FIG. 3 is a lateral side elevation of the shoe; and,

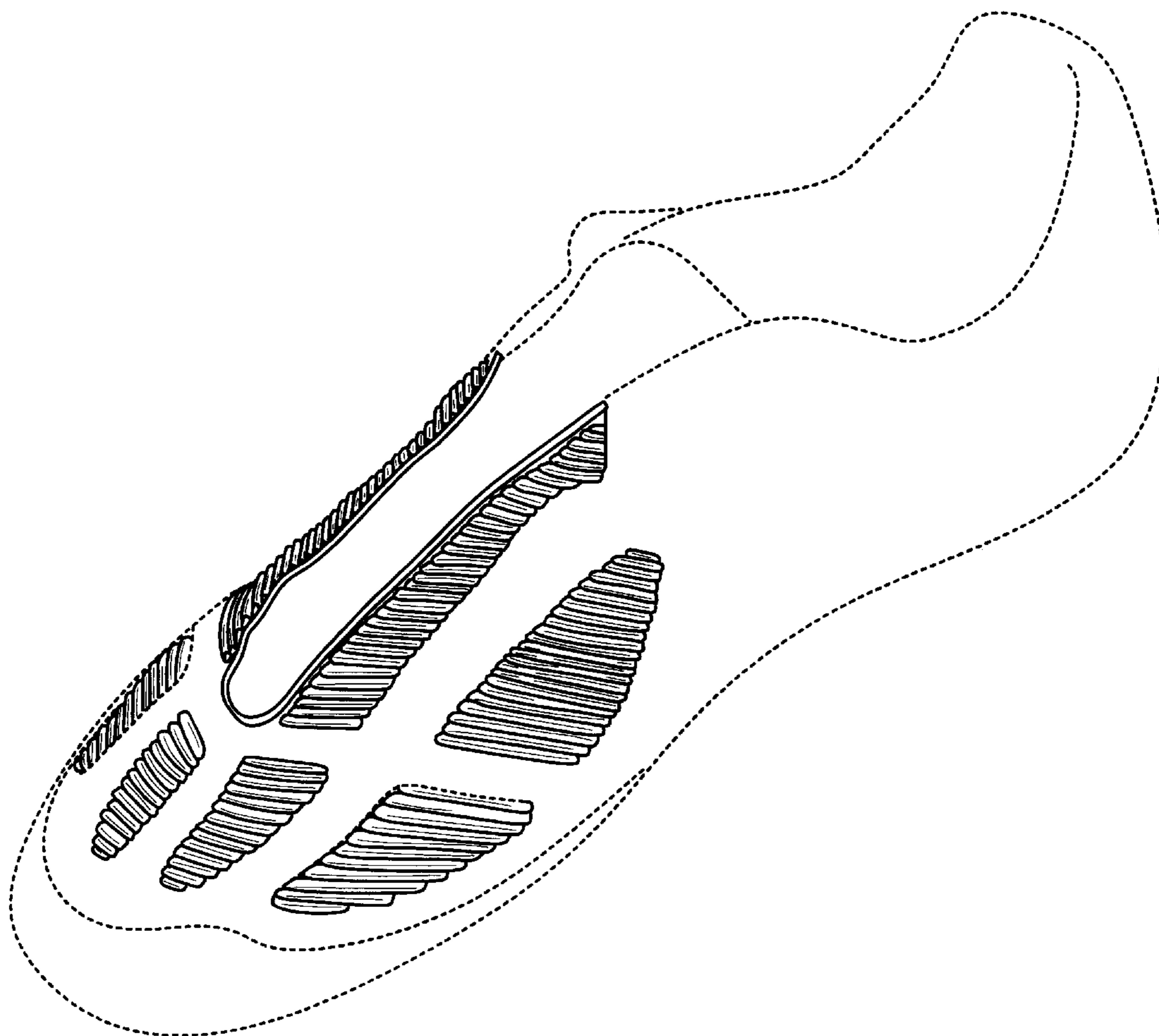
FIG. 4 is a medial side elevation of the shoe and sole.

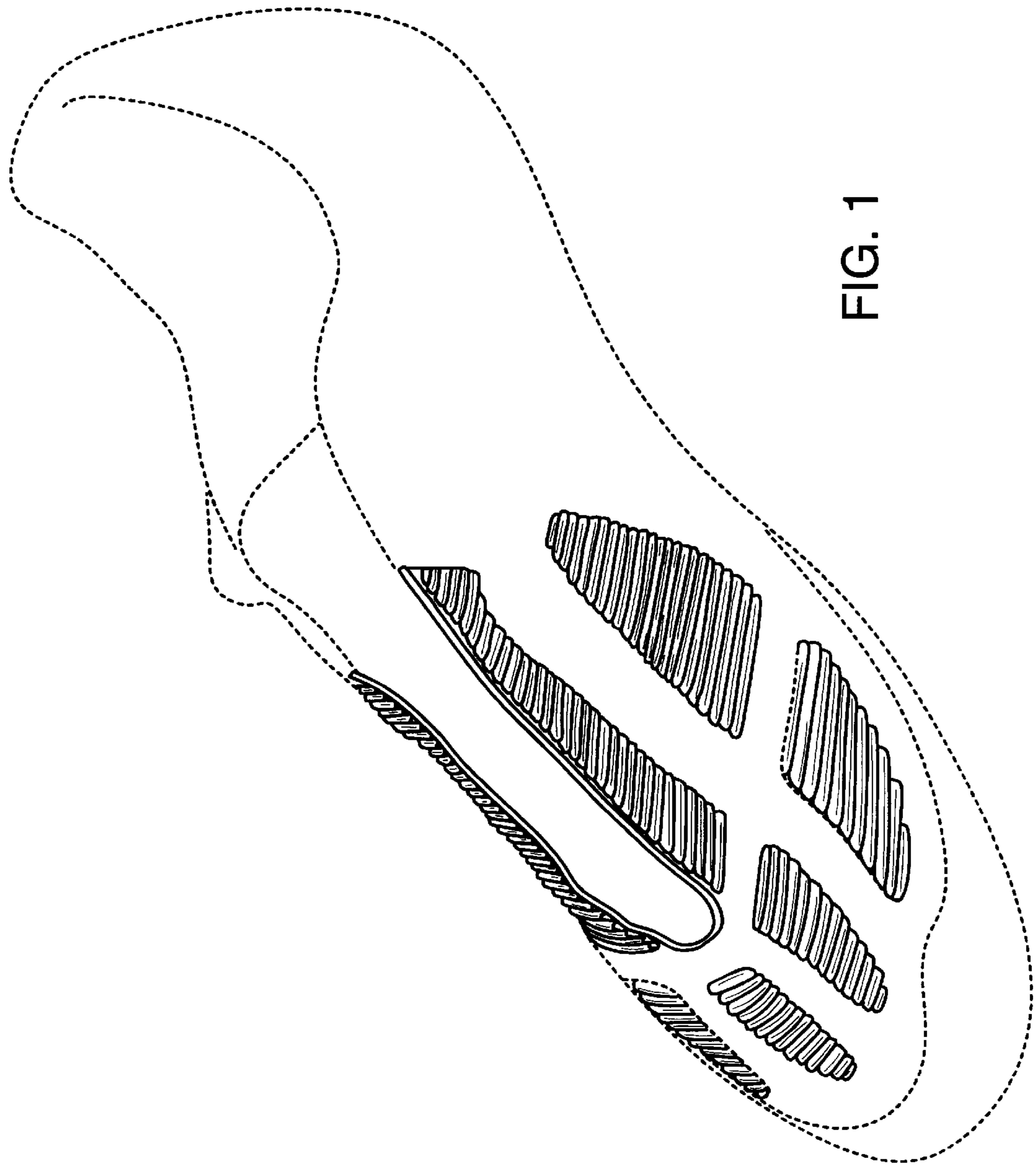

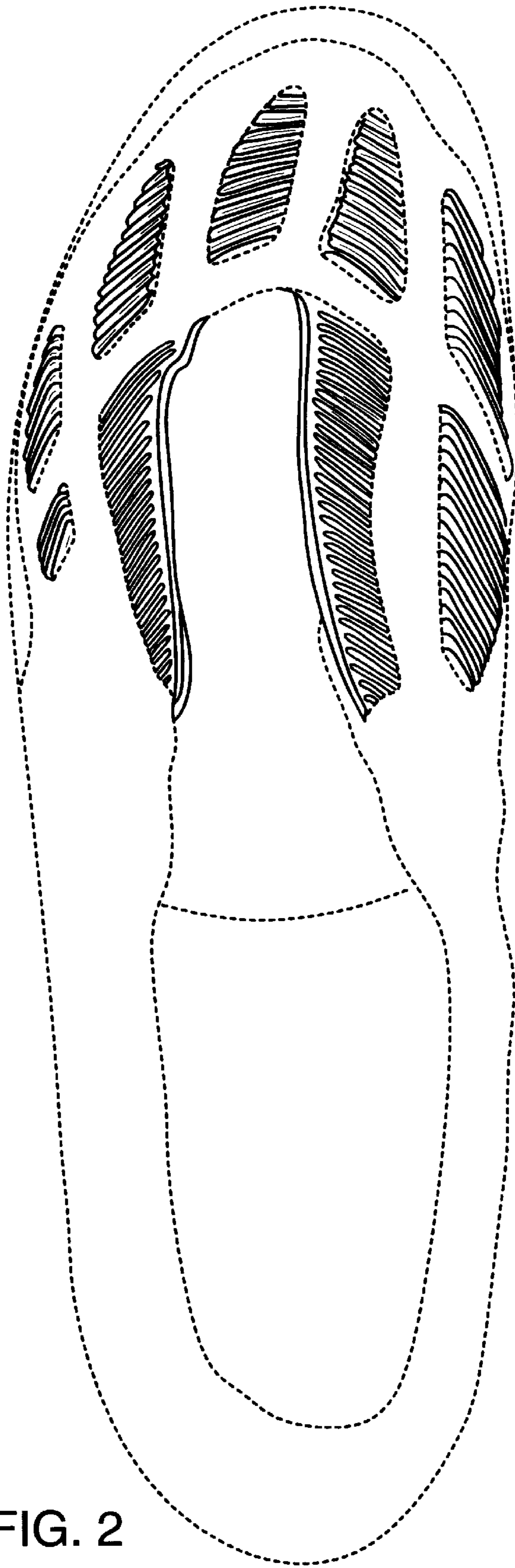

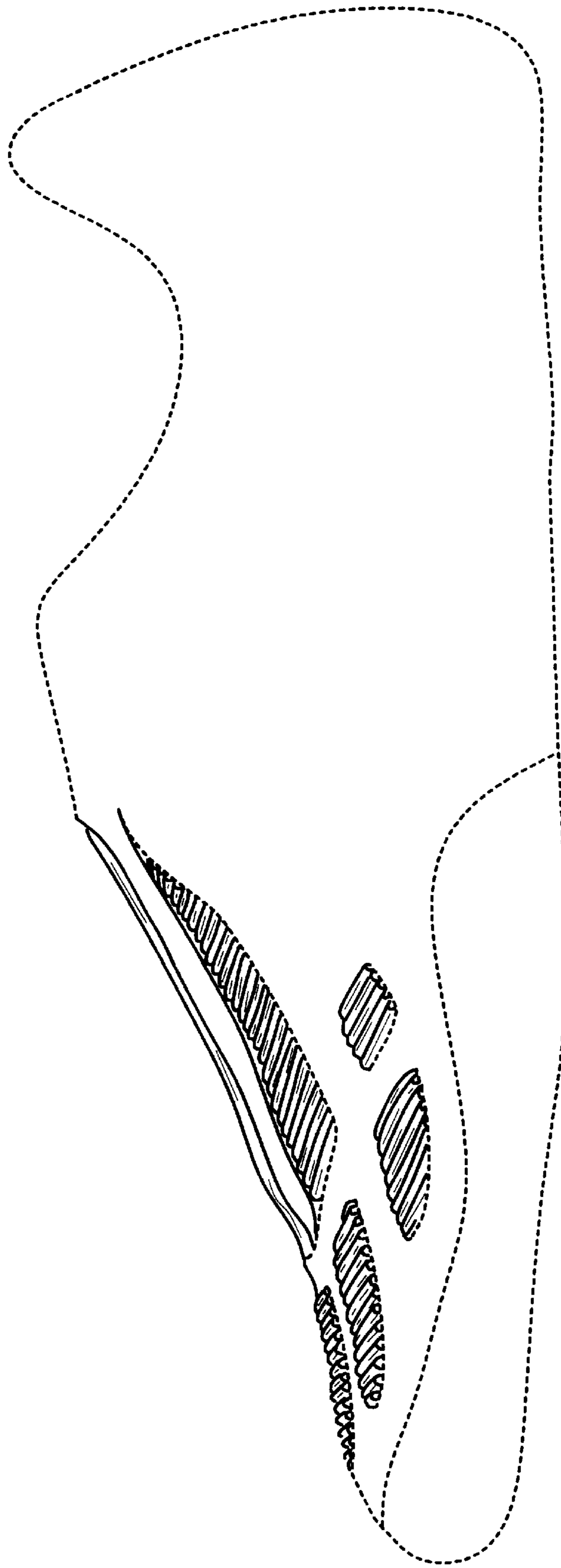

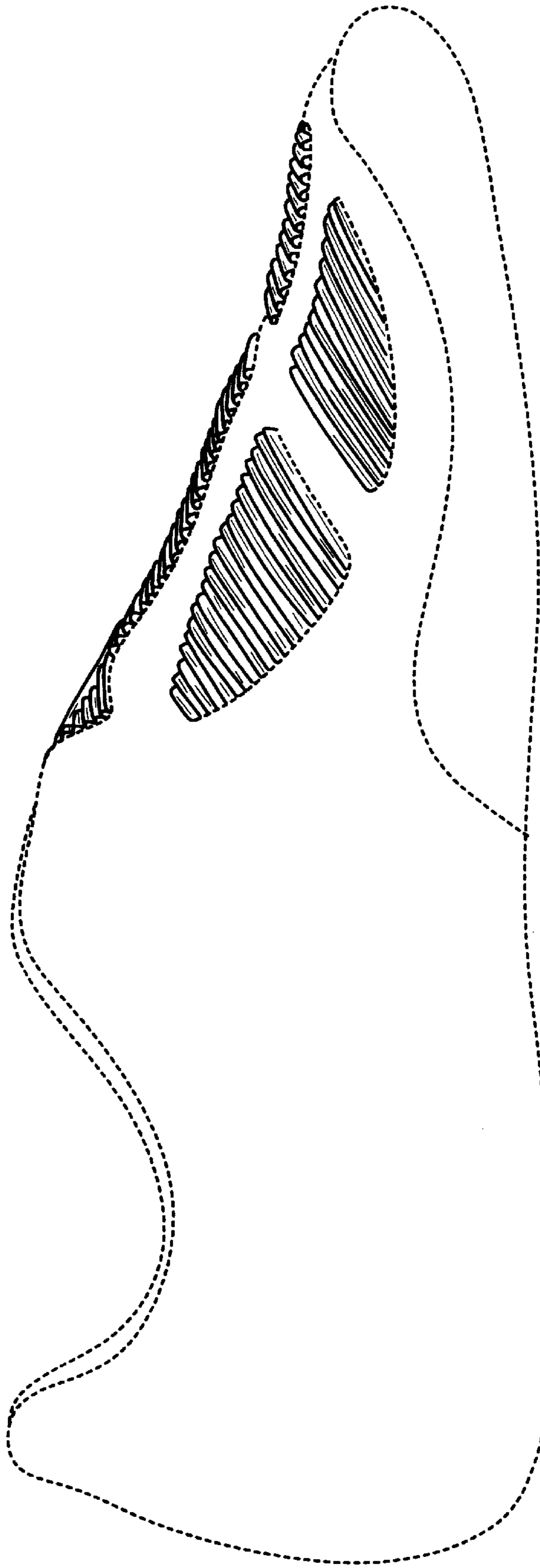
