DESCRIPTION

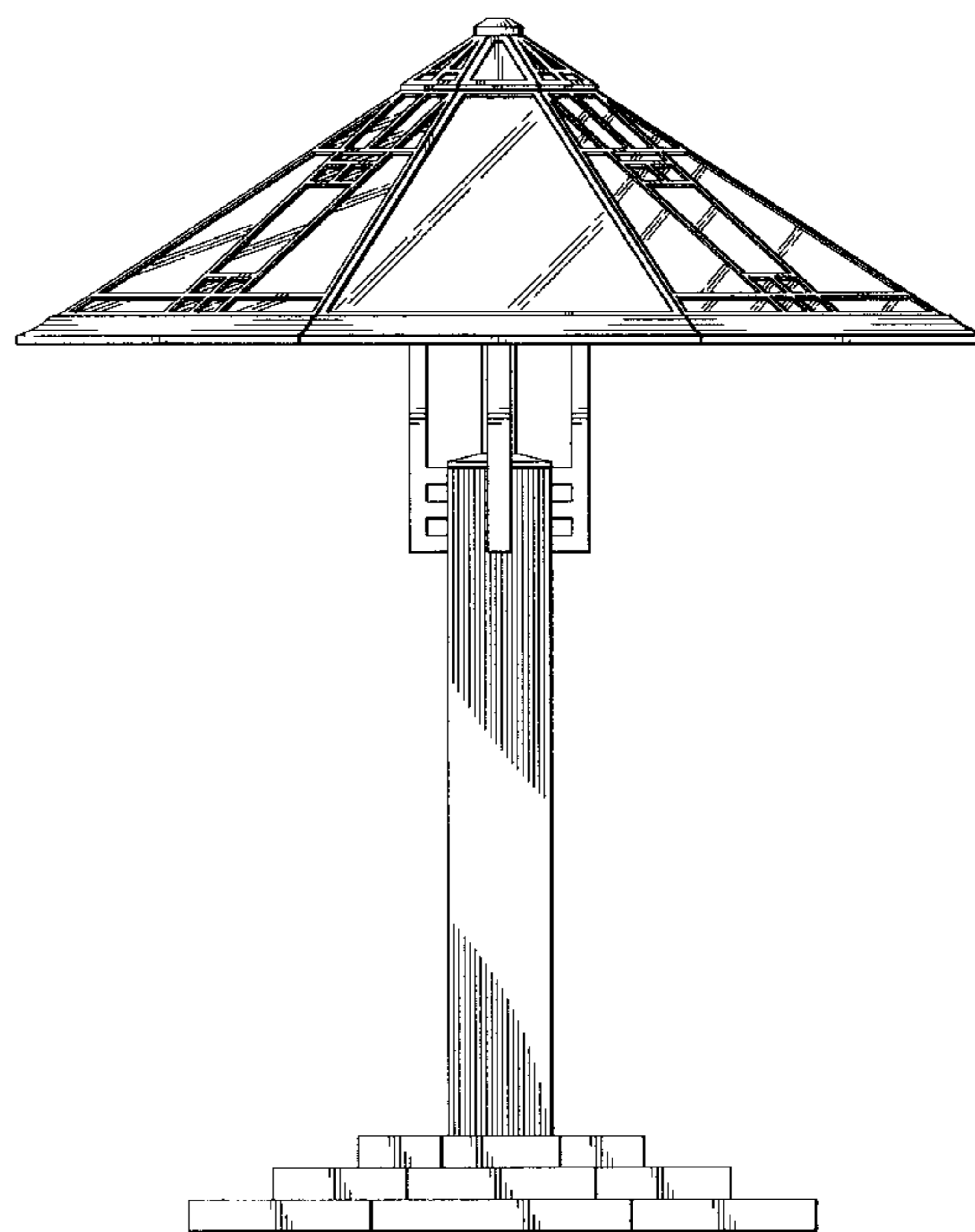
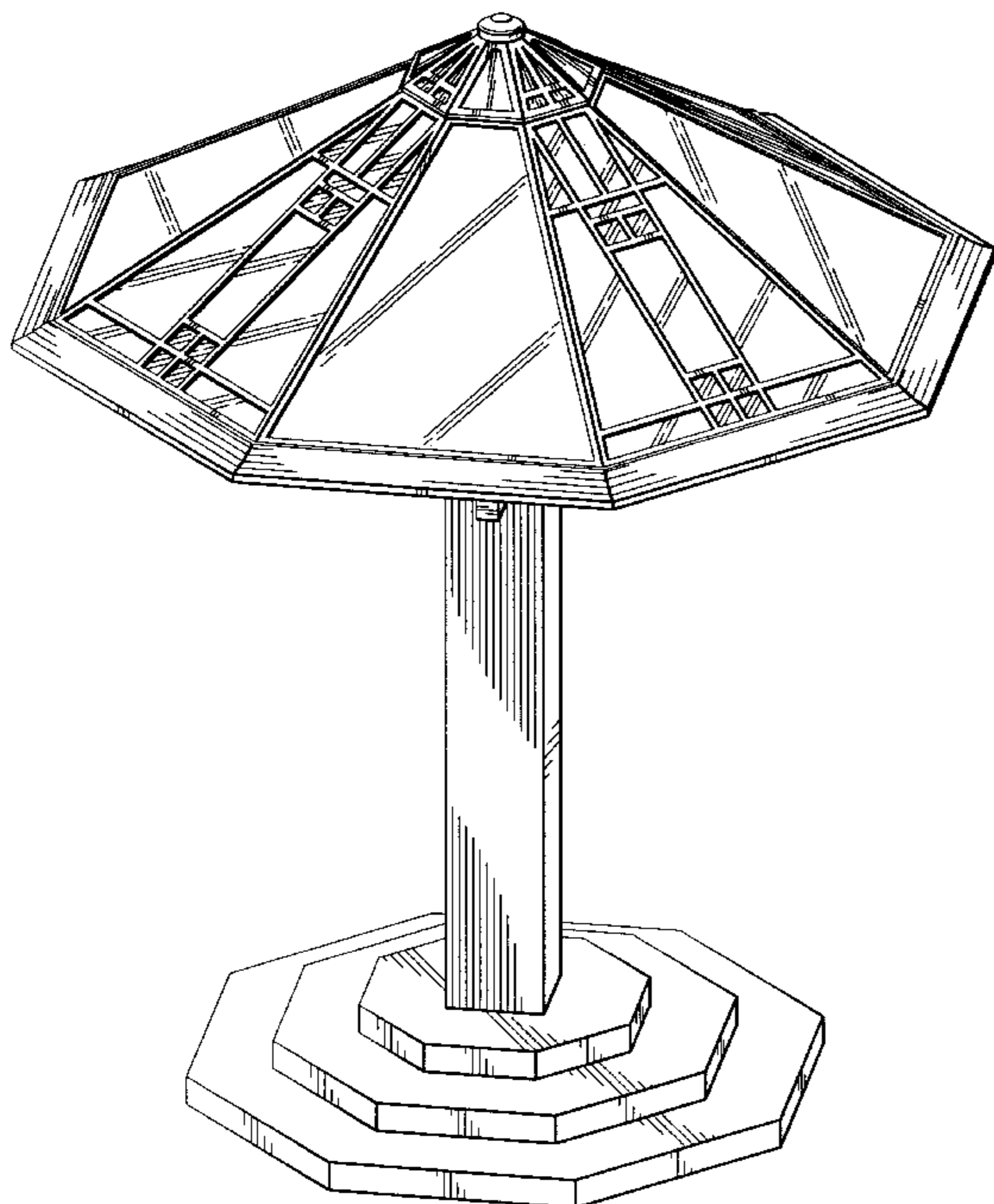
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a table lamp showing my new design;

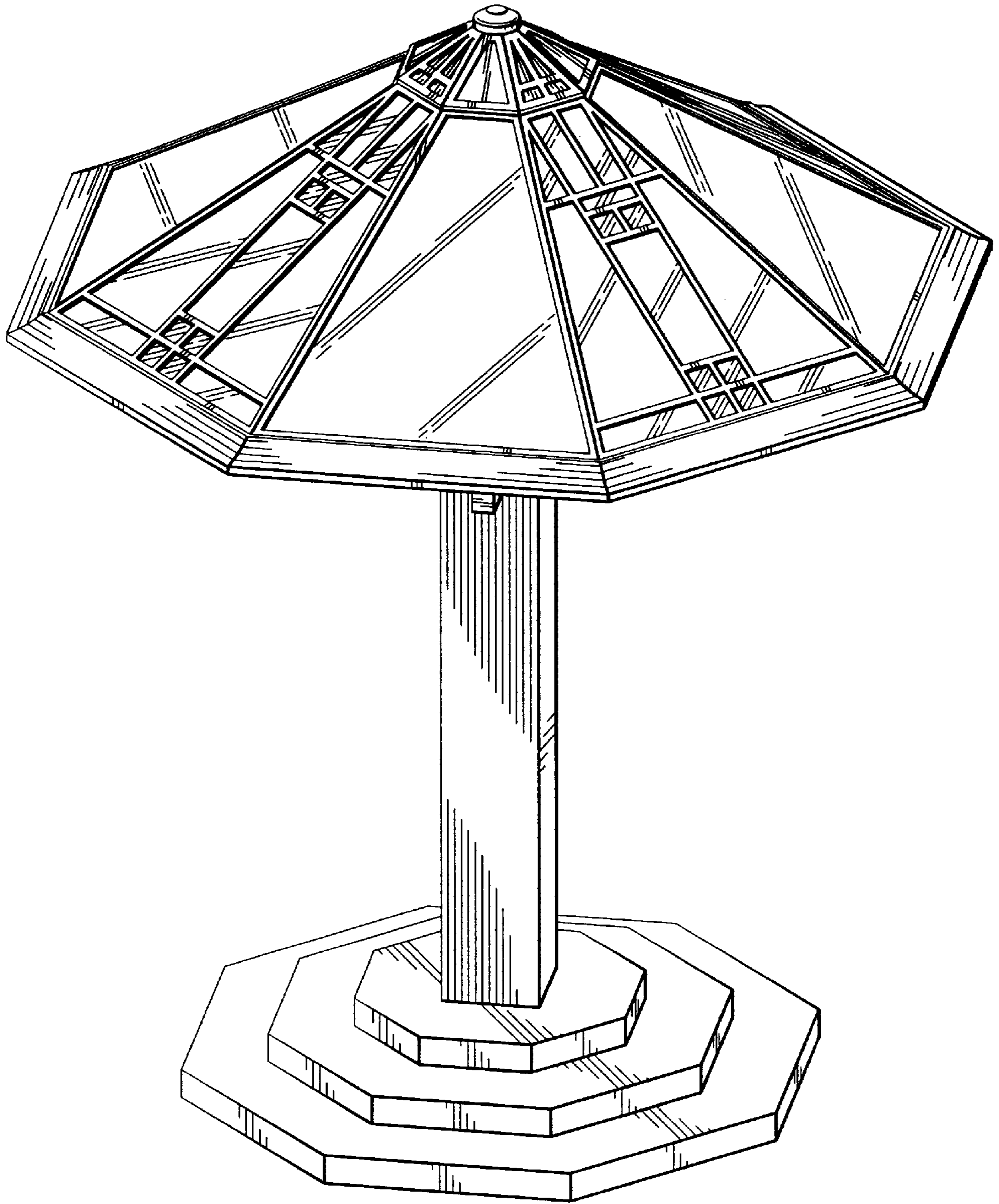

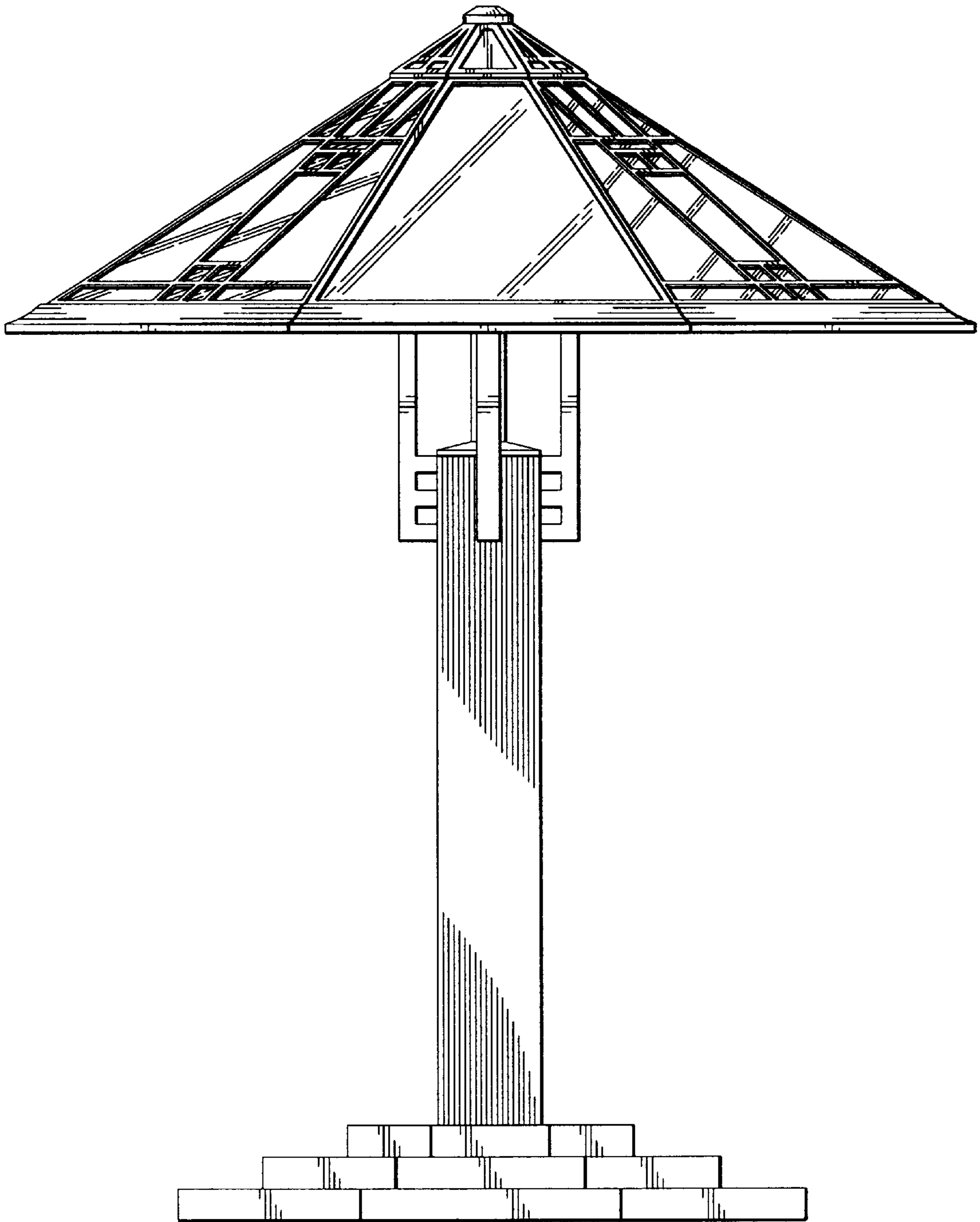

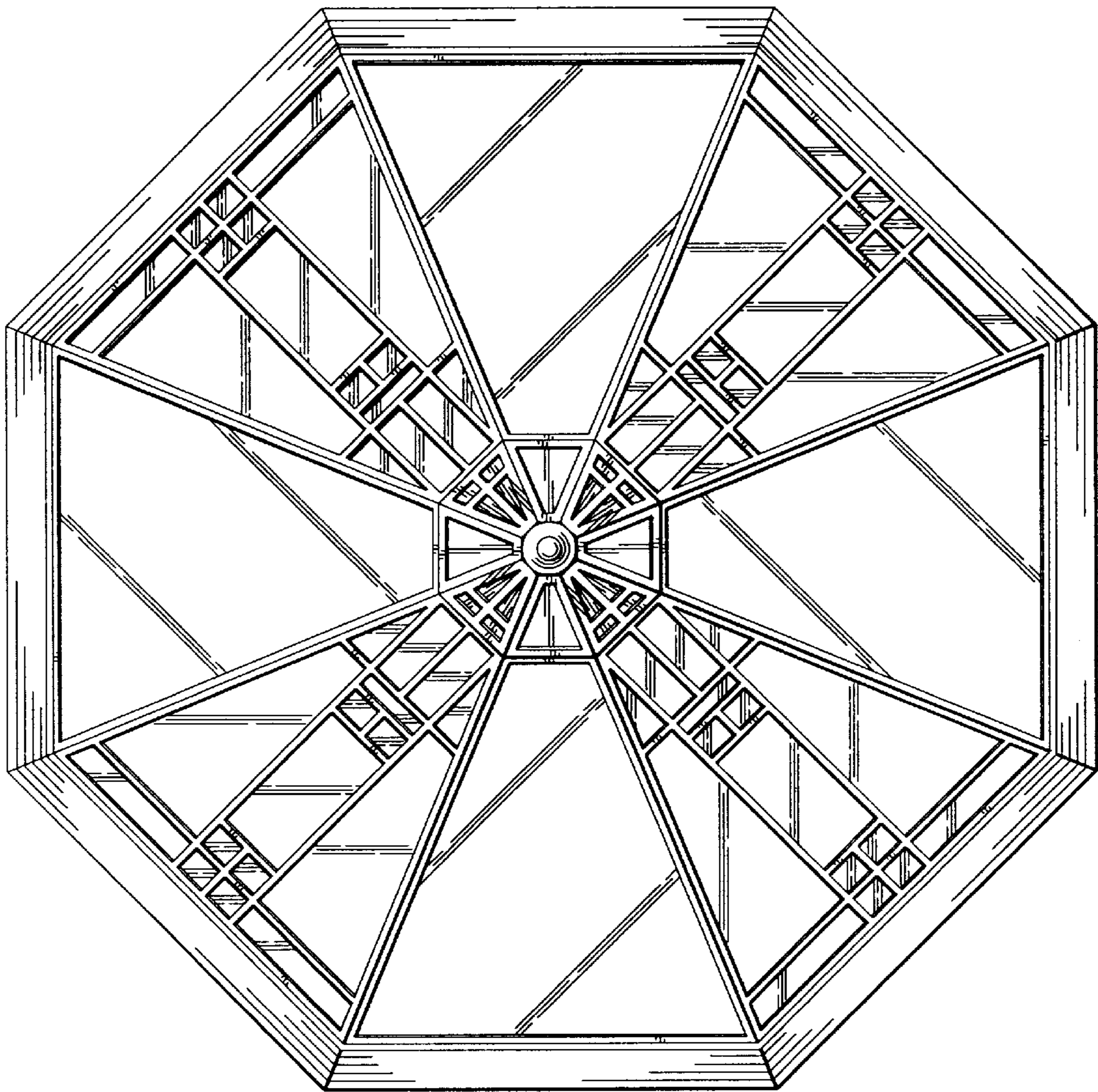

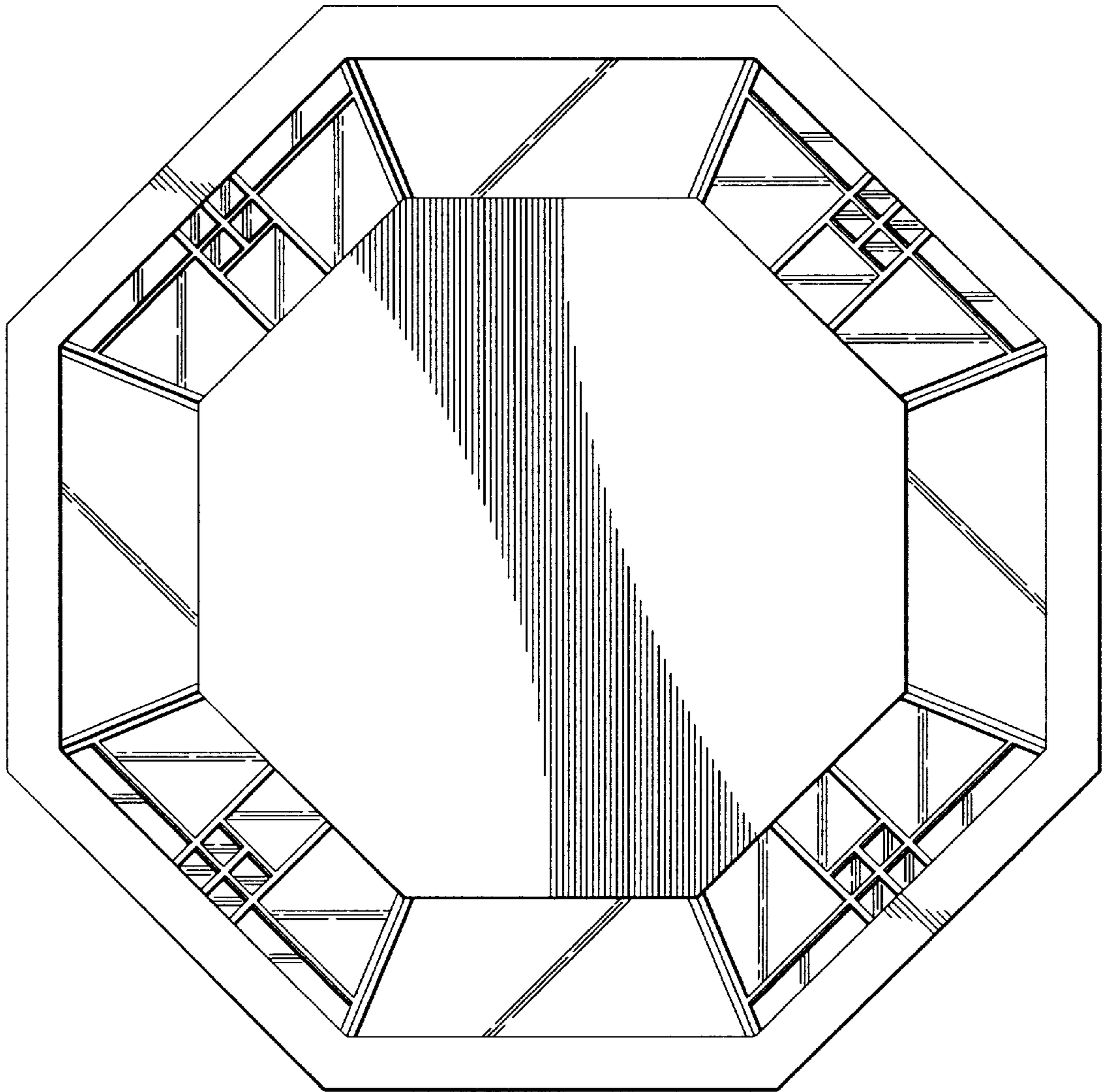
