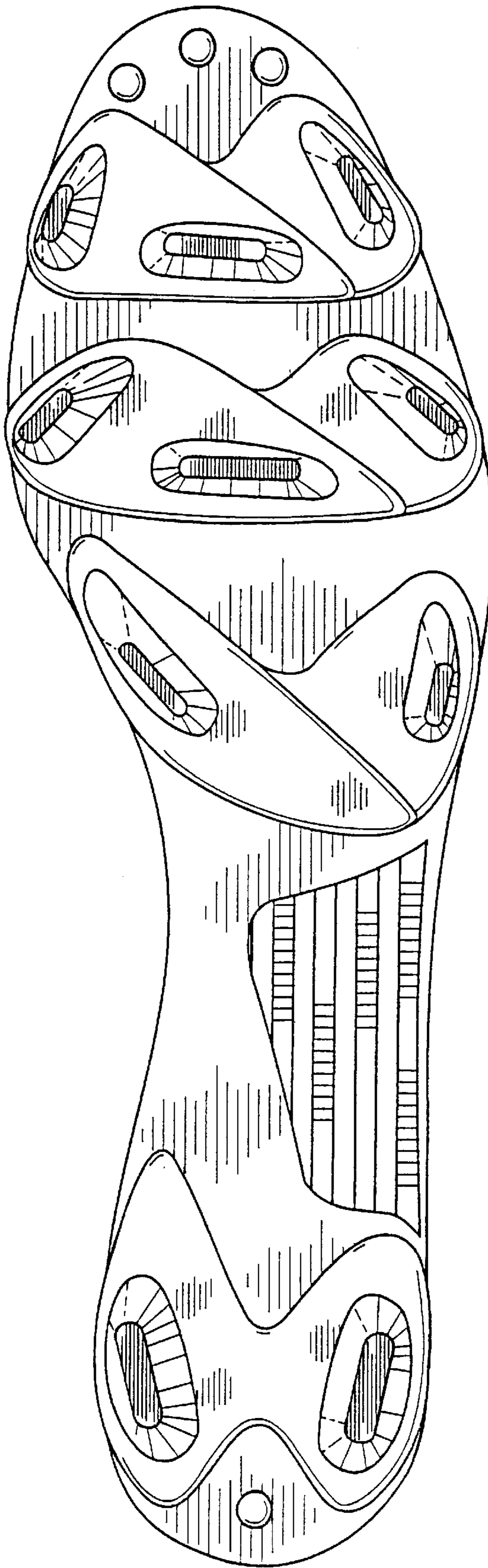

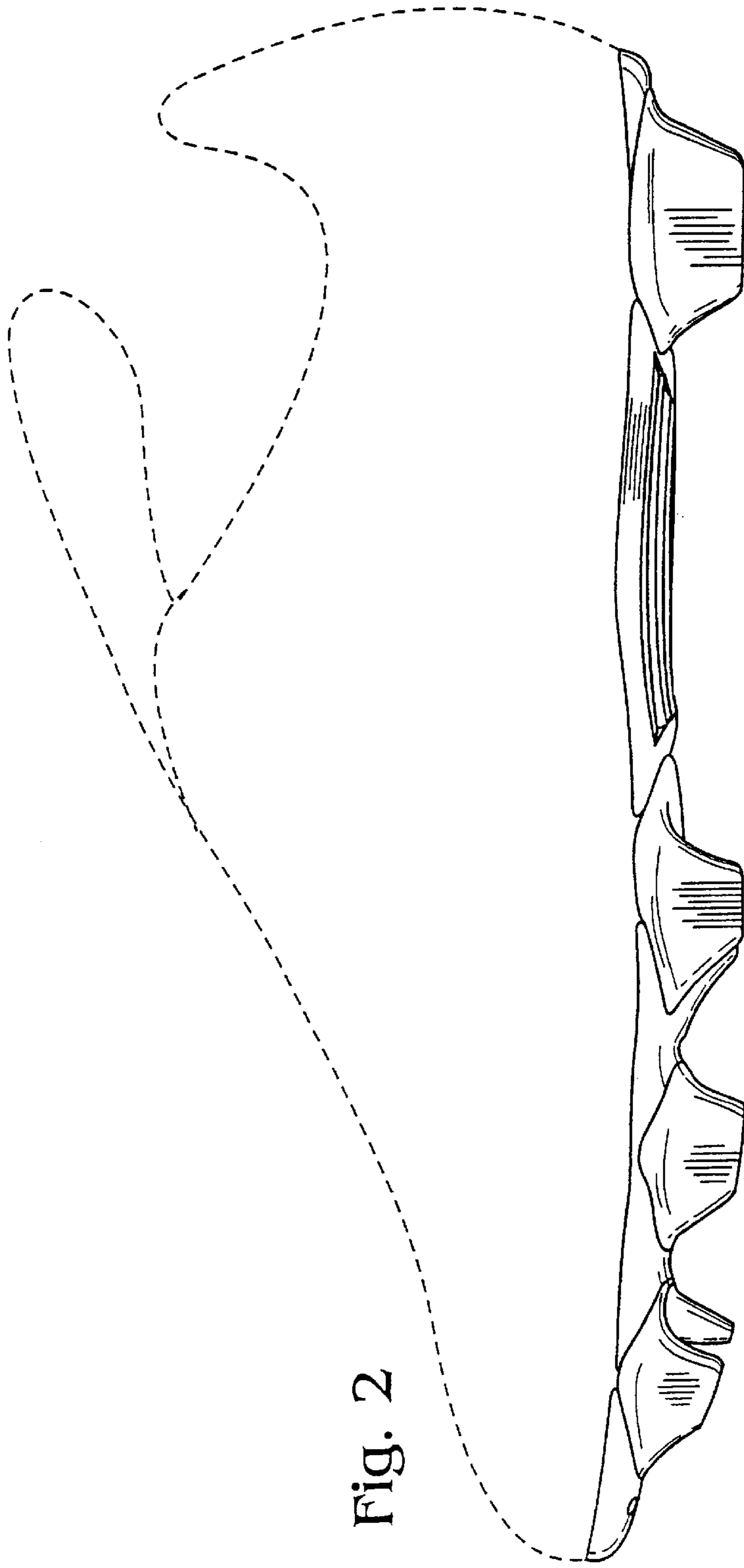

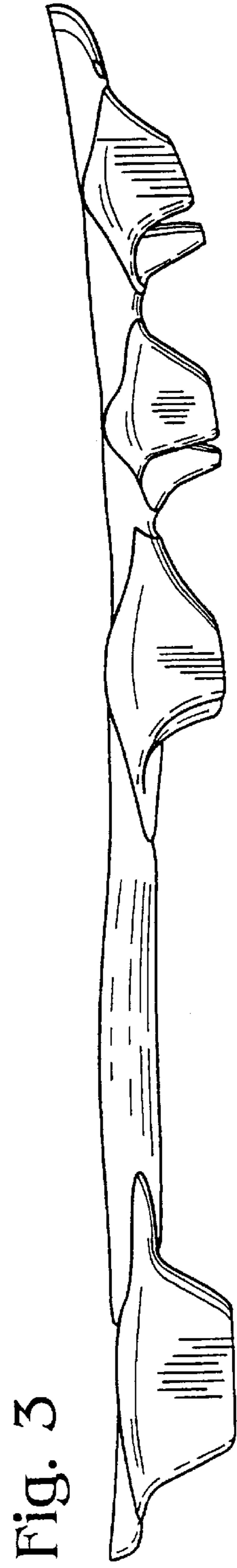

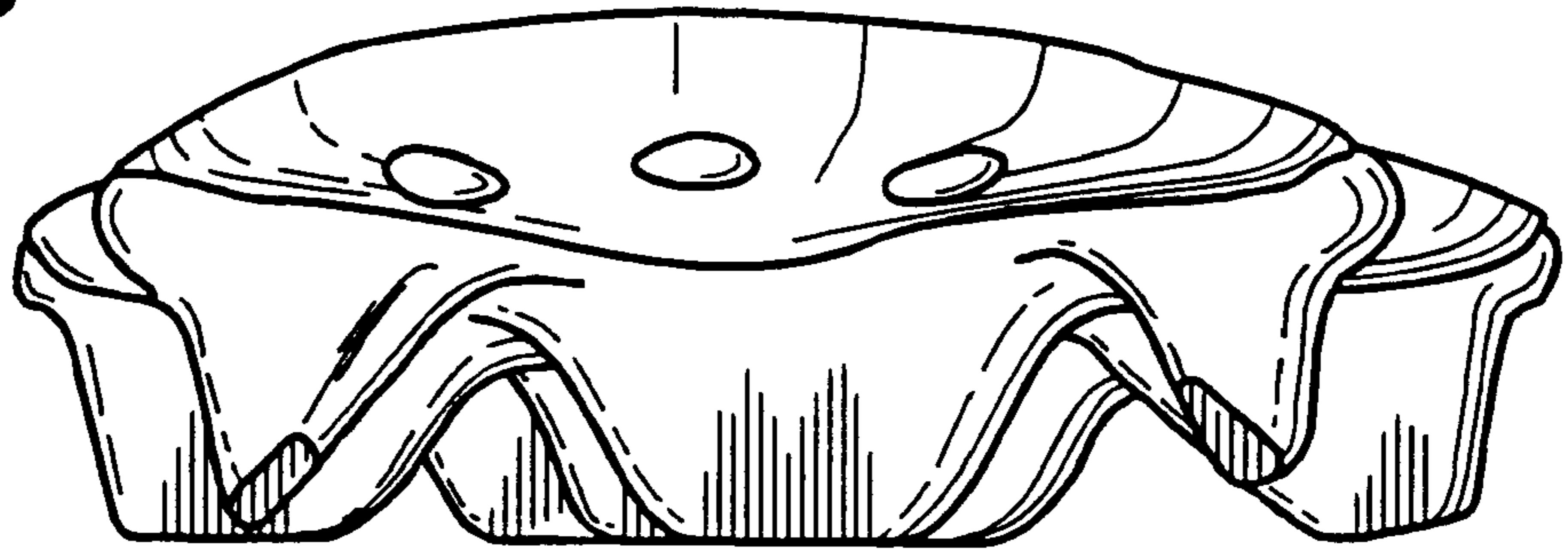
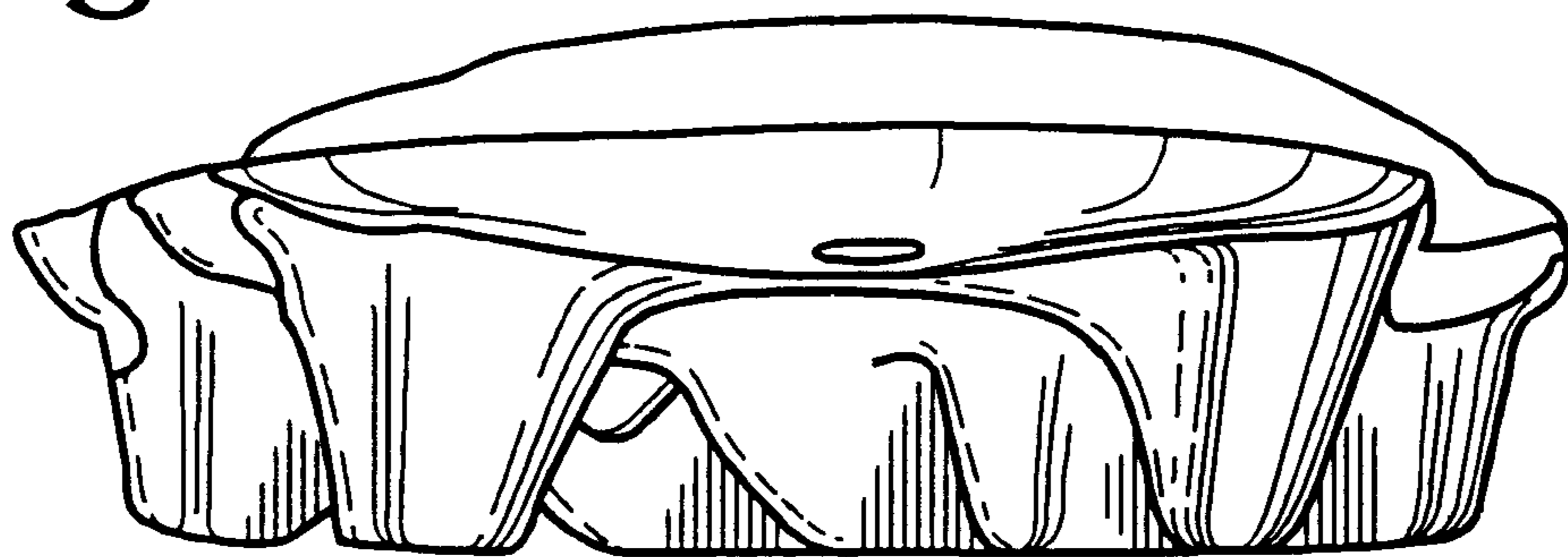

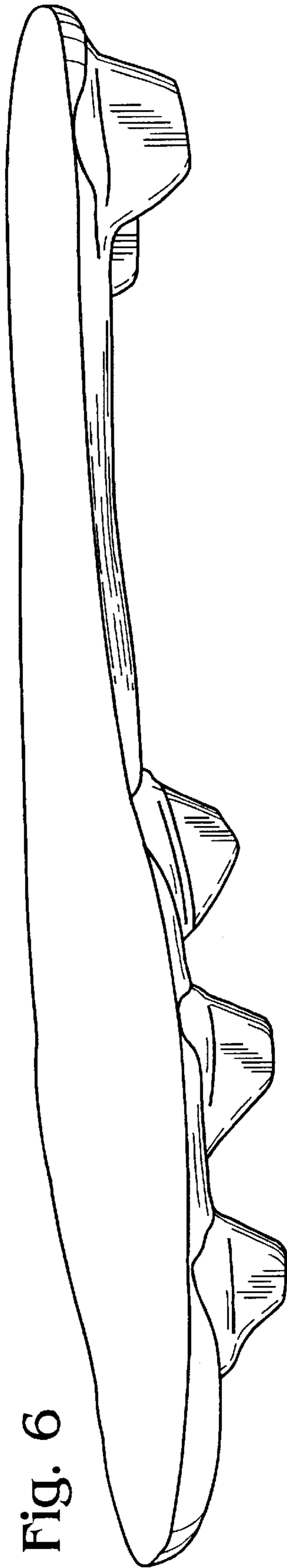

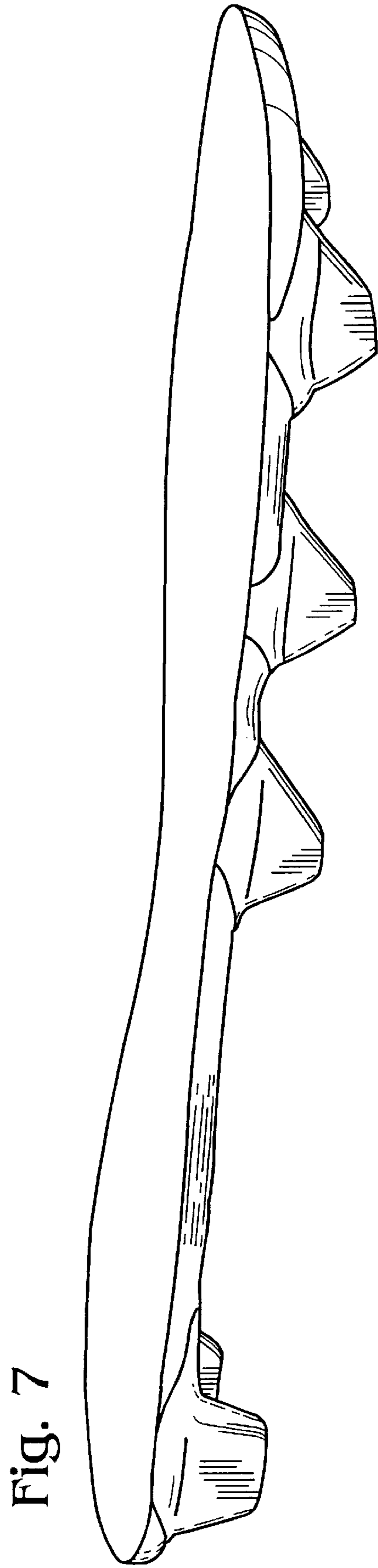
