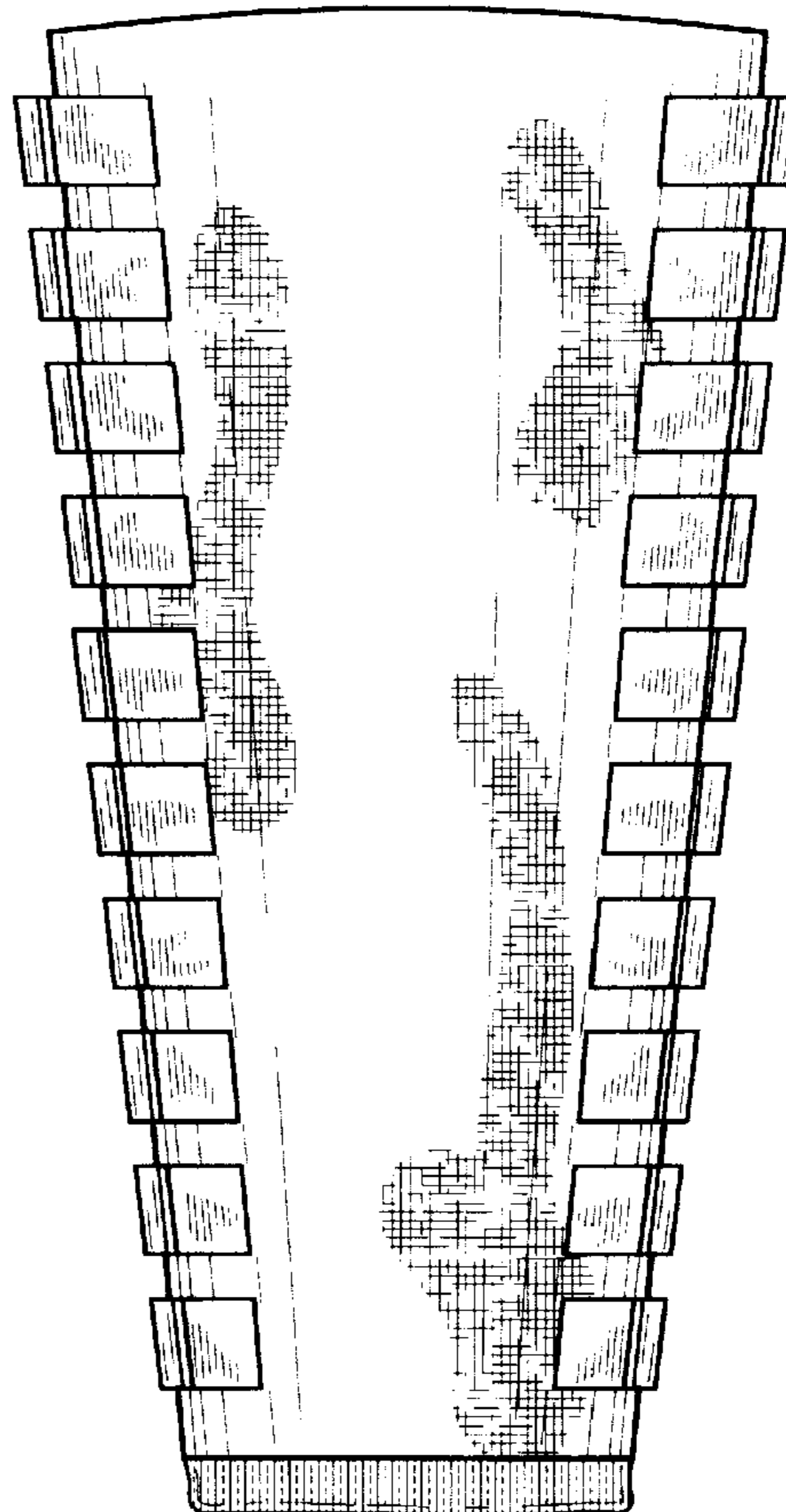
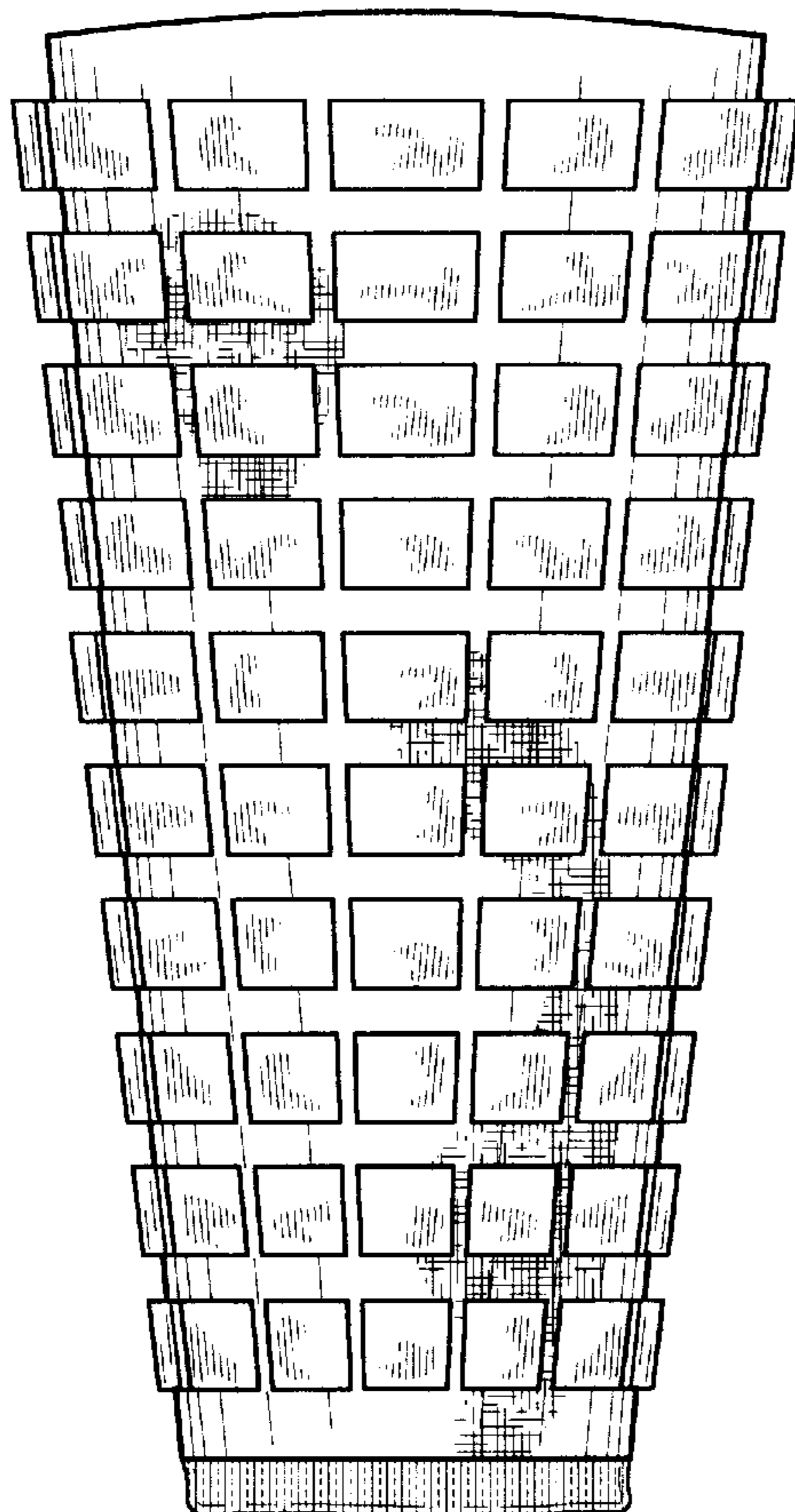
The ornamental design for a forearm guard, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the forearm guard of the present invention;
 FIG. 2 is a back elevational view of the forearm guard of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the forearm guard of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the forearm guard of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the forearm guard of FIG. 1; and,
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the forearm guard of FIG. 1.

The fragmentary cris-cross pattern shown in the drawing is understood to represent fabric and is repeated uniformly throughout the areas shown.

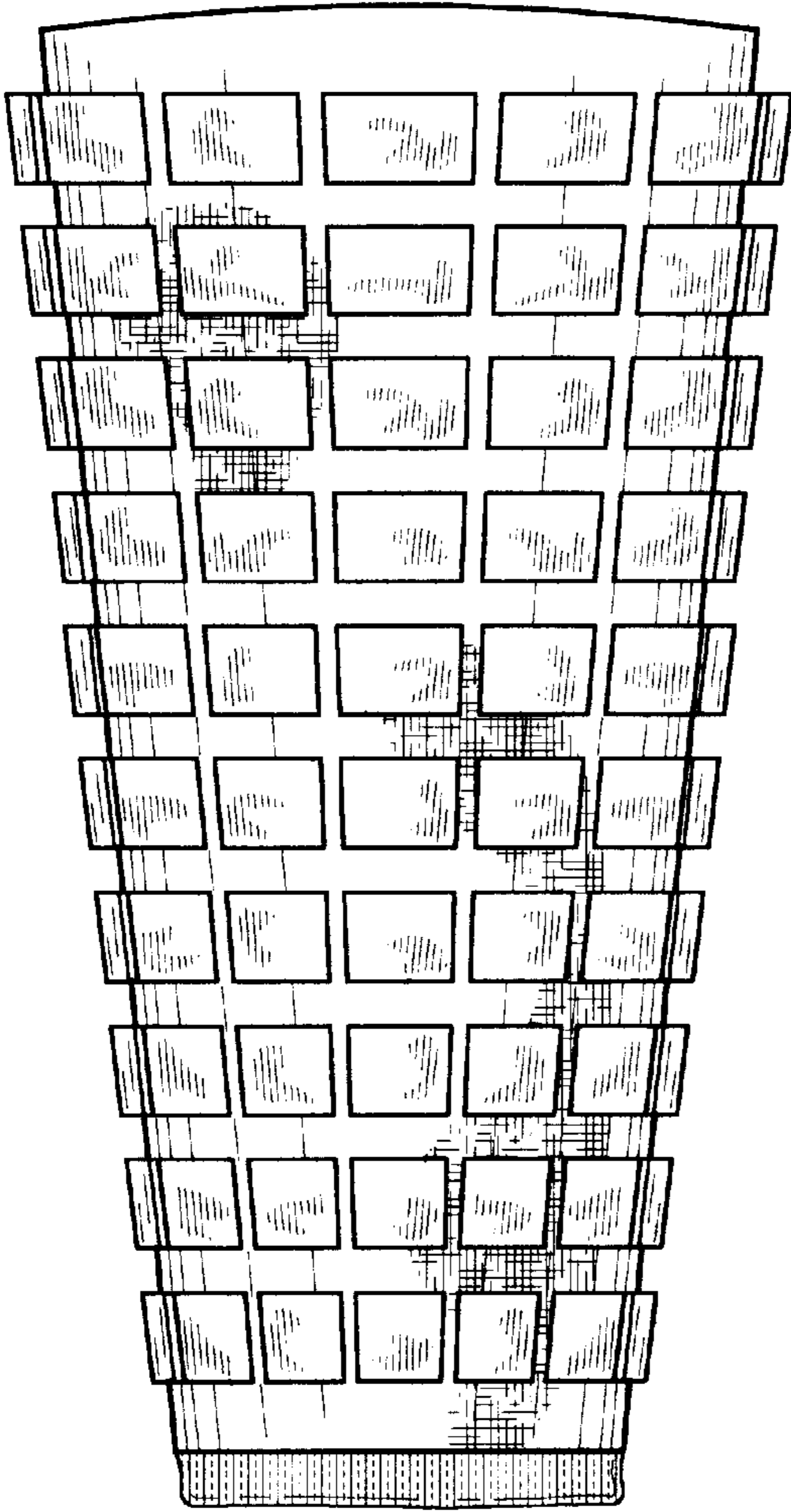

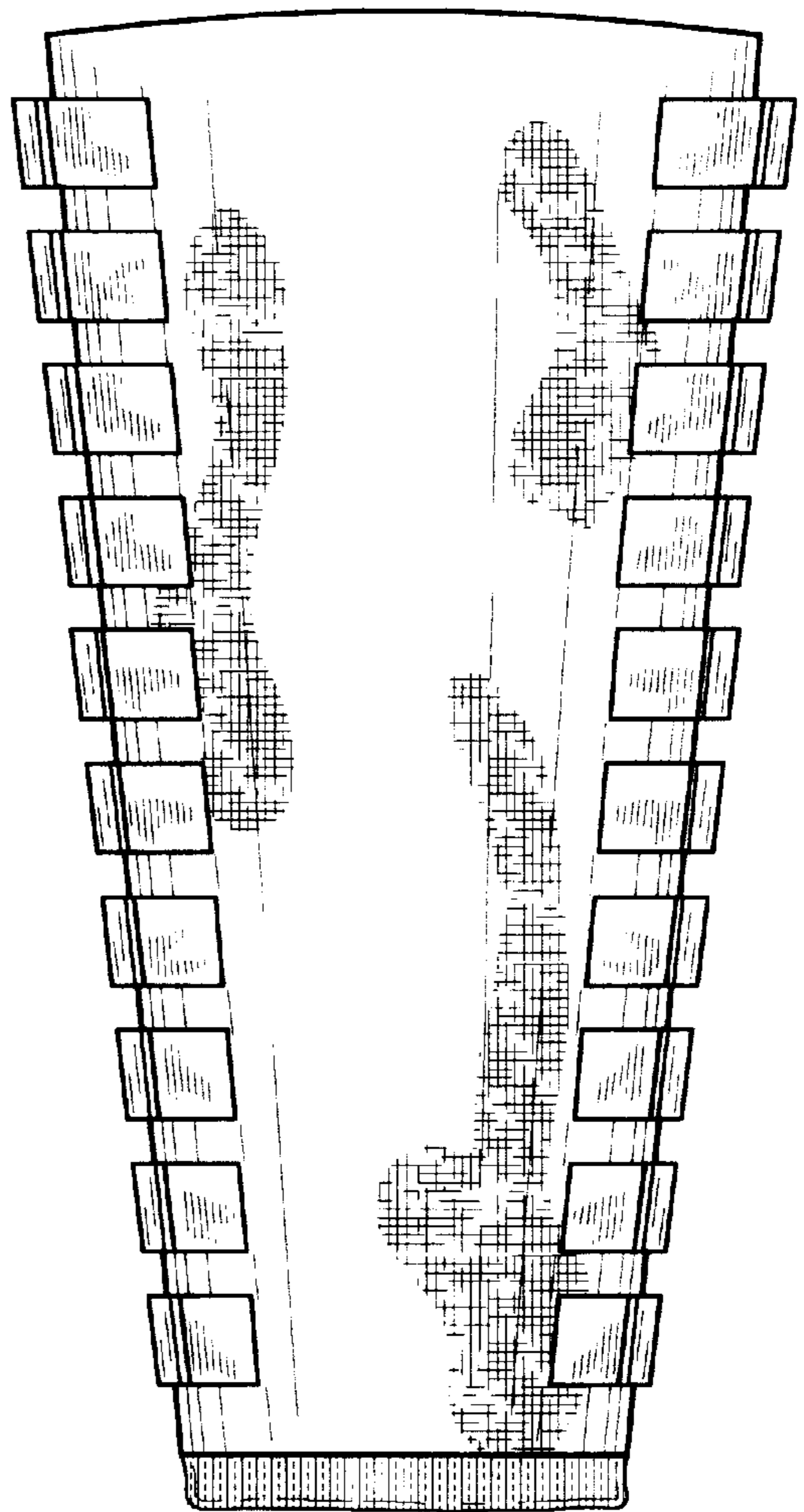

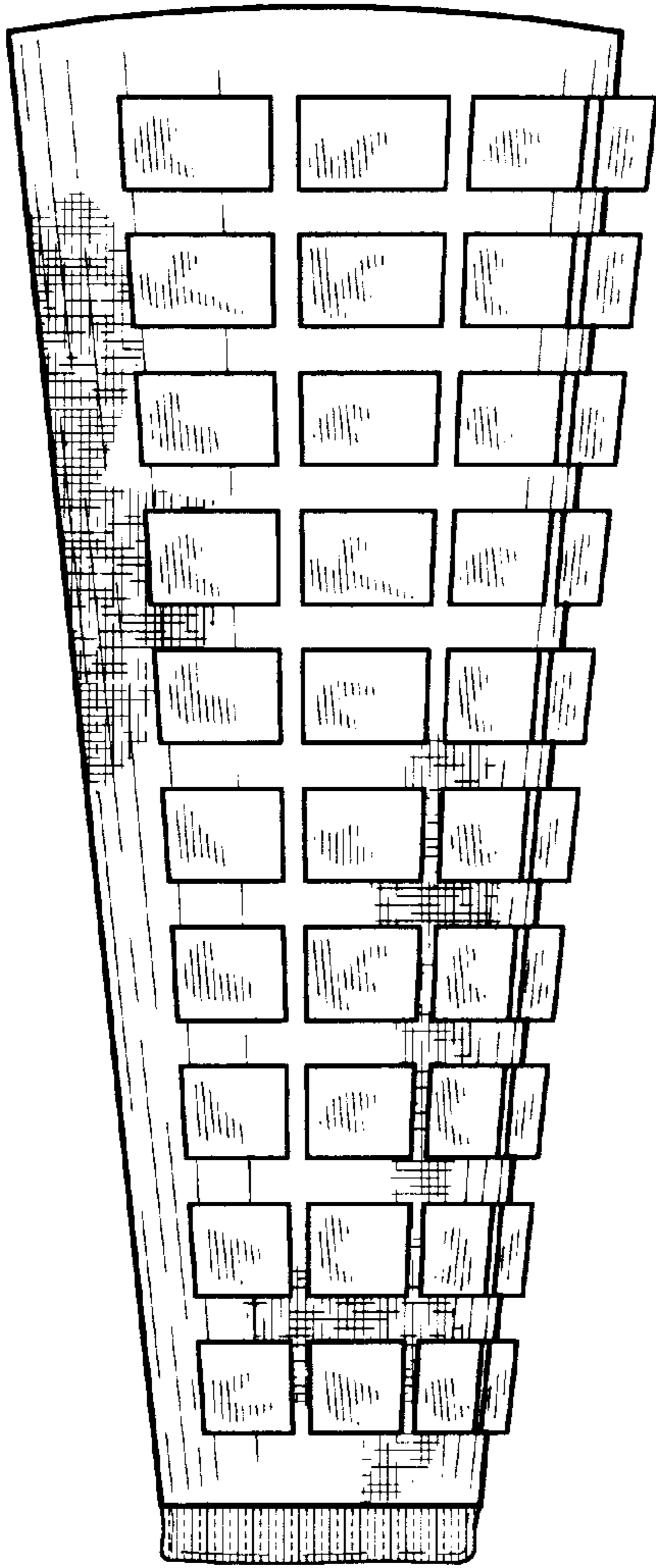

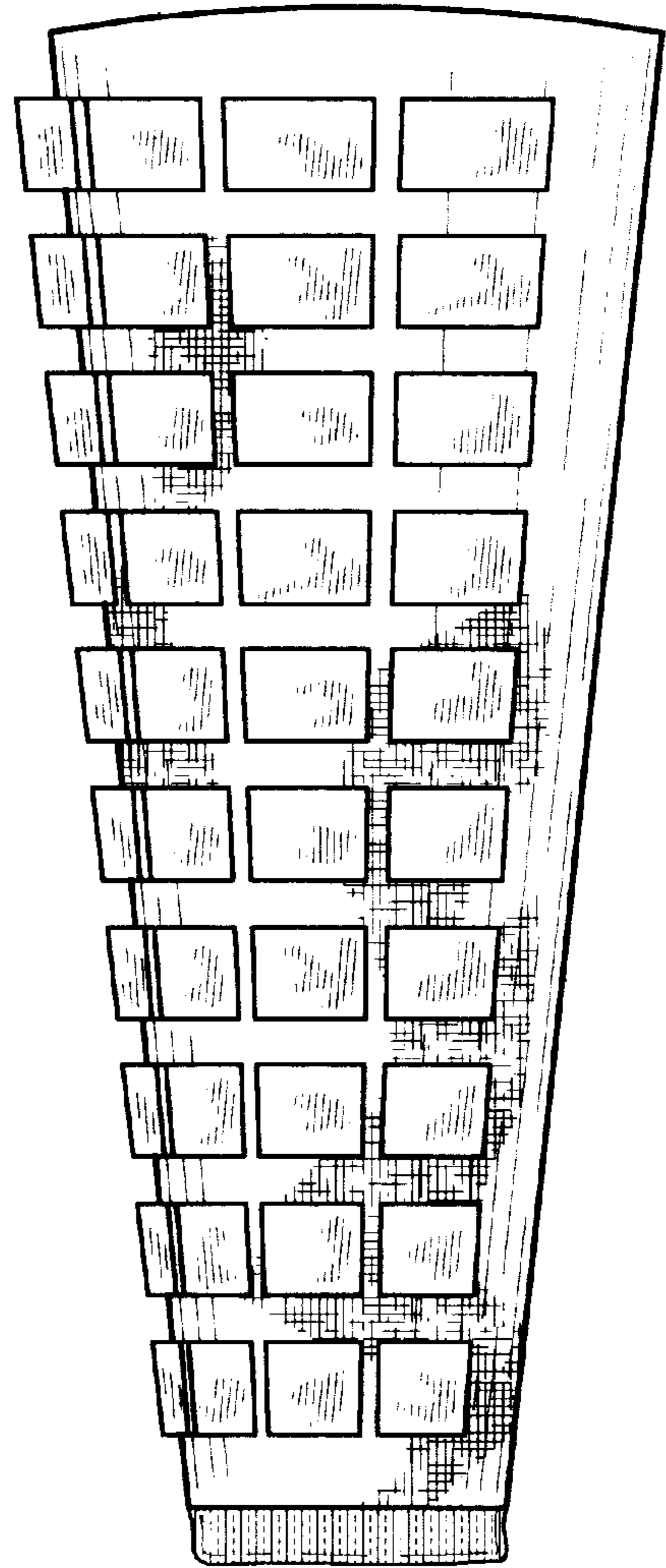

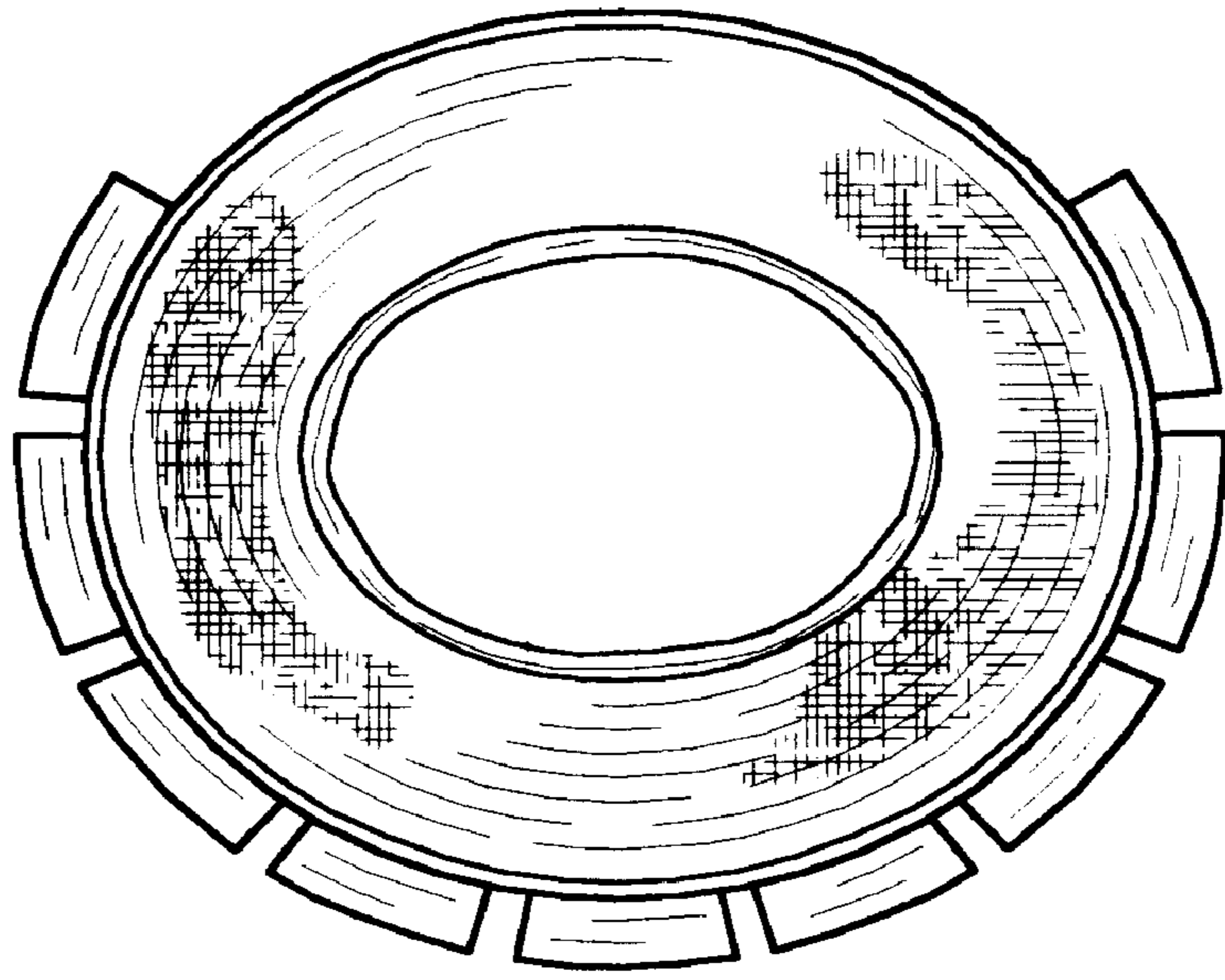

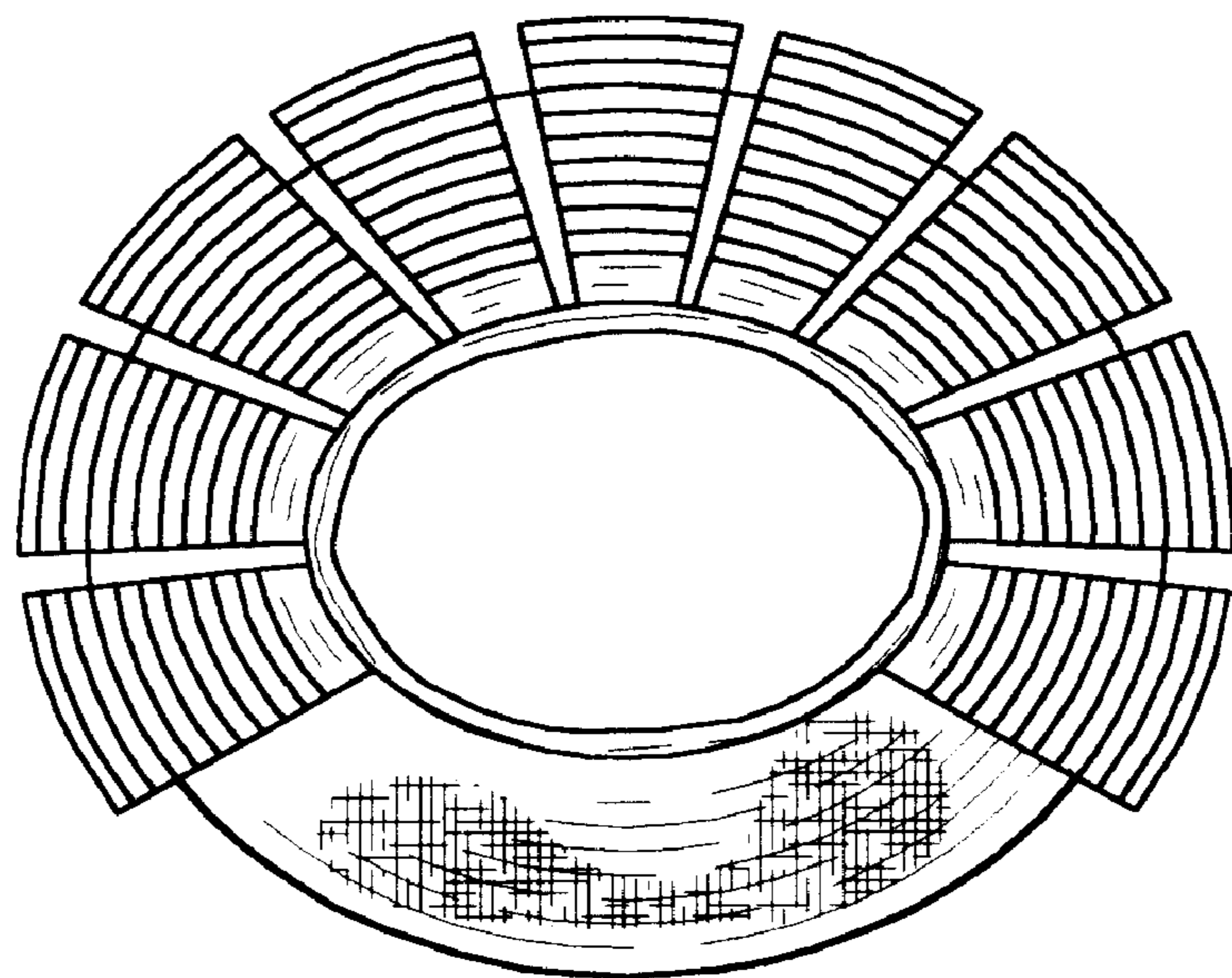
