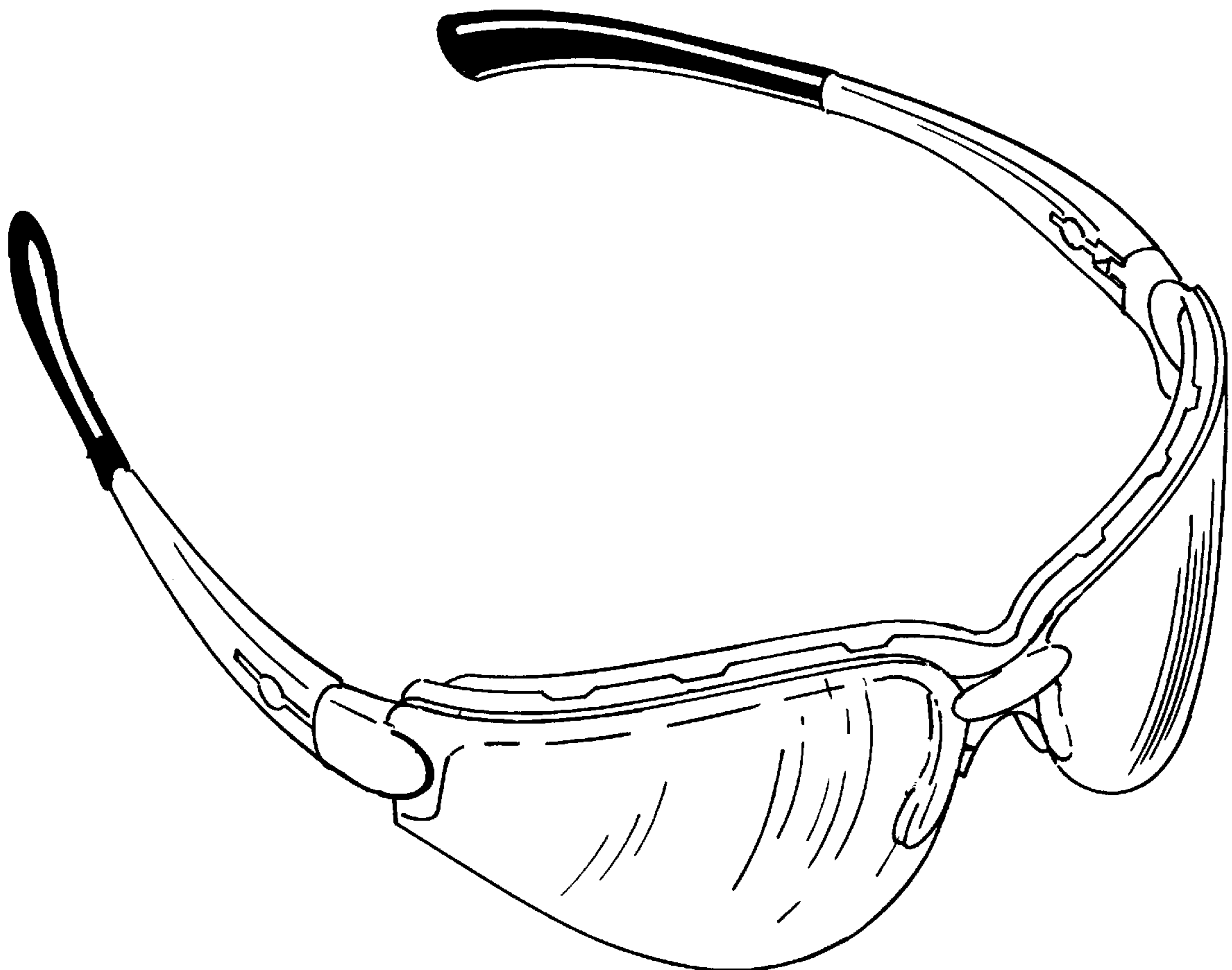
[57] **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of eyewear showing my new design;

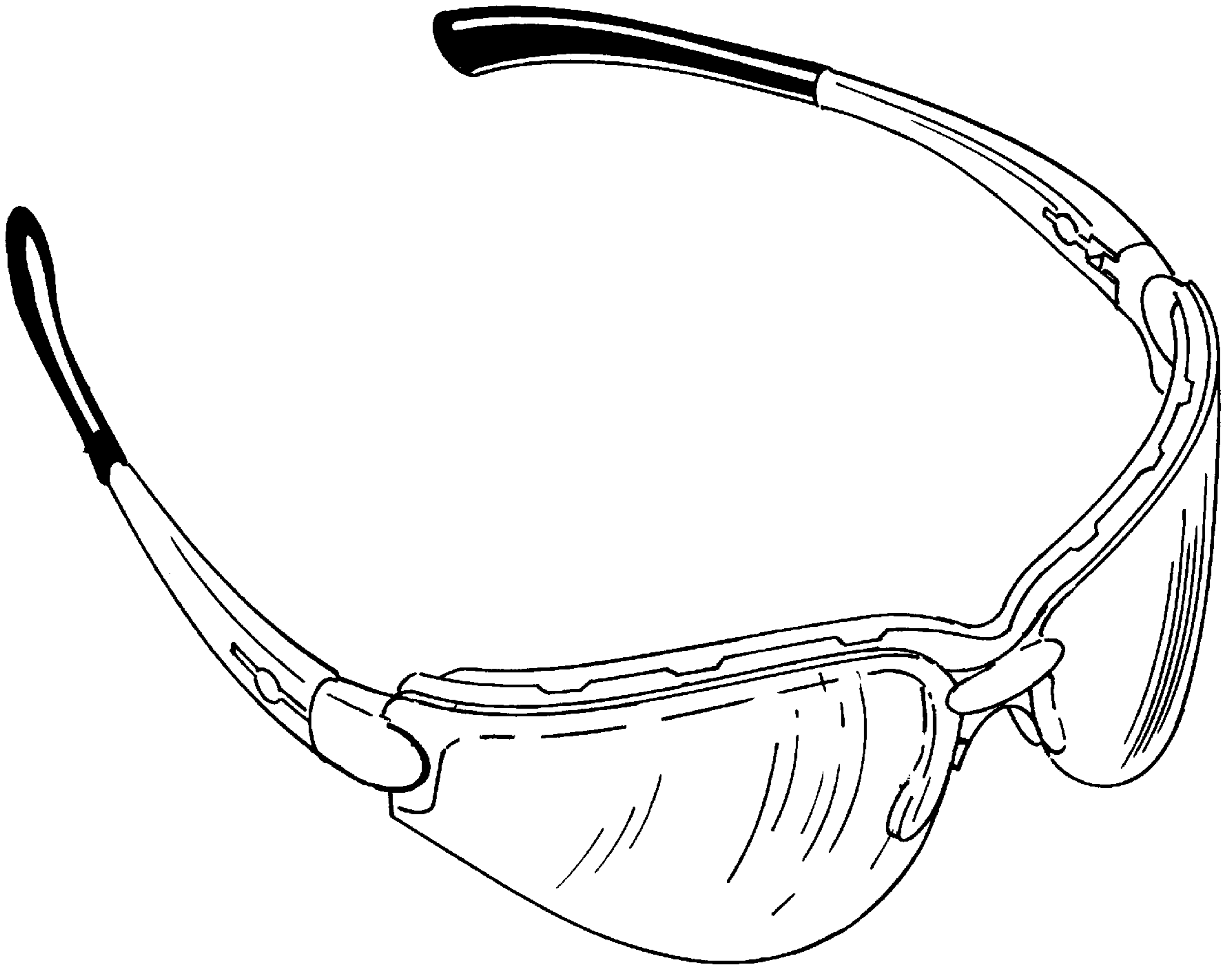

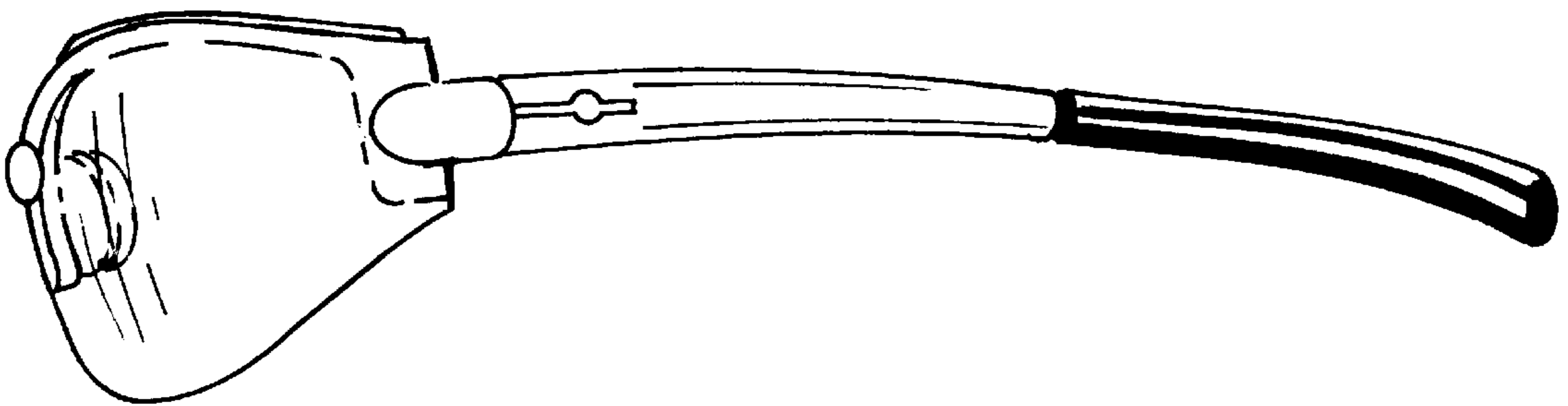
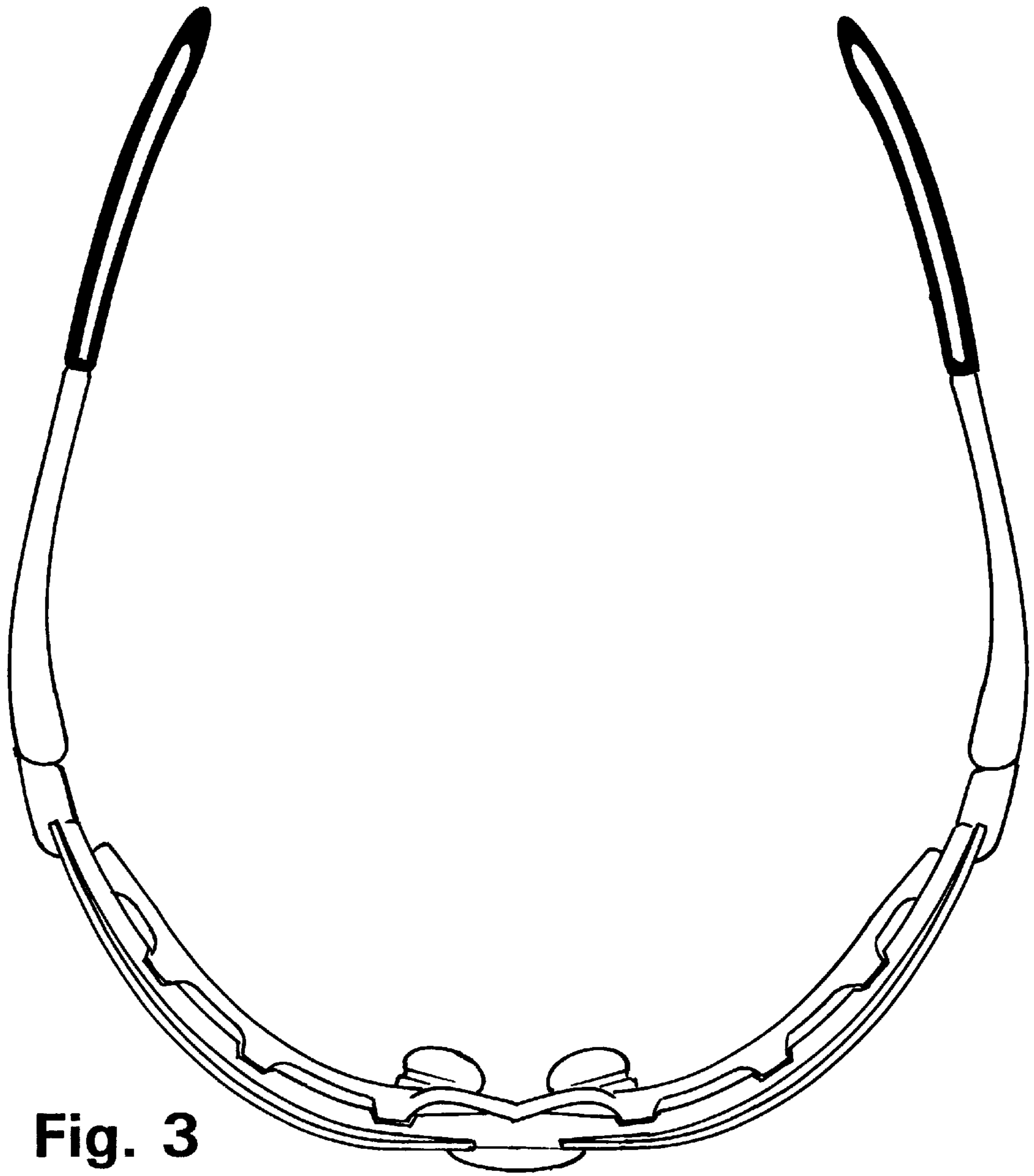
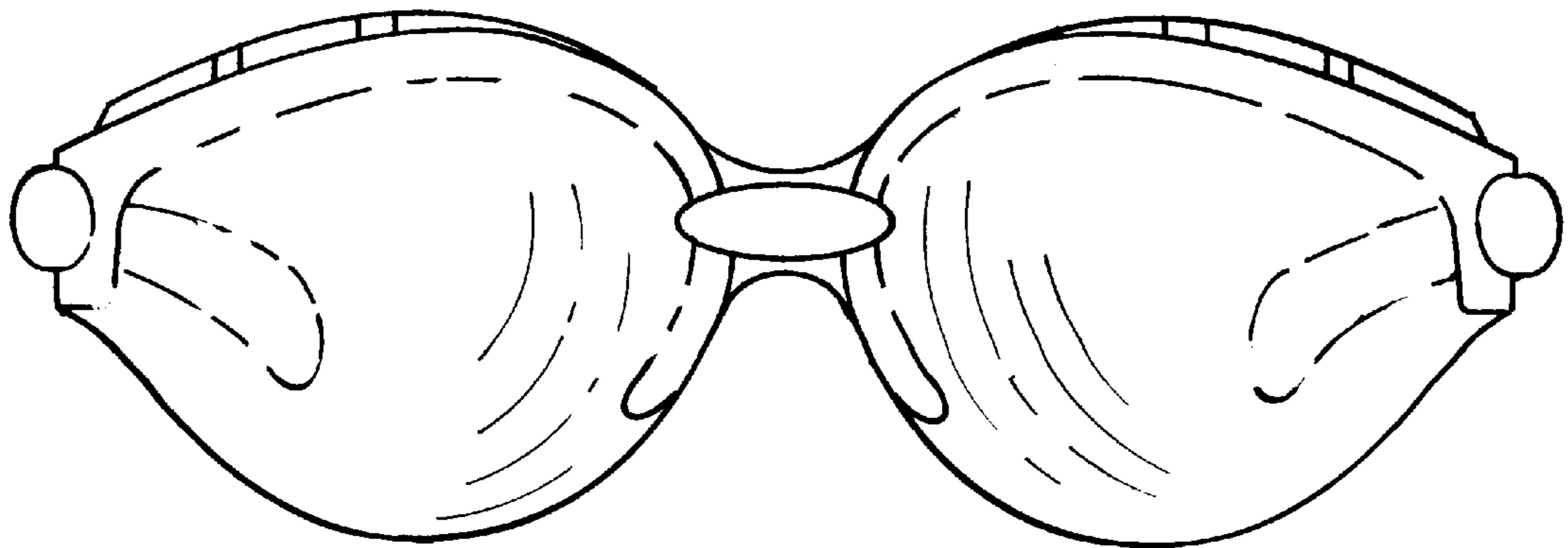


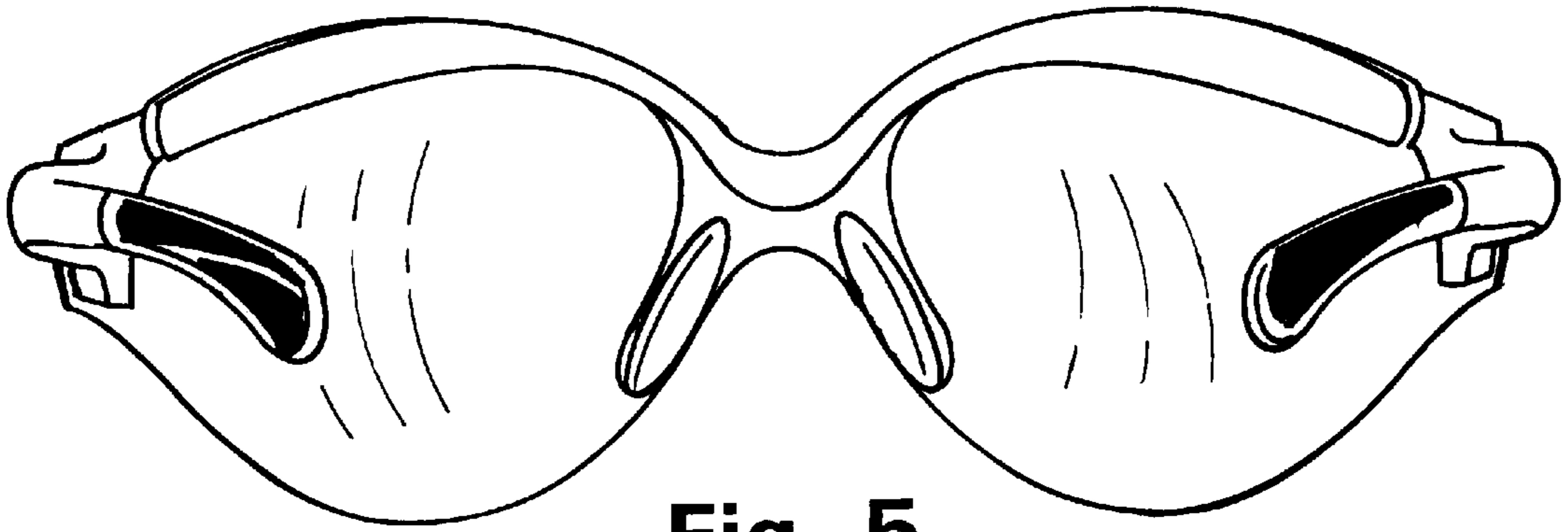

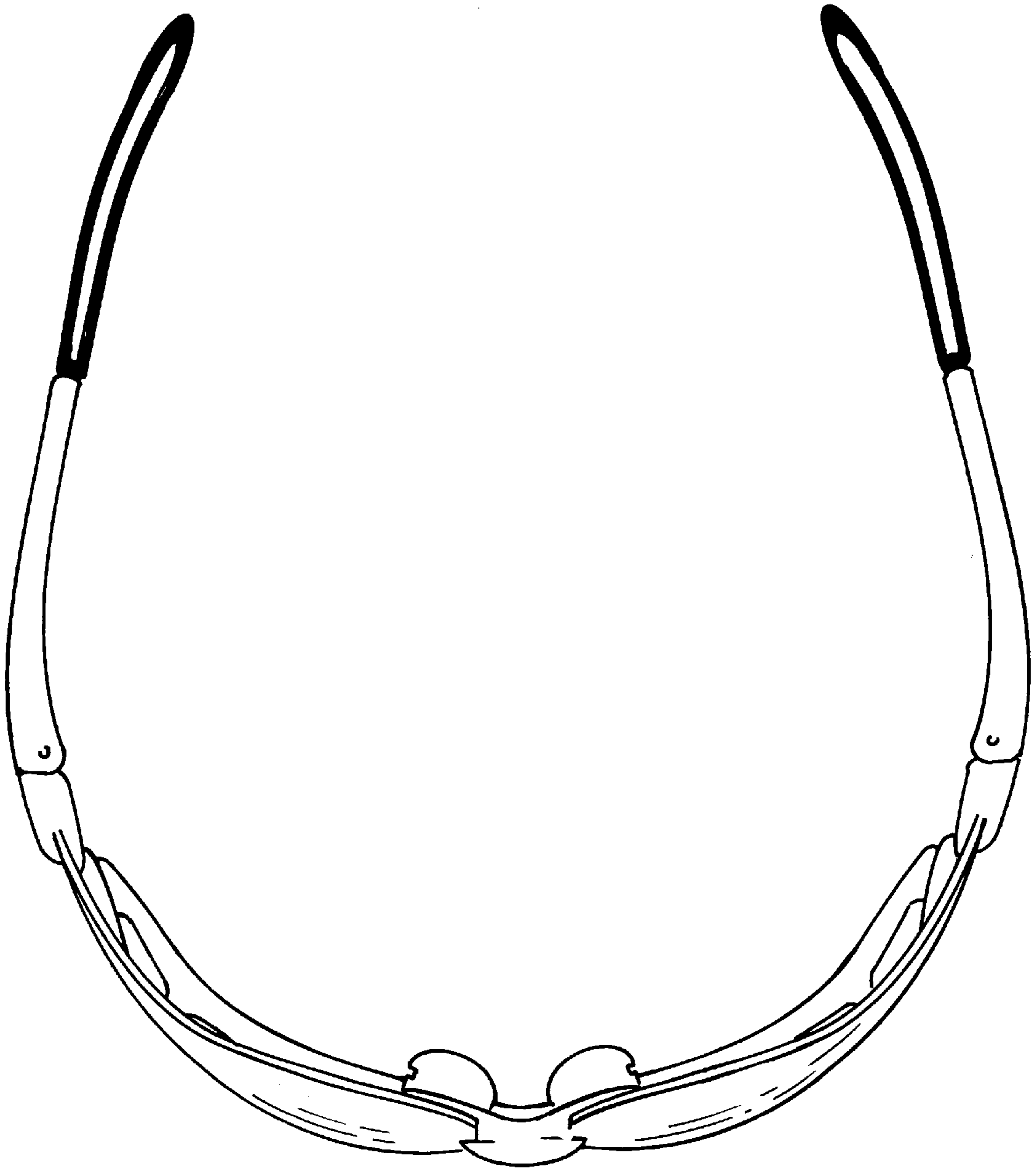
