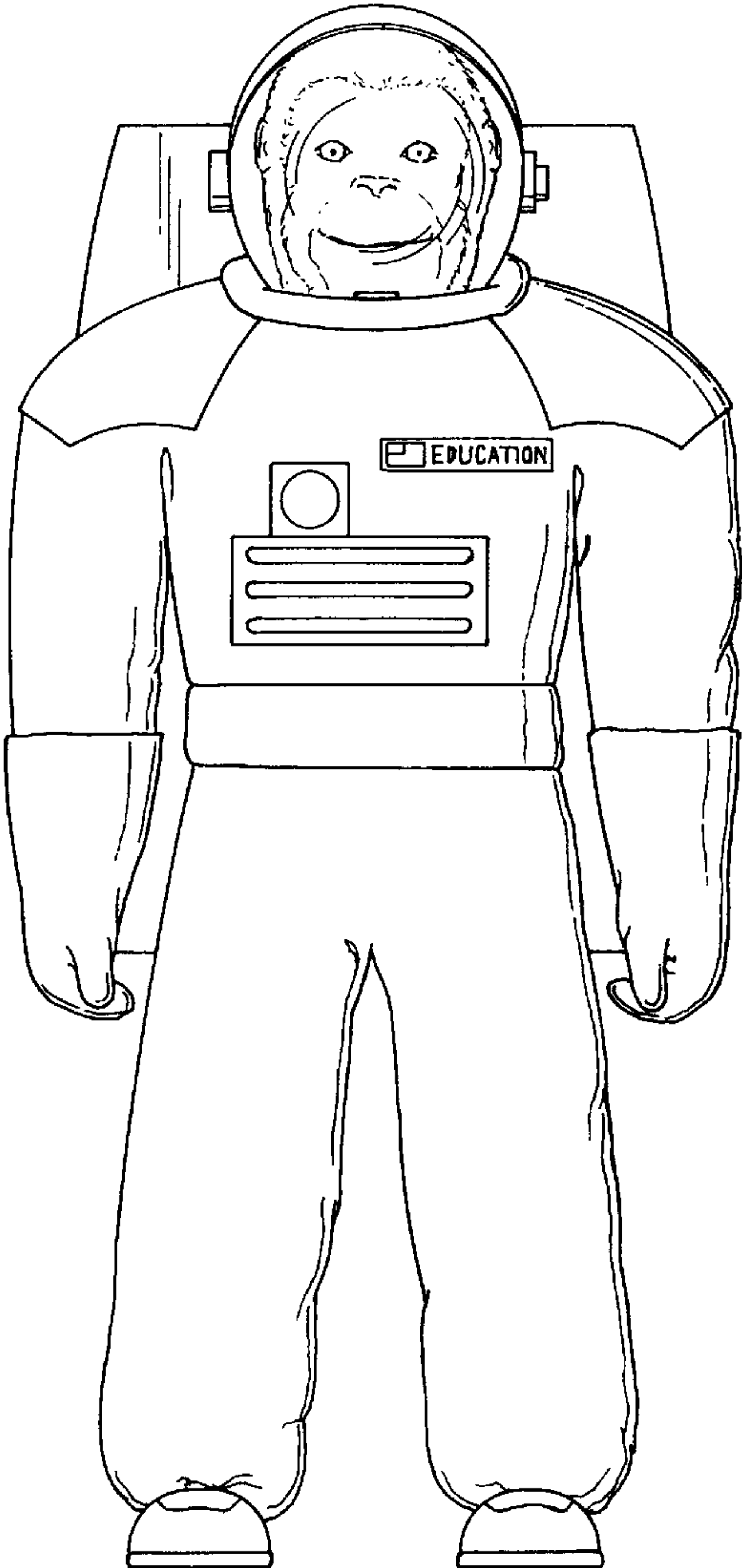
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the monkey doll of the present invention;

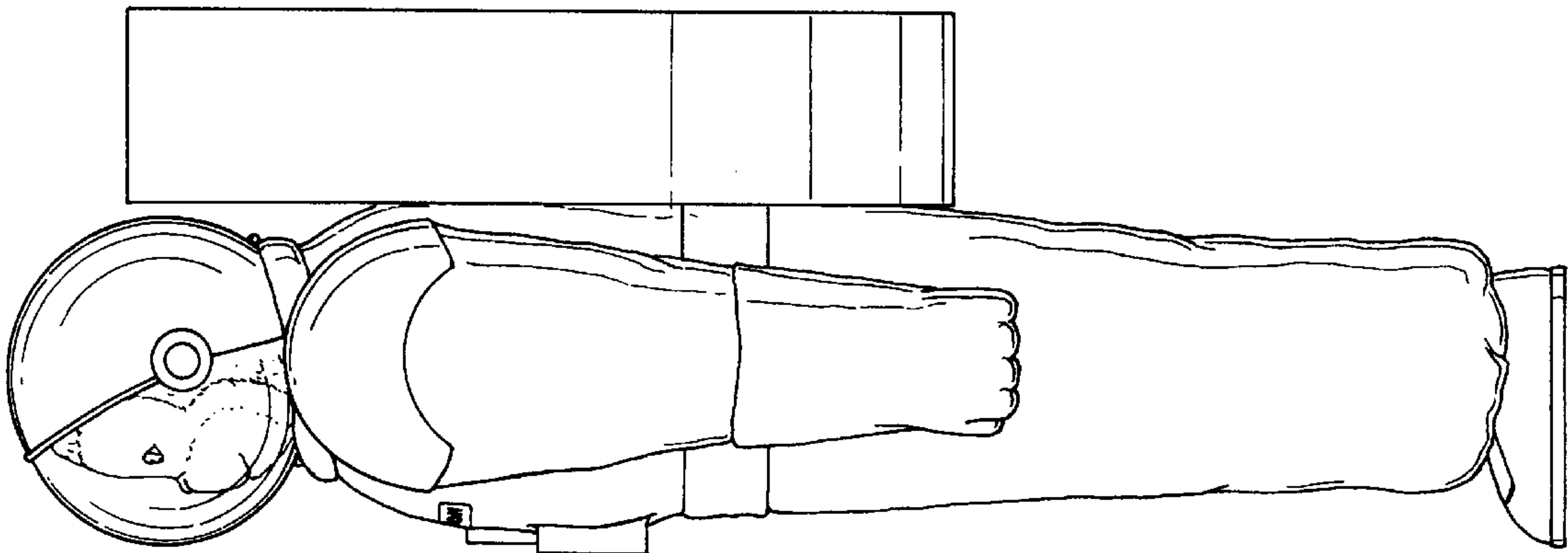

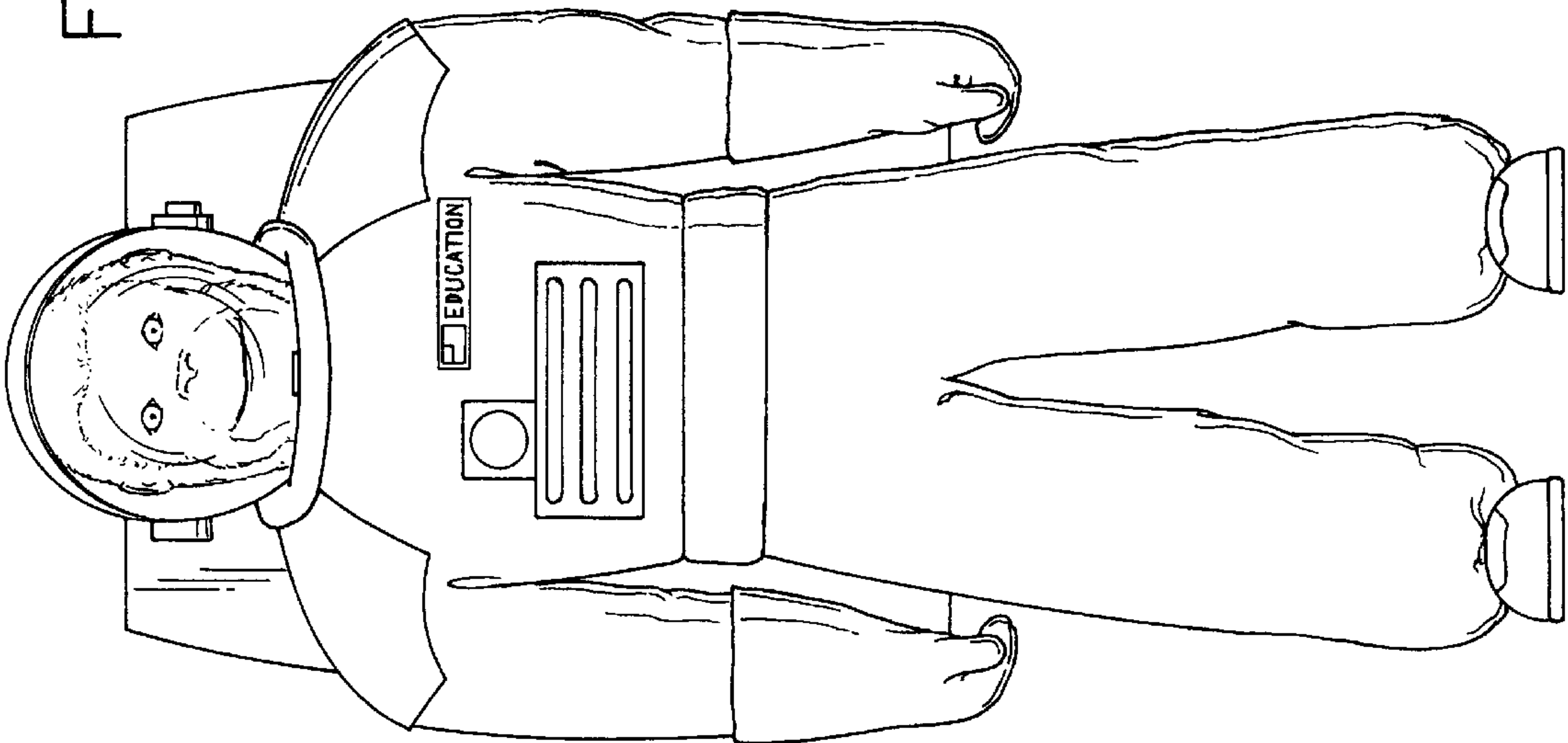

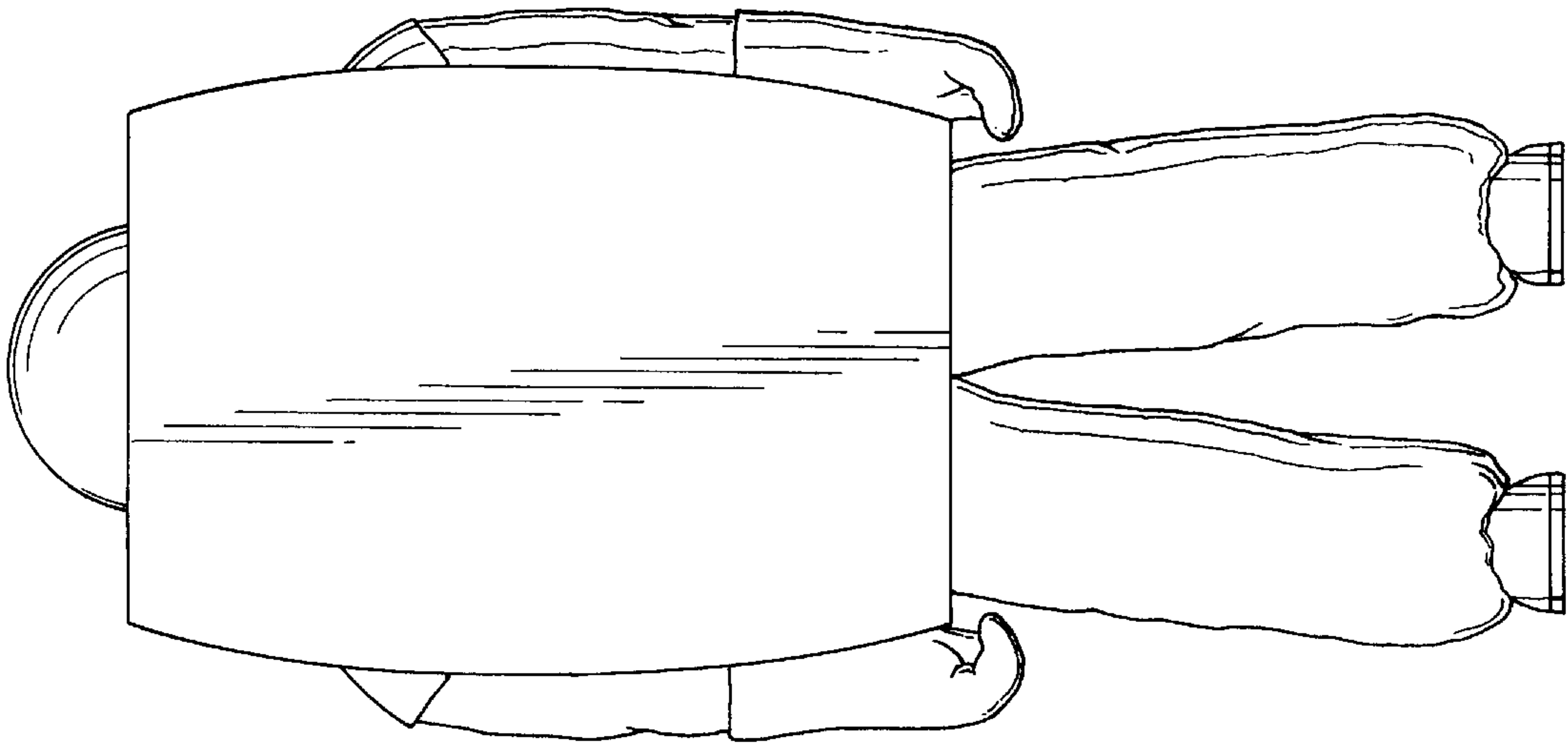

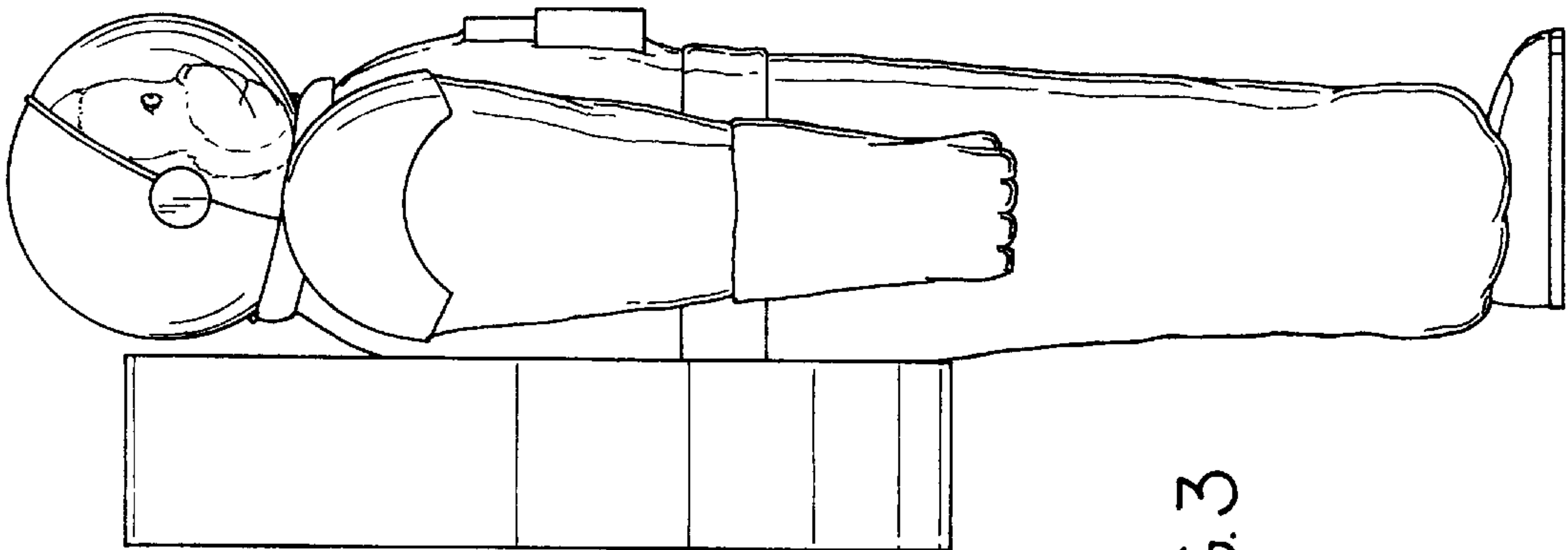

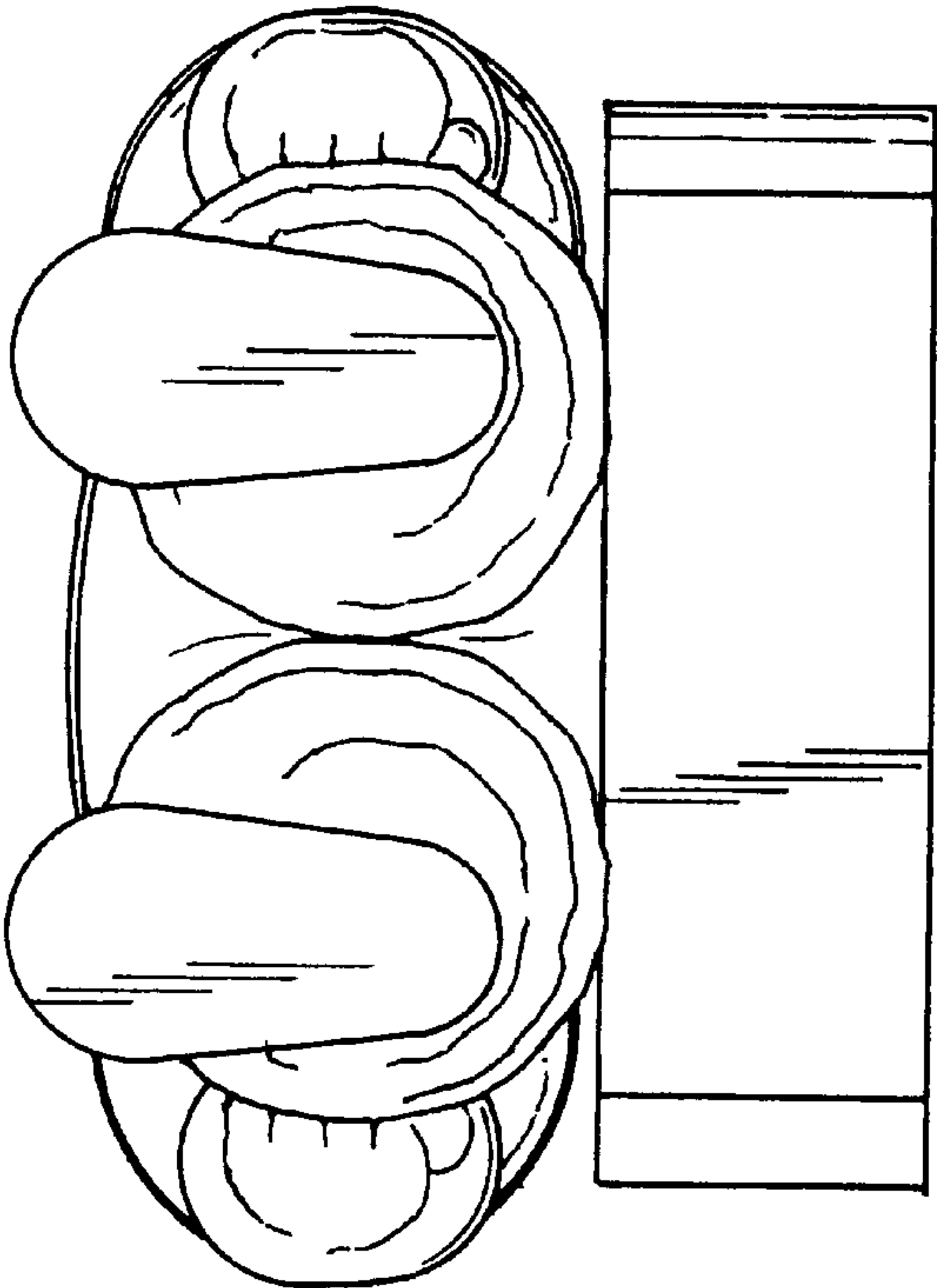
