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[57] **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for an embossed tissue, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of an embossed tissue illustrating the claimed design. A repeat unit is outlined in phantom lines, which form no part of the claimed design; and, FIG. 2 is a fragmentary sectional view of the tissue of FIG. 1 taken along line 2—2.

The surfaces or portions of the article not shown in the drawing or described in the specification form no part of the claimed design.

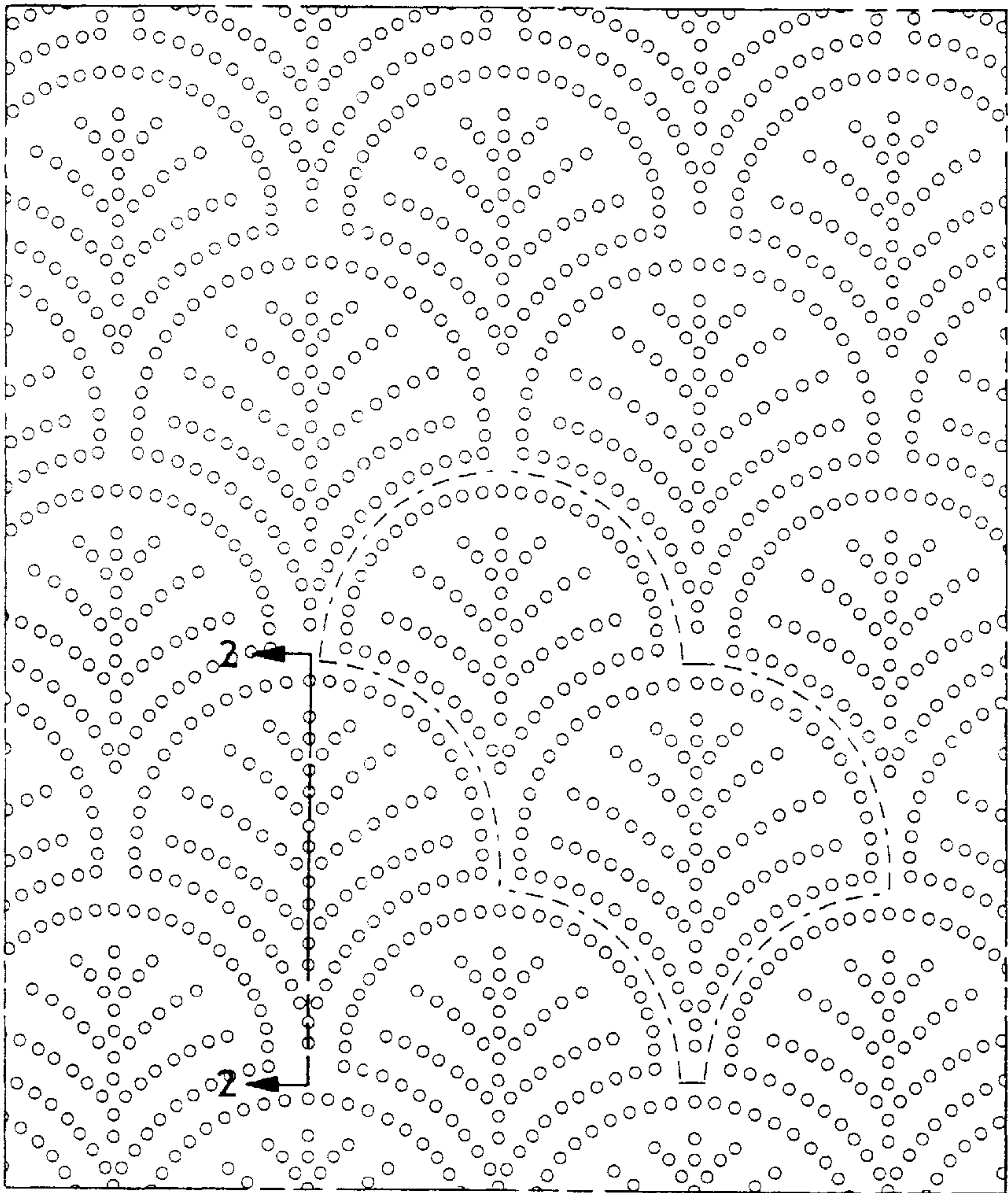
In FIG. 1, the outermost broken lines depict the boundaries of the claimed design and form no part thereof.

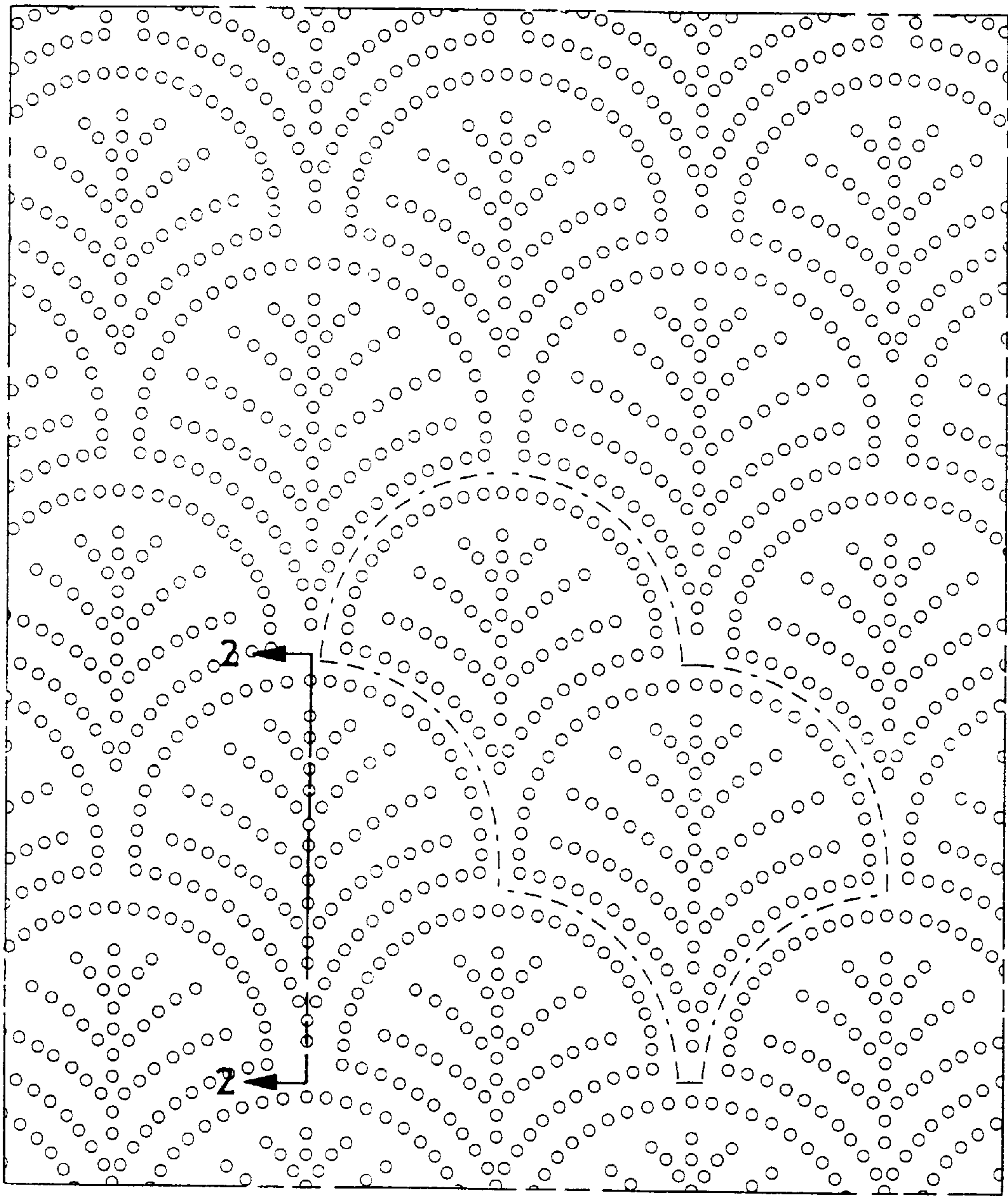
