# [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a video game accessory chair apparatus, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a video game accessory chair of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a view in front elevation showing the video game accessory chair of the present invention;

FIG. 3 is a view in back elevation showing the video game accessory chair of the present invention;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the video game accessory chair of the present invention;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the video game accessory chair of the present invention;


FIG. 6 is a view in side elevation of the video game accessory chair of the present invention;


FIG. 7 is a view in side elevation of the video game accessory chair of the present invention;






