The ornamental design for a “handles in a pair of swinging doors”, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the handles formed in a pair of opposed swinging doors illustrating the handles formed immediately adjacent each other and in horizontal misalignment; and,

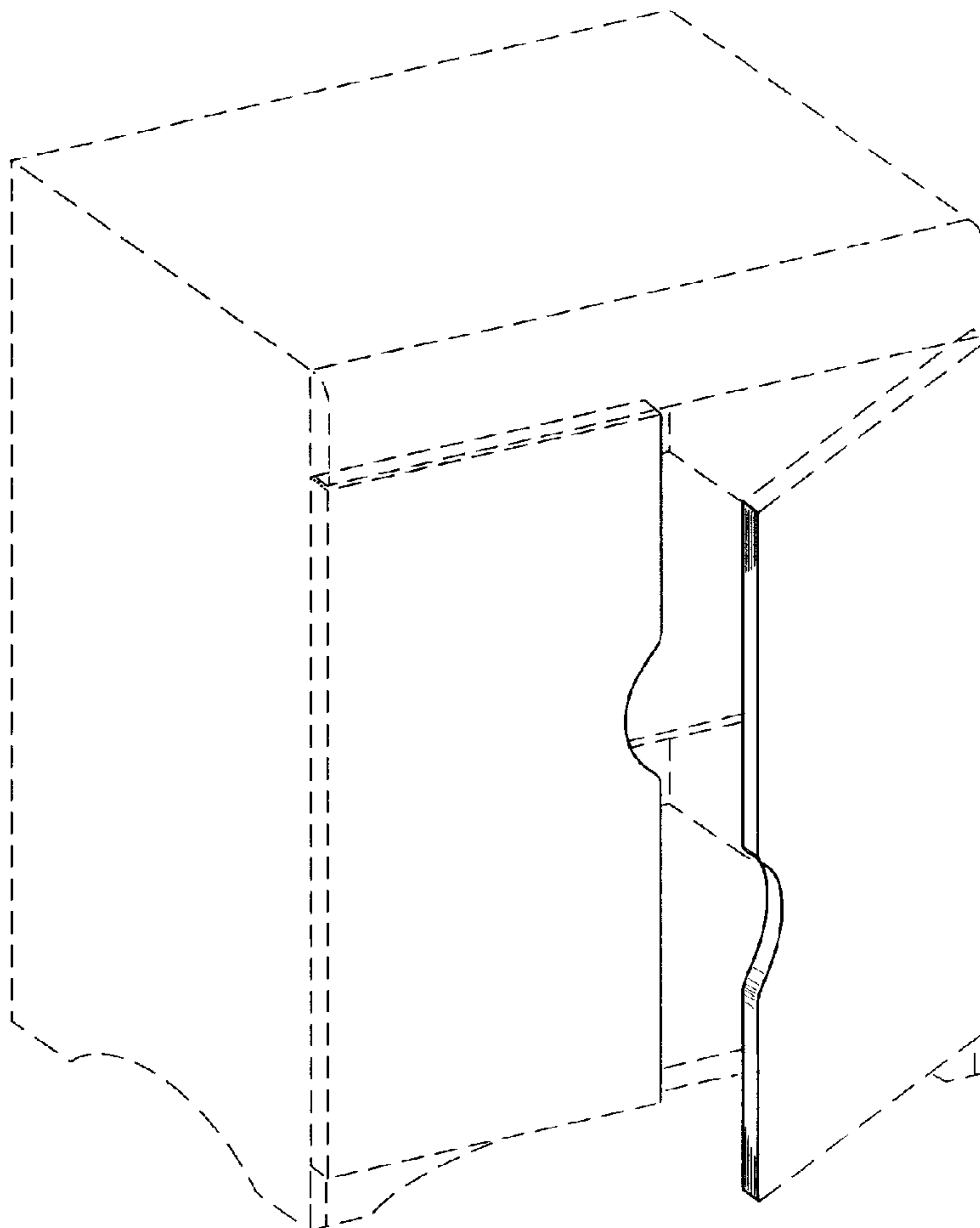
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof illustrating one of the pair of swinging doors partially open.

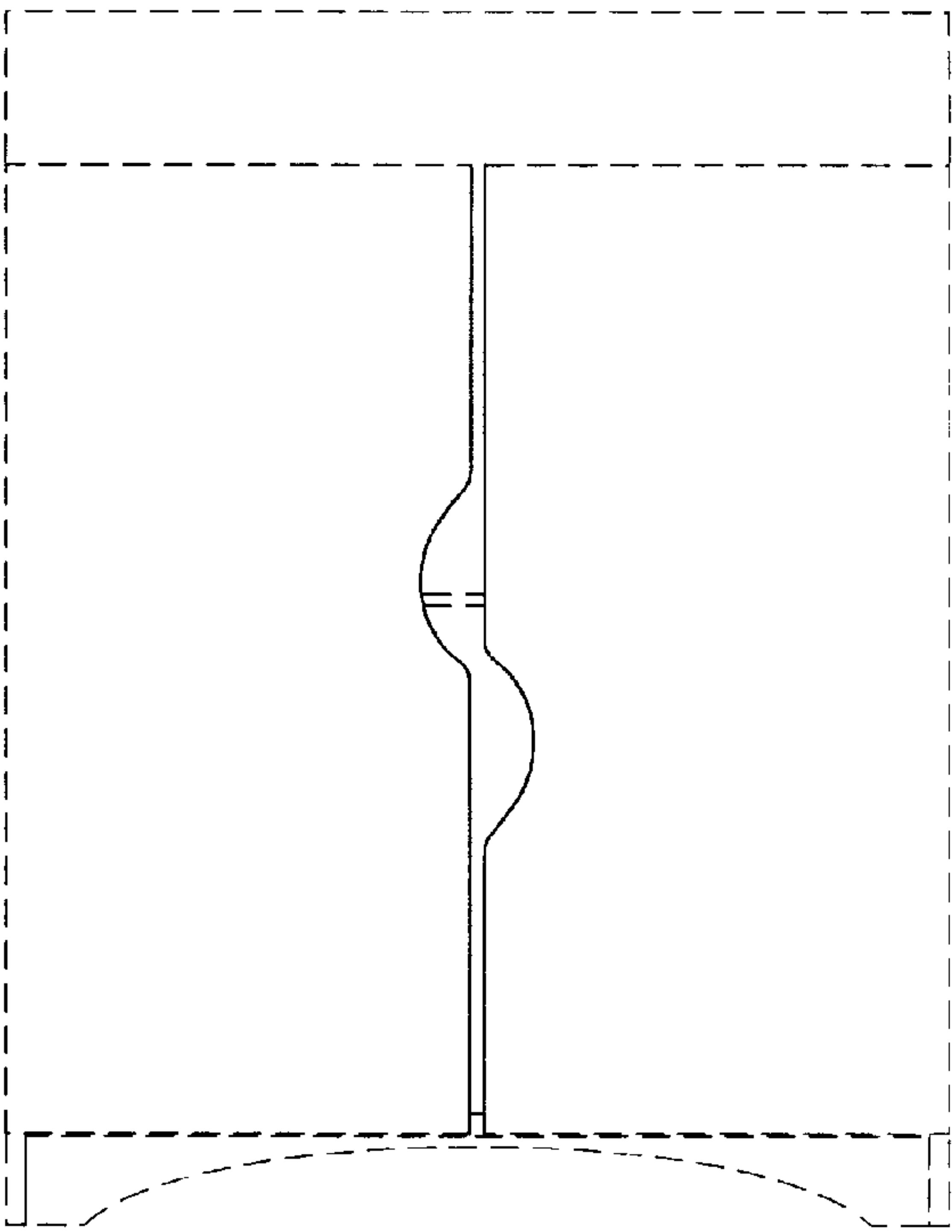

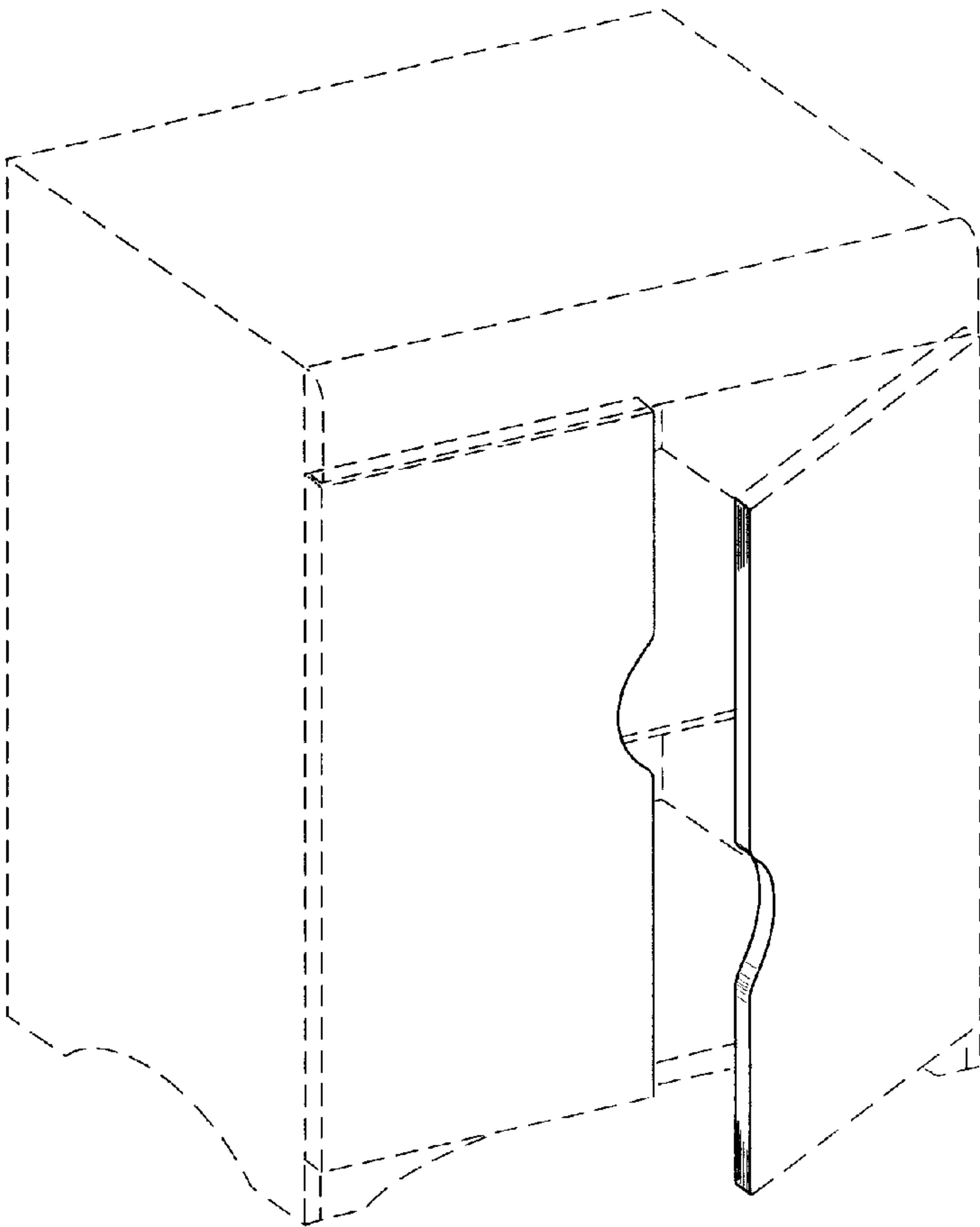
