FIG. 3 is a back end view of FIG. 1.

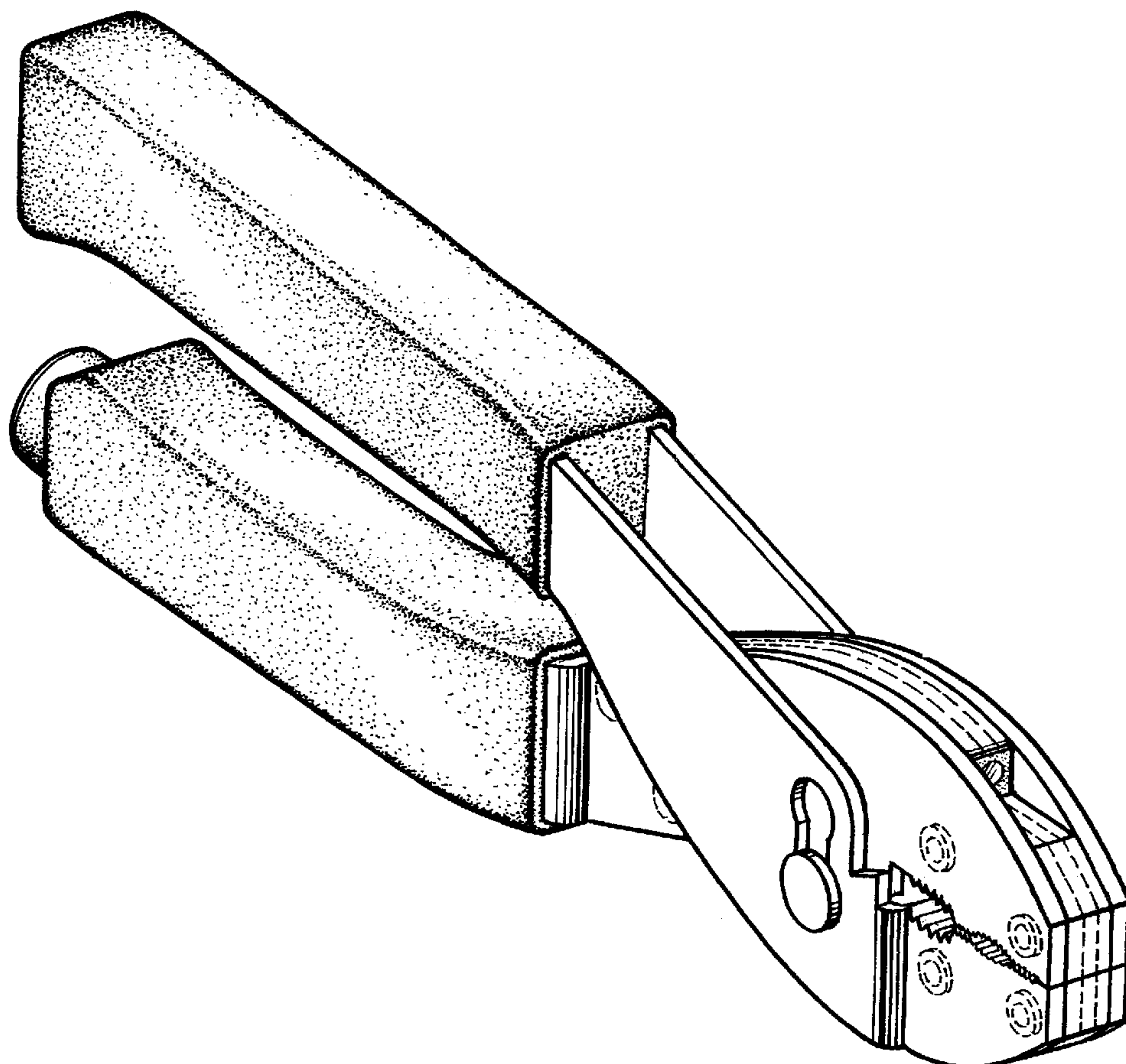
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1, wherein the opposite side is a mirror image.

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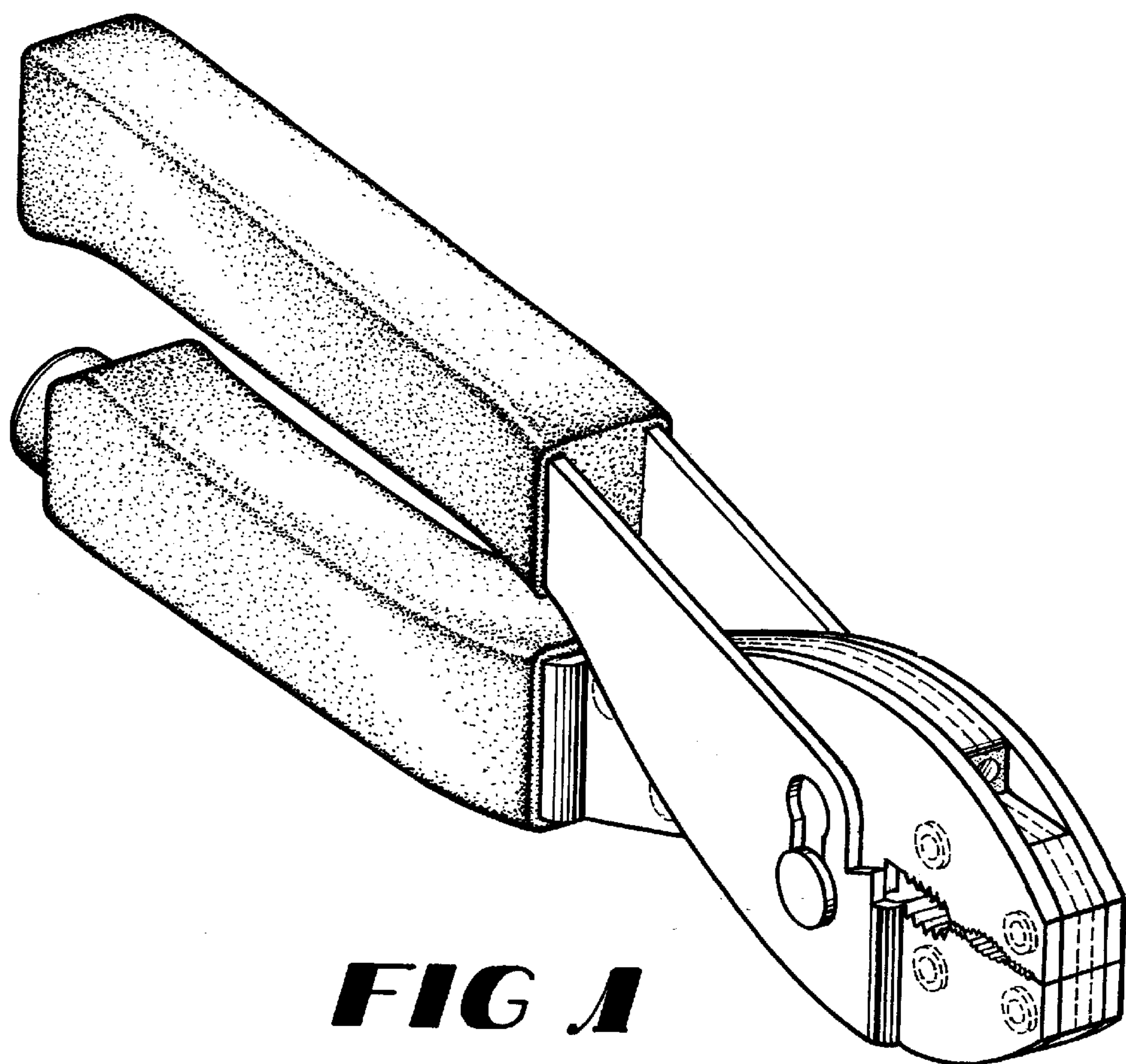

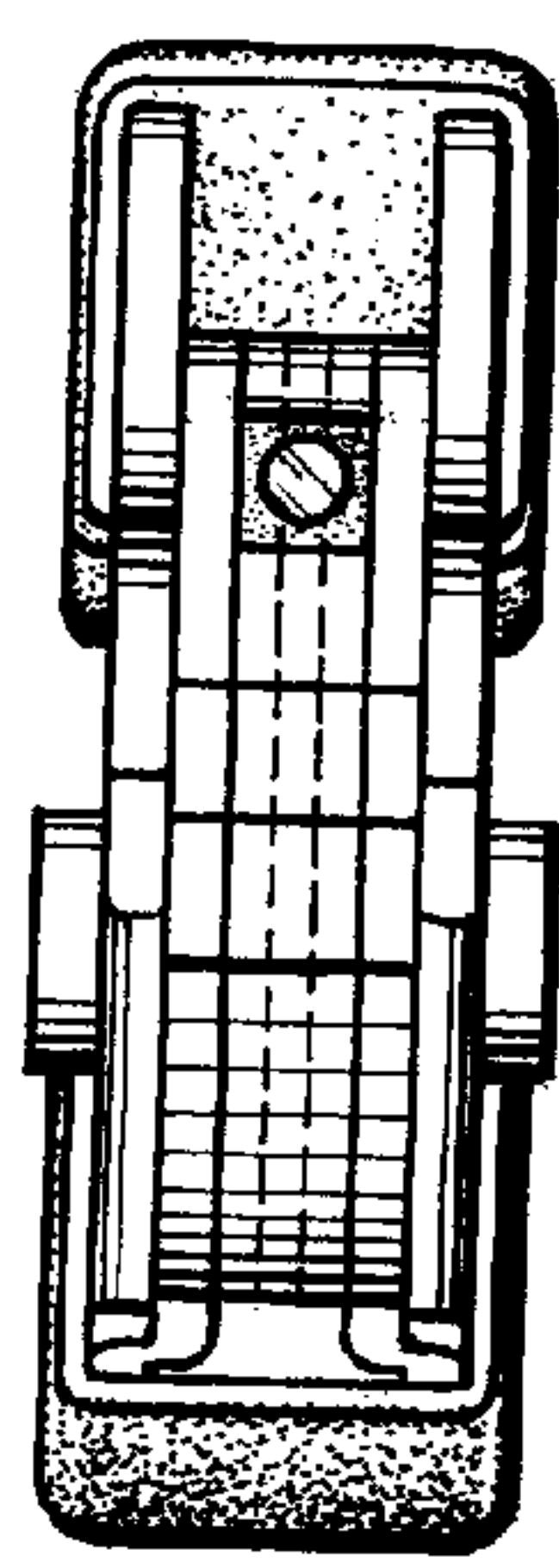

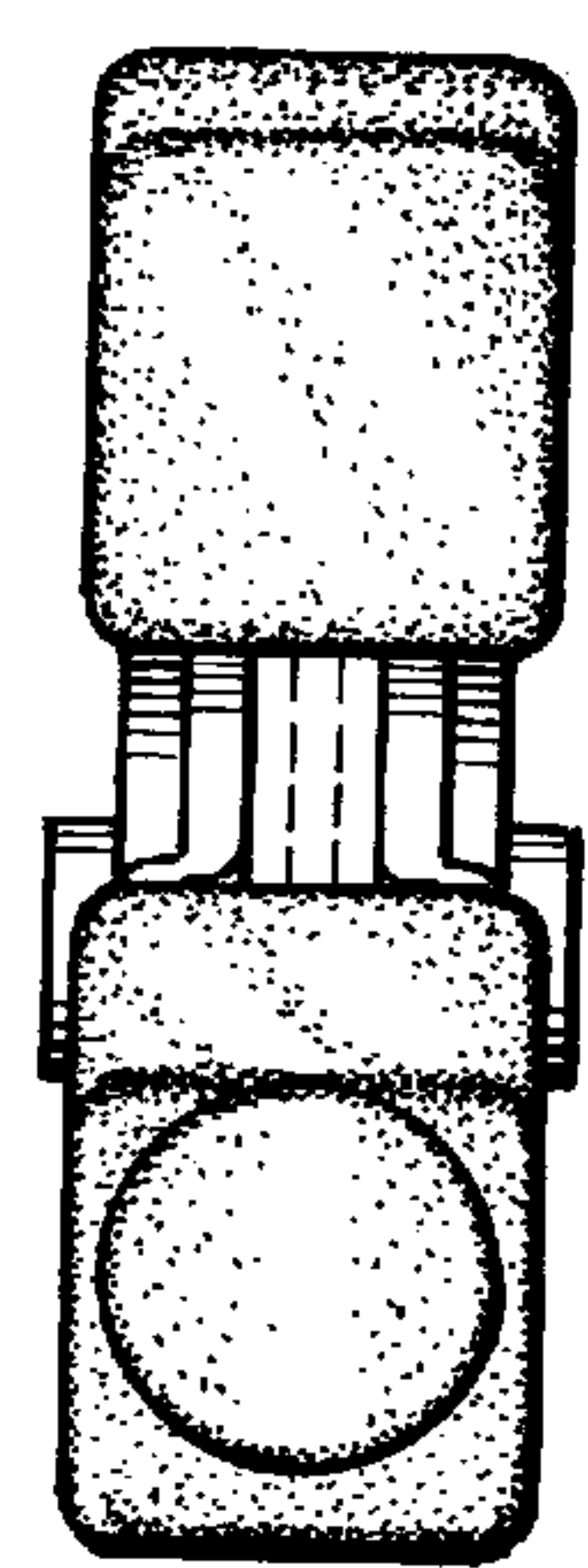

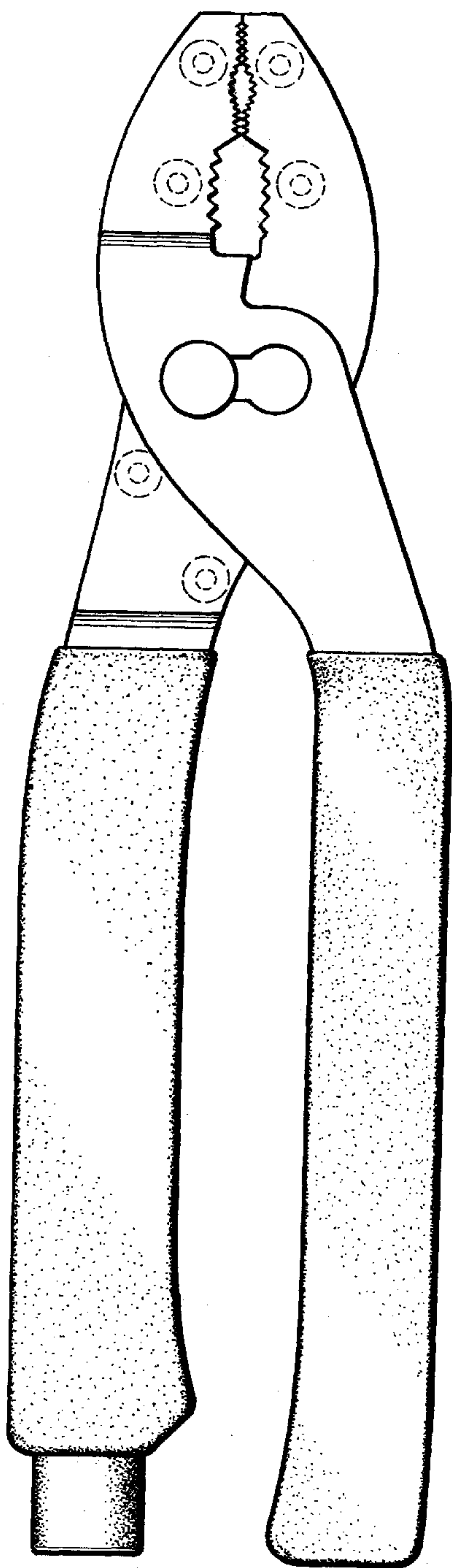

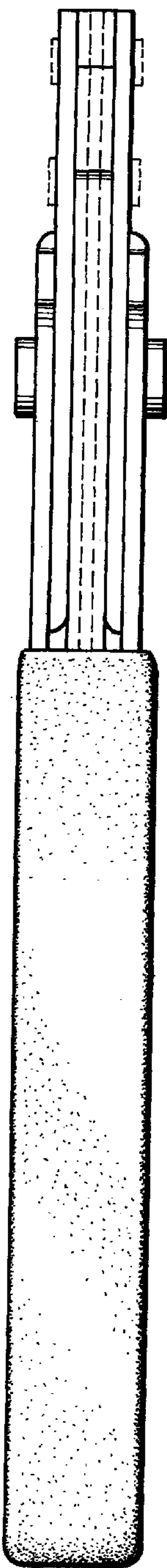

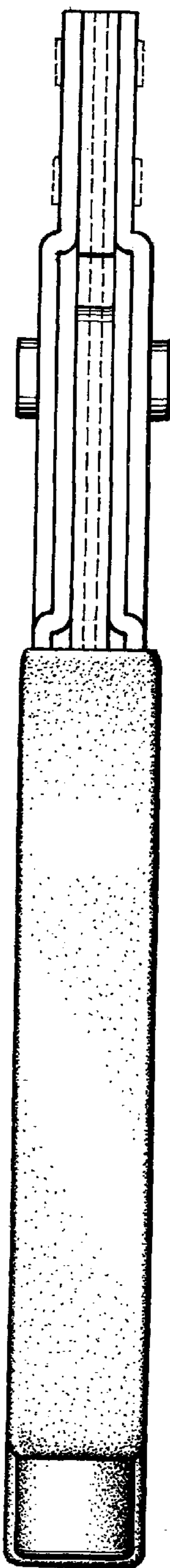
