The ornamental design for a tea kettle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the tea kettle of the invention; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side of which is an identical mirror image; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
