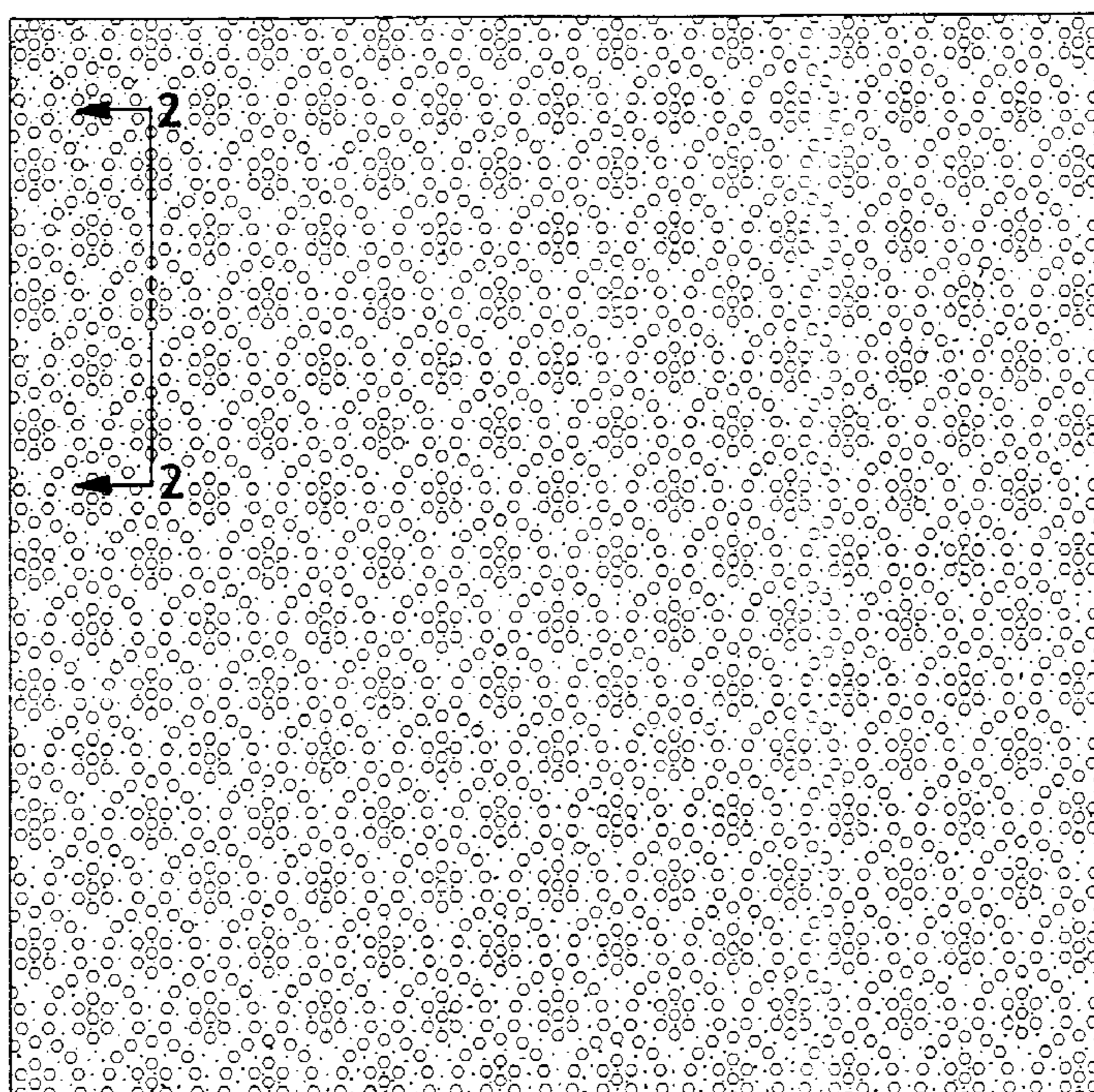
[57] **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for embossed bath tissue, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an embossed bath tissue showing our new design; and, FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view, taken along line 2—2 of FIG. 1. The surfaces or portions of the article not shown in the drawing or described in the specification form no part of the claimed design.

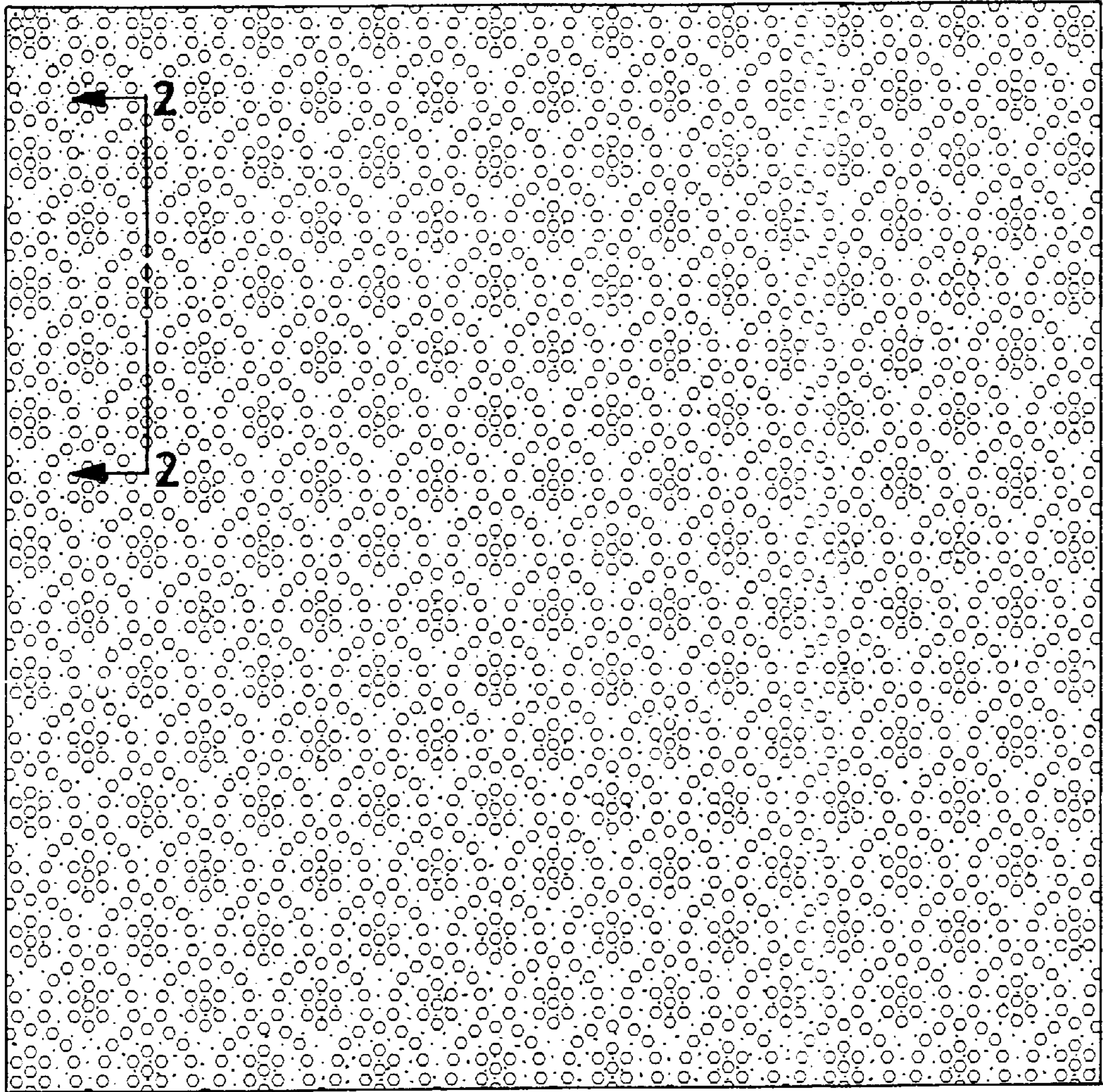
