The ornamental design for a fuel dispenser interface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a fuel dispenser interface showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view; and,

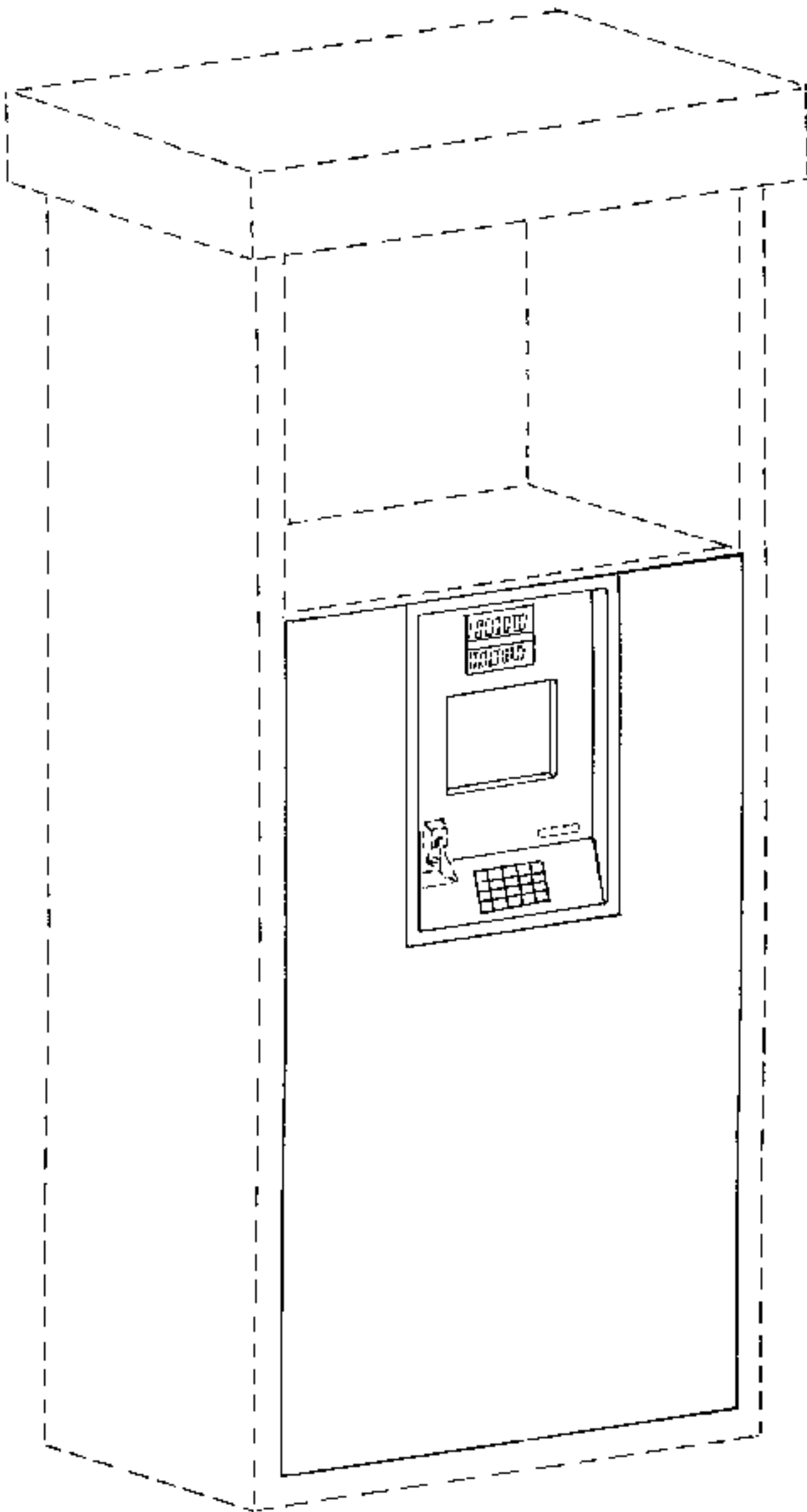
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view.

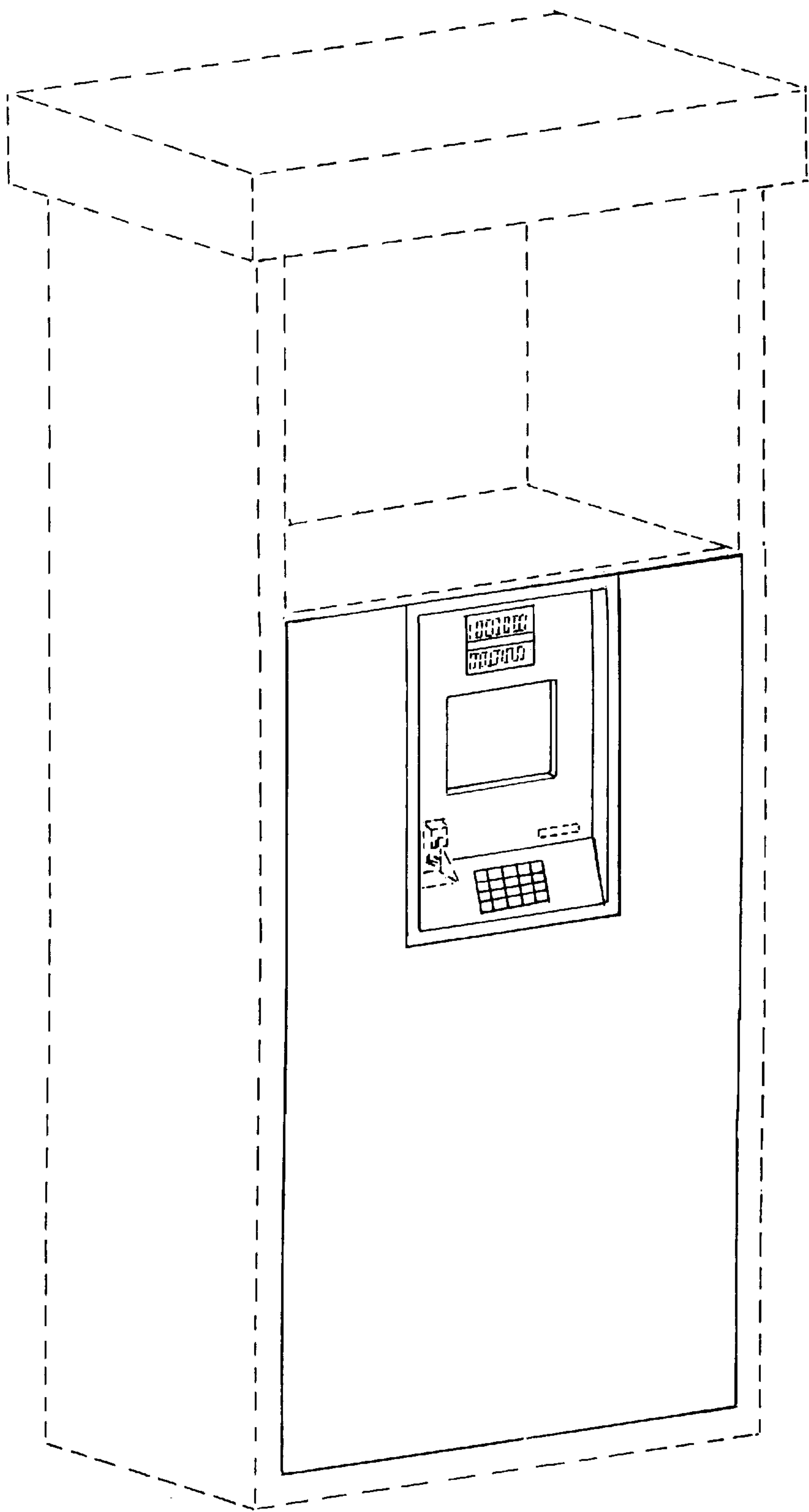

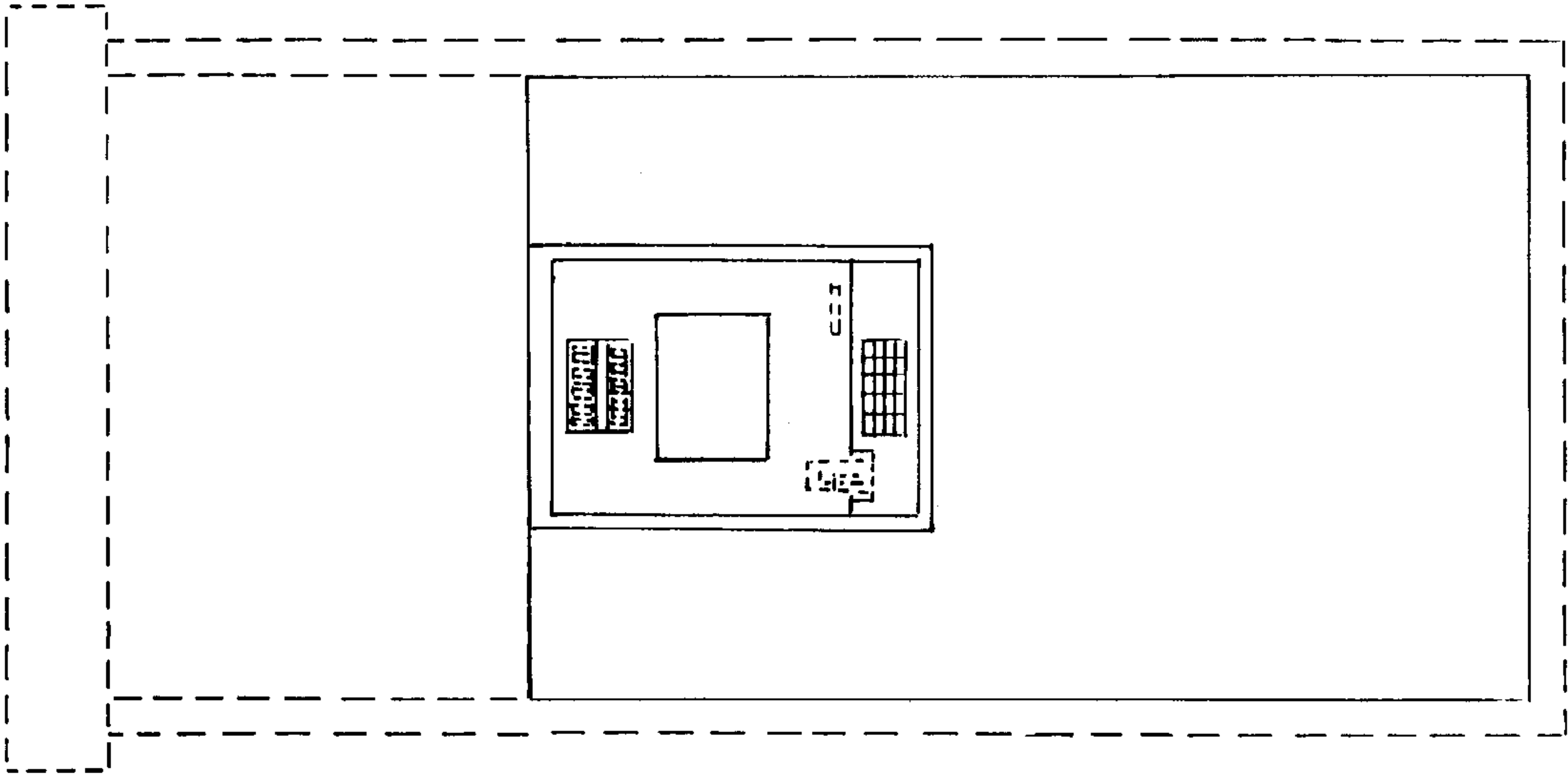
