DESCRIPTION

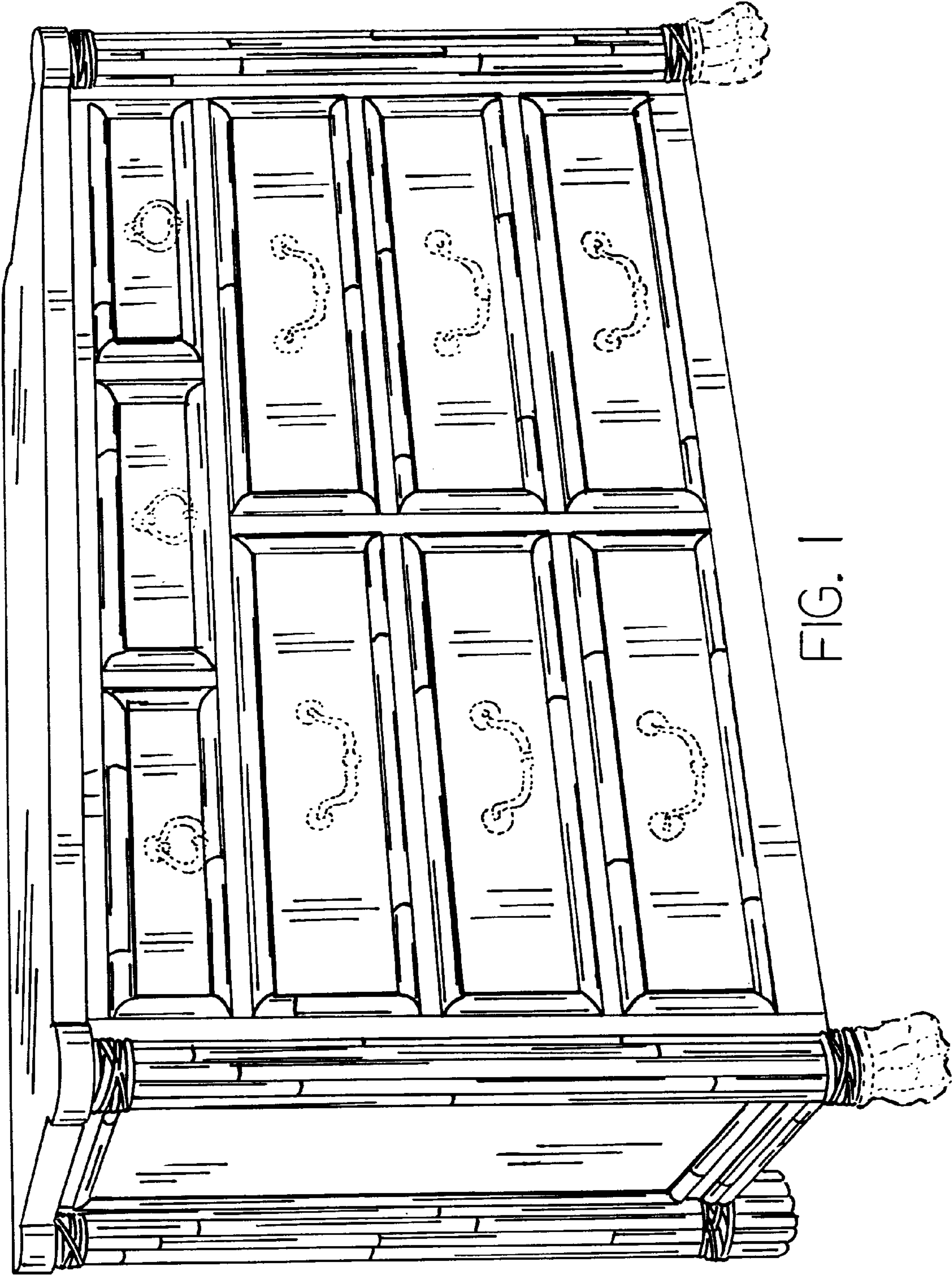

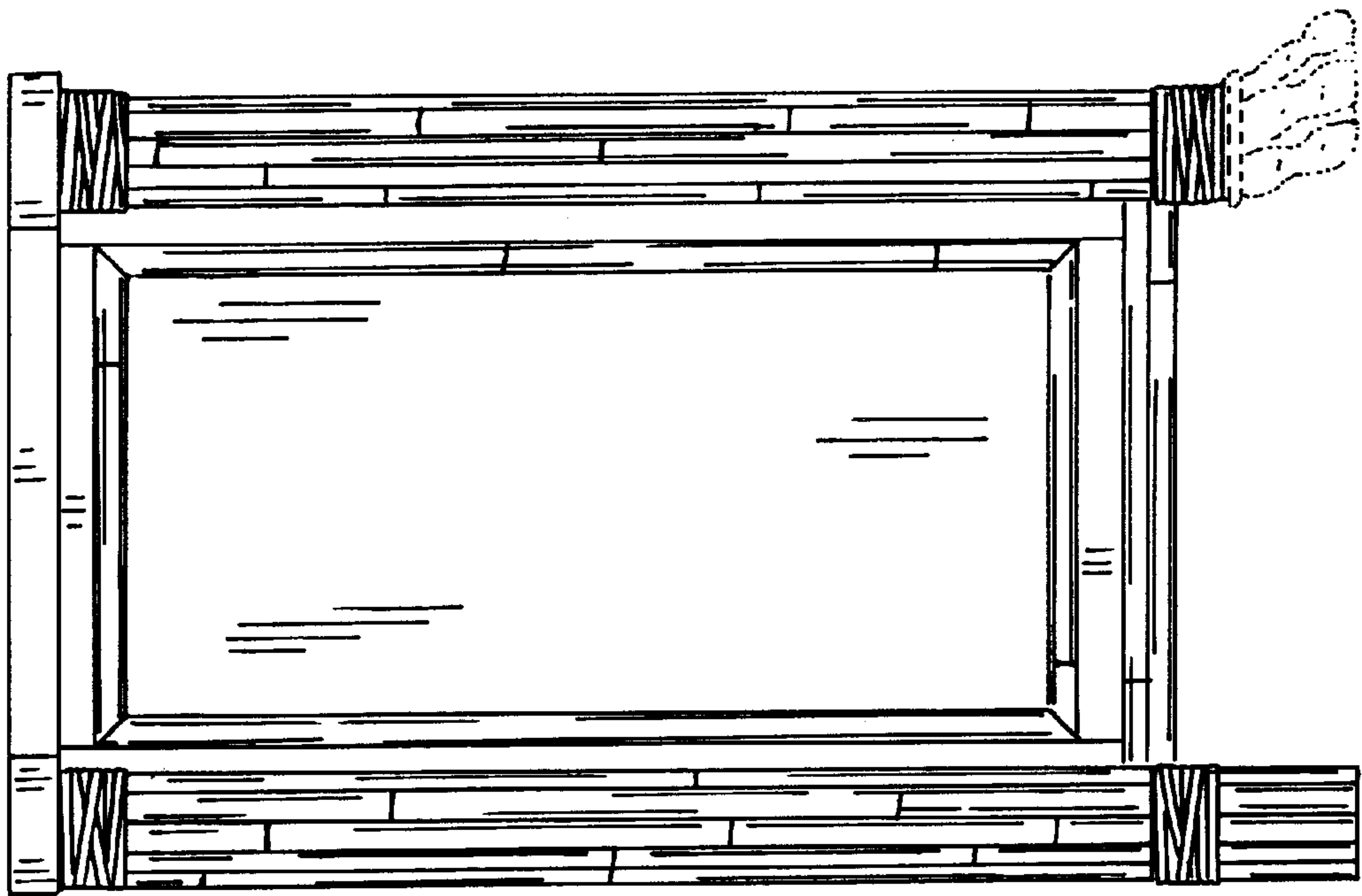

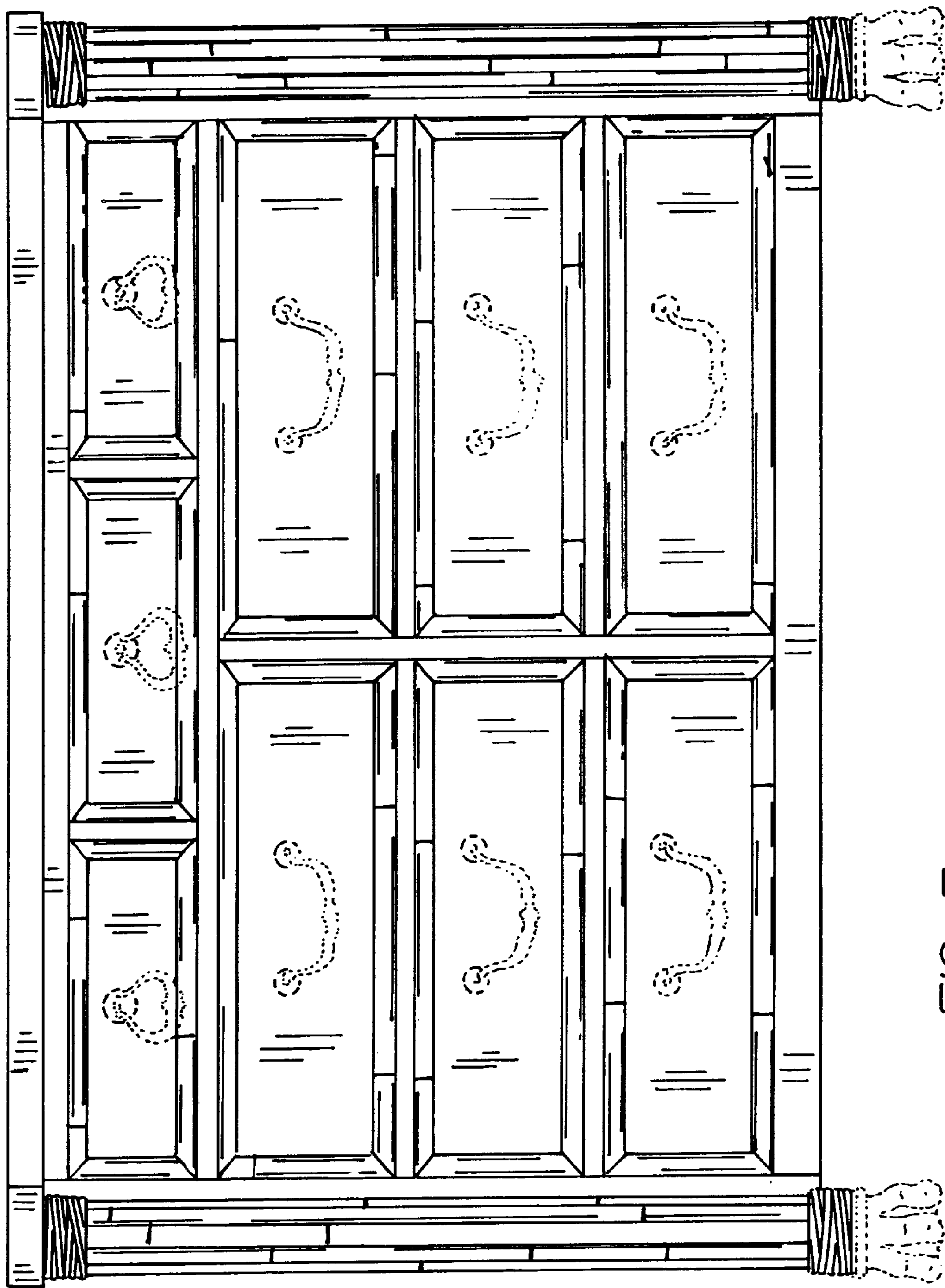

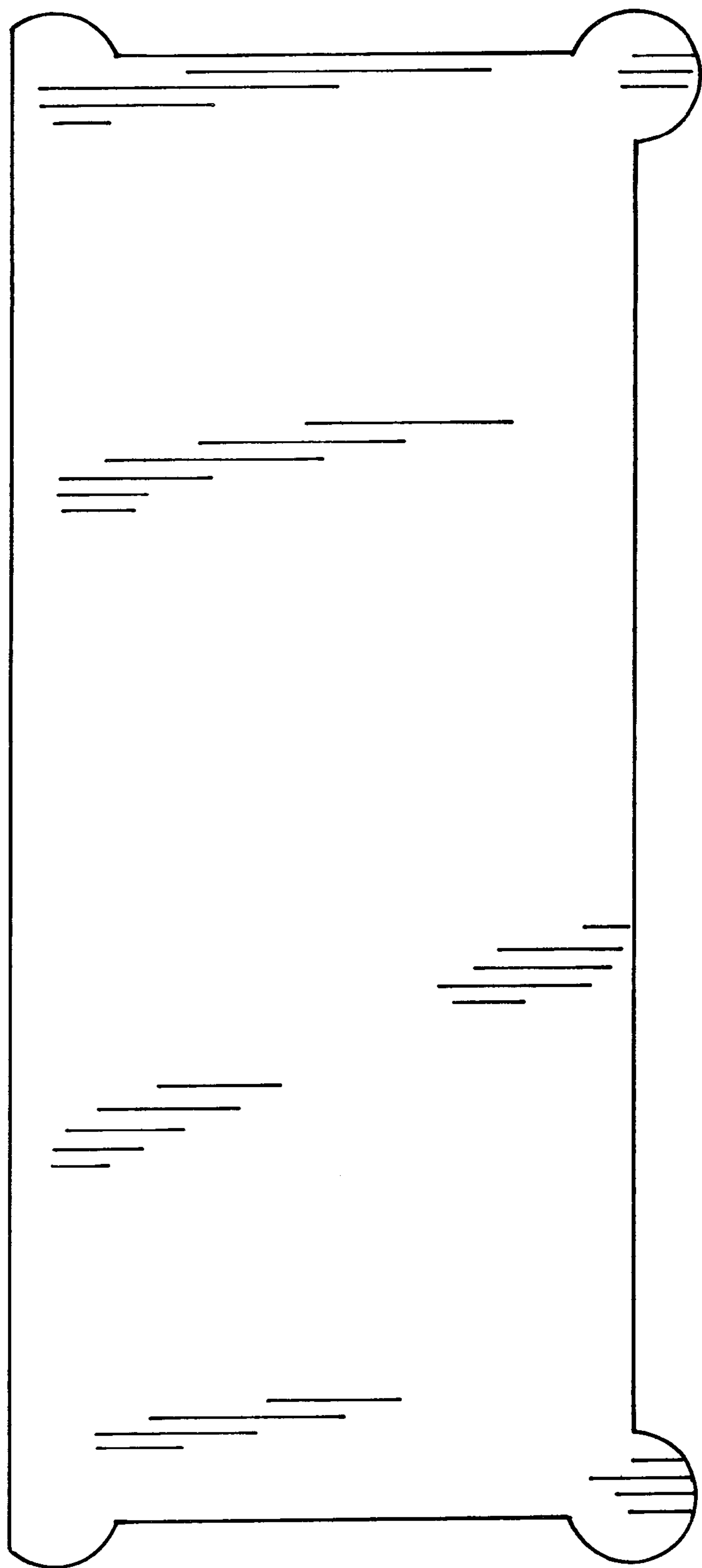
