[57] CLAIM

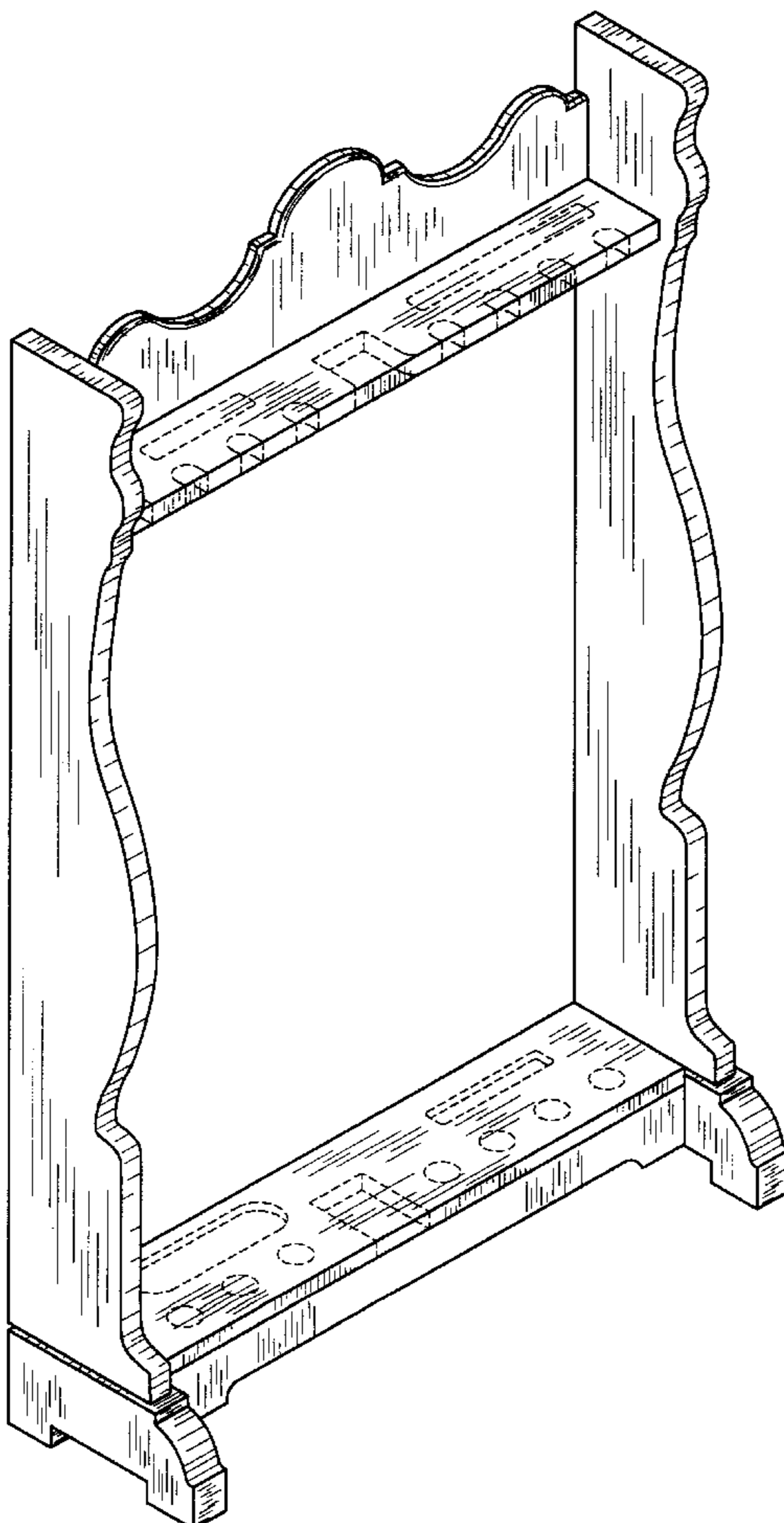
We claim the ornamental design for a billiard cue cabinet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the top, left side, and front of the billiard cue cabinet of the present invention; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the billiard cue cabinet of the present invention; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the right side of the billiard cue cabinet of the present invention; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the billiard cue cabinet of the present invention; FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the left side of the billiard cue cabinet of the present invention; FIG. 6 is top elevational view of the billiard cue cabinet of the present invention; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom elevational view of the billiard cue cabinet of the present invention.

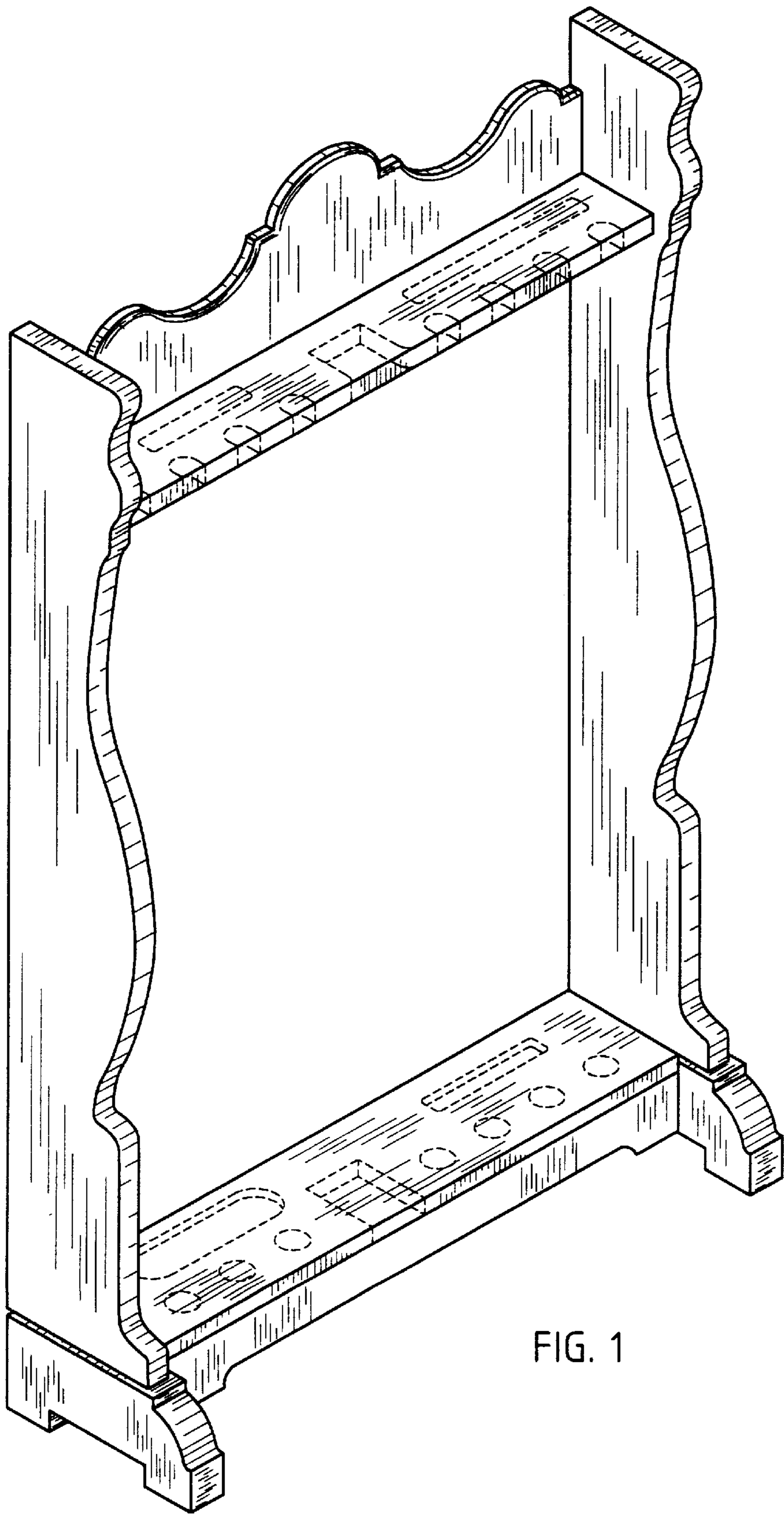

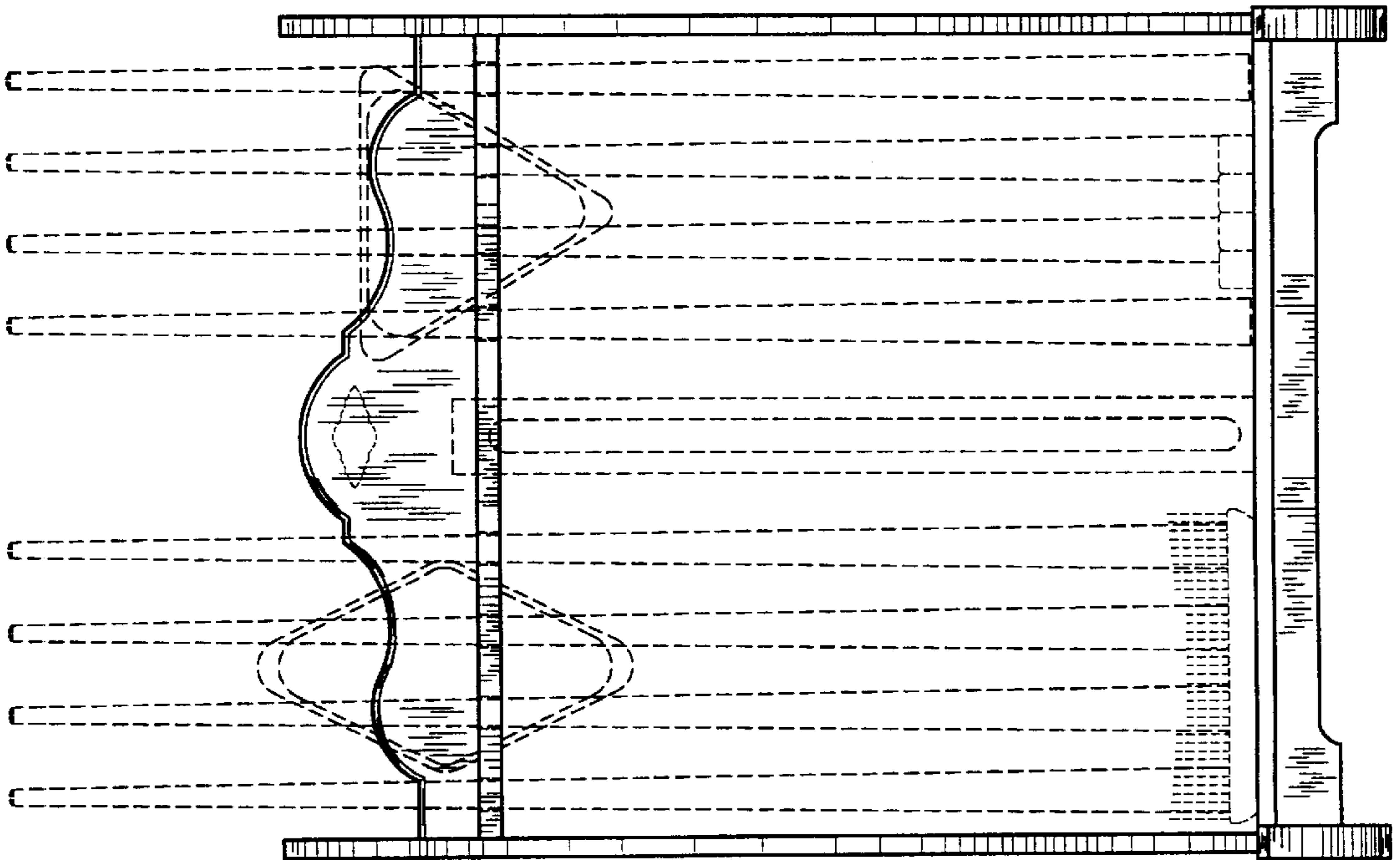

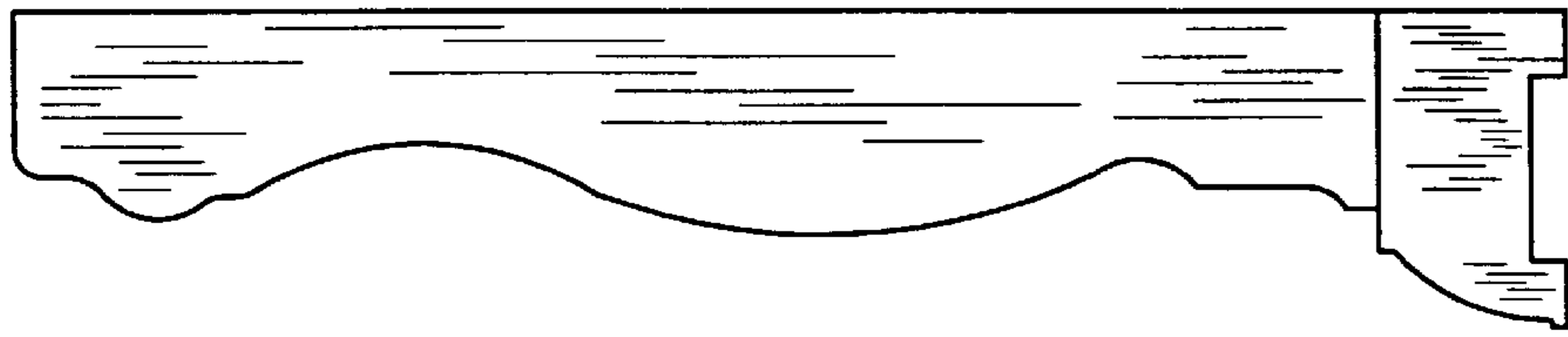

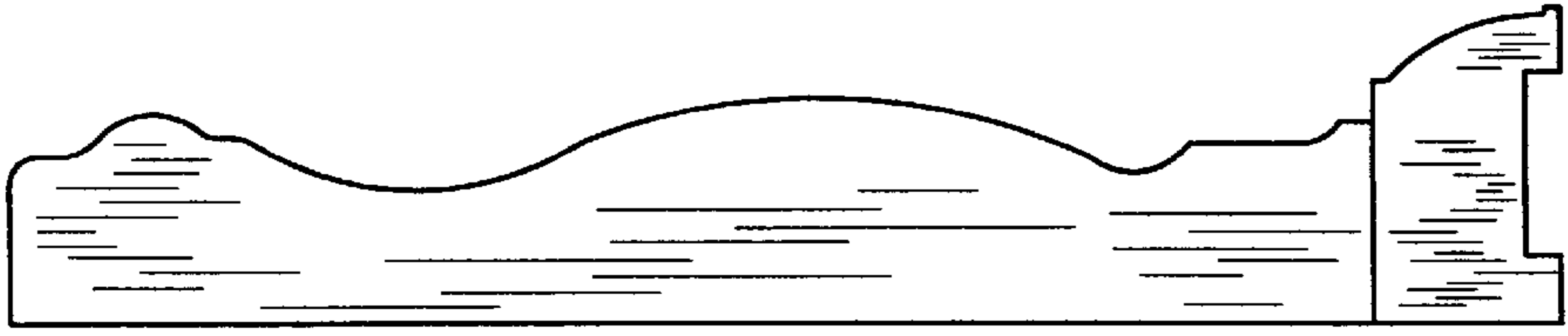

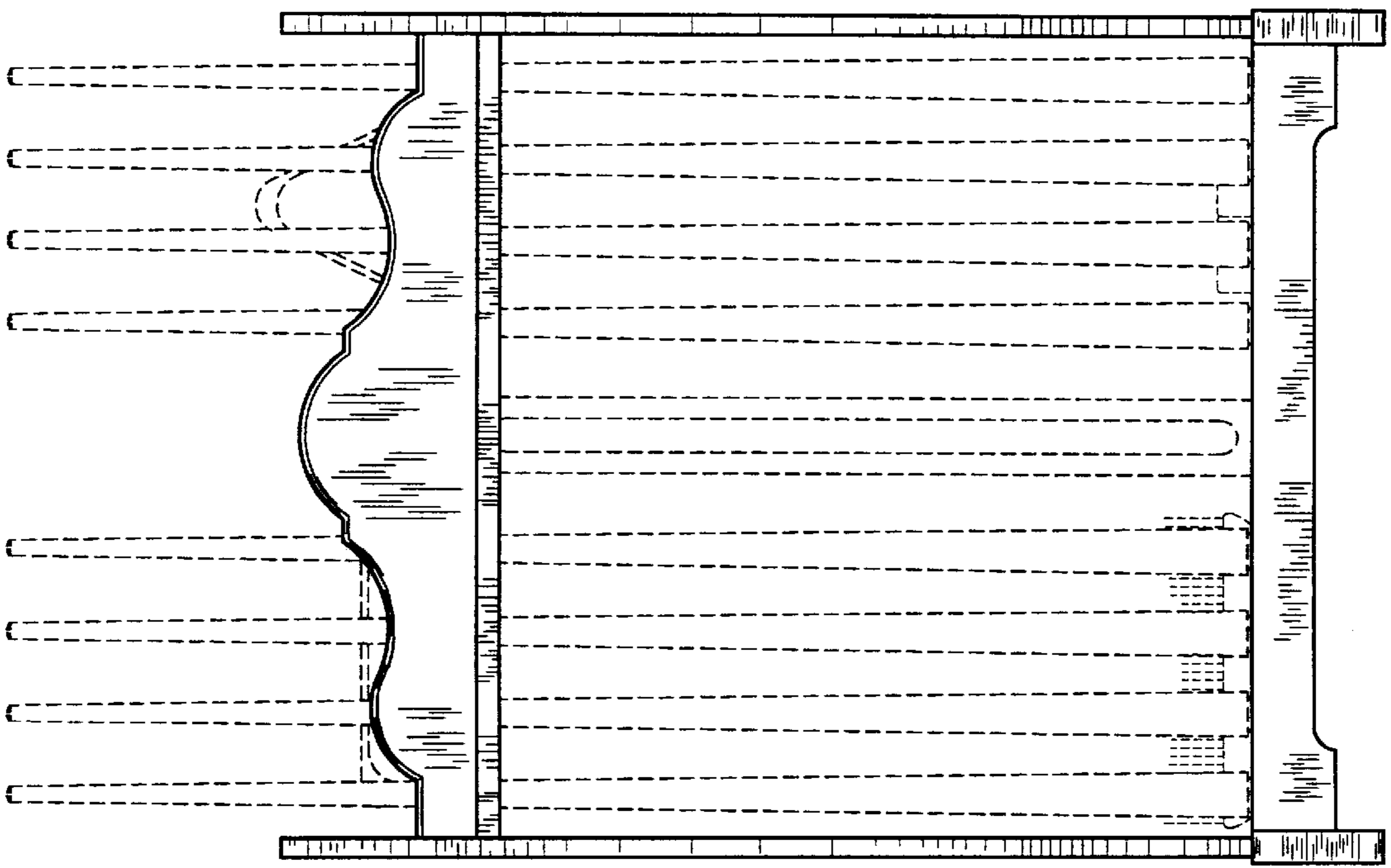

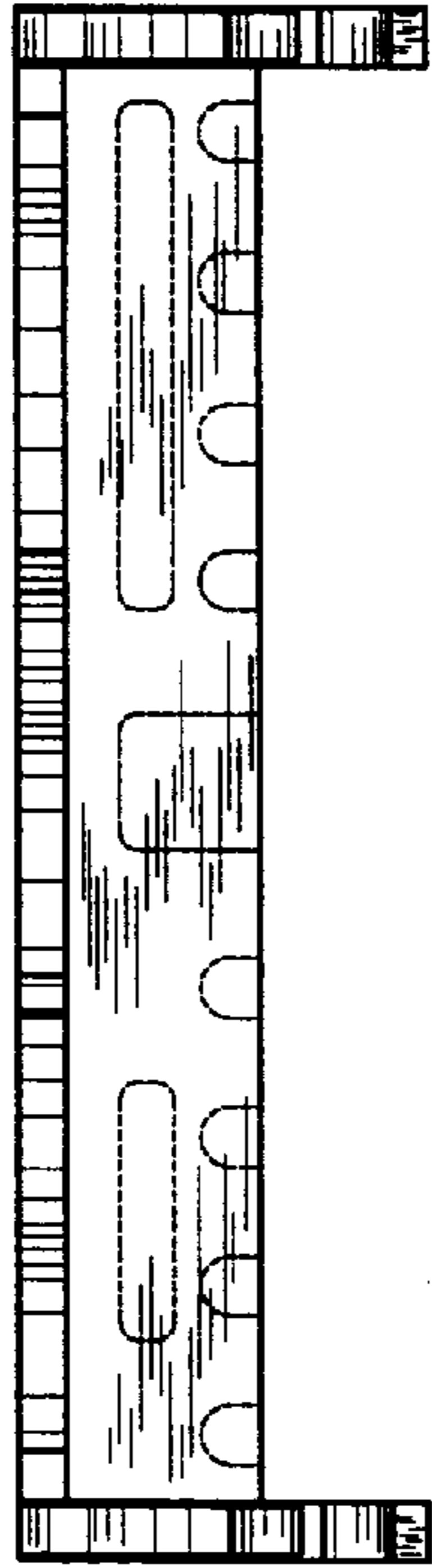

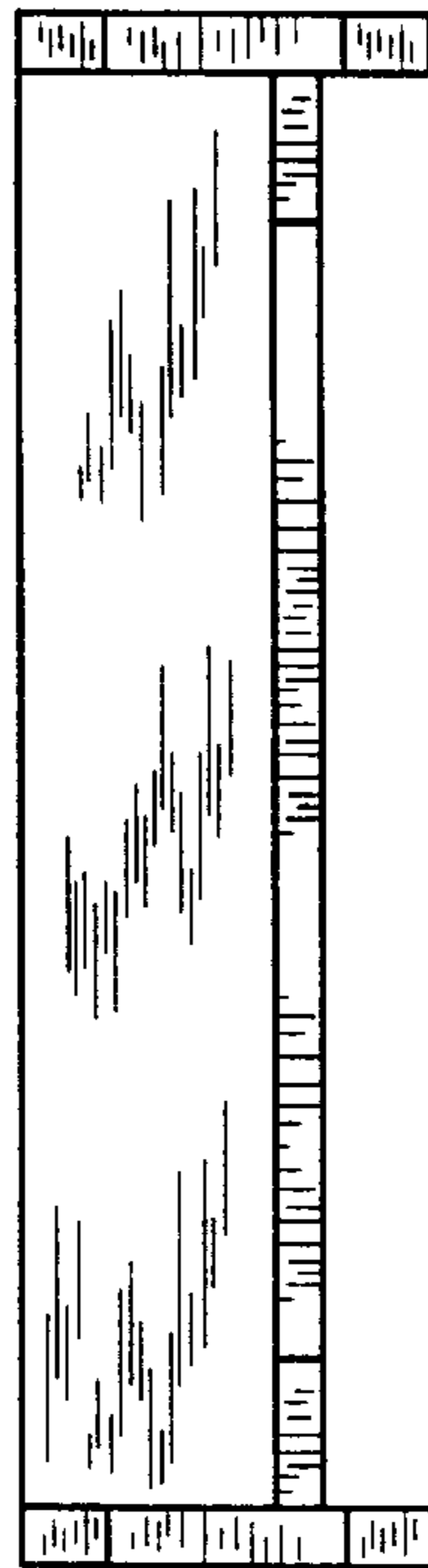
