FIG. 6 is an elevational view of the lower end; and,

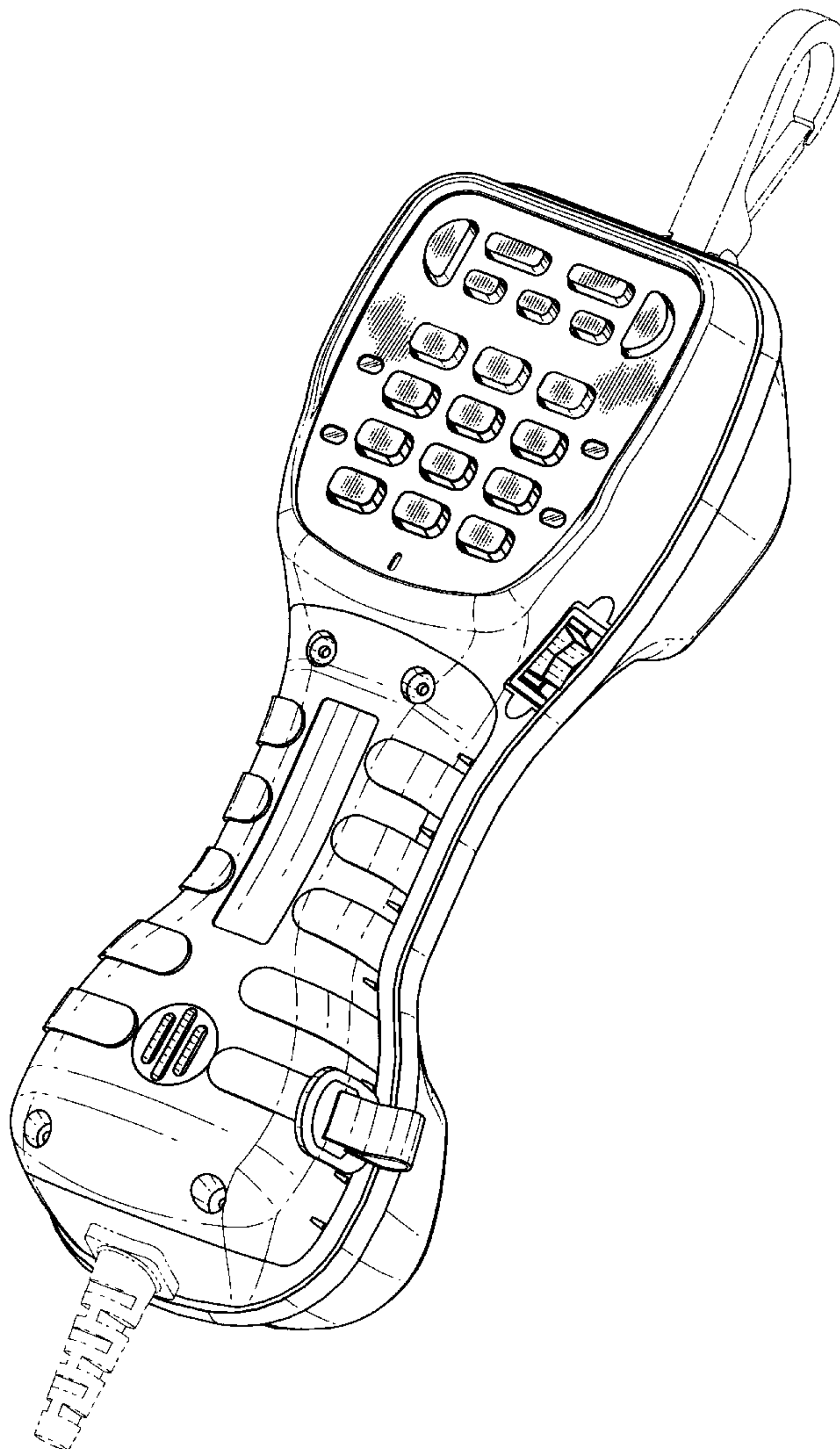
FIG. 7 is an elevational view of the upper end.

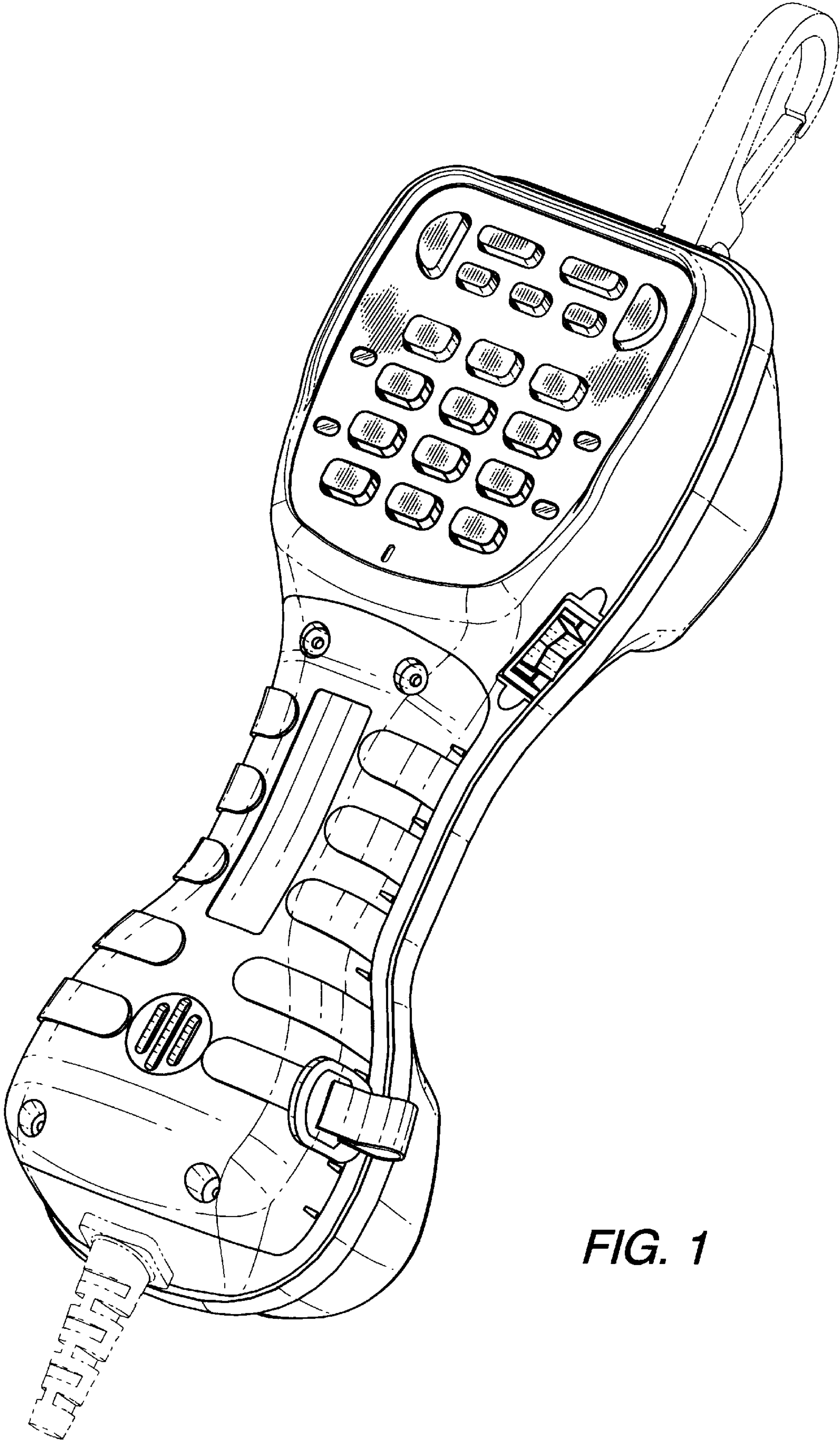

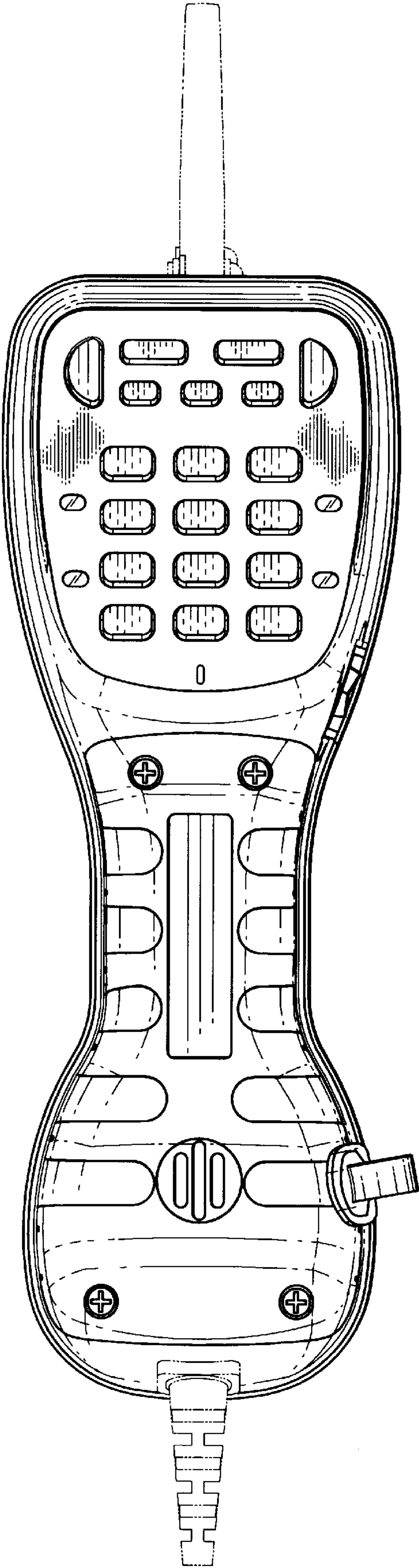

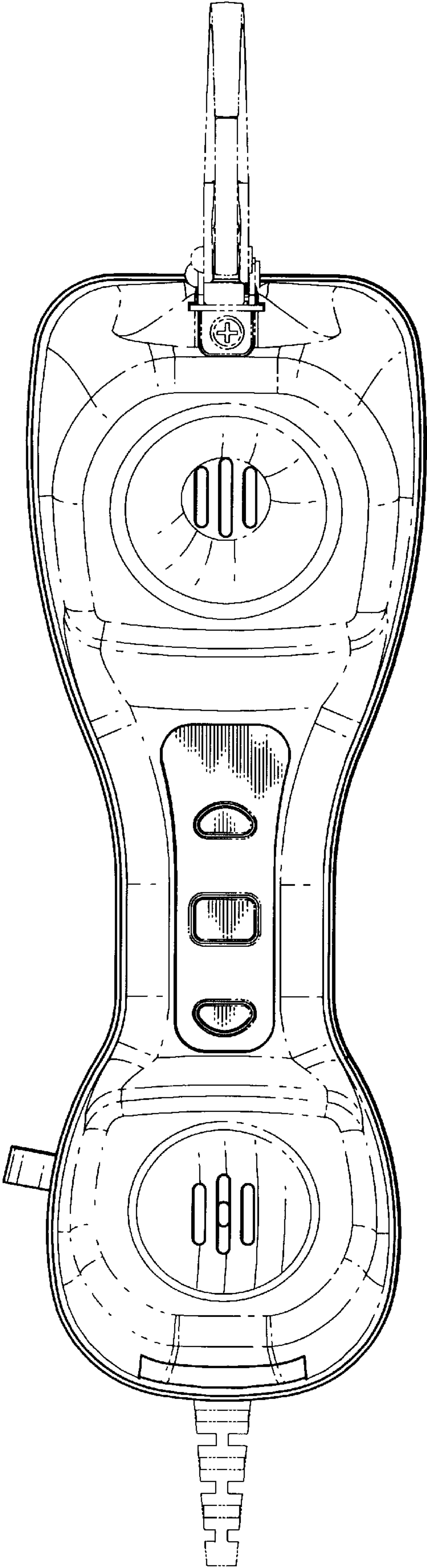

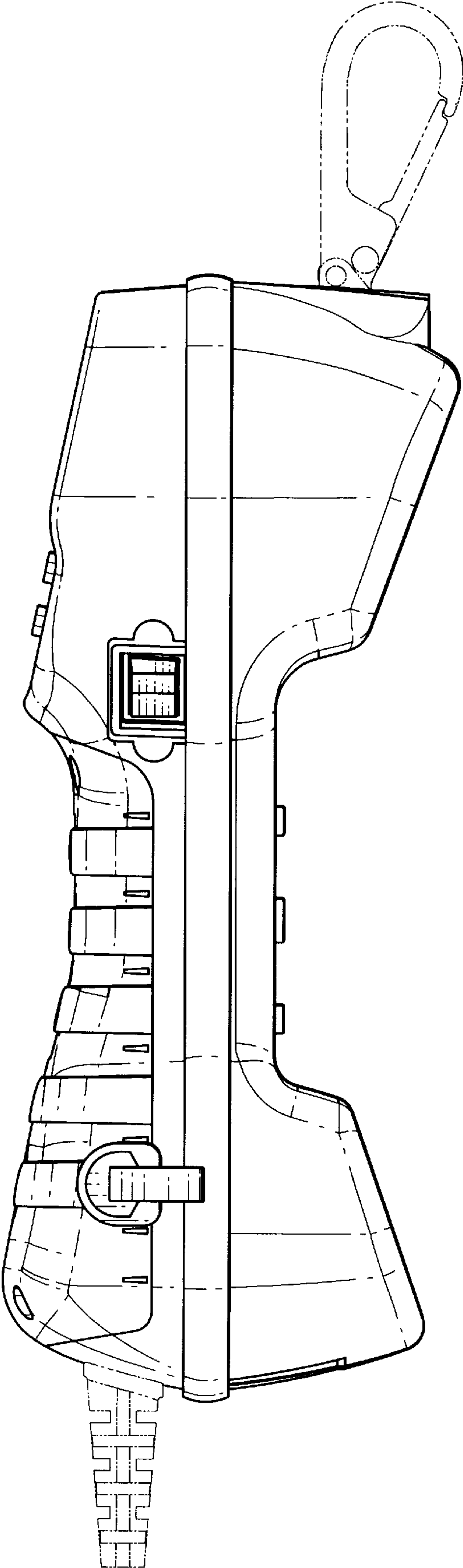

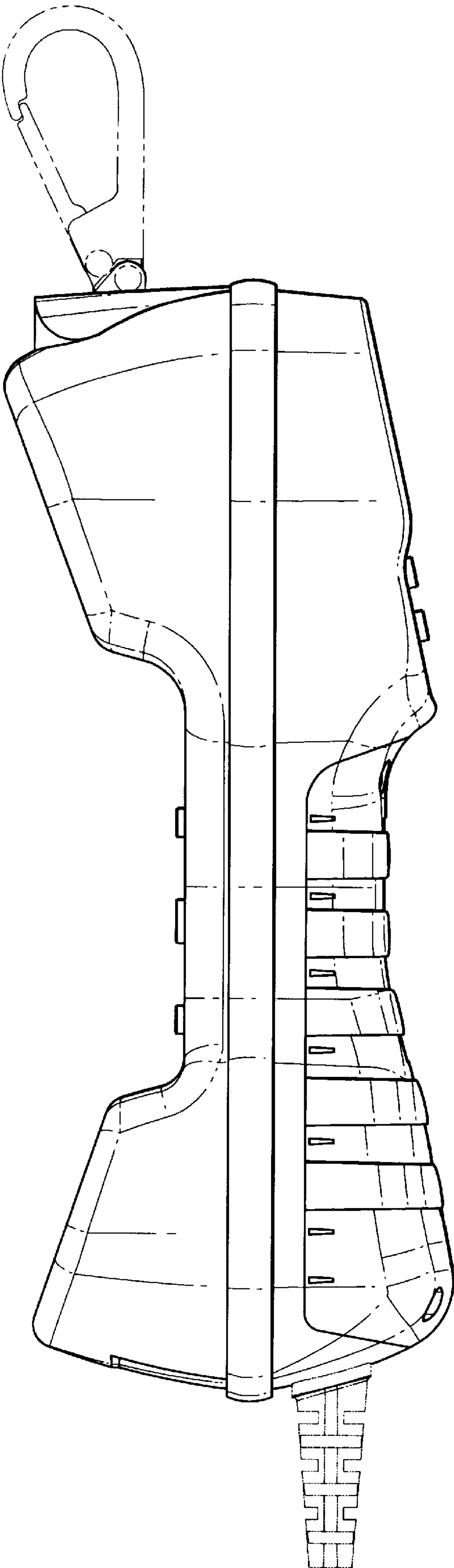

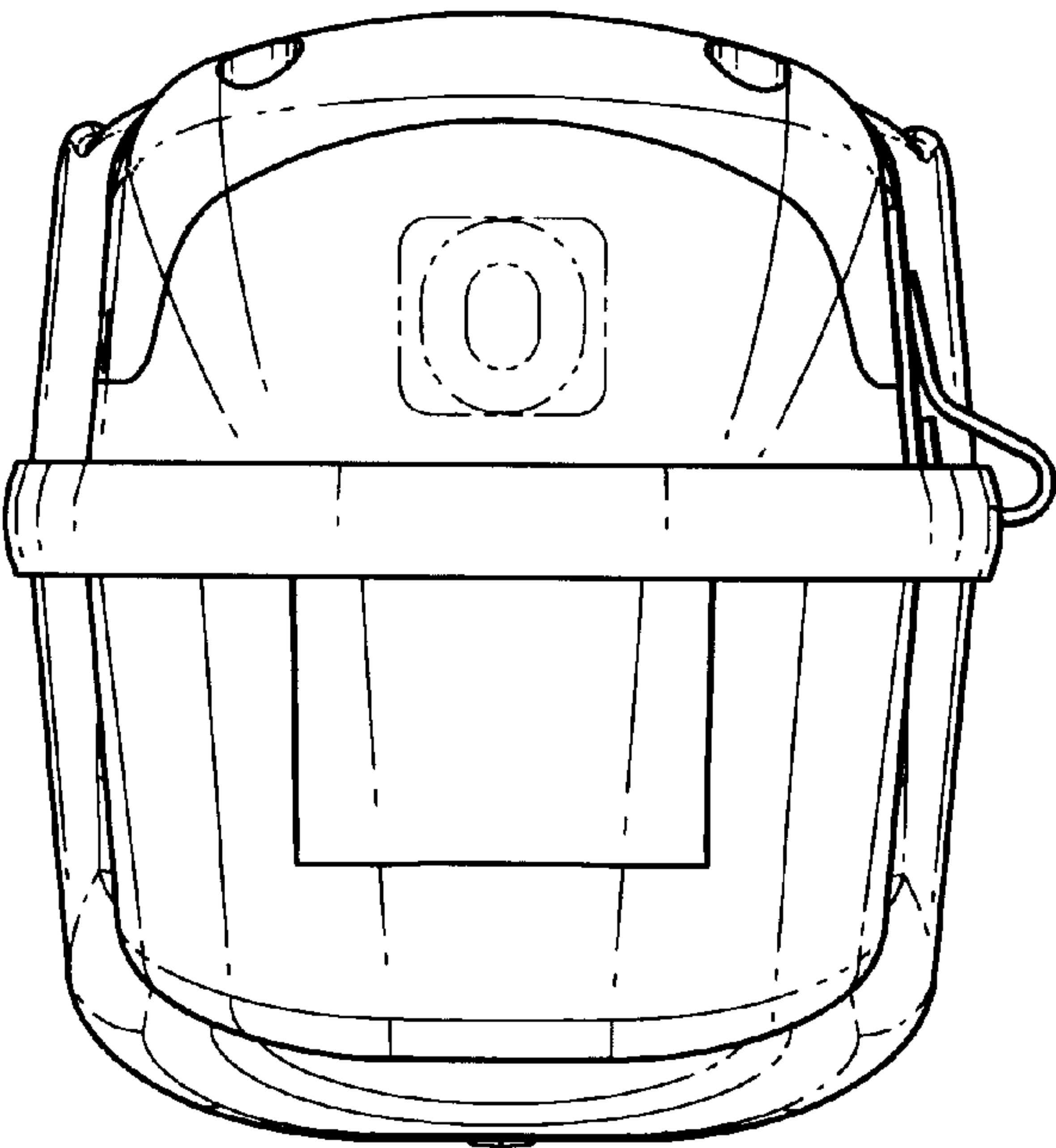

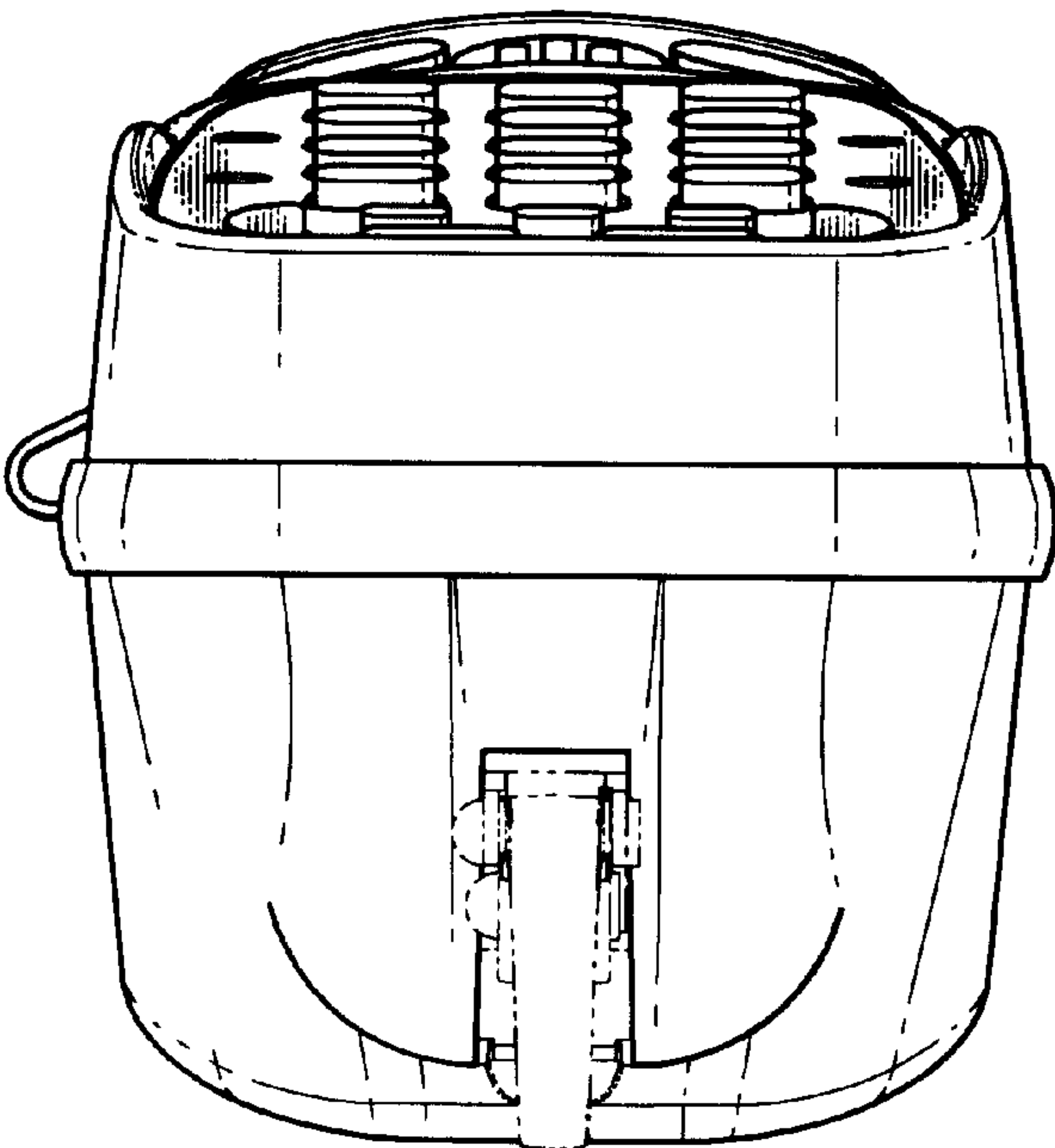
