The ornamental design for a bicycle lamp, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a bicycle lamp, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof, with the left side view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is an exploded perspective view thereof, with the lens cover removed.

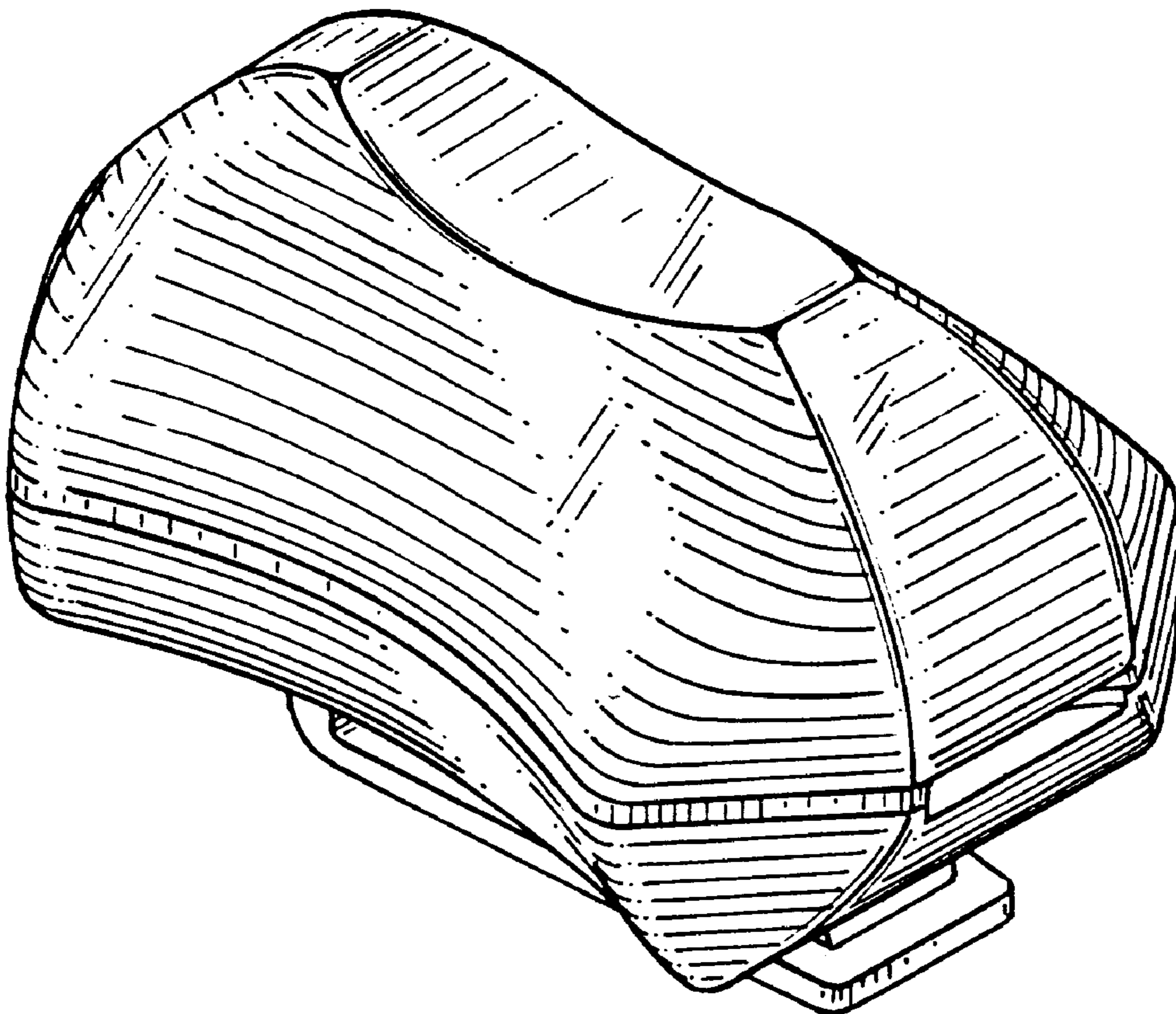

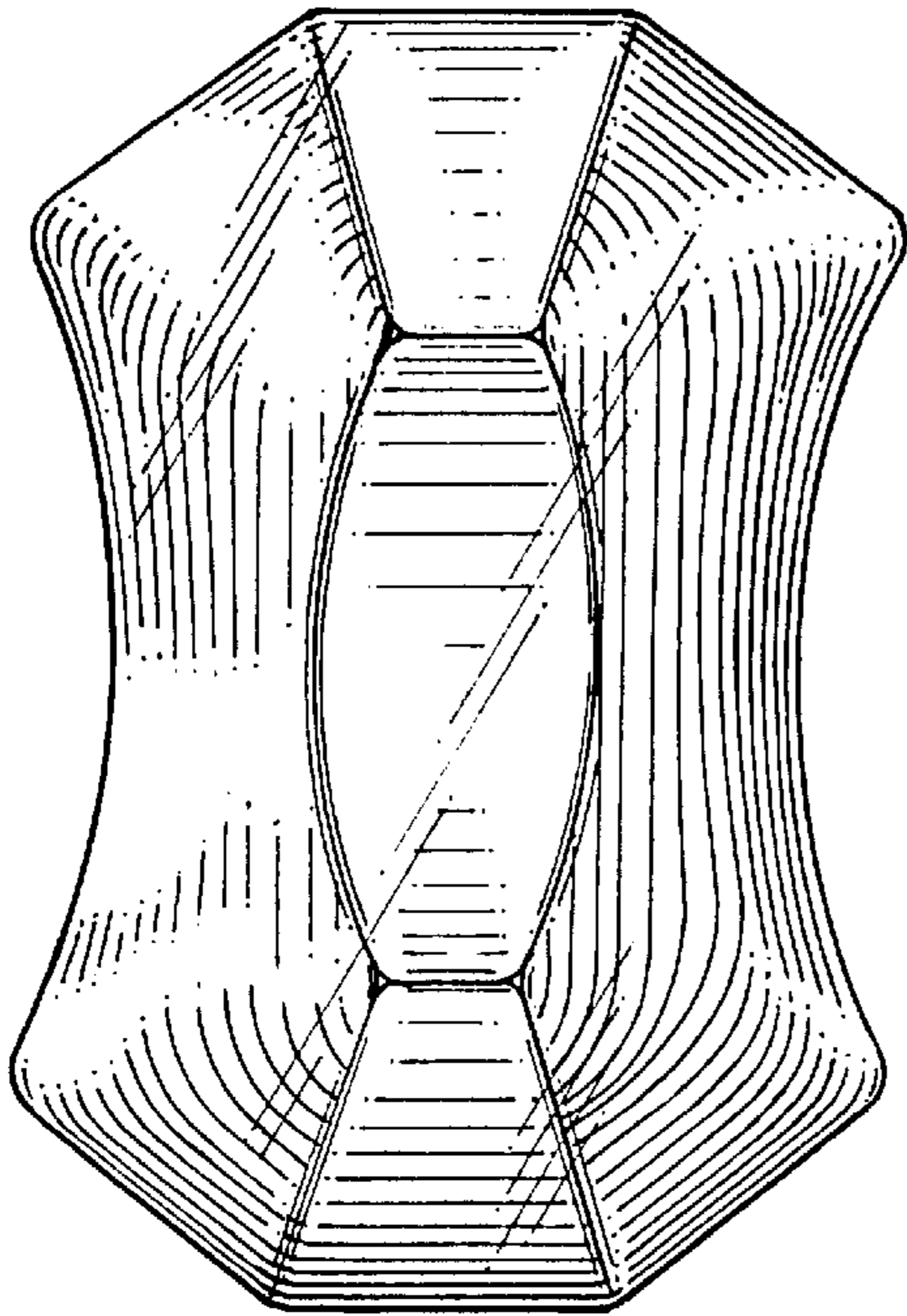

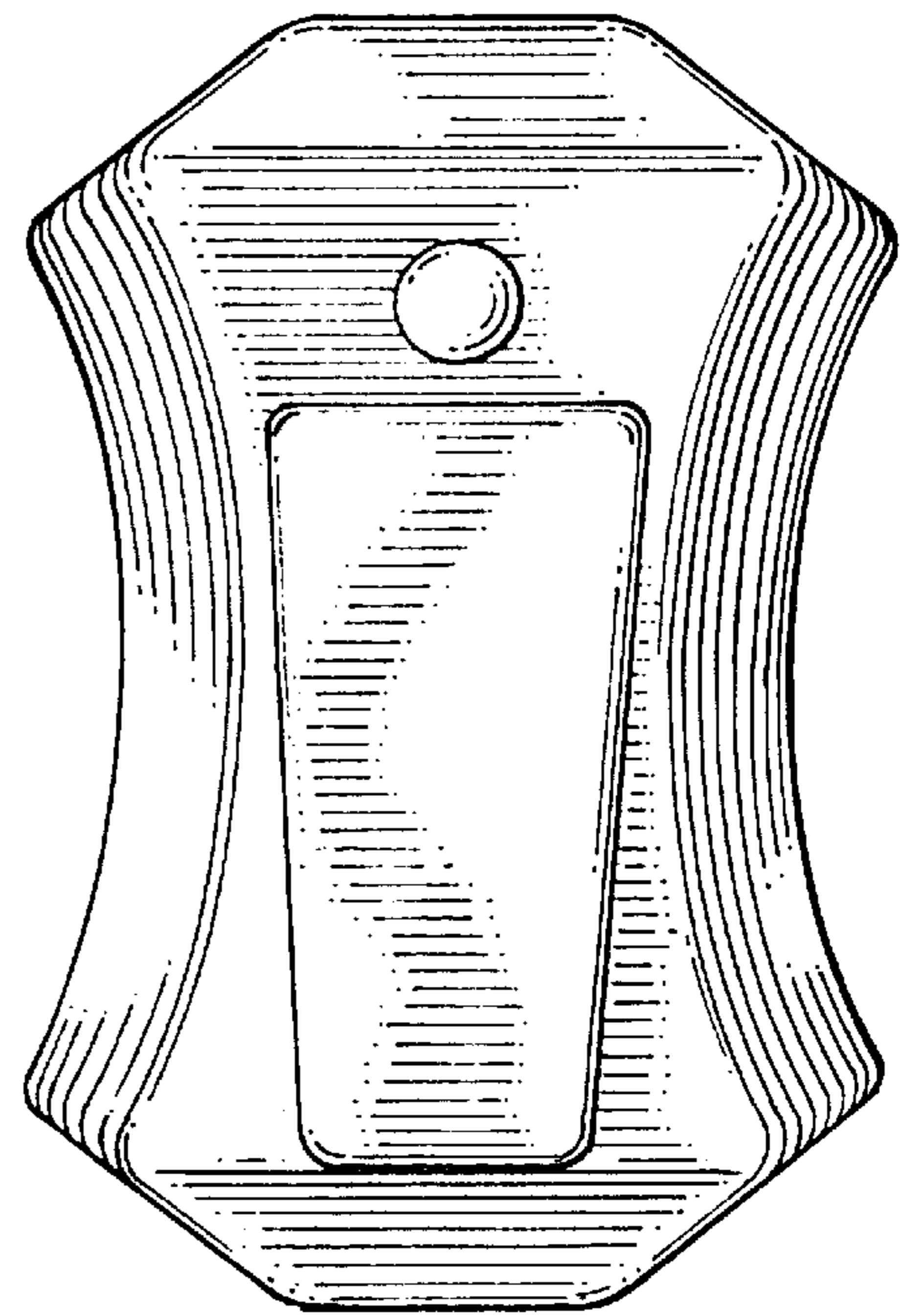

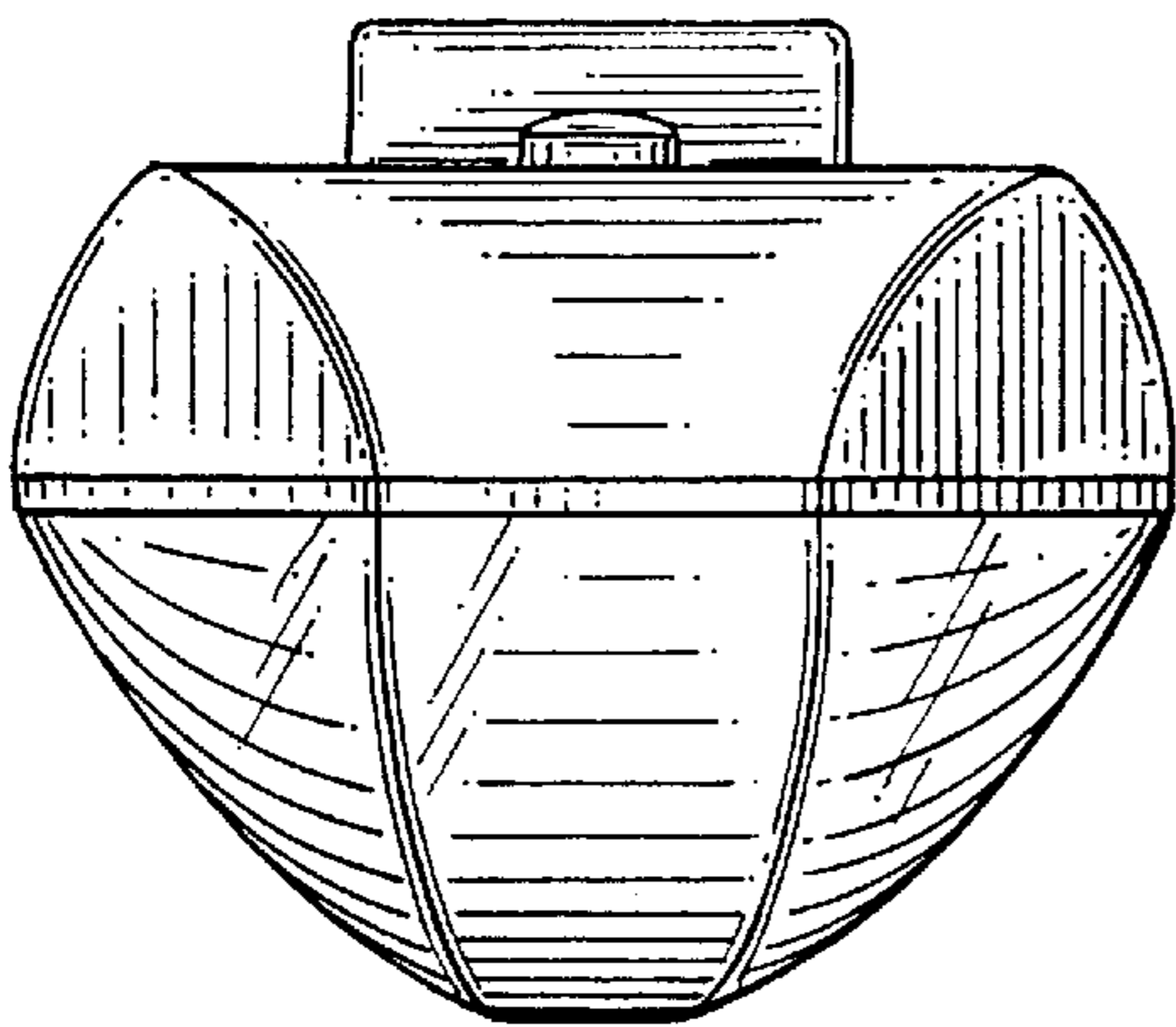

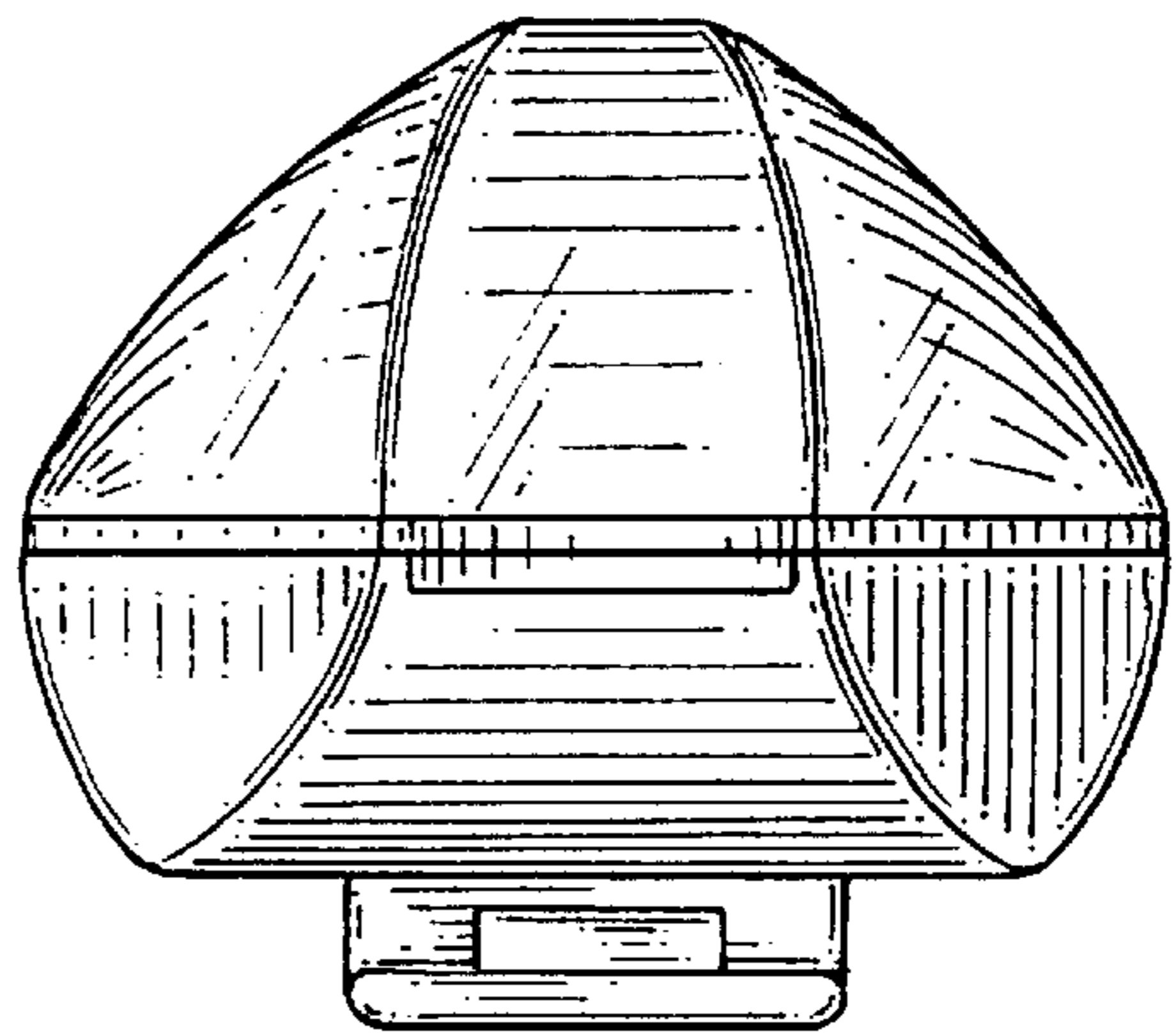

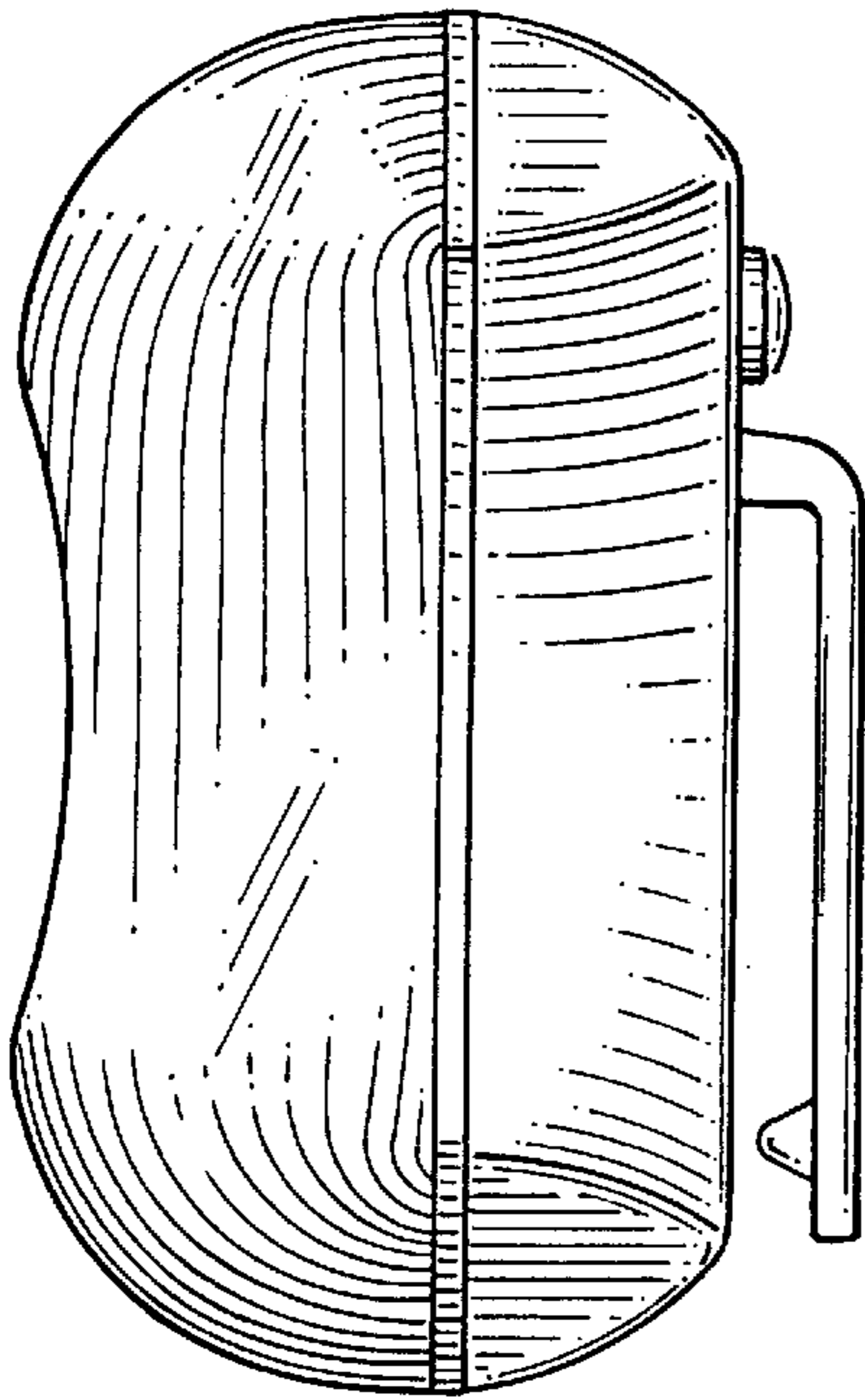

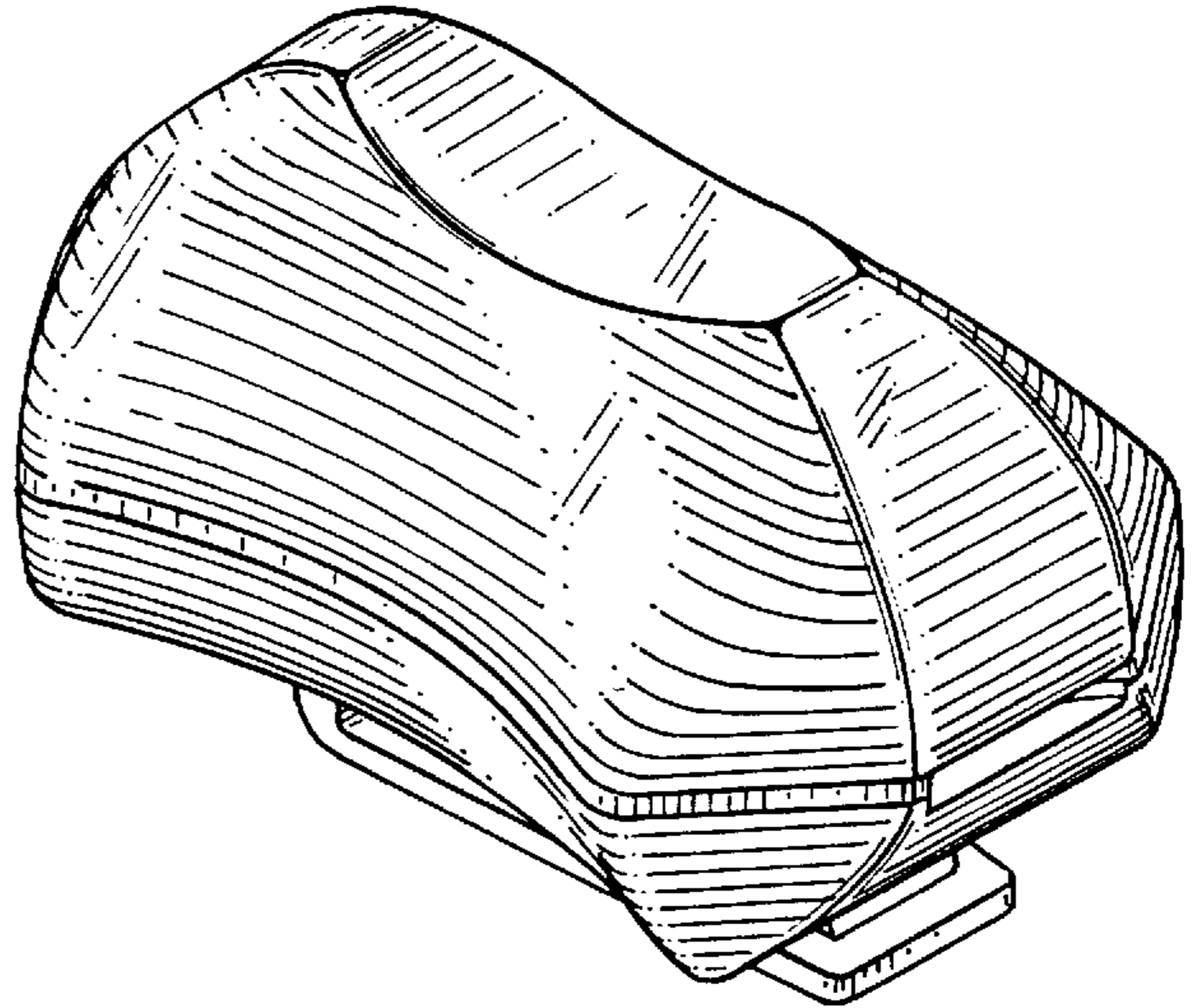
