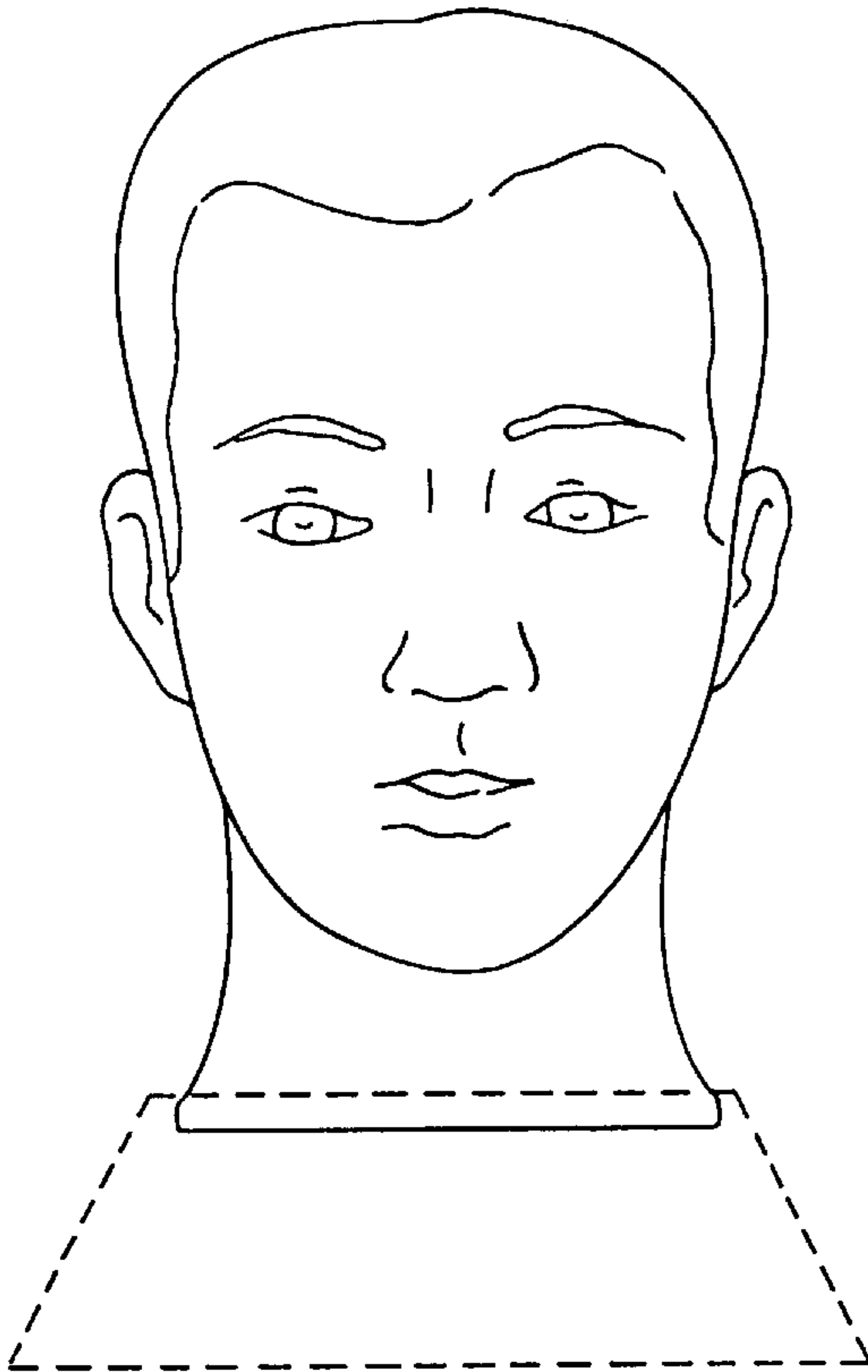
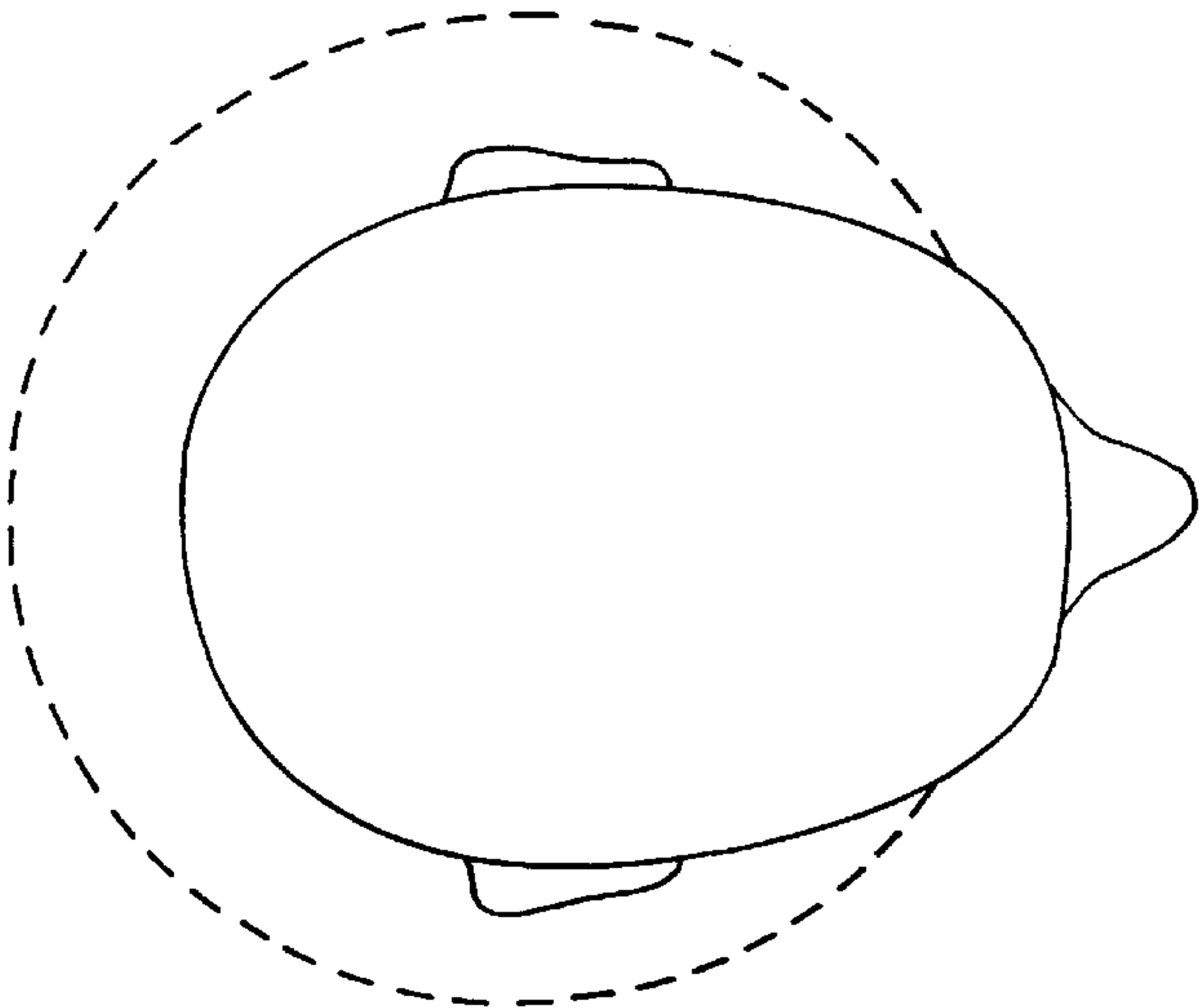
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an anthropomorphic lamp, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of the anthropomorphic lamp embodying my new design.
FIG. 2 is a side view of the anthropomorphic lamp embodying my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown;
FIG. 3 is a front view of the anthropomorphic lamp embodying my new design;
FIG. 4 is a back view of the anthropomorphic lamp embodying my new design; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the anthropomorphic lamp facing sideways.

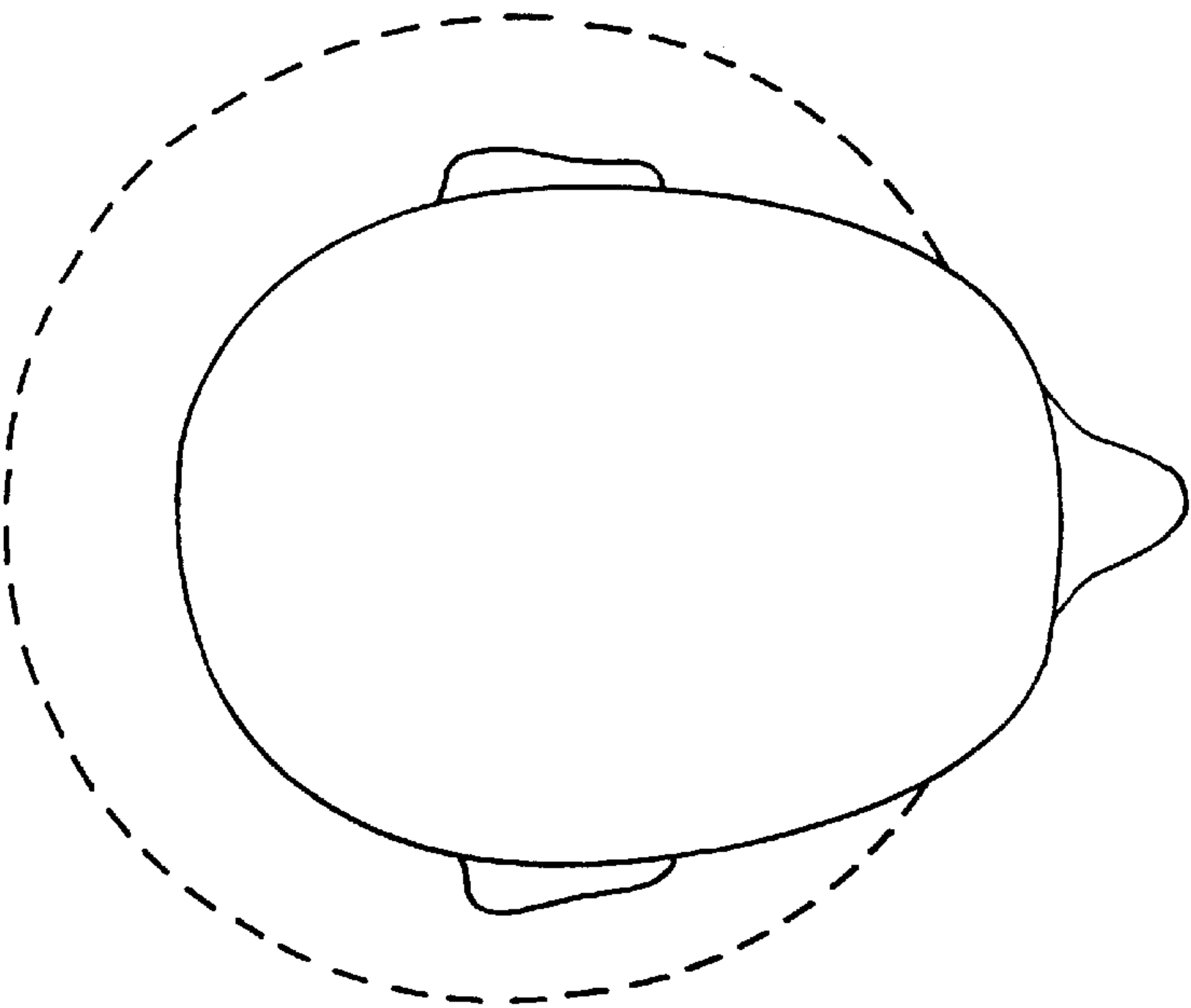

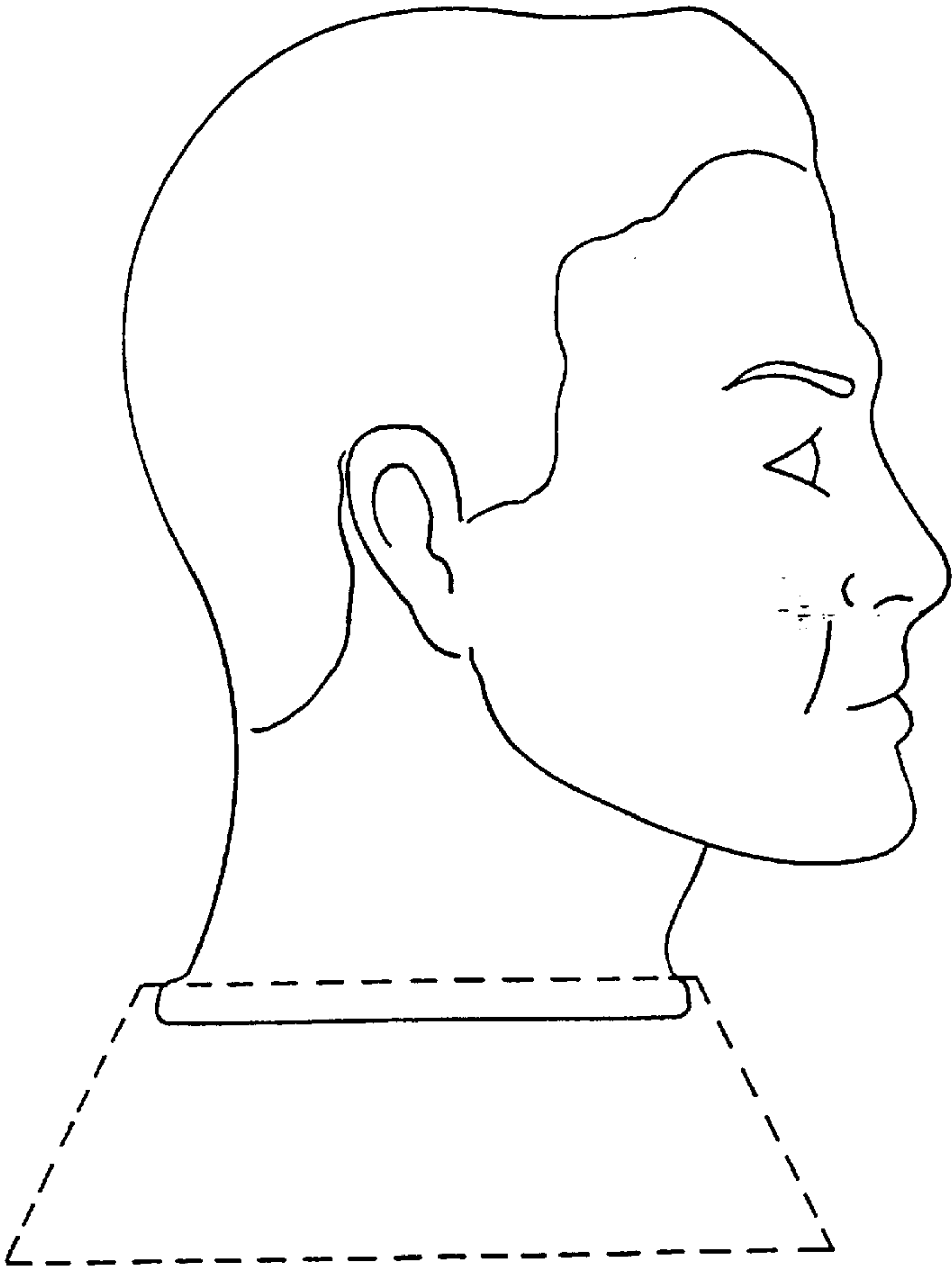

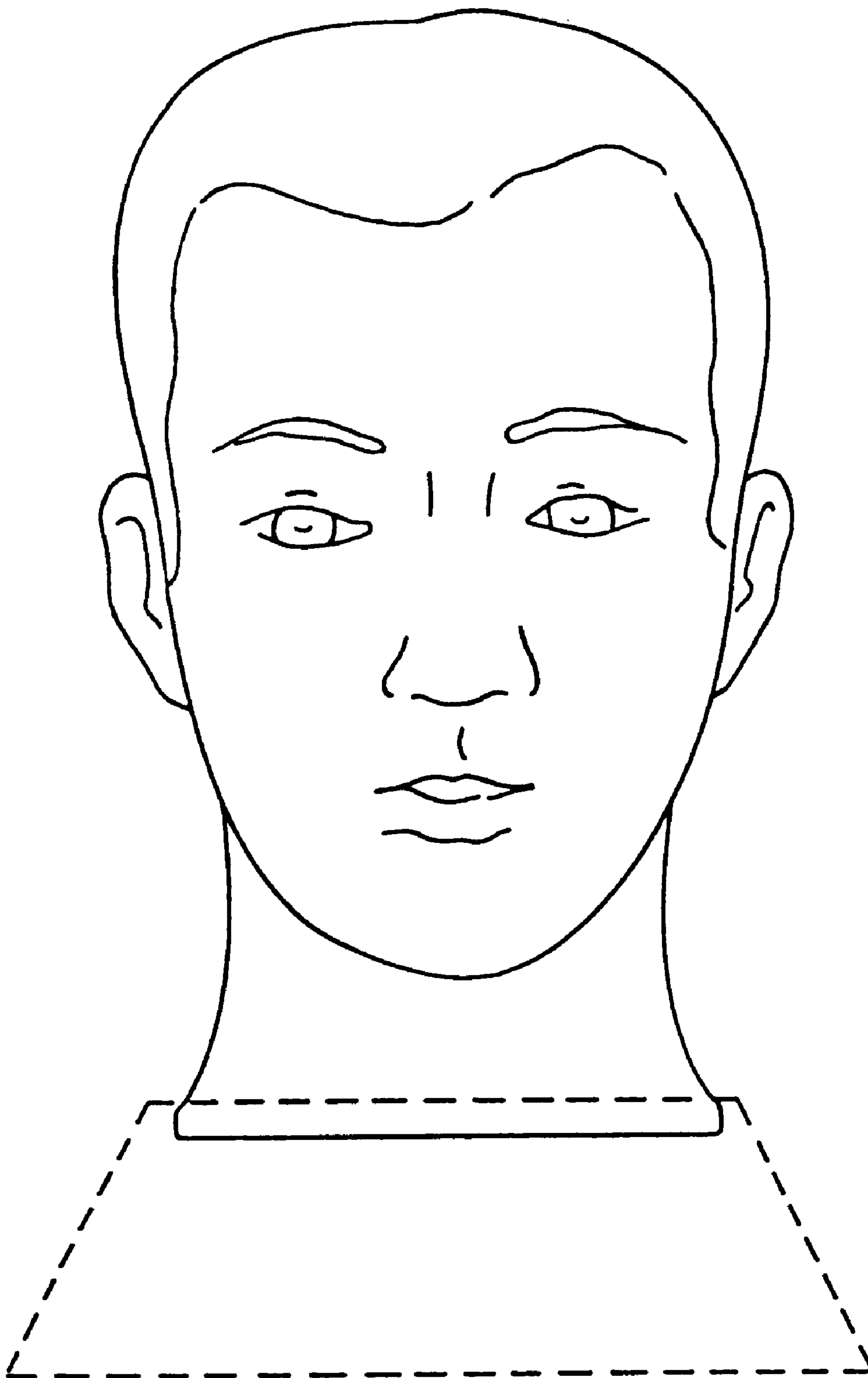

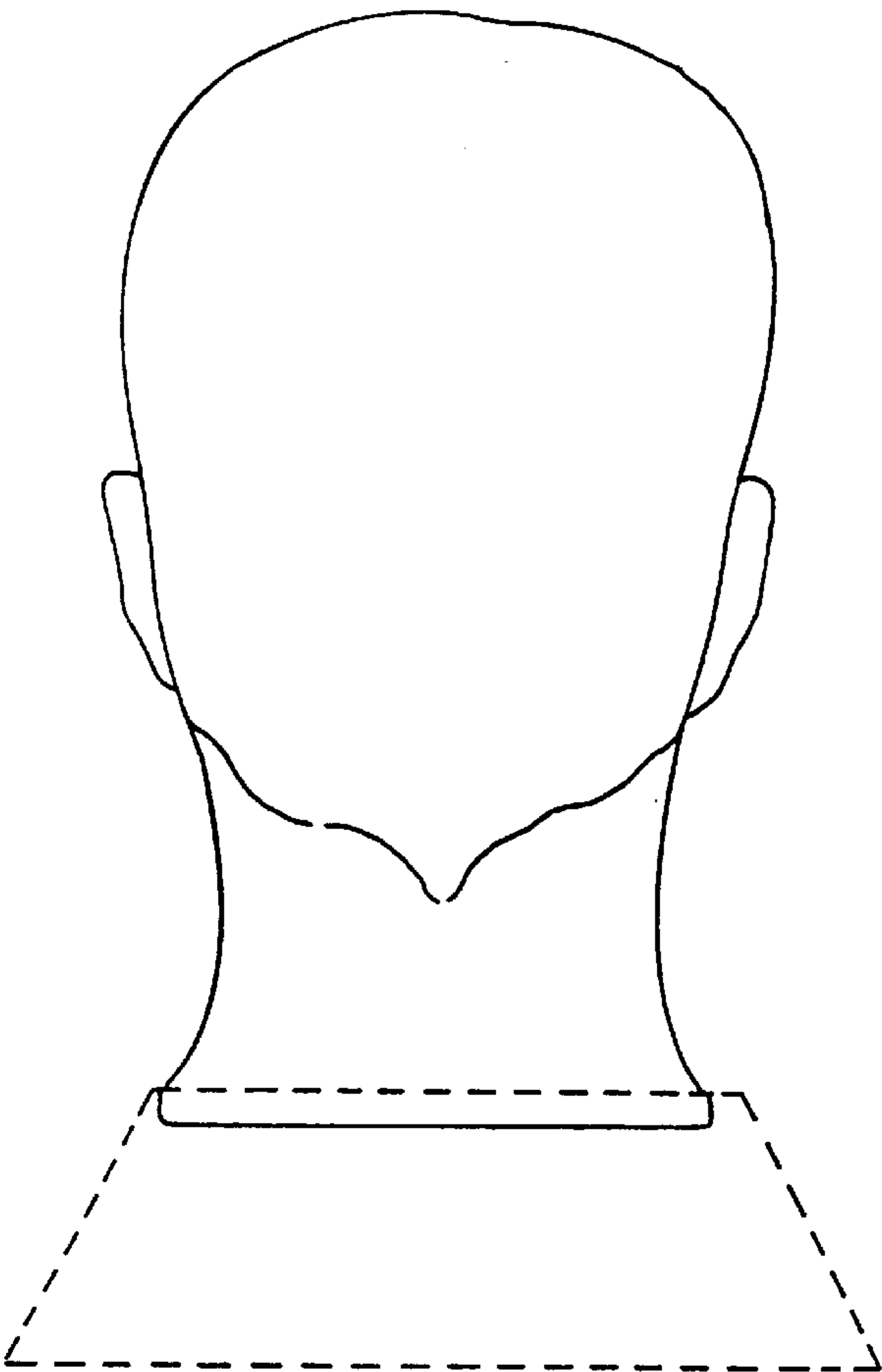

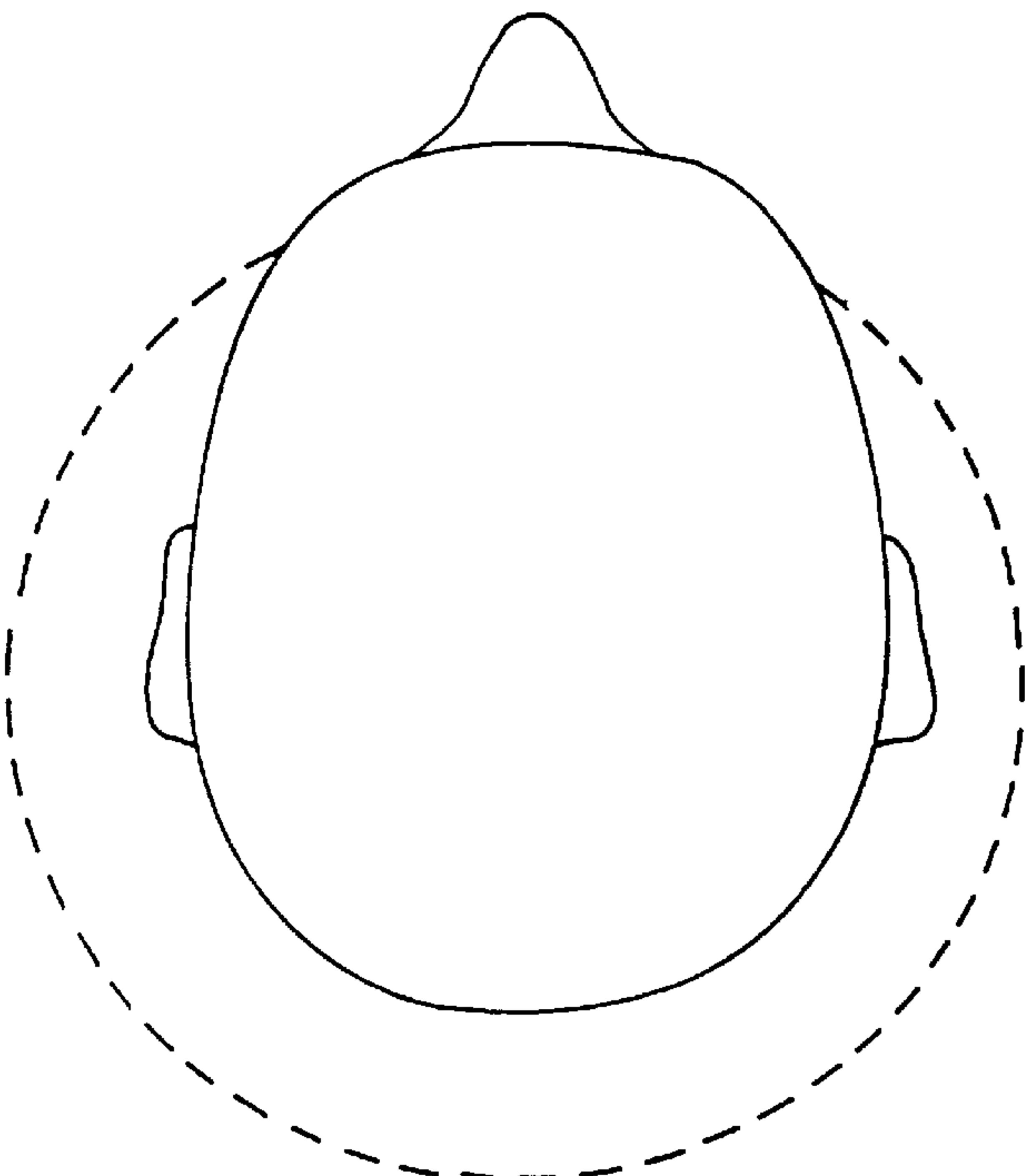
