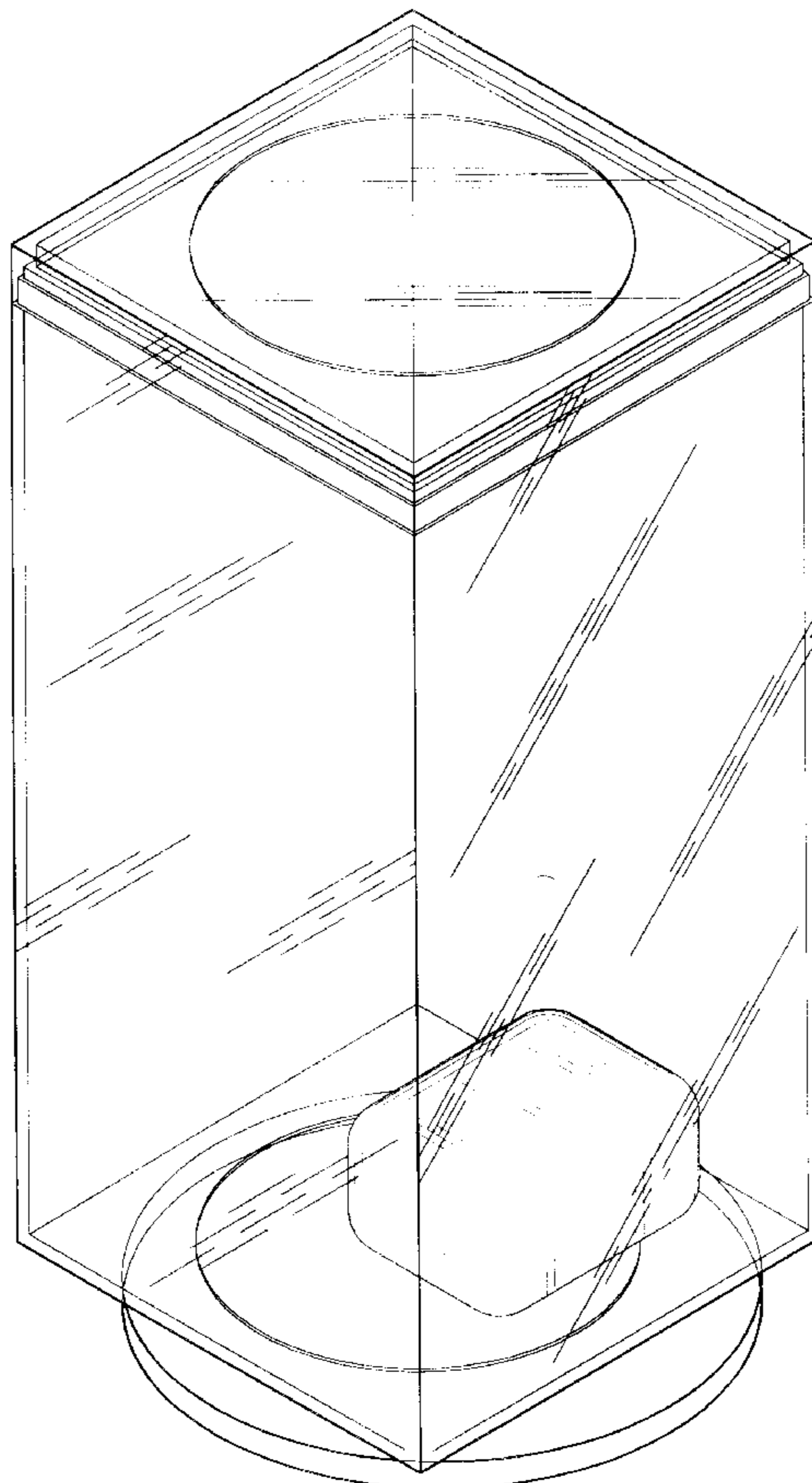
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a musical display case and pedestal, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the musical display case and pedestal showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, both sides being identical;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is bottom plan view thereof.

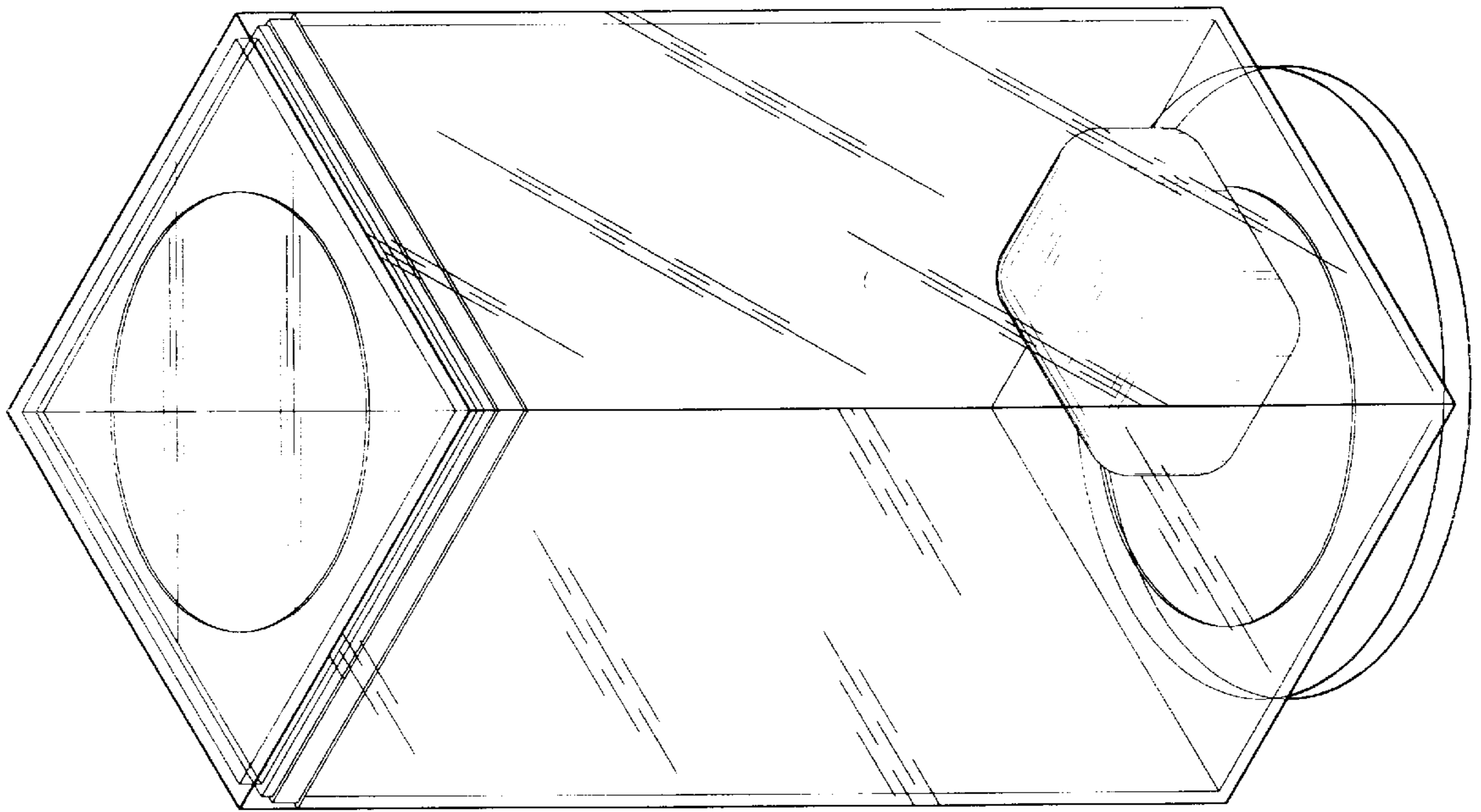

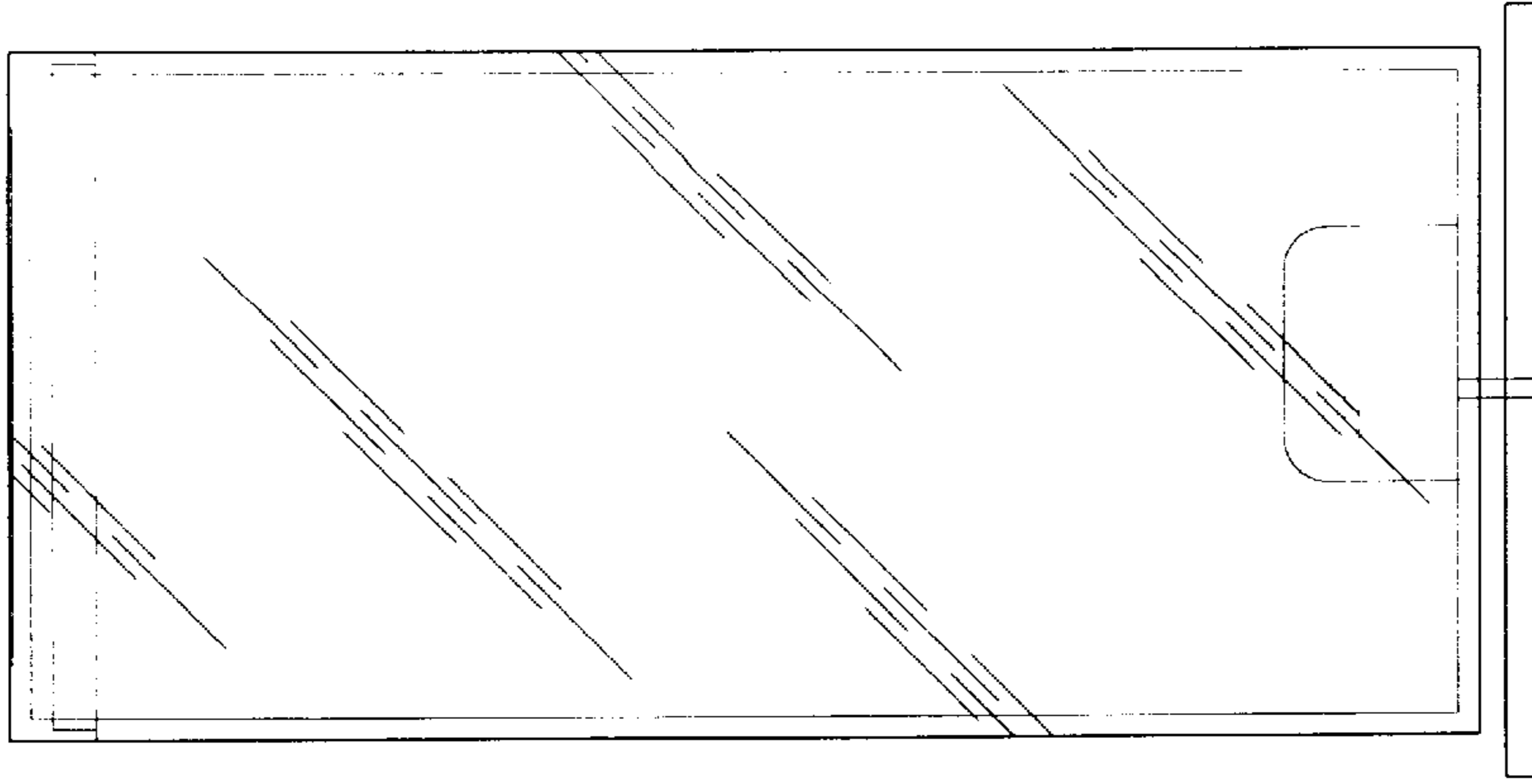

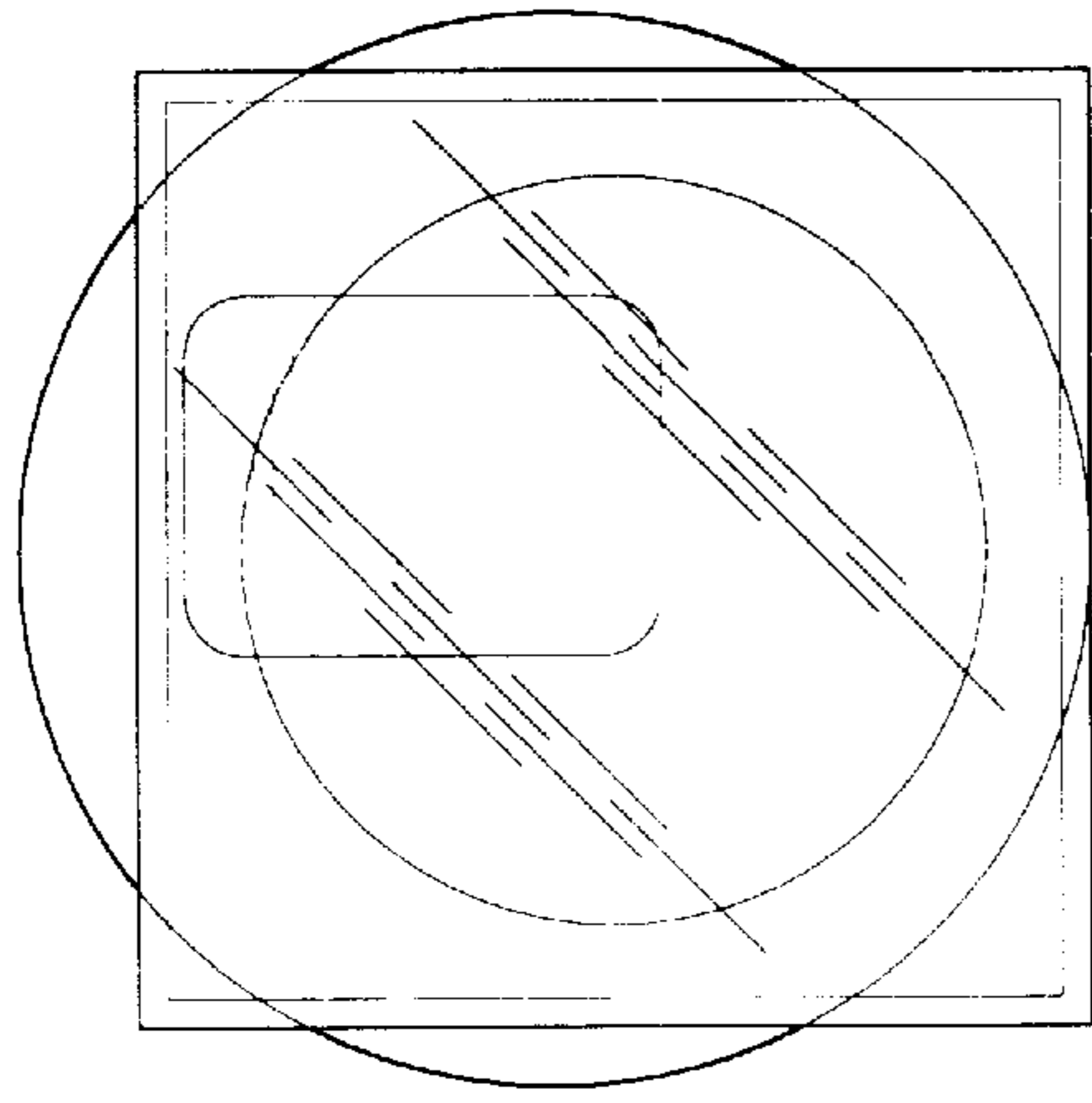

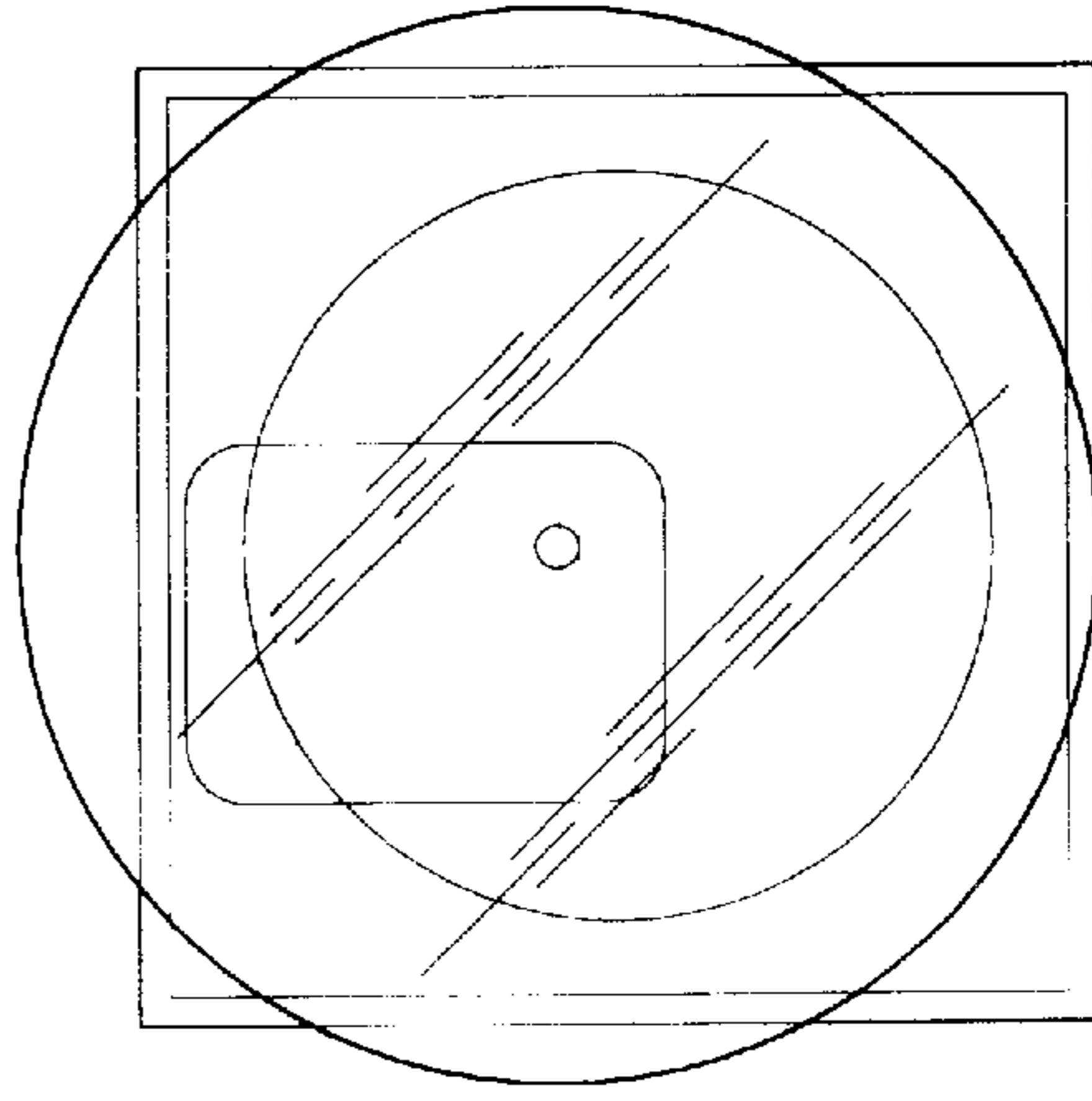

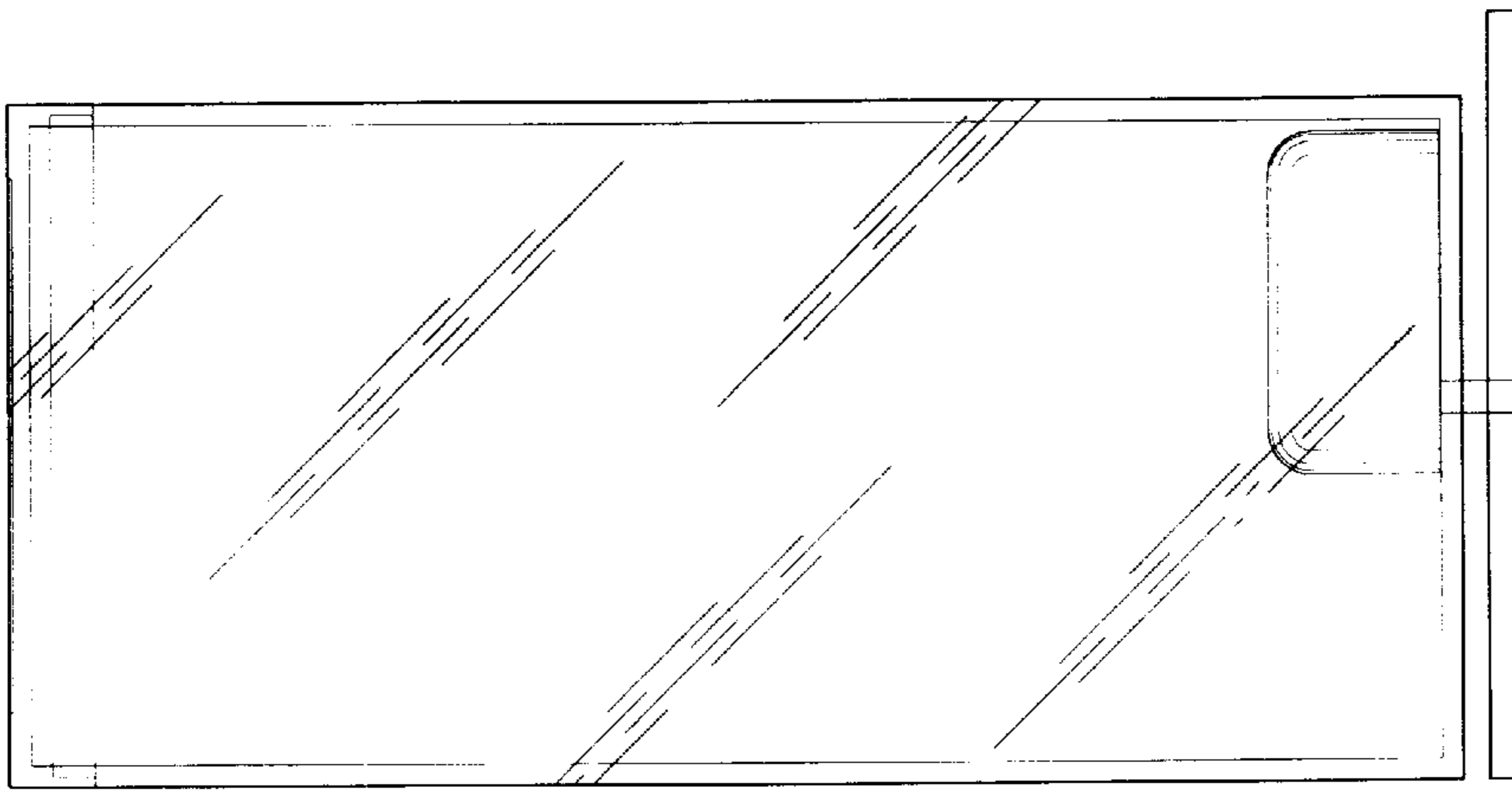

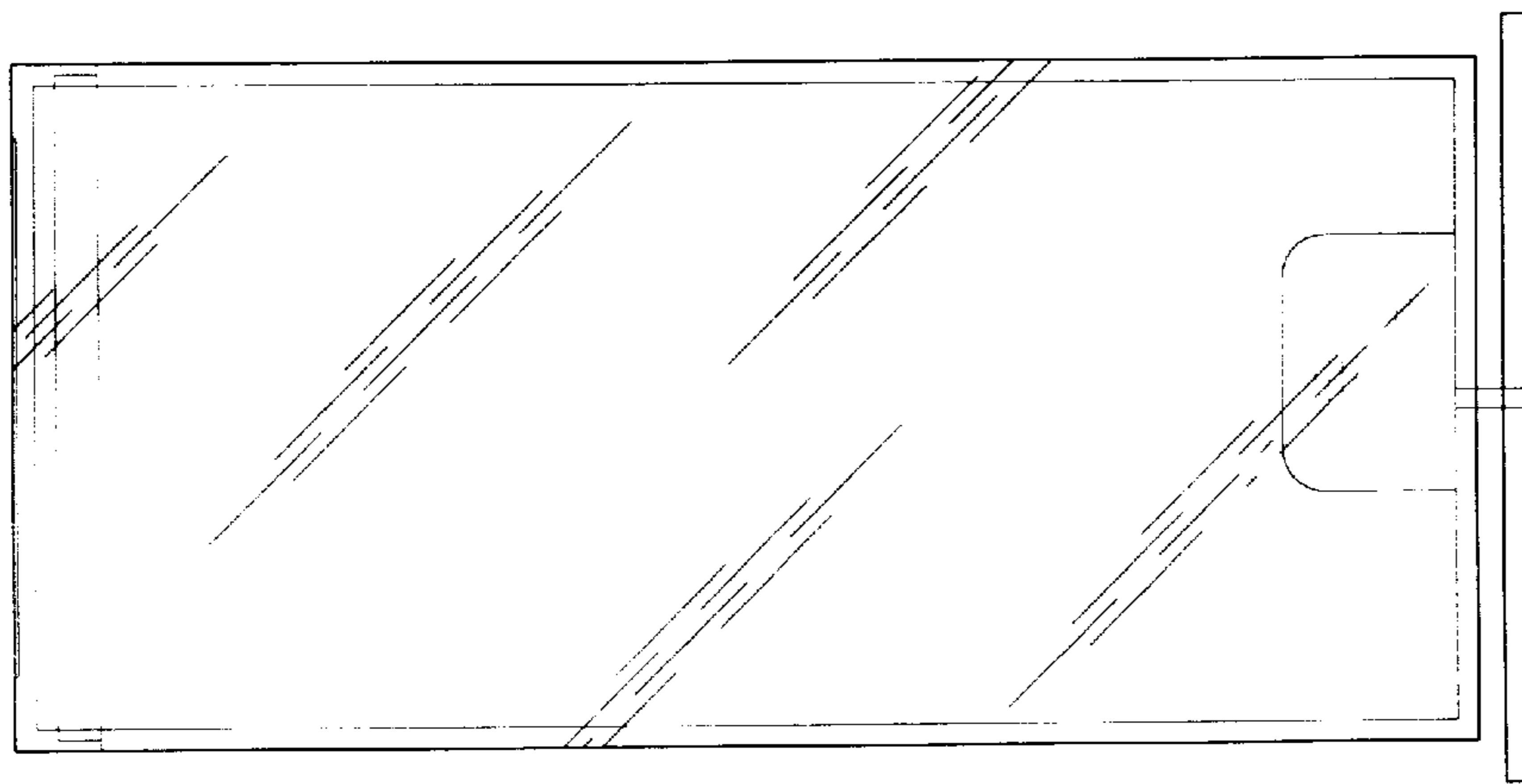
