We claim the ornamental design for a golf club shaft, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf club shaft, showing a first embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 2 is another perspective view of a golf club shaft, showing the first embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 3 is a rear side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of golf club shaft, showing a fourth embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 8 is another perspective view of a golf club shaft, showing the fourth embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 9 is a rear side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a front side elevation view thereof;


FIG. 11 is a left side elevation view thereof; and,

FIG. 12 is a right side elevation view thereof.








