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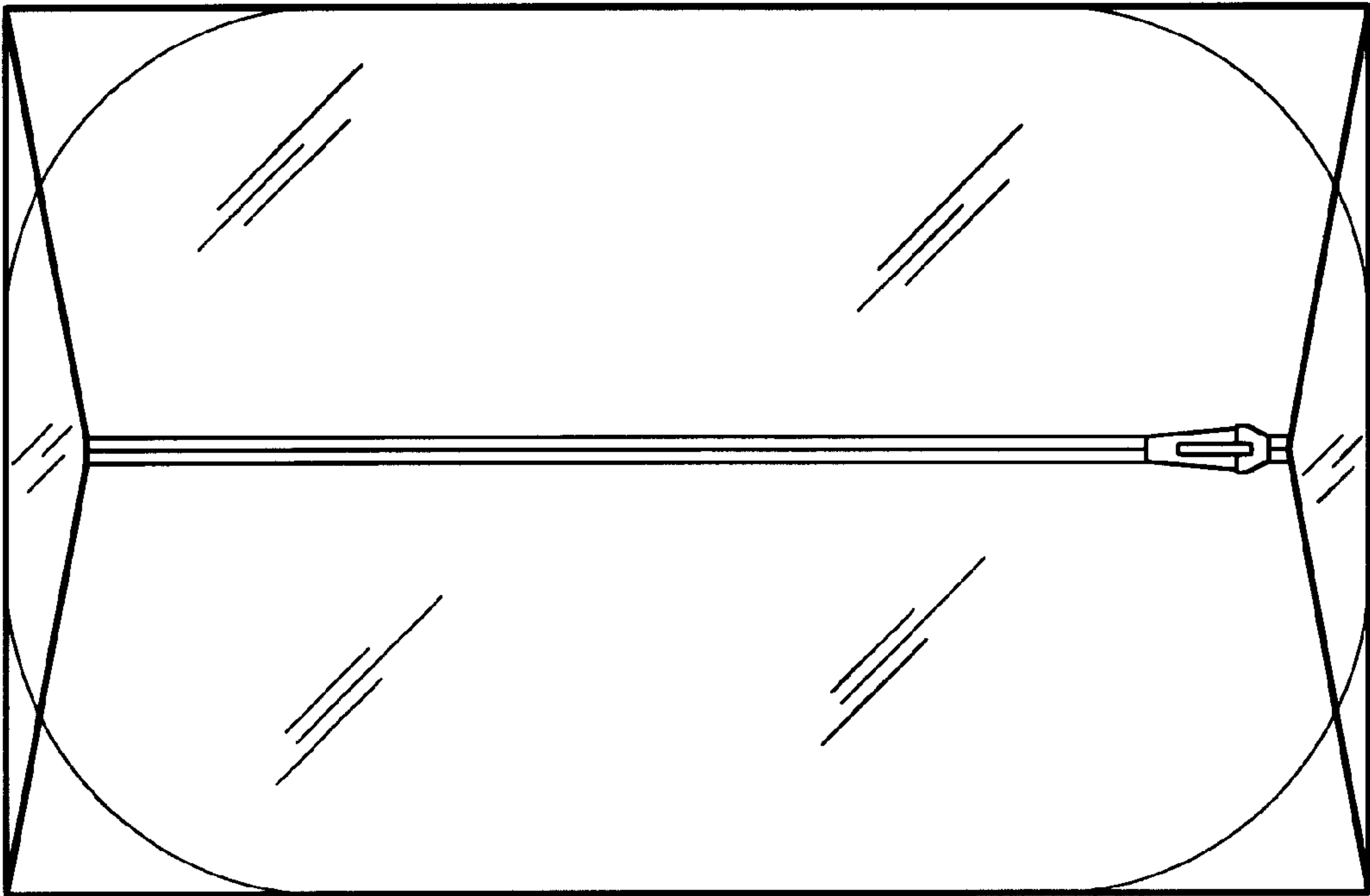
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a wound drainage device embodying my design with shading showing the transparent nature of the upper portion;

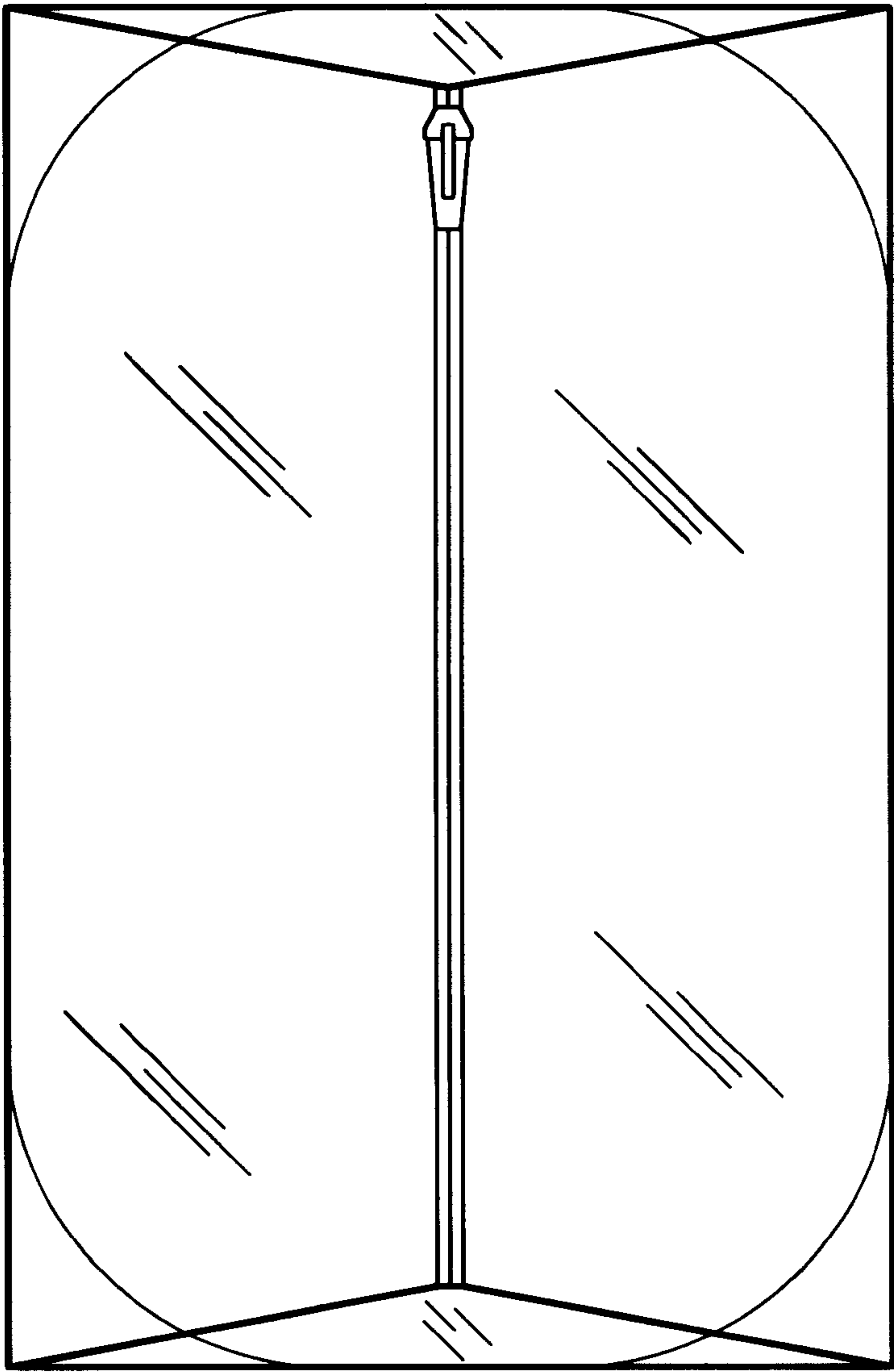

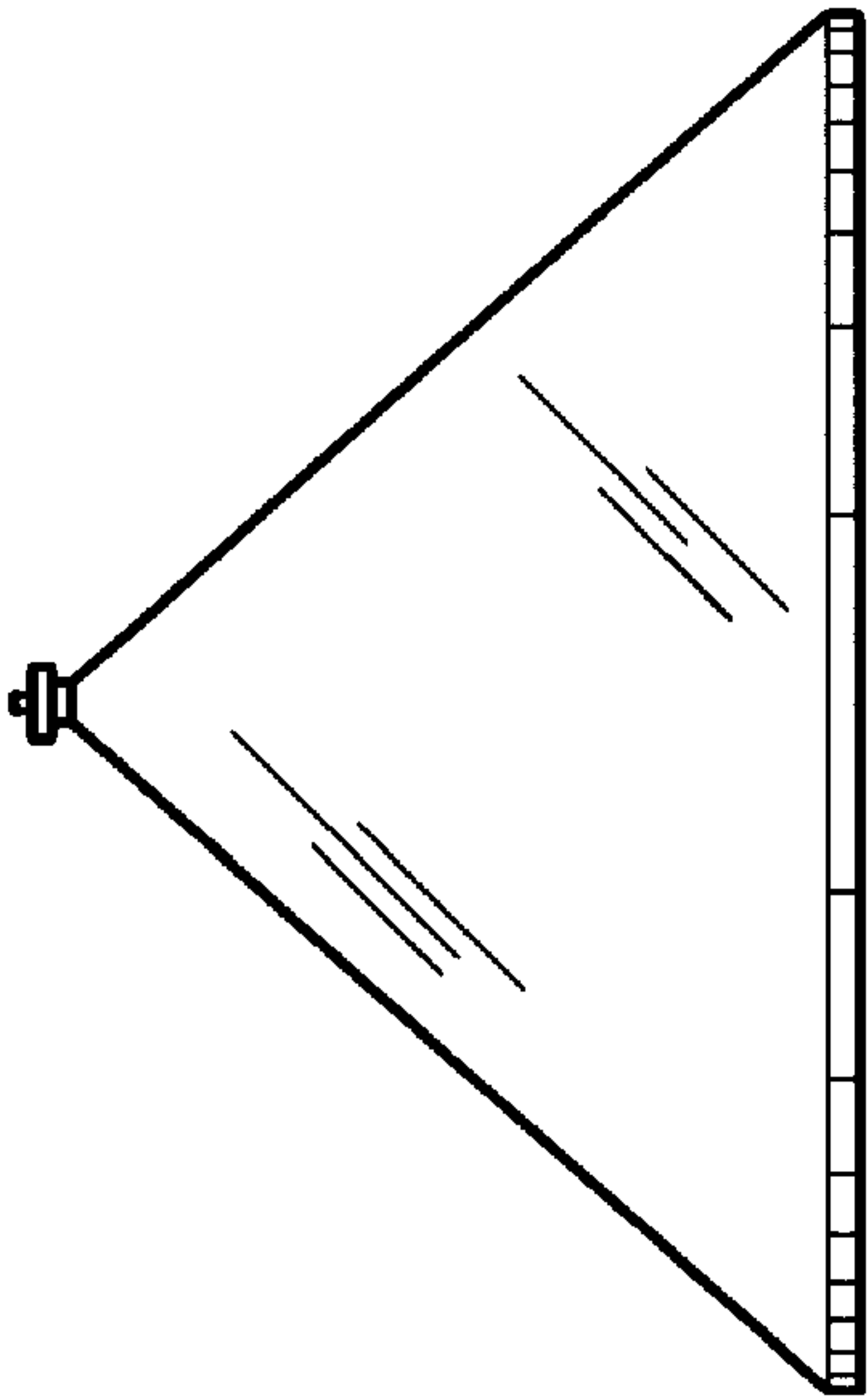

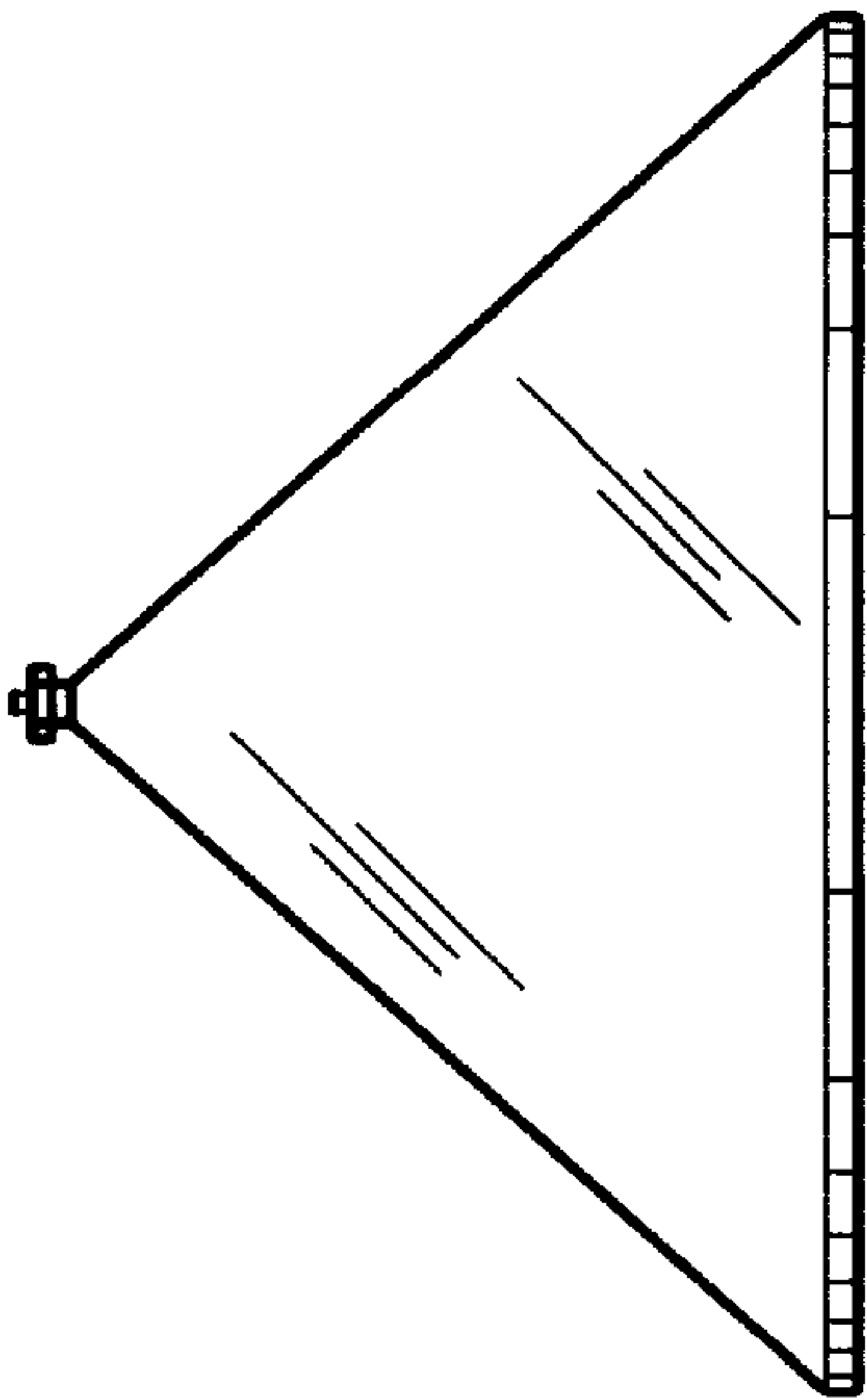

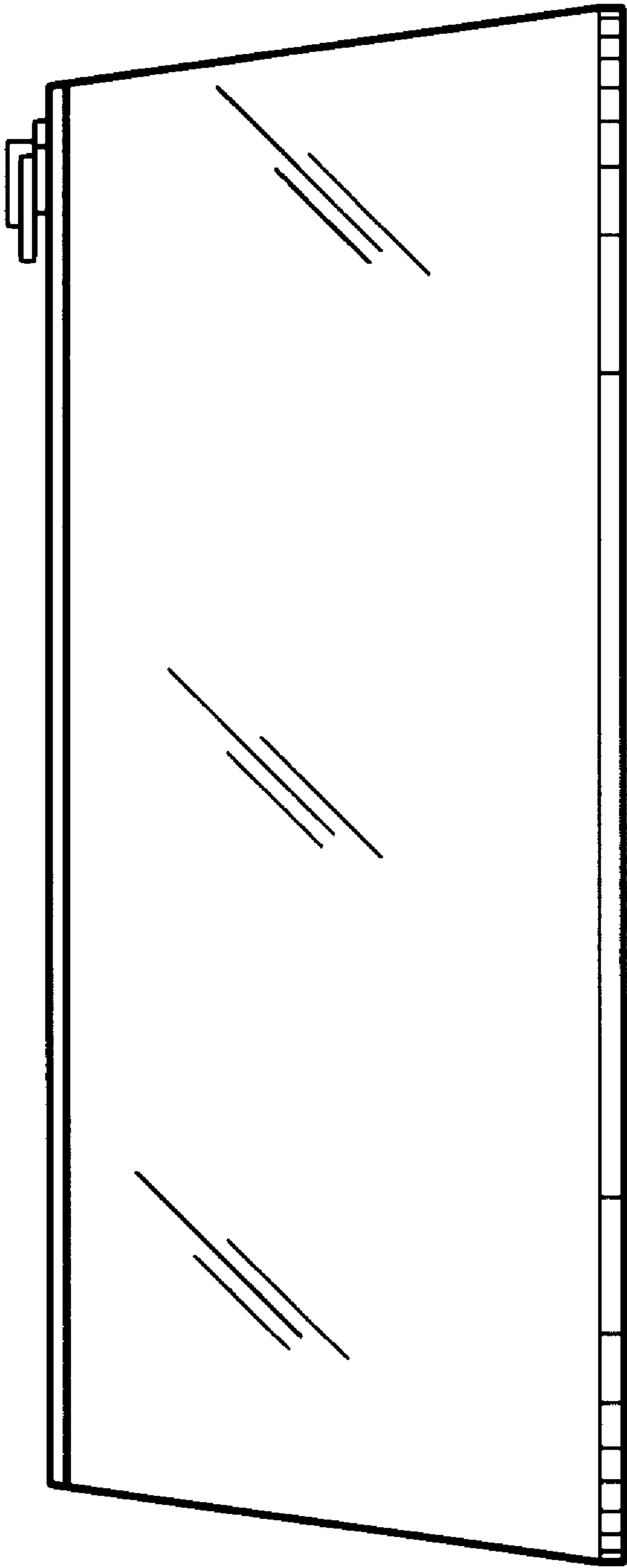

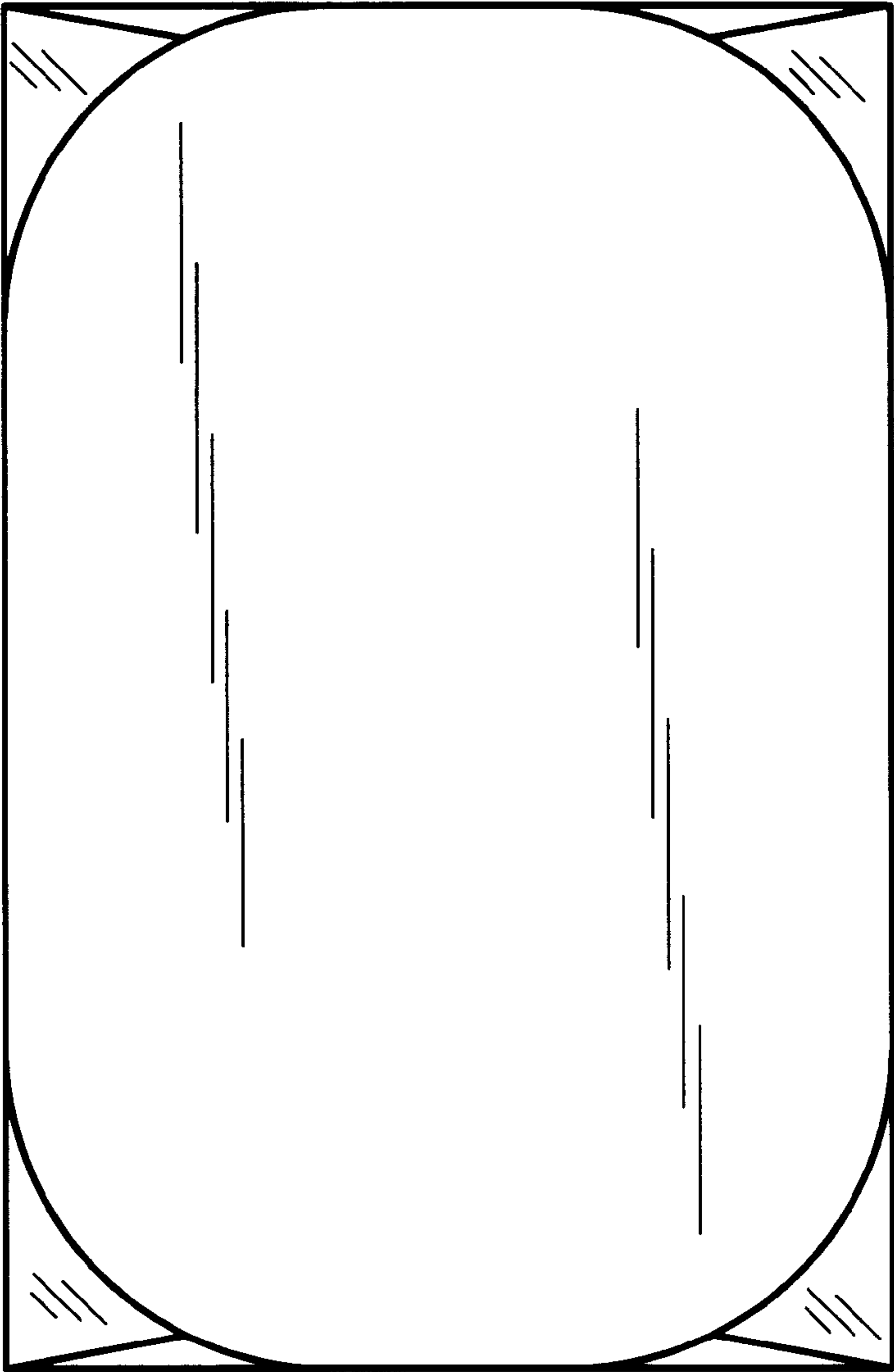
