FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the male incontinence guard of the present invention;

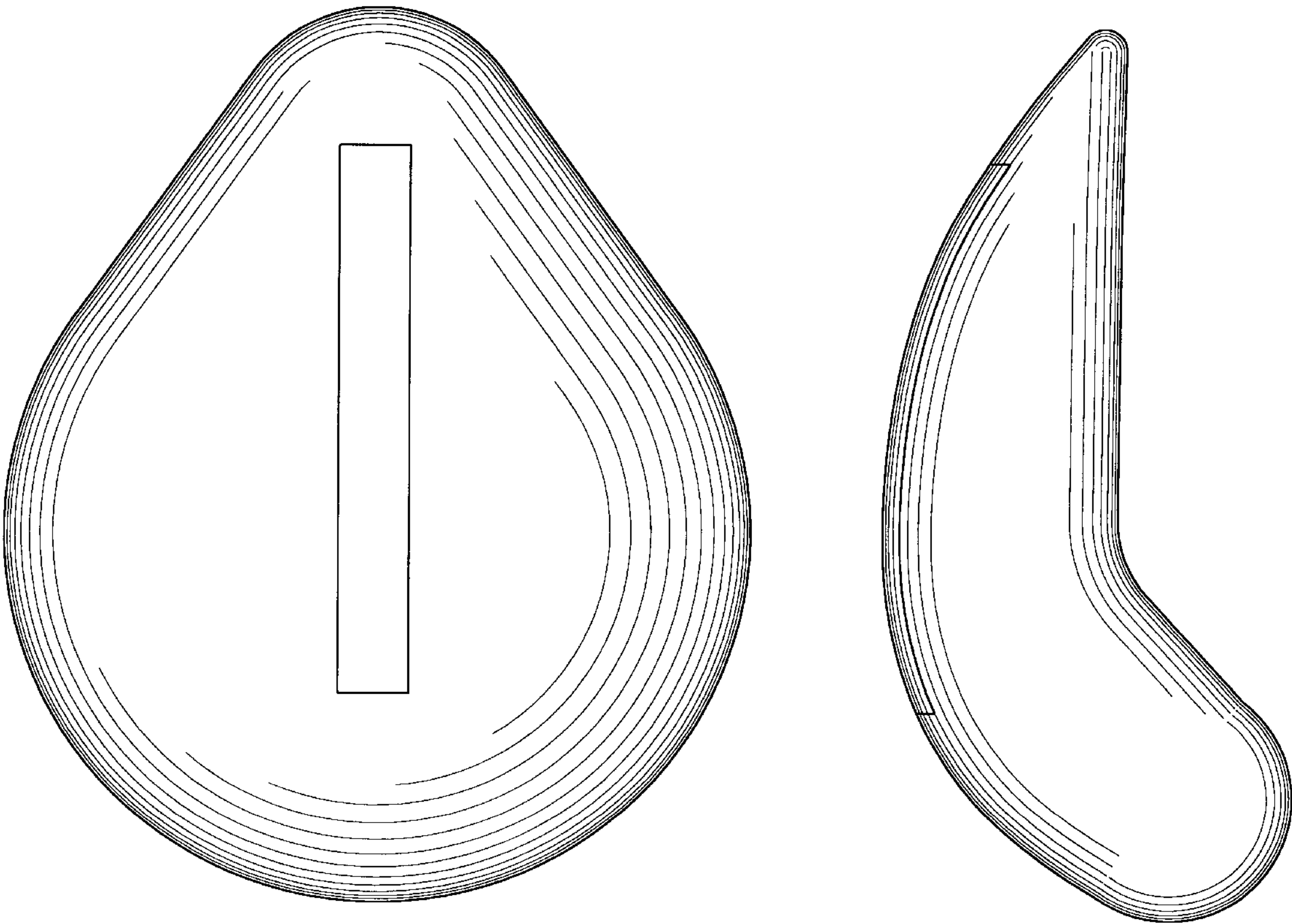

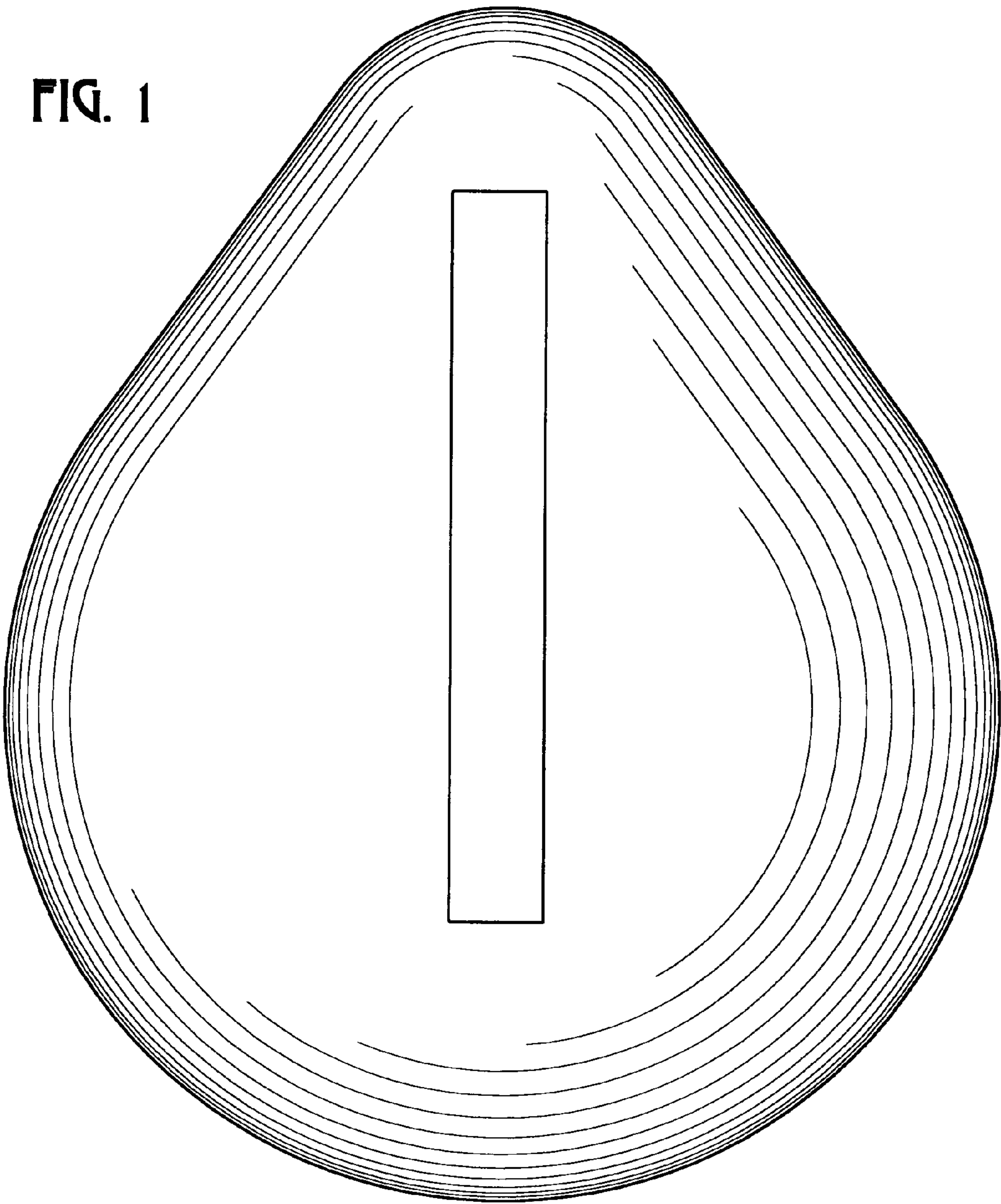

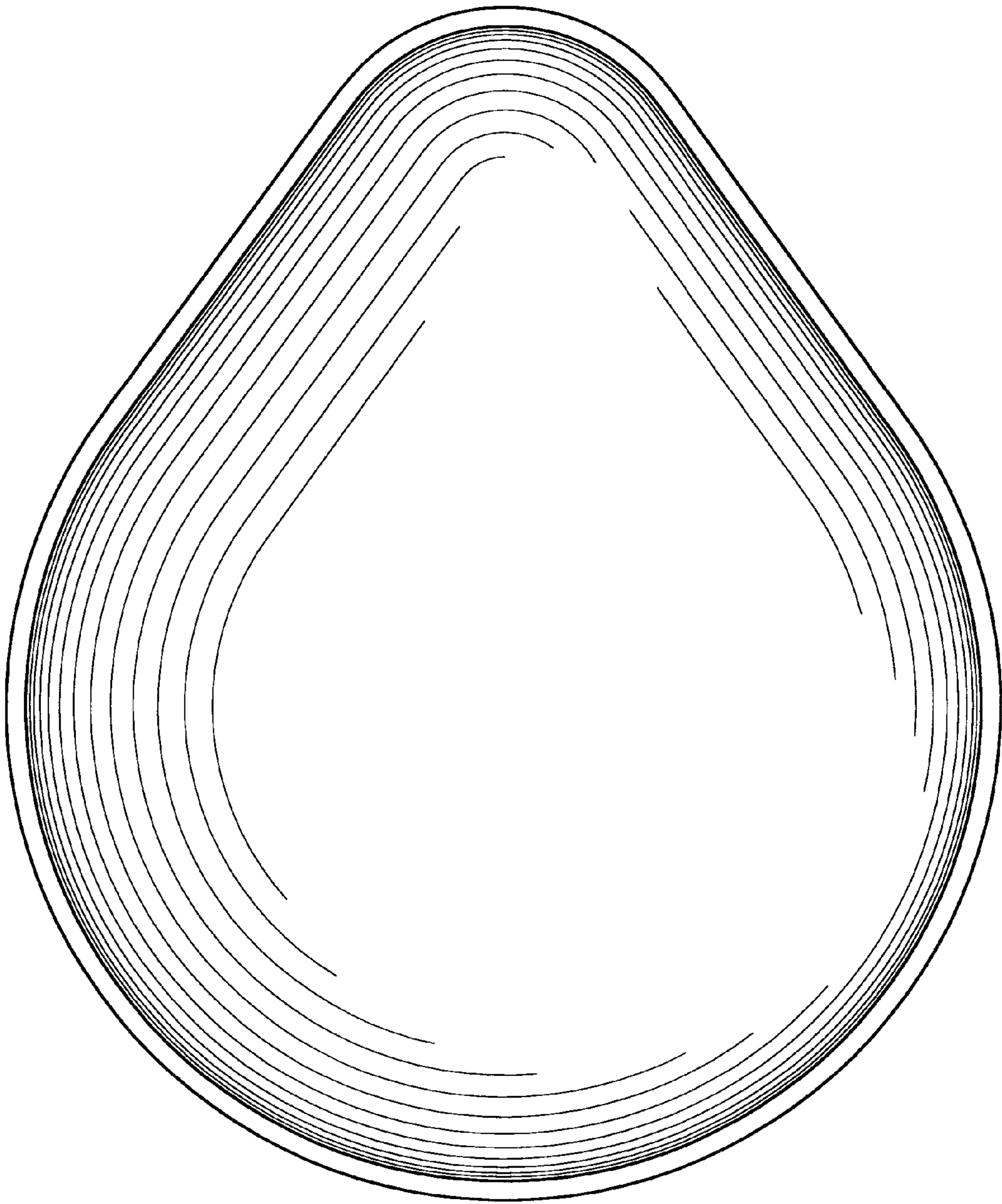

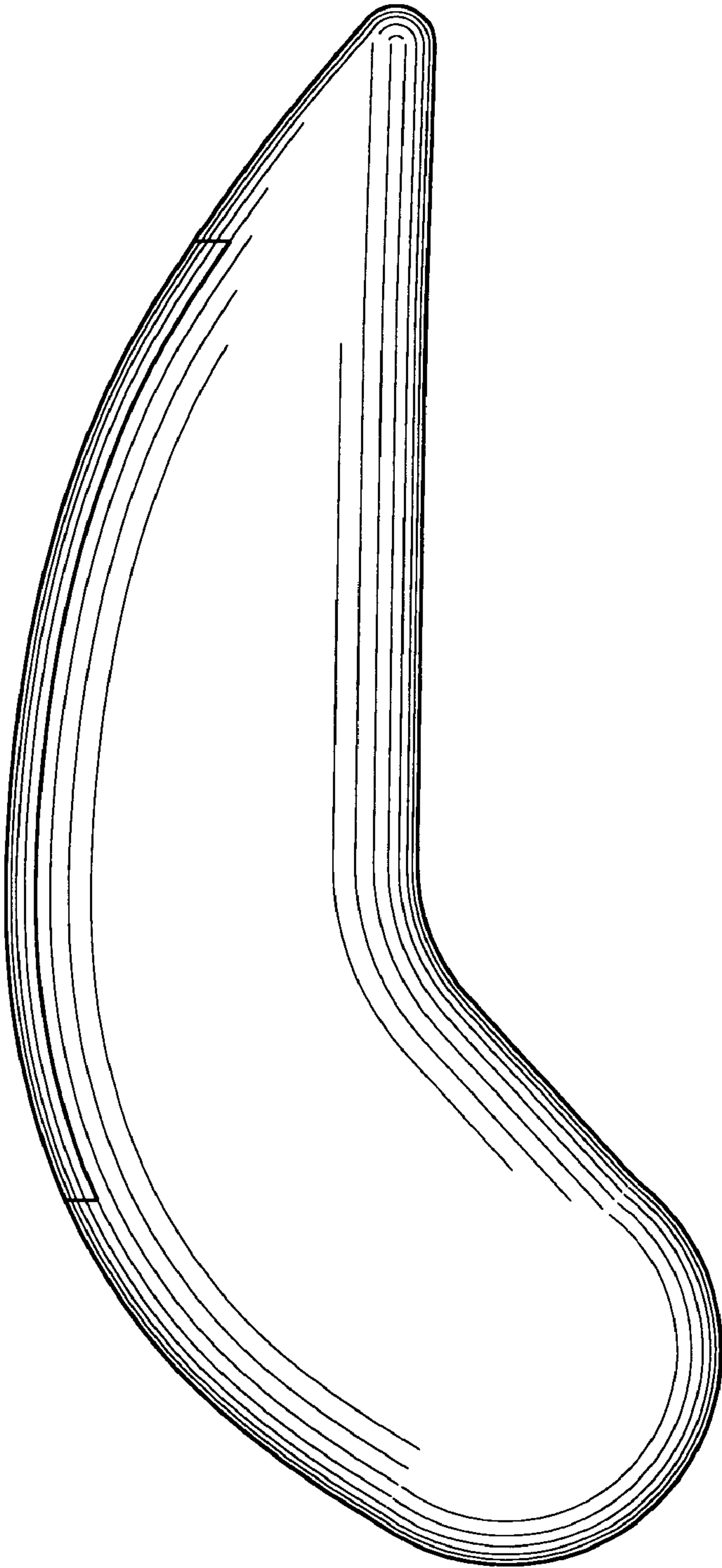

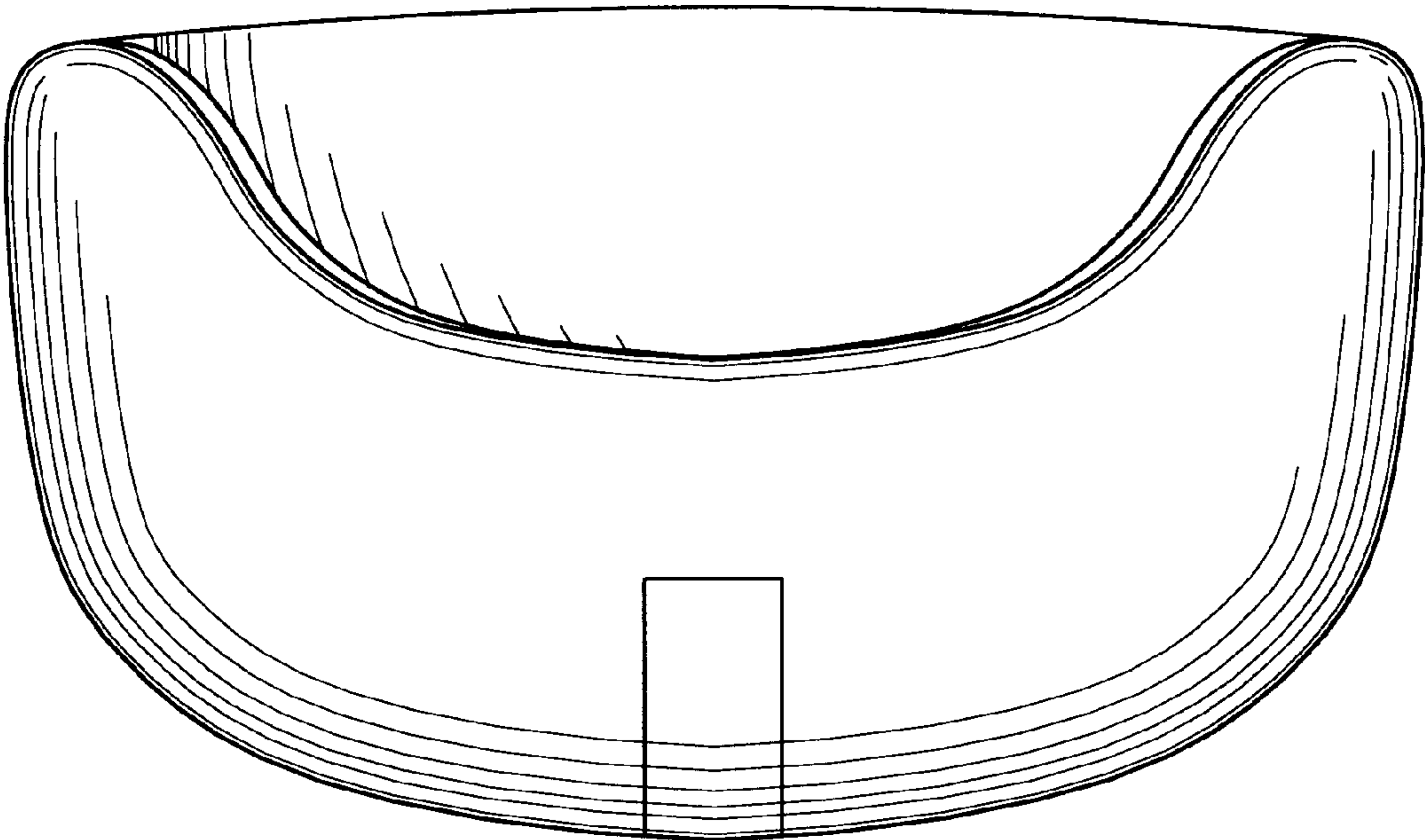
