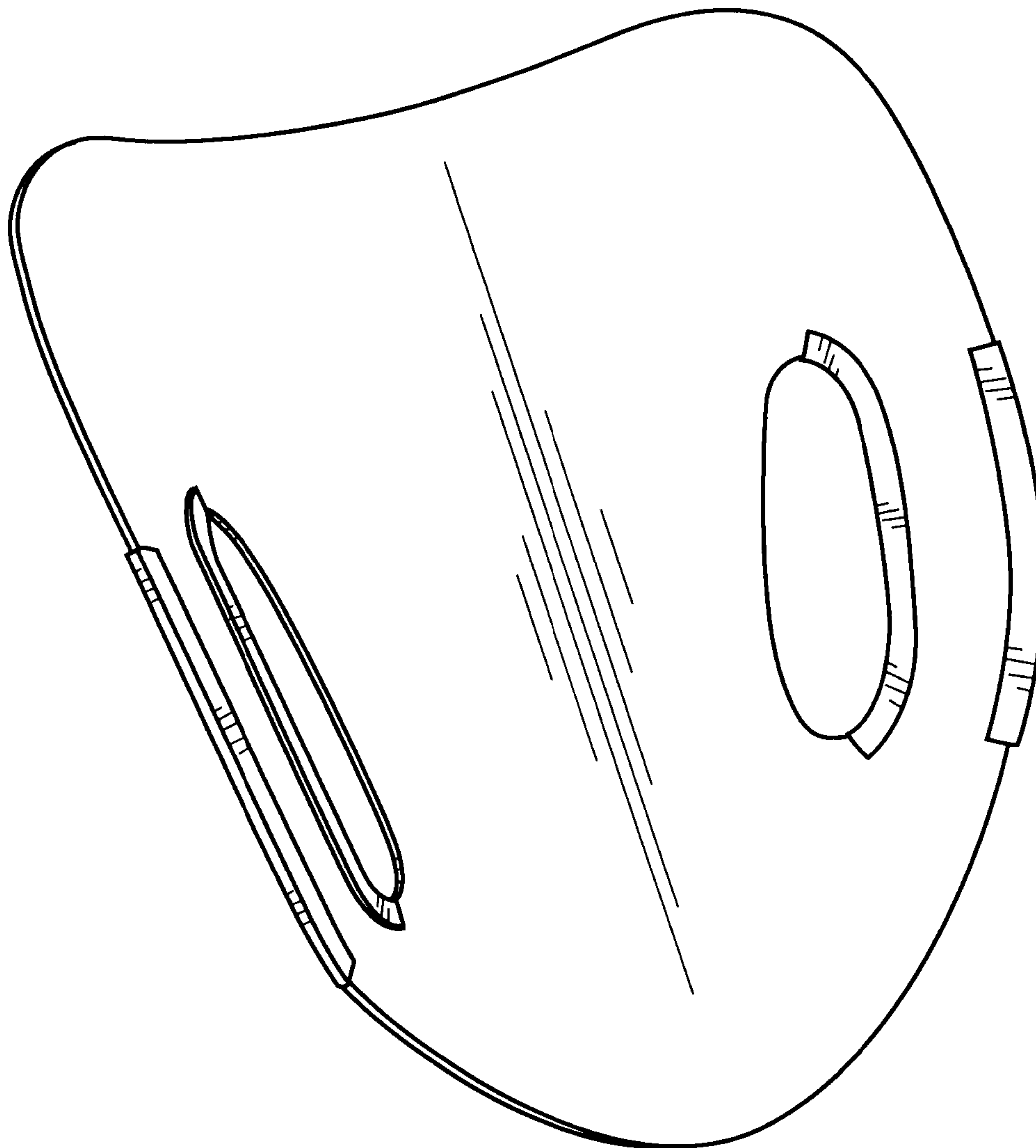
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the snow digging device showing my new design;

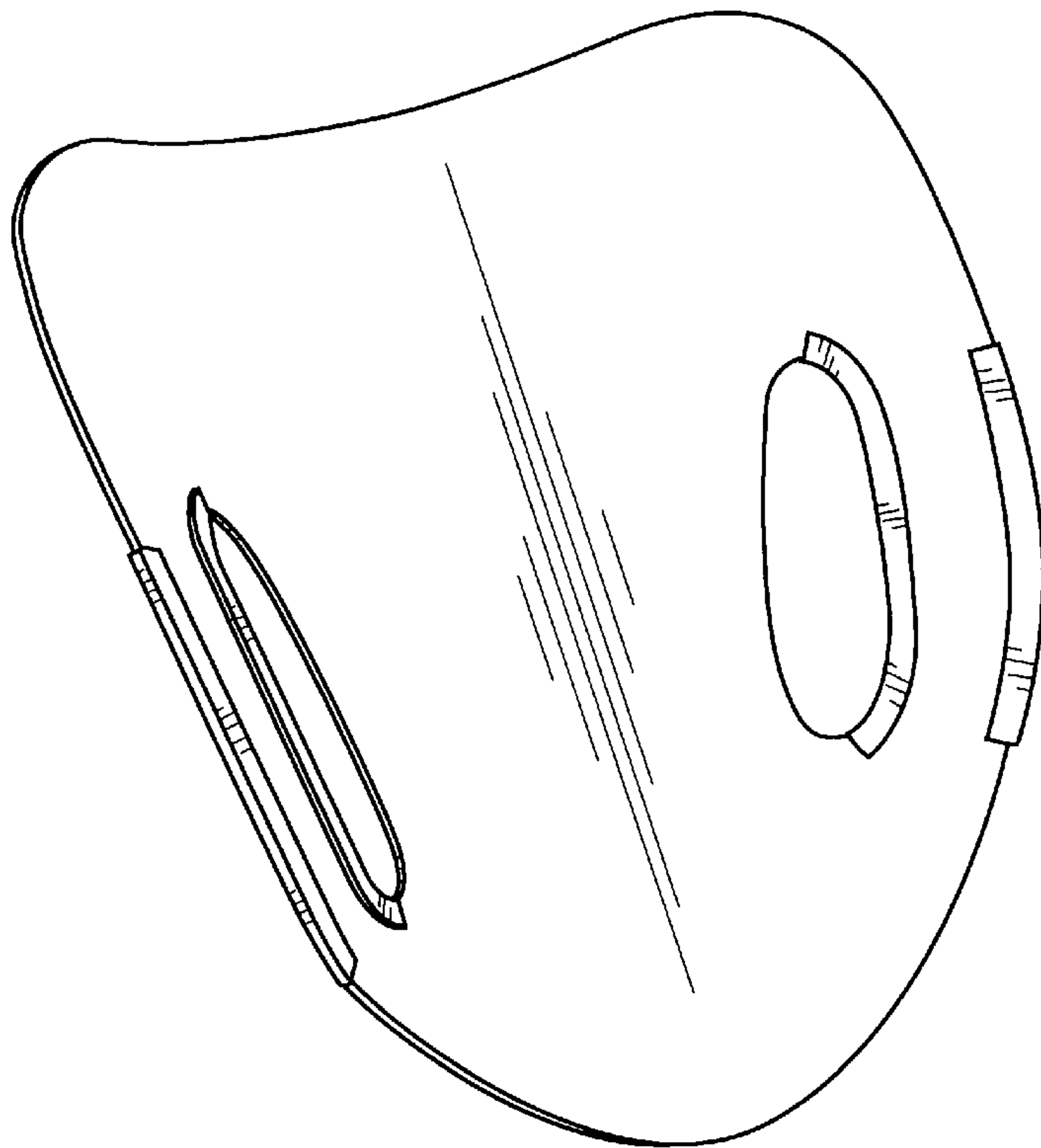

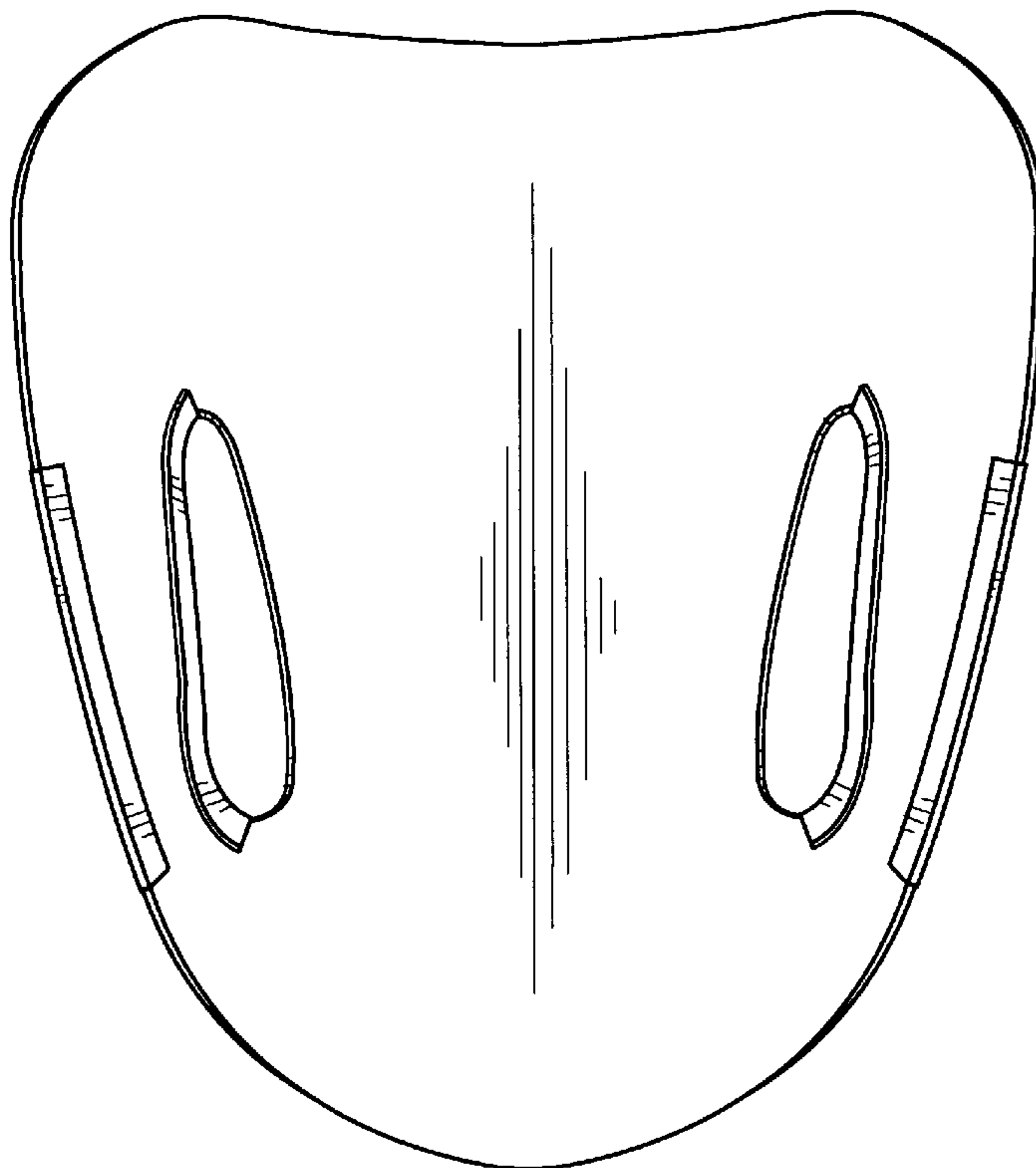

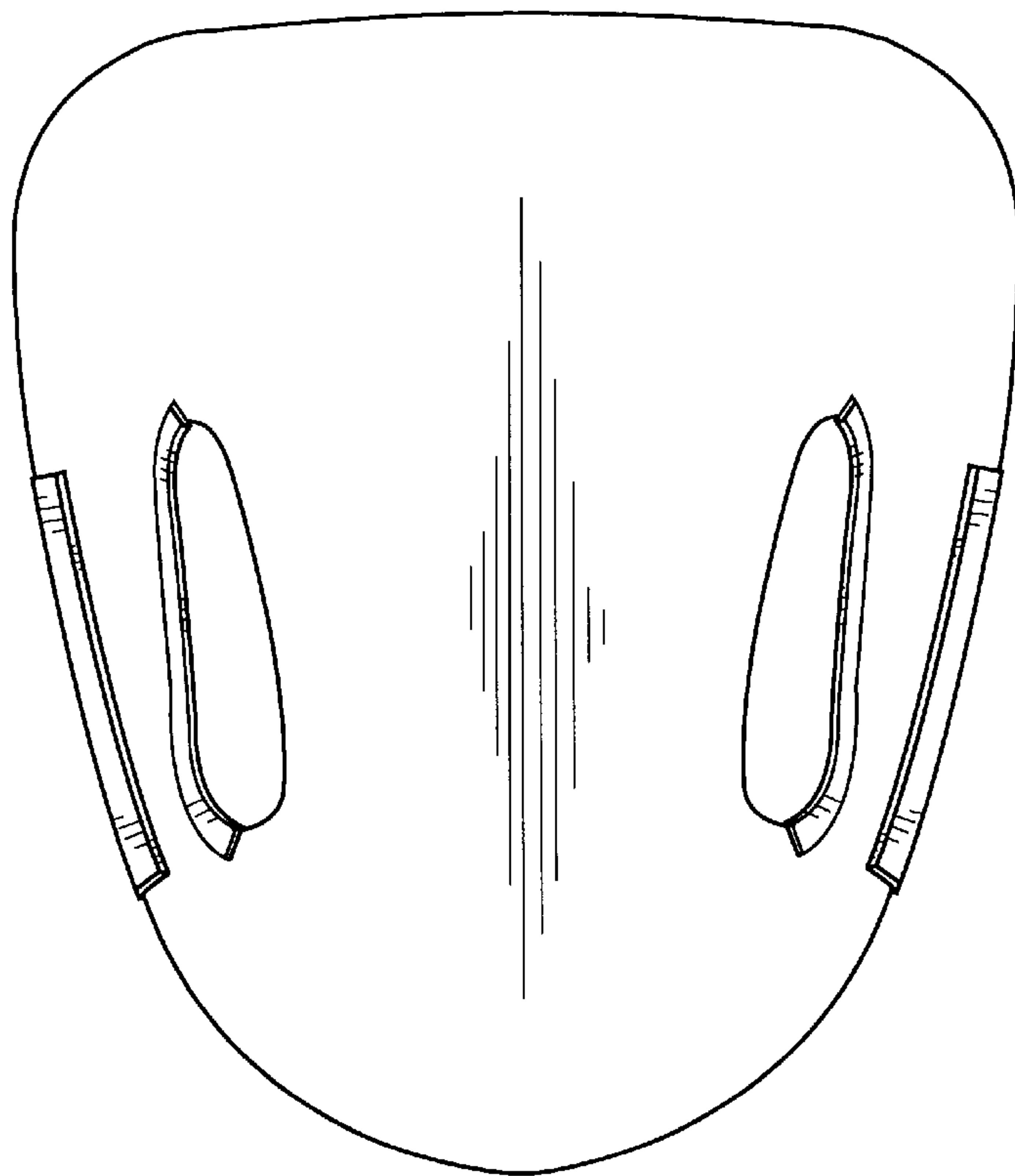

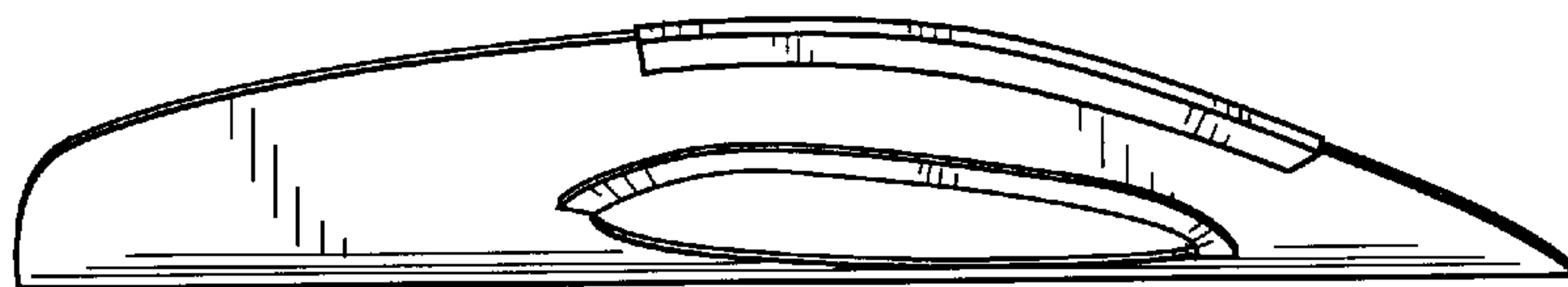
