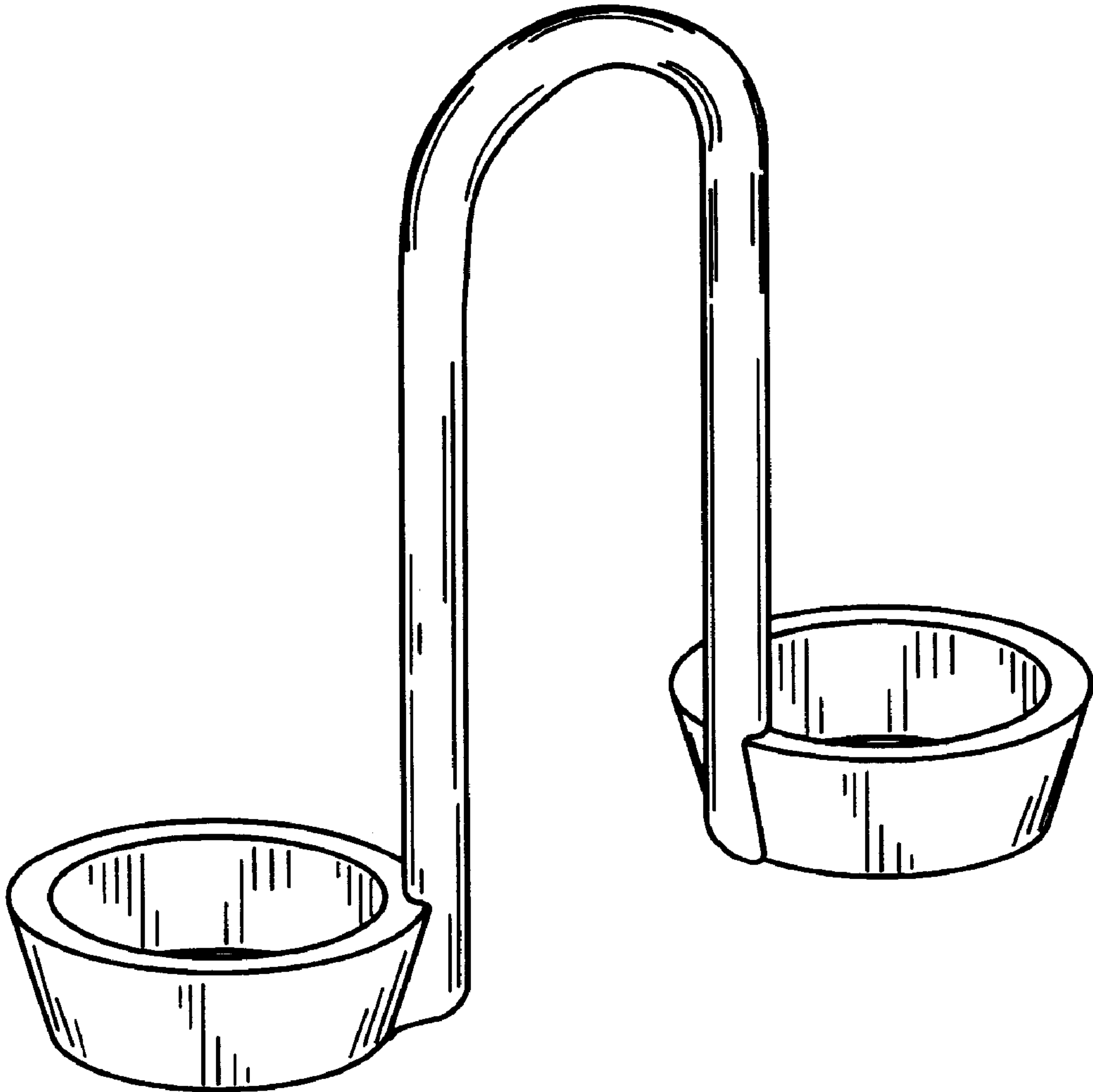

dilation device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tapered ring nasal passage
dilation device showing my new design;

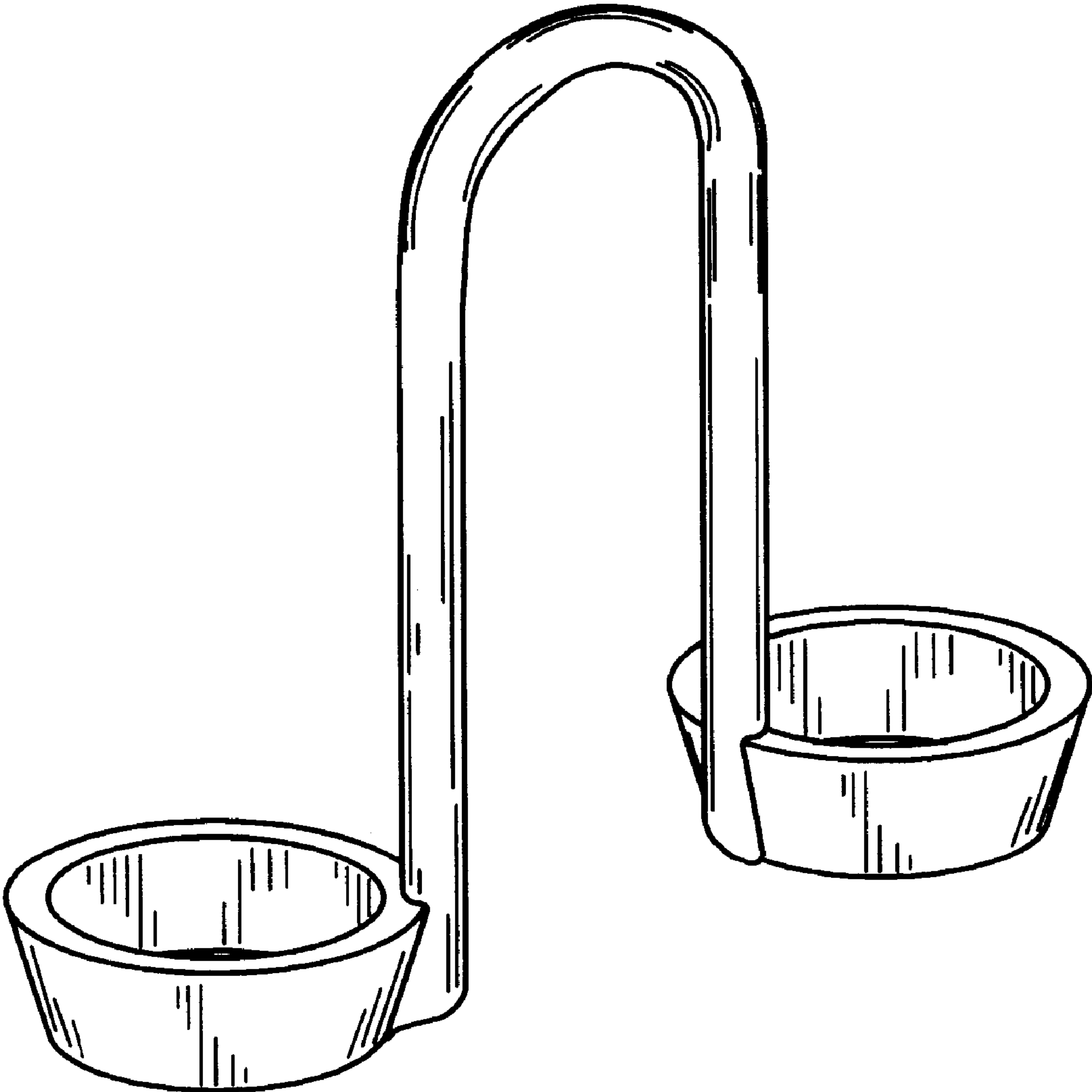

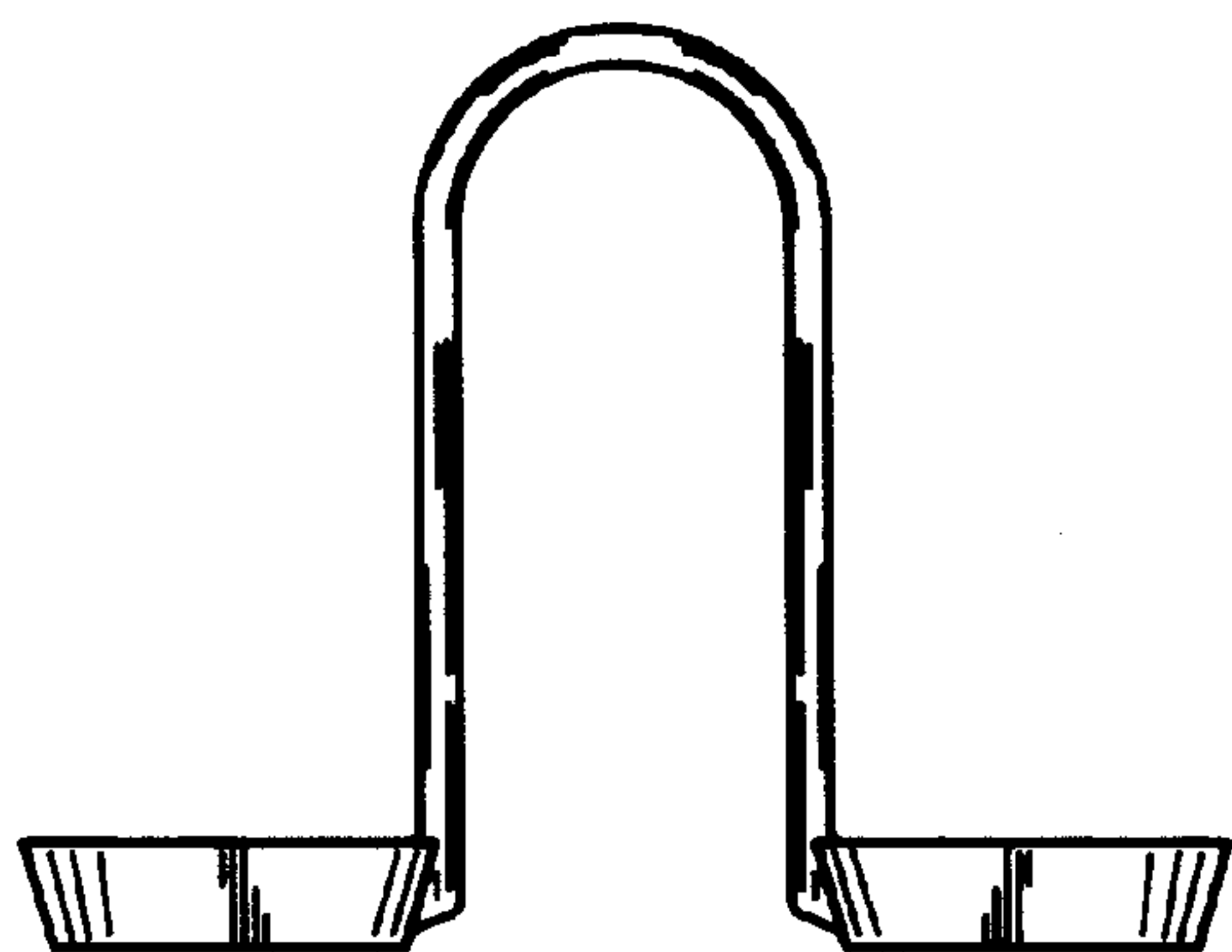

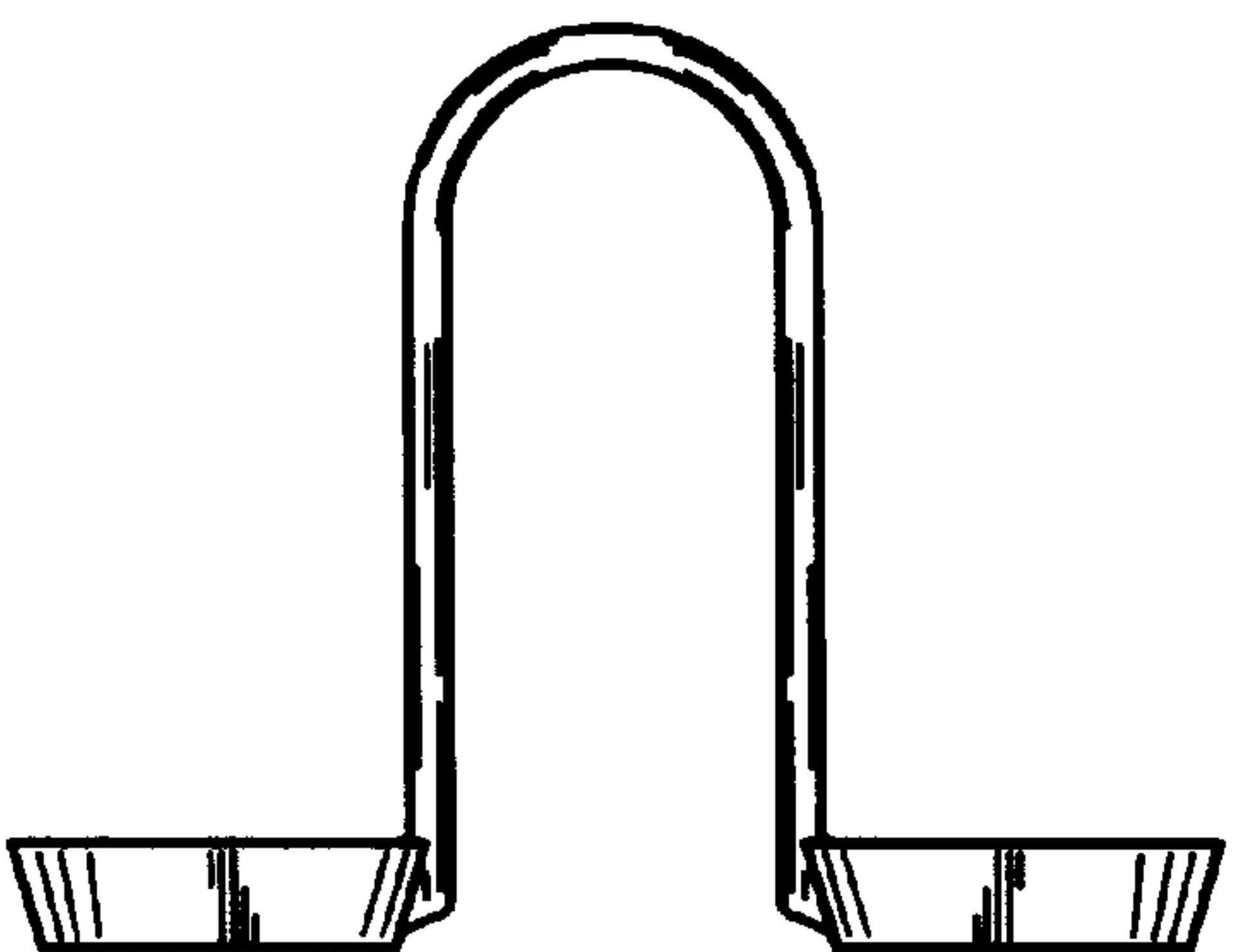

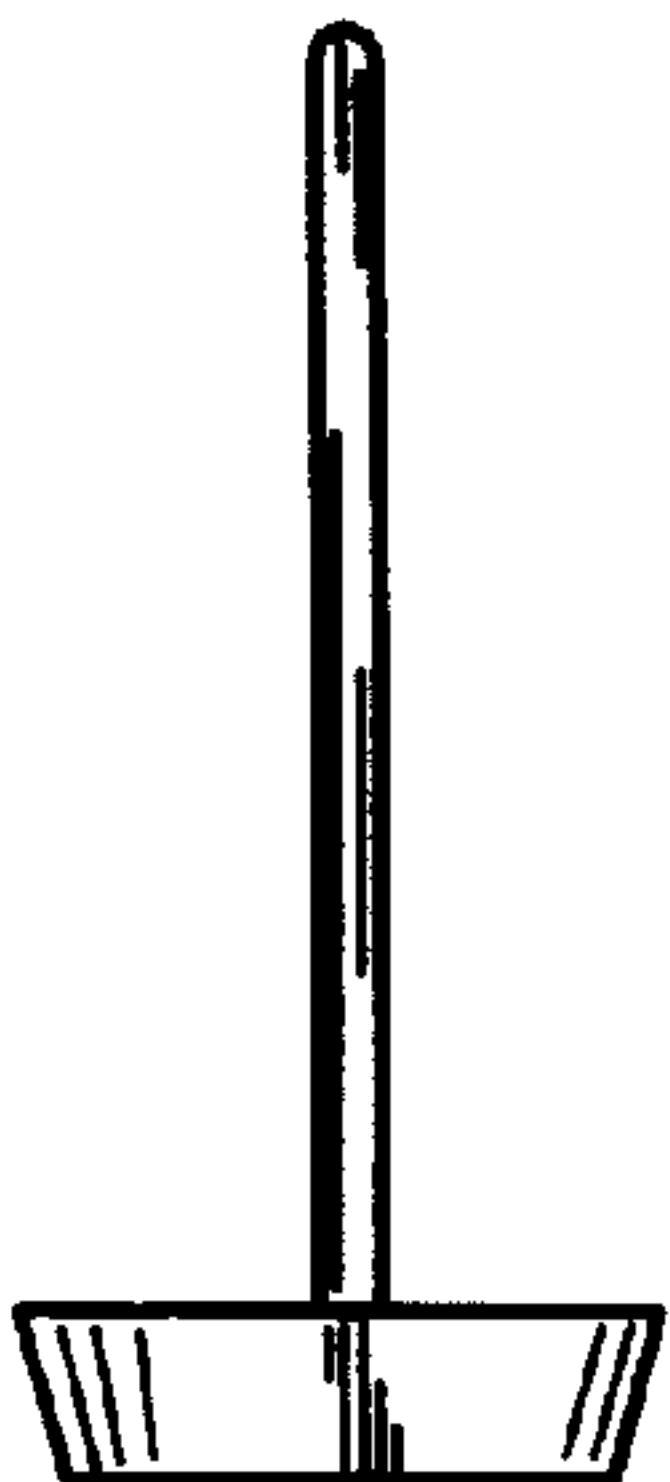

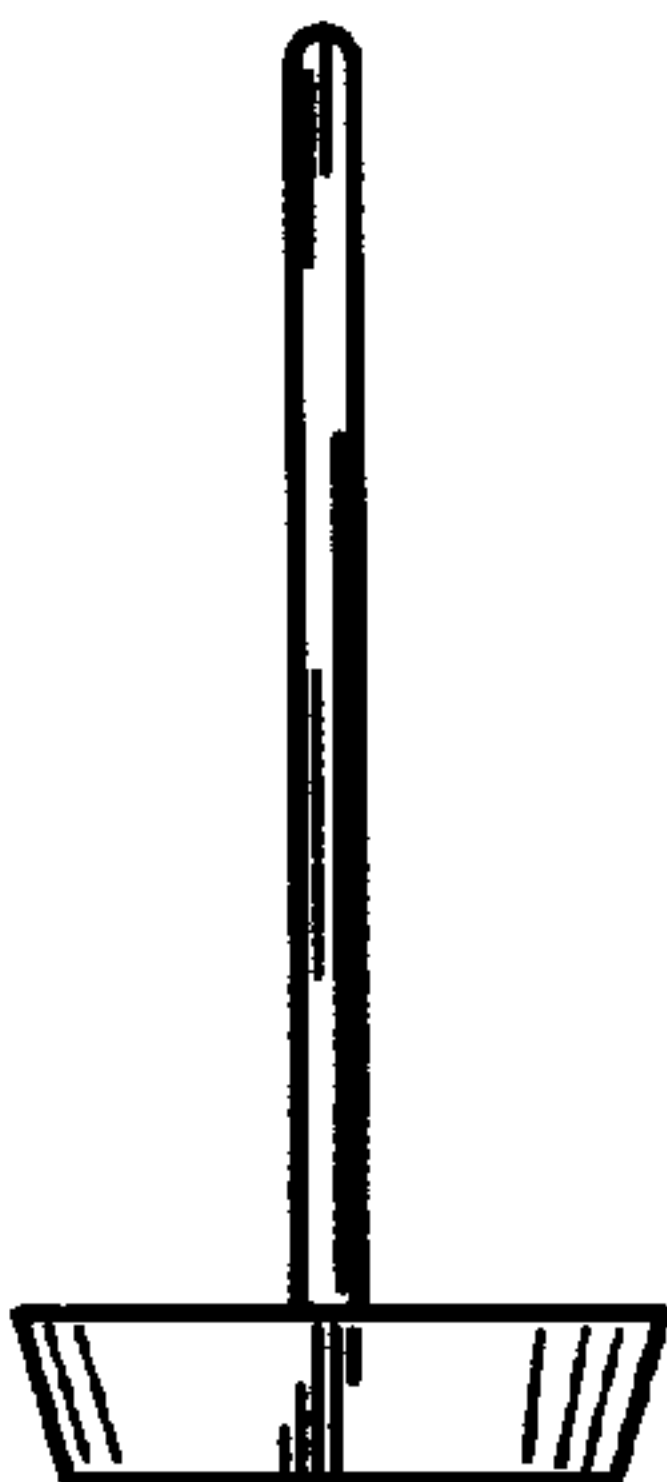

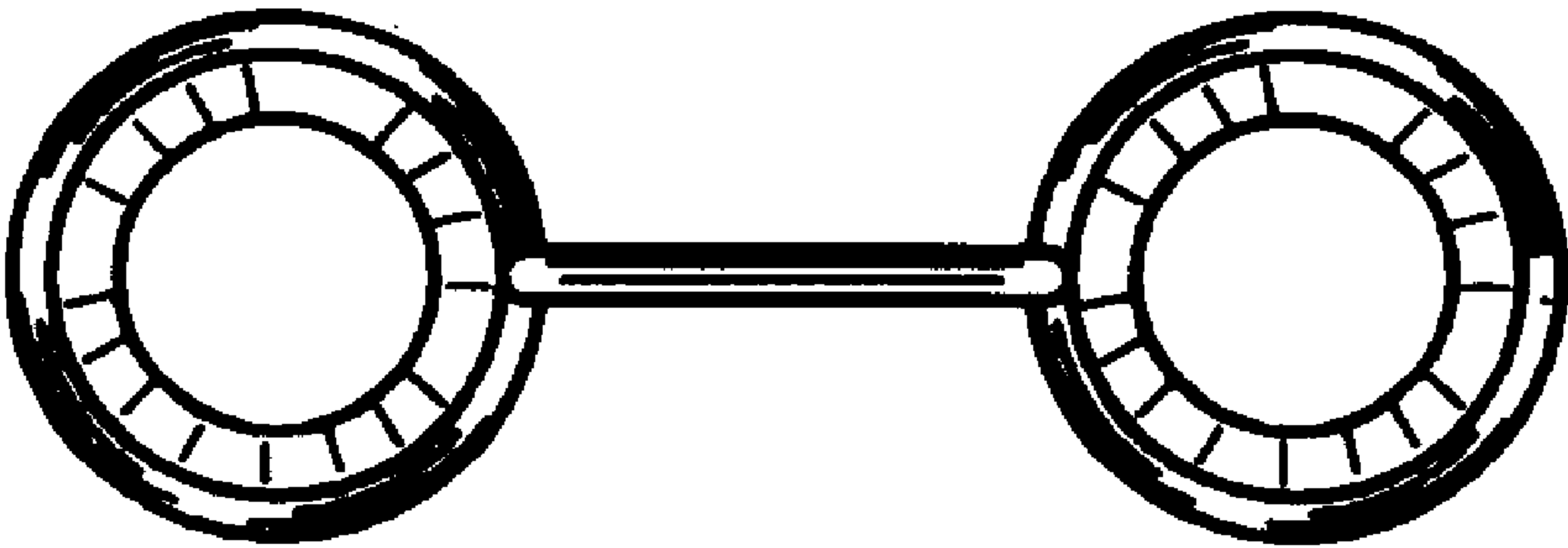

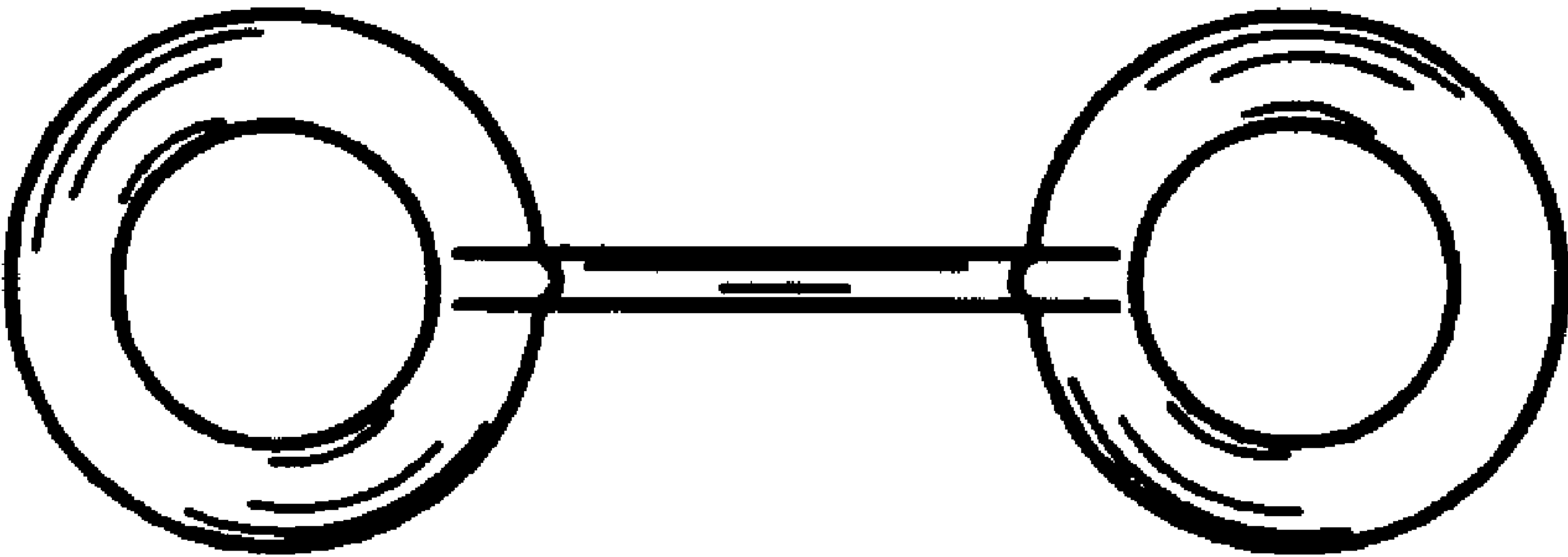
