[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a drug test card for drugs of abuse, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a drug test card for drugs of abuse showing my new design

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan thereof, the bottom plan view being identical thereto;

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along the line 4—4 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being identical thereto;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of a drug test card for drugs of abuse showing my new design

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being identical thereto;

FIG. 9 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along the line 9—9 of FIG. 6;

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being identical thereto;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment of a drug test card for drugs of abuse showing my new design

FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being identical thereto;

FIG. 14 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 14—14 of FIG. 11;

FIG. 15 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being identical thereto;

FIG. 16 is a front elevational view of a fourth embodiment of a drug test card for drugs of abuse showing my new design

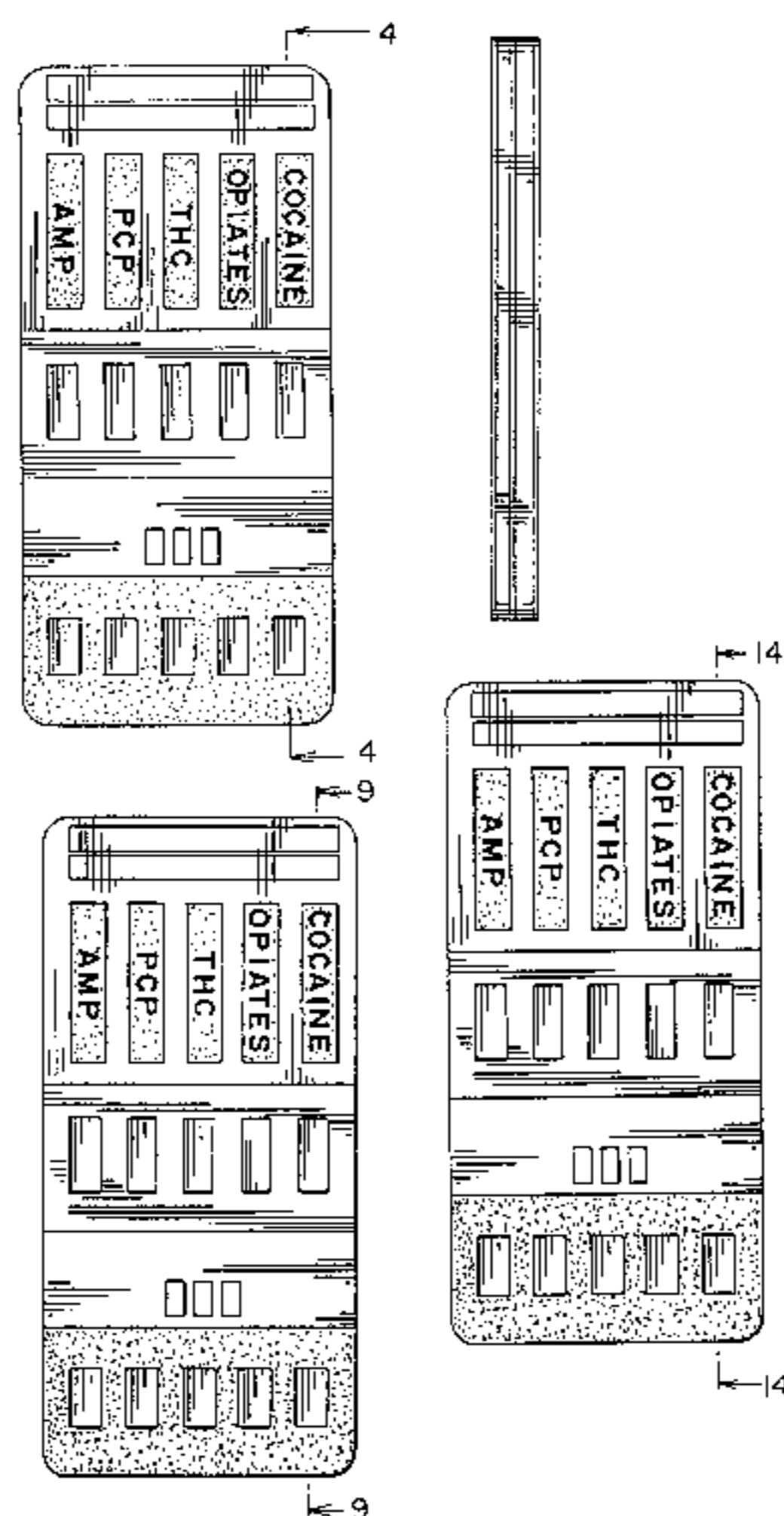
FIG. 17 is a rear elevational view thereof;

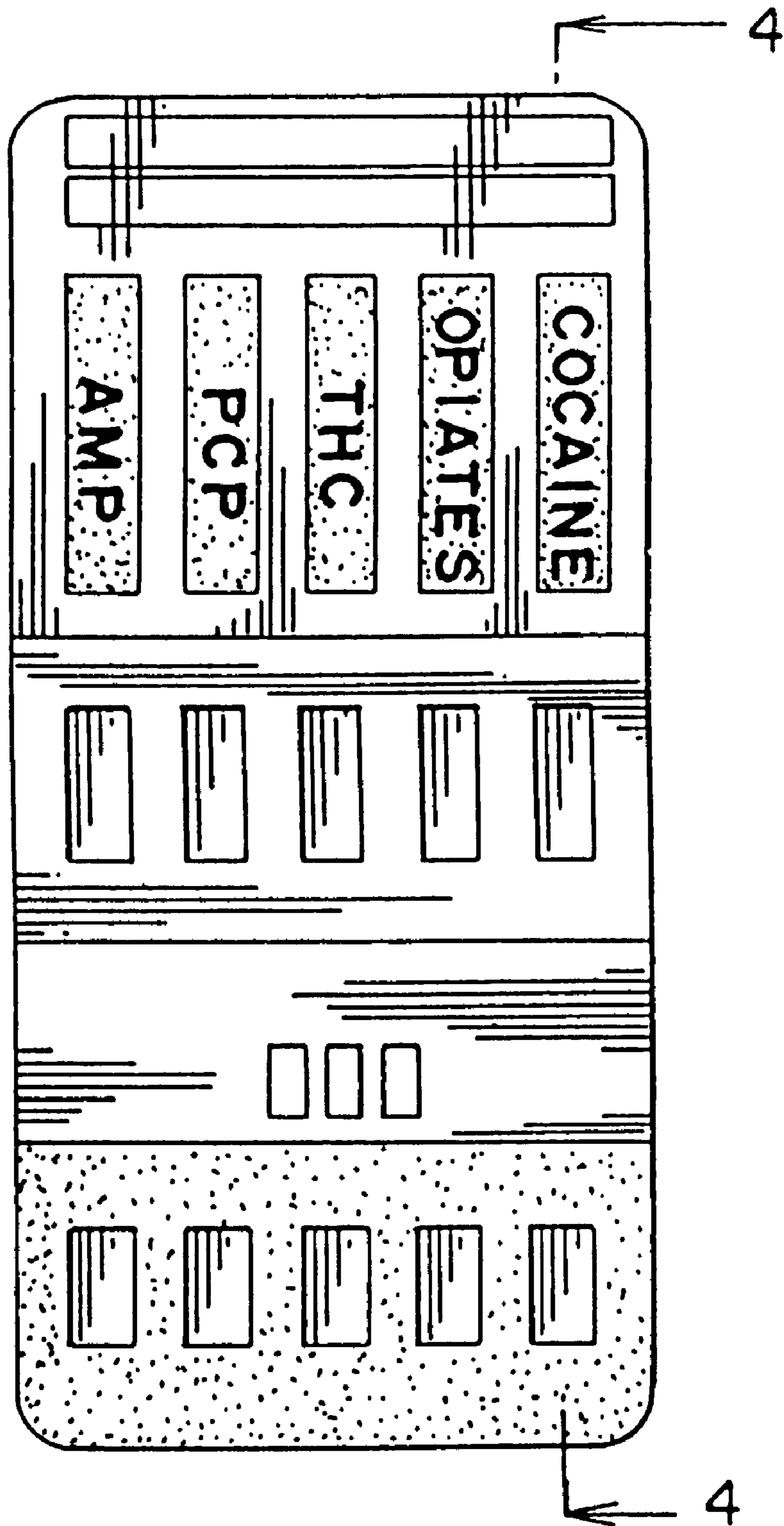

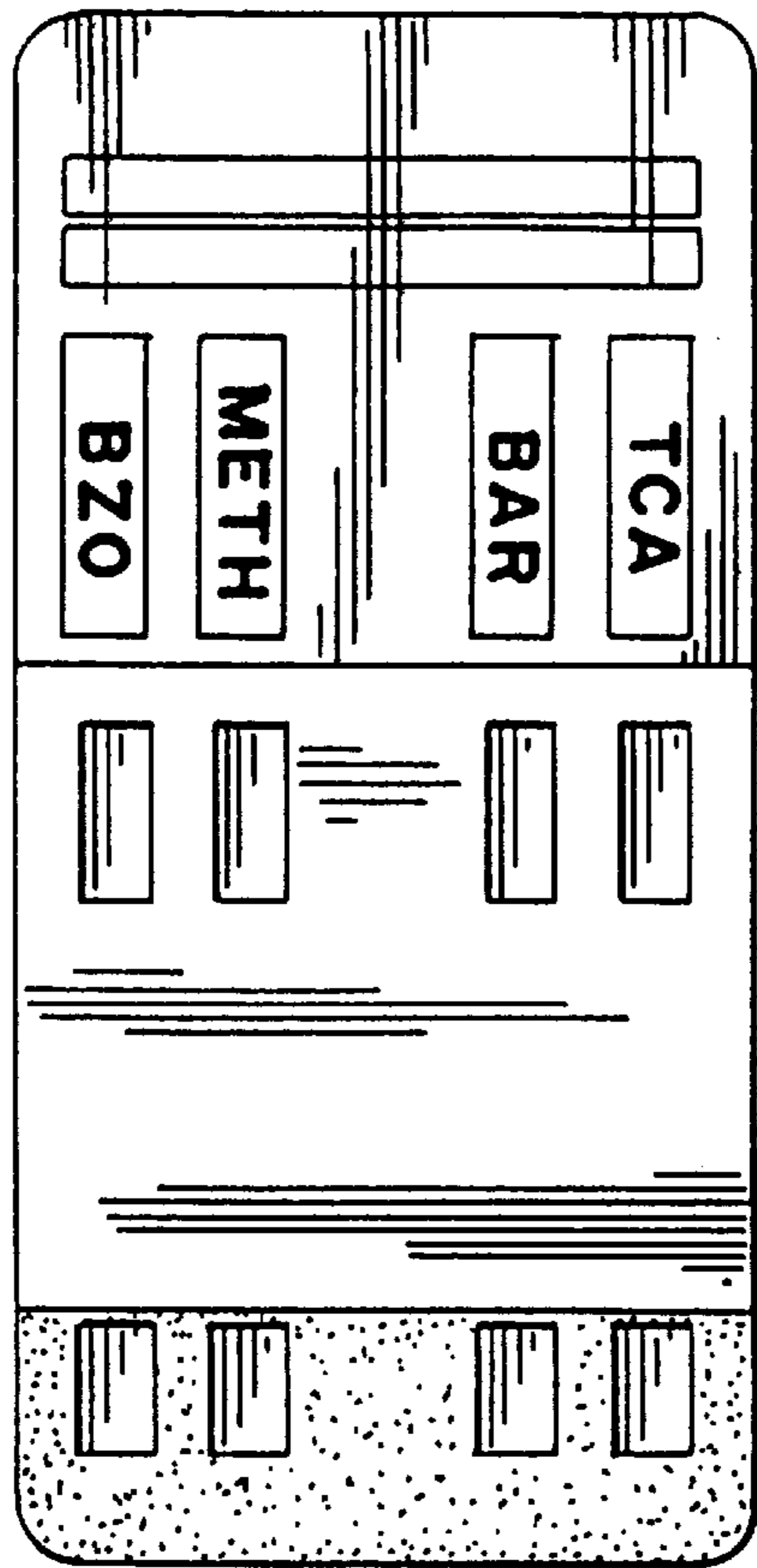

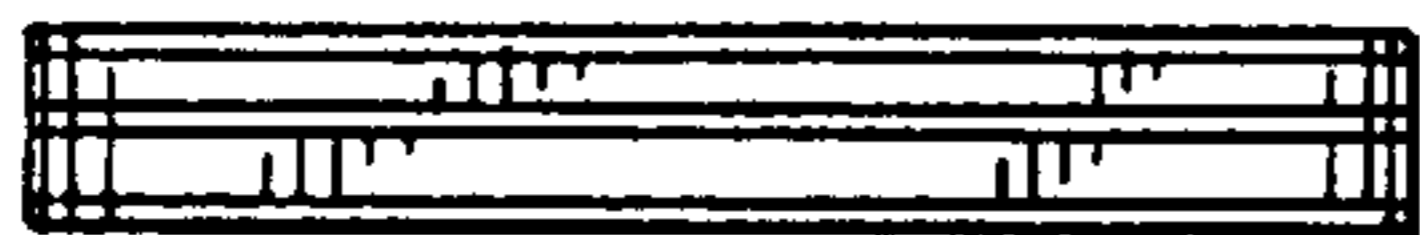

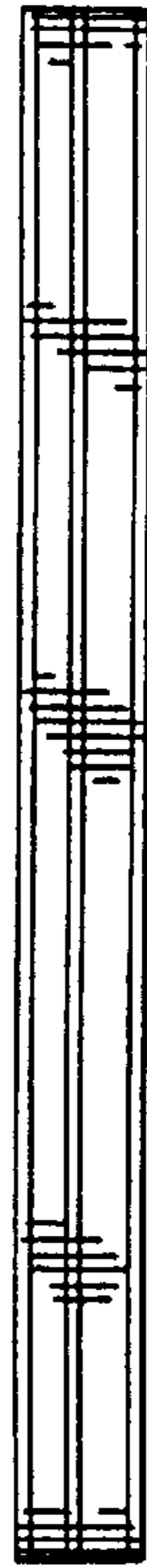

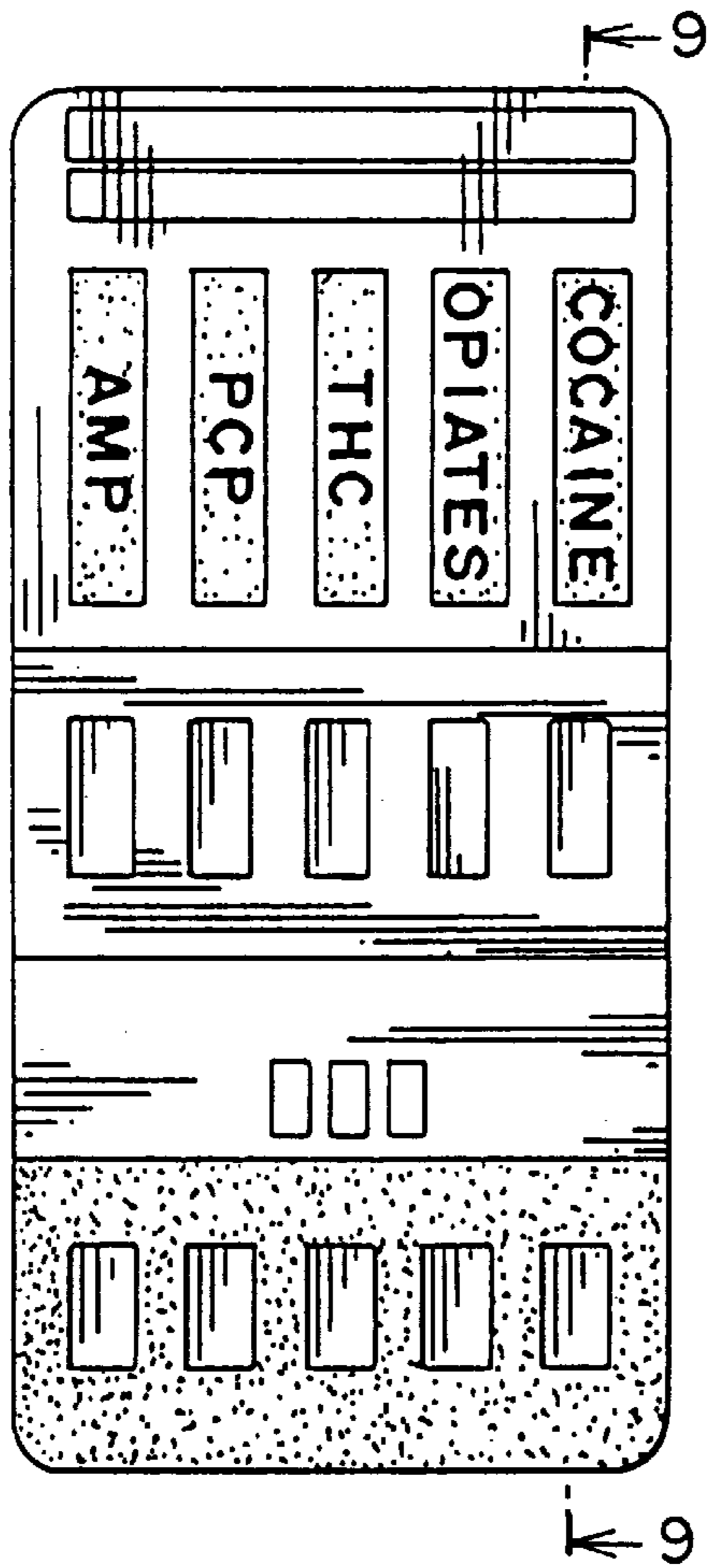

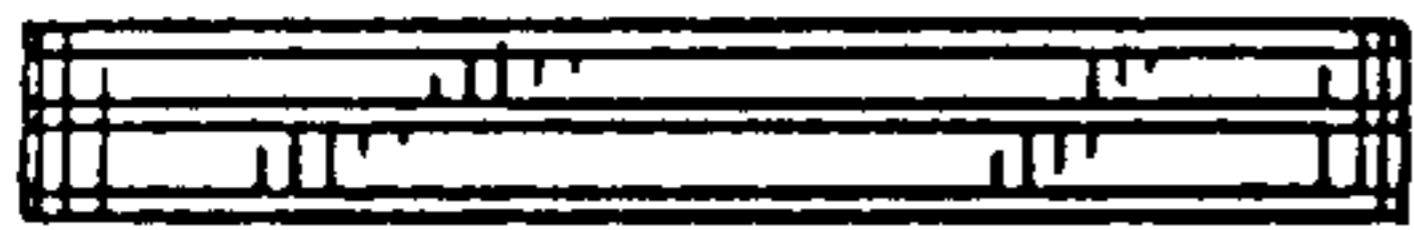

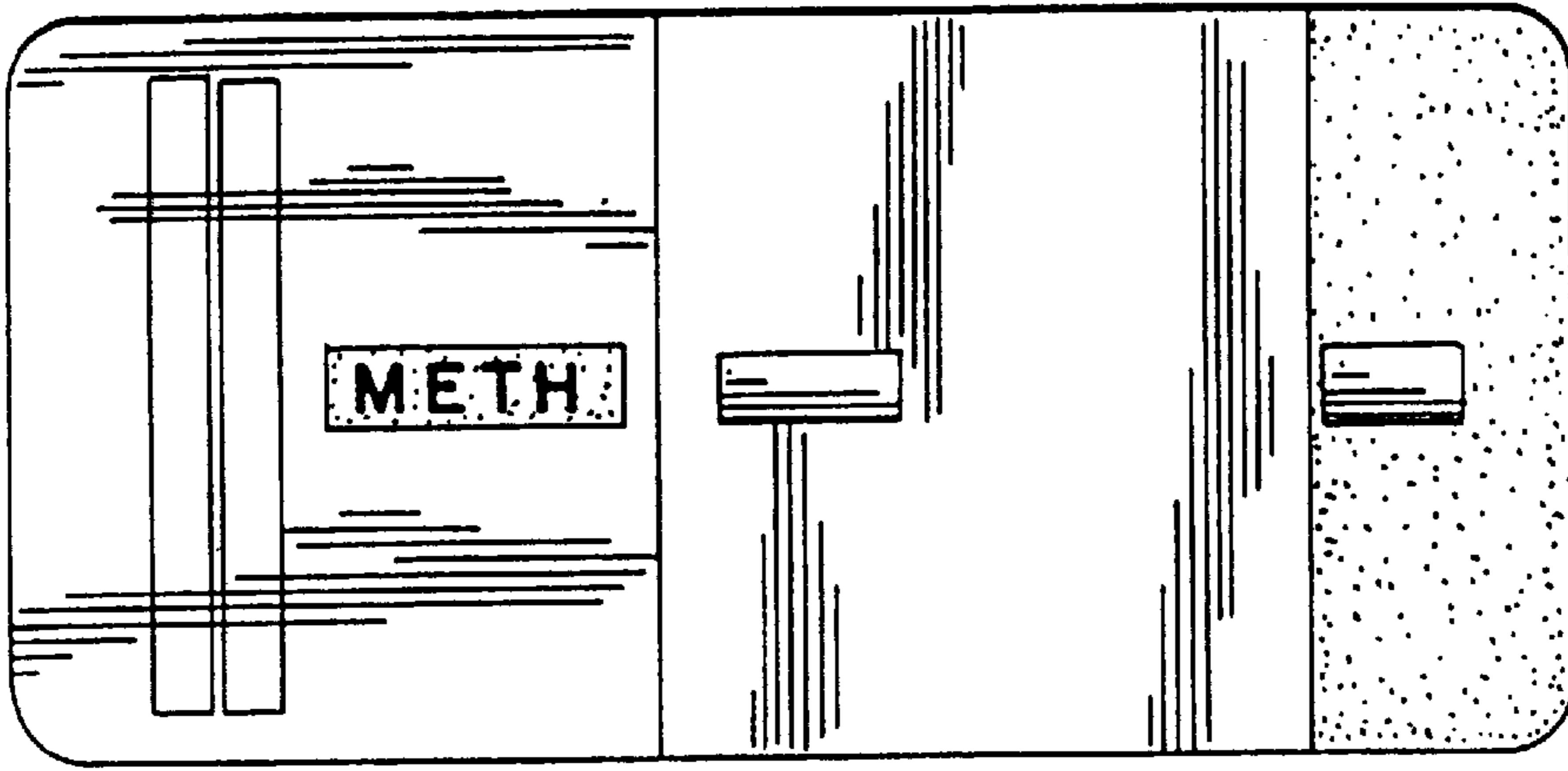

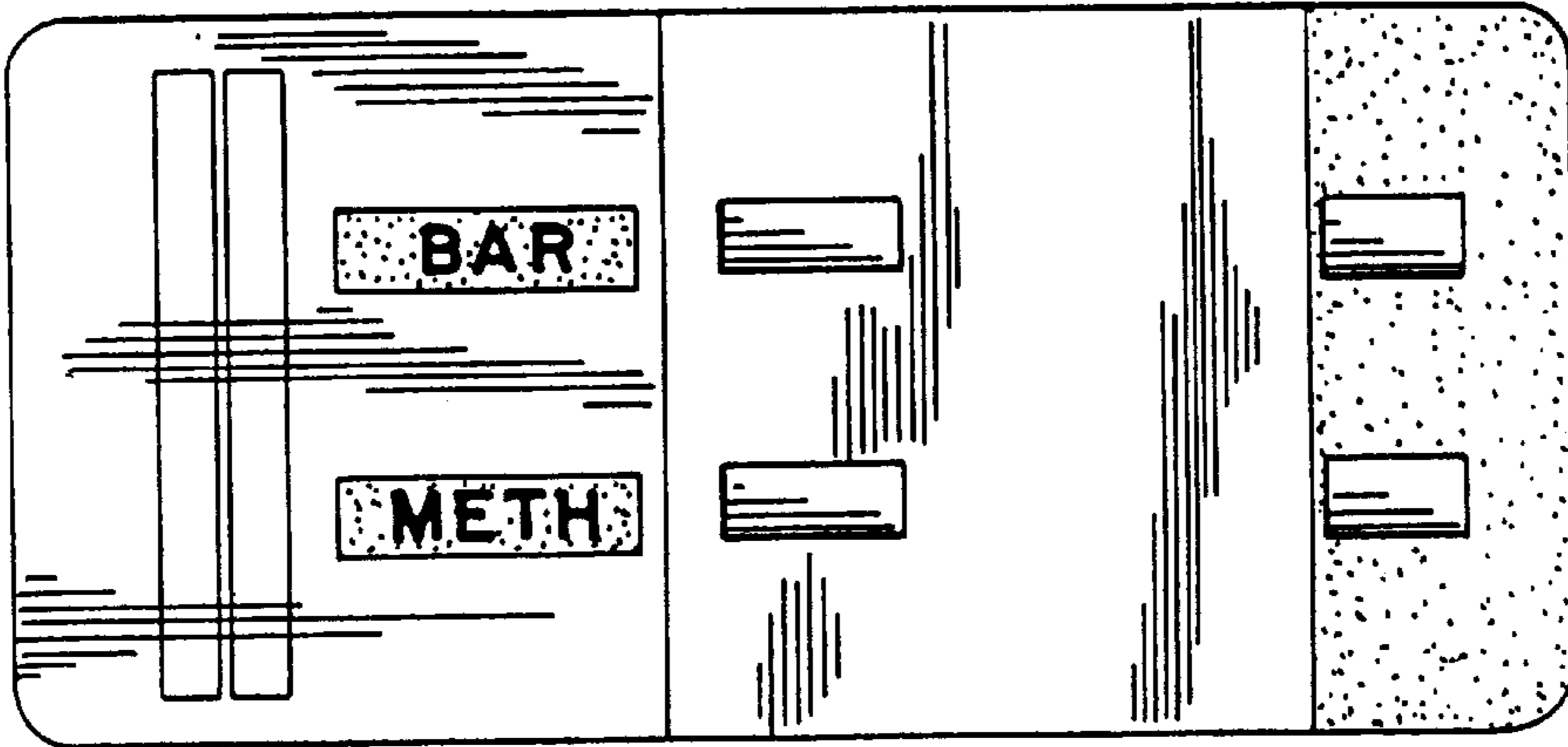

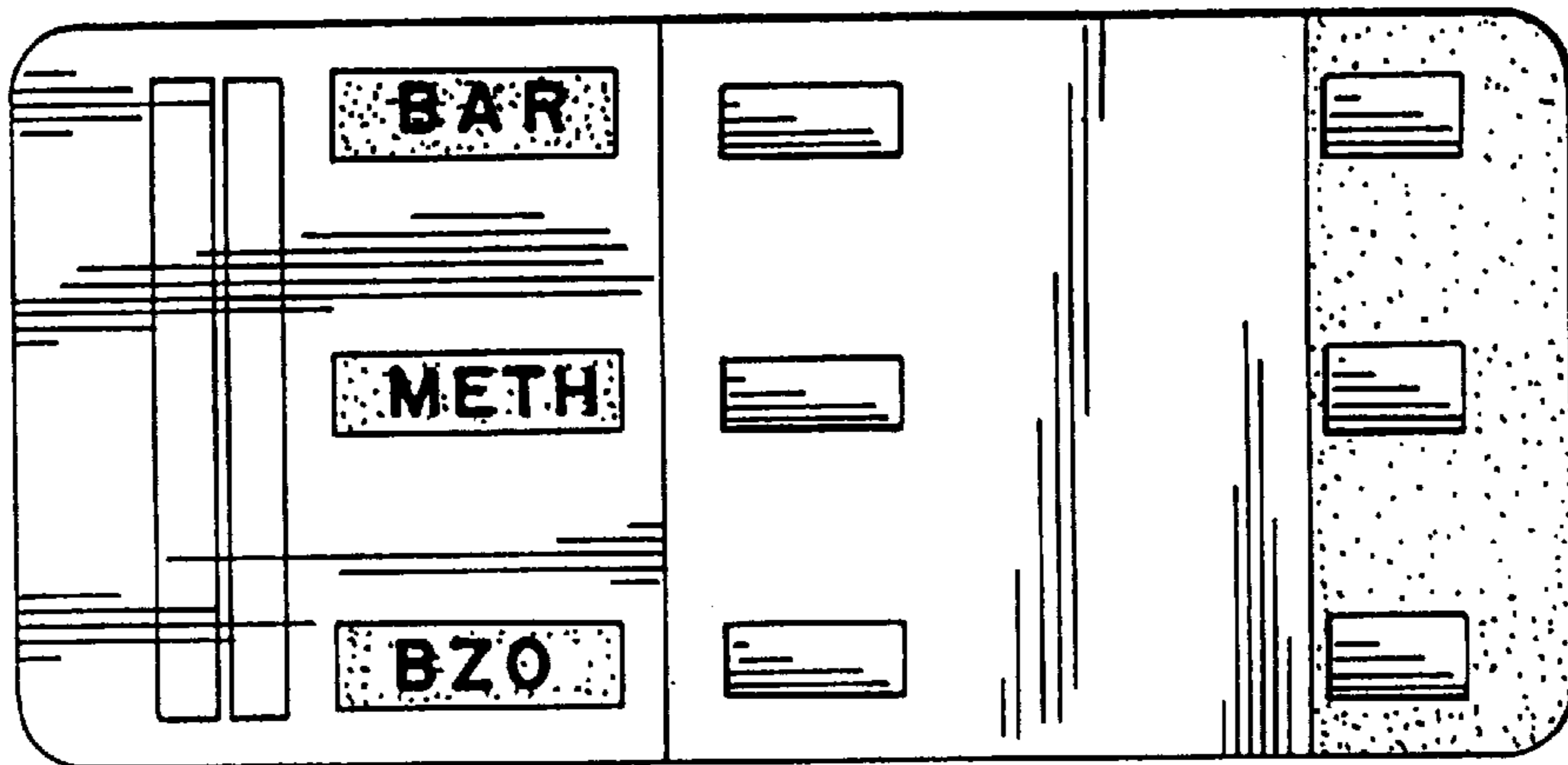

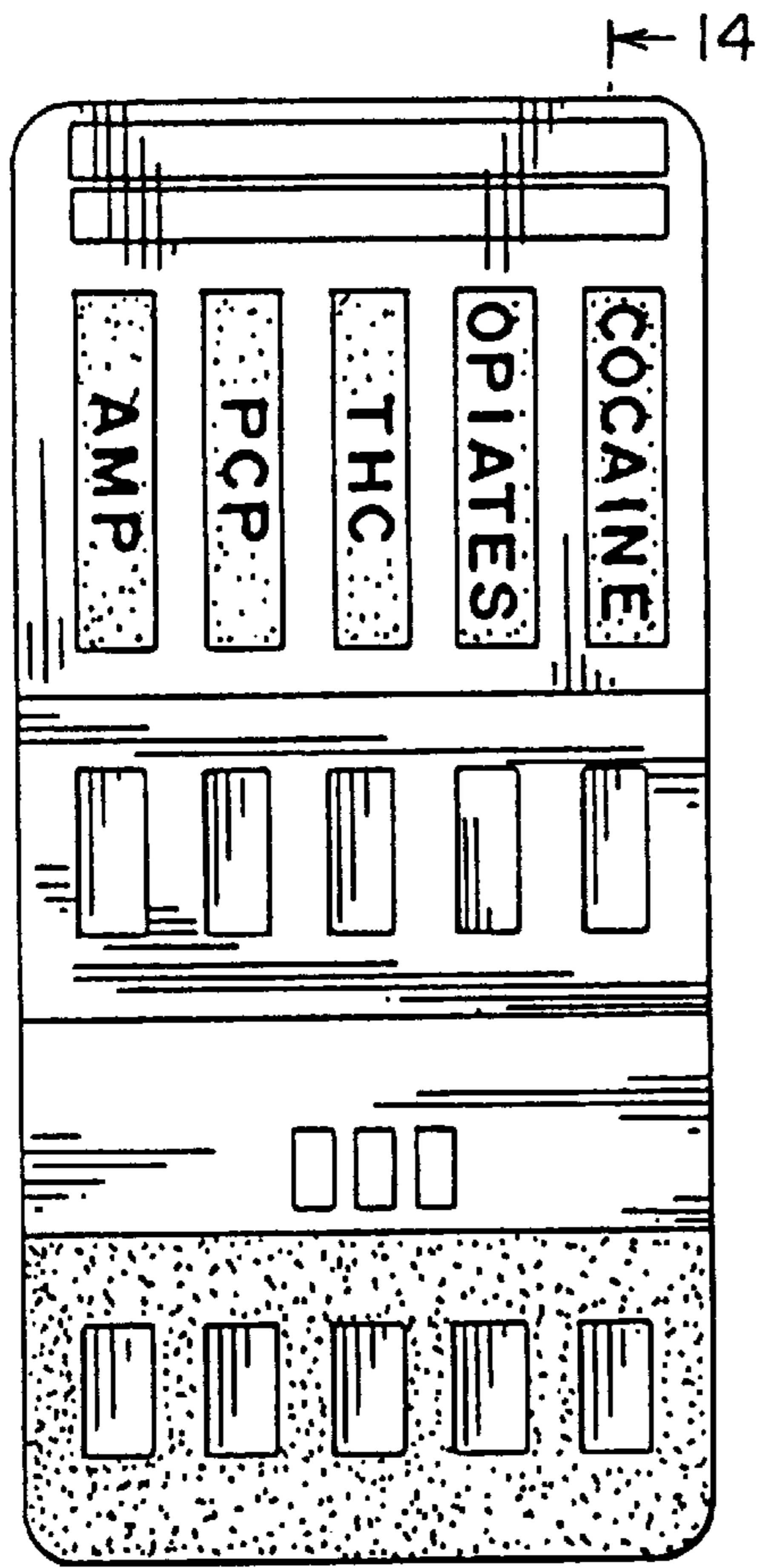

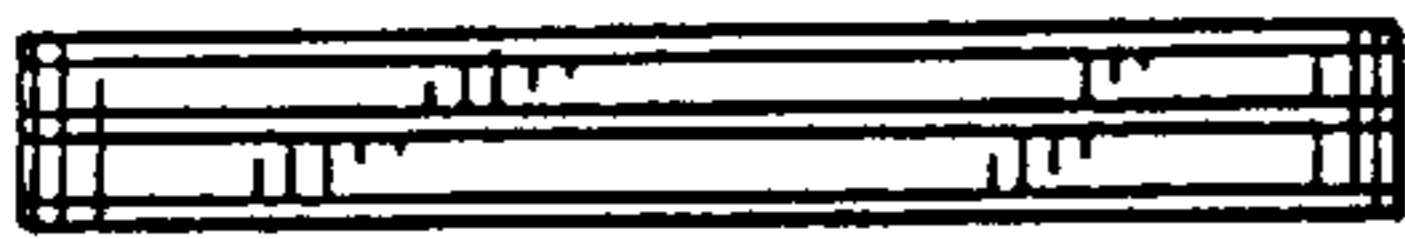

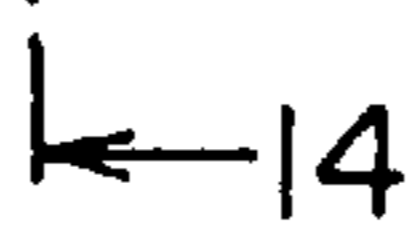

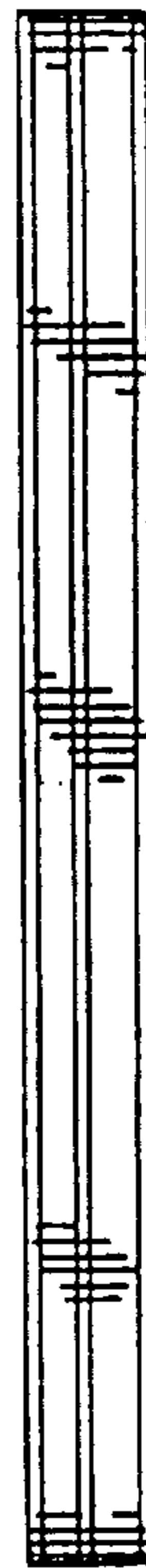

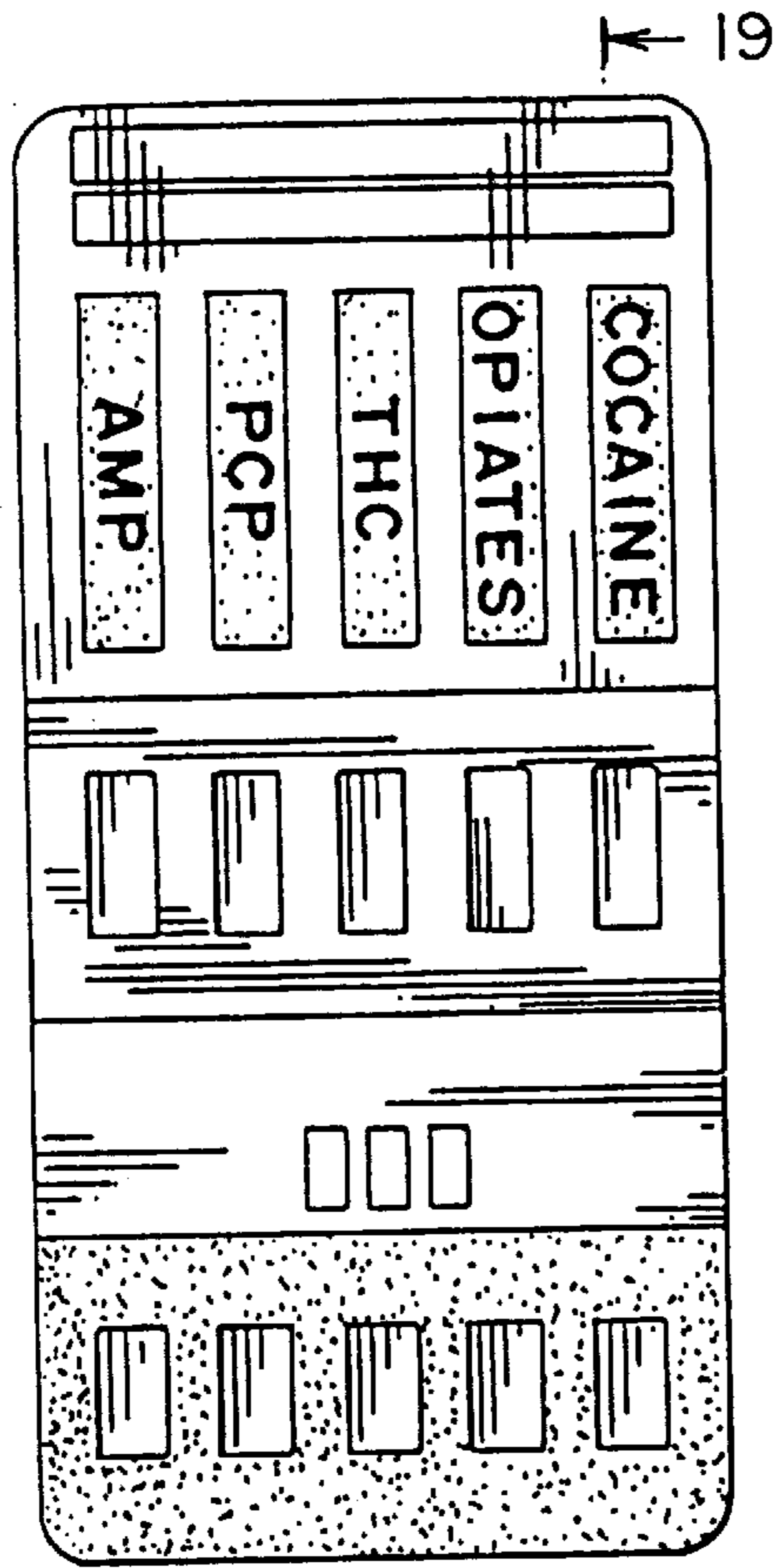

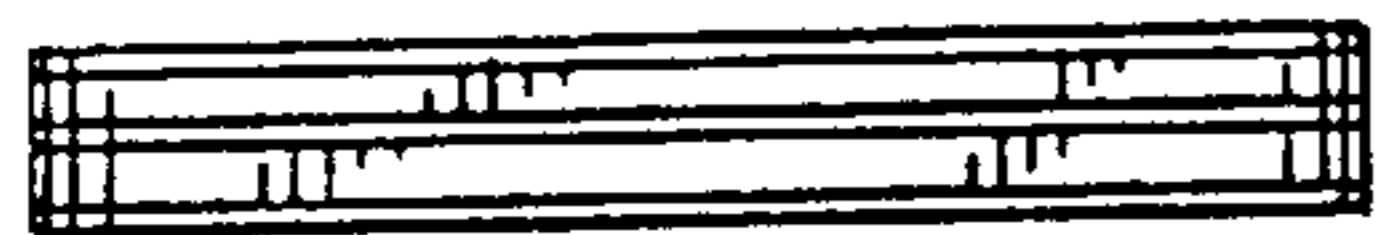

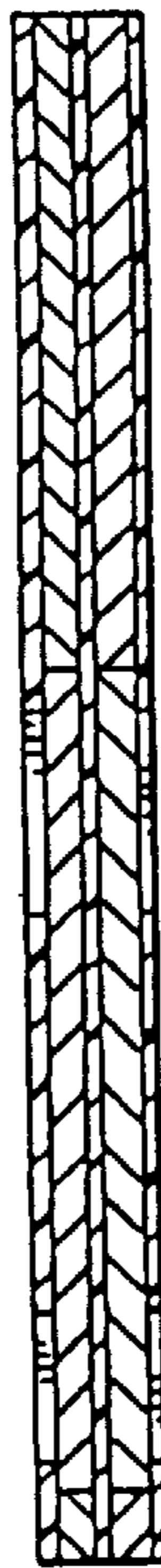
