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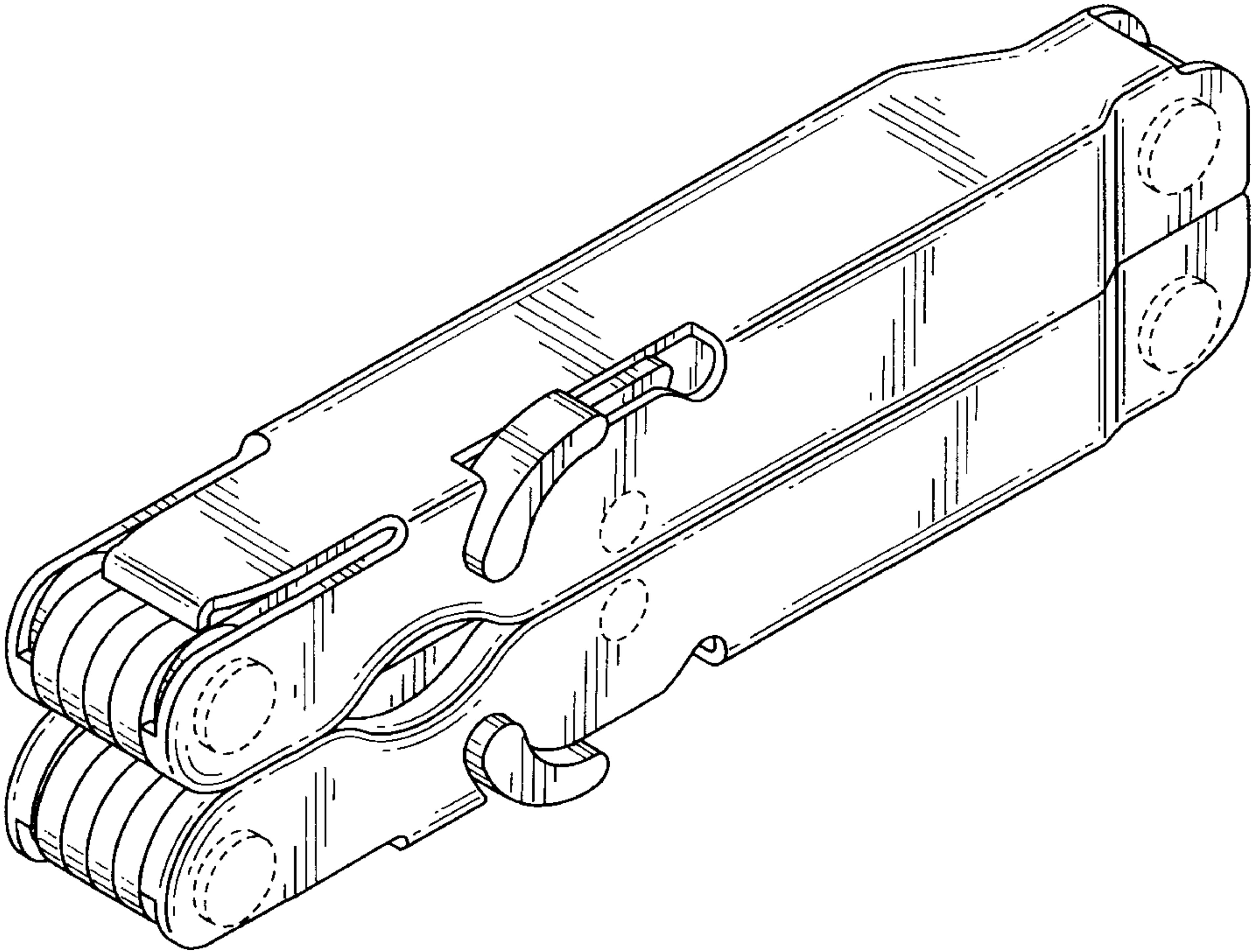

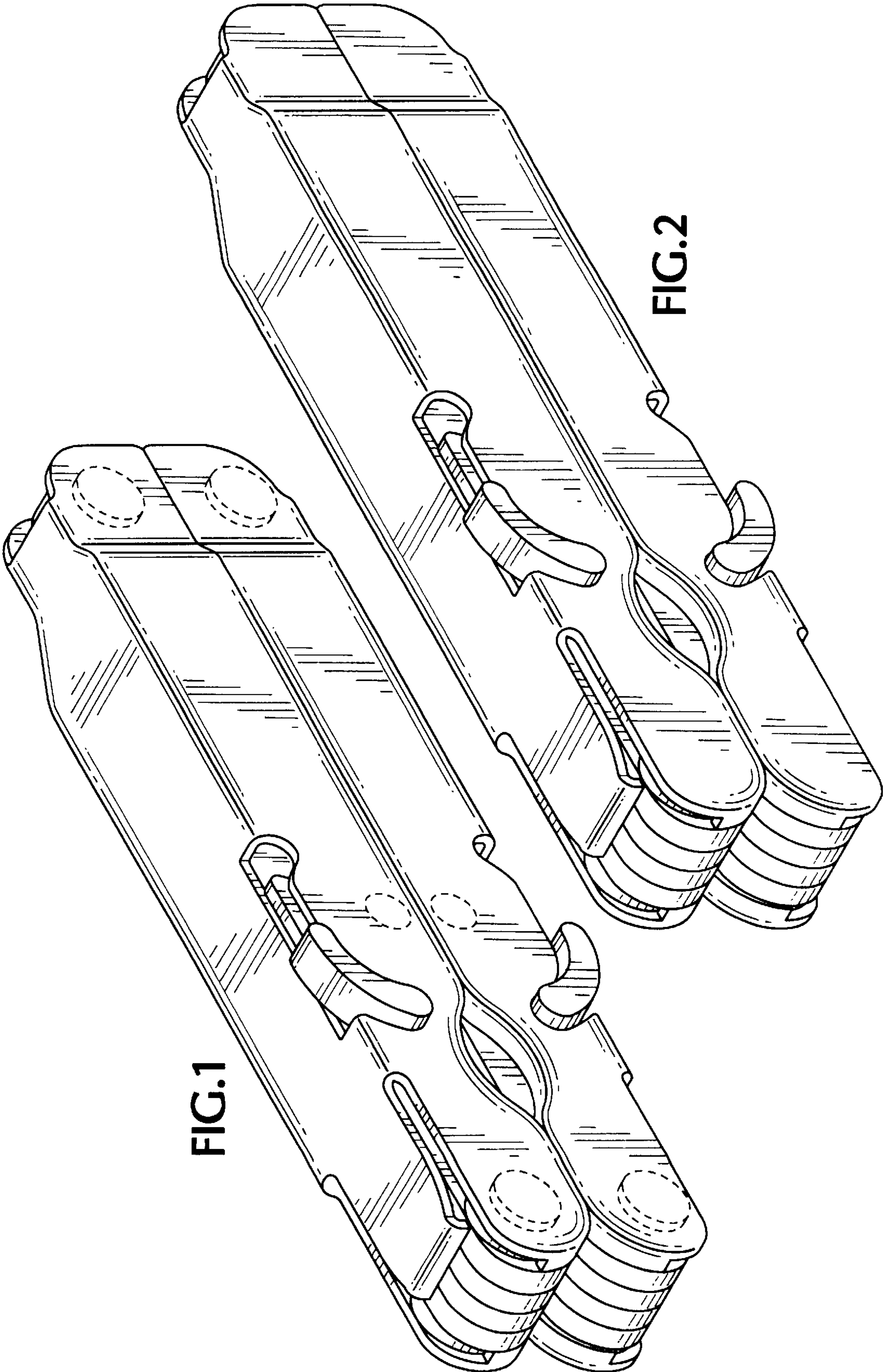
The ornamental design for a folded multipurpose hand tool, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view from the upper right rear of a folded multipurpose hand tool including my new design, wherein the broken line depiction of the heads of fasteners is included for illustrative purposes and forms no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is an isometric view from the upper right rear of the folded multipurpose hand tool shown in FIG. 1, showing my new design;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view thereof being a mirror image of this top plan view;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear, or folding blade, end elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a front, or folding jaw, end elevational view thereof.

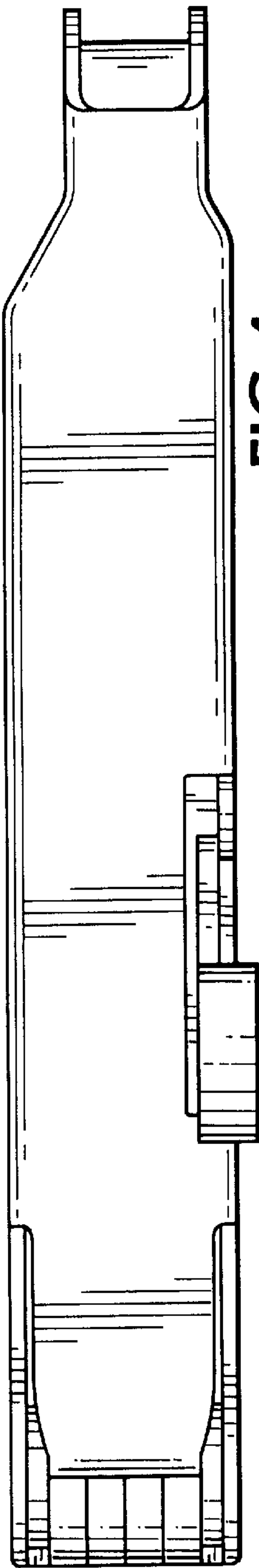

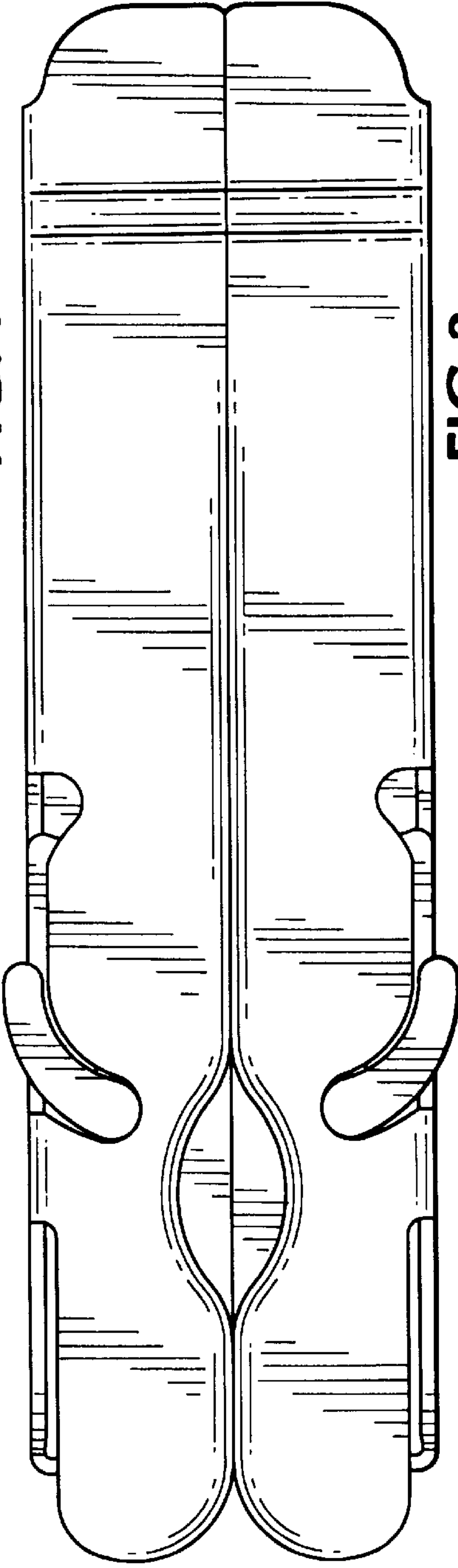

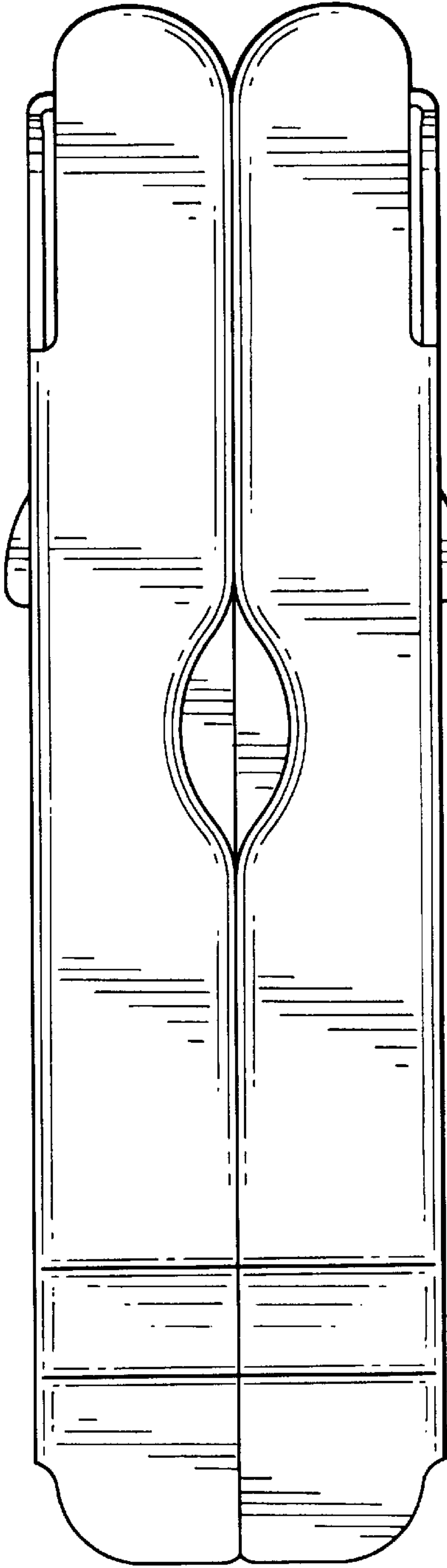

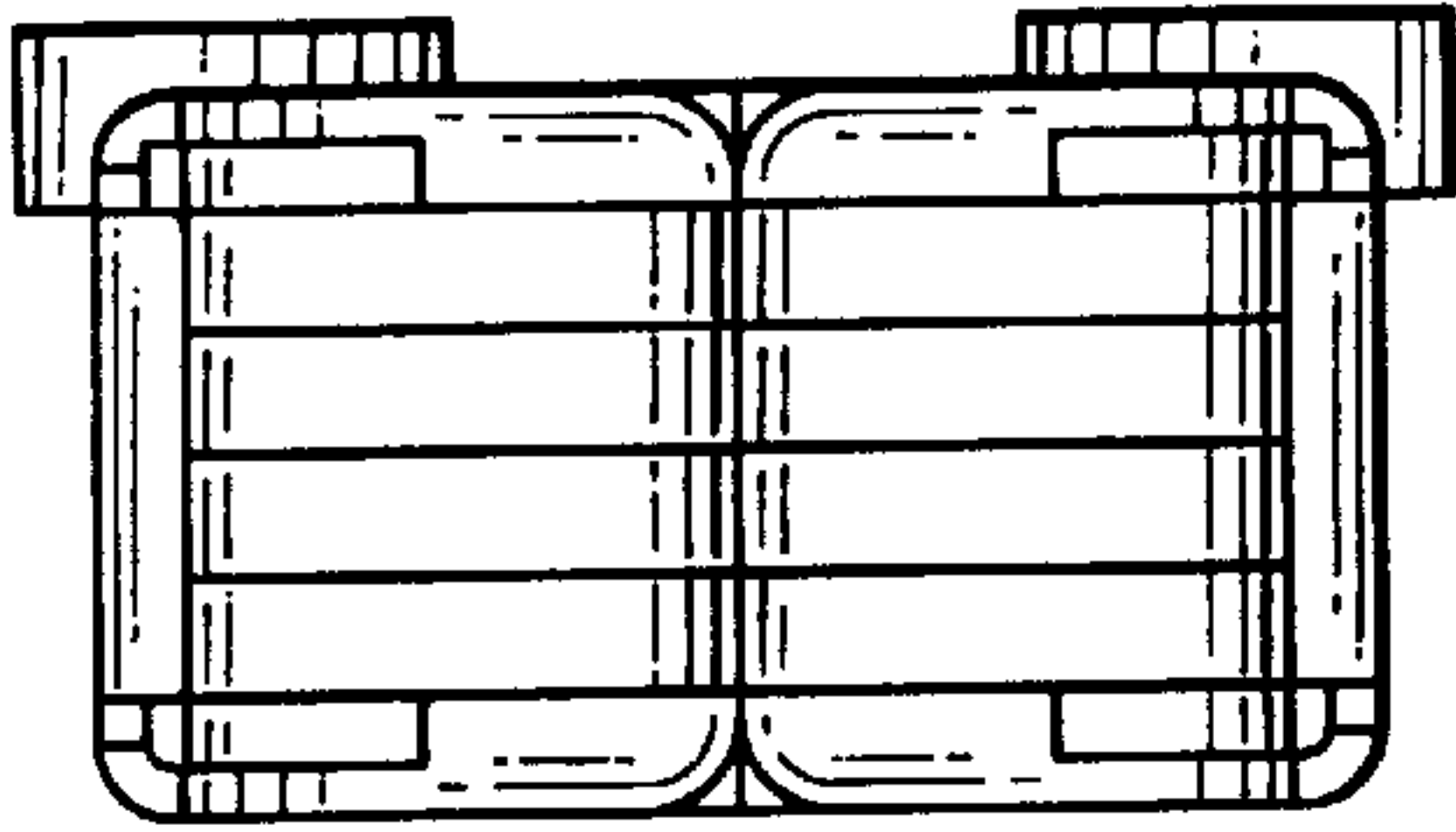

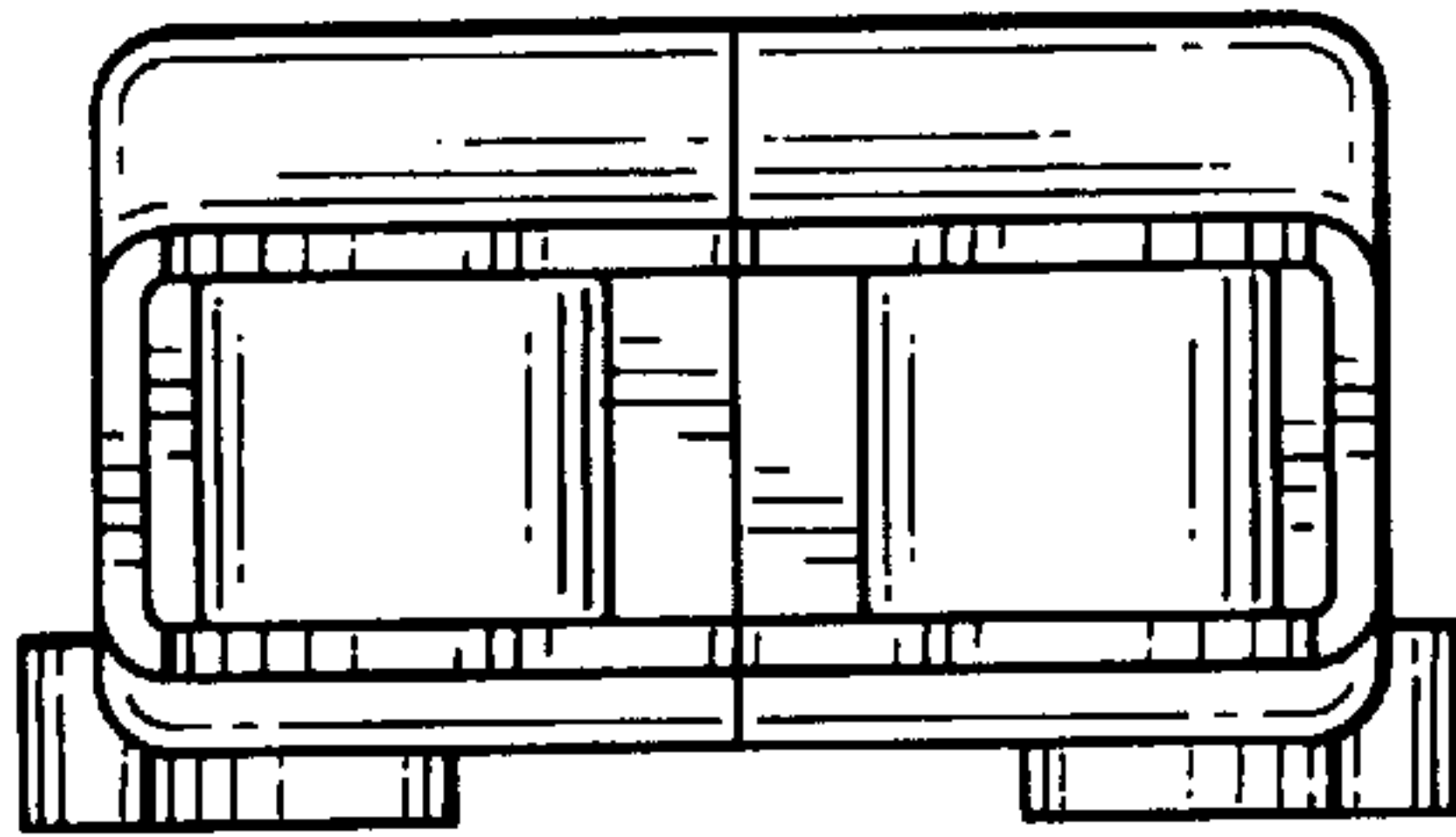
