FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

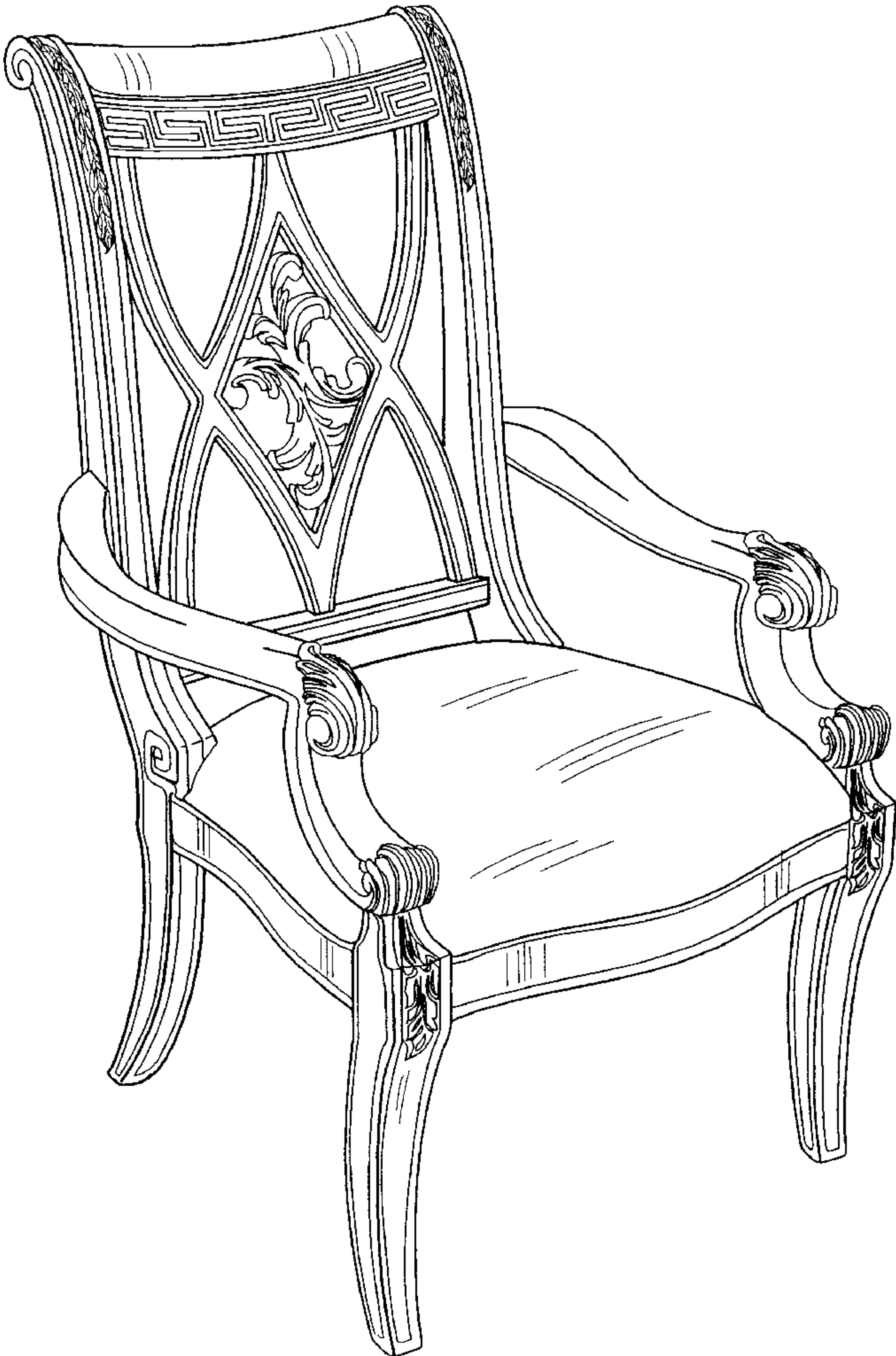
FIG. 5 is a right rear perspective view thereof;

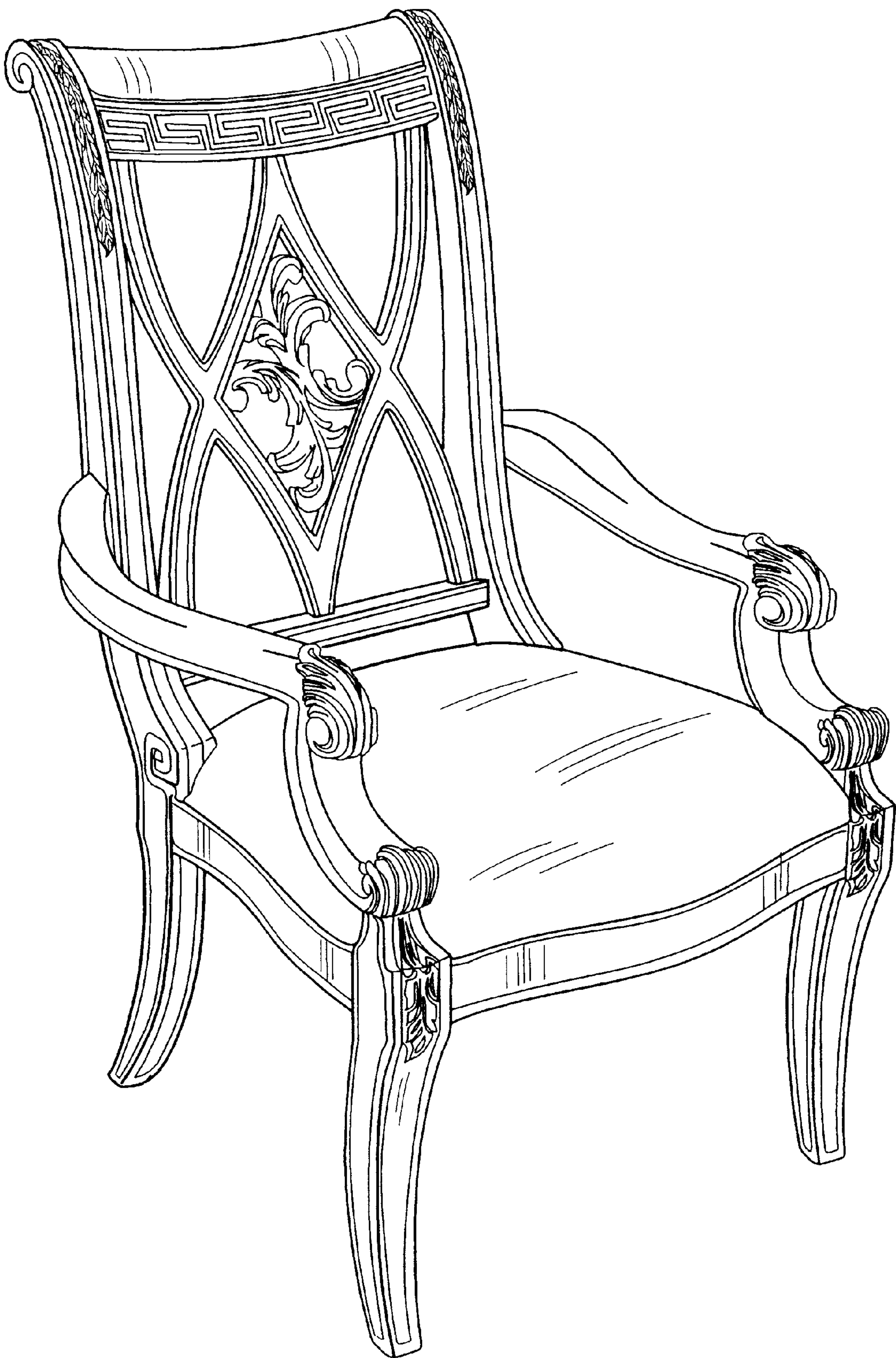

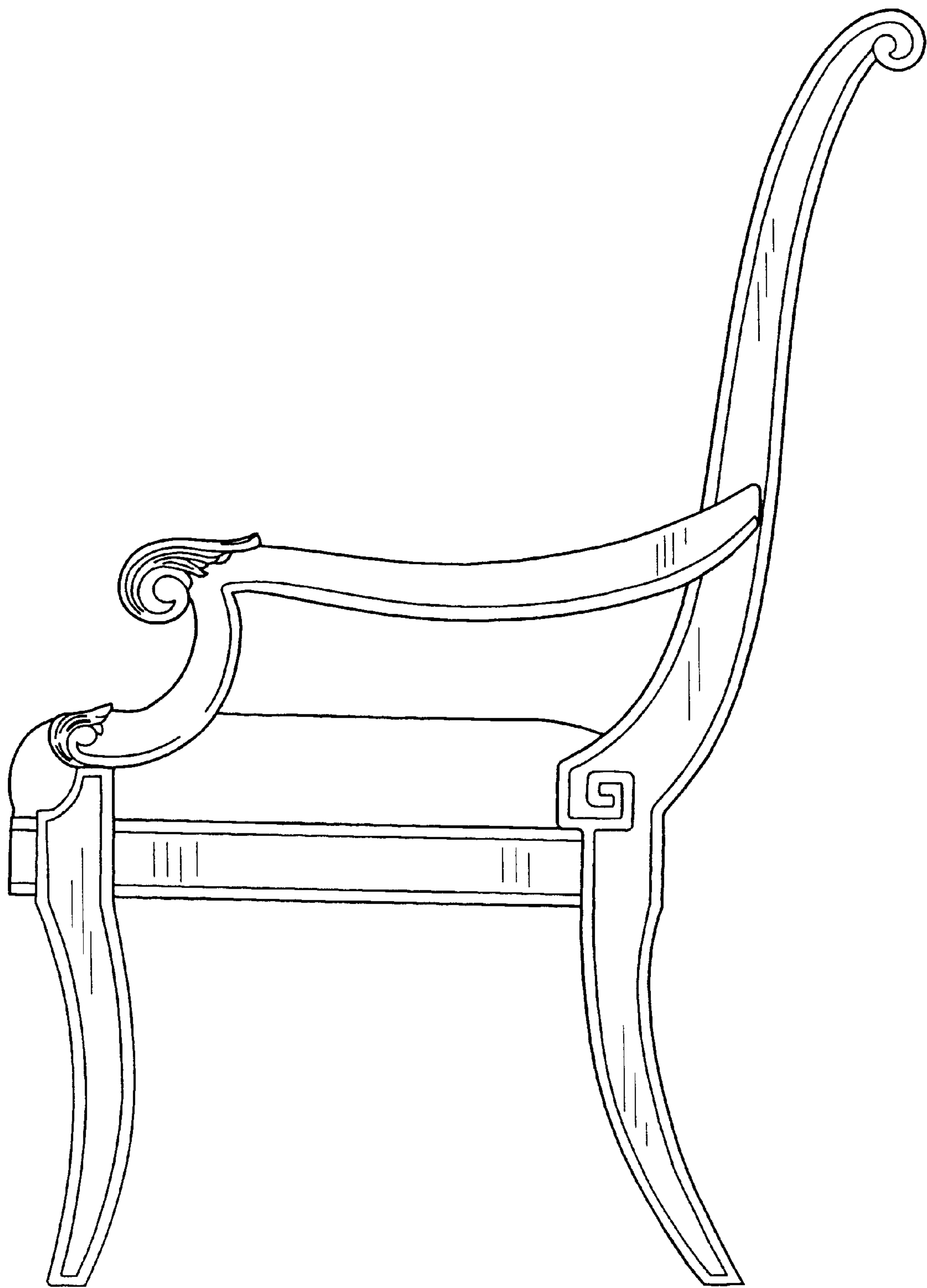

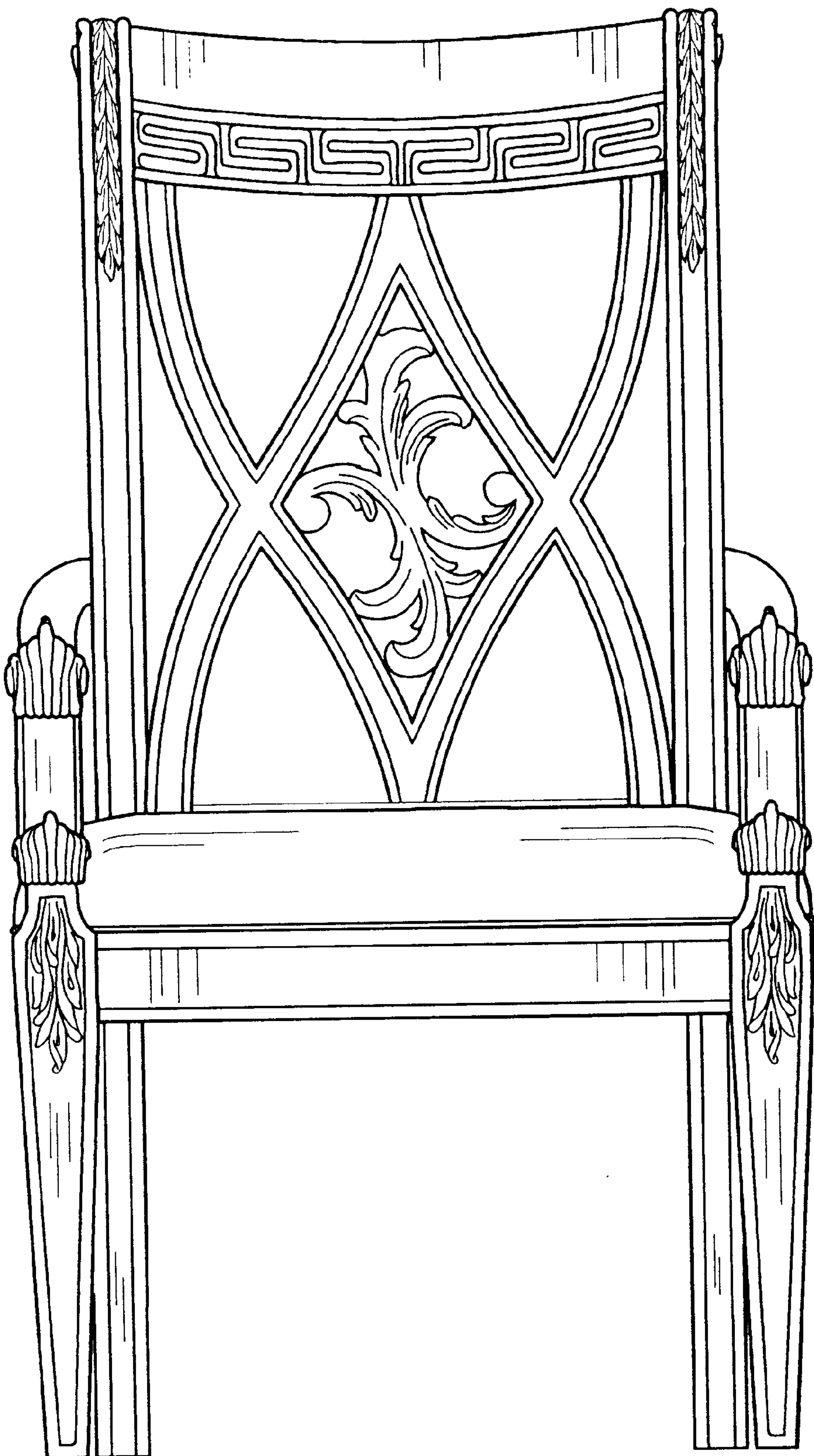

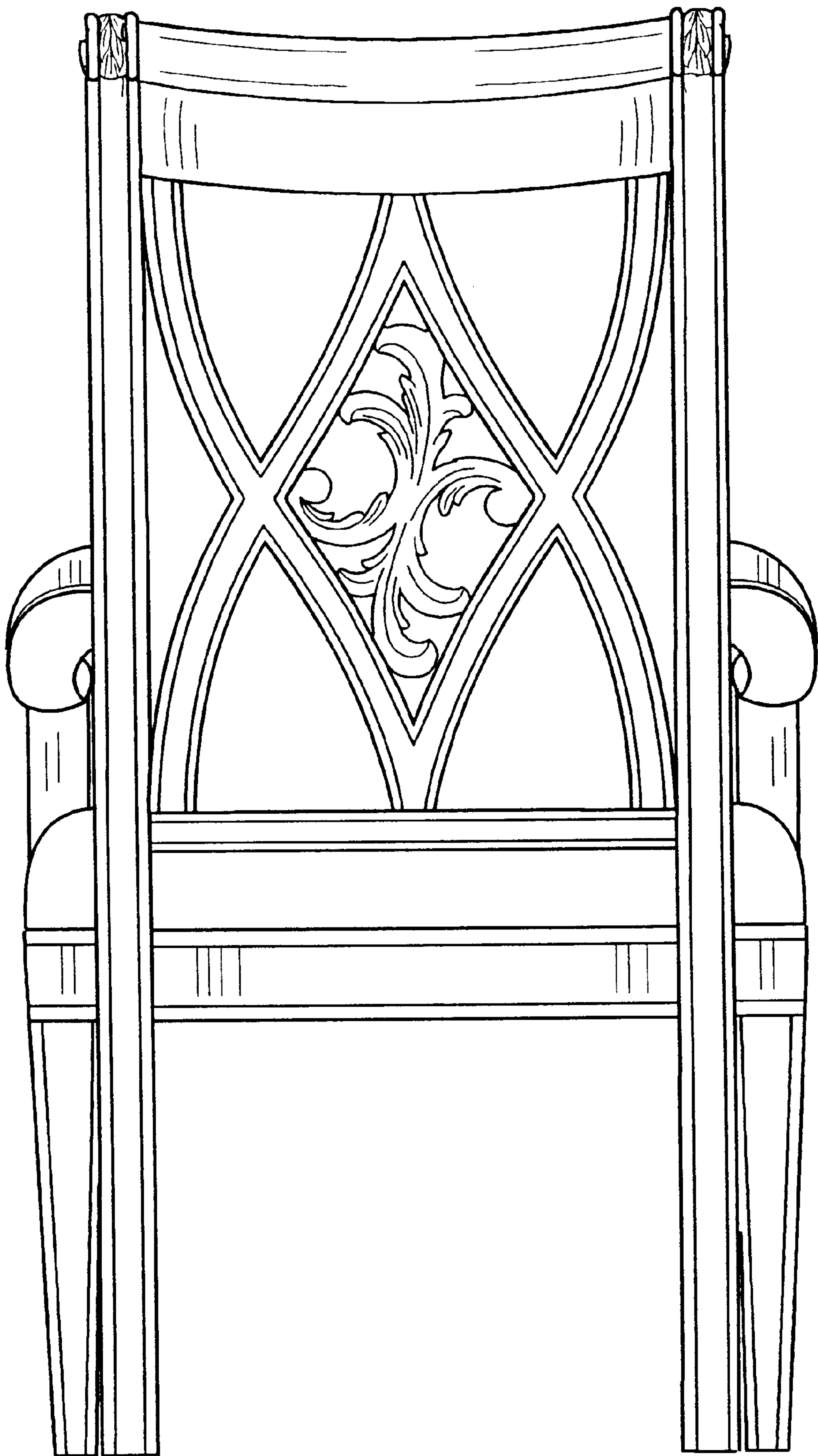

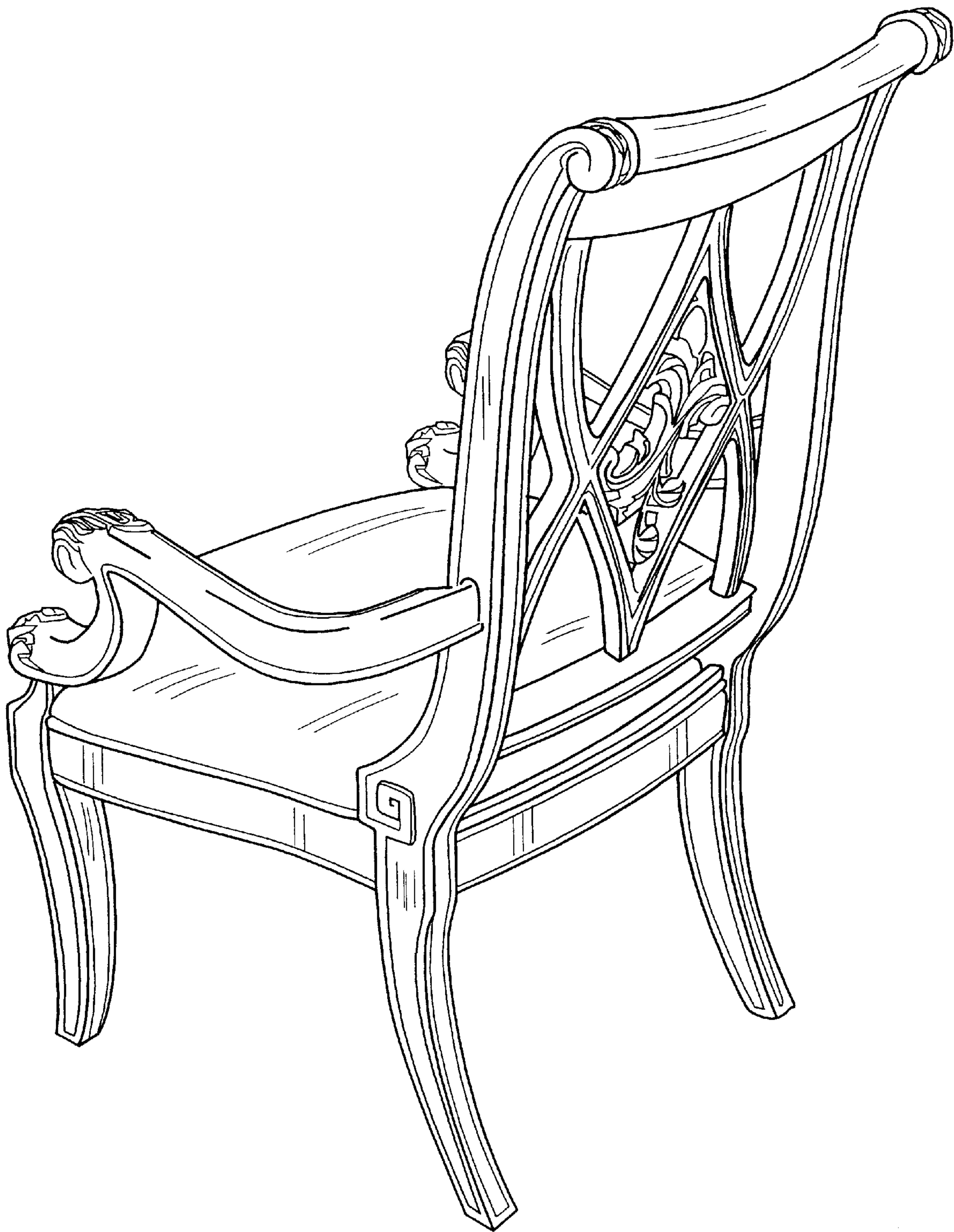

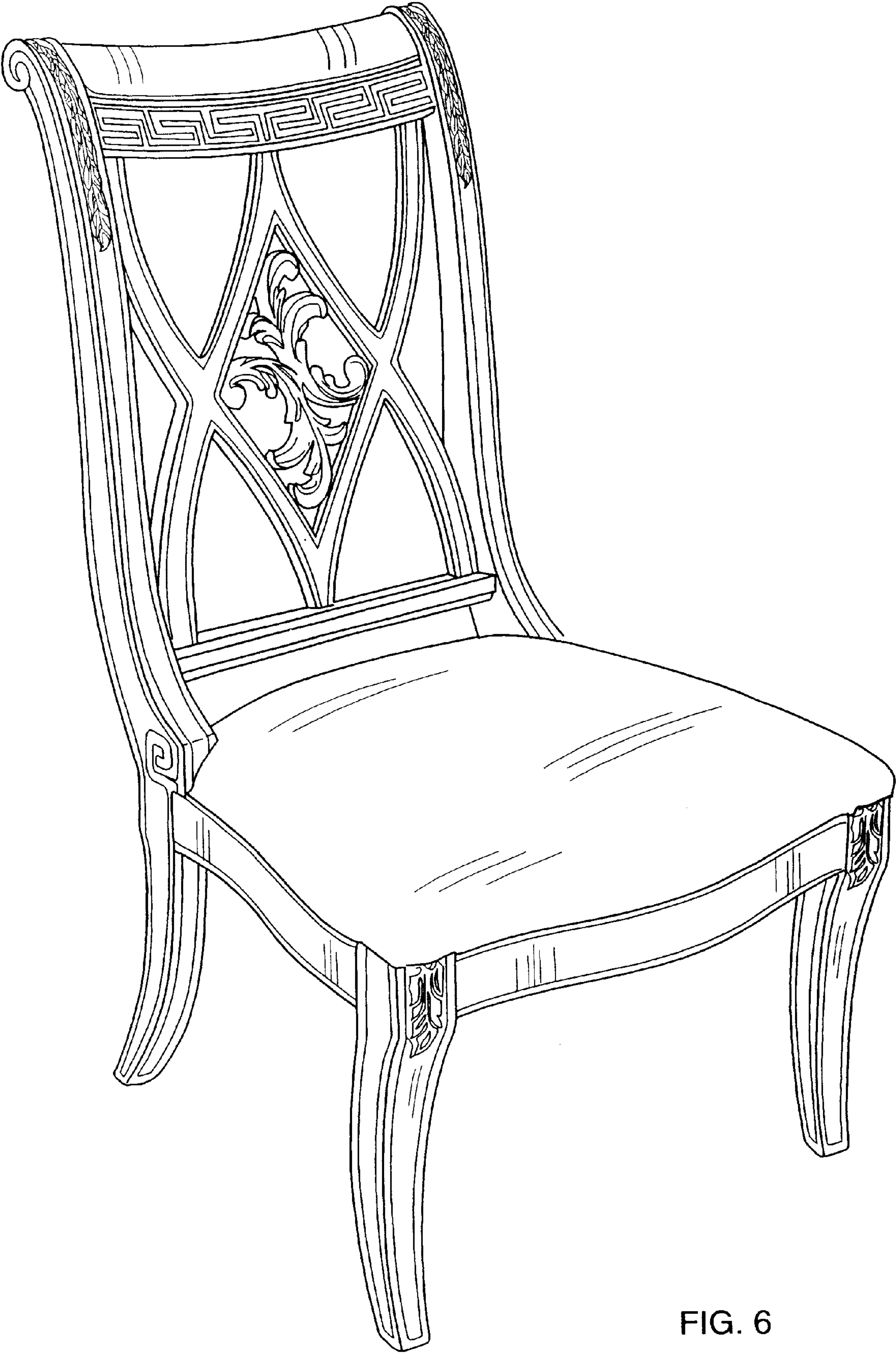

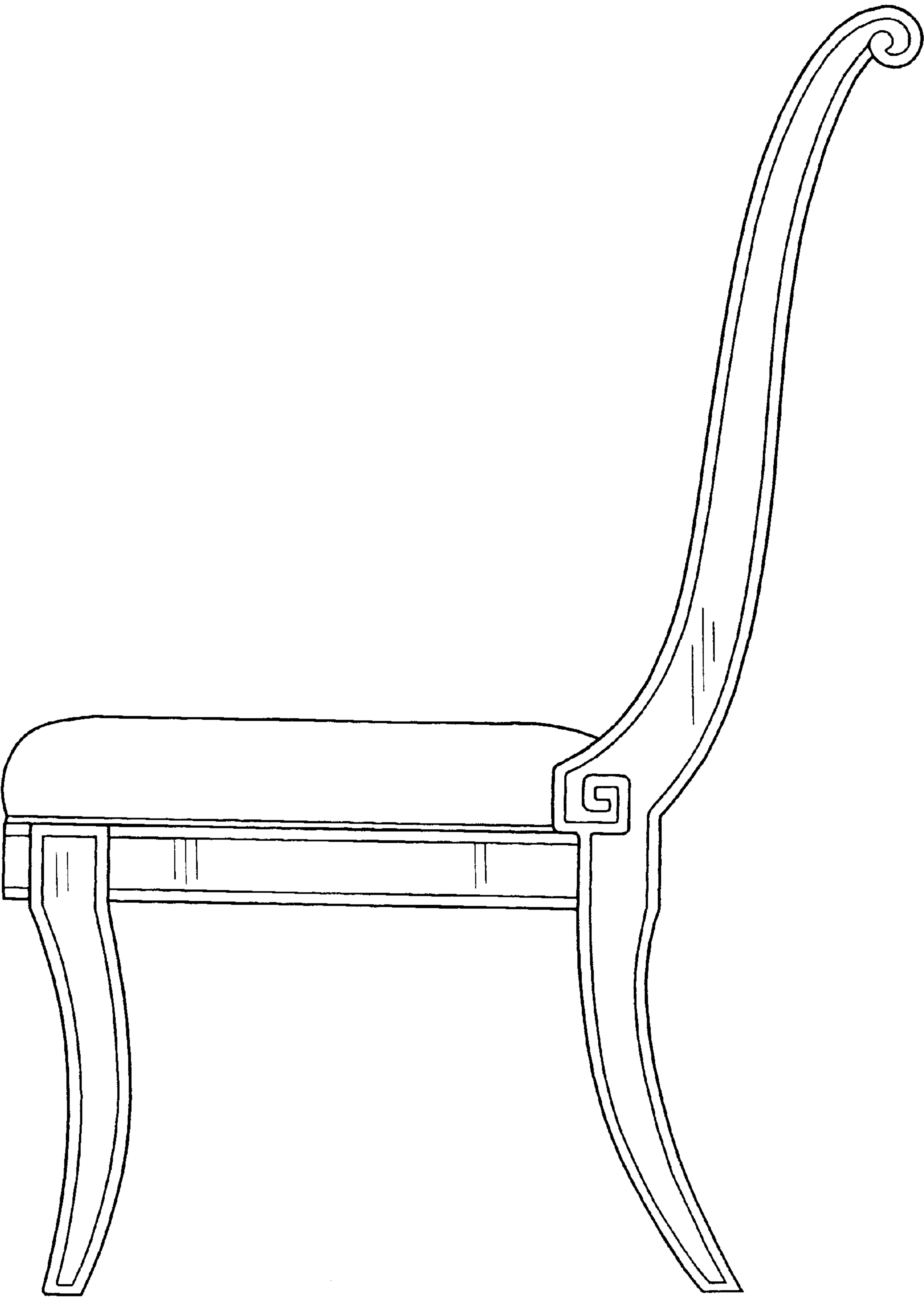
