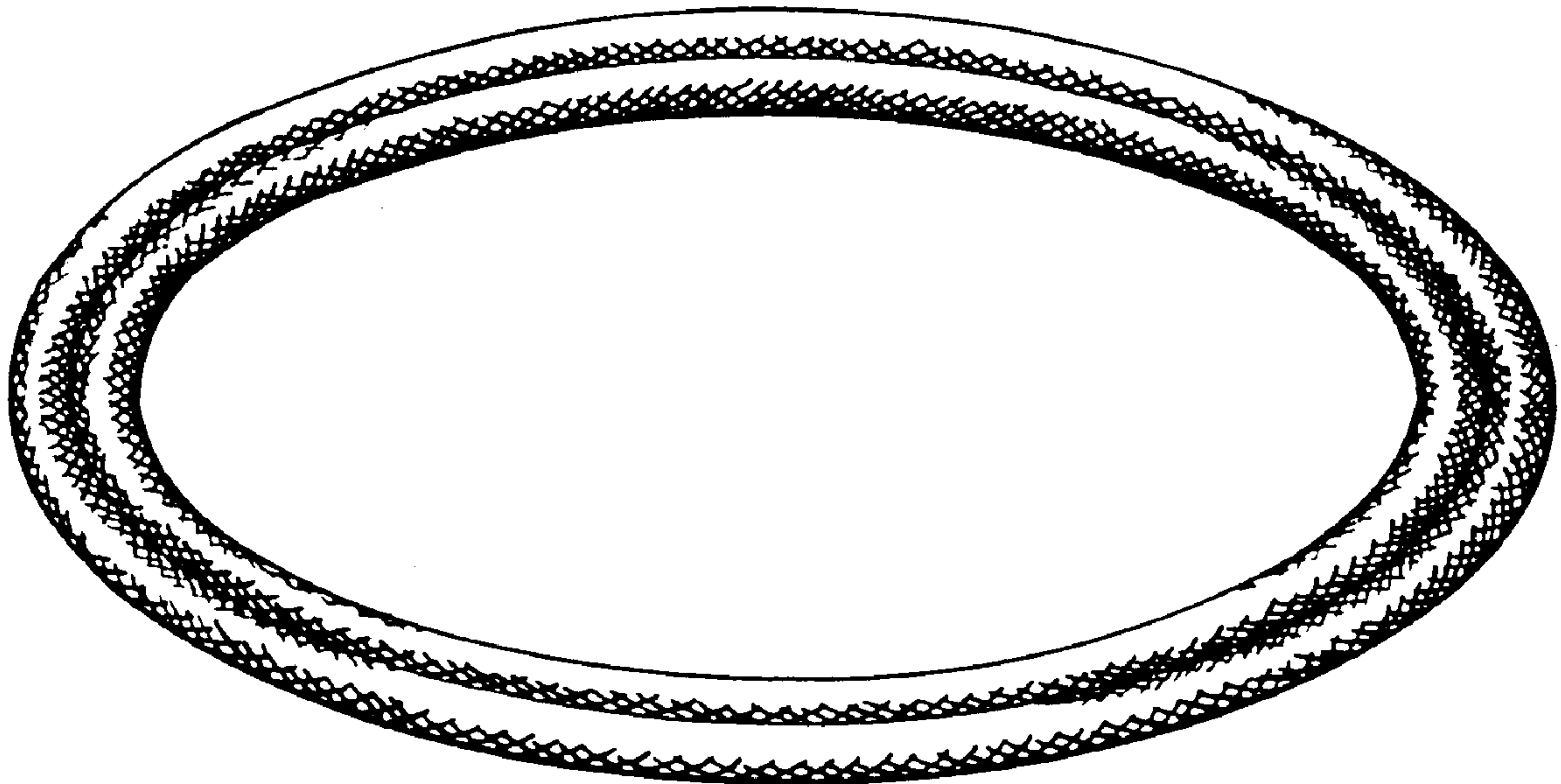
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a plant tie, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of the plant tie from a first side; FIG. 2 is a plan view from a second side opposite to the first side thereof; FIG. 3 is an end view thereof; FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof; FIG. 5 is a cross-section on line 5—5 of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 6 is an environmental sectional view of a plant tie showing the article in use. The broken line showing of a partial plant is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

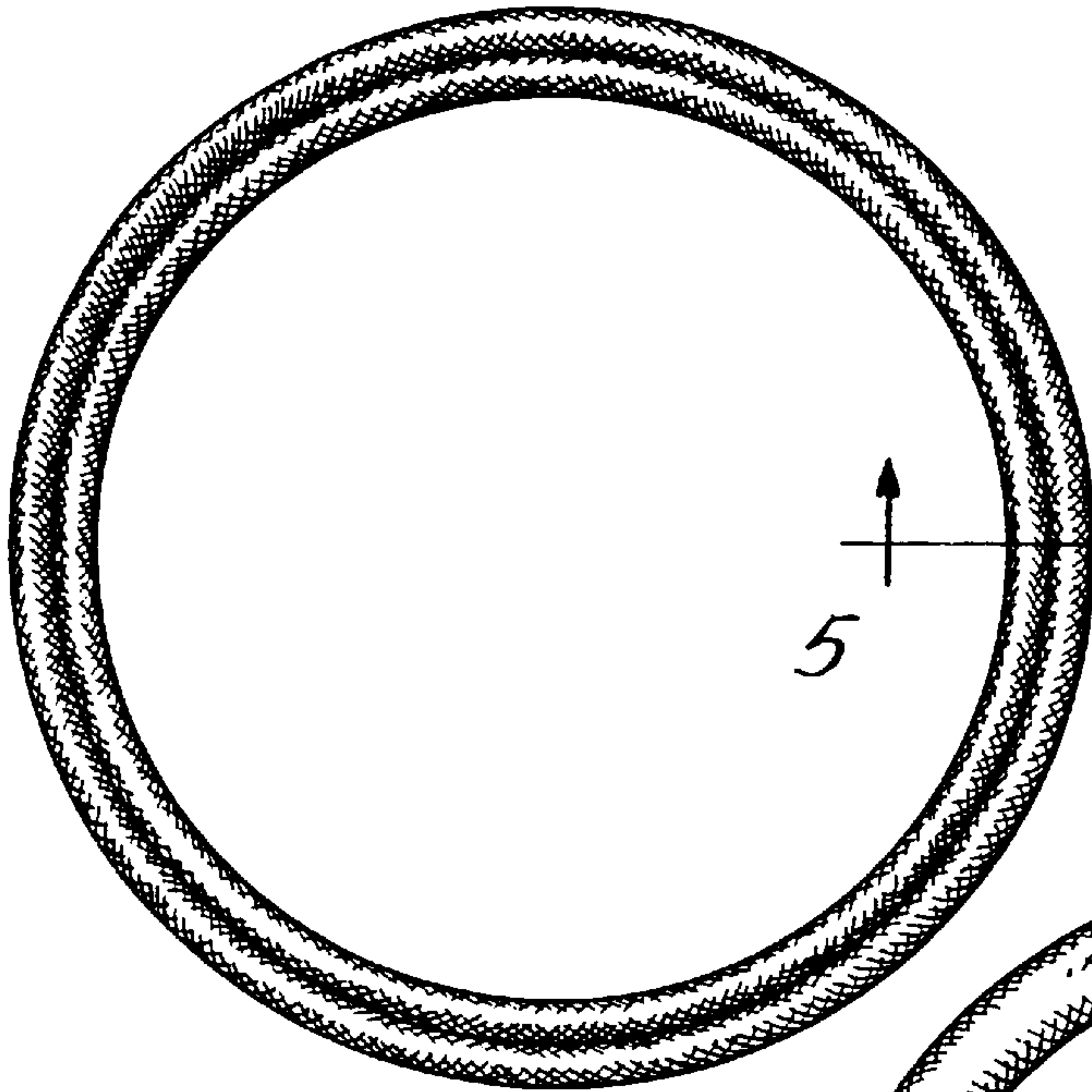

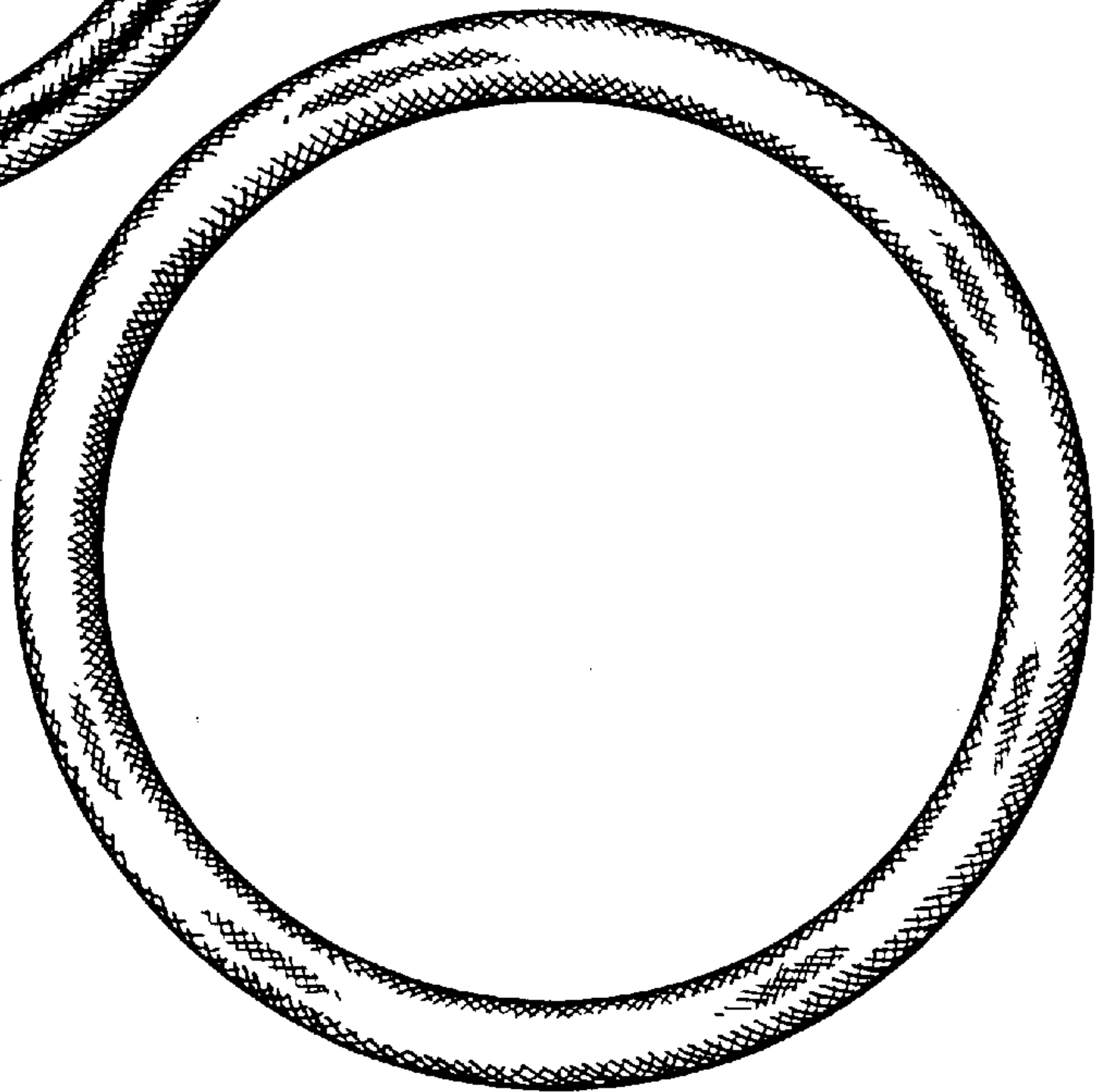

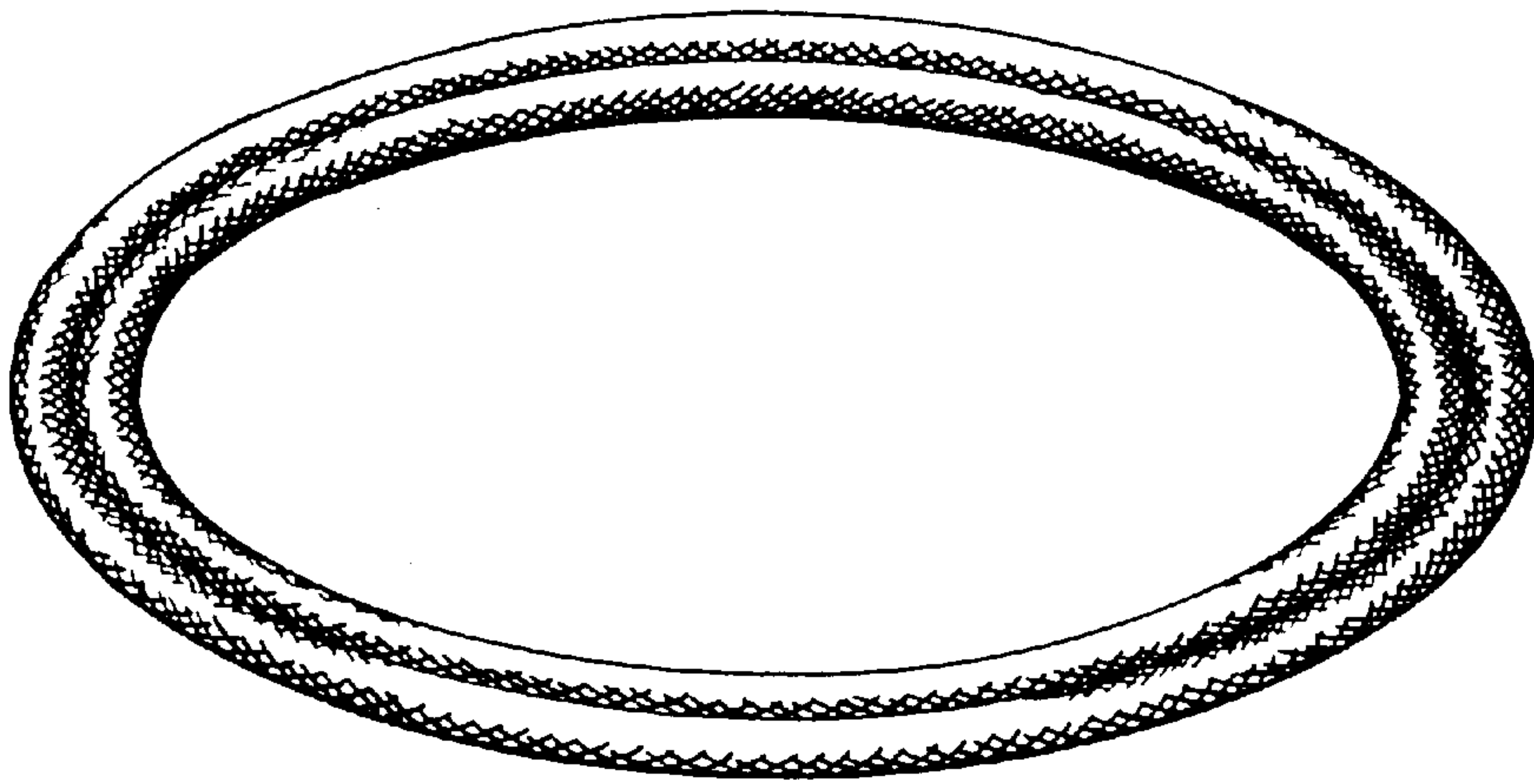

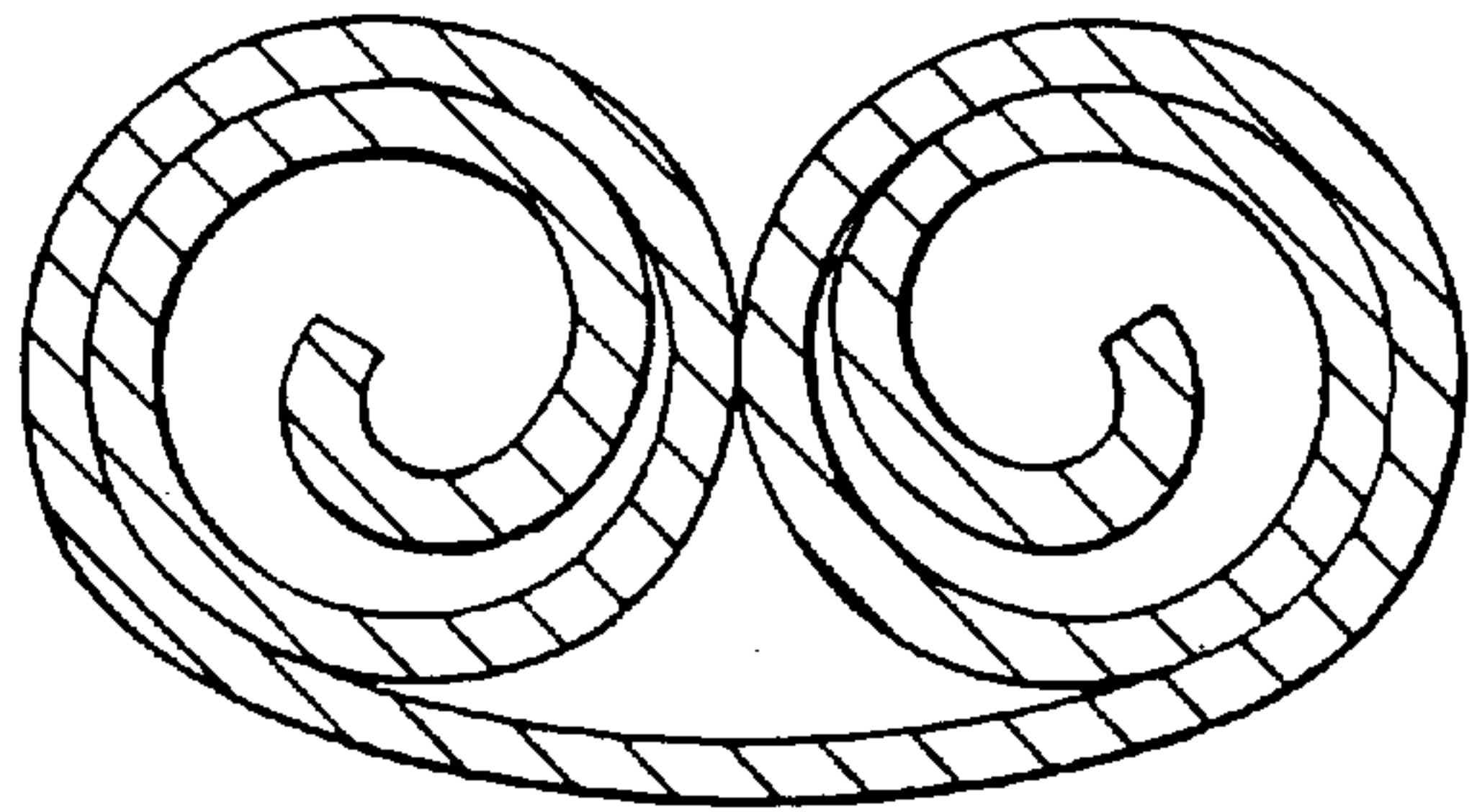

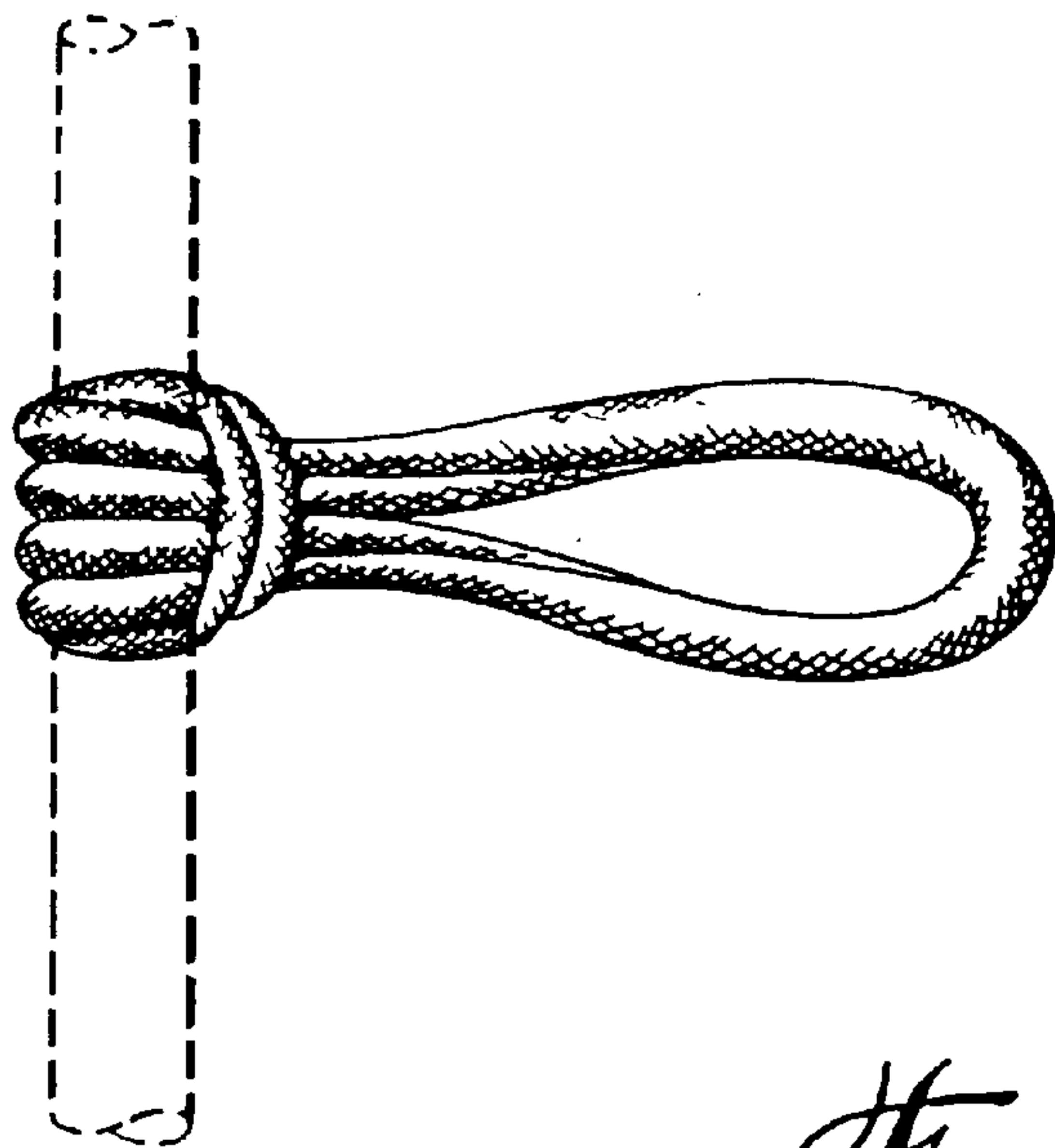
