## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an adhesive label, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a plan view of the top side of a first embodiment of the adhesive label showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a plan view of the top side of a second embodiment thereof; and,

FIG. 3 is a plan view of the top side of a third embodiment thereof.

The curved arrows represented by the phantom lines in FIGS. 1–3 is for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. Further, since the adhesive label of the present invention is effectively two-dimensional, and the contents of the bottom side of the label do not form a part of the present invention, the invention is shown by the top side views of FIGS. 1–3.




