FIG. 2 is a front view of the design,

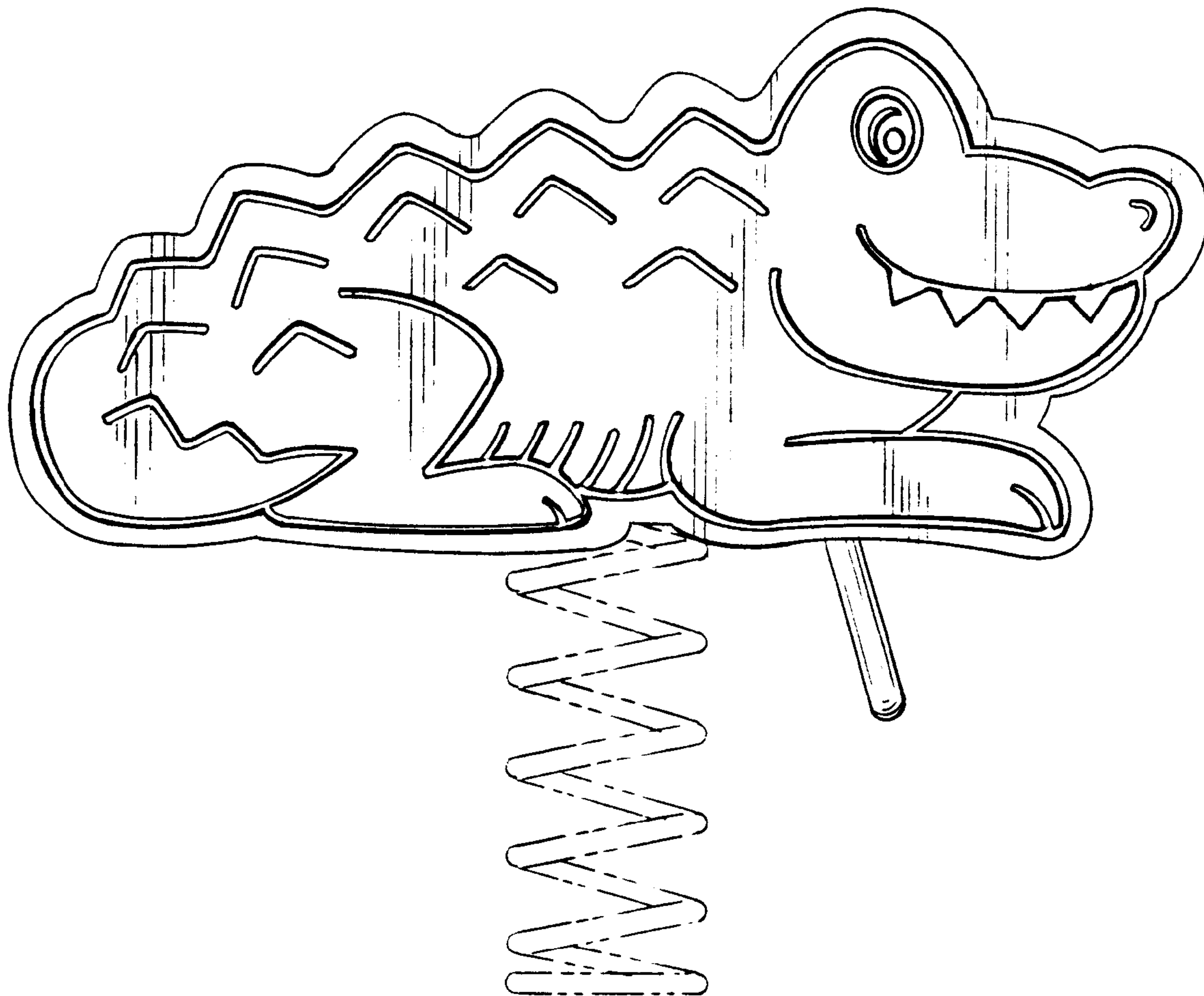
FIG. 3 is a rear view of my new design; and,

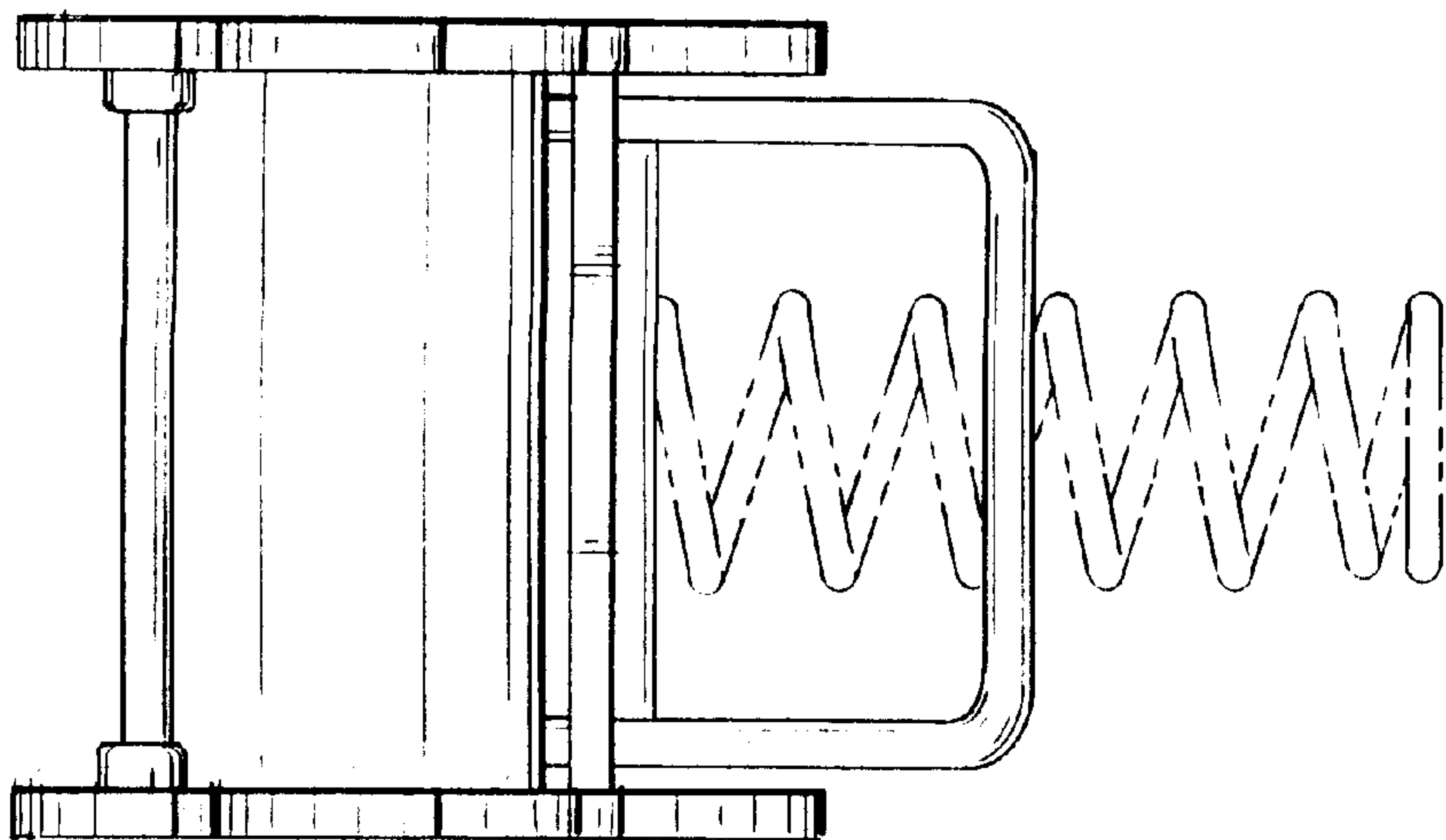

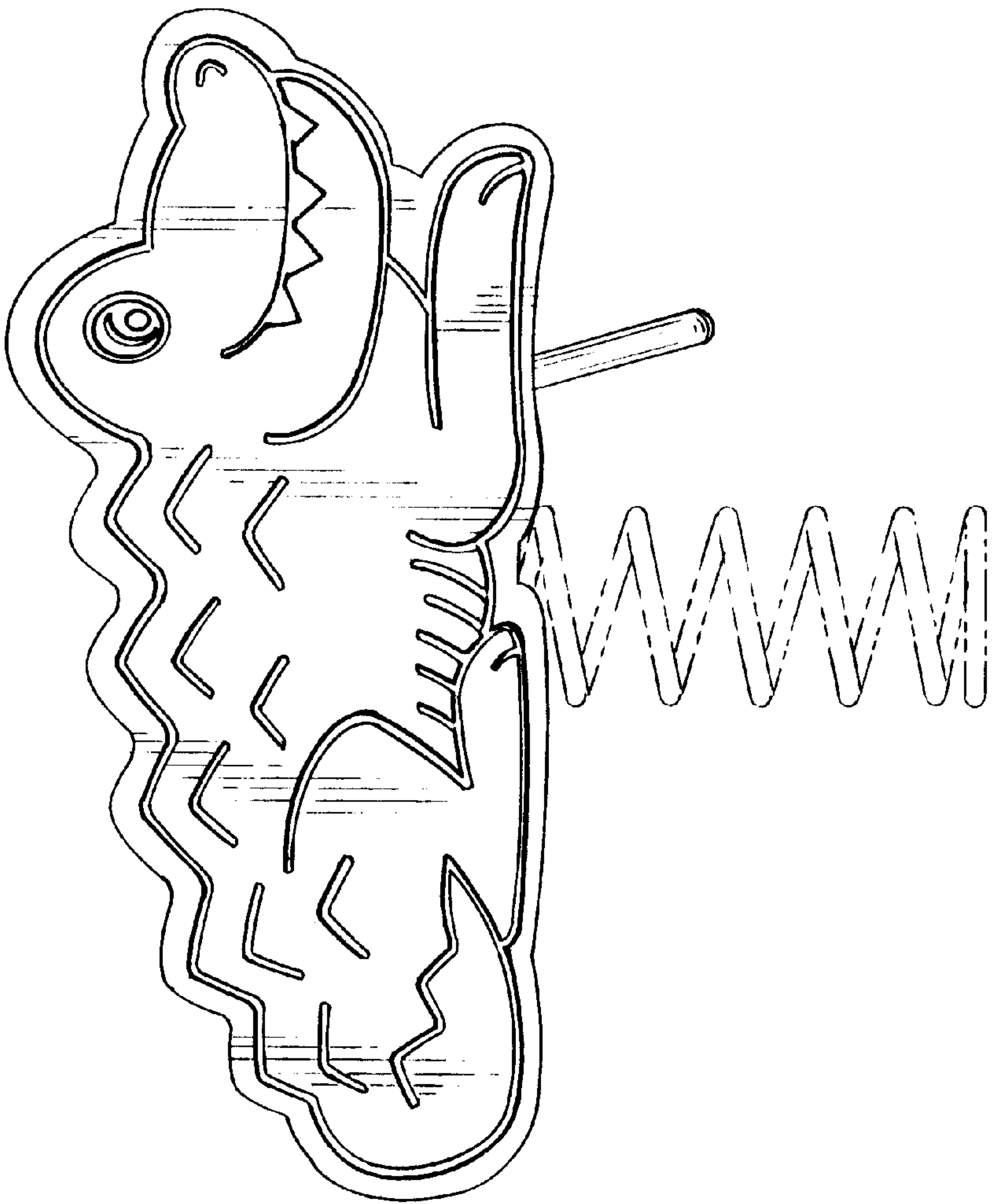

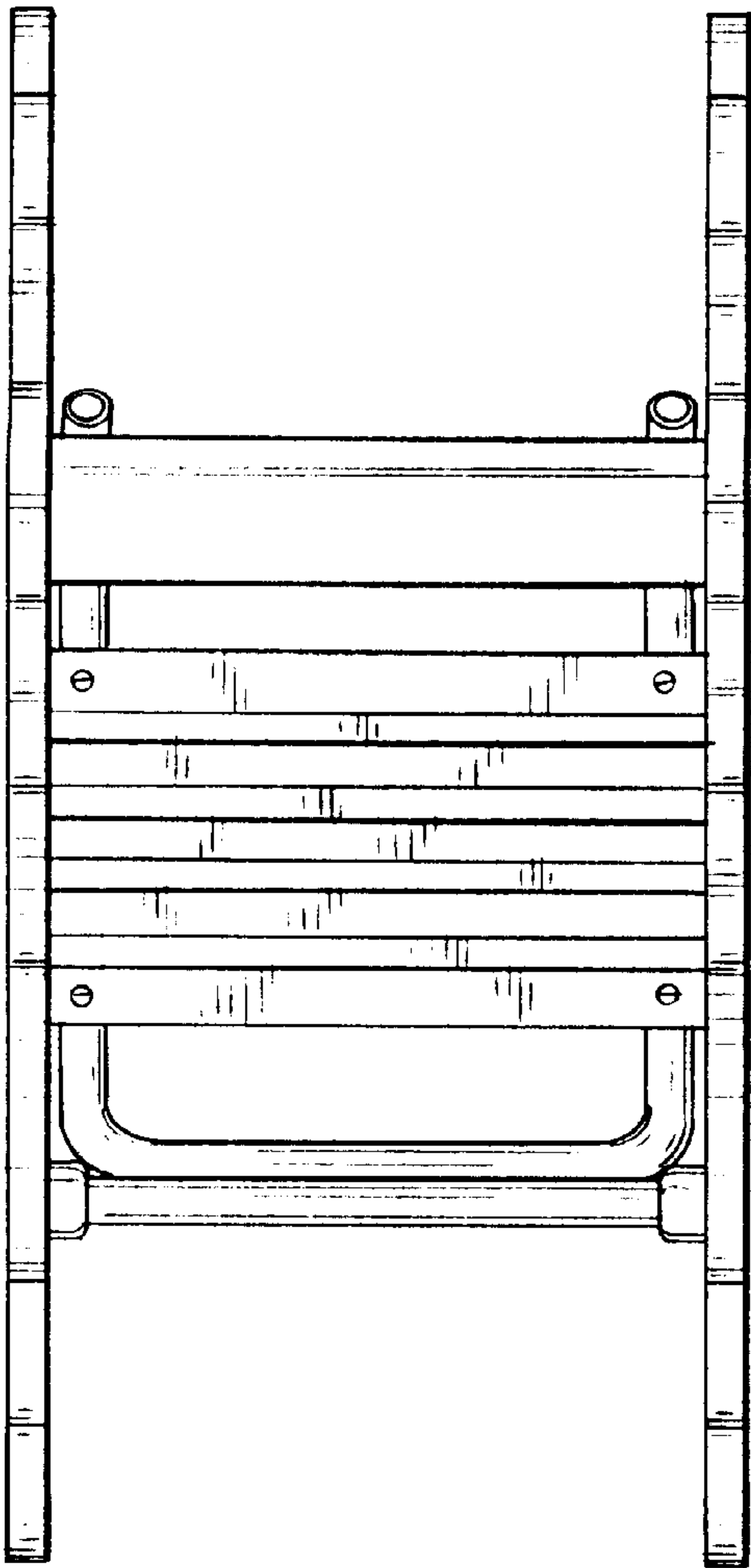

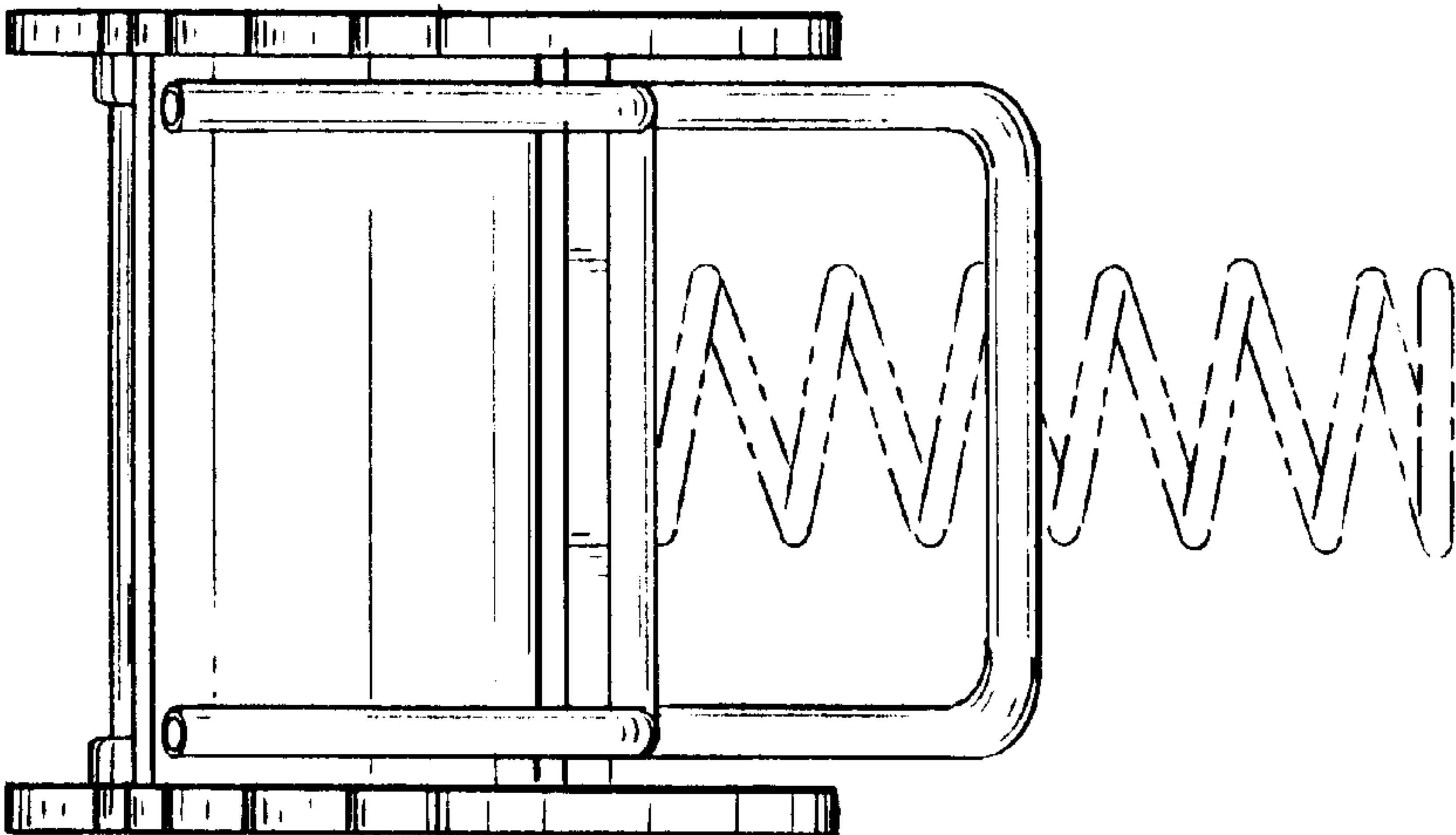
