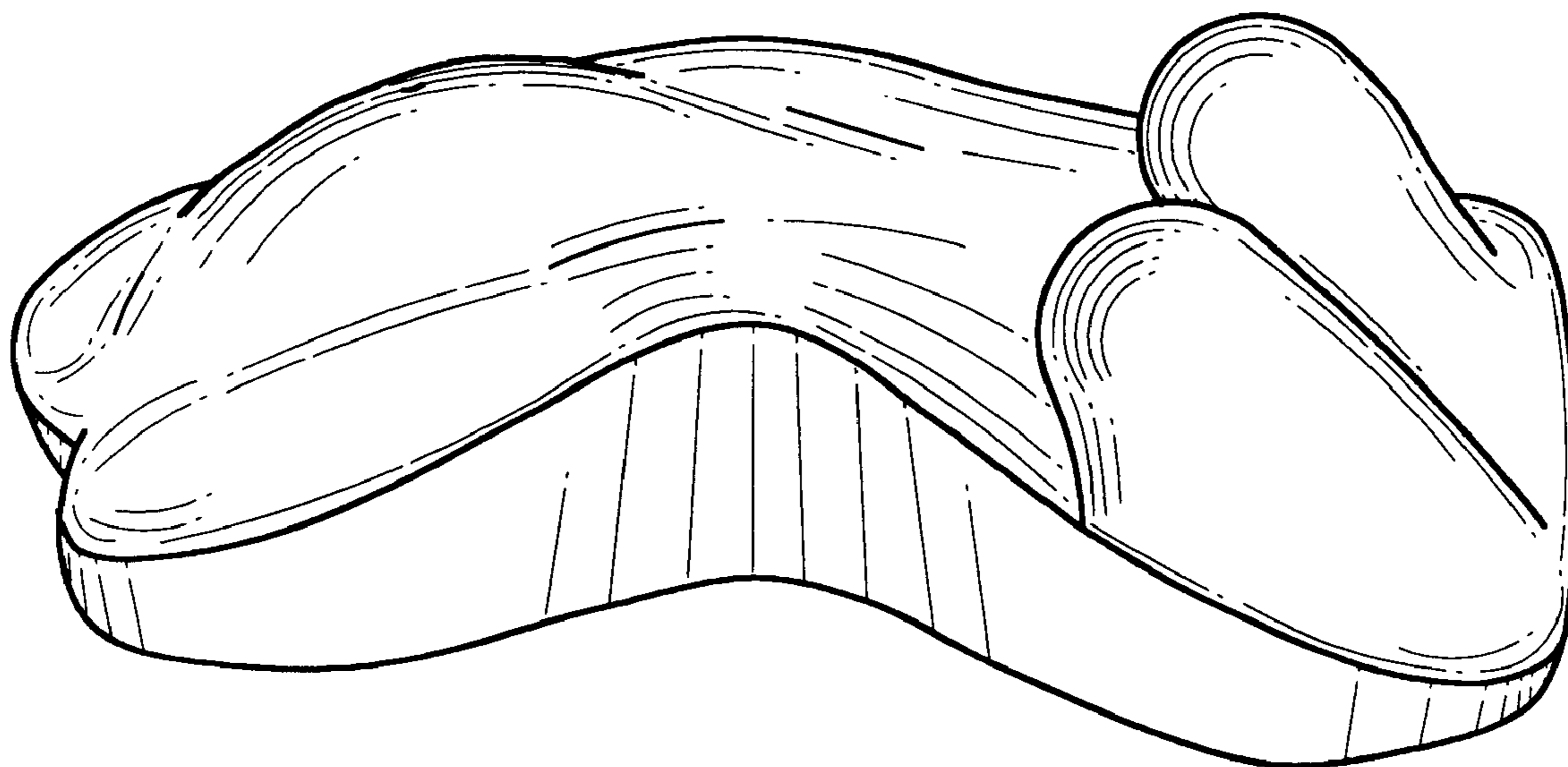
[57] **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a computer mouse, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a computer mouse showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The bottom of the computer mouse forms no part of the claimed design.

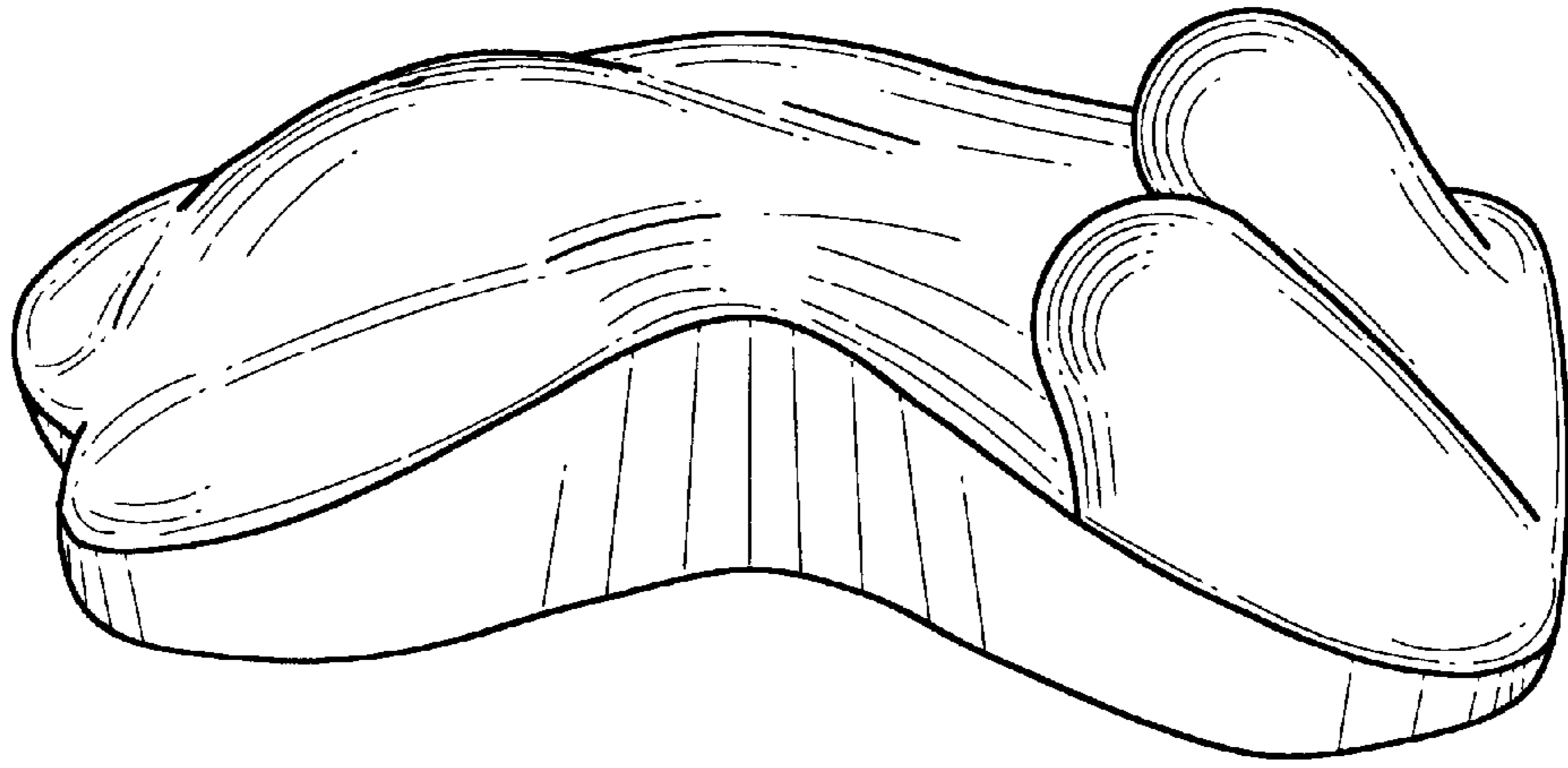

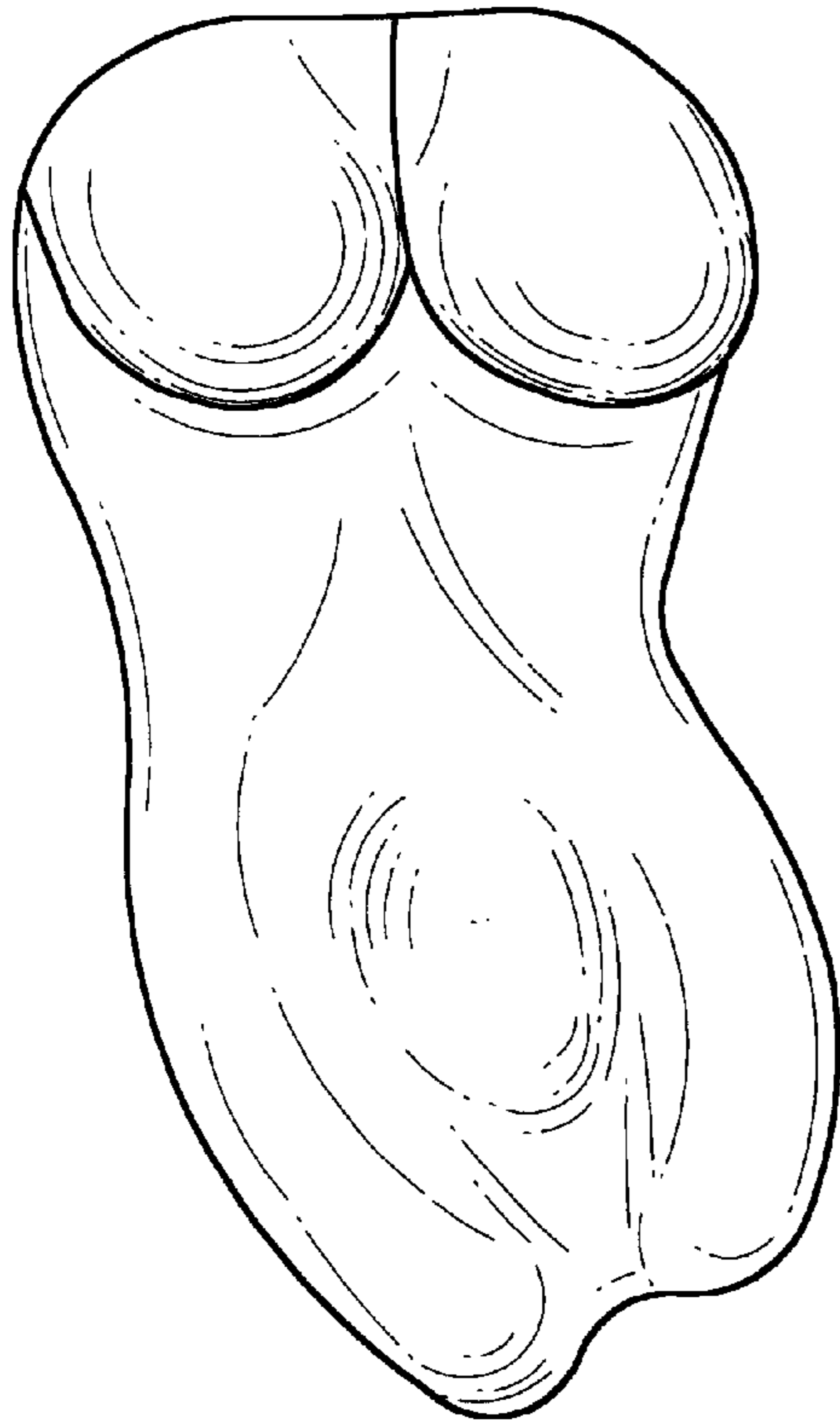

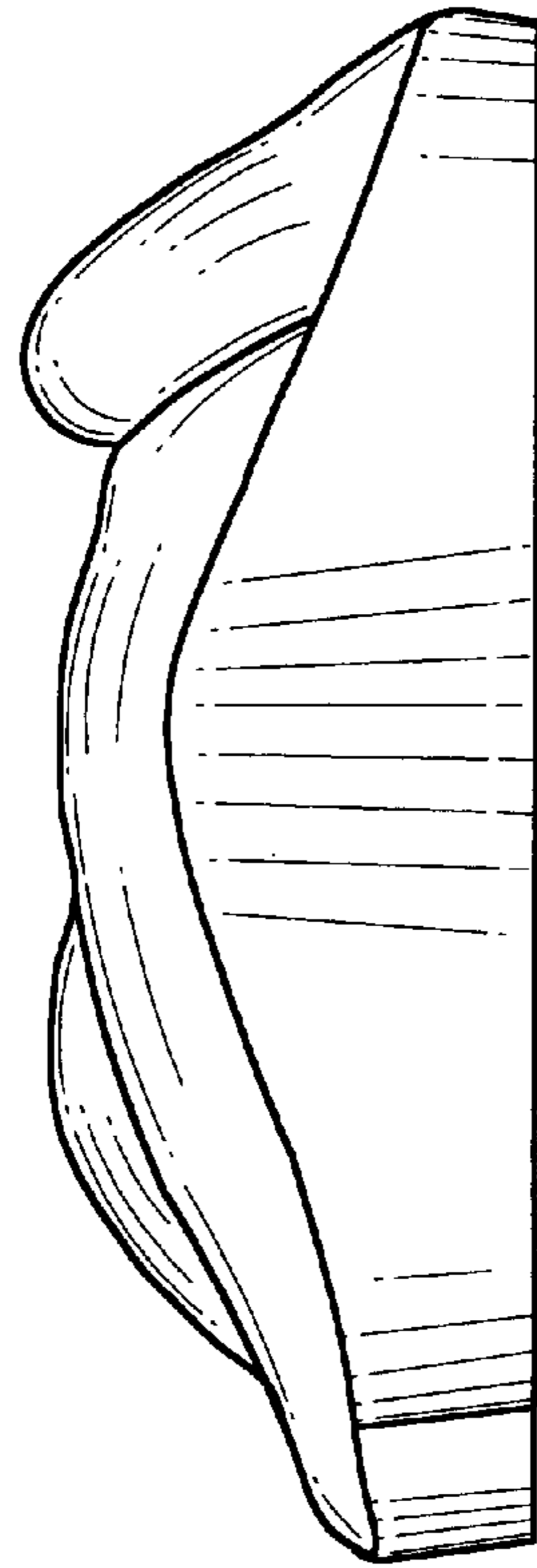

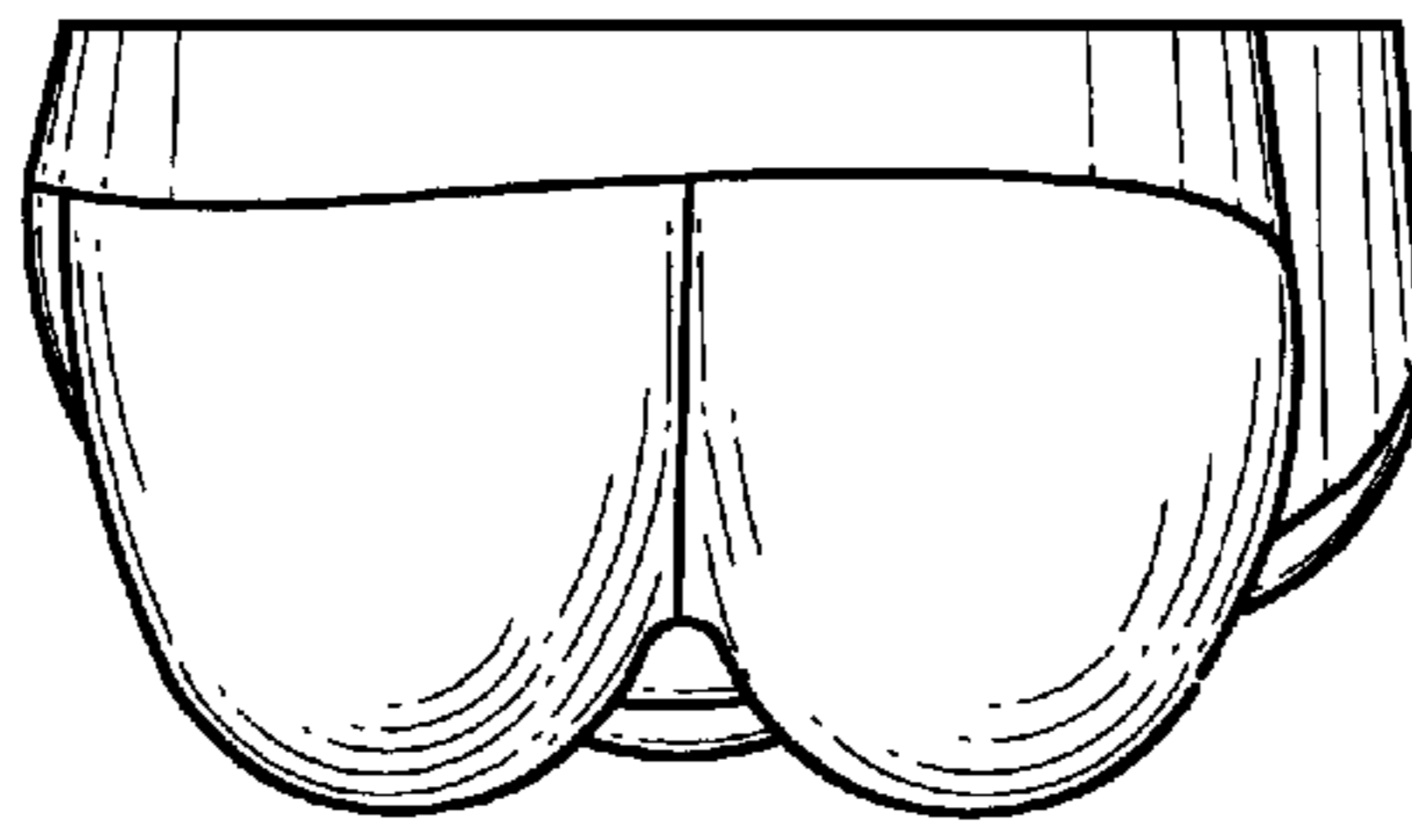

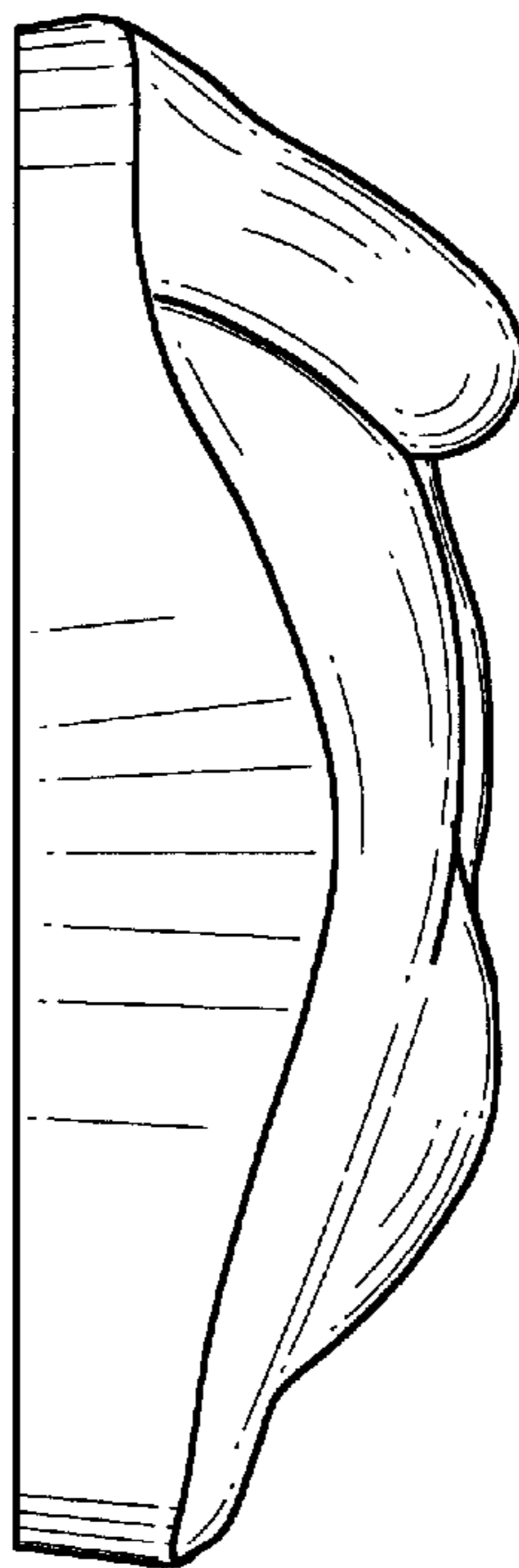

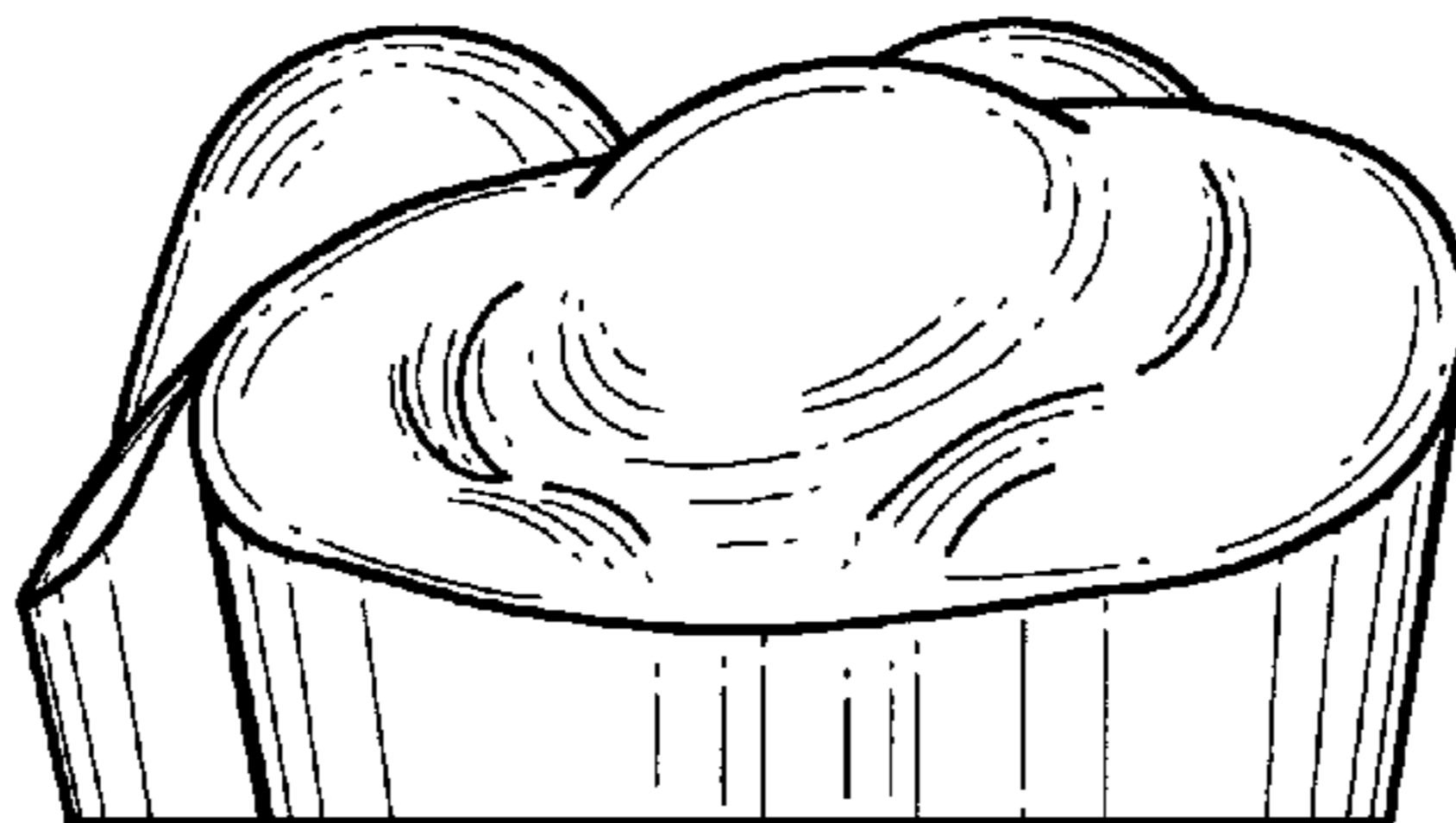
