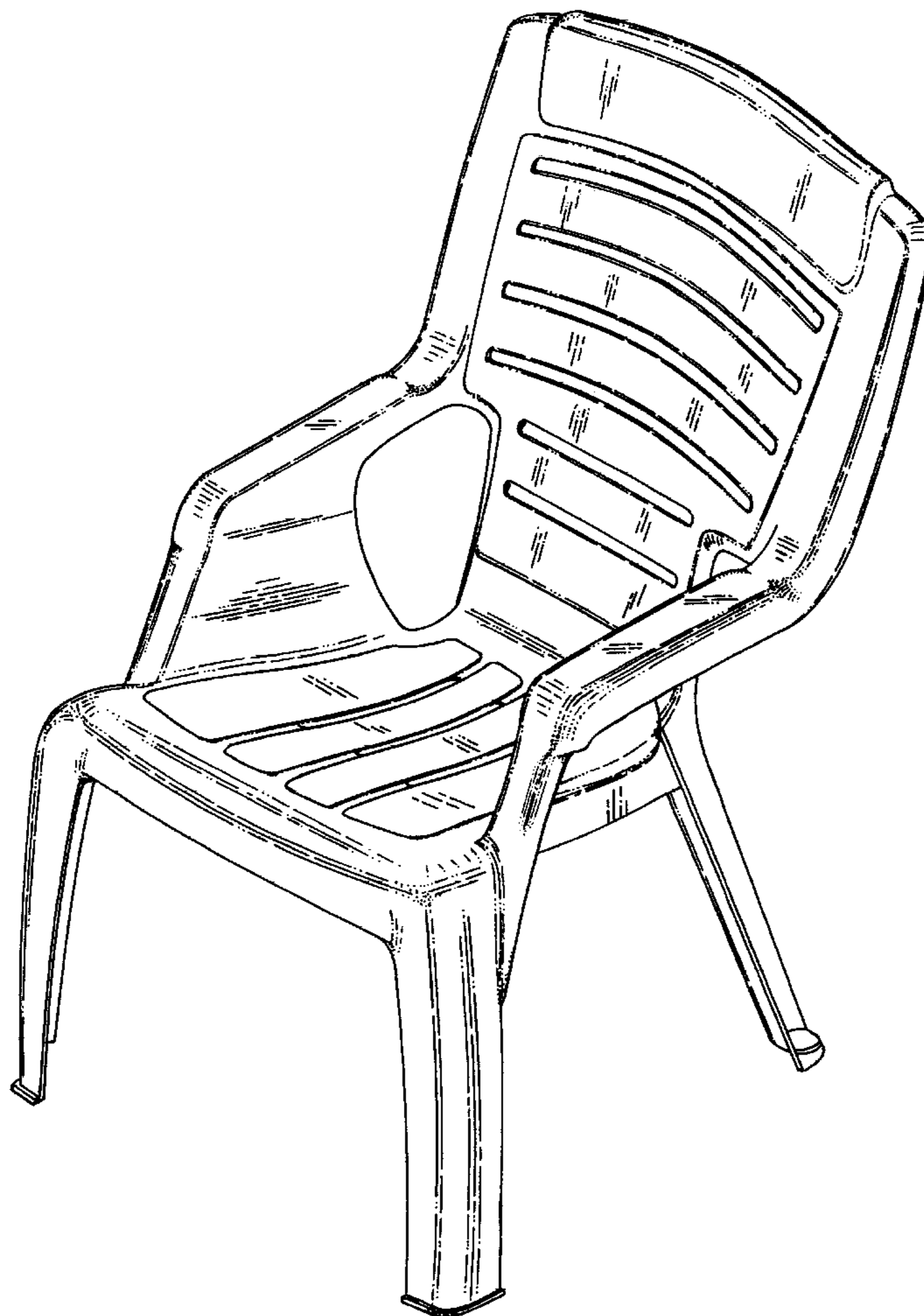
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the chair of our invention;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the chair shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a right elevational view of the chair shown in FIG. 1; the left elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1; and,
 FIG. 6 is a rear view of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1.

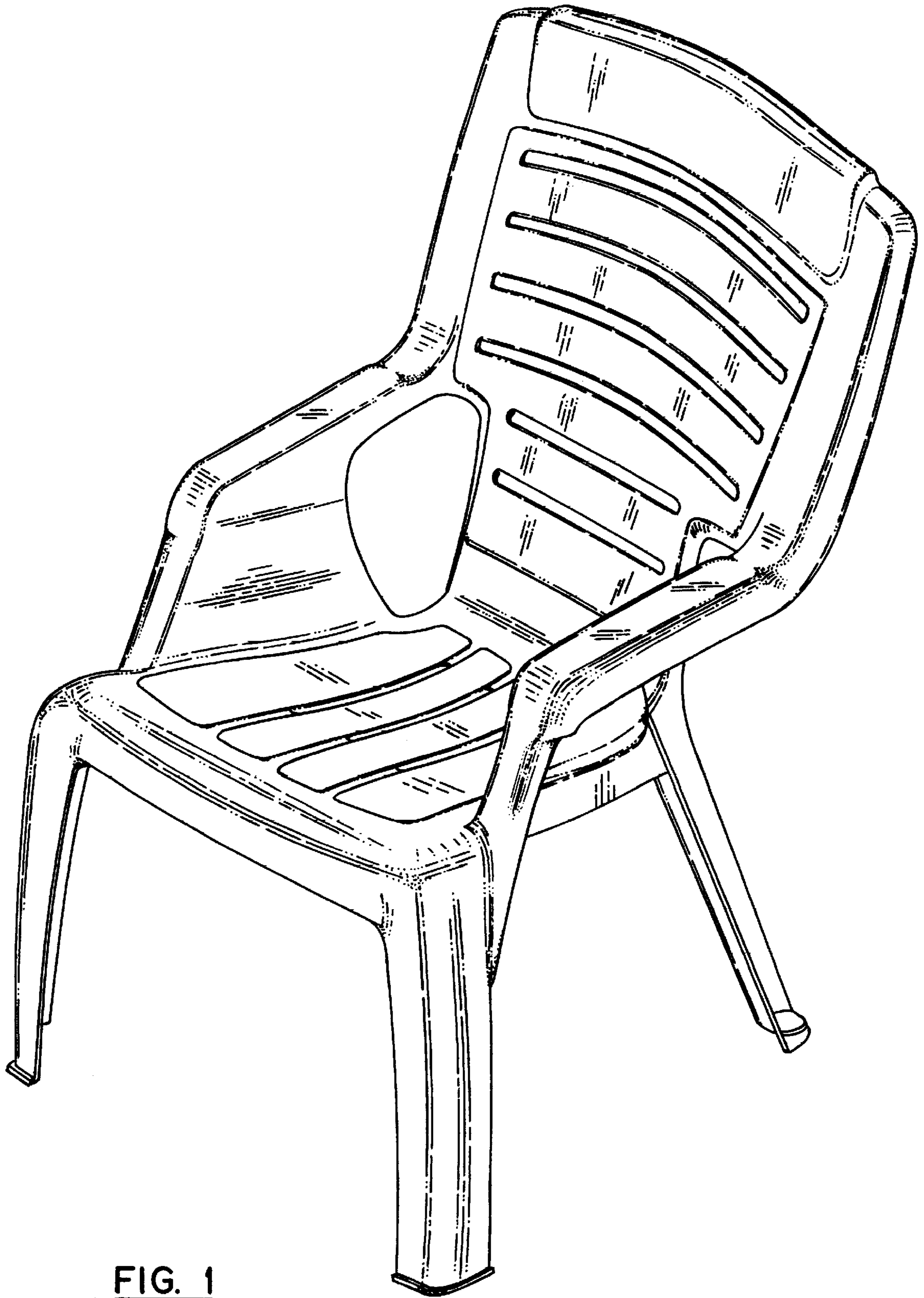

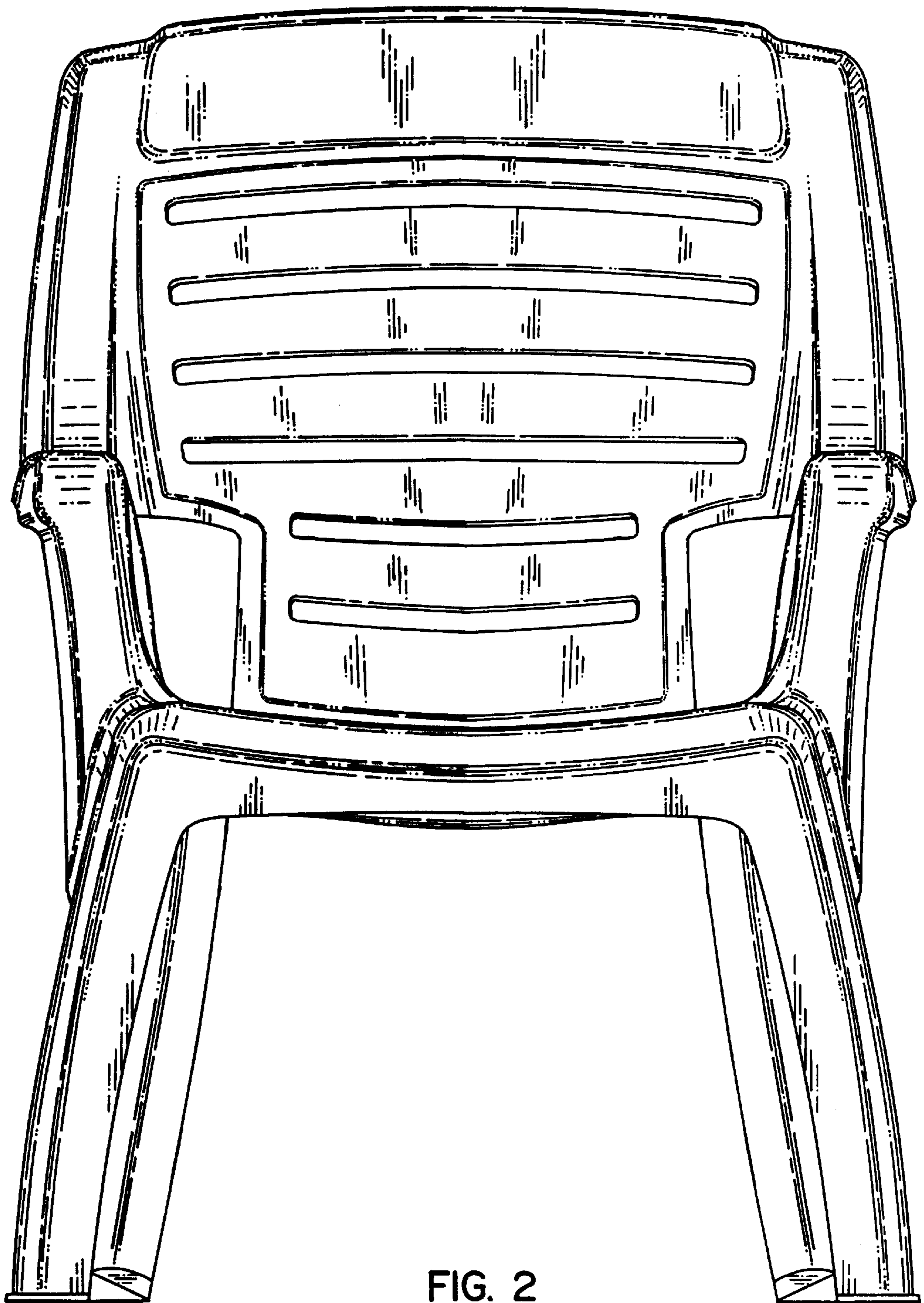

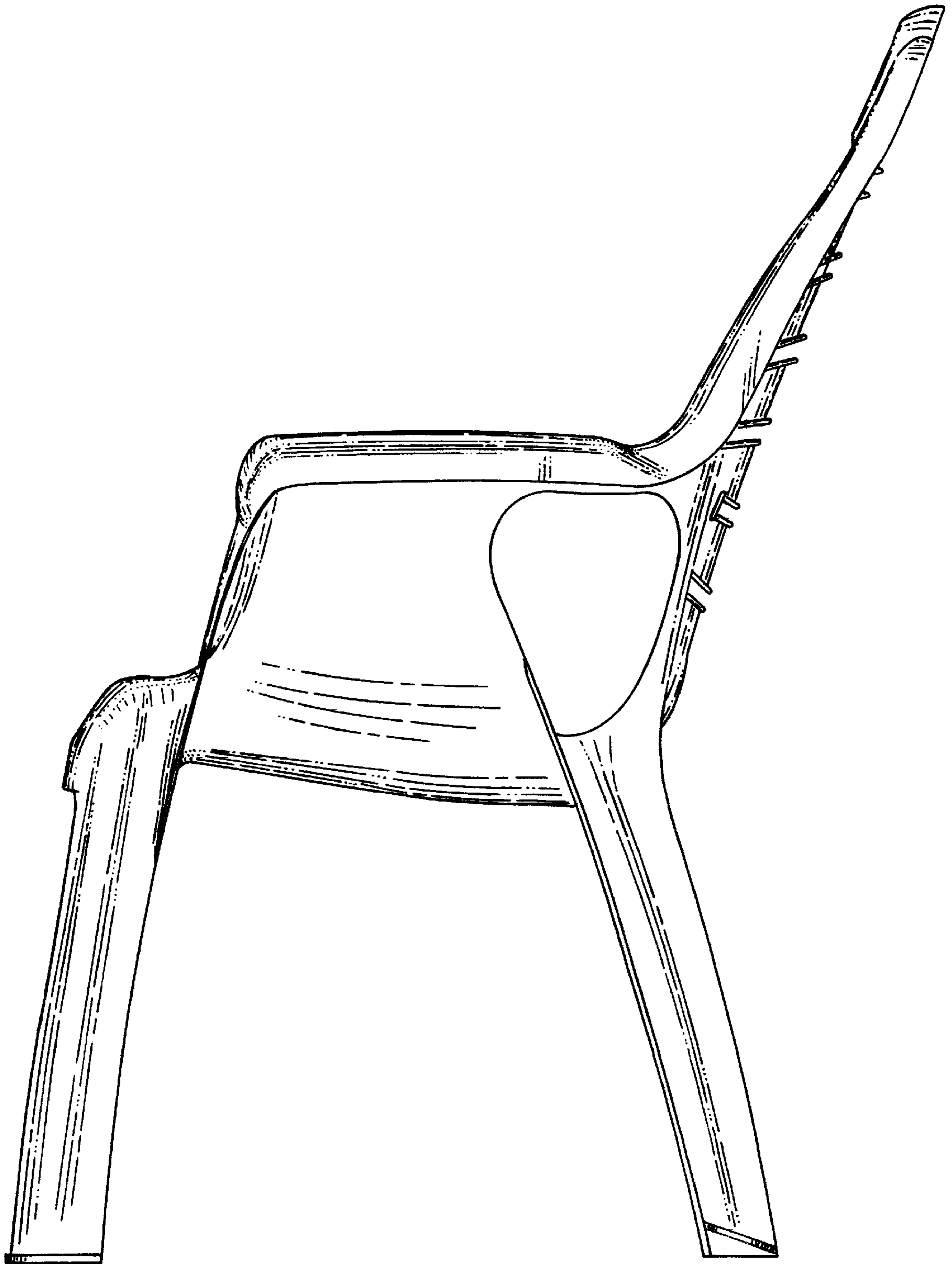

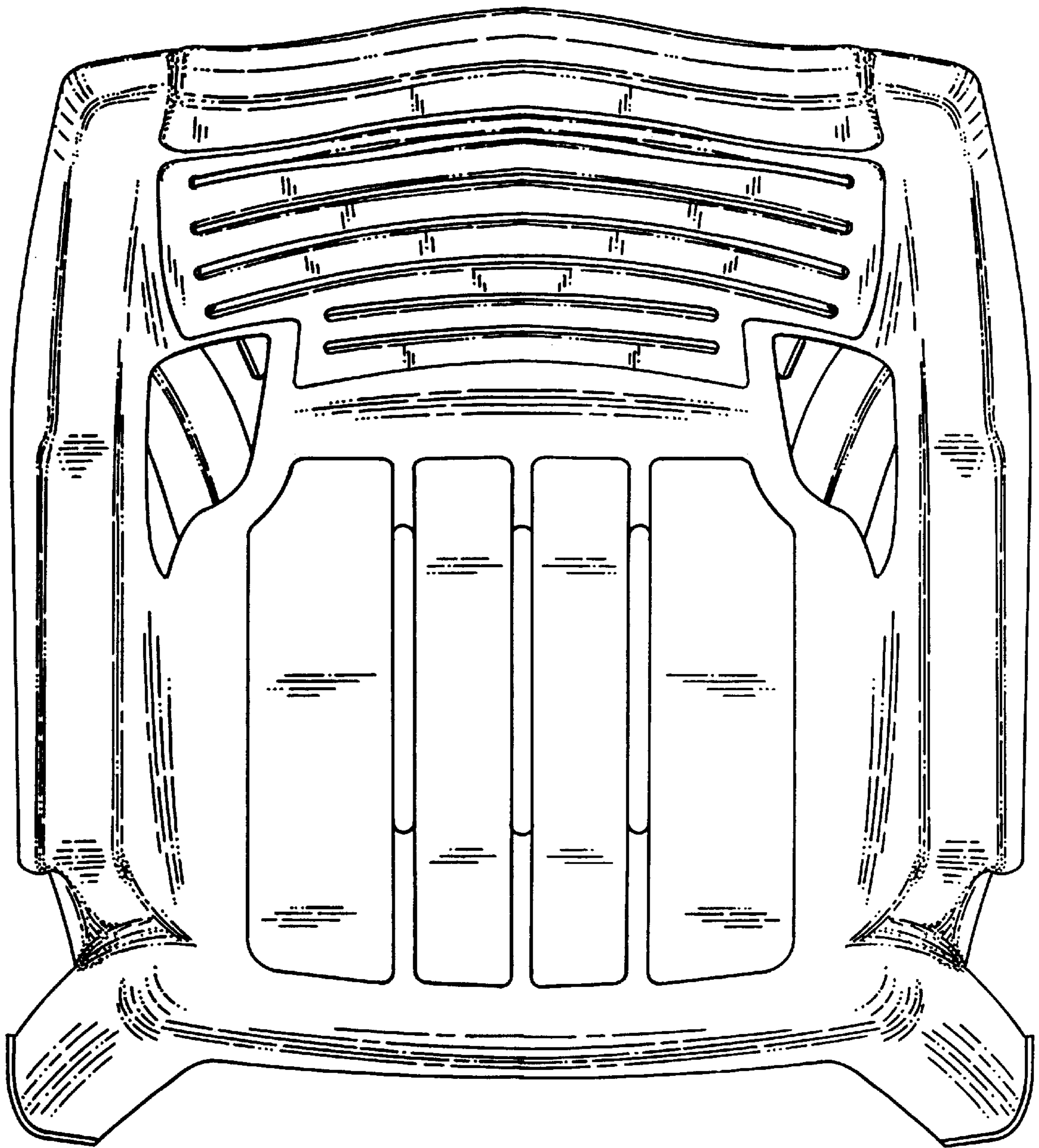

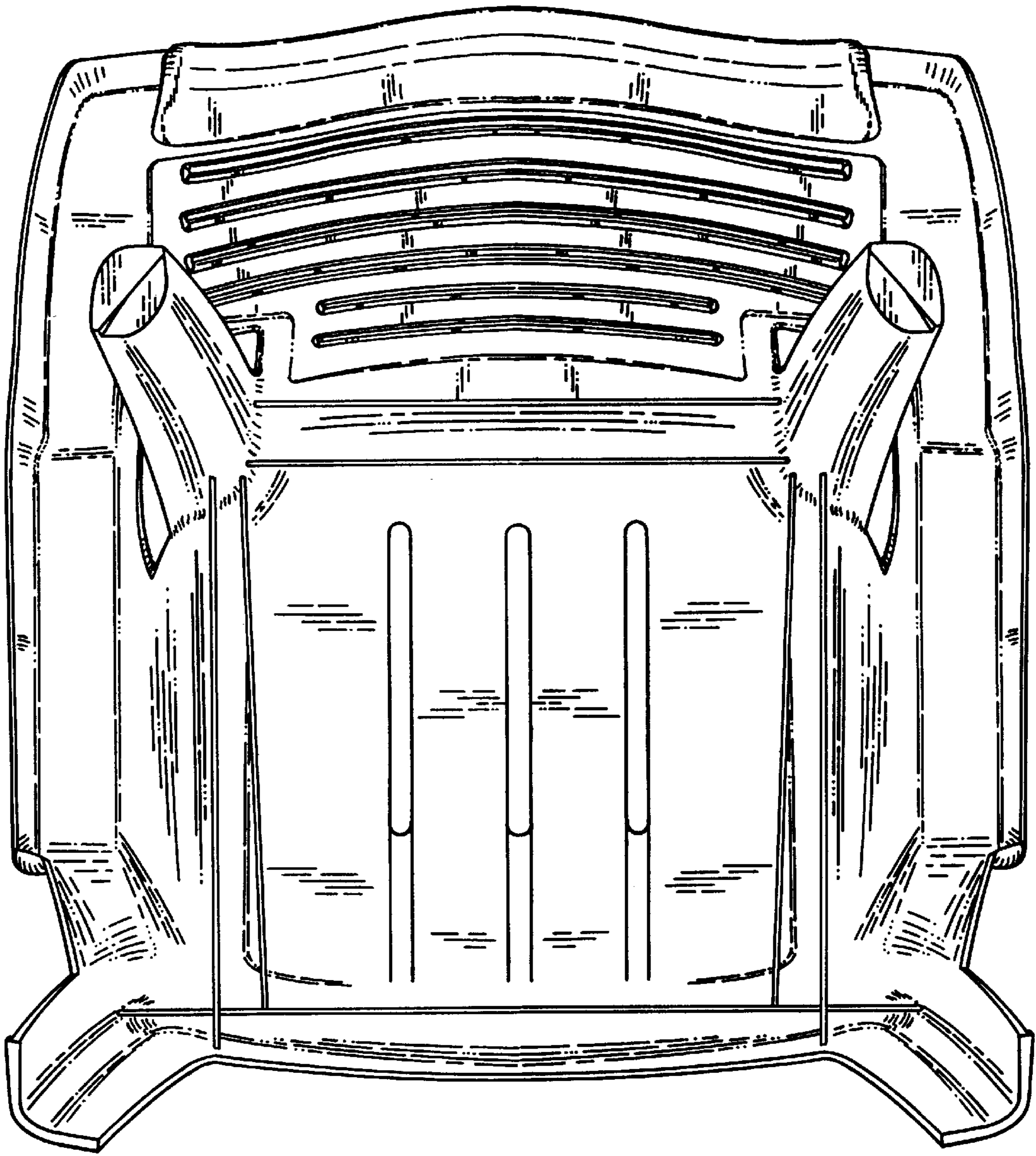

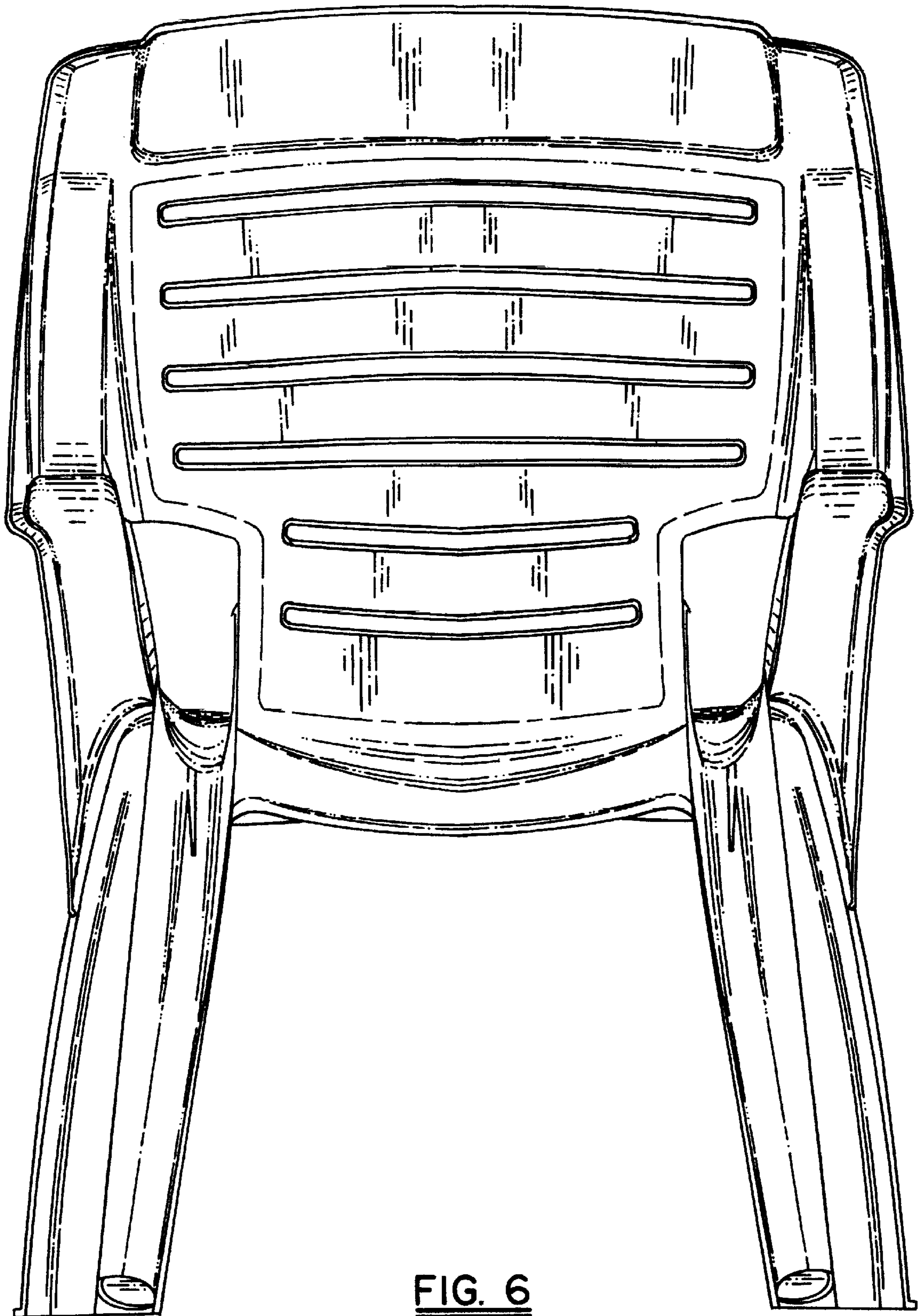
