[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a reconfigurable decorative sculpture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the reconfigurable decorative sculpture of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a rear view of the reconfigurable decorative sculpture of the present invention.

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the reconfigurable decorative sculpture of the present invention.

FIG. 4 is a side elevation view of the reconfigurable decorative sculpture of the present invention.

FIG. 5 is a top view of the reconfigurable decorative sculpture of the present invention.

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the reconfigurable decorative sculpture of the present invention.

FIG. 7 is a front view of the reconfigurable decorative sculpture of the present invention in its folded position.

FIG. 8 is a rear view of the reconfigurable decorative sculpture of the present invention in its folded position.

FIGS. 9 and 10 are left and right side views of the present invention respectively; and,

FIGS. 11 and 12 are top and bottom views, respectively, of the reconfigurable decorative sculpture of the present invention.

The dotted lines depict lights that may be attached to the reconfigurable decorative sculpture and are not part of the claimed design. Lights and connecting wires are shown in dashed lines in FIG. 1 but only the lights are shown in FIGS. 2–11 for purposes of clarity.
