FIG. 4 is a front view of a bicycle saddle, showing a preferred embodiment of our new ornamental design.

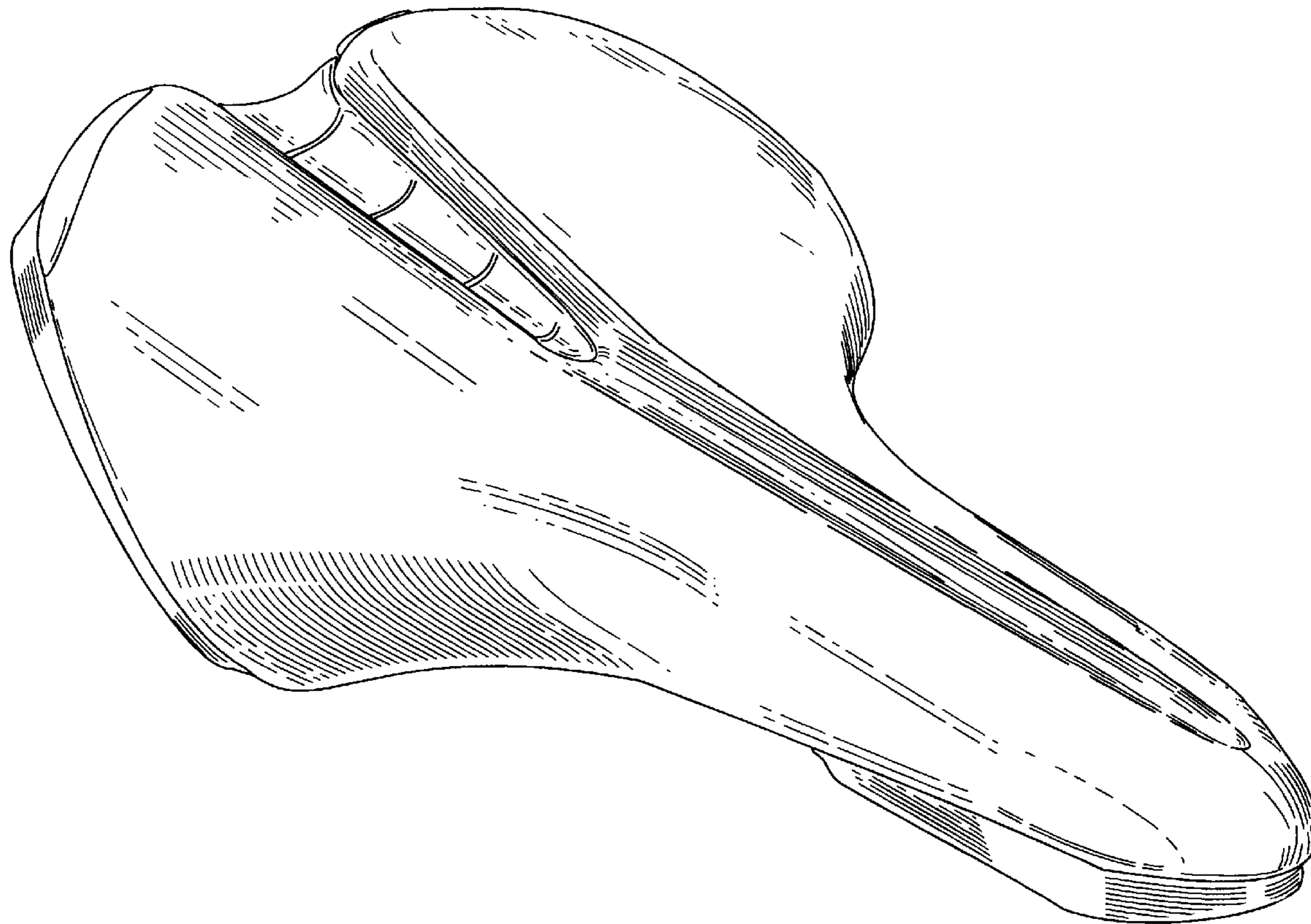
FIG. 5 is a back view of a bicycle saddle, showing a preferred embodiment of our new ornamental design.

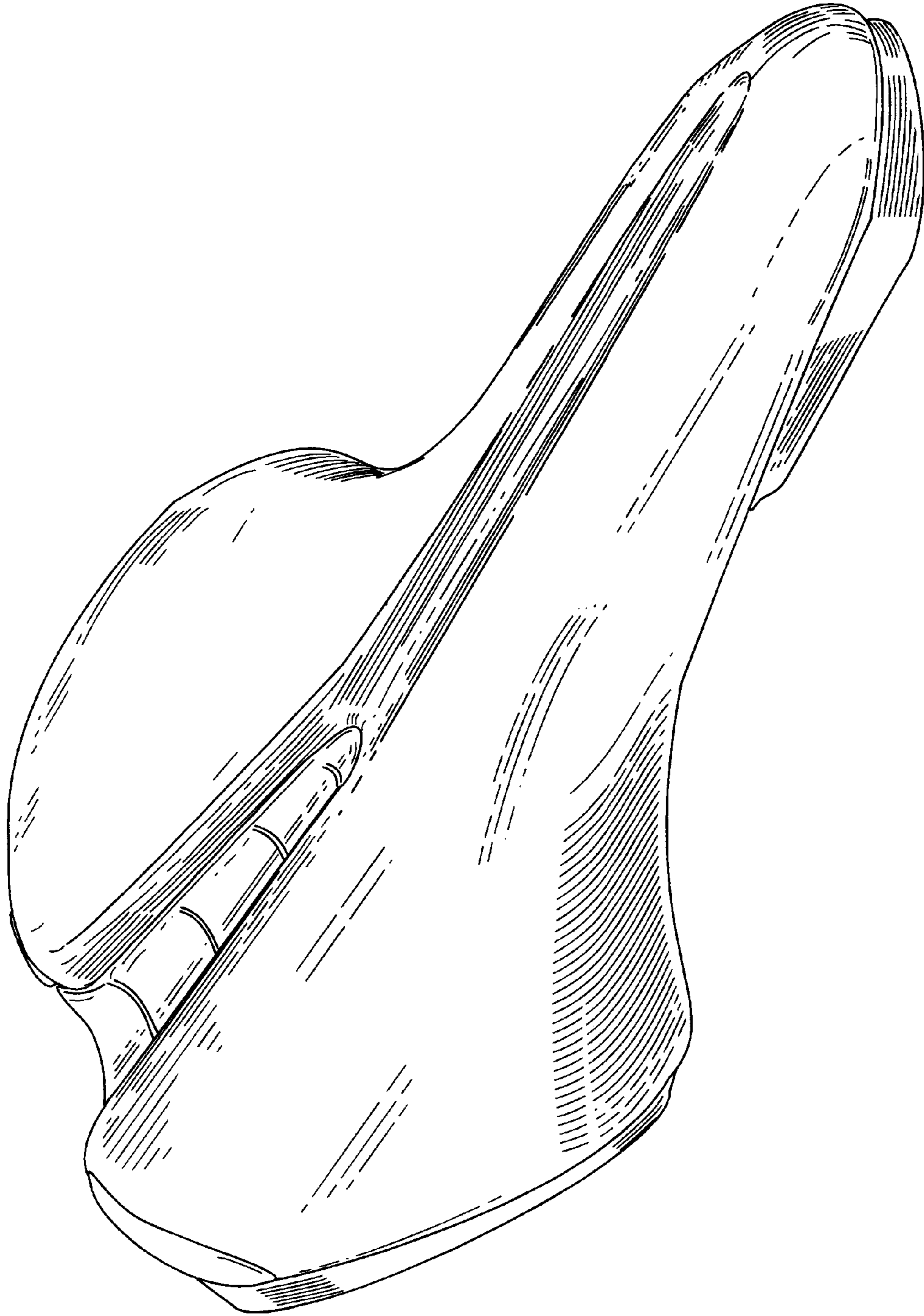

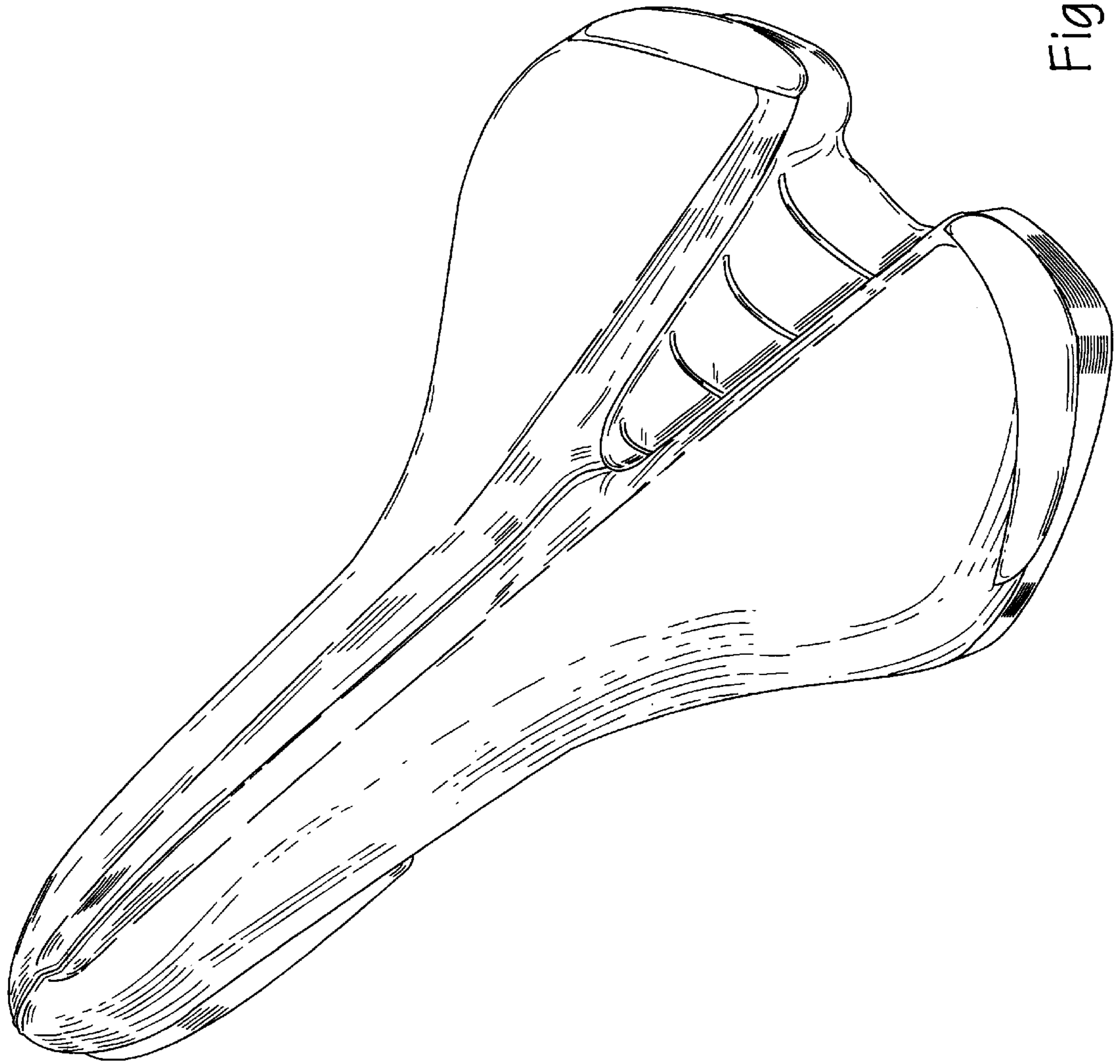

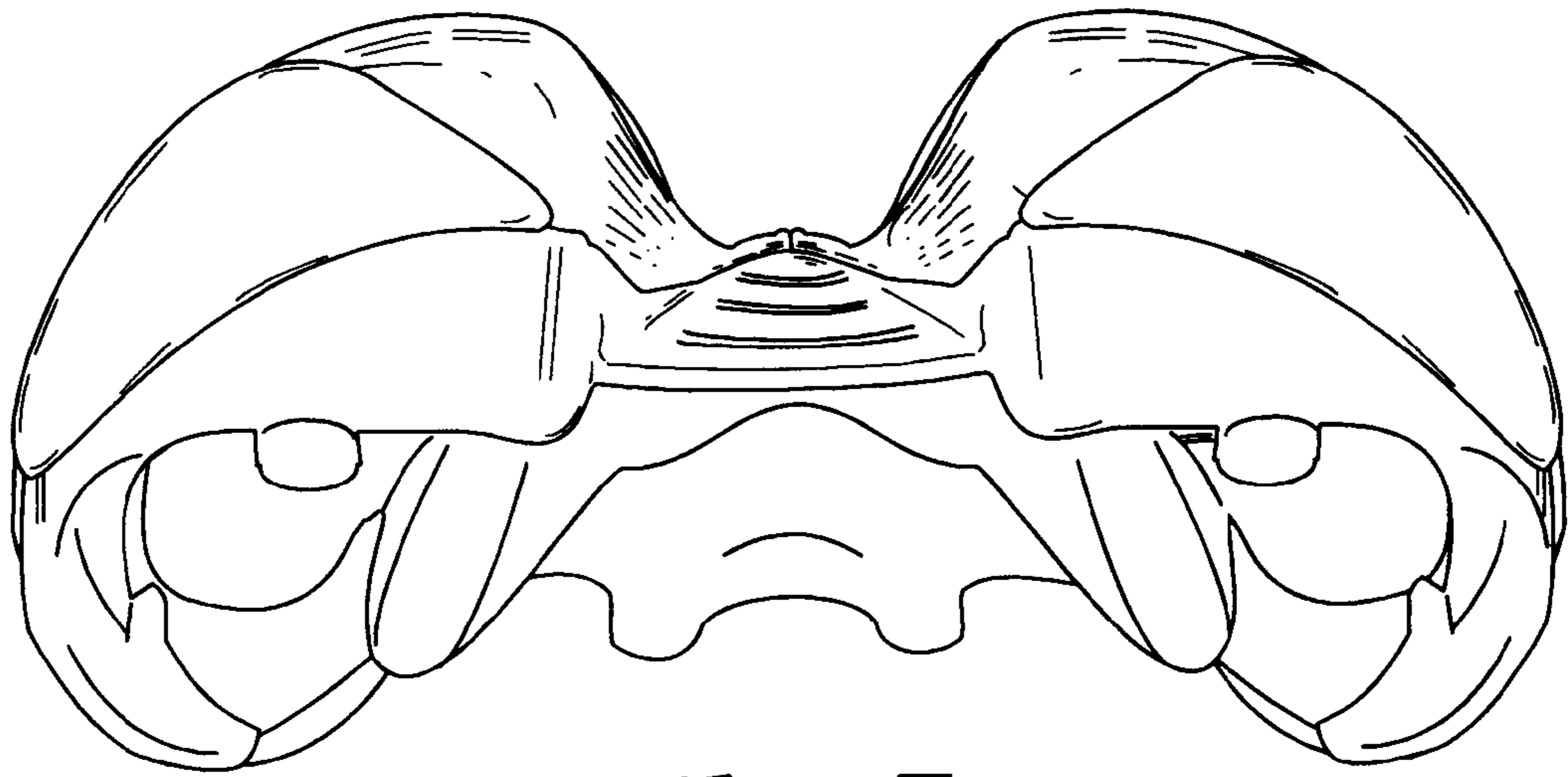

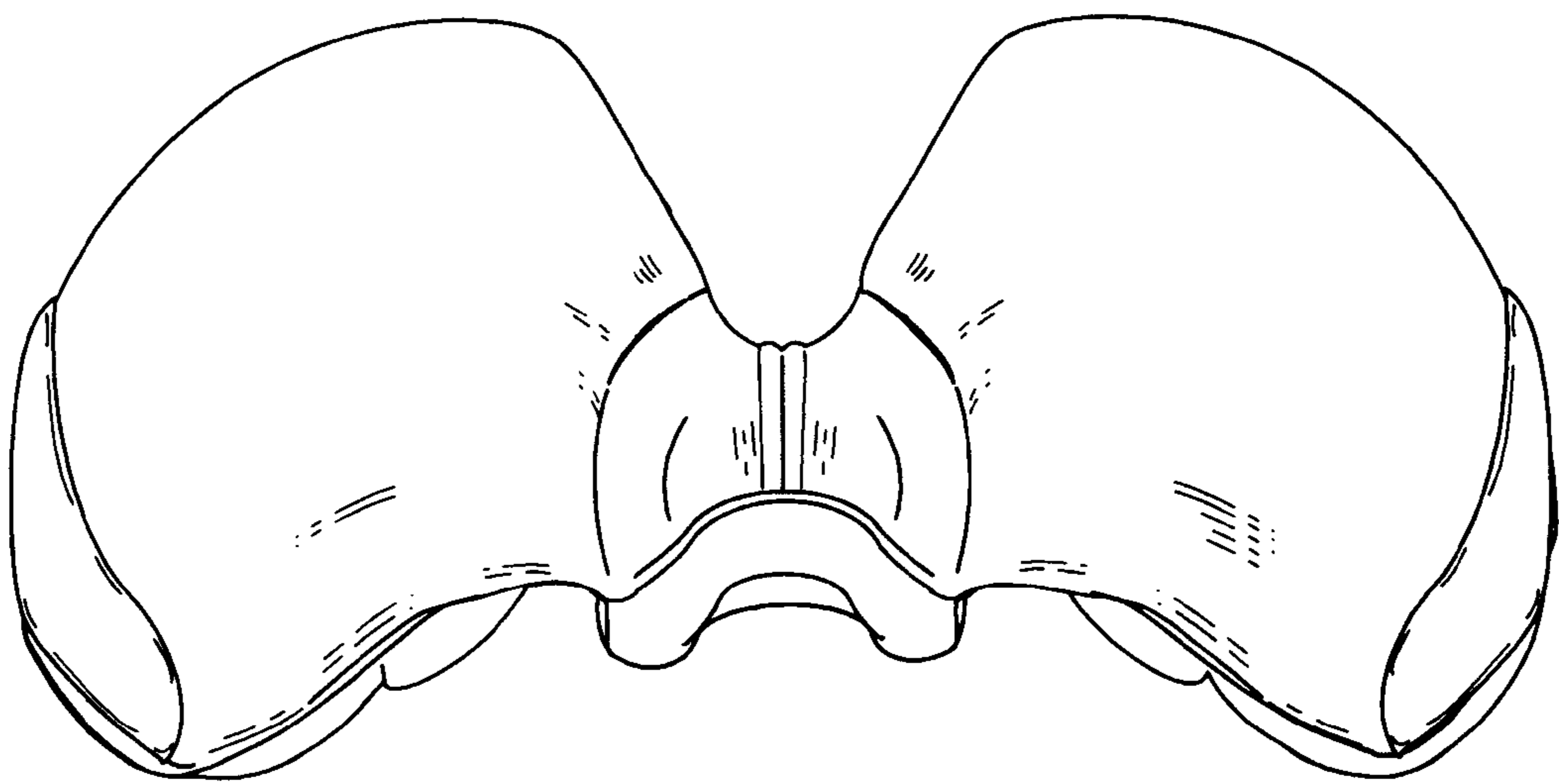

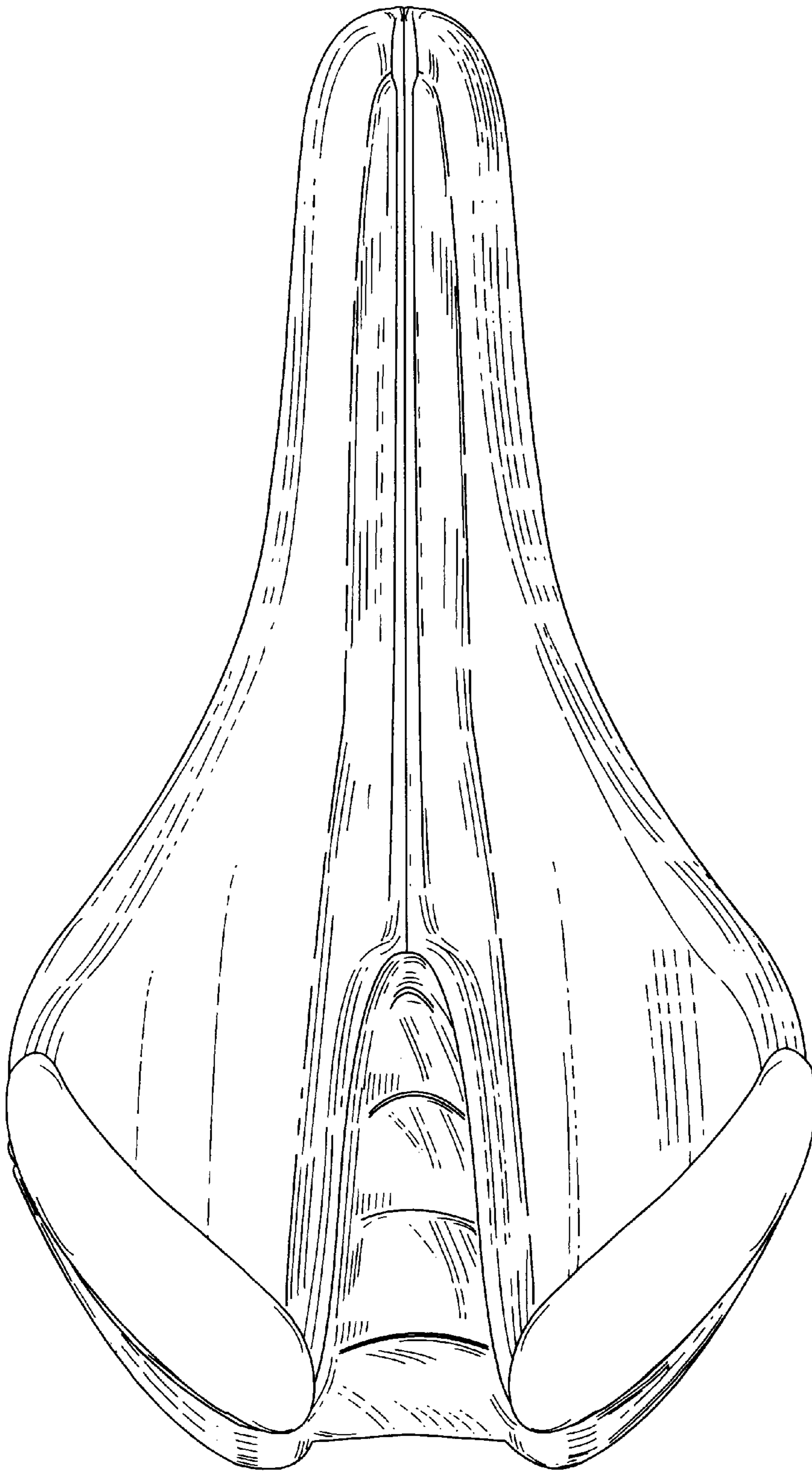

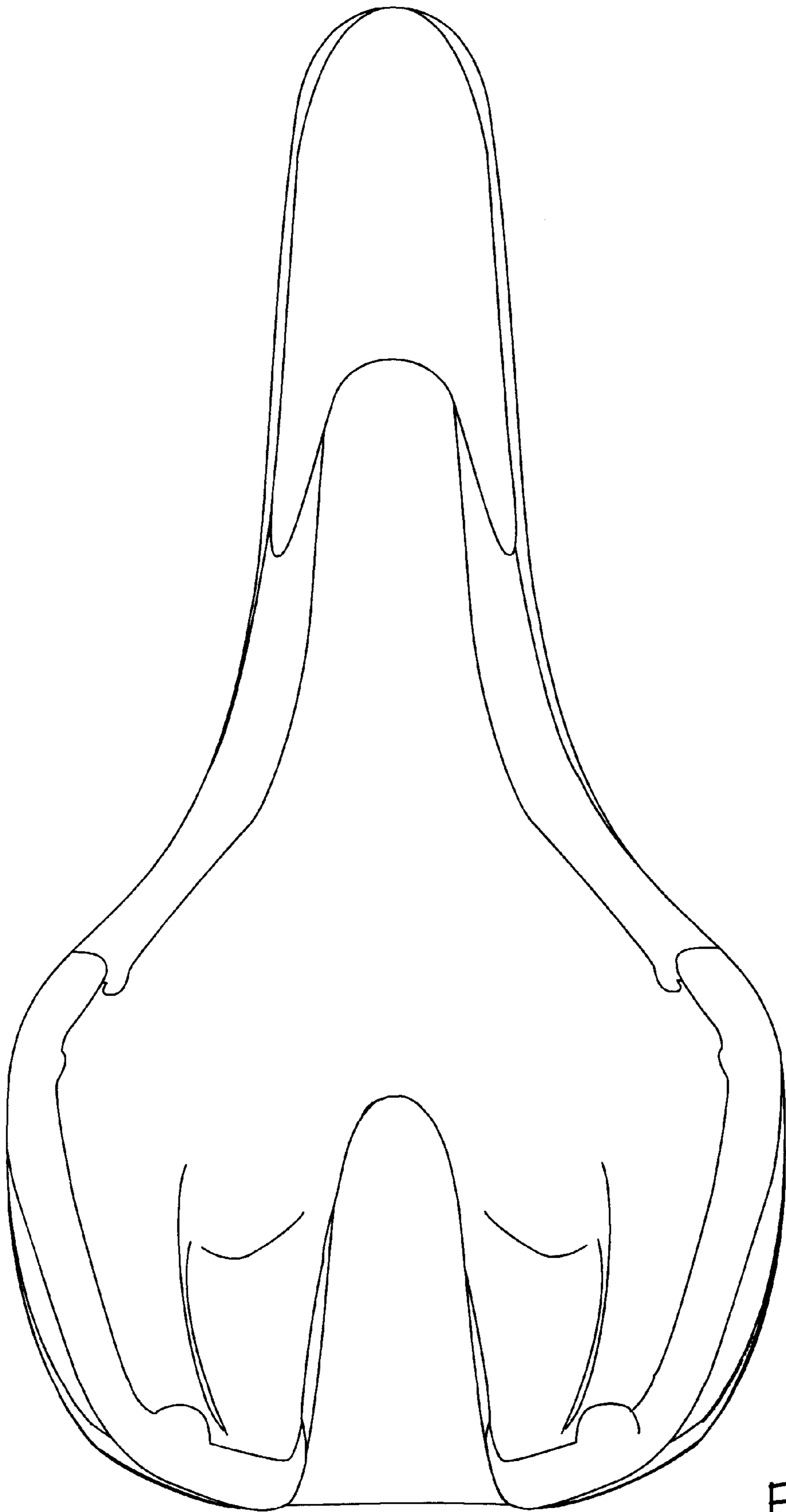

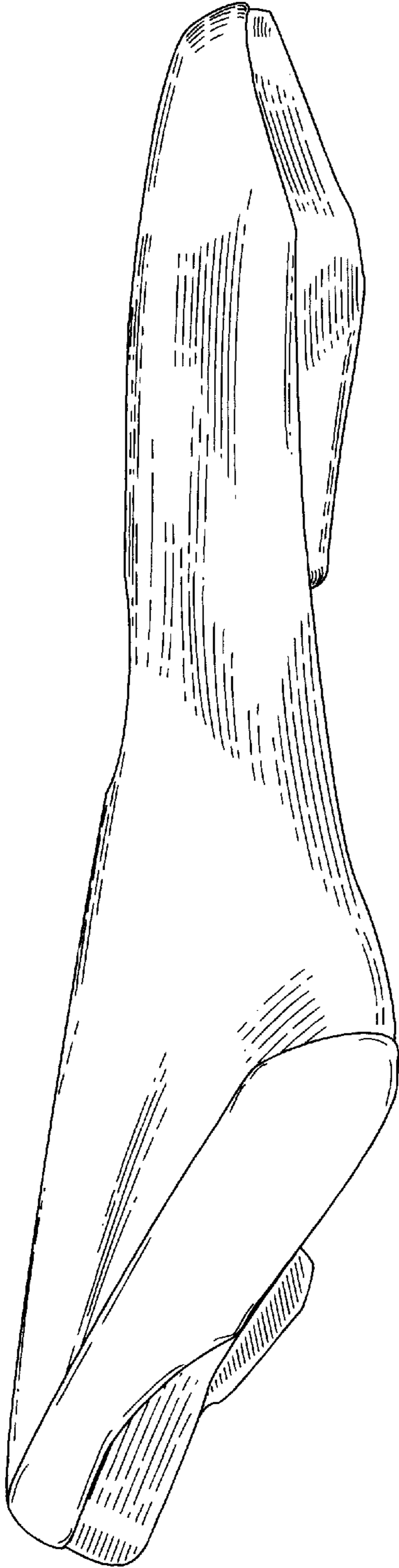

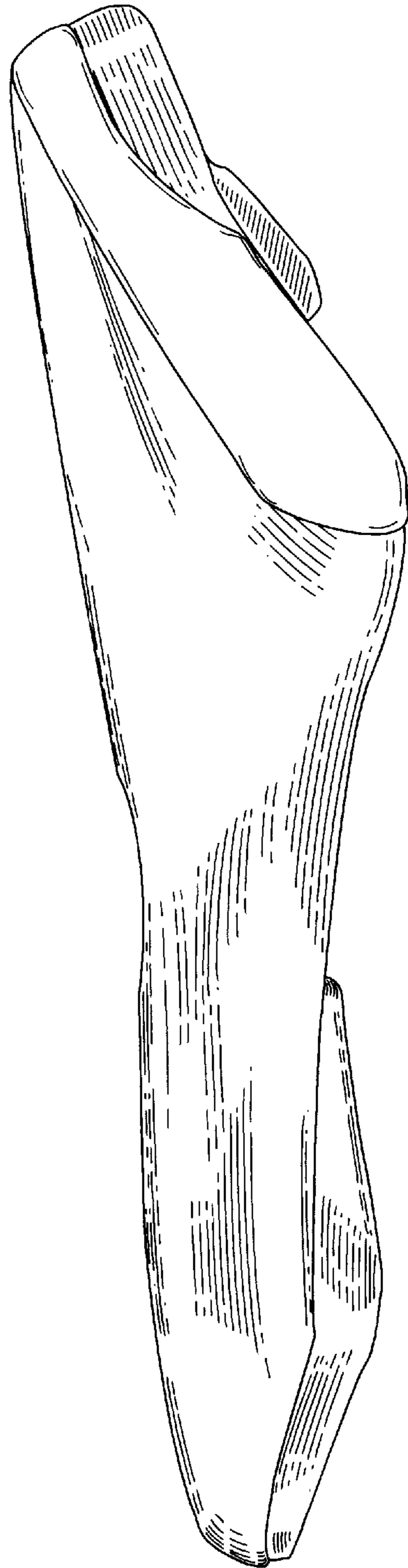
