DESCRIPTION

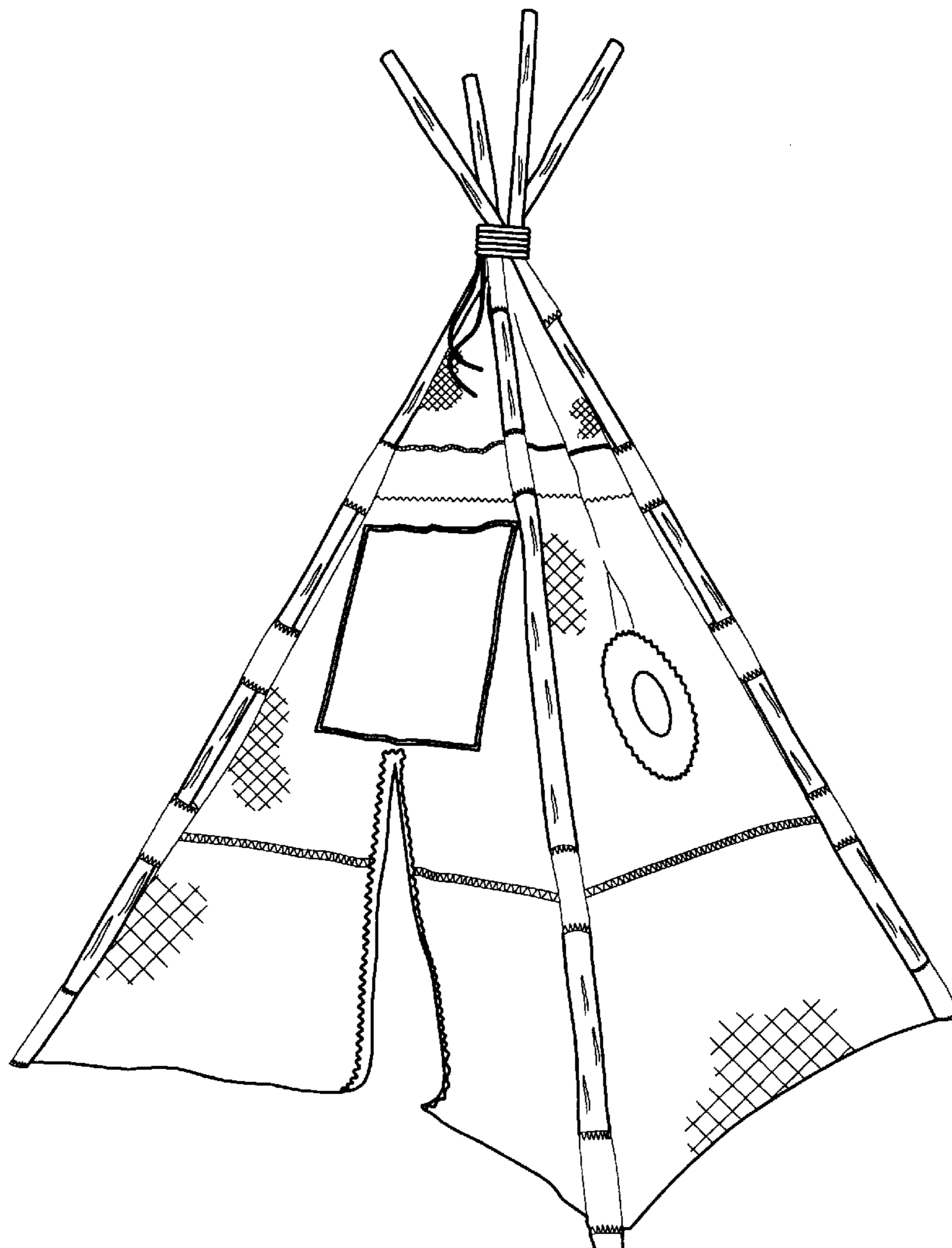
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the children's play tee-pee having a unique configuration of the present design;

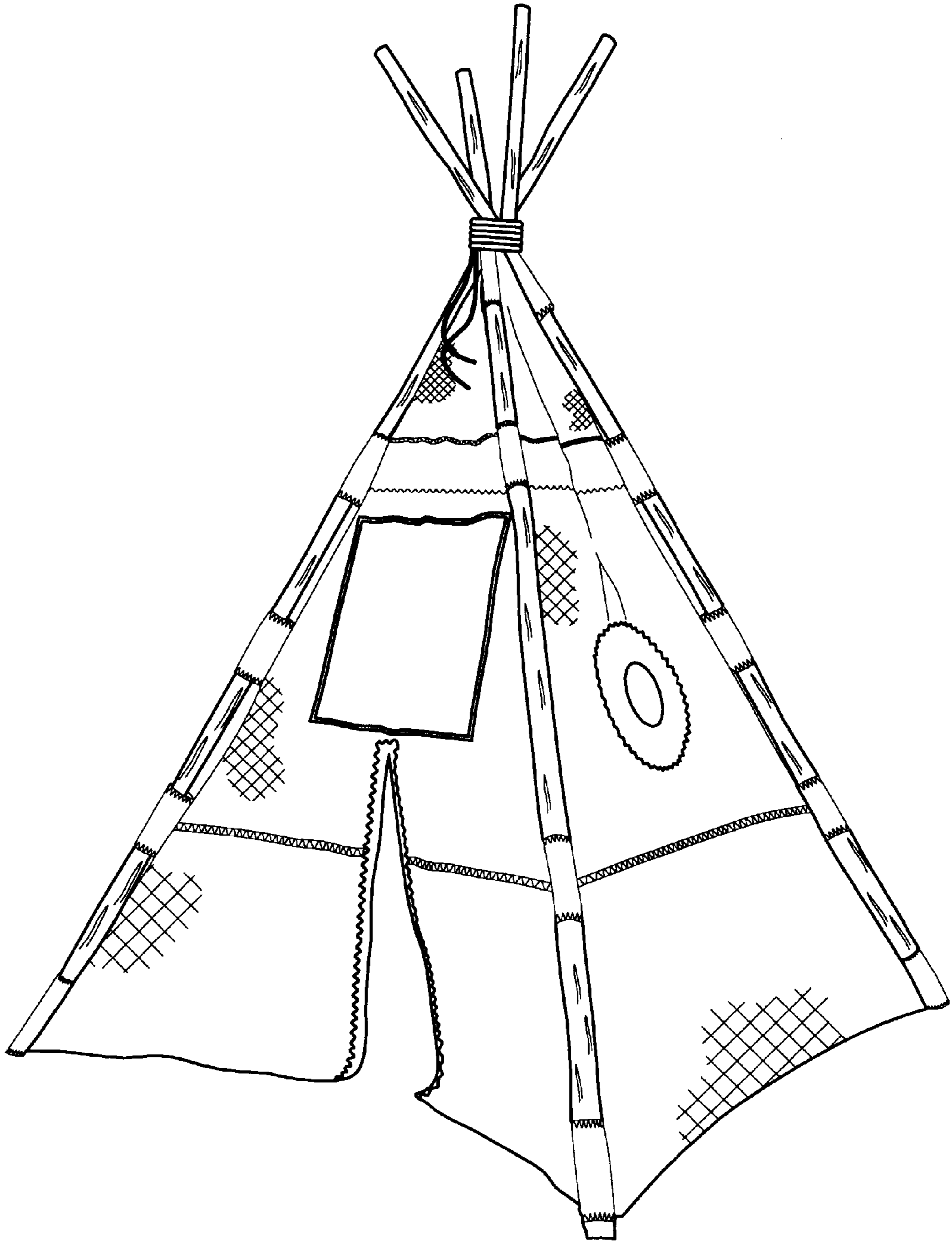

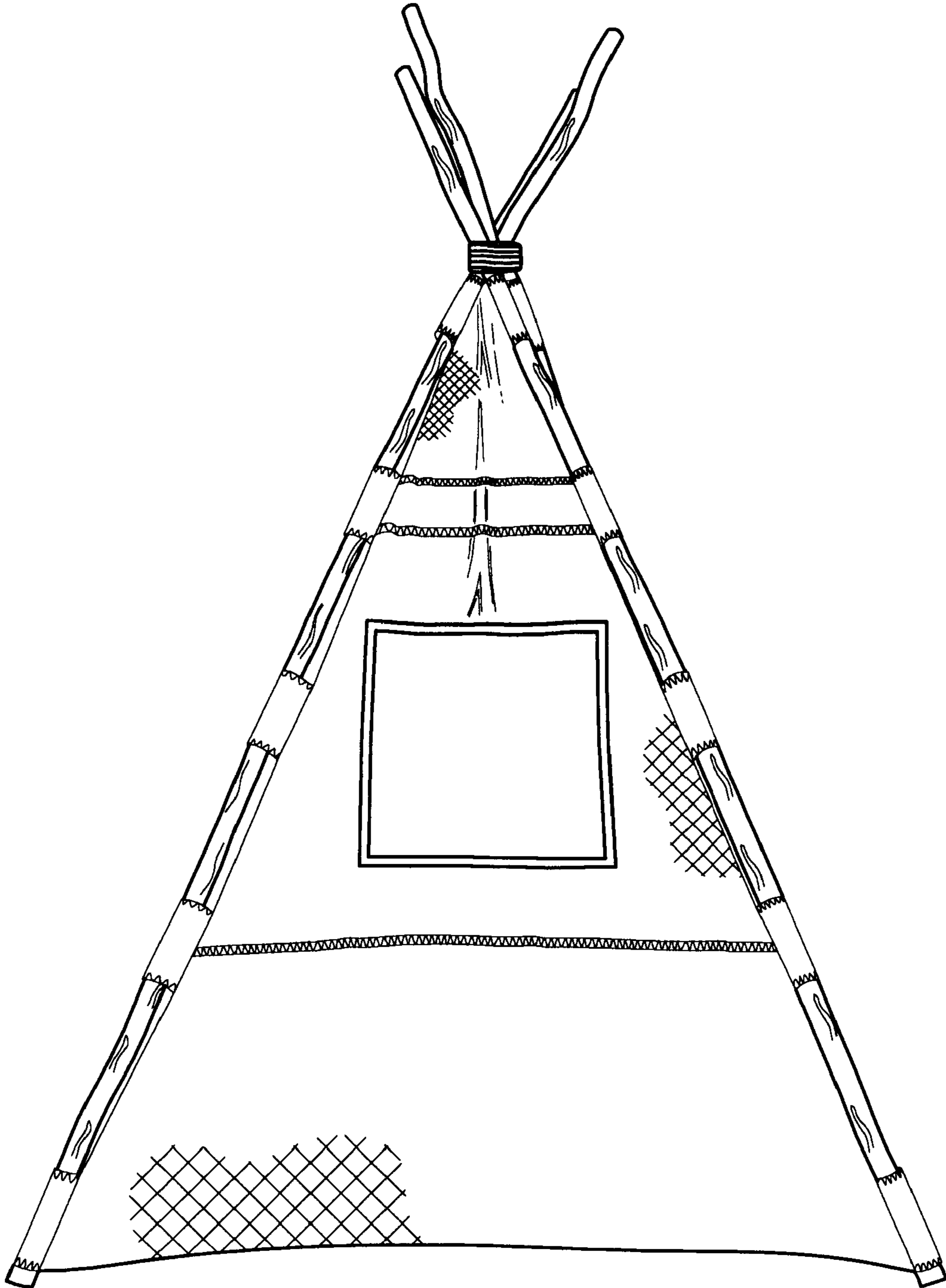

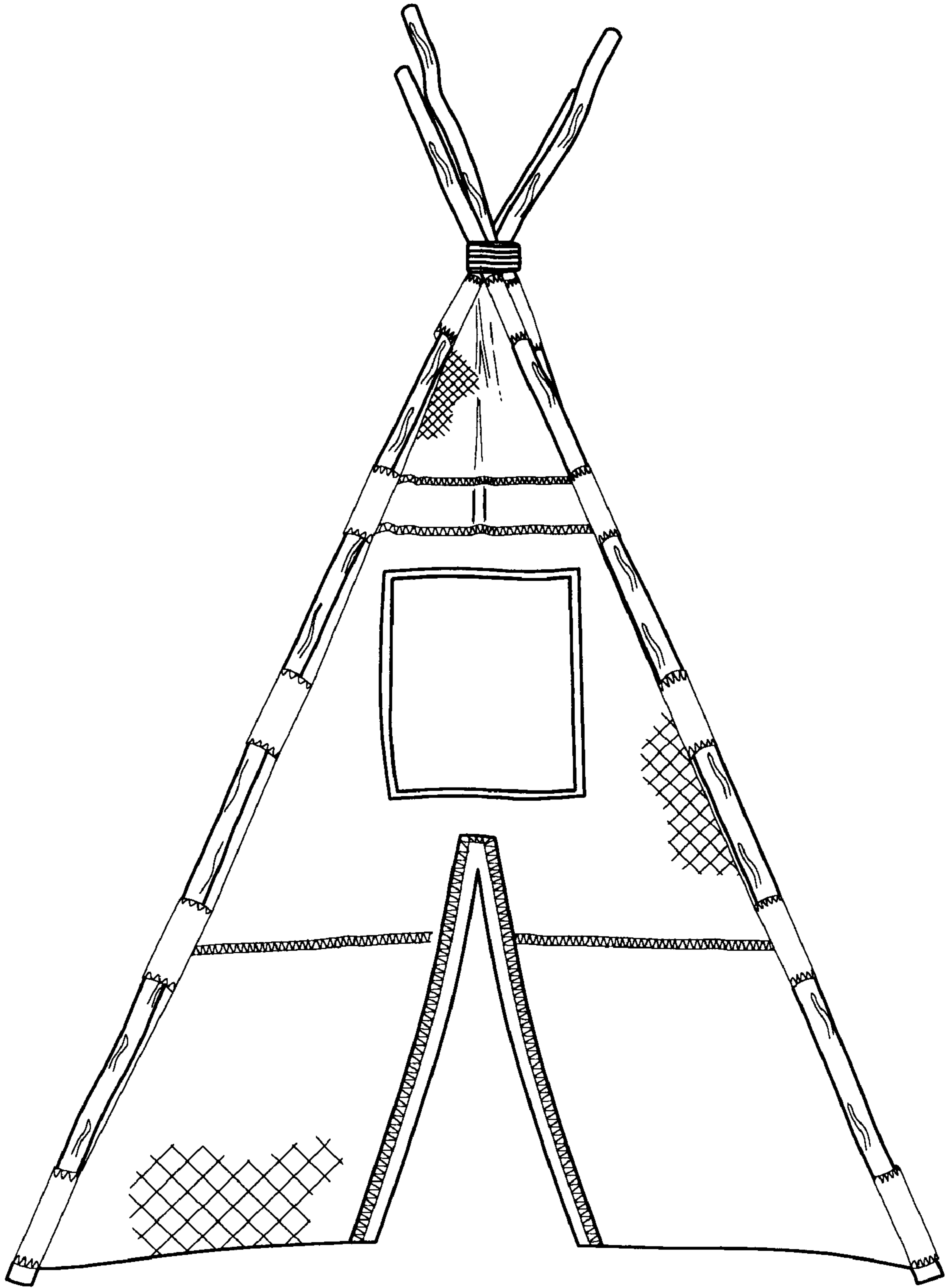

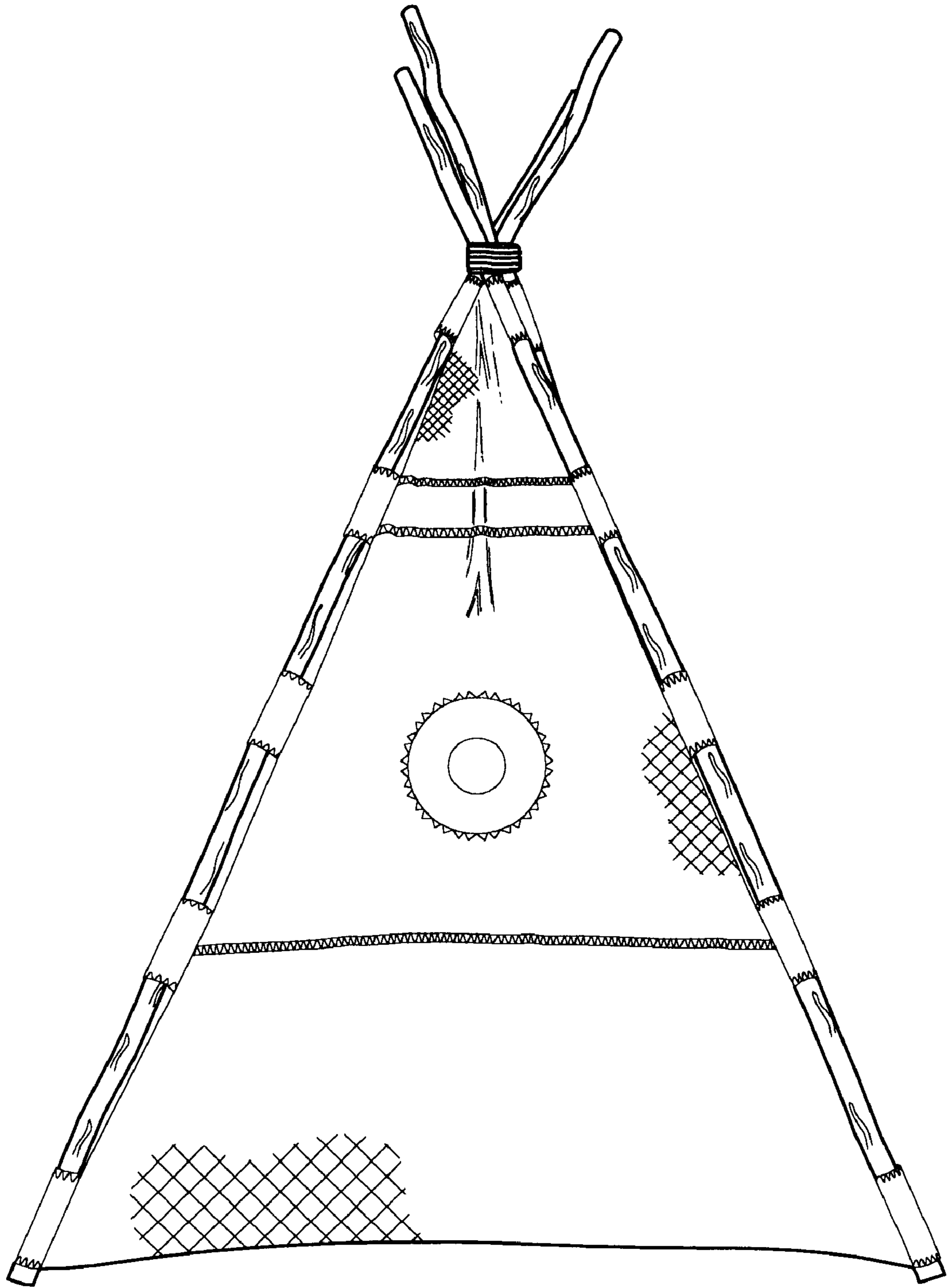

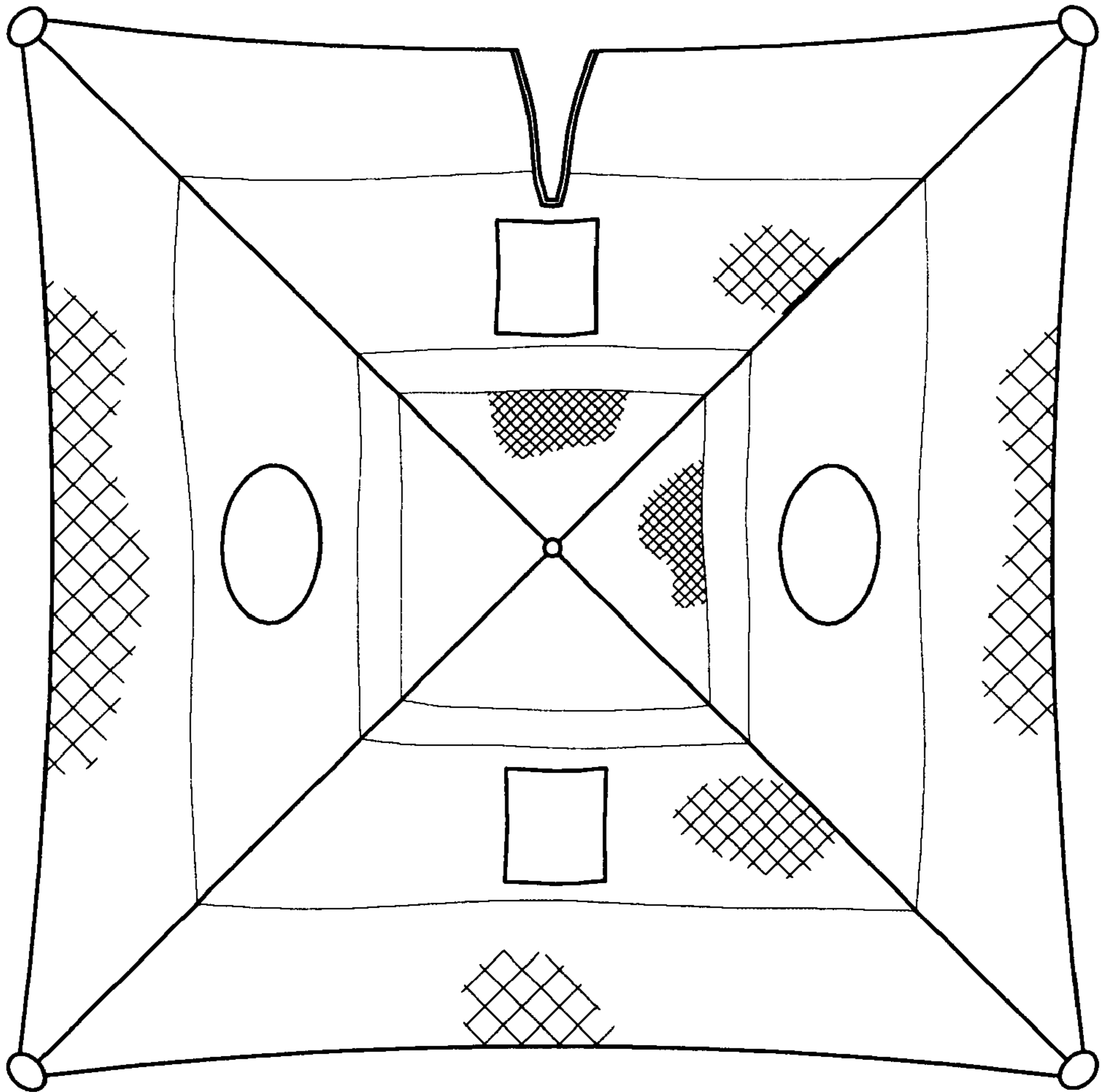
