[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a floor-mounted billiard cue rack, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a floor-mounted billiard cue rack showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an elevational view taken from one side opposite that of FIG. 3;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The bracketed portion of the vertical shaft is shown brokenaway in the views to indicate indeterminate length.
