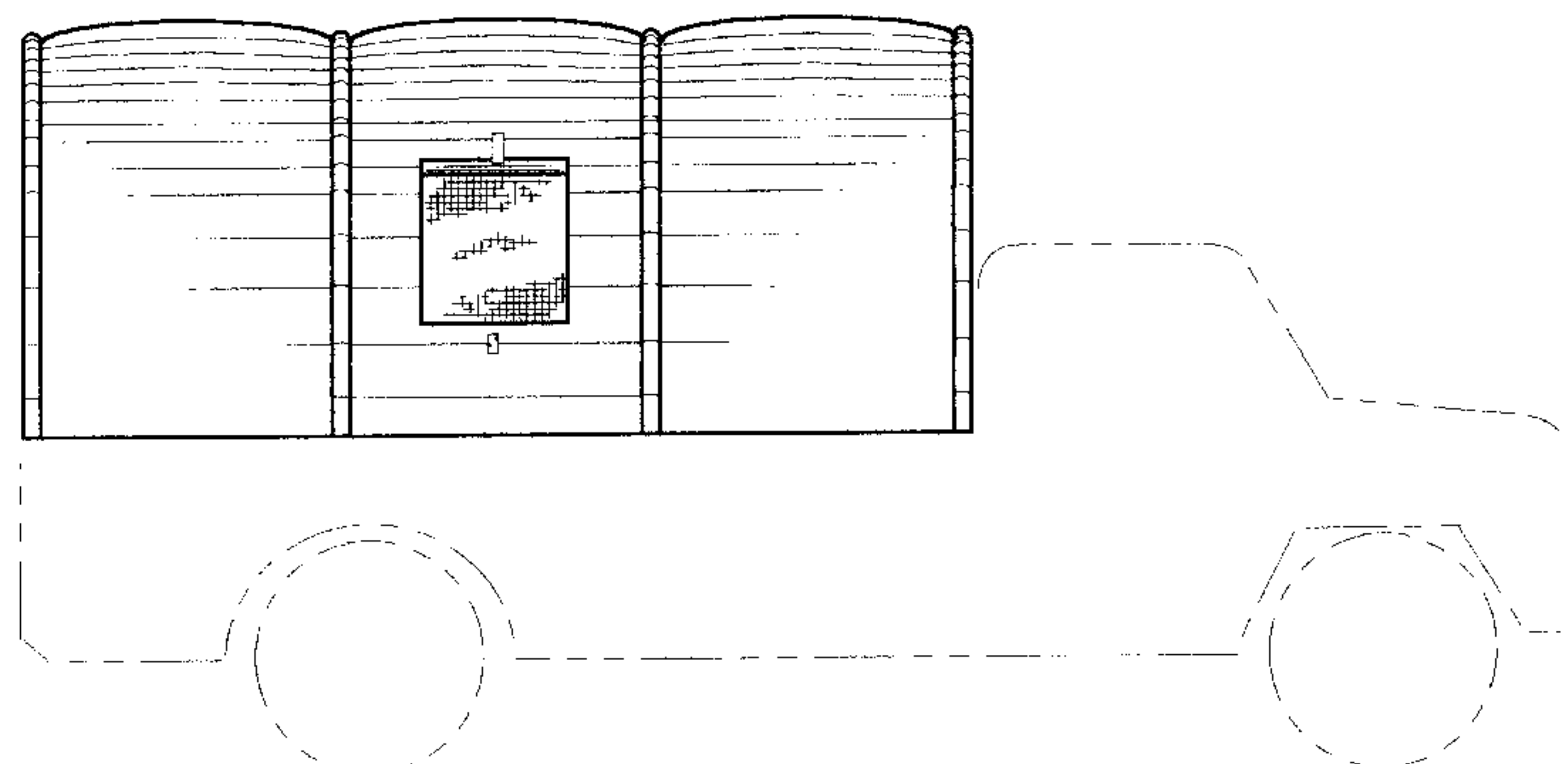
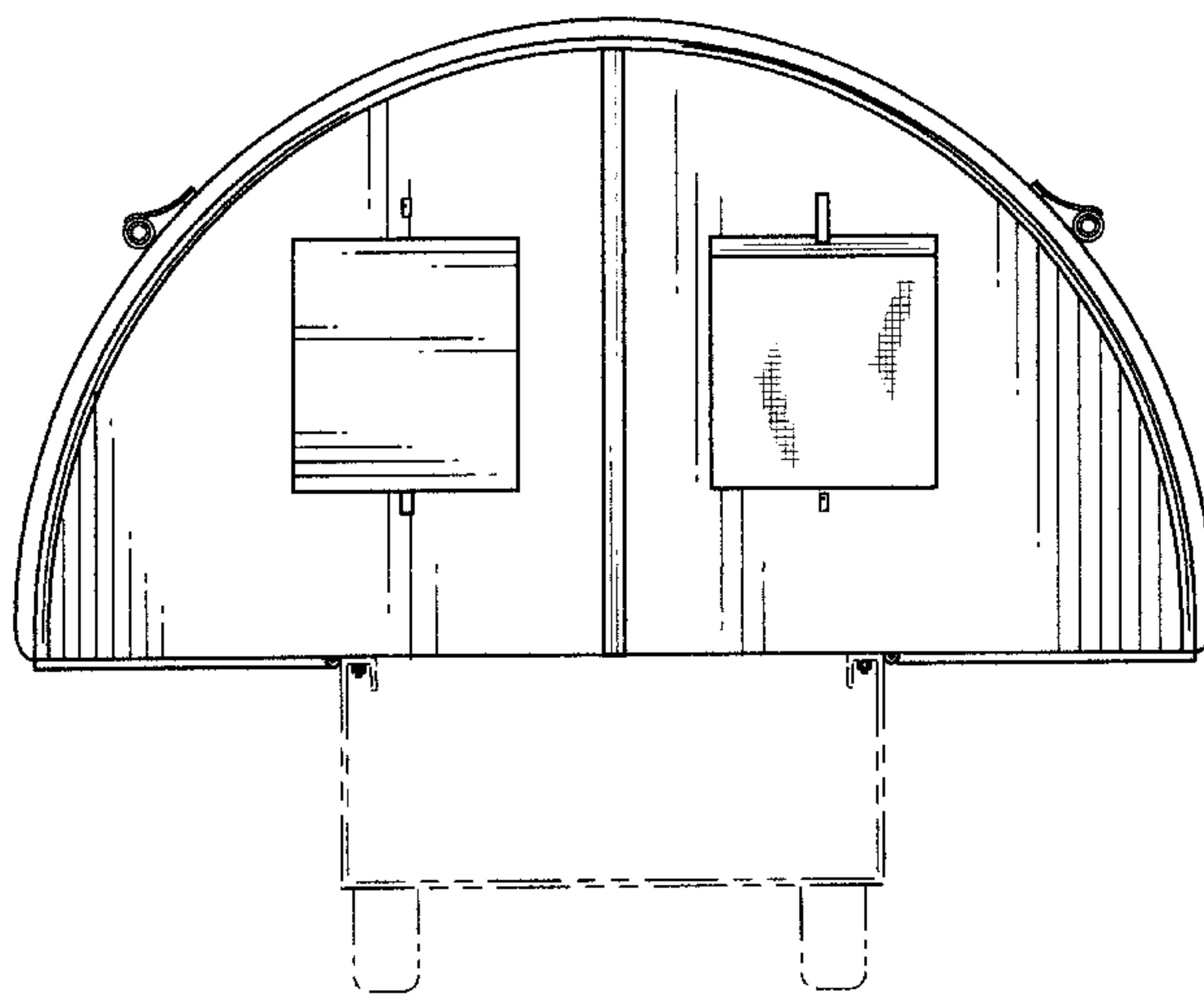
The ornamental design for a truck bed pop up tent, as shown and described.

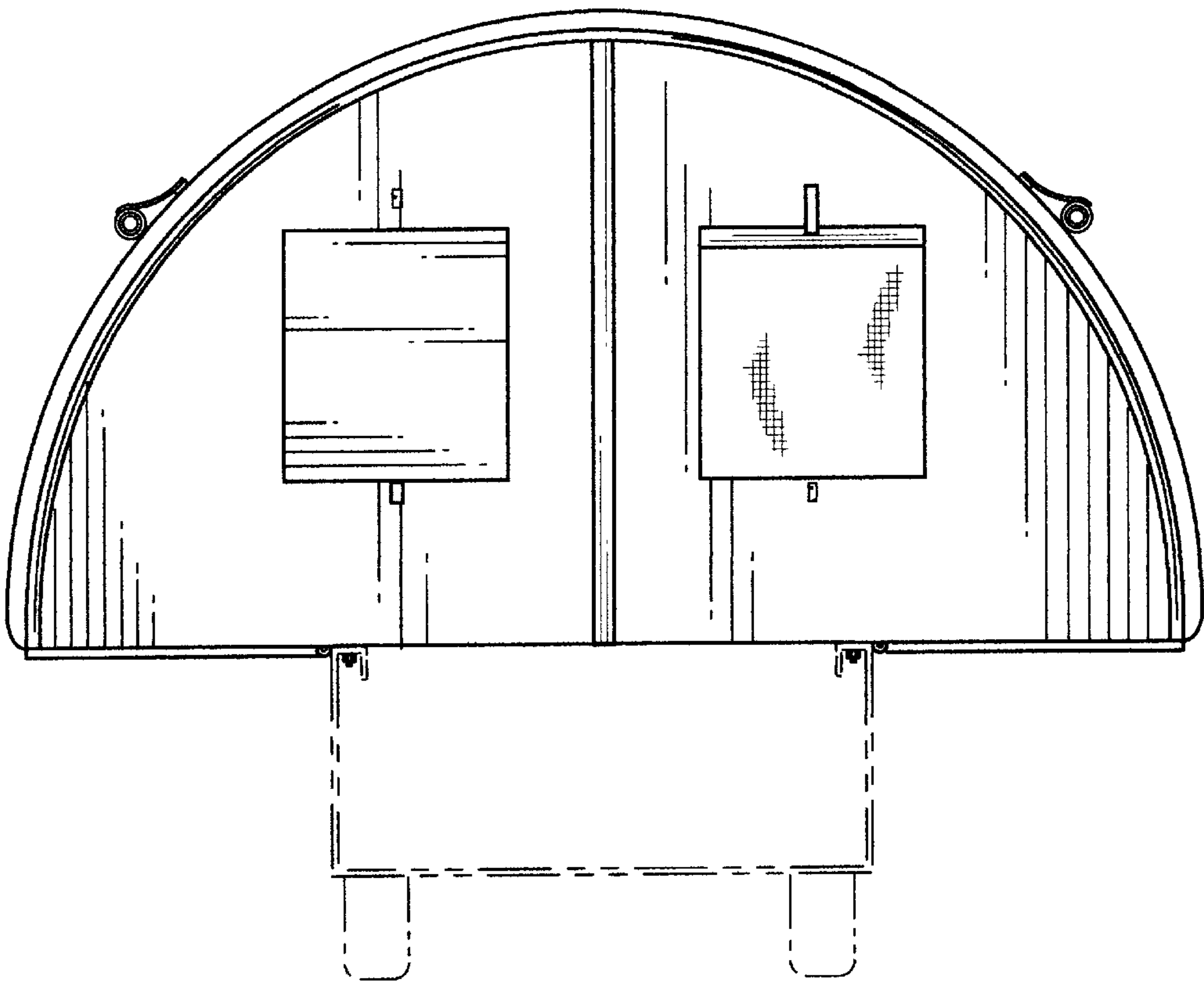

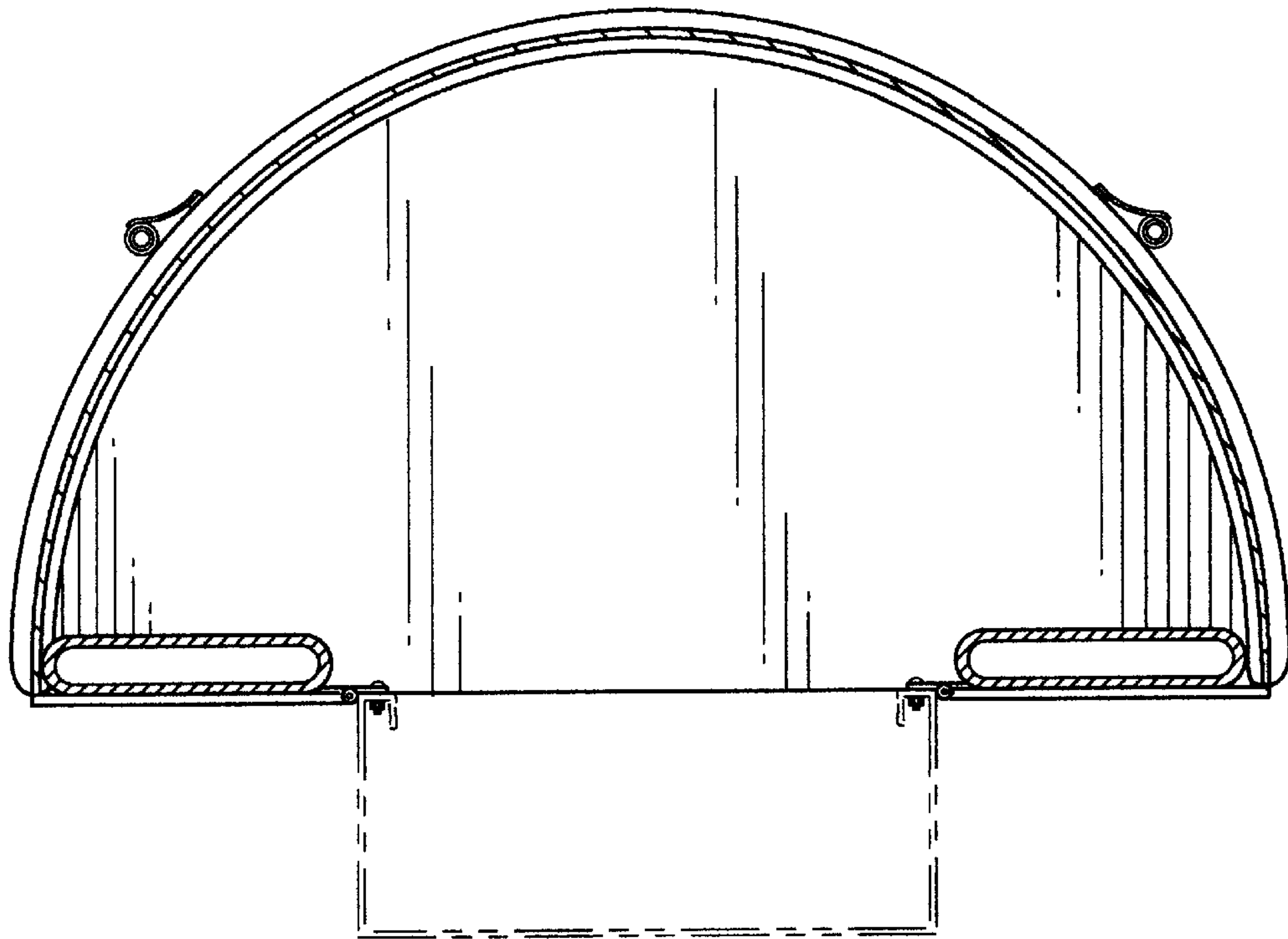

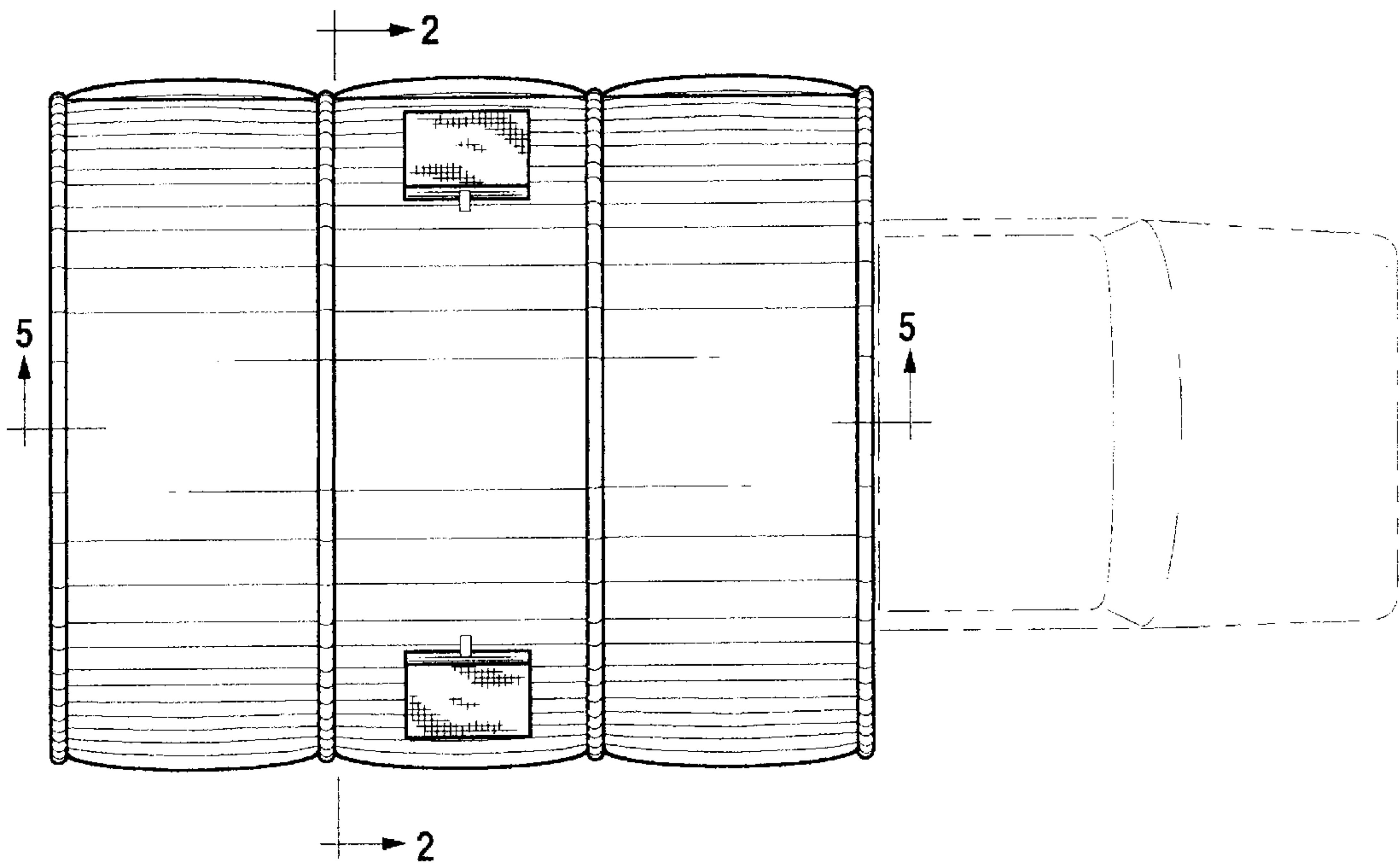

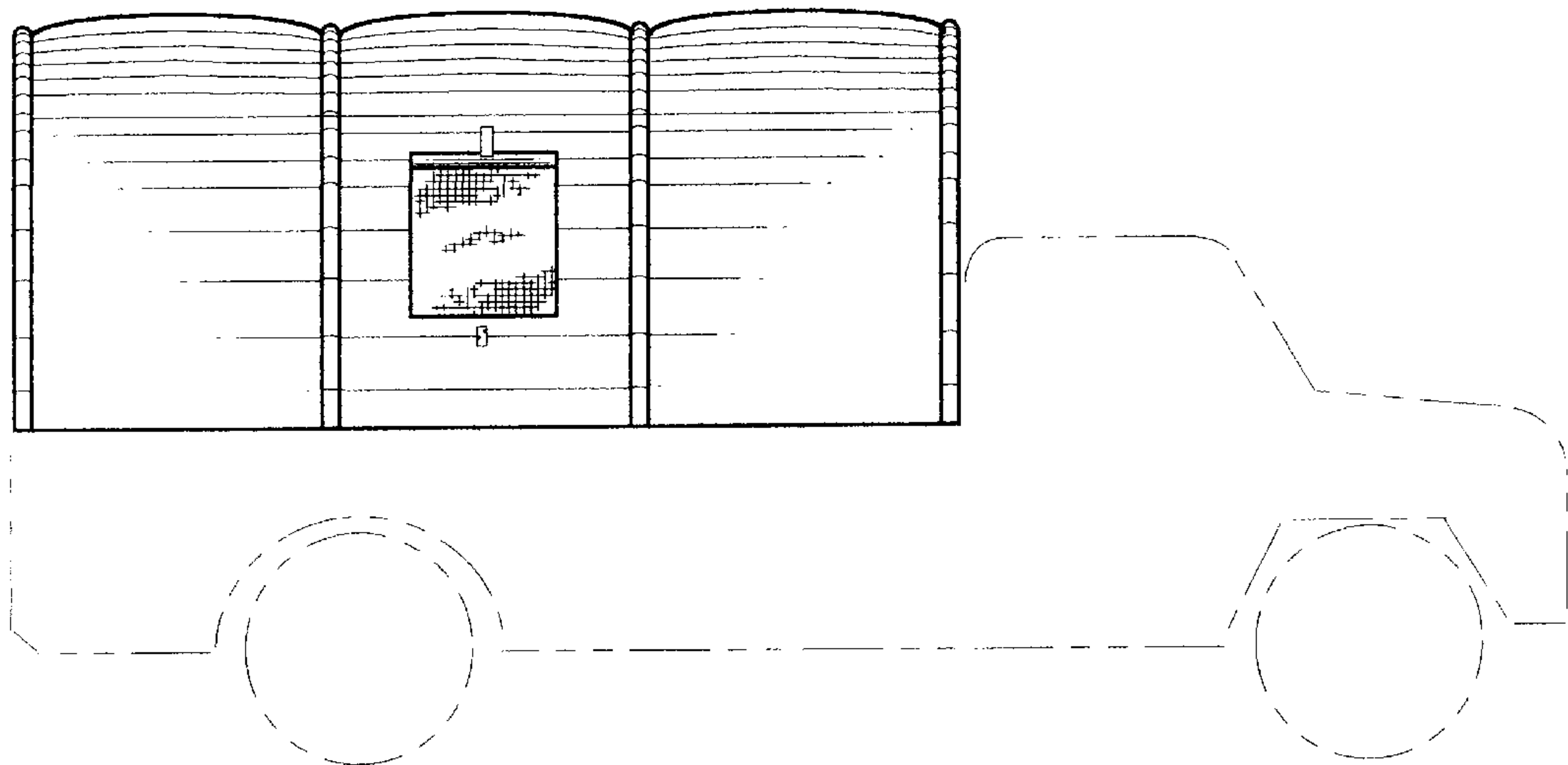

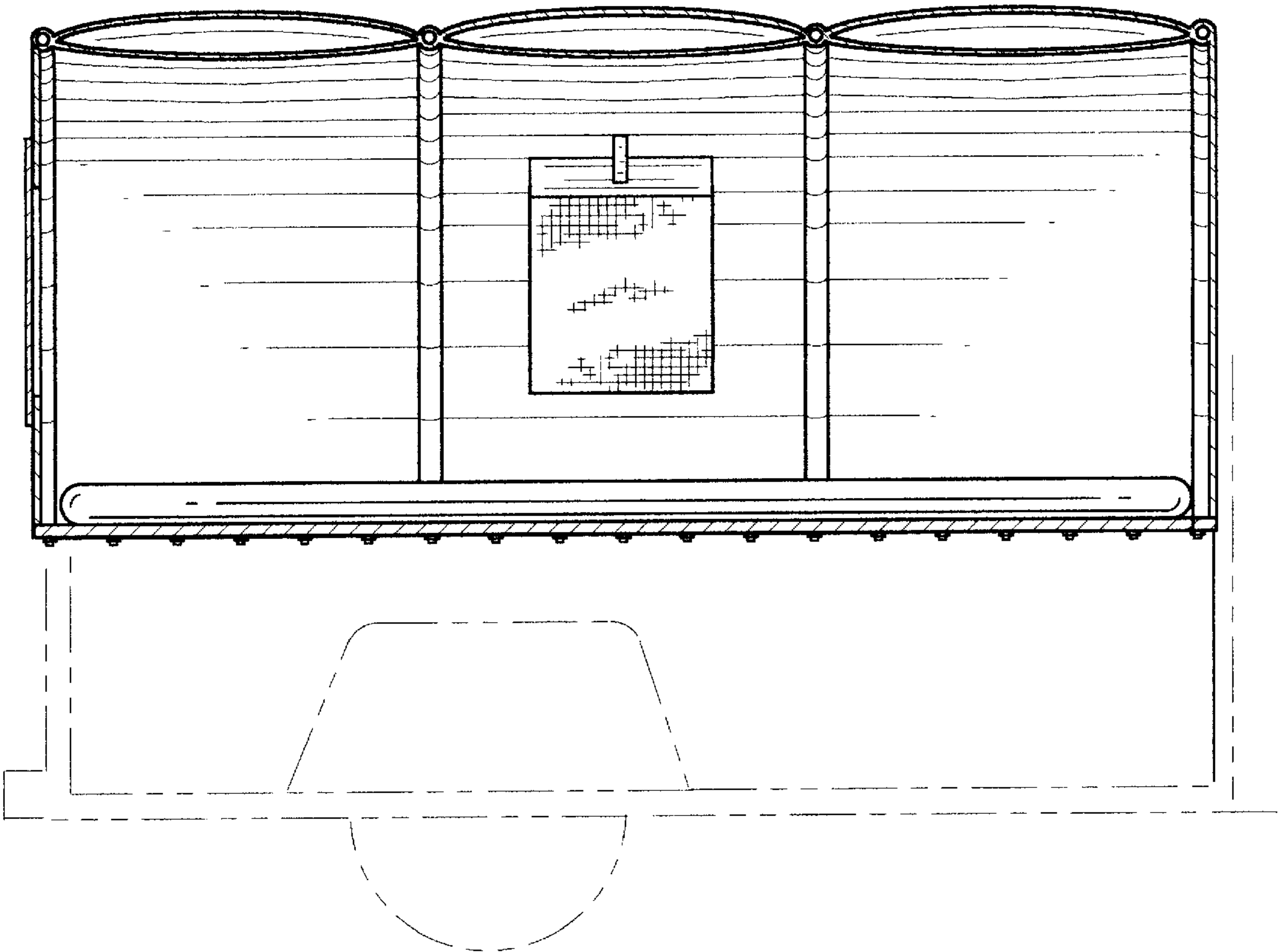

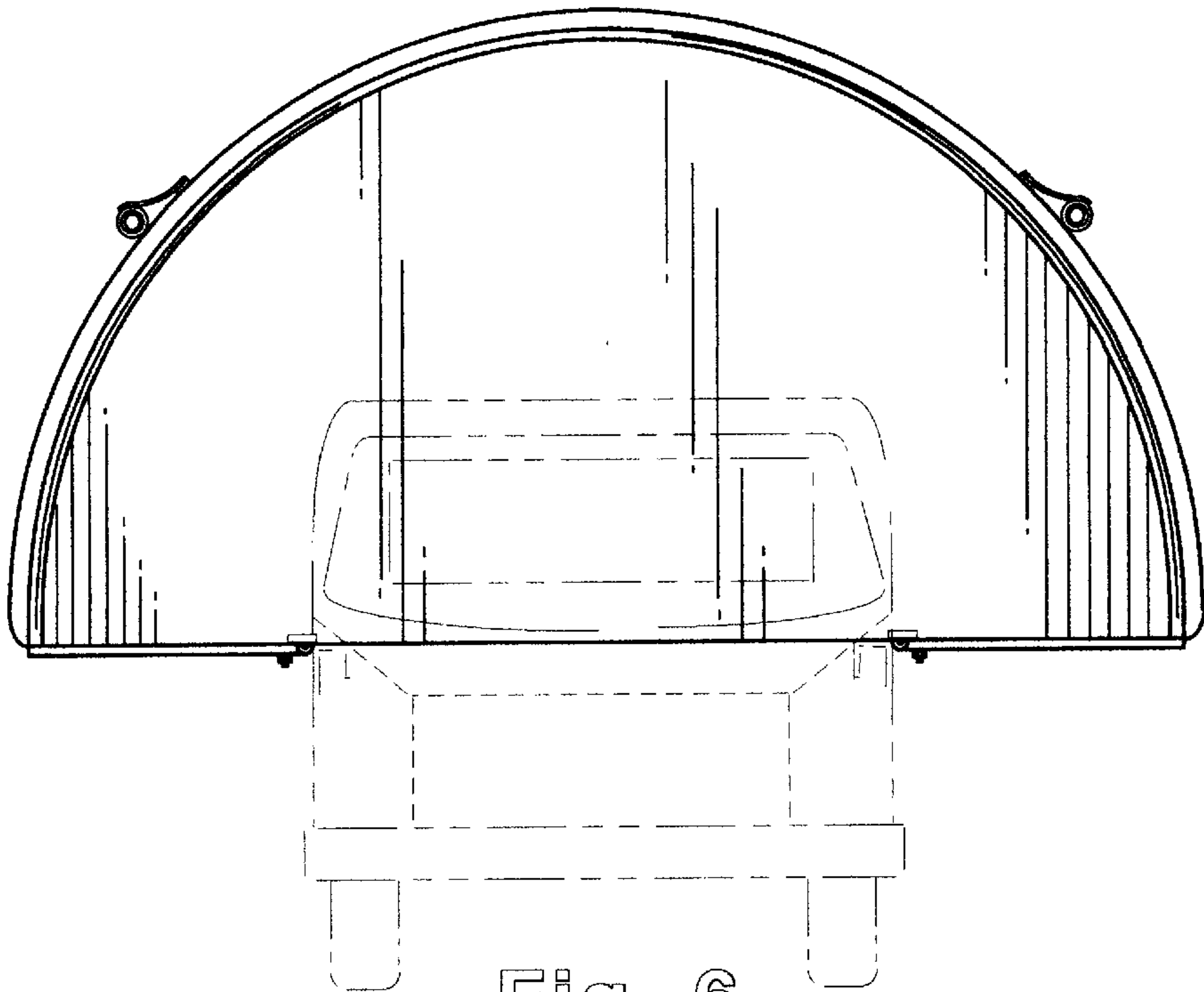

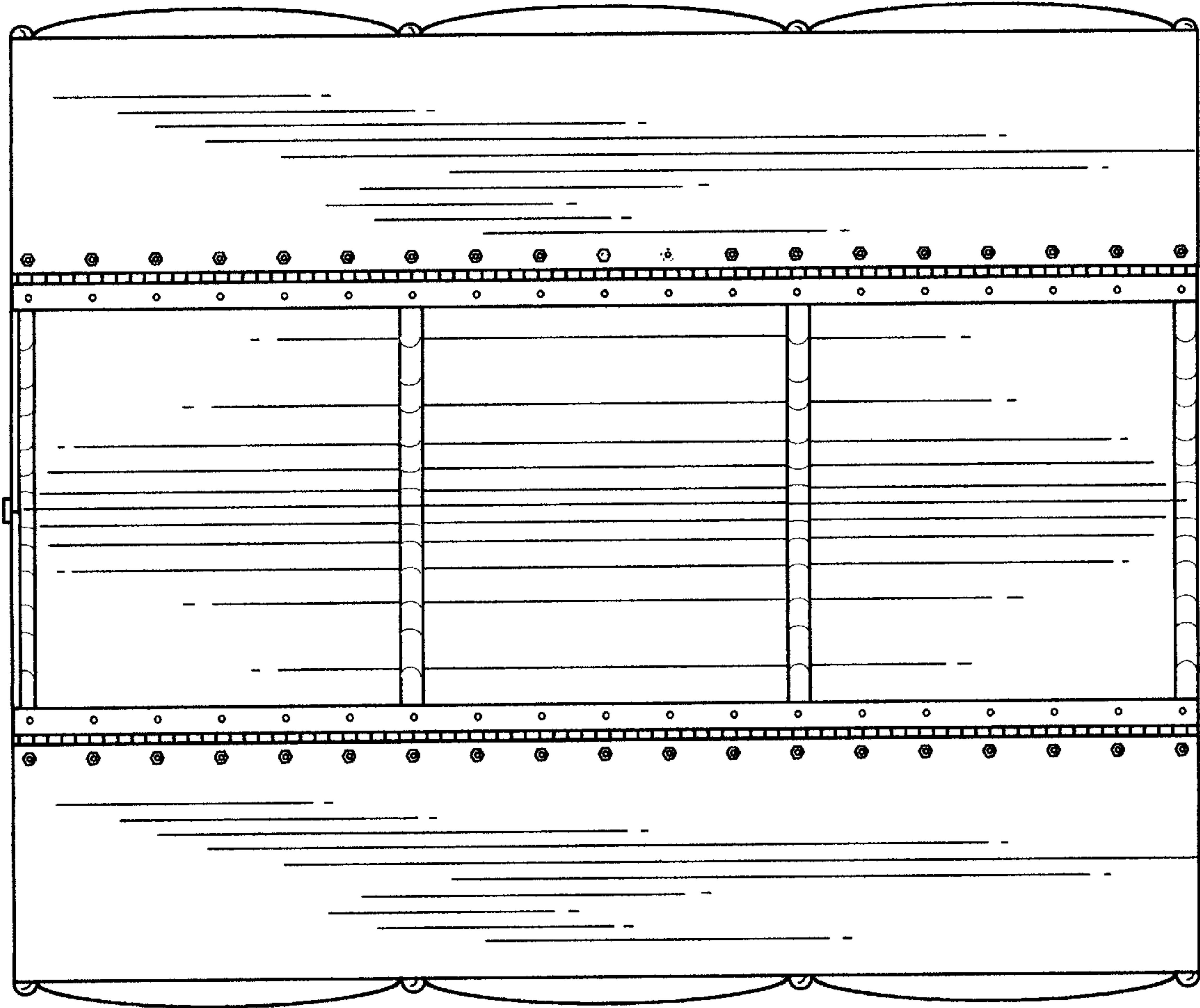
