[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a furniture support, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of a furniture support showing my new design incorporating a wire, for connection to, for example, a table top by, for example, a boss, wherein a lower end of the furniture support may be connected to, for example, a static leg or castor;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a furniture support showing my new design incorporating a strut in place of the wire of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of a typical boss for use of the embodiment of FIG. 1 or the embodiment of FIG. 2, shown in greater detail for the convenience of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a bottom view of a boss of FIG. 3, shown in greater detail for the convenience of illustration;

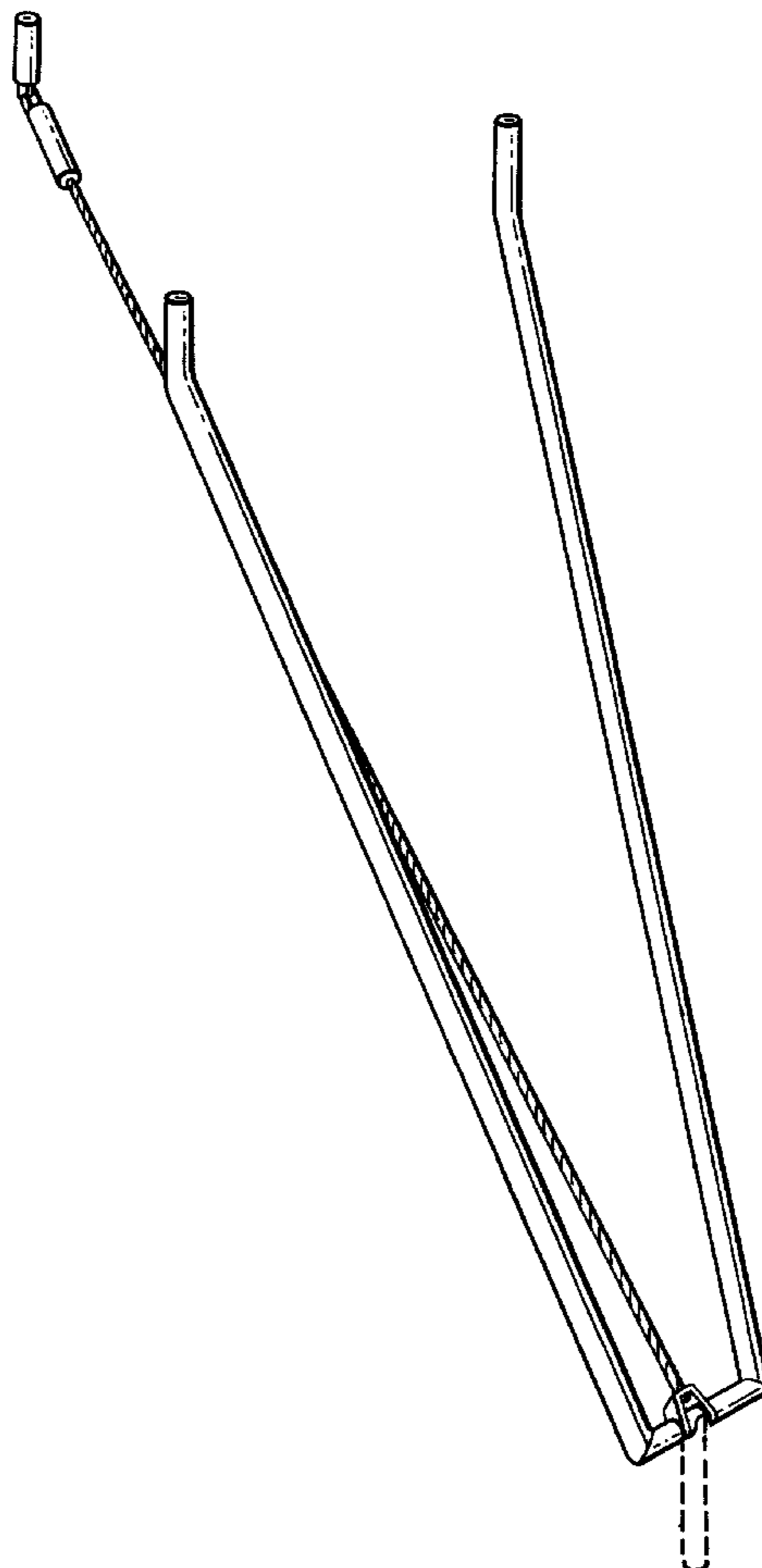
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of a four-legged table incorporating a first embodiment of my design;

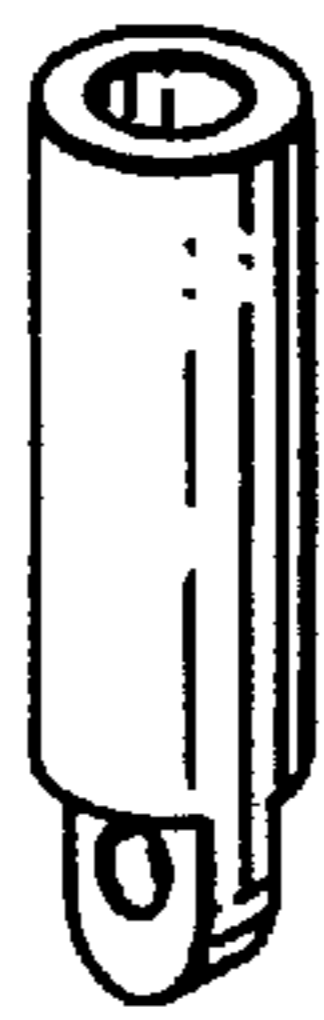
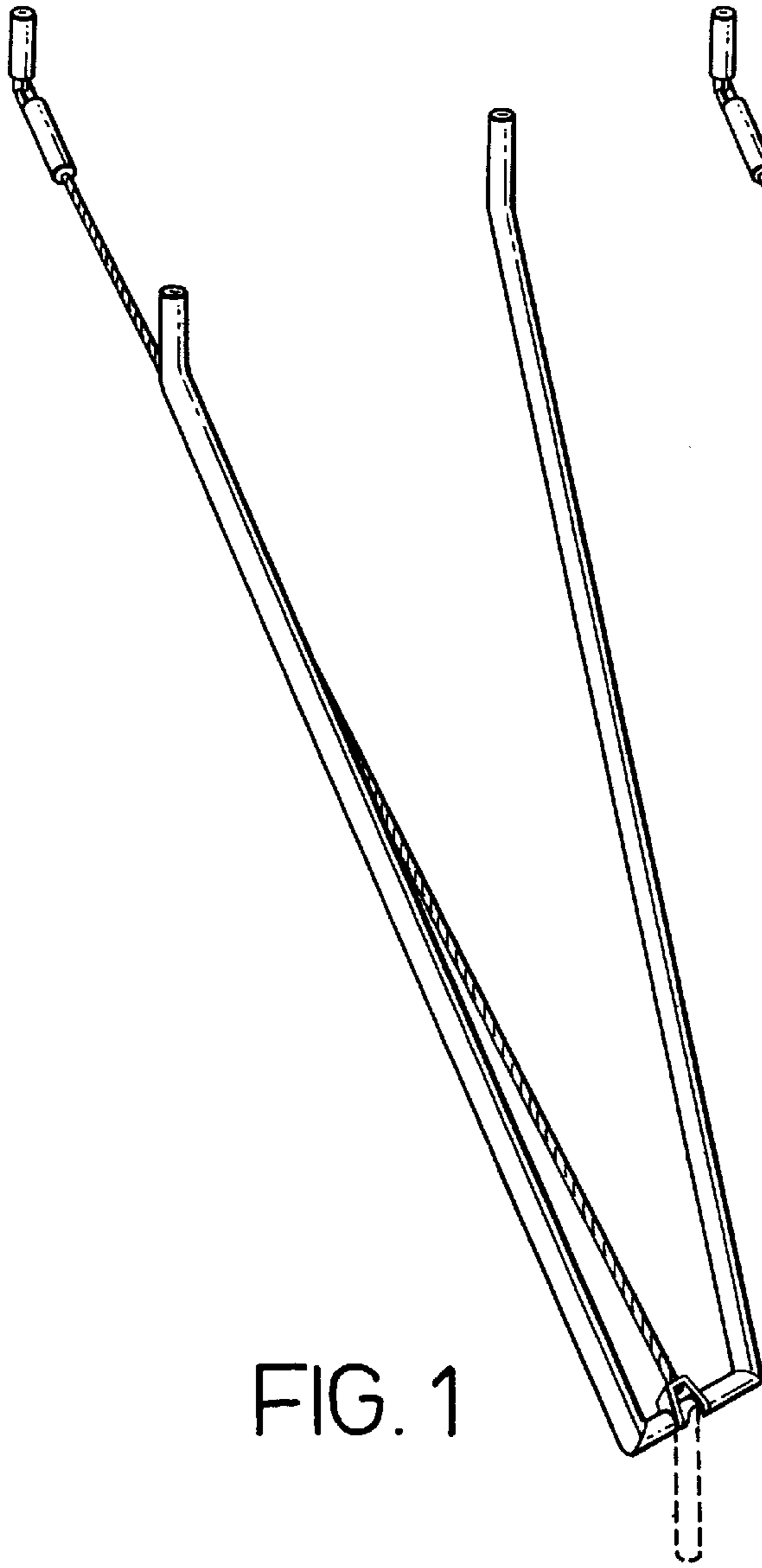
FIG. 6 is a front view of the table of FIG. 5; and,

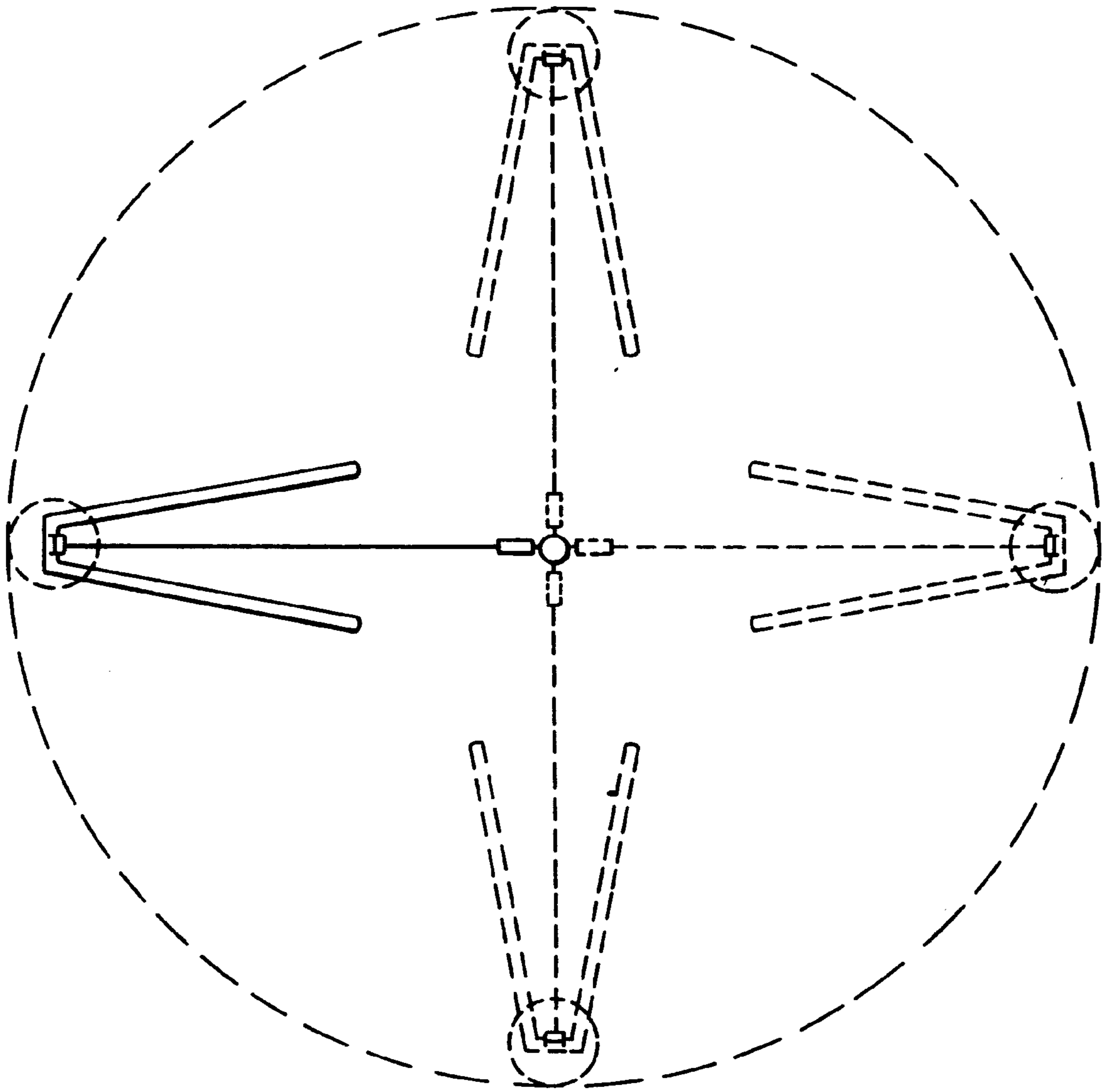

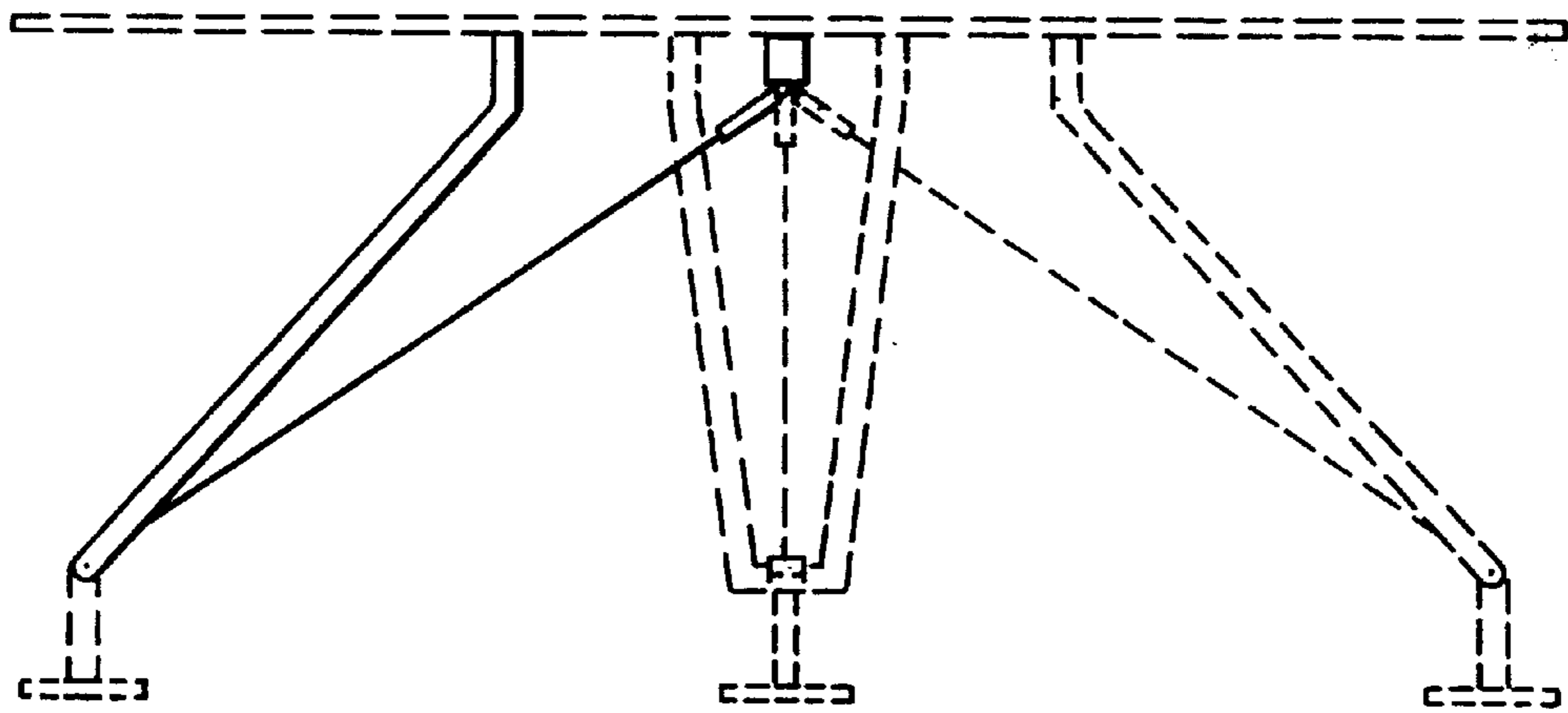

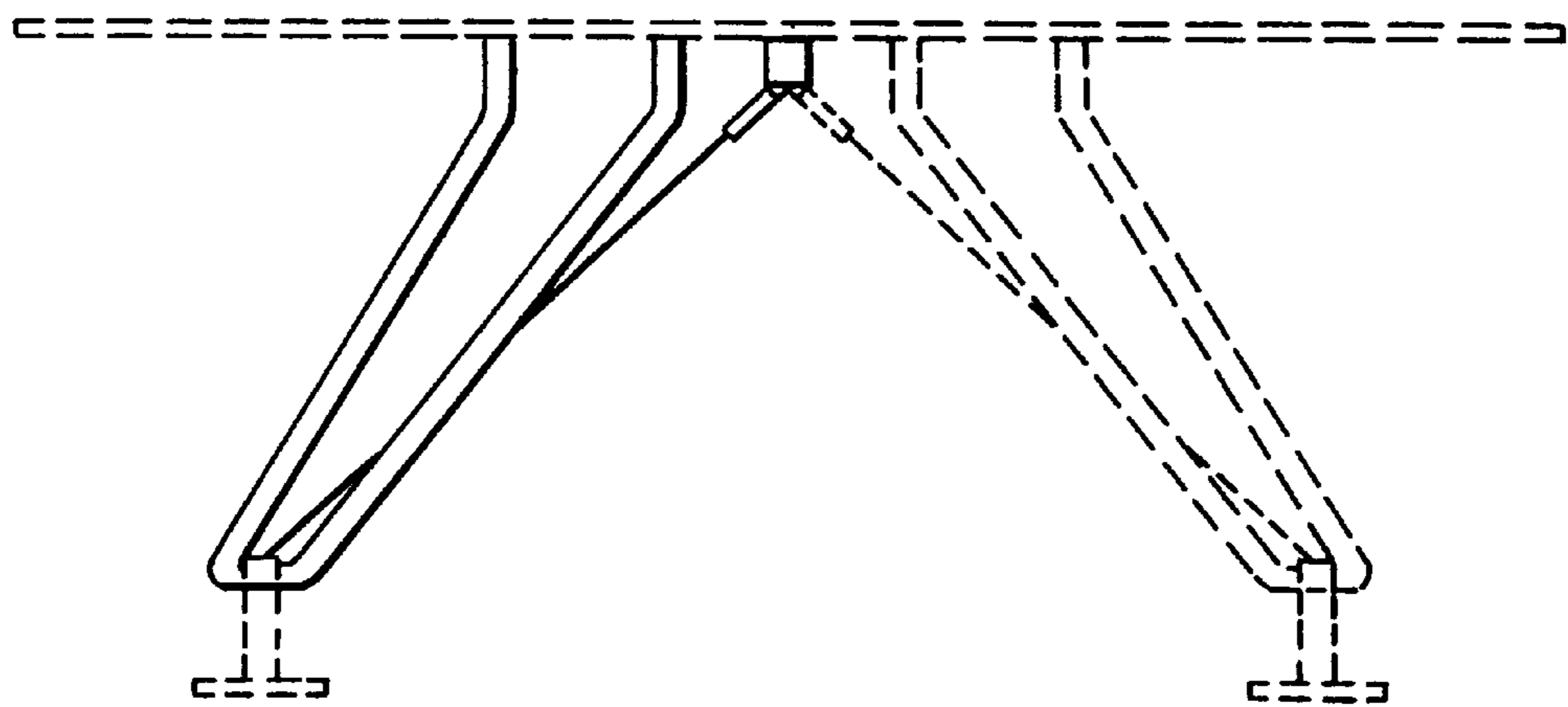
