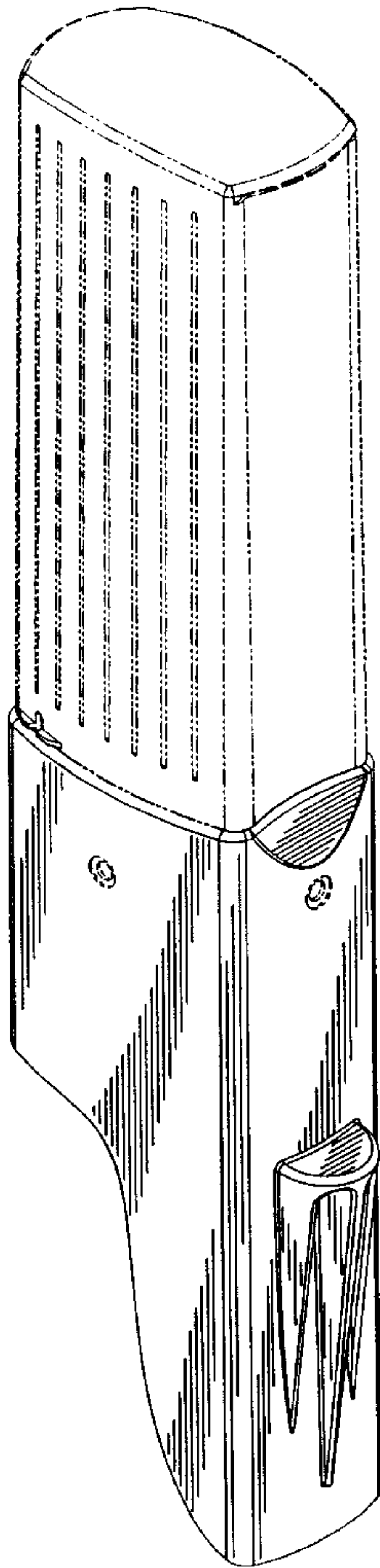
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[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the pedestal closure assembly of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a back view of the pedestal closure assembly of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front view of the pedestal closure assembly of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a right side view of the pedestal closure assembly of FIG. 1, the left side view being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the pedestal closure assembly of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the pedestal closure assembly of FIG. 1.

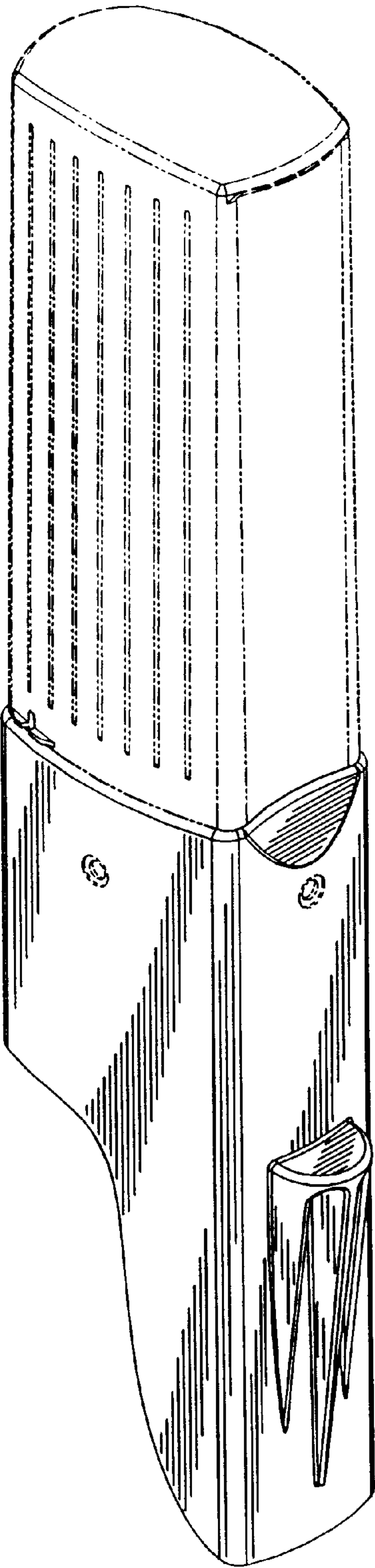

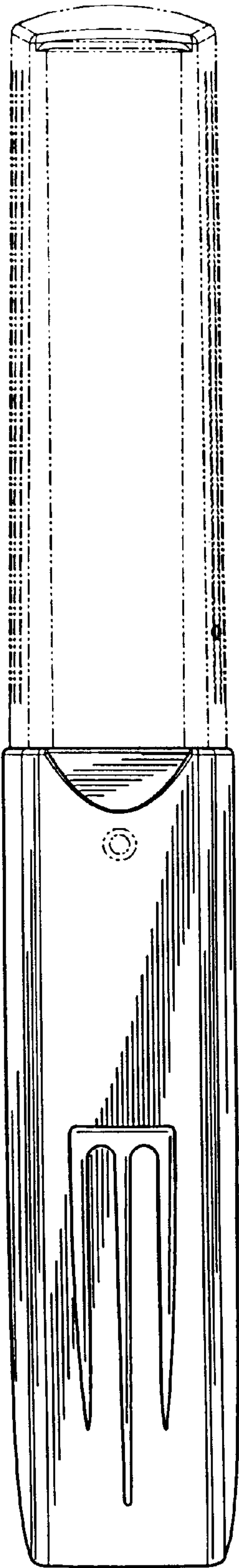

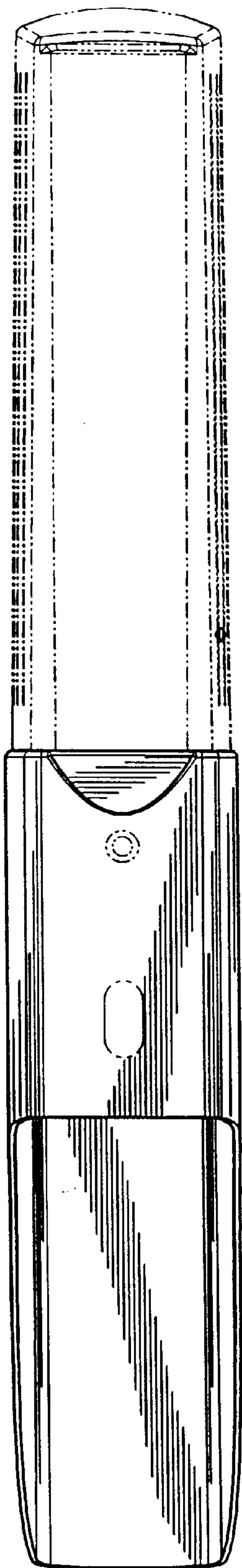

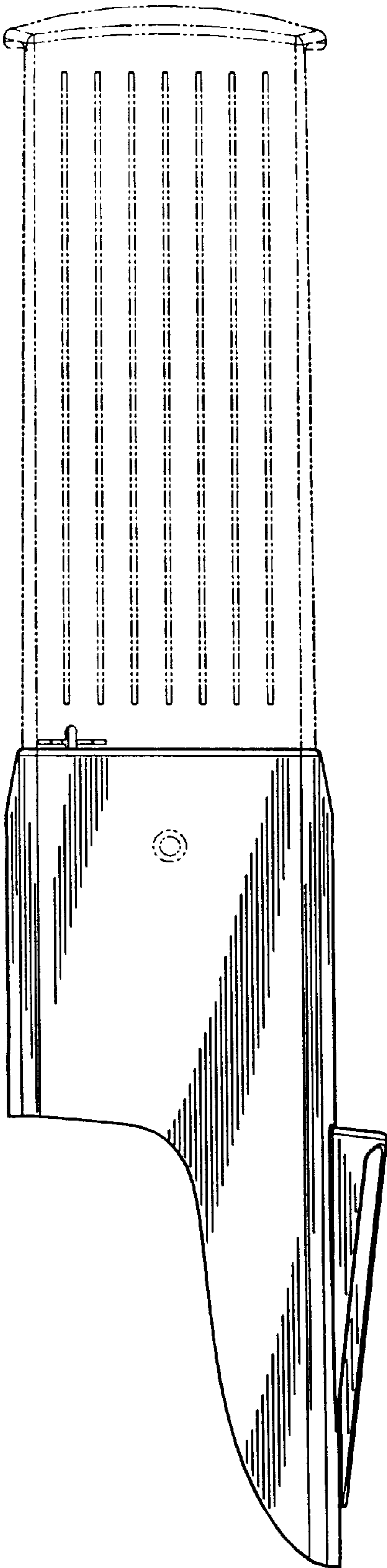

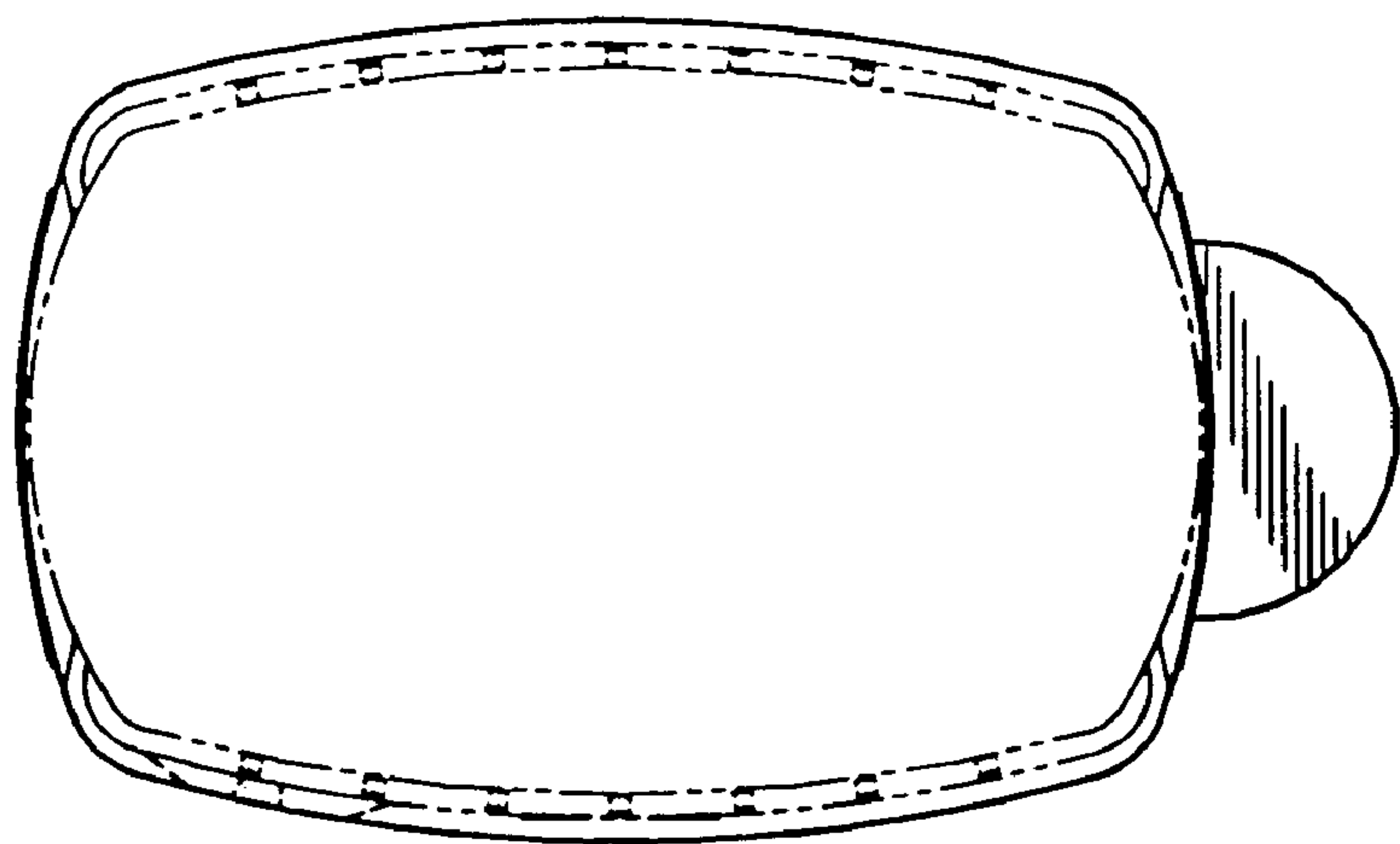

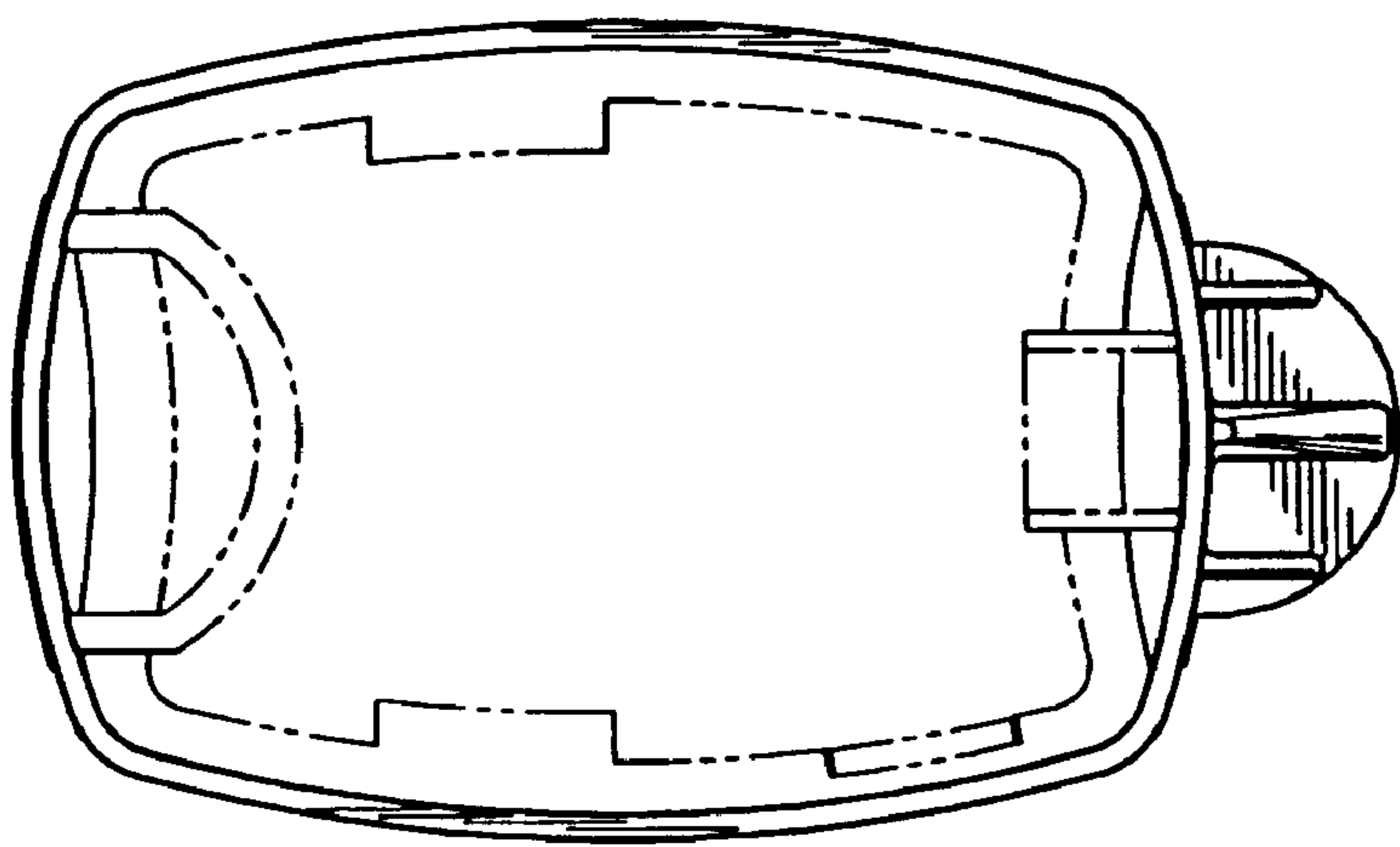
