our new design;

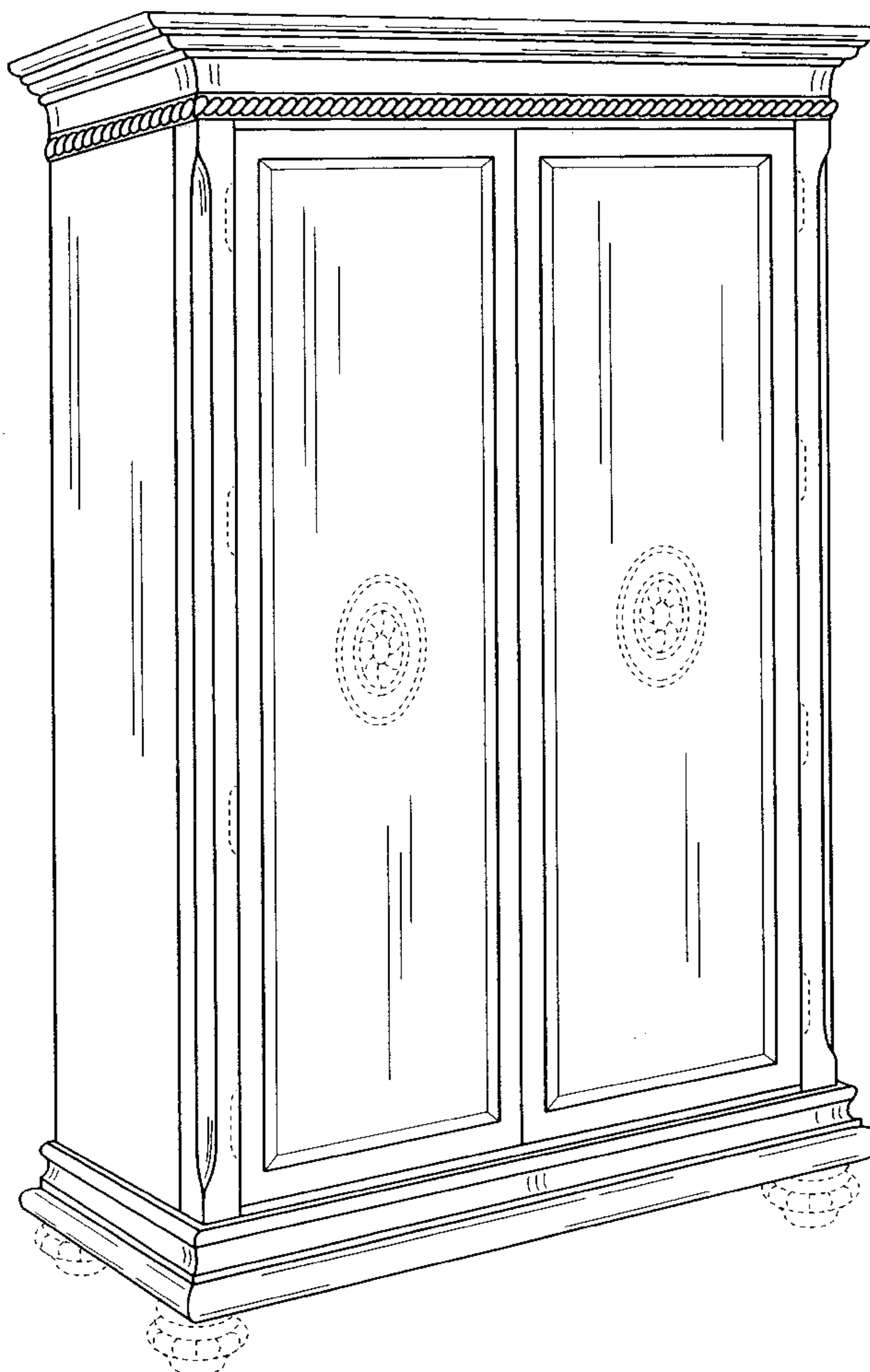
FIG. 2 is a side view, the opposite side being a mirror image

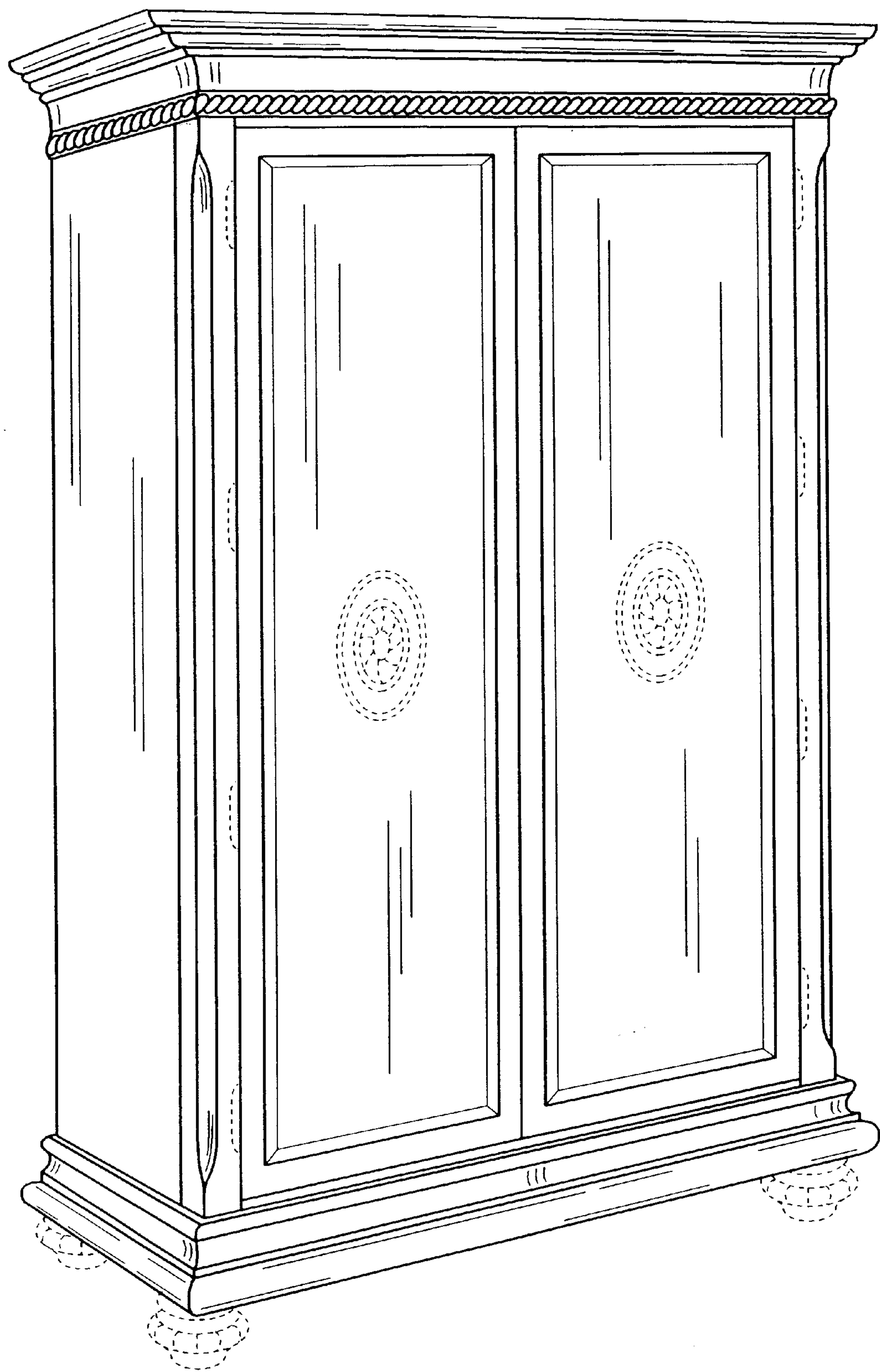

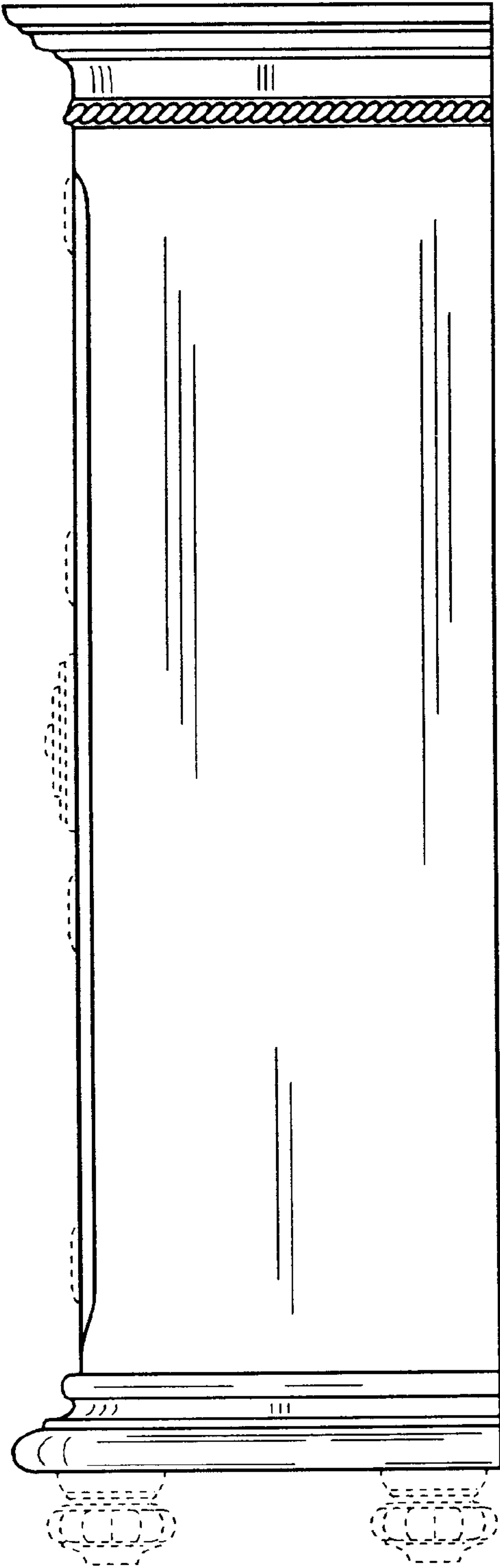

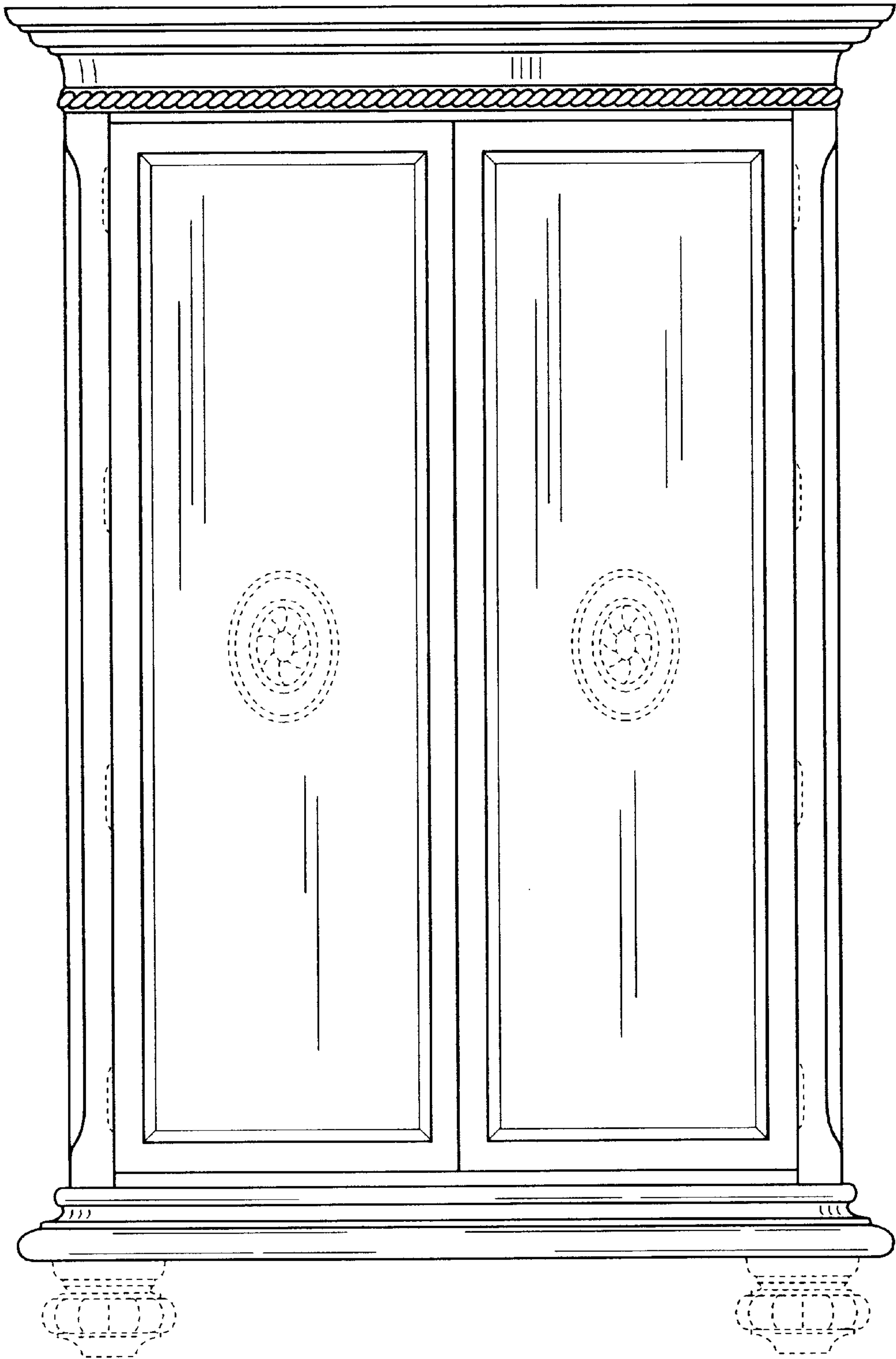

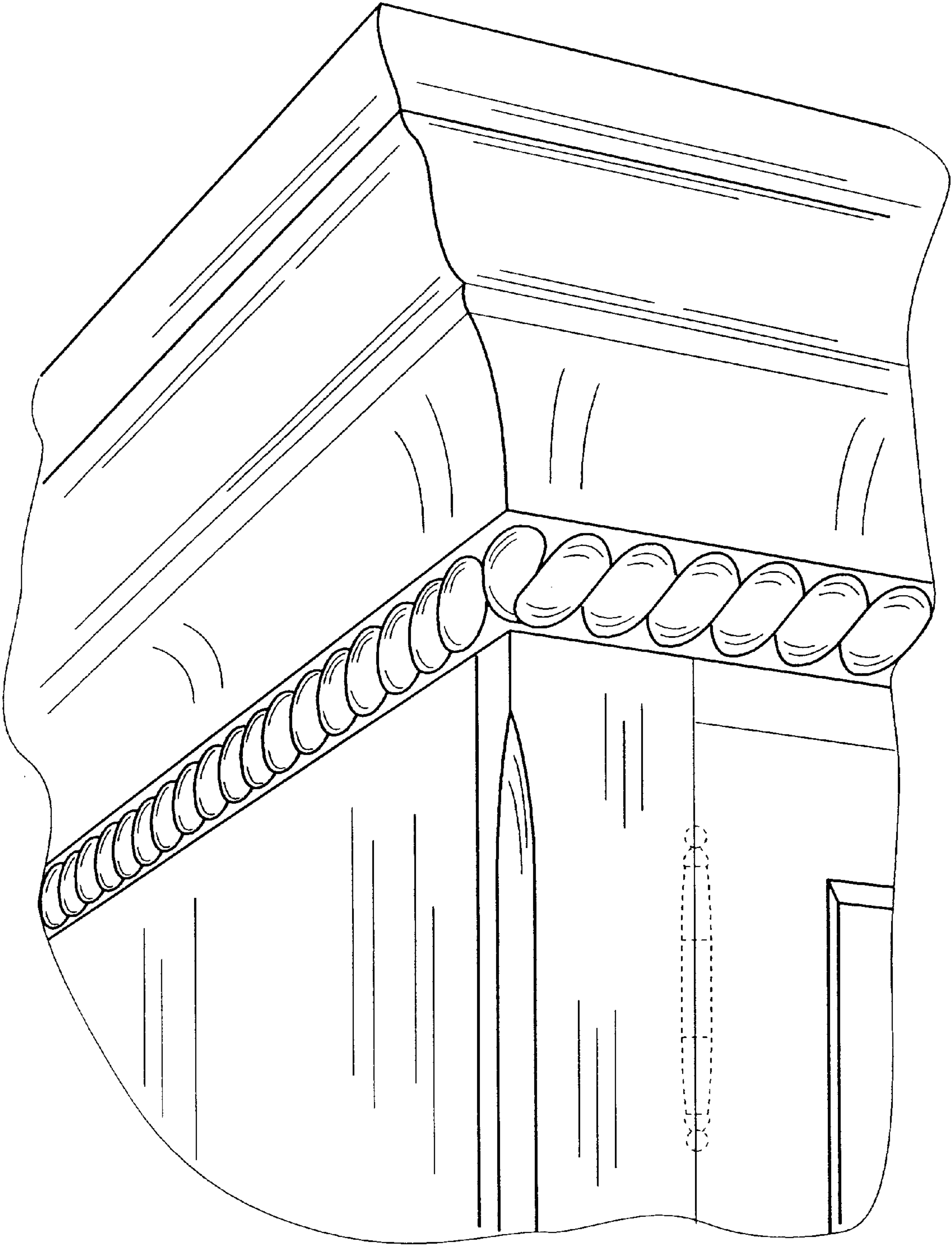
