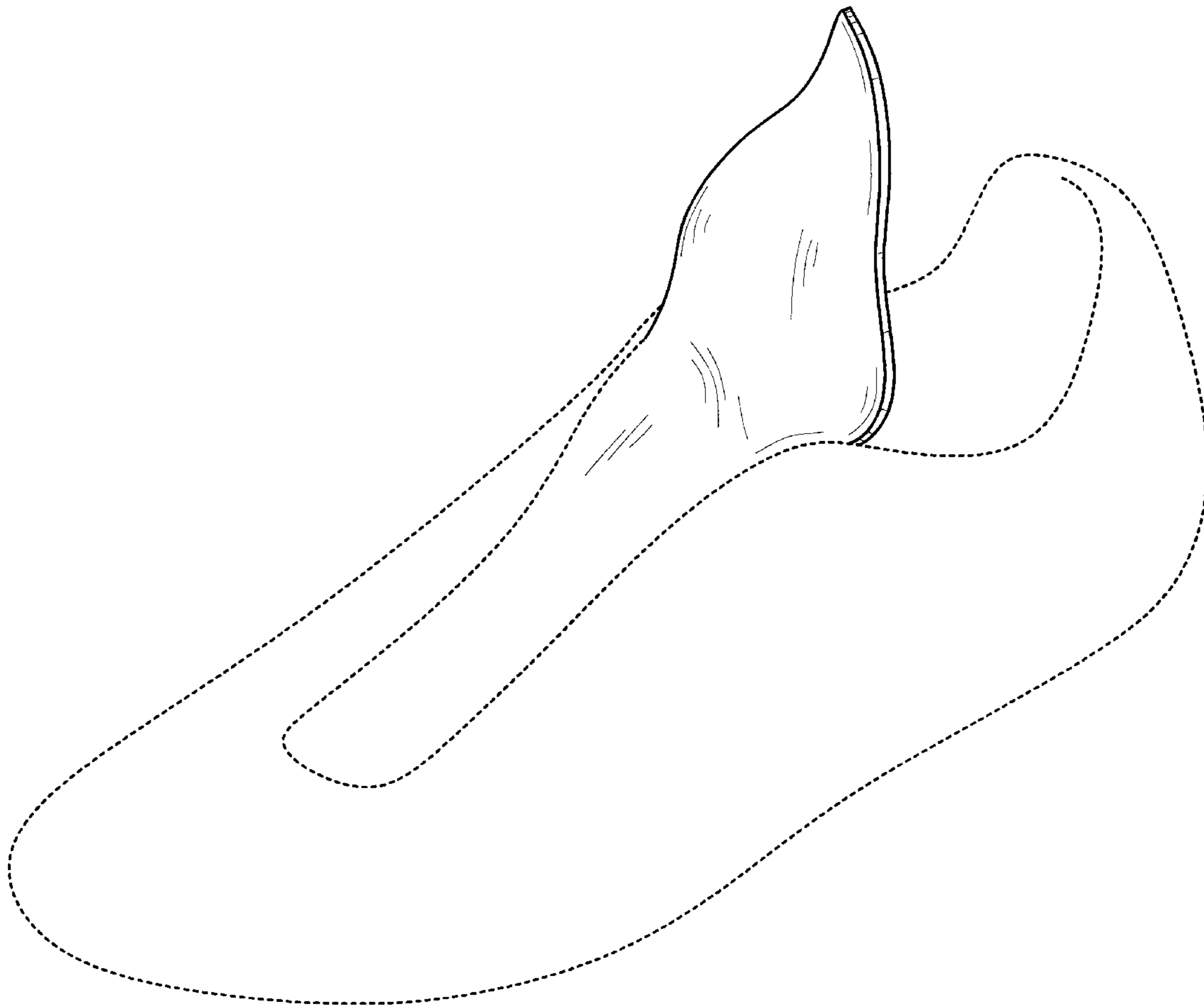
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the shoe showing the new design as viewed from the top of the shoe. The shoe upper shown in broken lines is not part of the design sought to be patented and is shown for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the shoe; FIG. 3 is a medial side elevation of the shoe; FIG. 4 is a second perspective view of the shoe showing the new design as viewed from the top of the shoe; FIG. 5 is a second top plan view of the shoe; and, FIG. 6 is a second medial side elevation of the shoe.

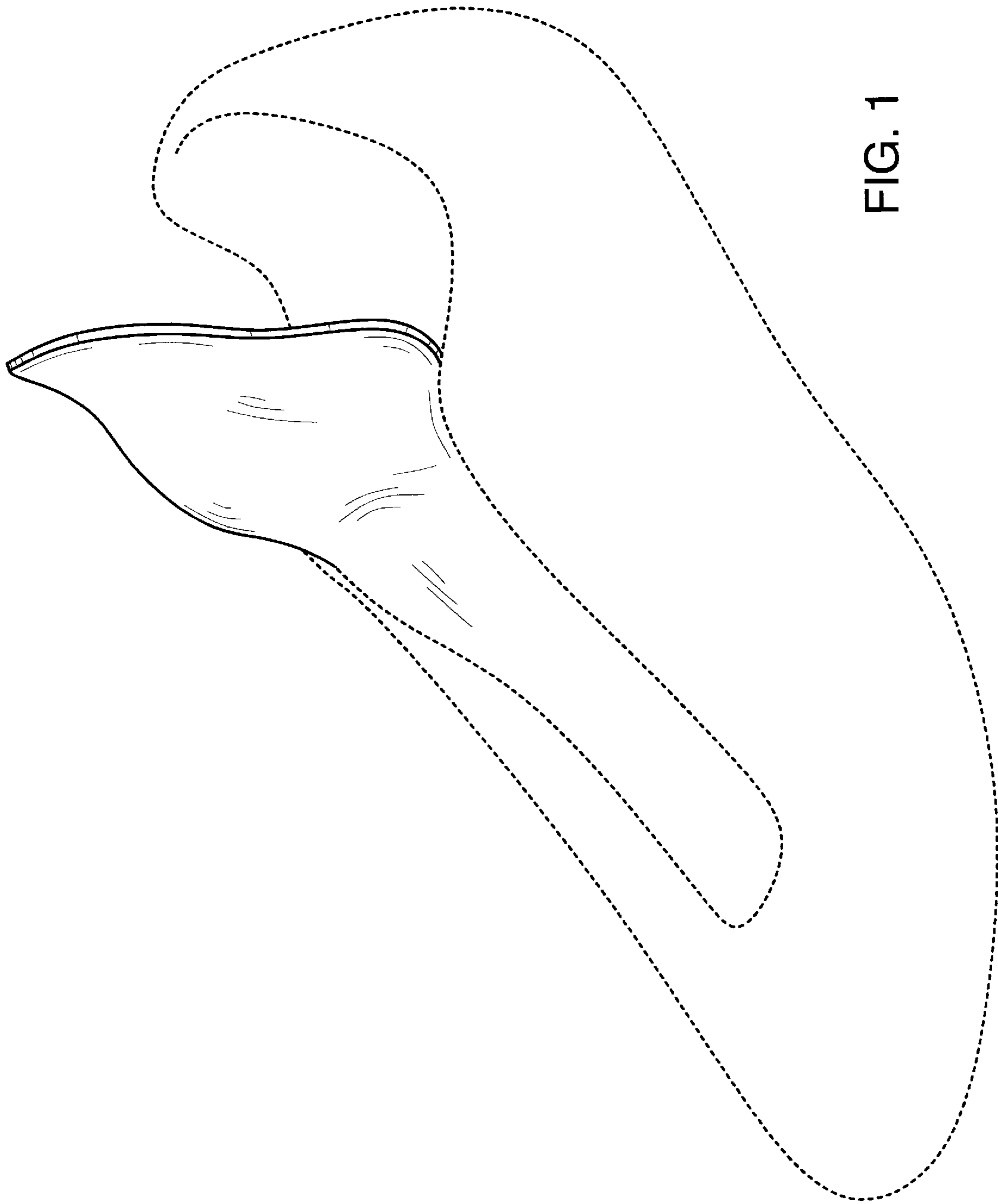

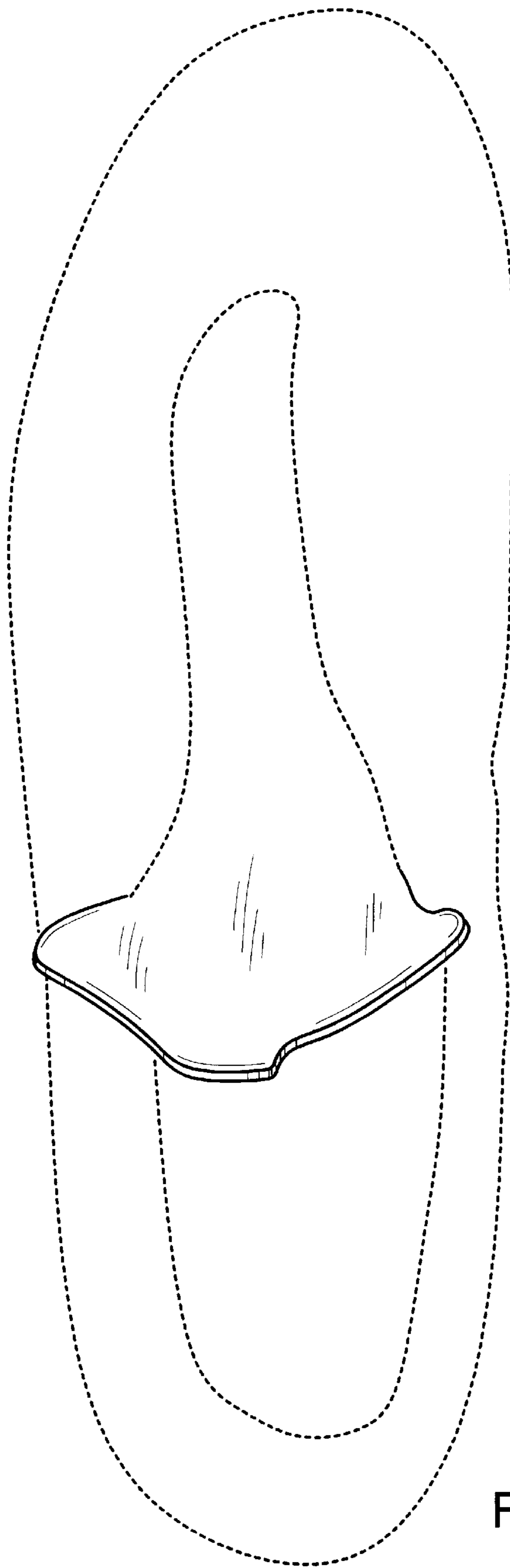

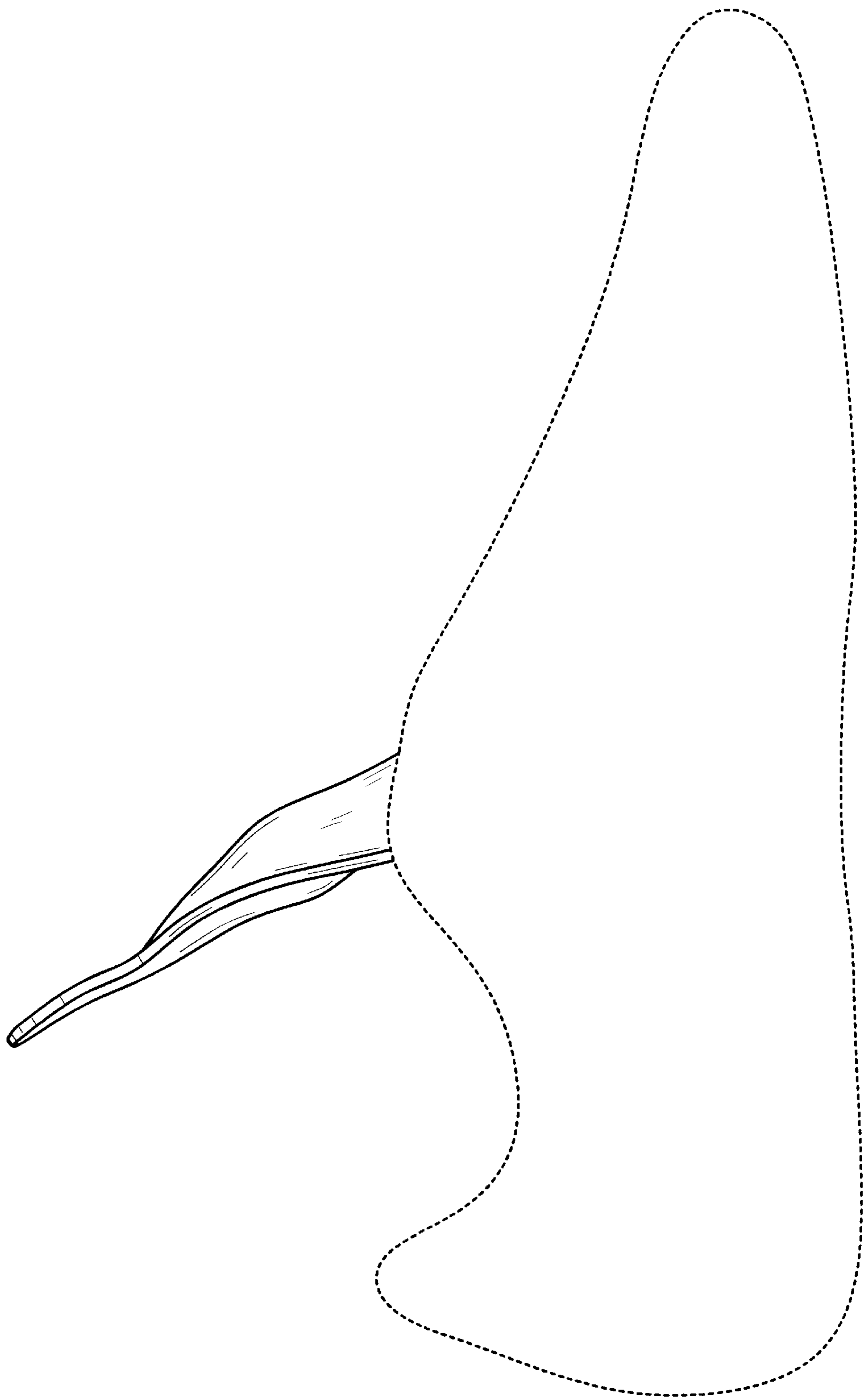

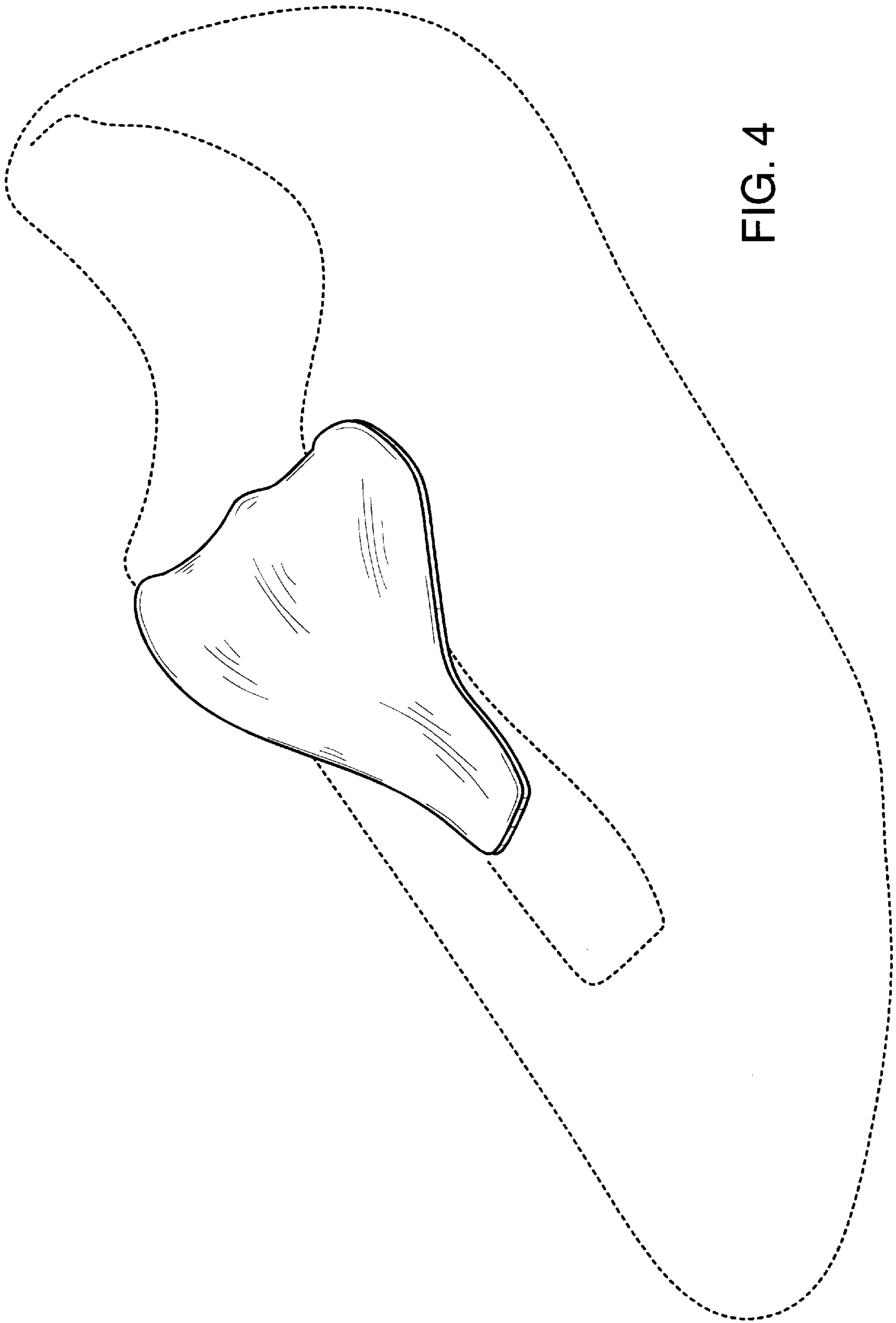

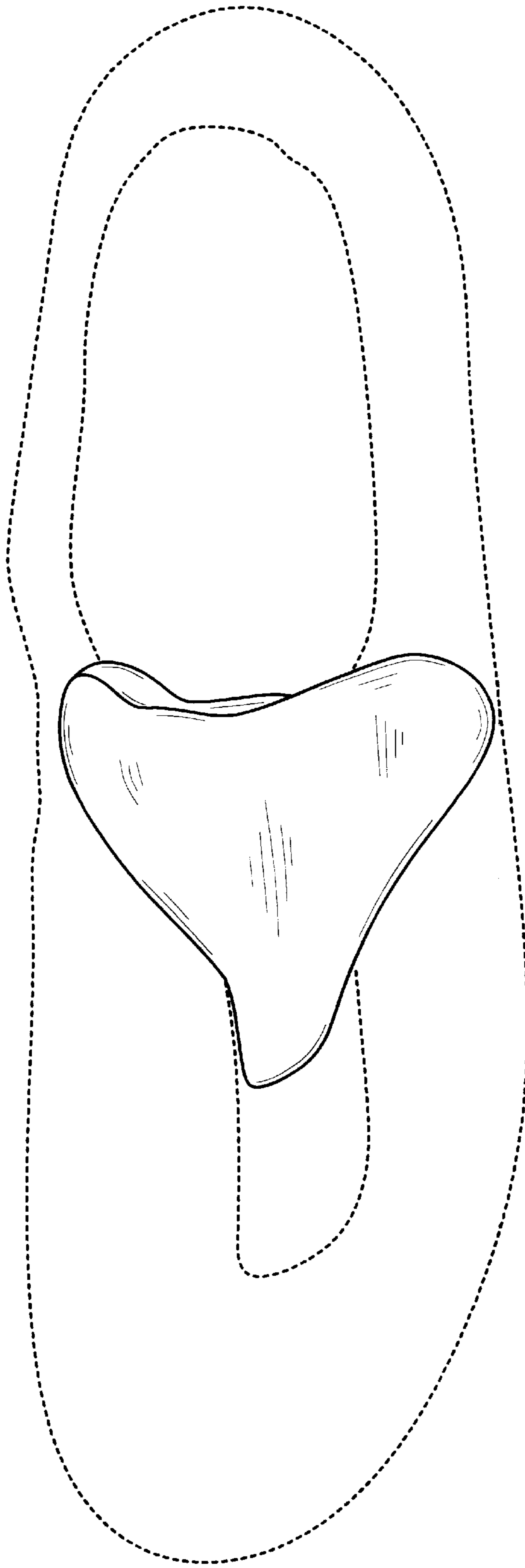

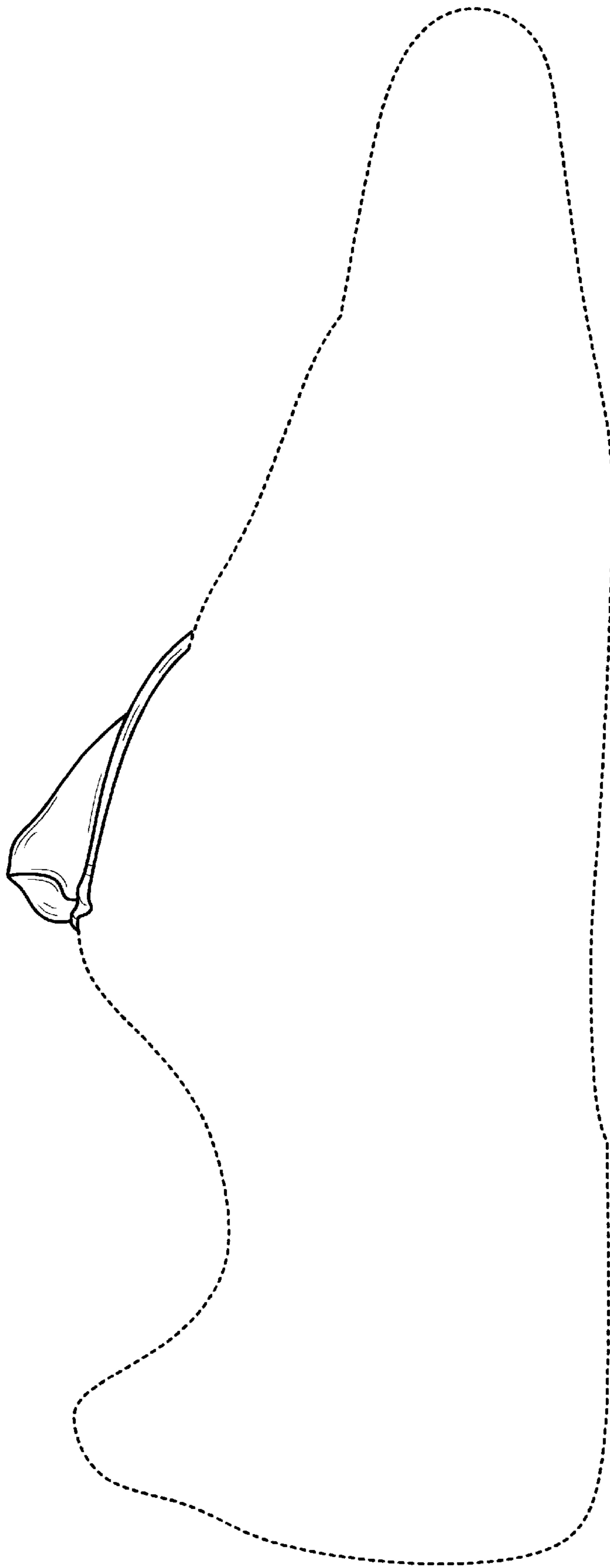
