DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of my new design for a loudspeaker.
FIG. 2 is a left end elevation view of the loudspeaker.

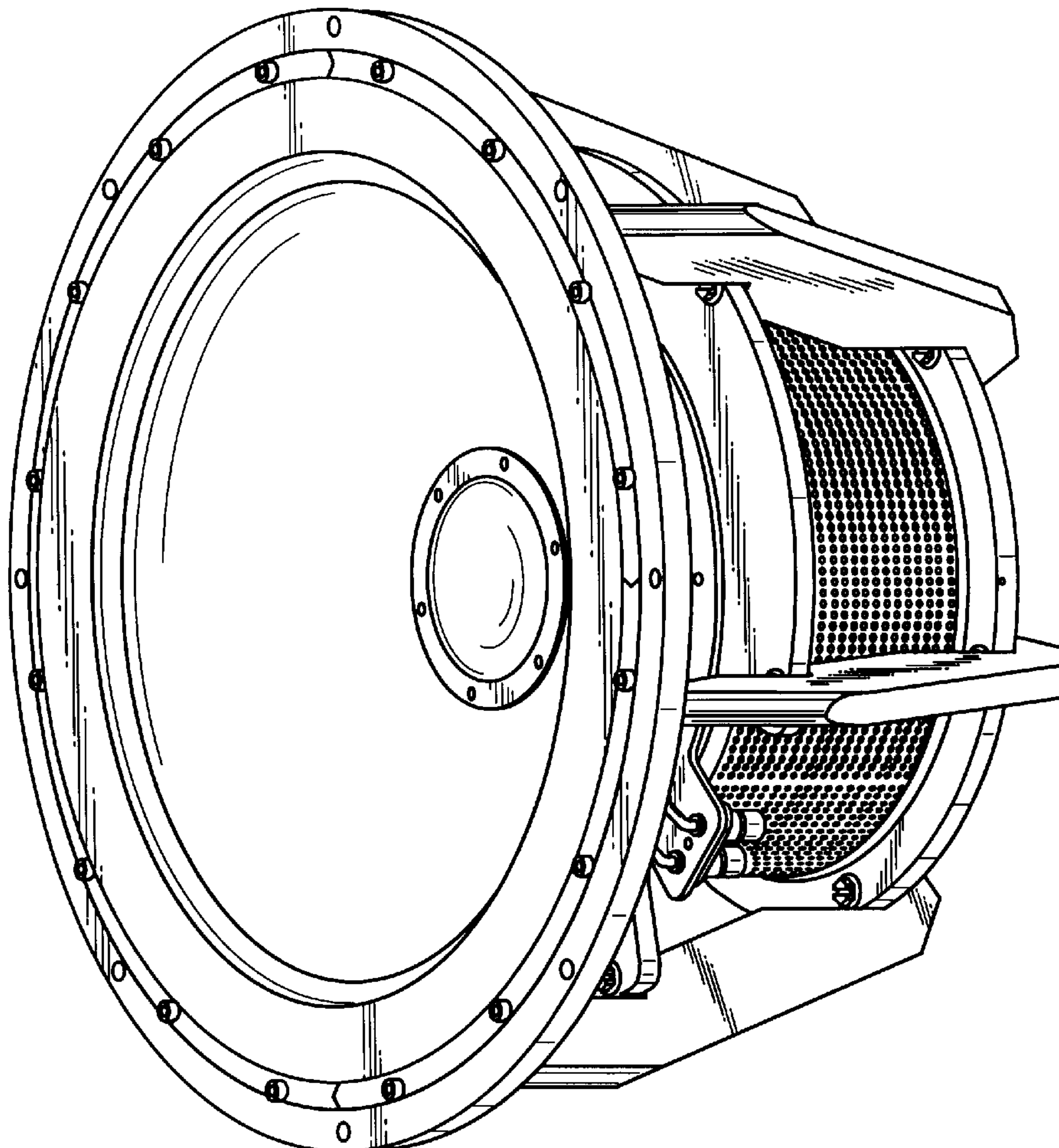

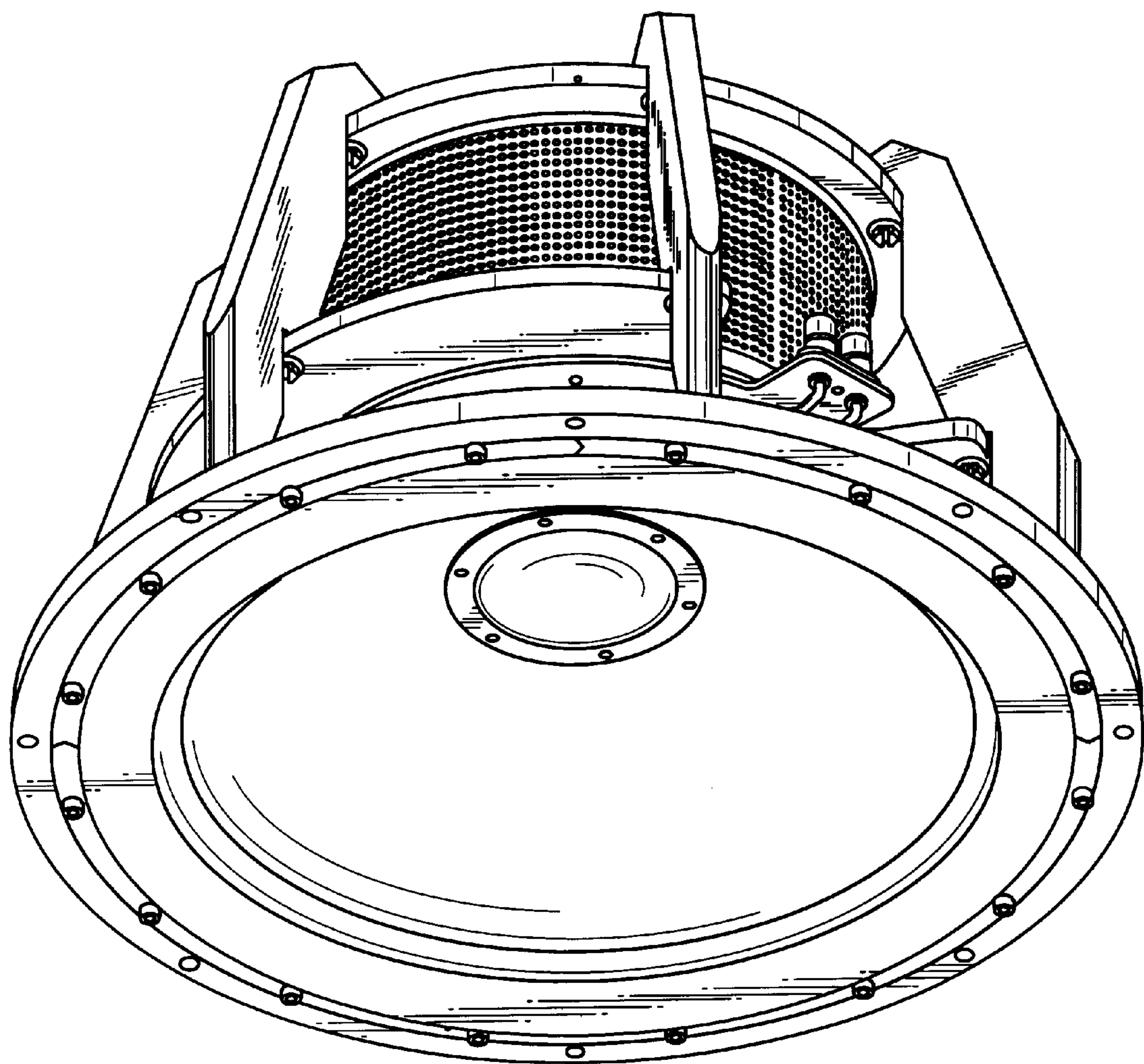

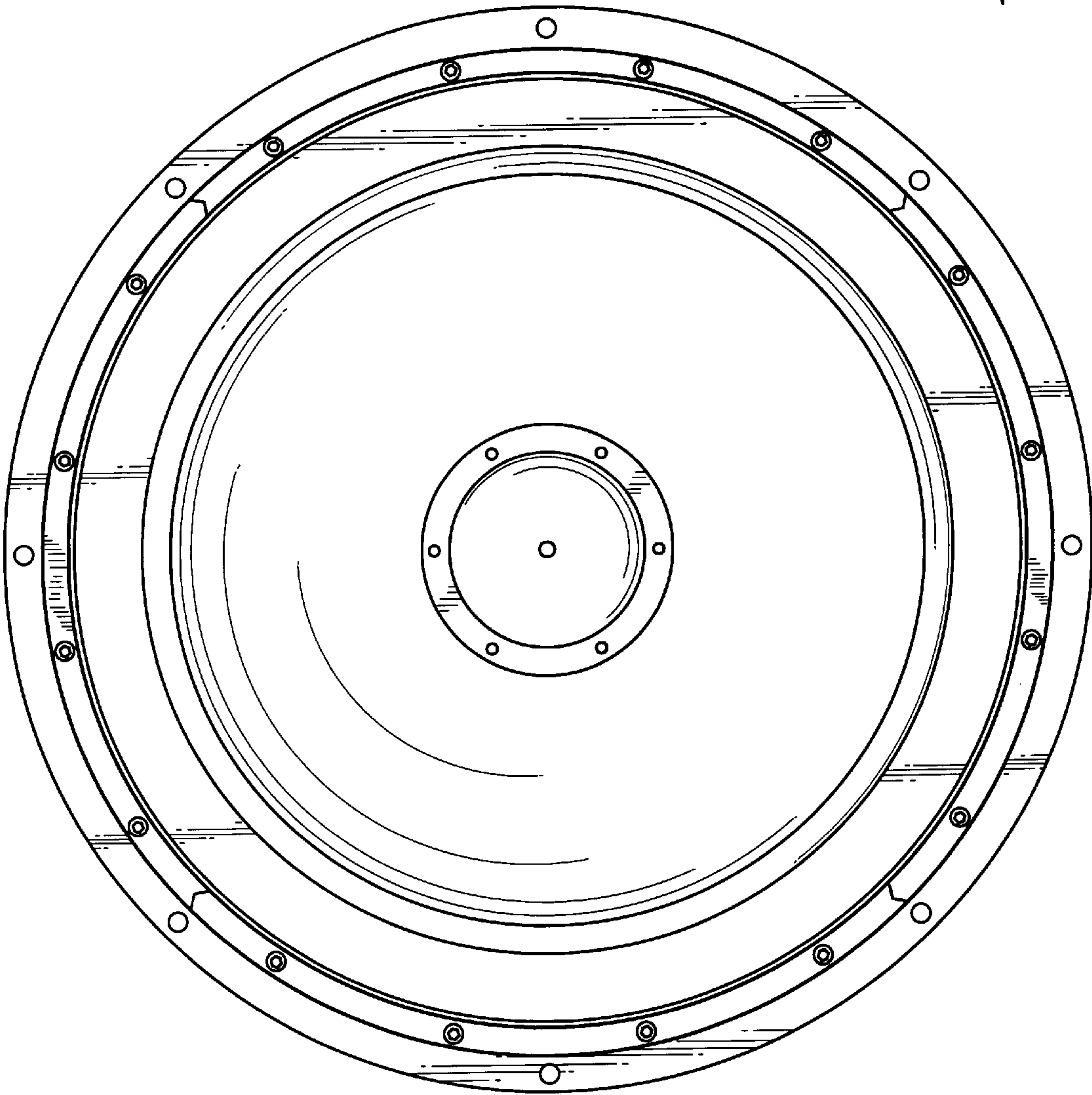
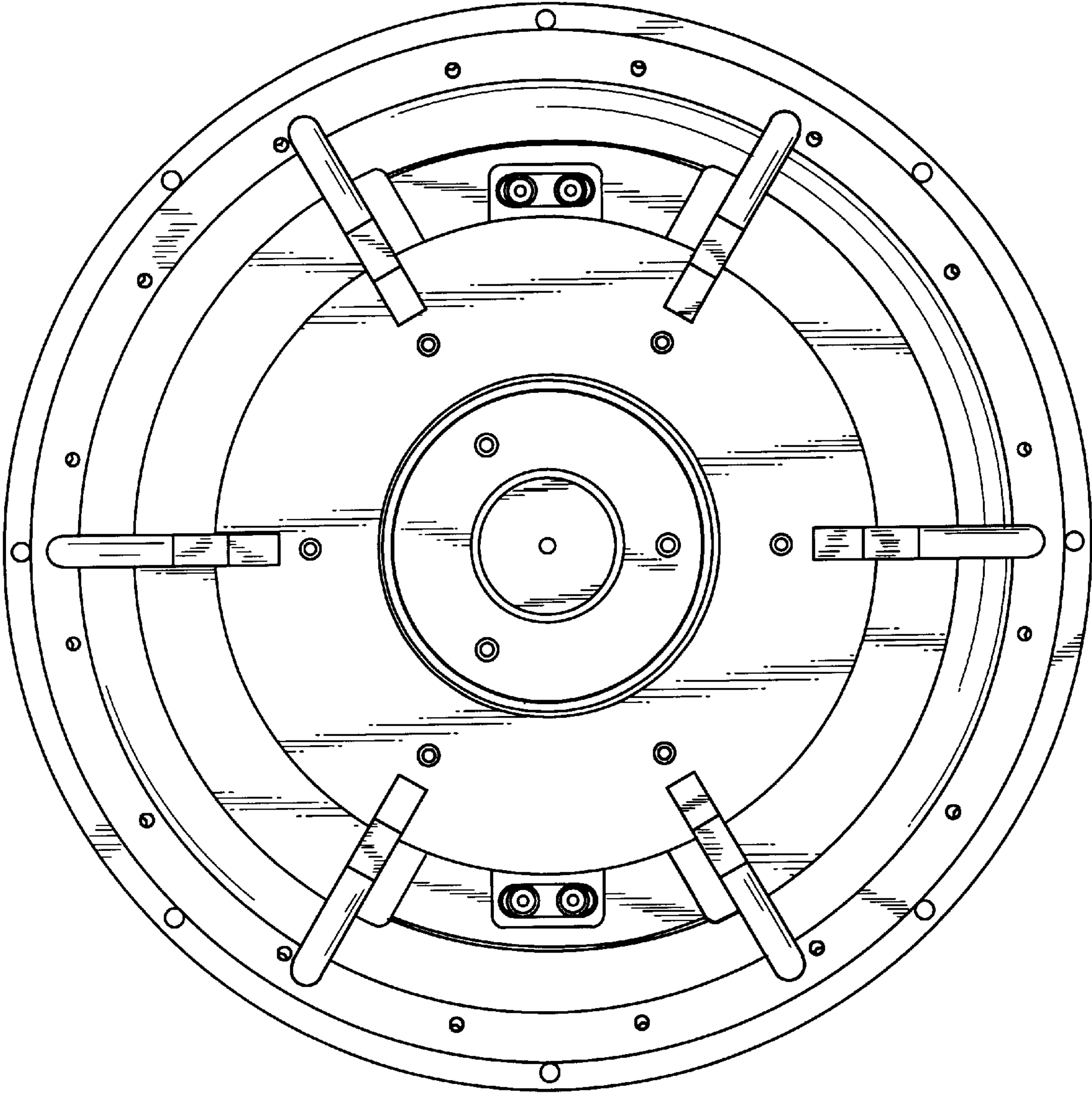

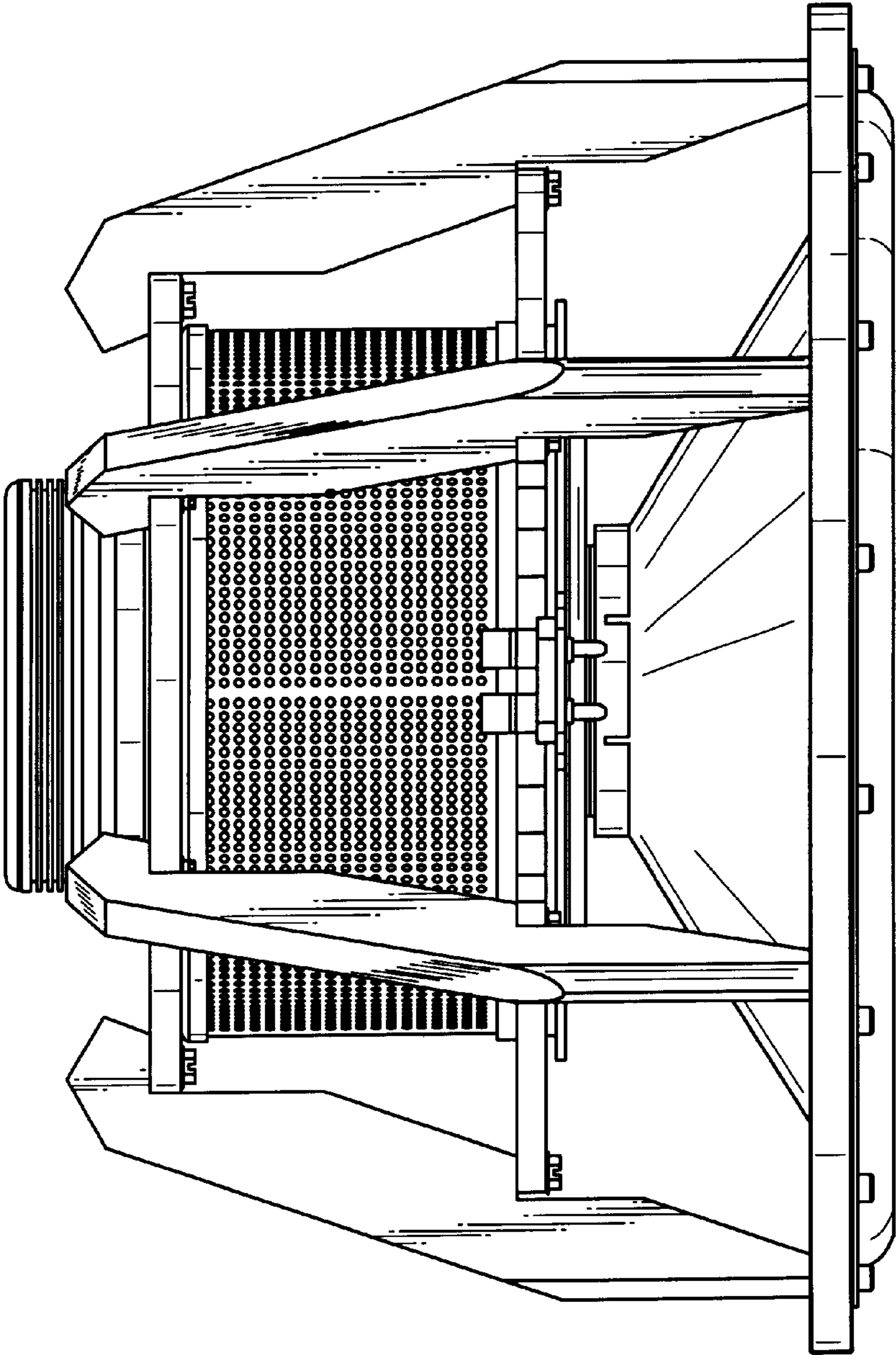

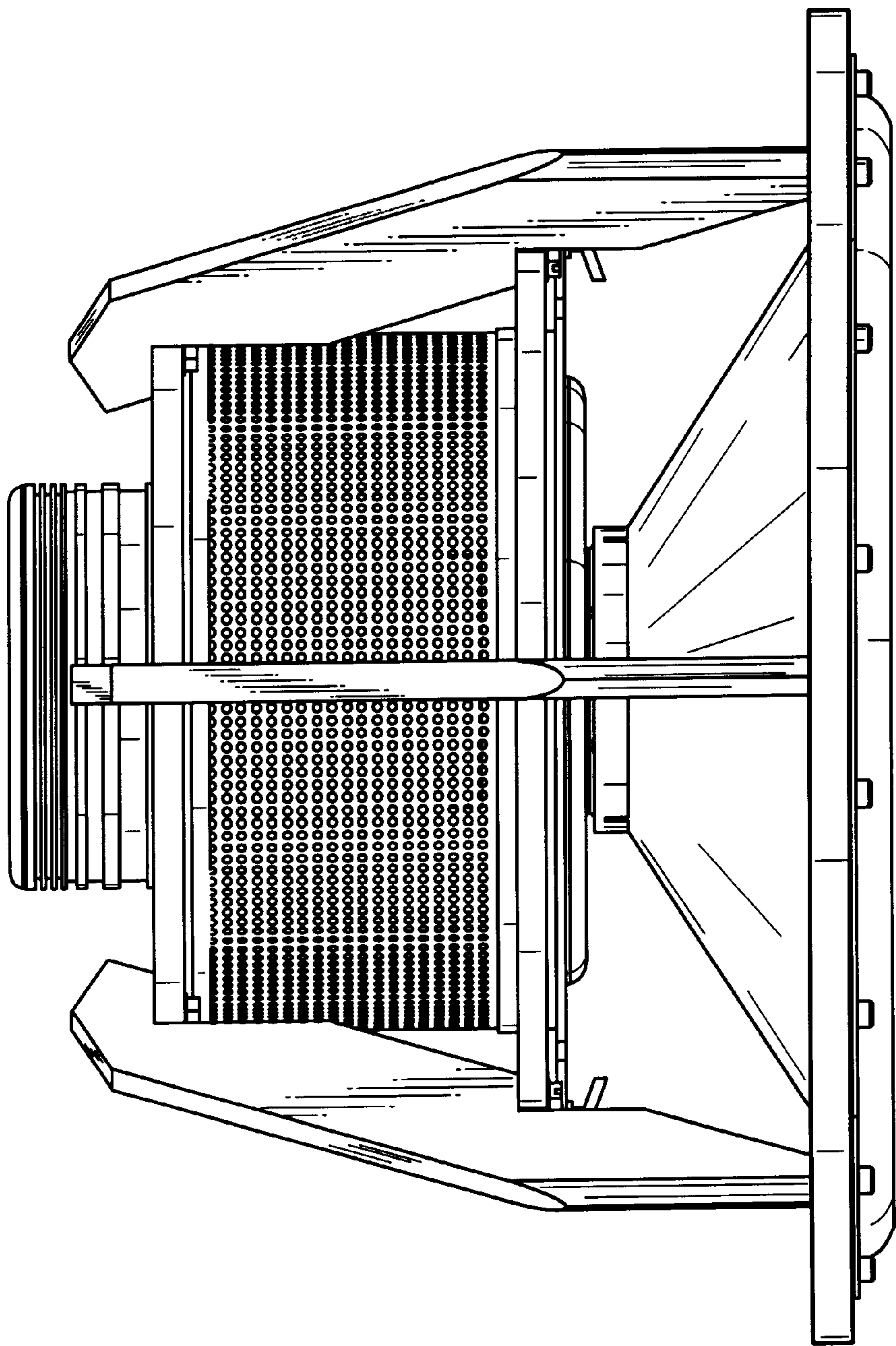
