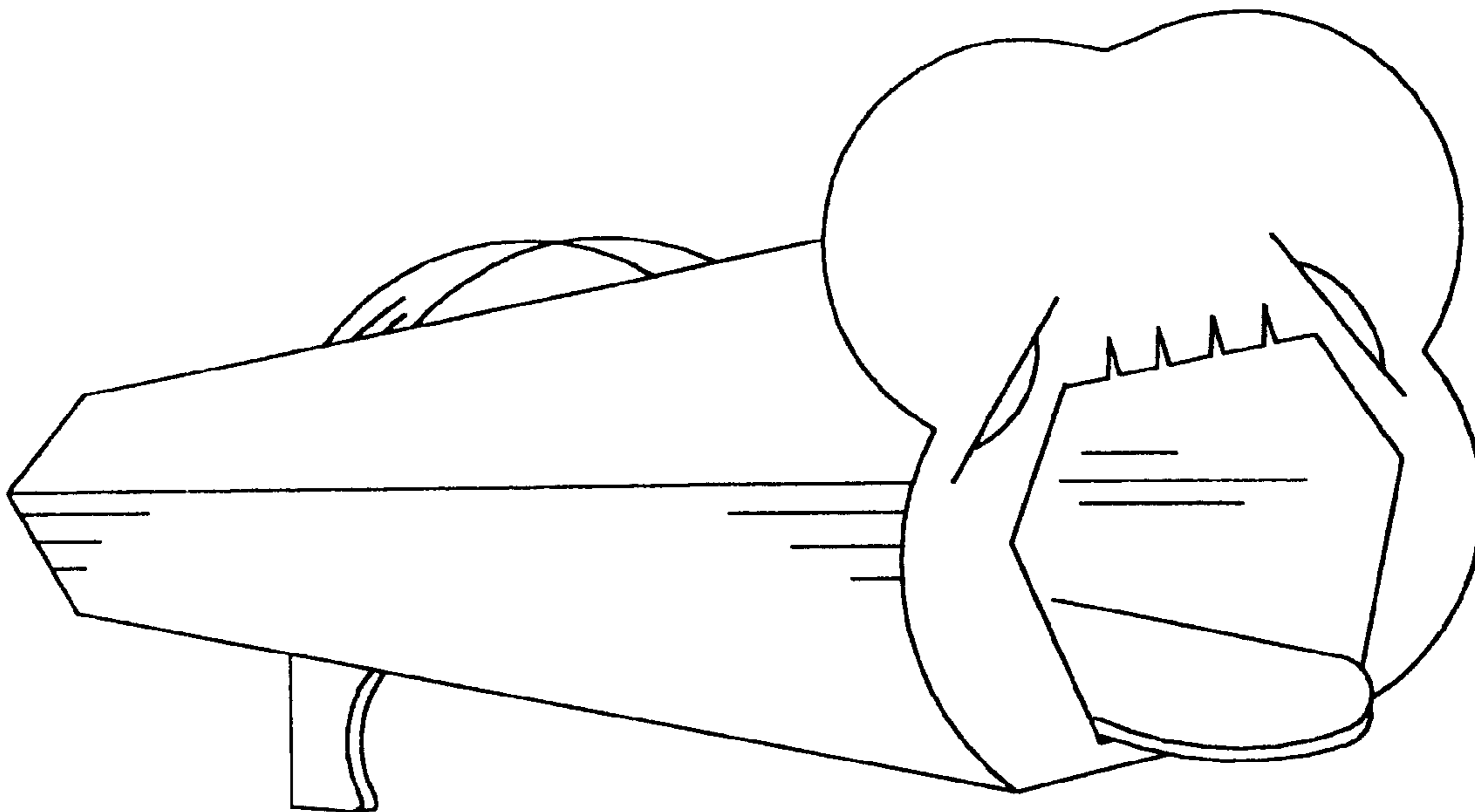
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a humorous megaphone, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a side view of a megaphone showing our new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof; FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is another perspective view of our humorous megaphone with the tongue fully extended therefrom.

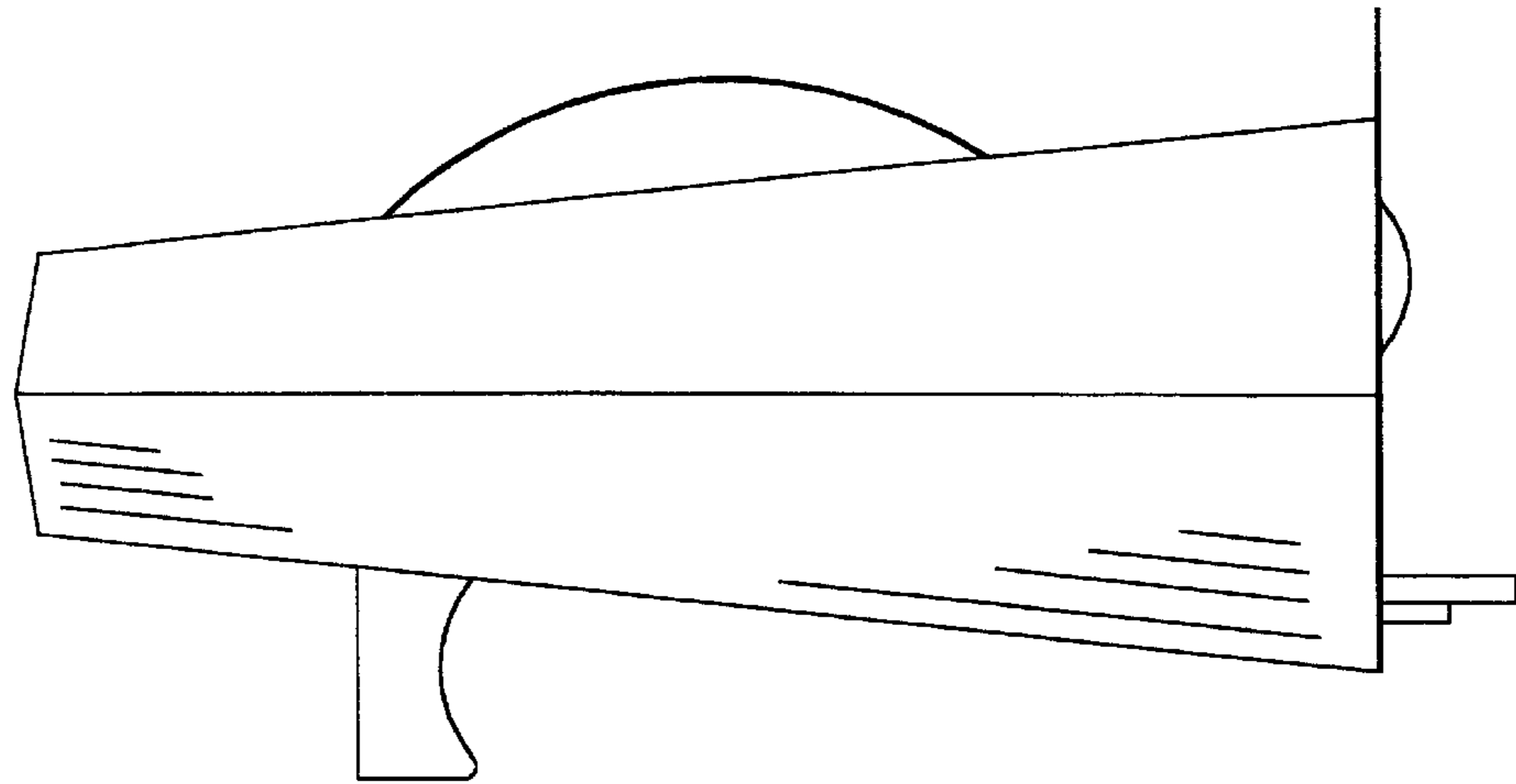

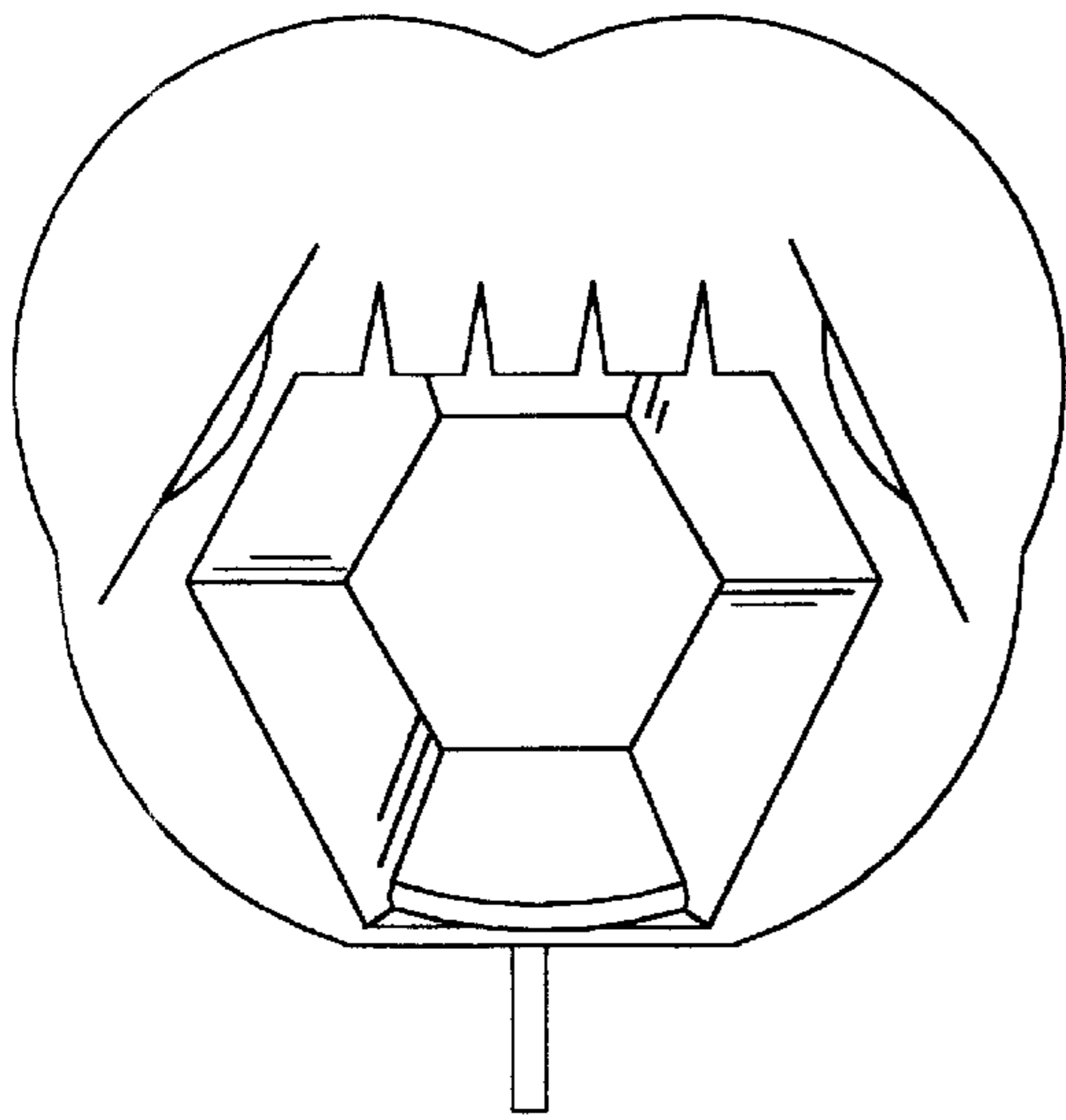

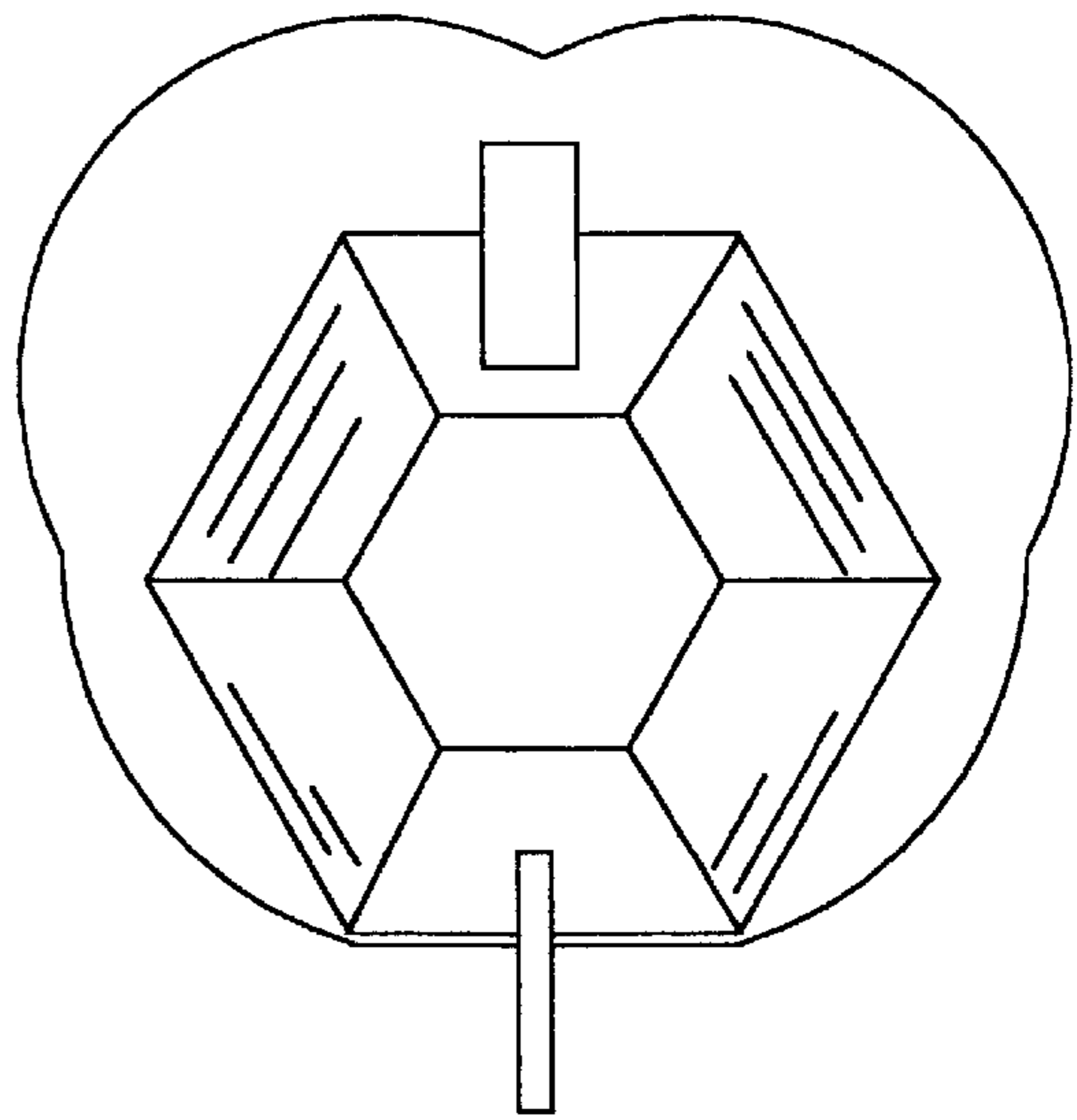

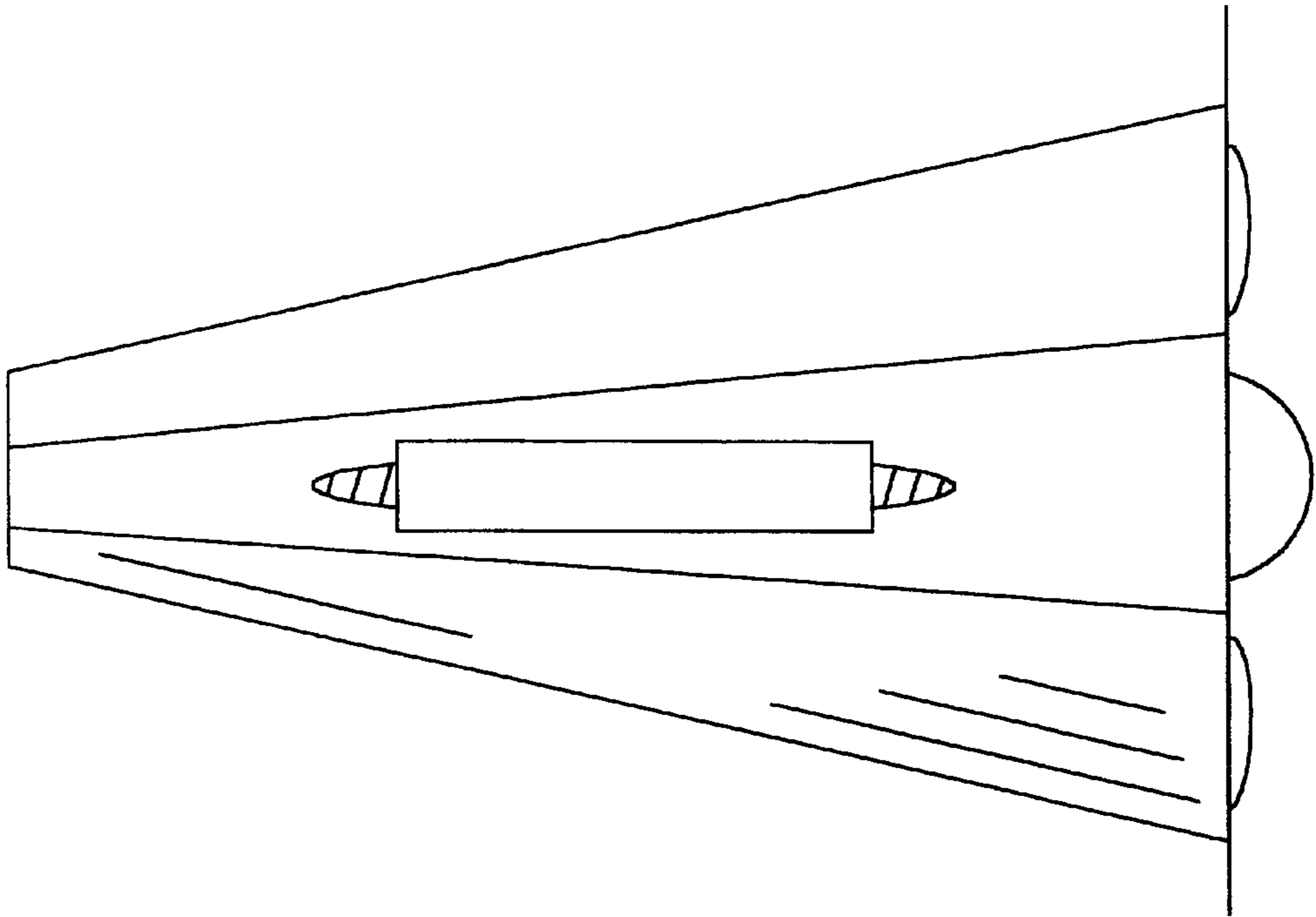

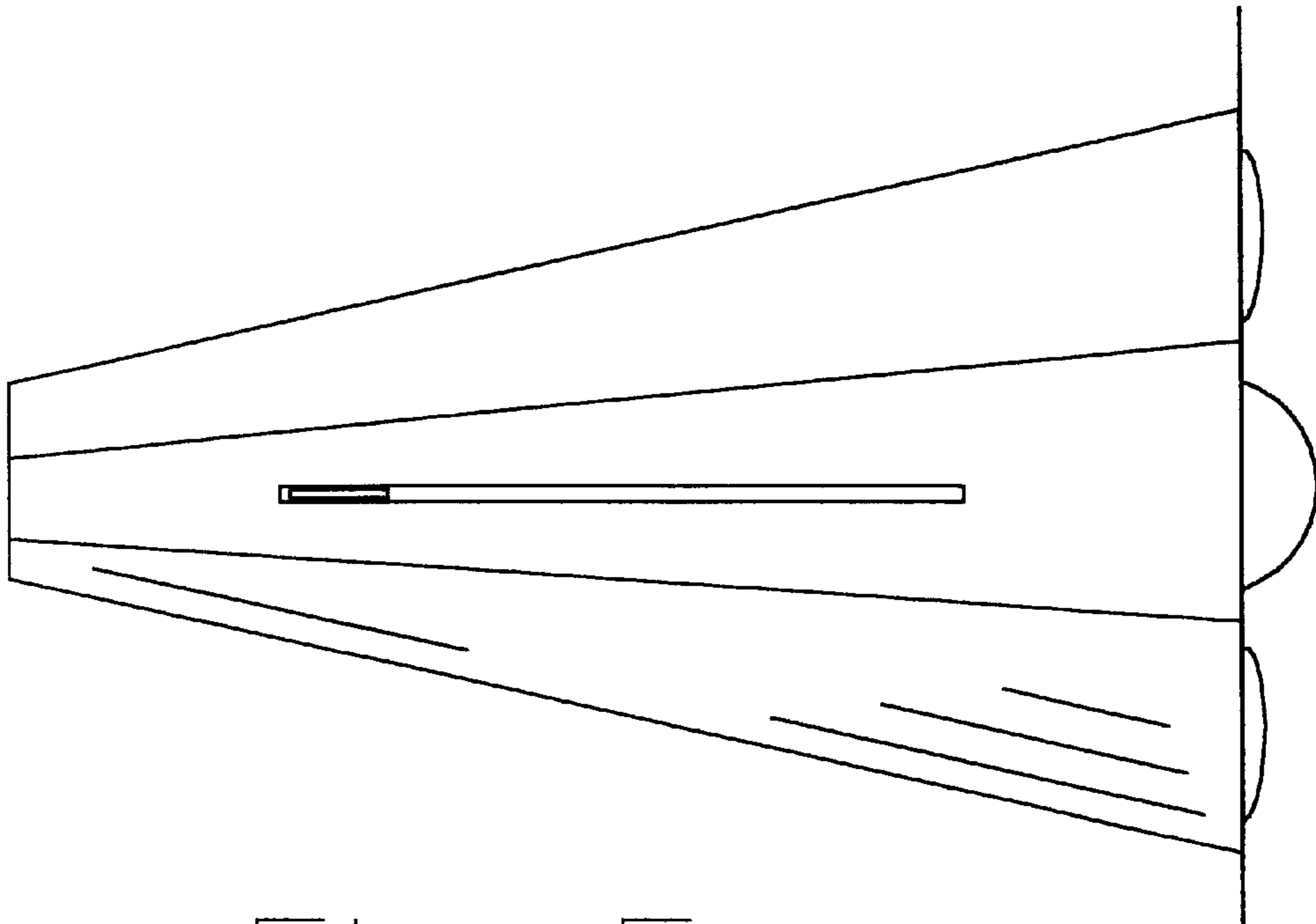

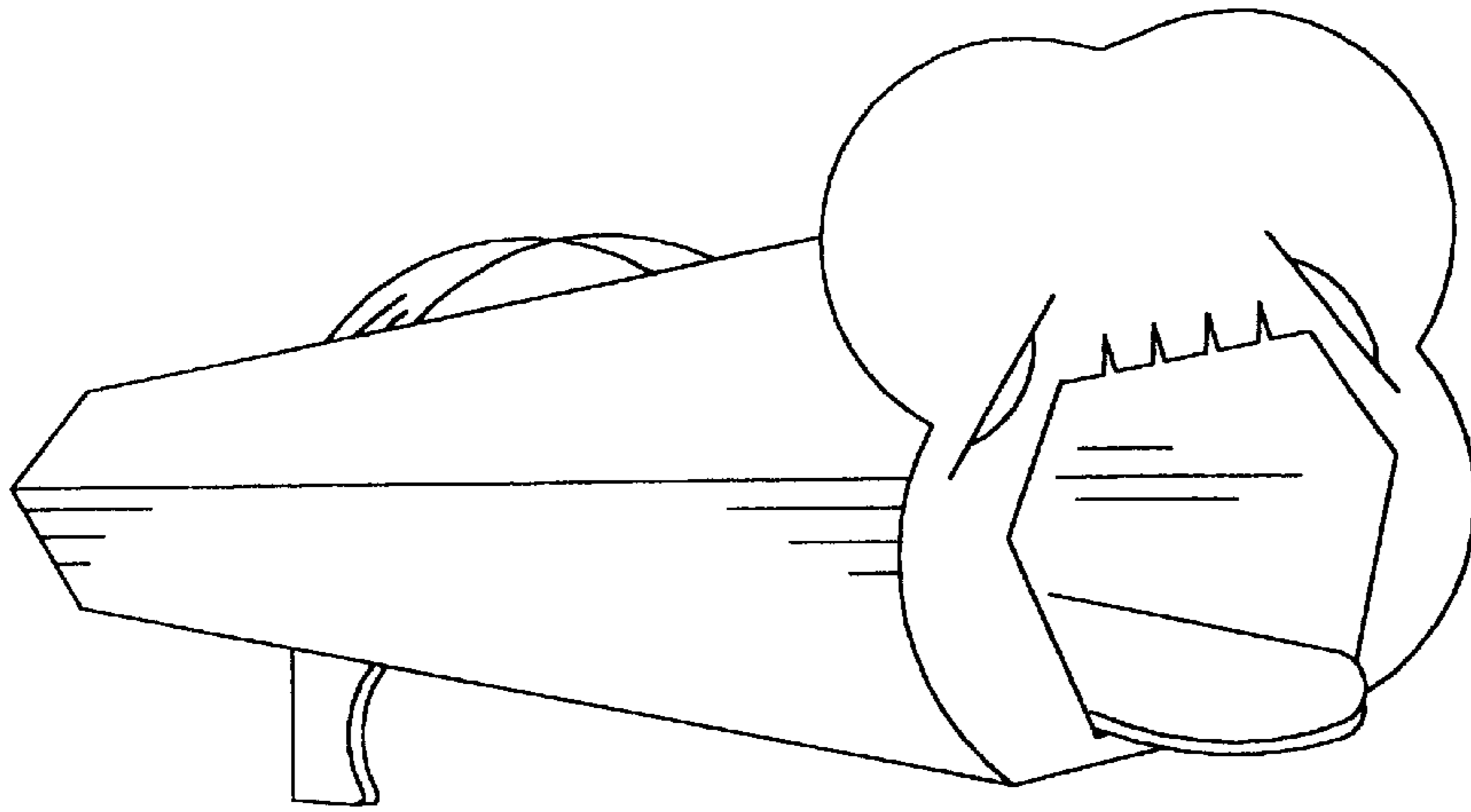

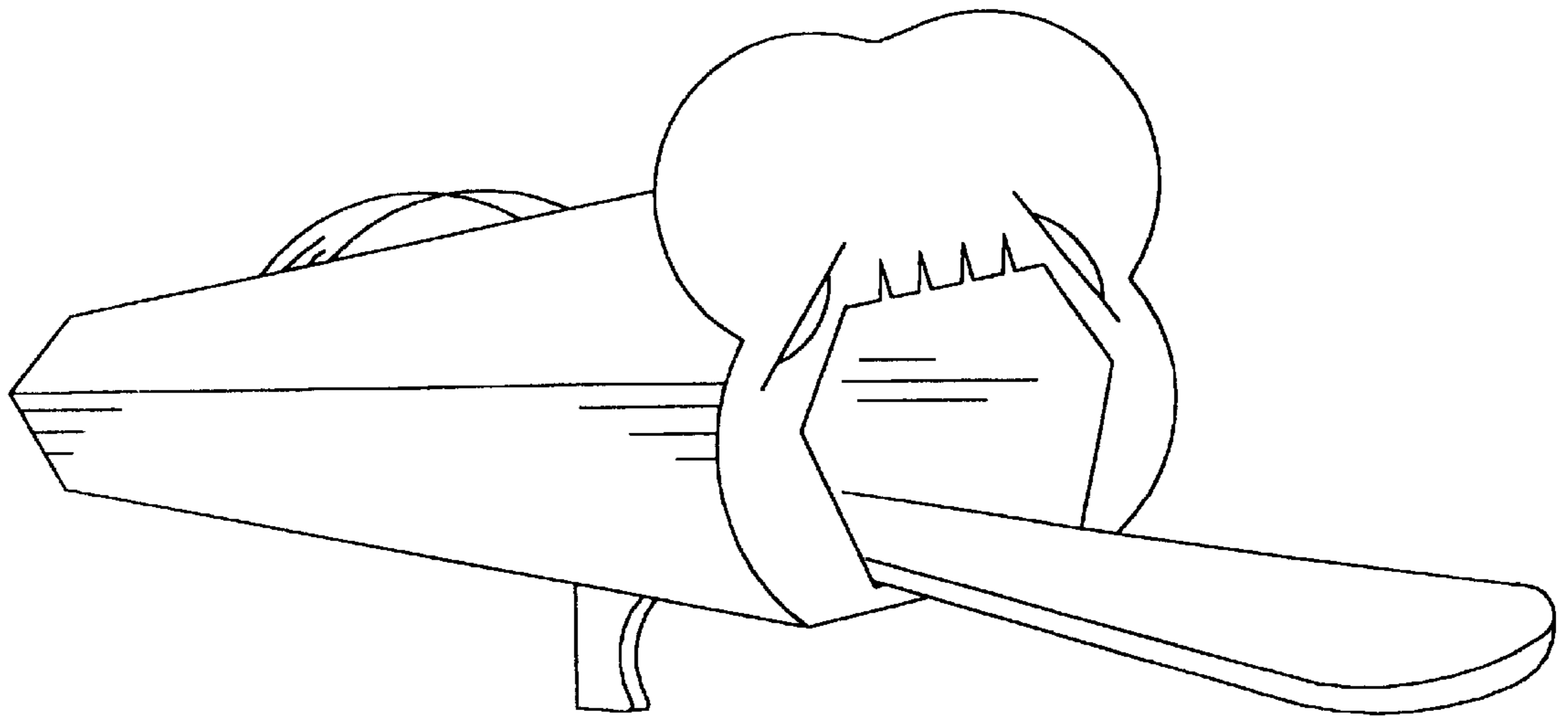
