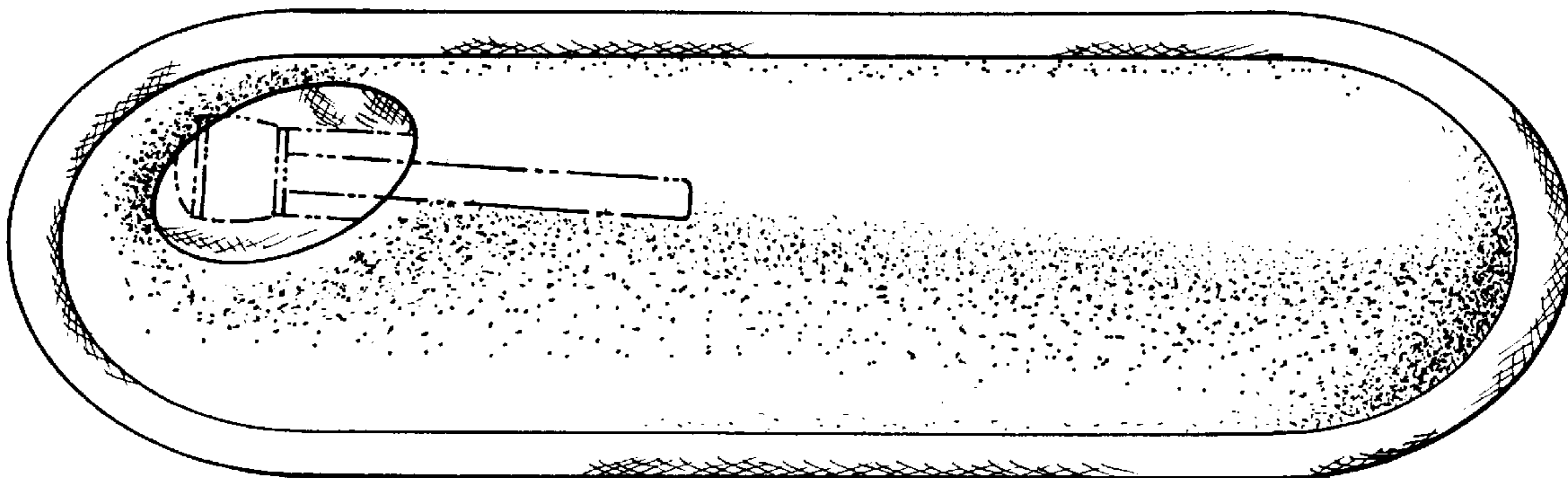
The broken line showing of a writing instrument in the pouch is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

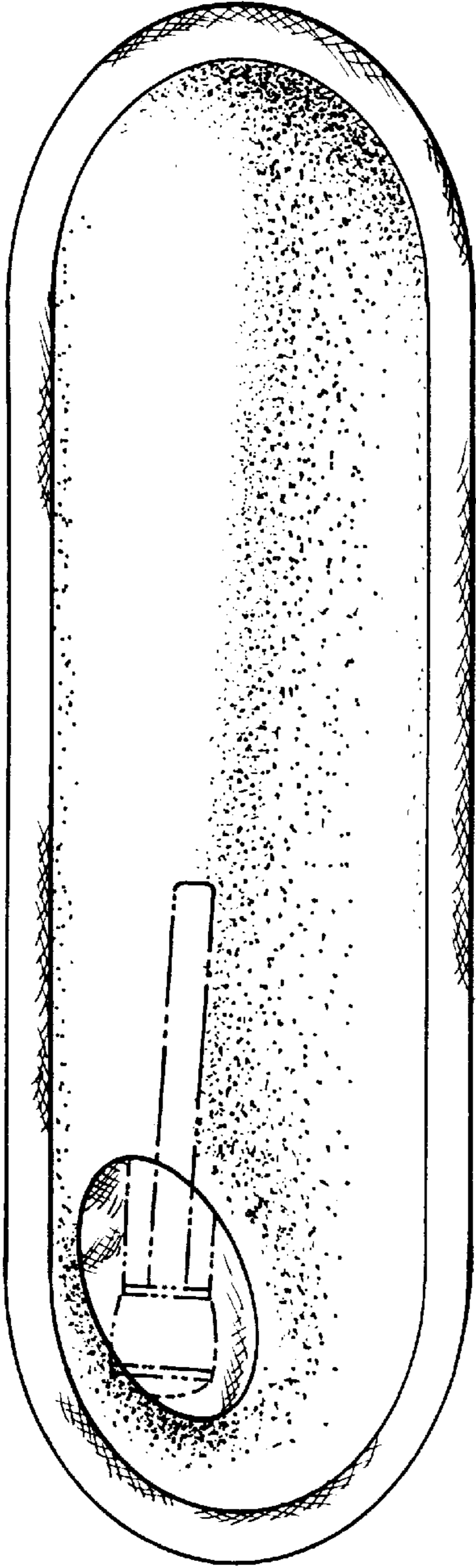

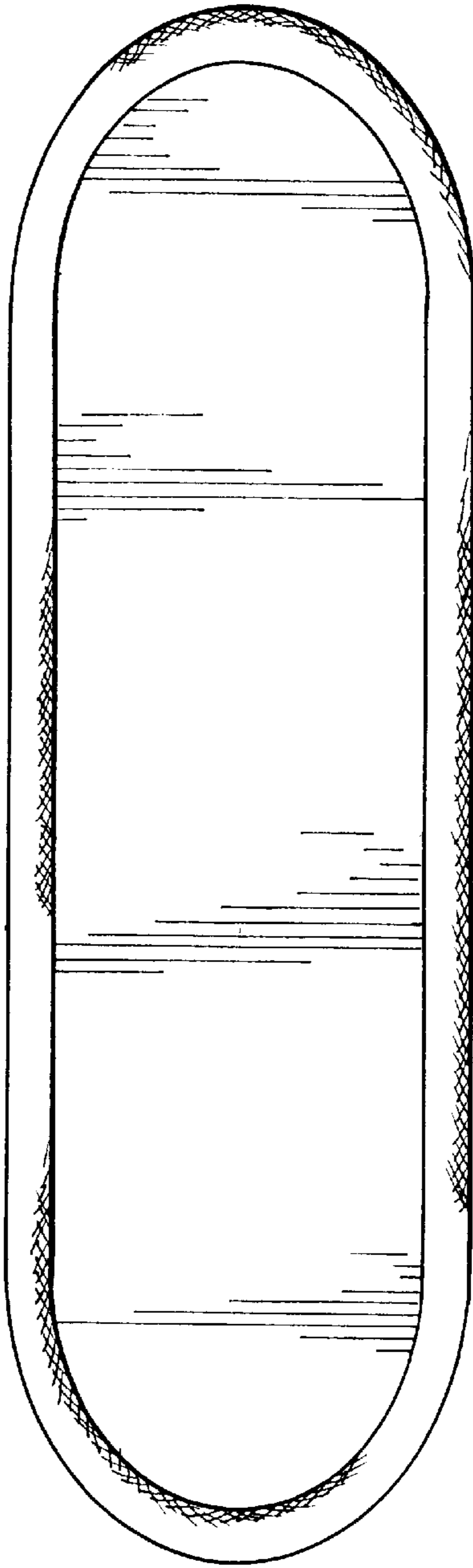

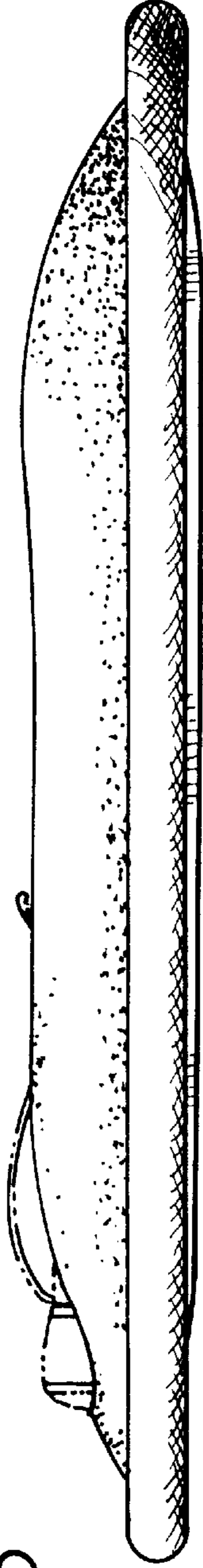

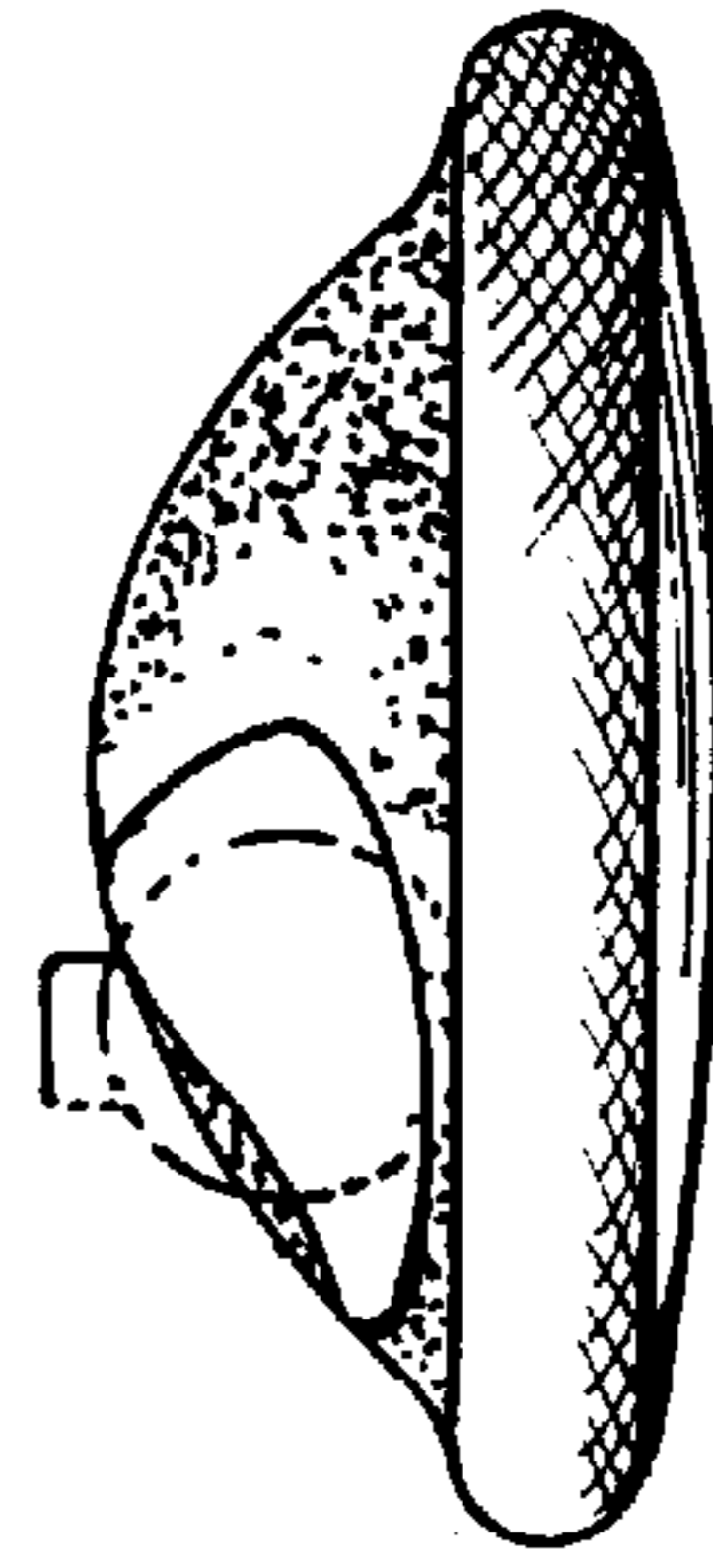
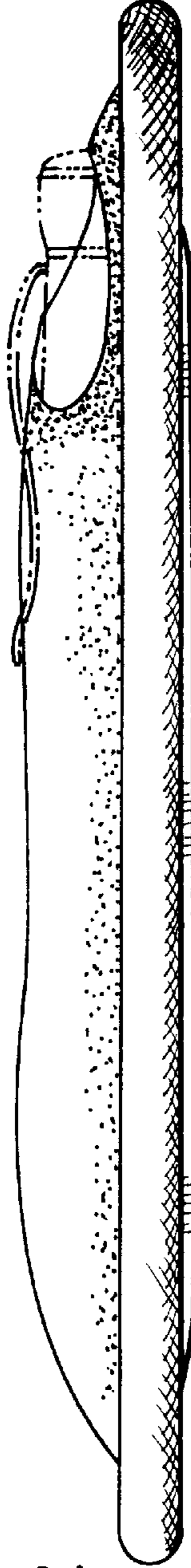

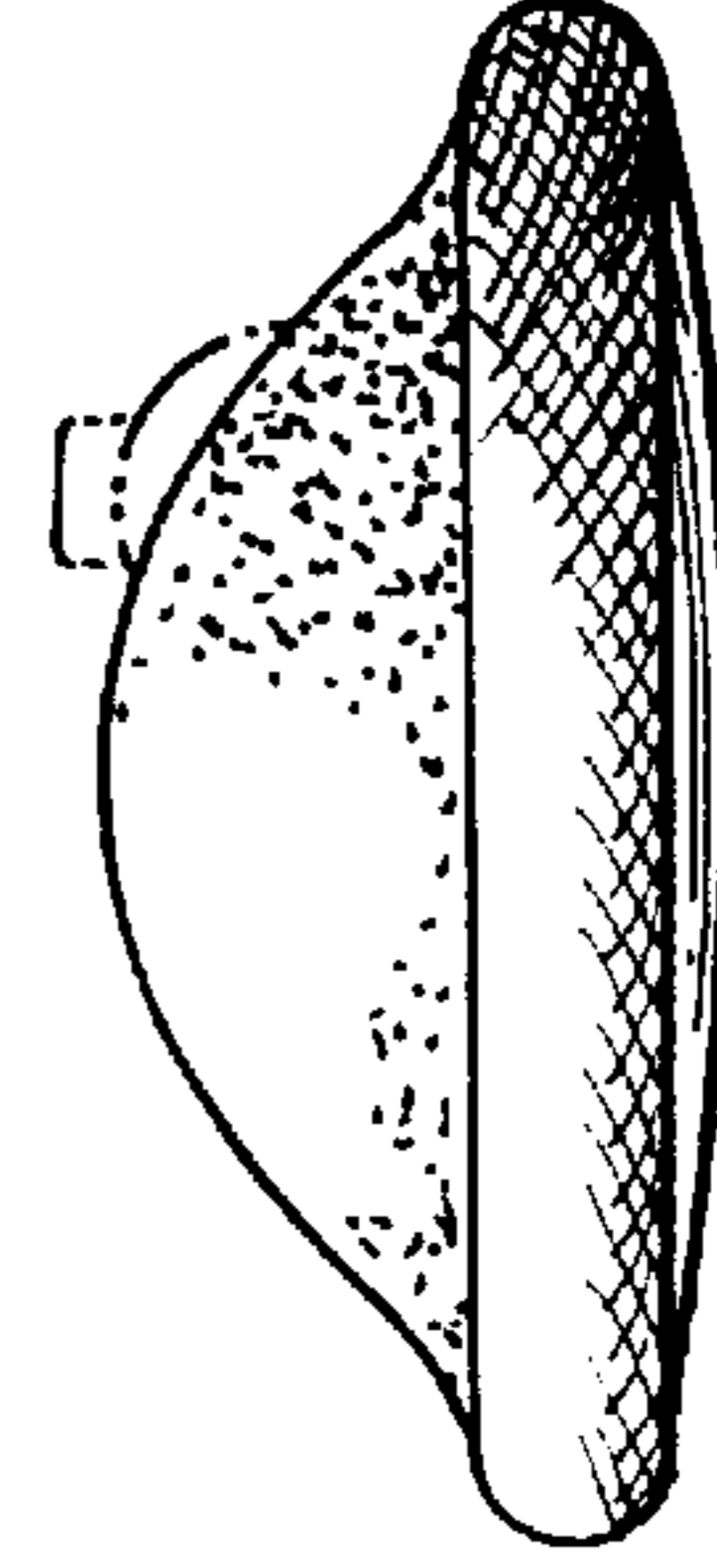

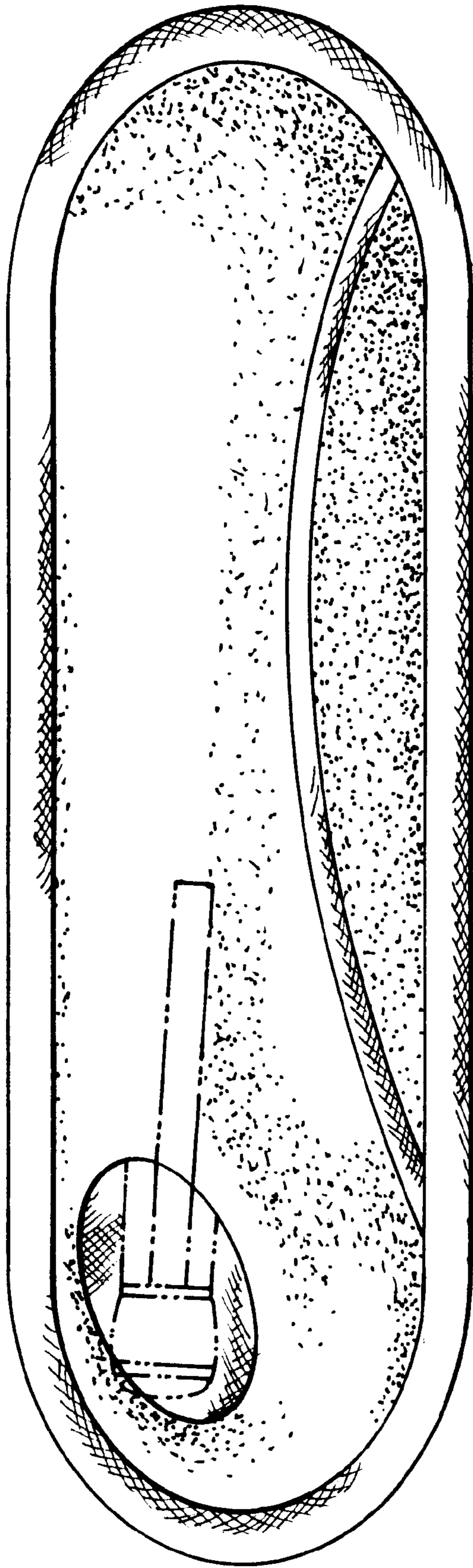
