FIG. 2 is an elevational view from one end in FIG. 1; the view from the opposite end is the same;

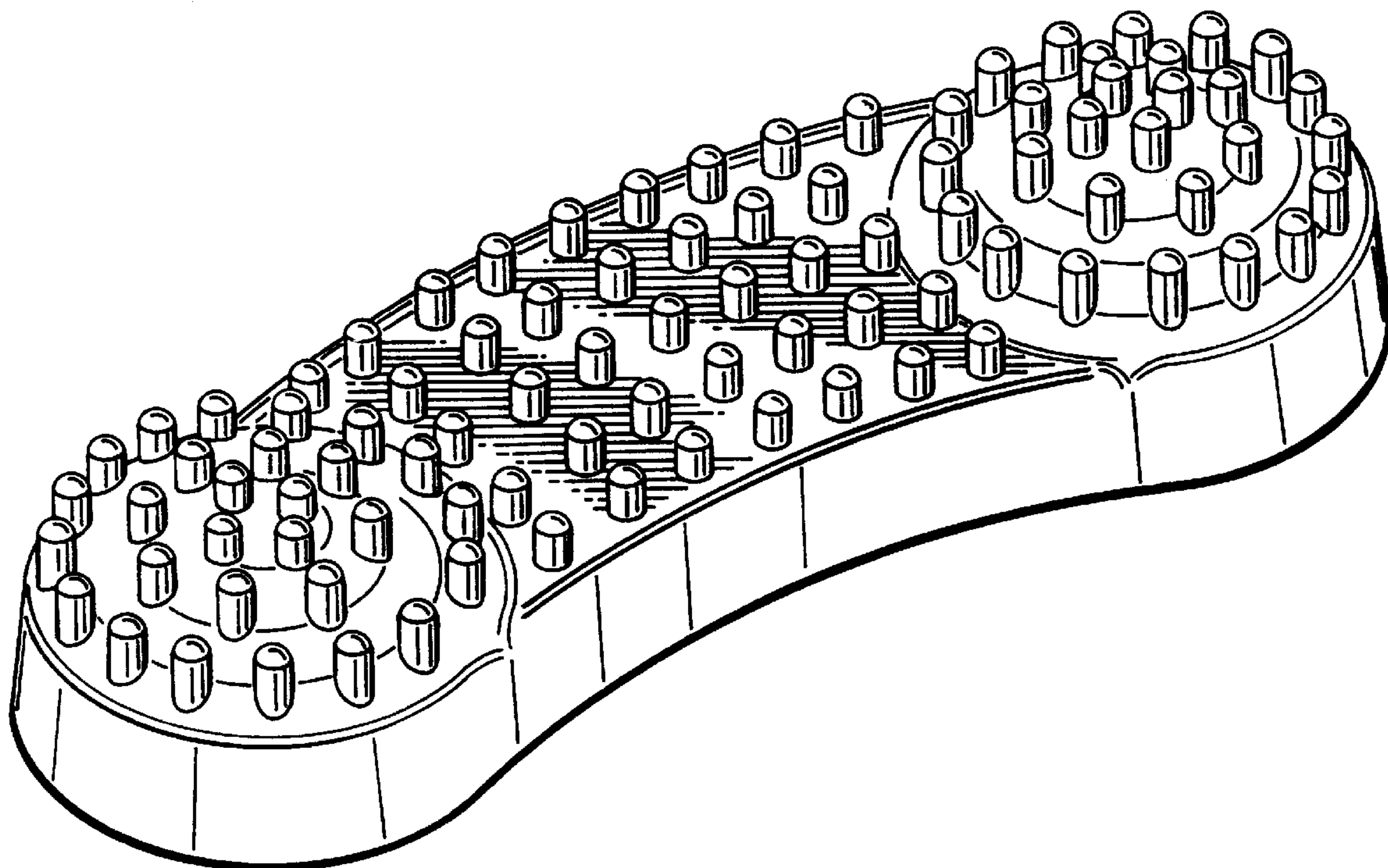
FIG. 3 is a plan view;

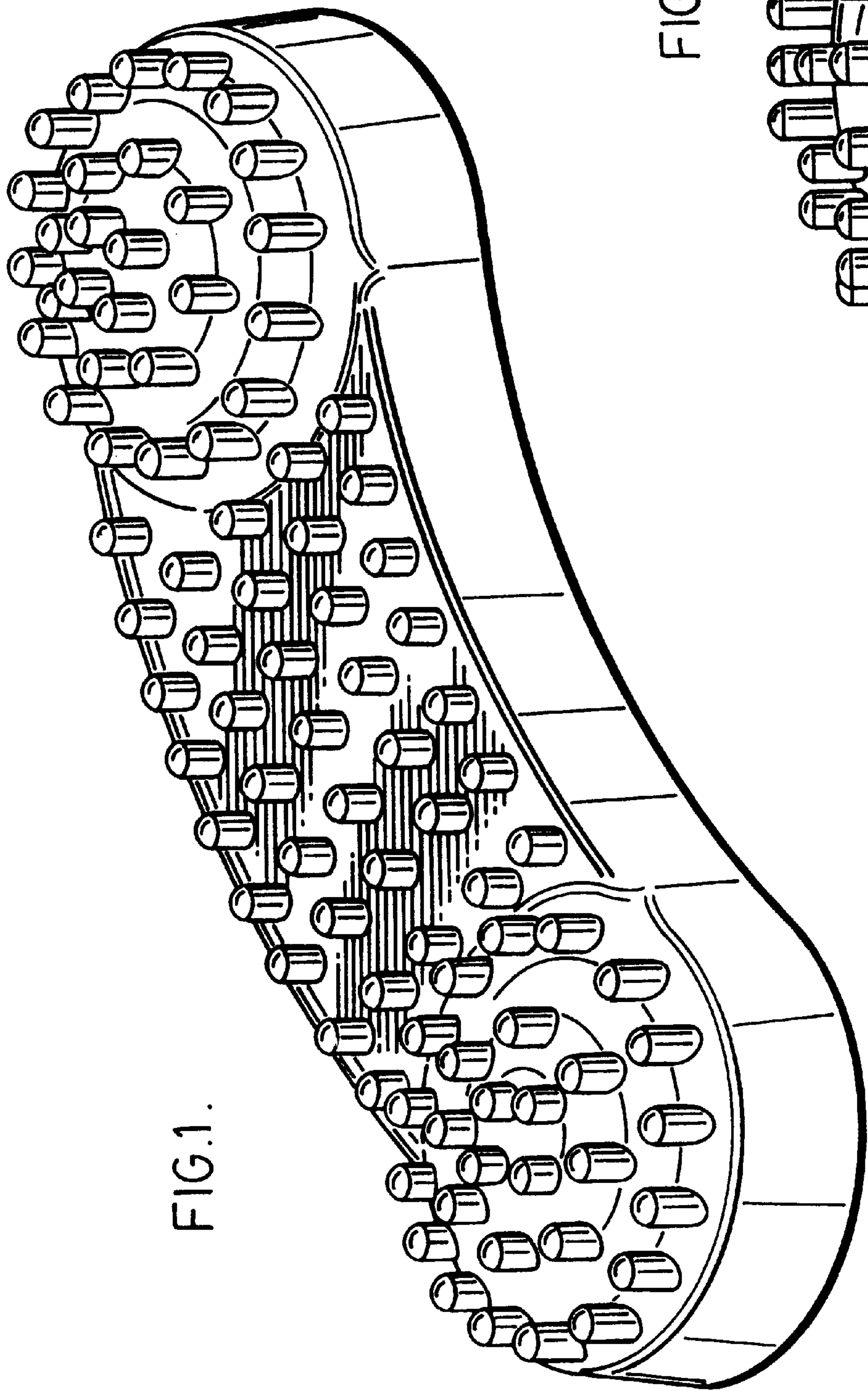
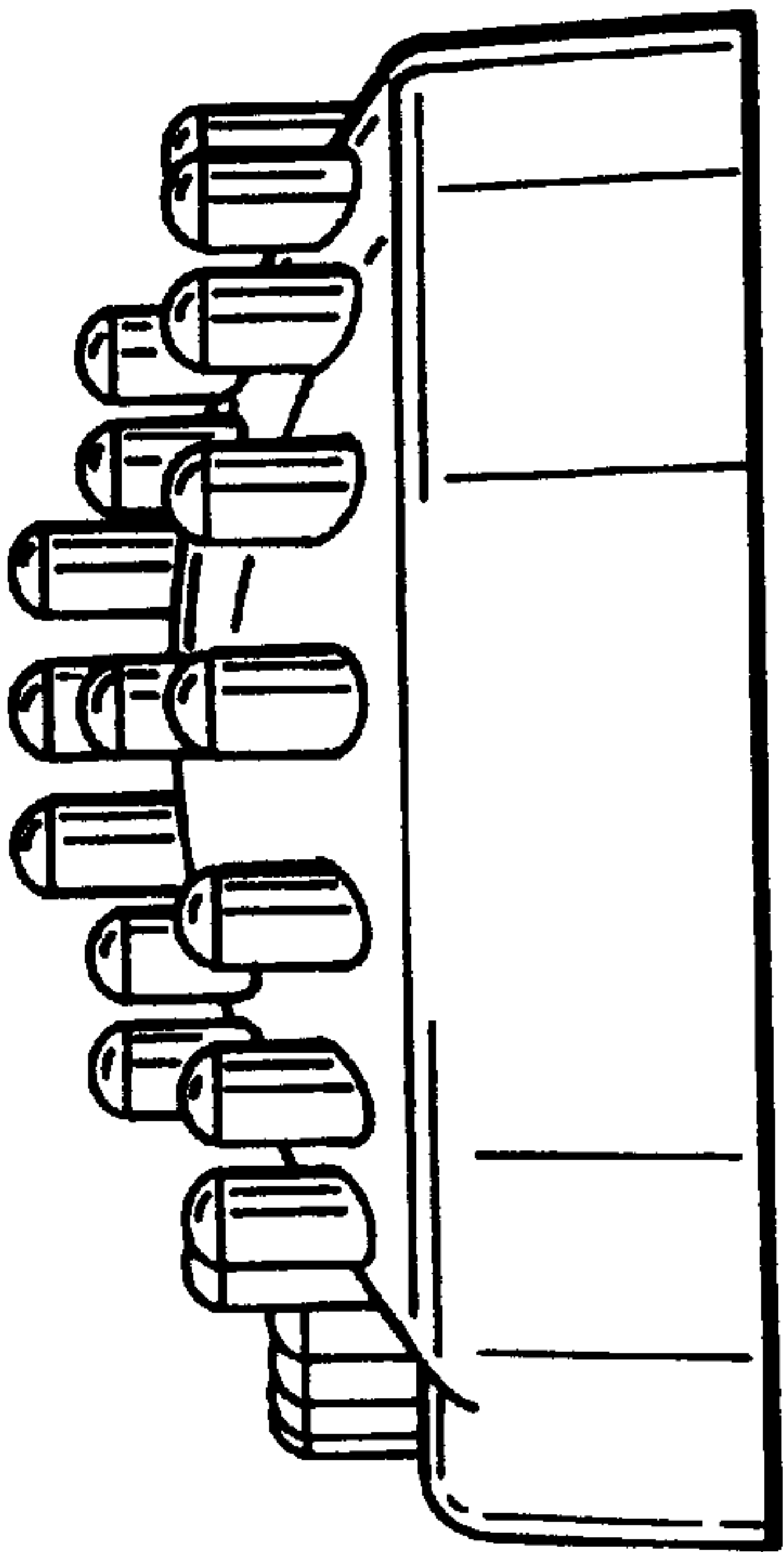

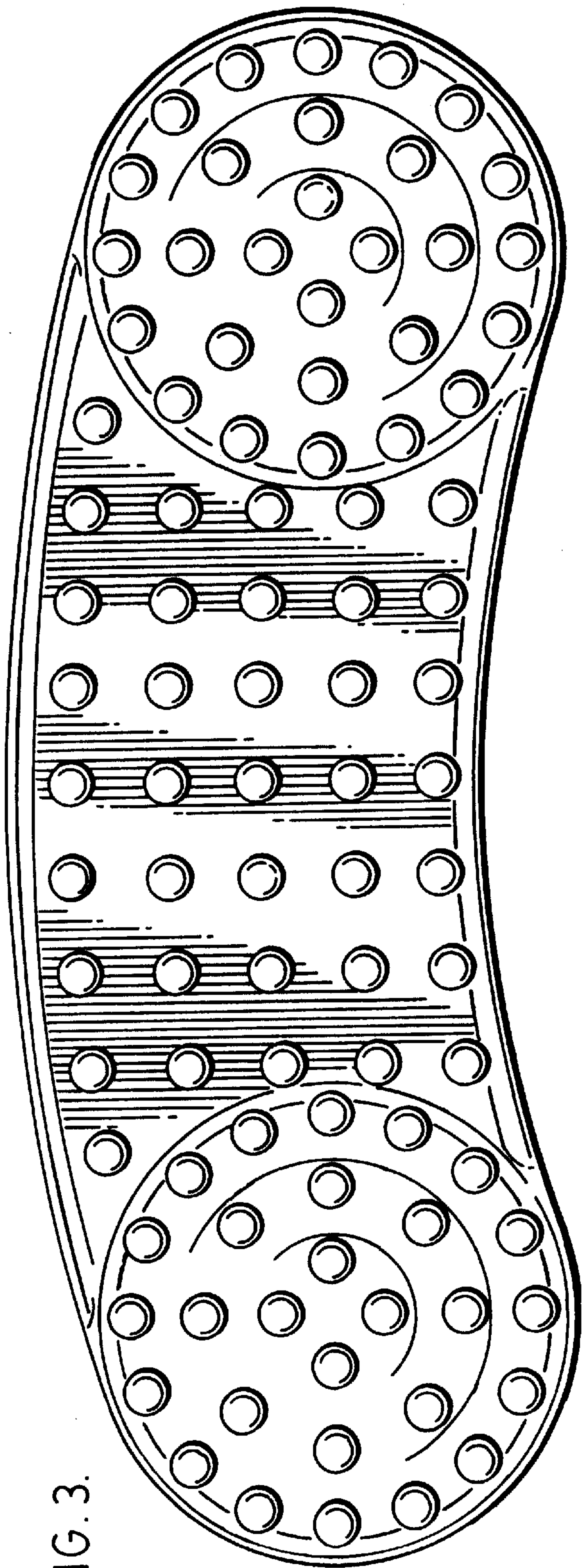

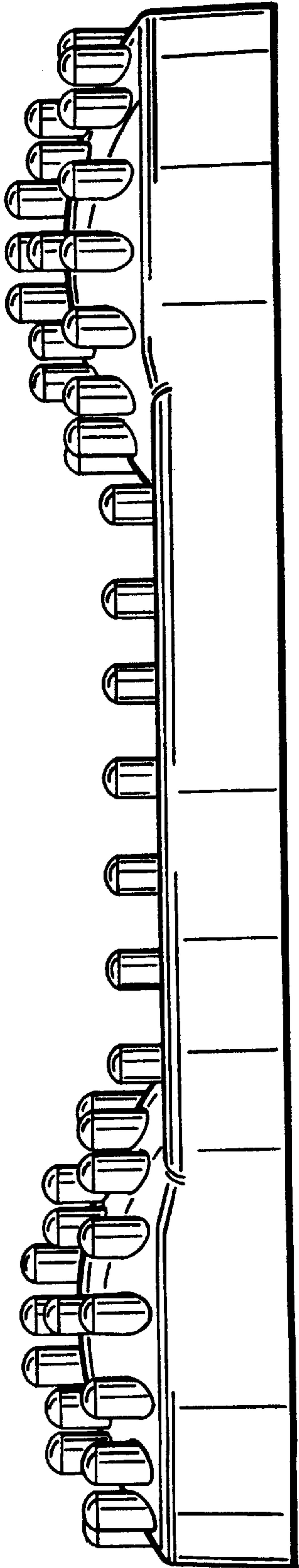

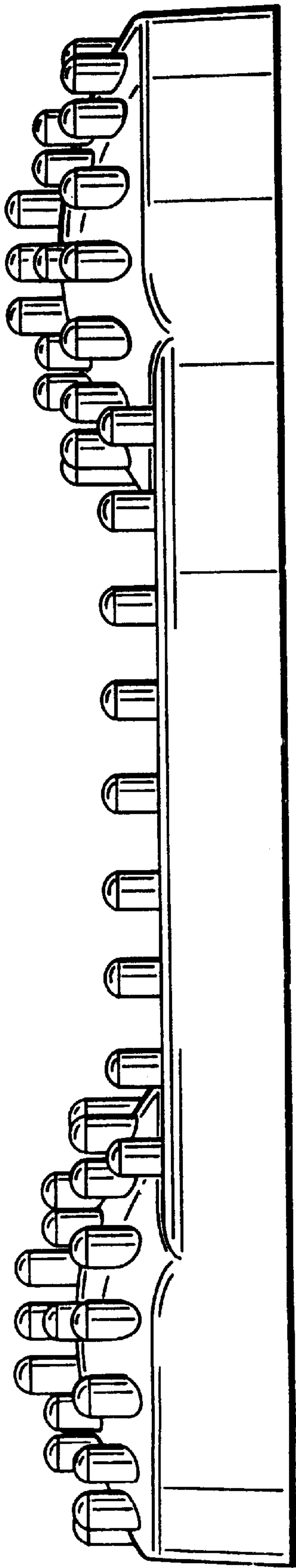

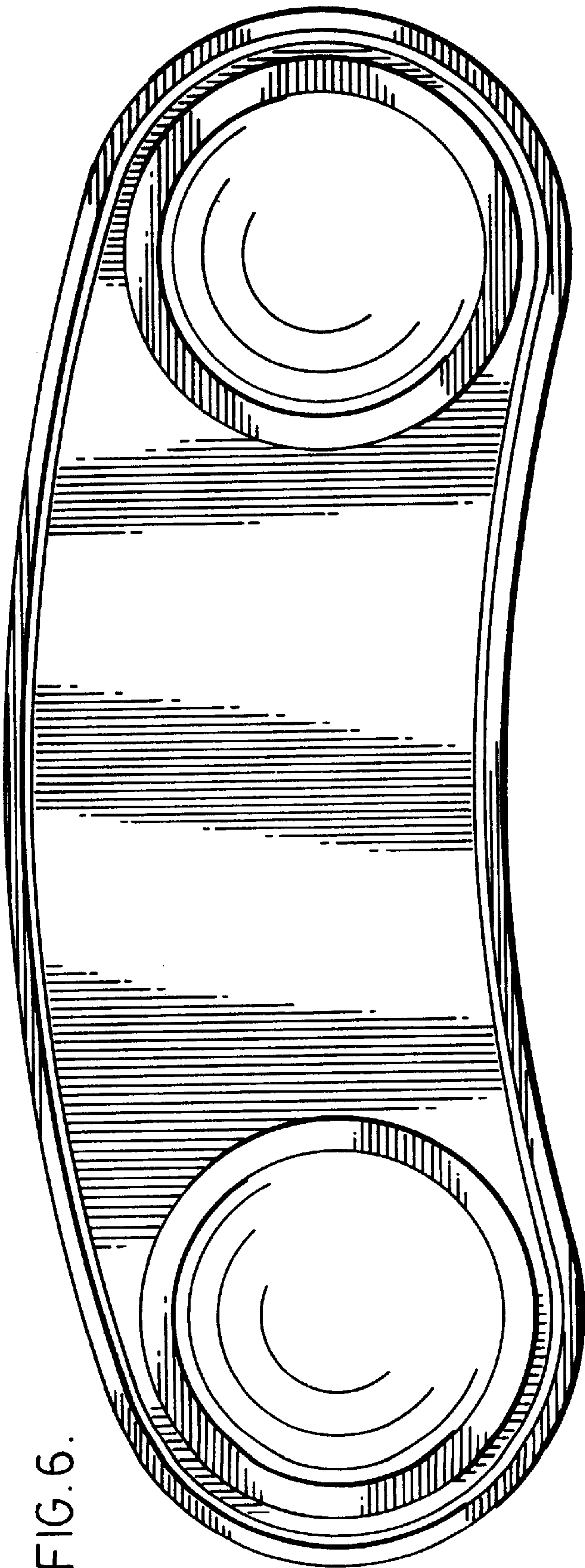
